The ornamental design for a combined television and video cassette recorder stand, as shown and described.

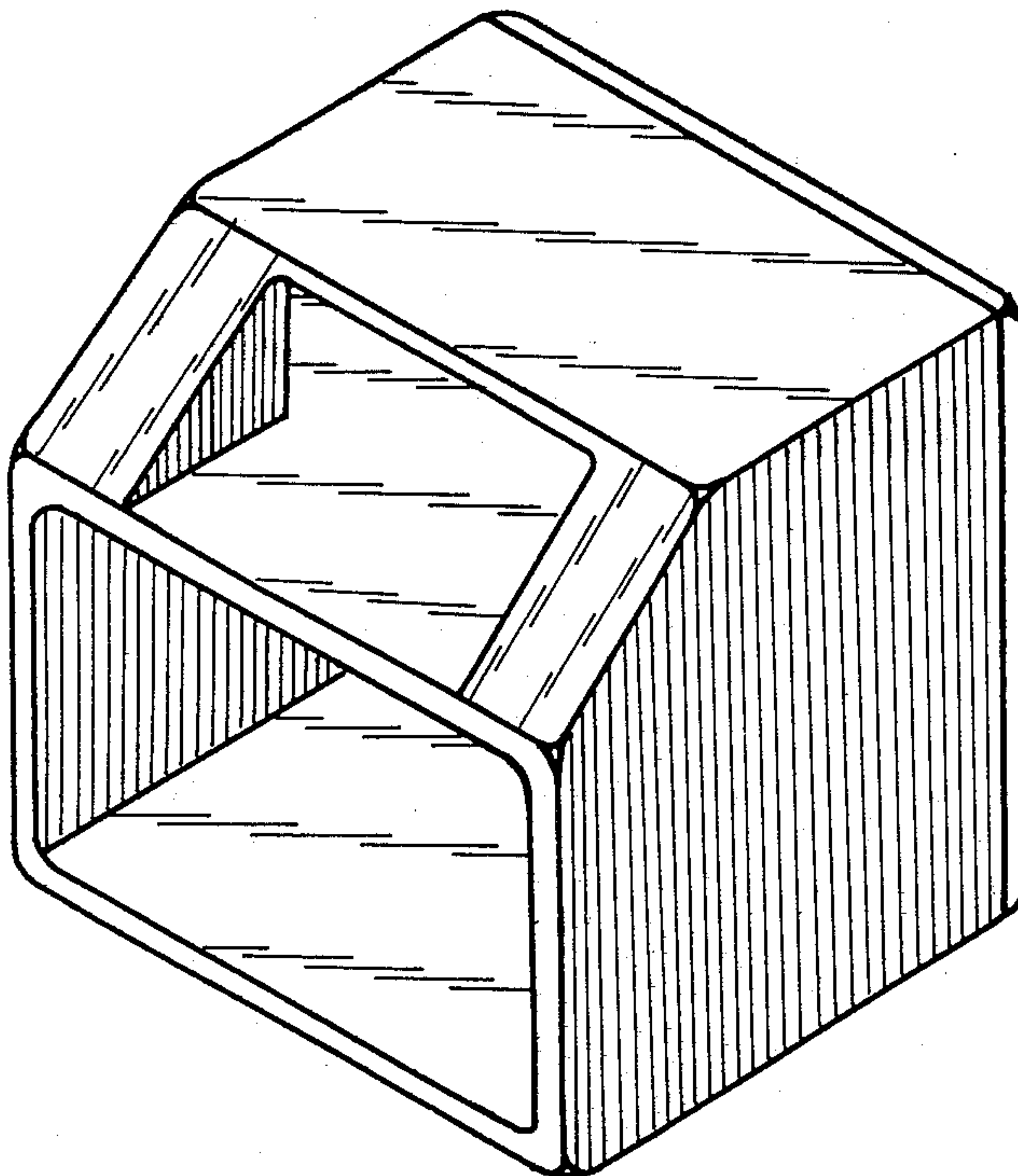
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof.



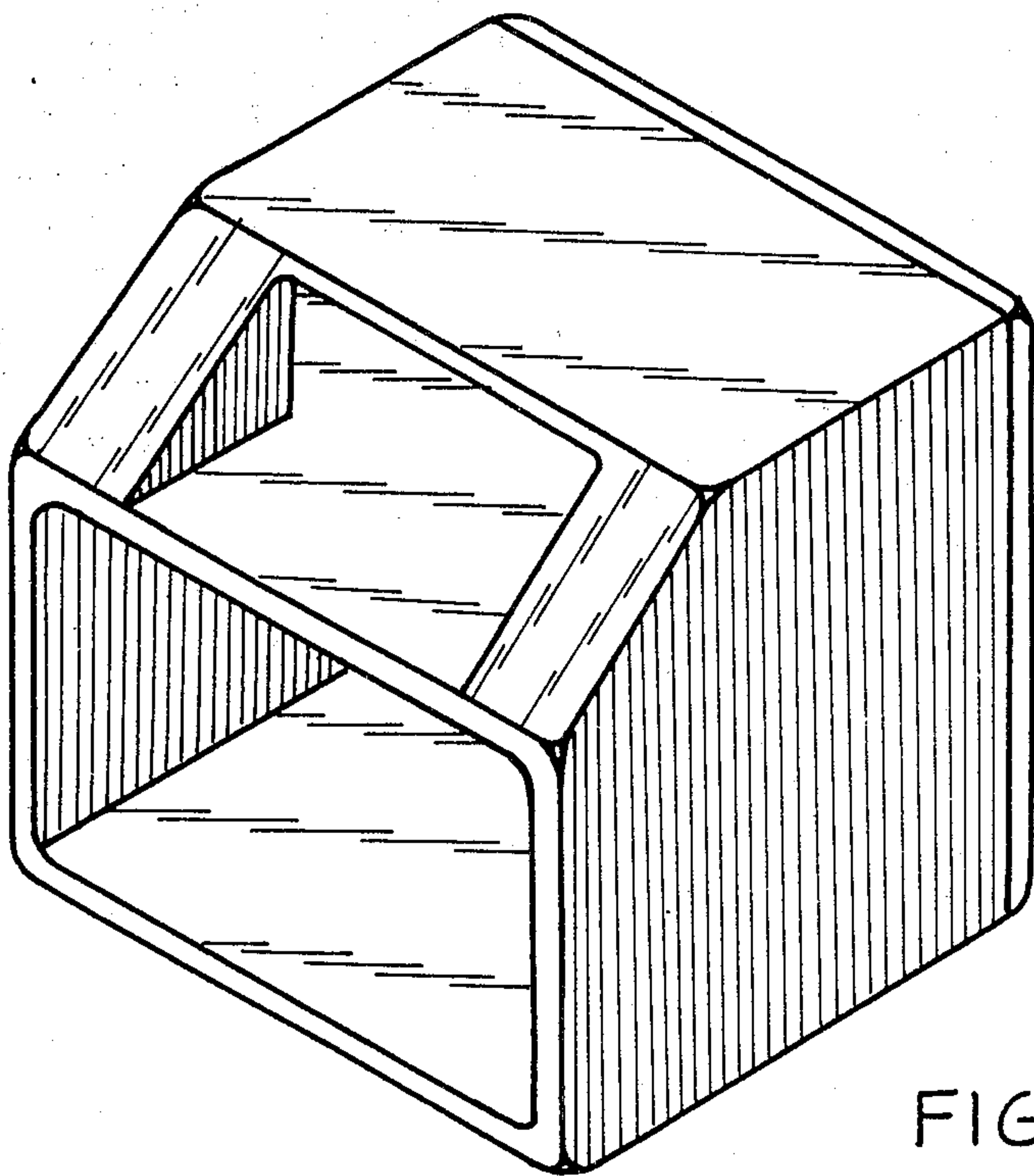

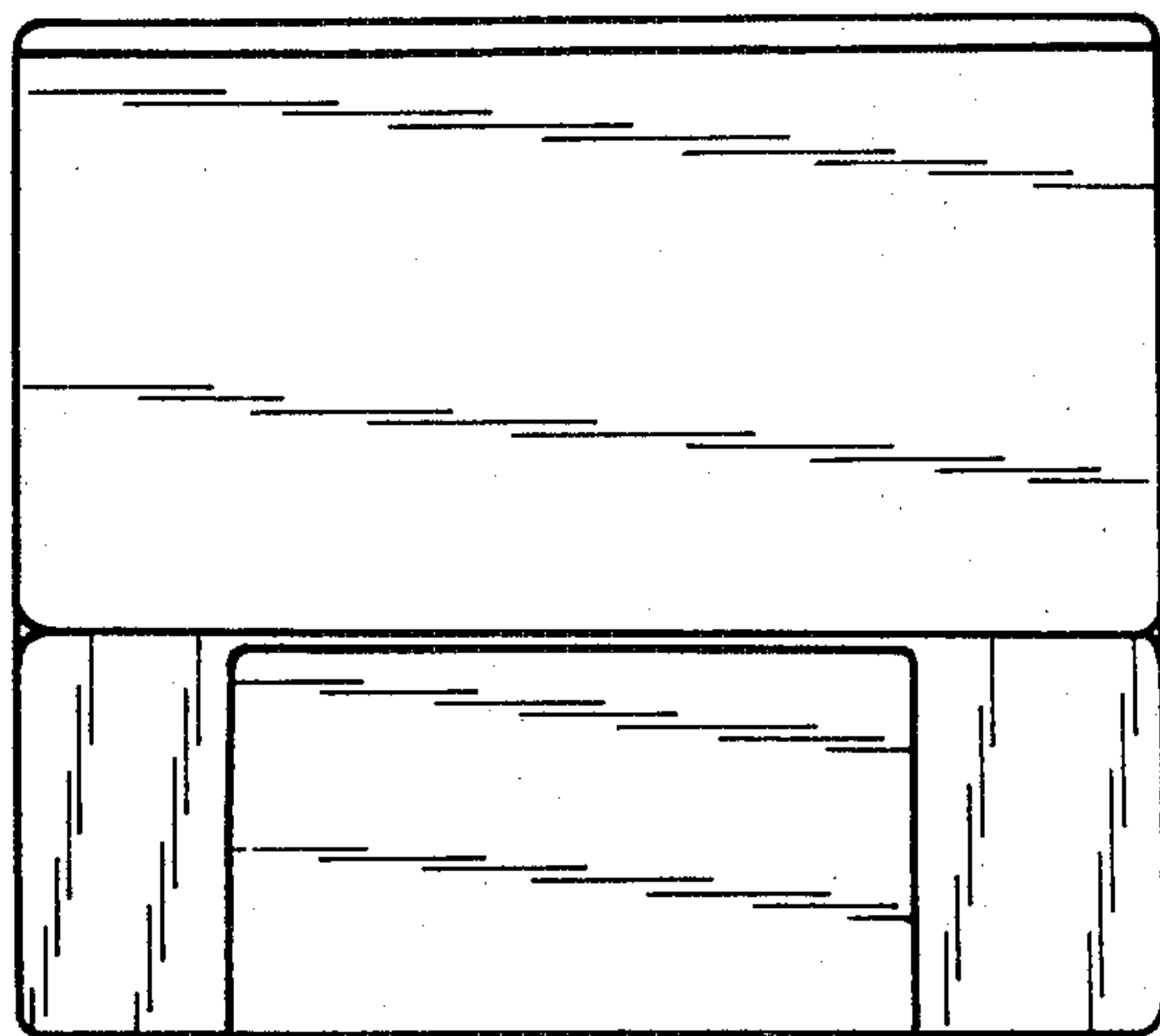

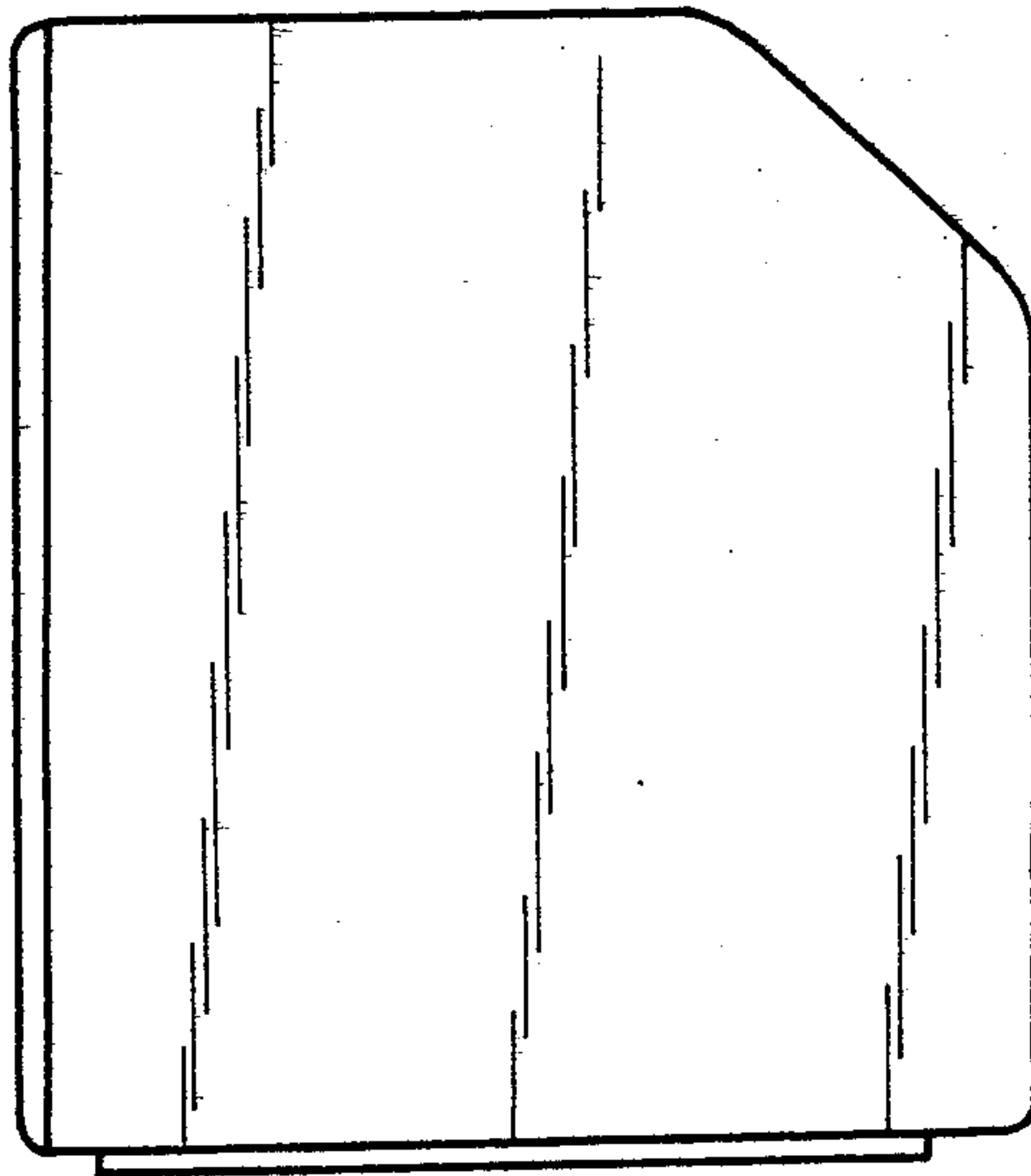

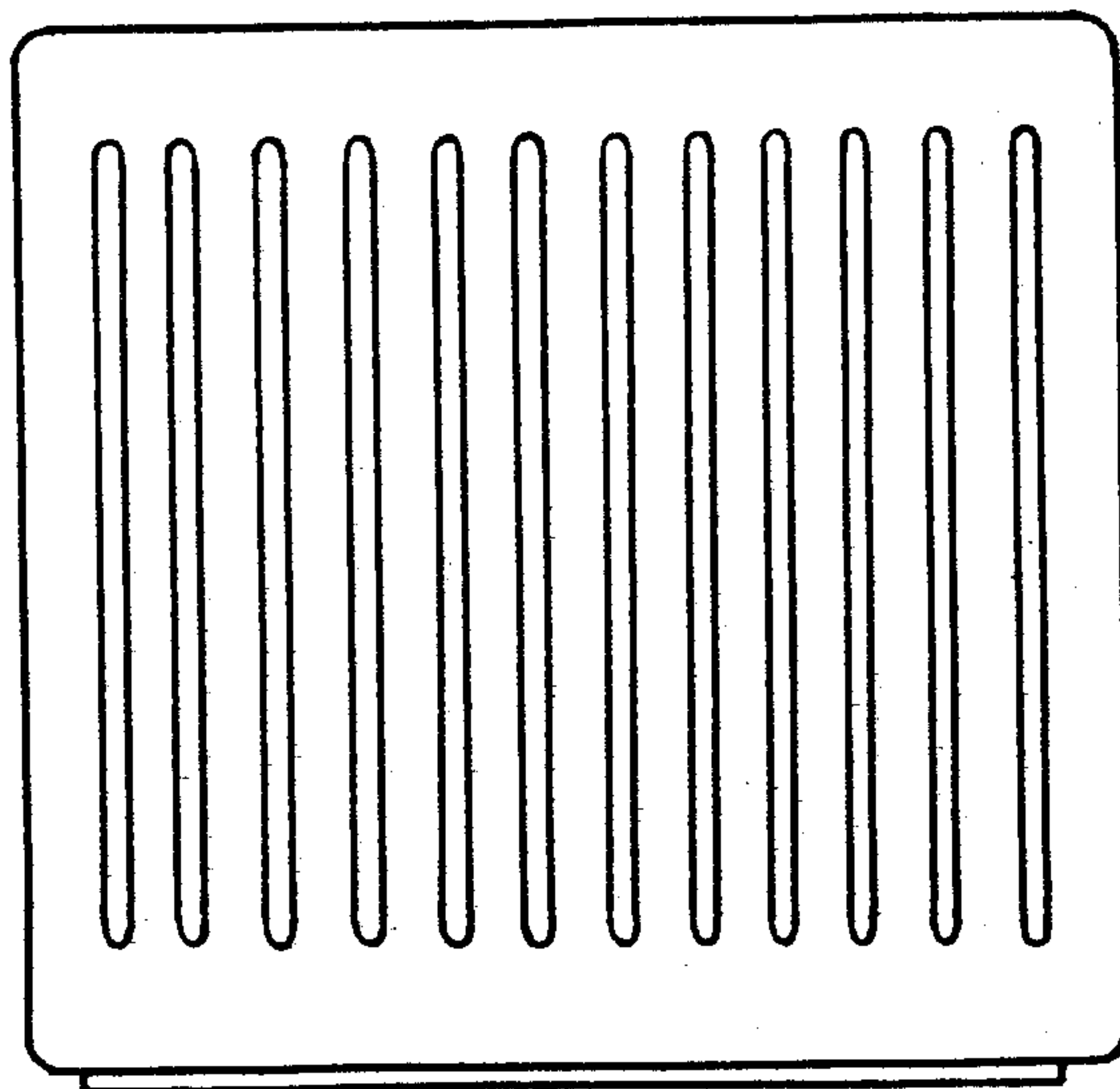
