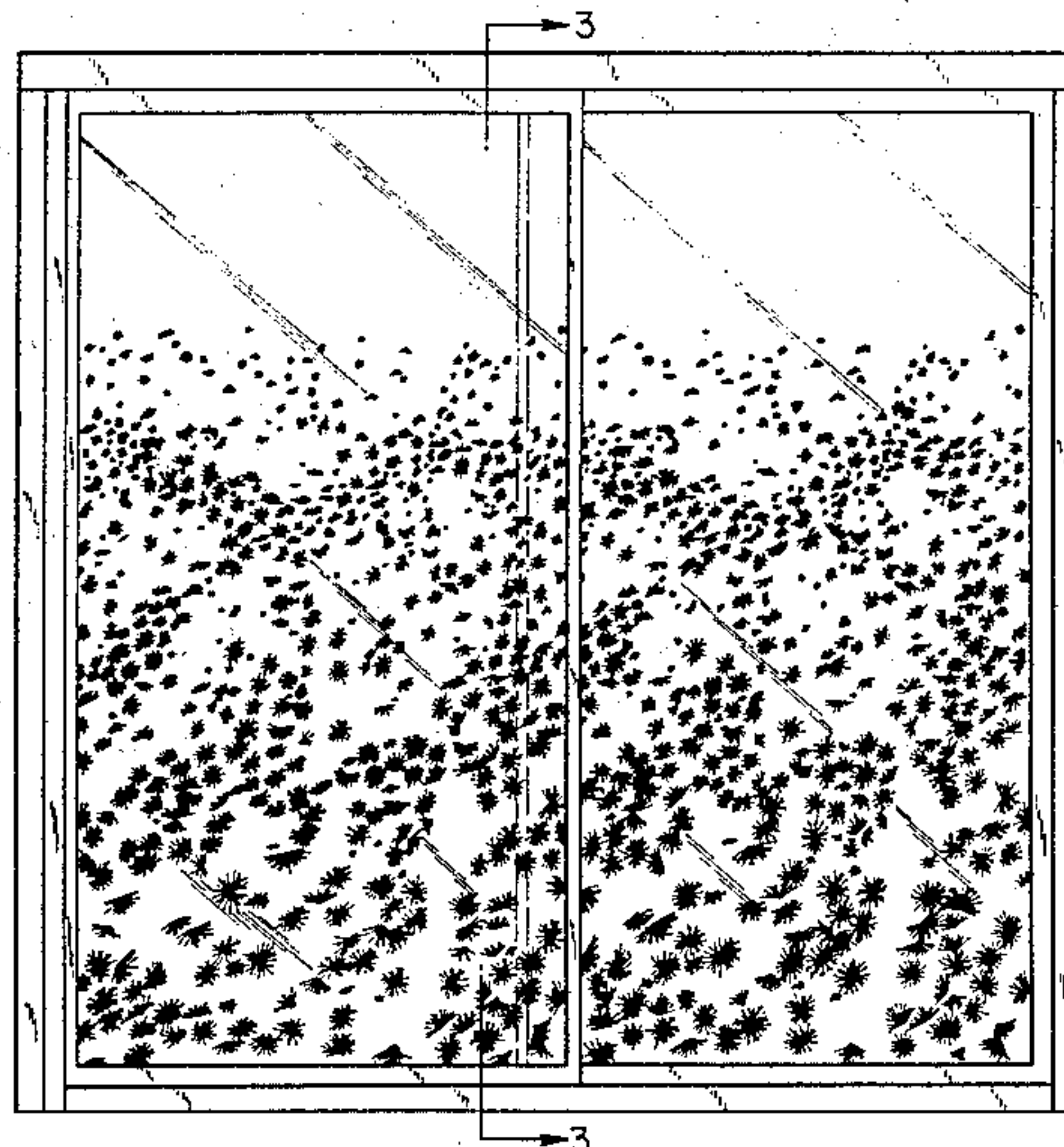

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 1.



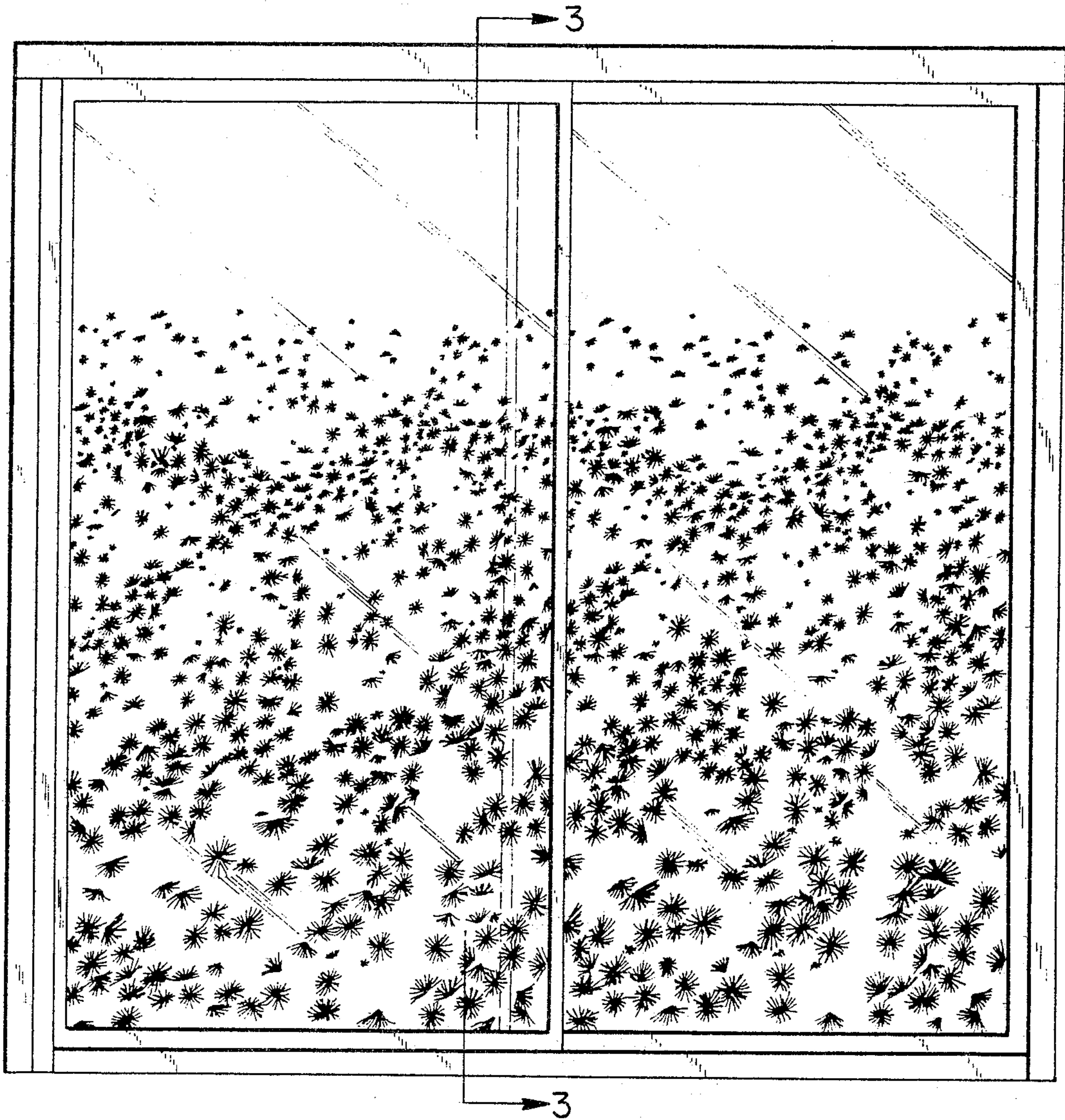

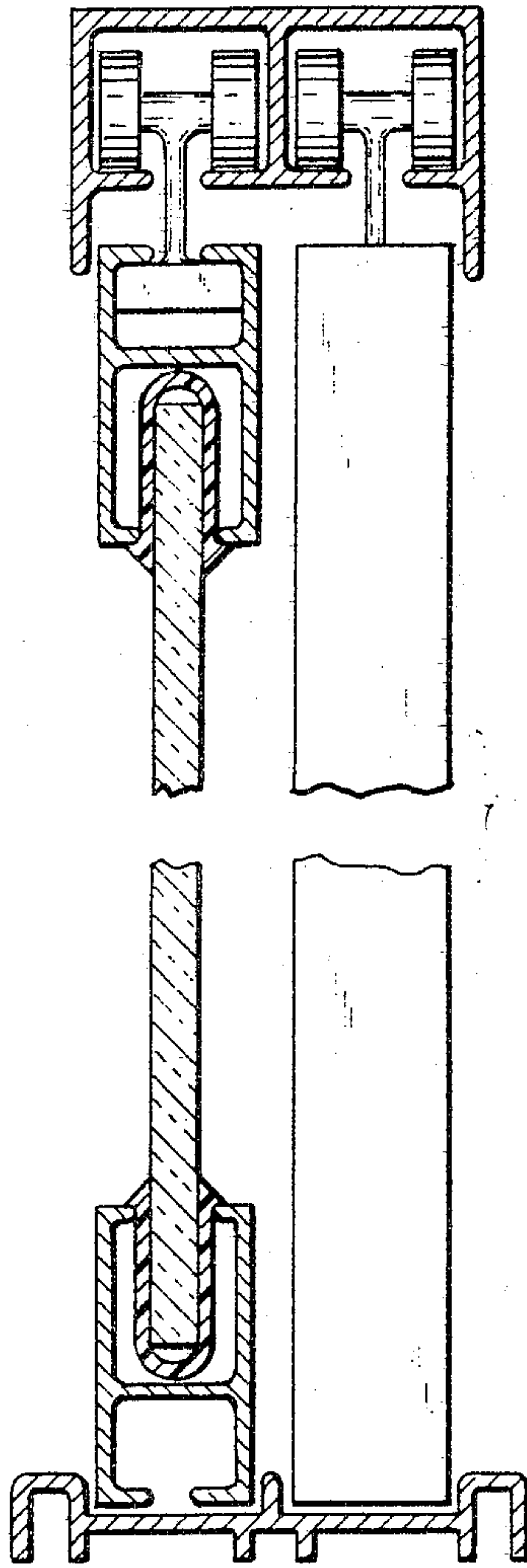
