[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a housing for a computer monitor or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a housing for a computer monitor or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale.

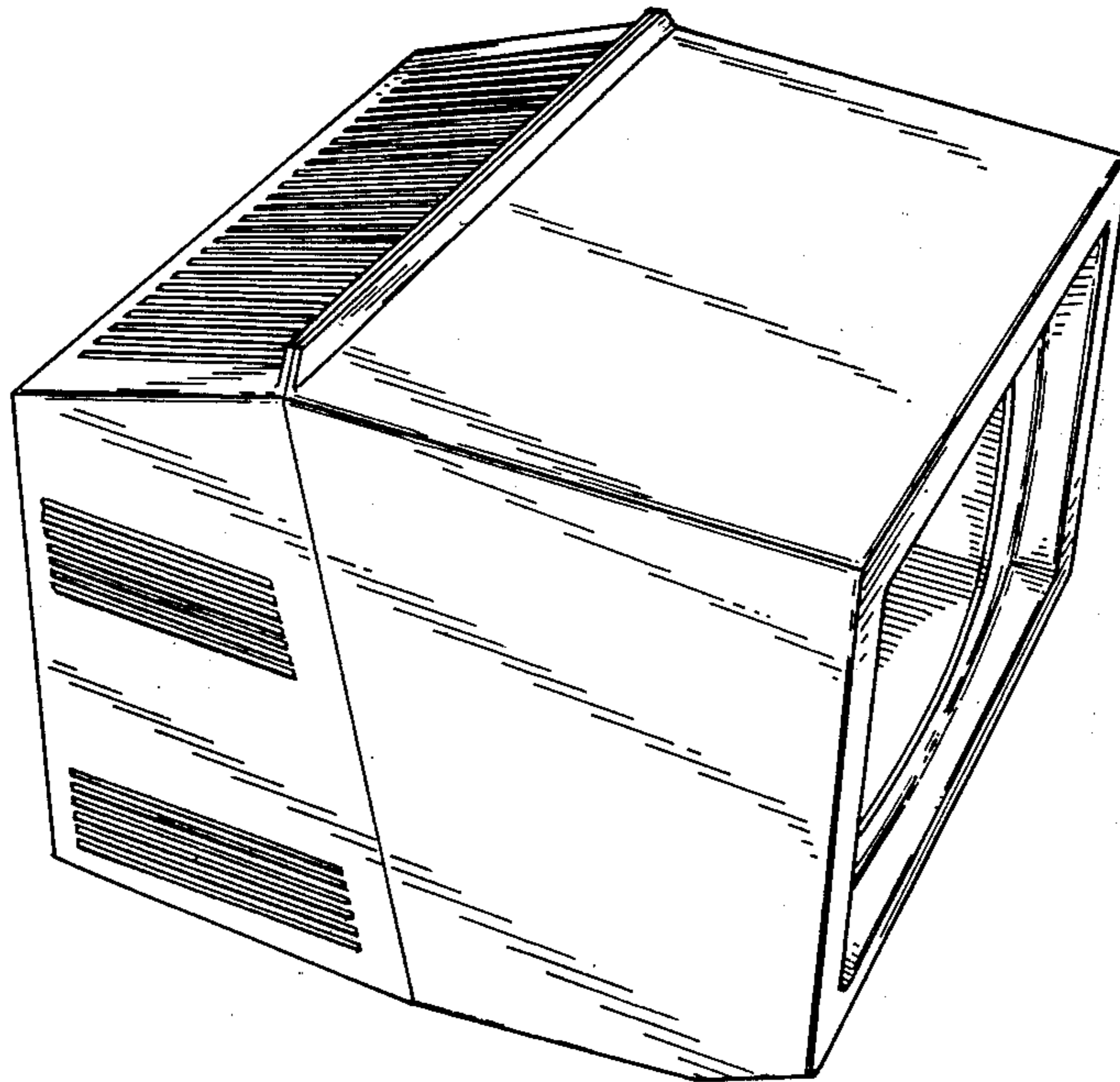

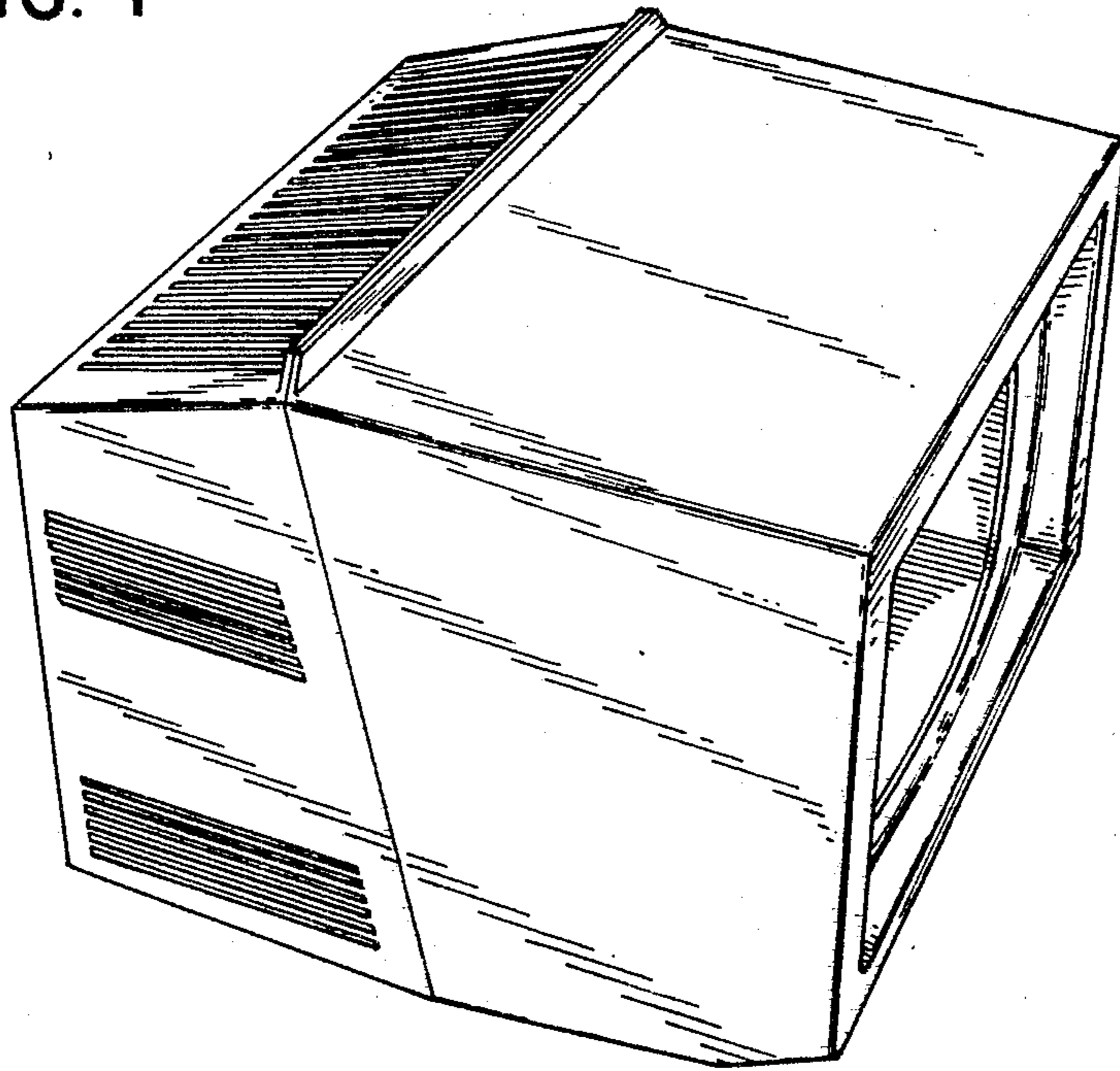

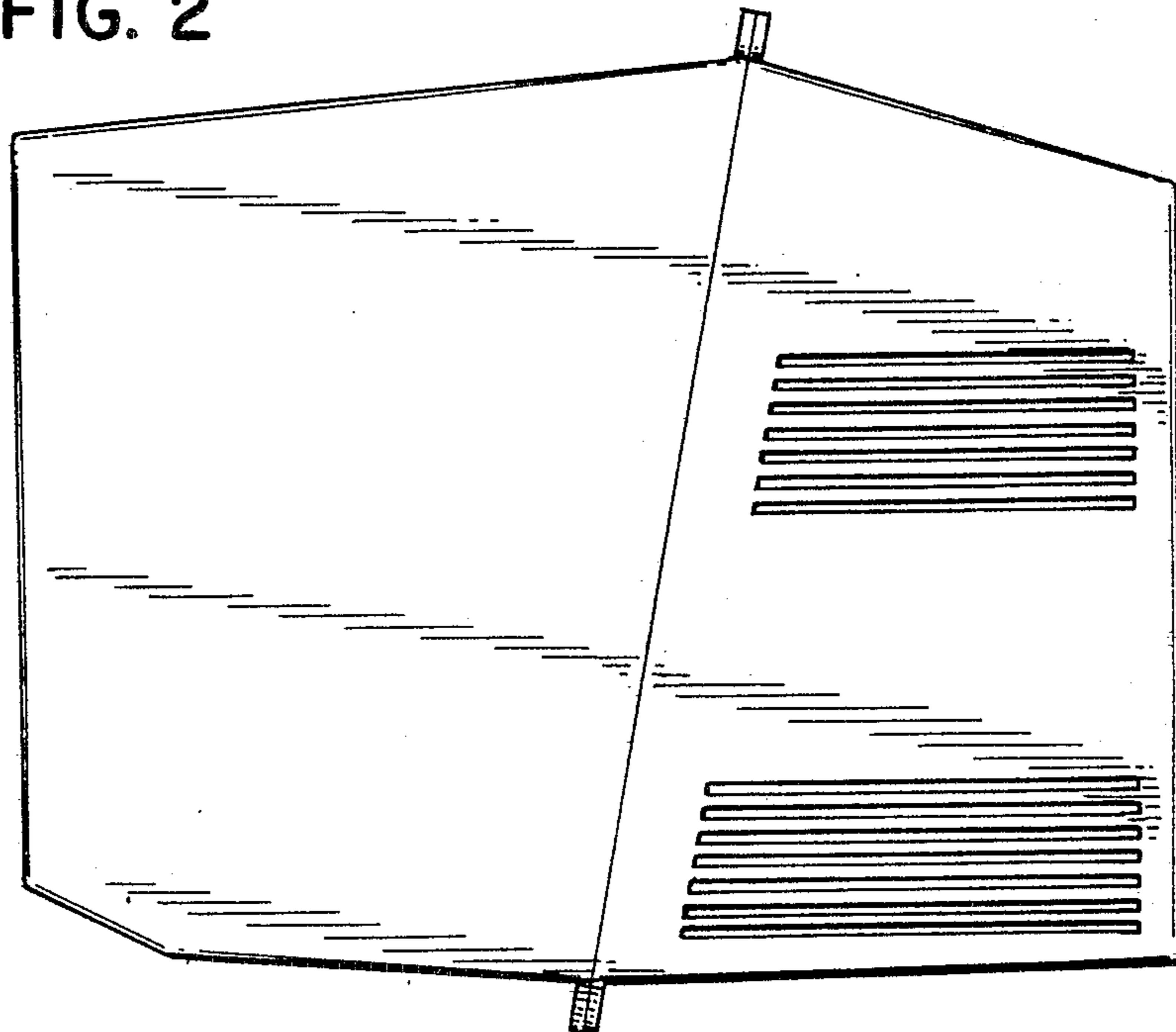

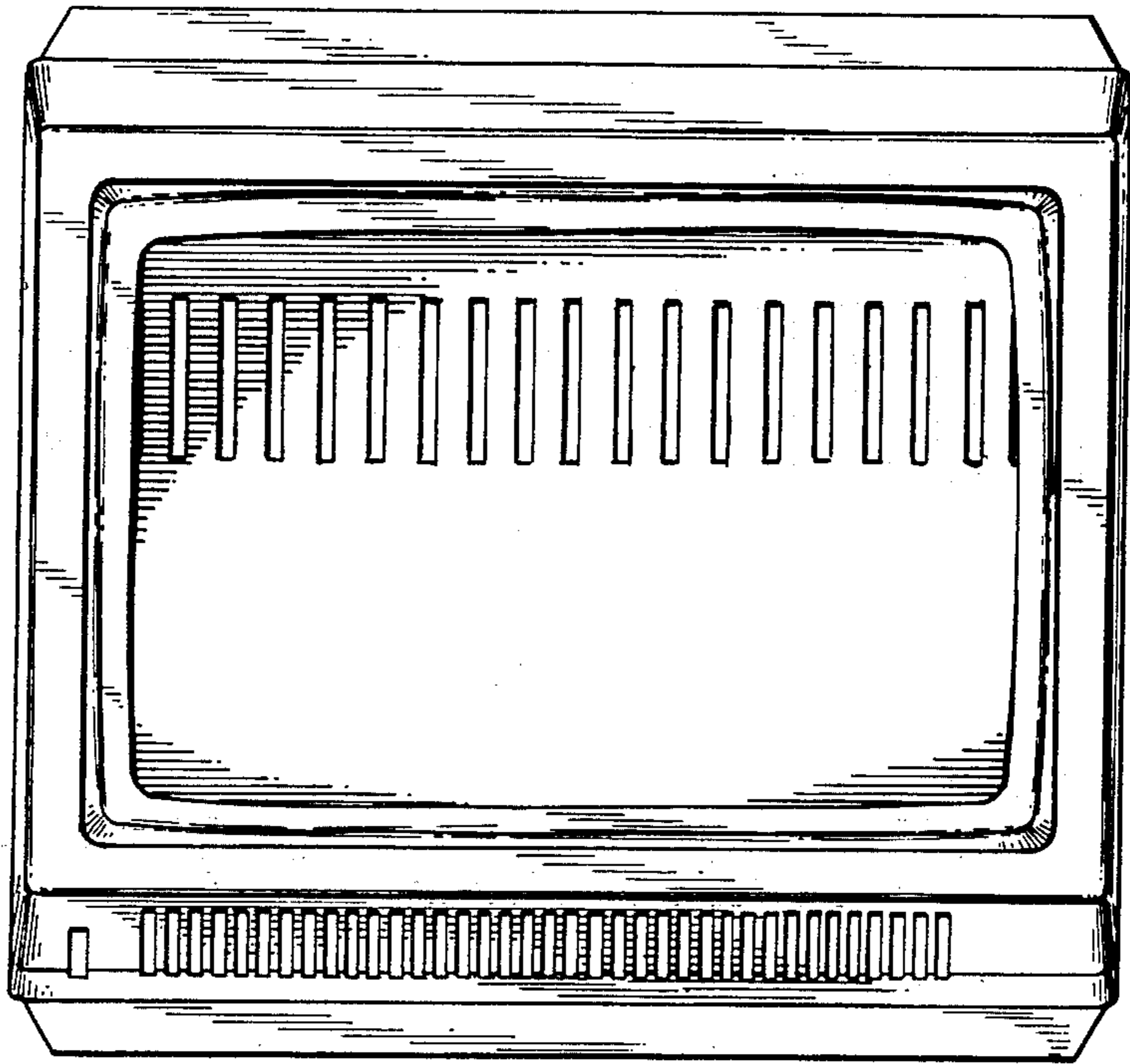

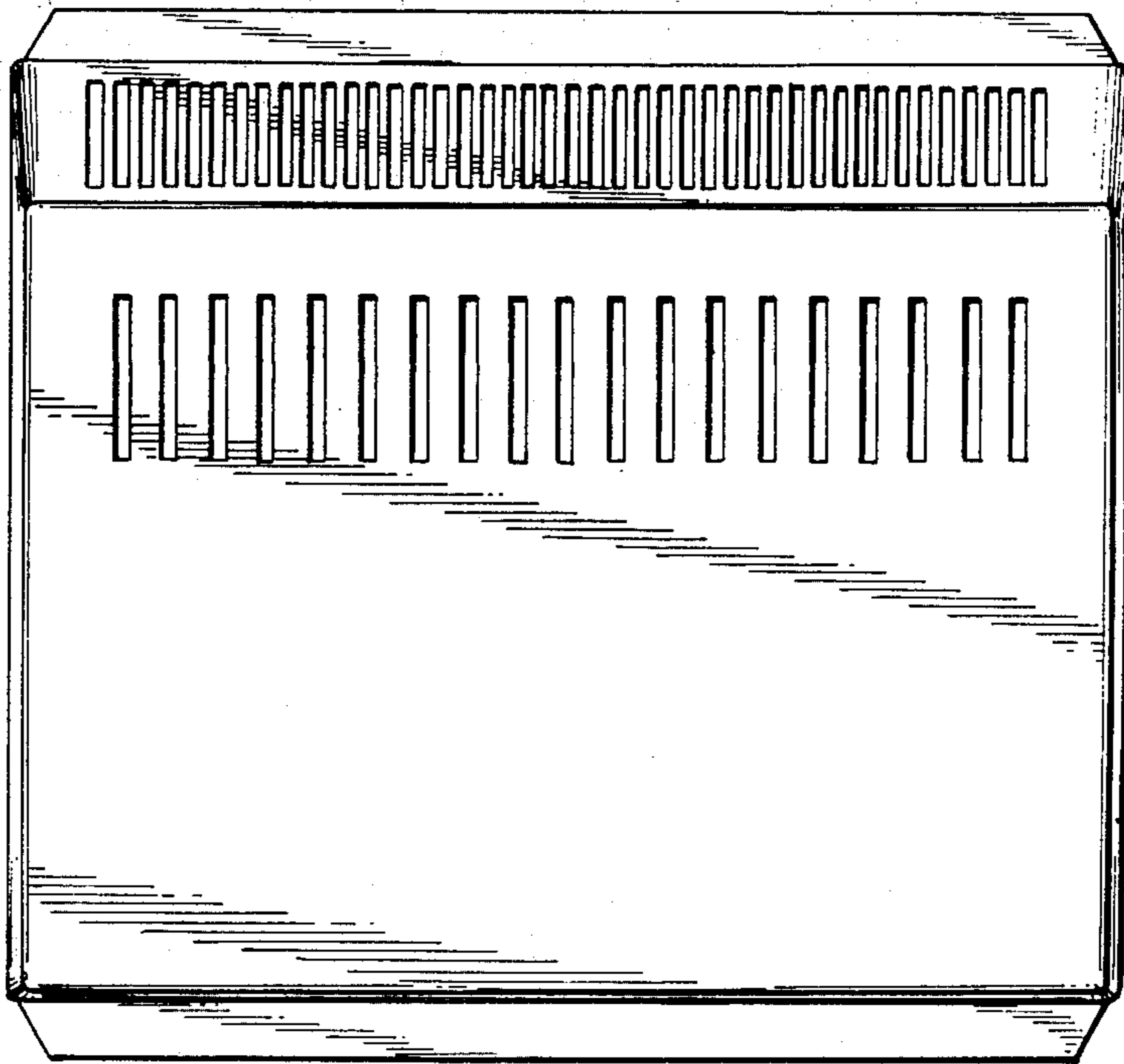
