DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a horse shoe showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown;

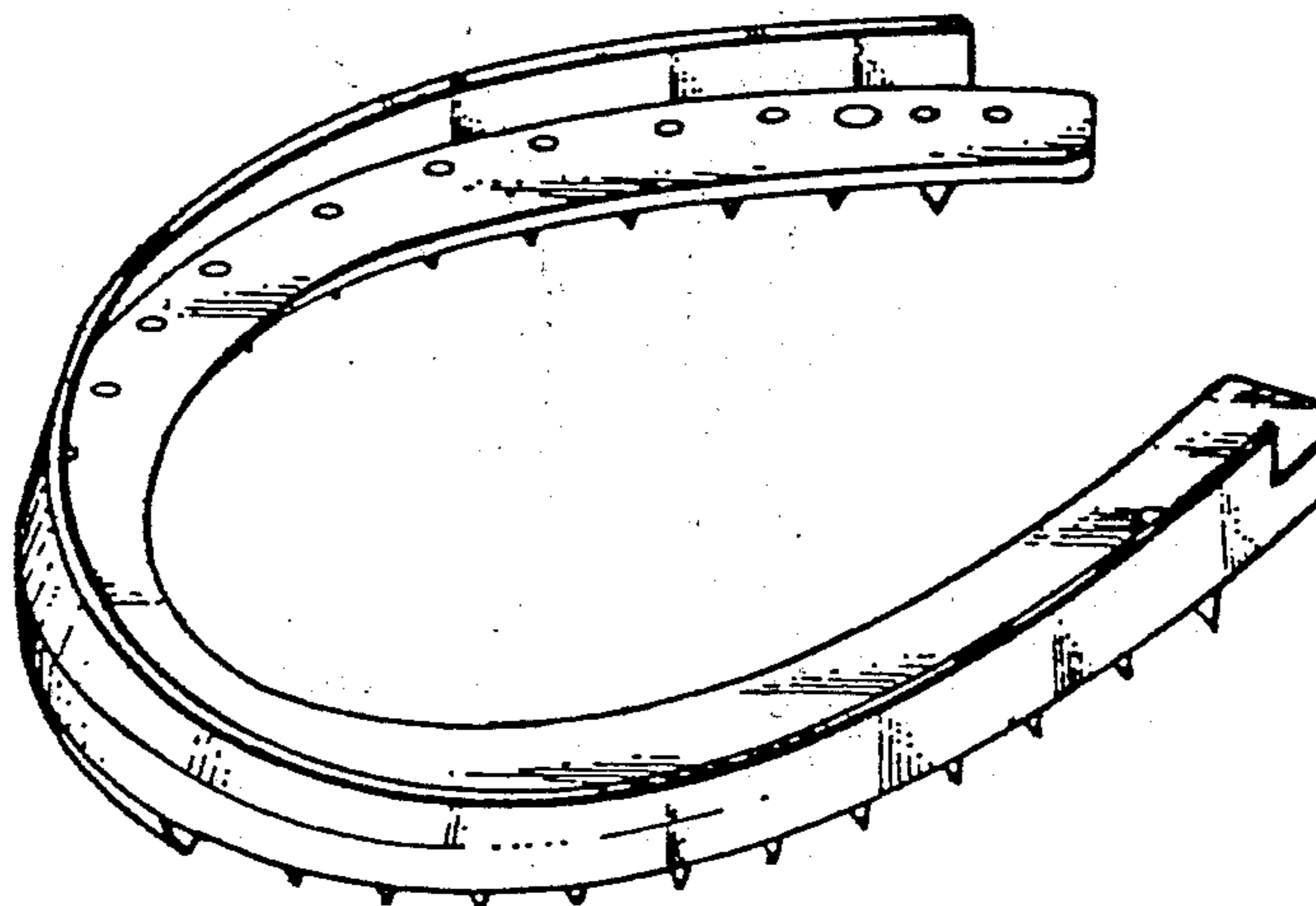

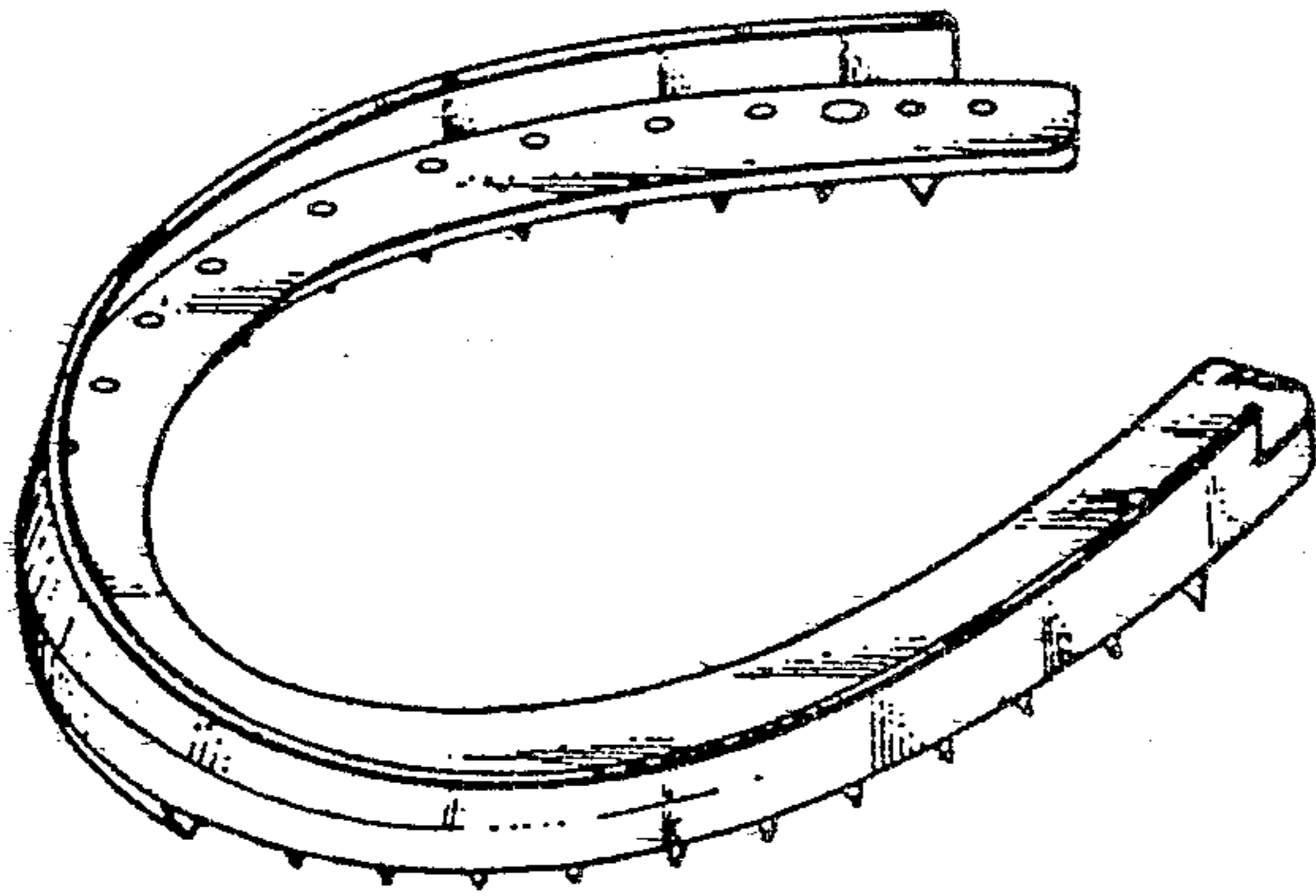

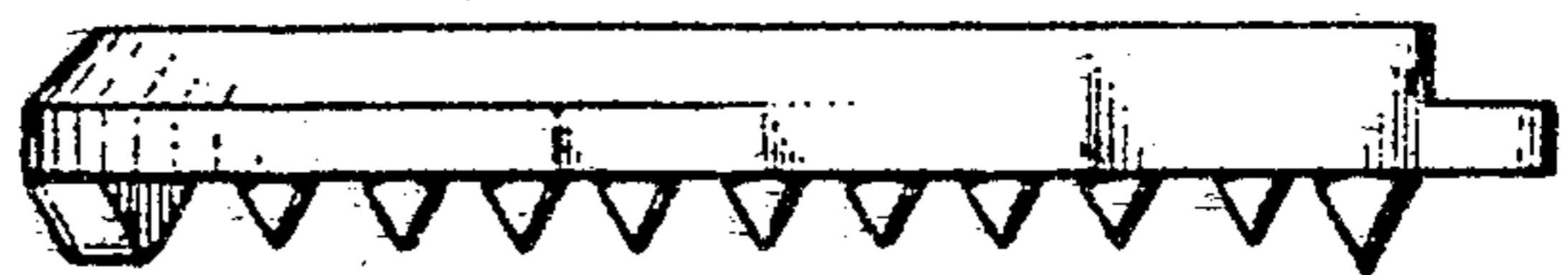

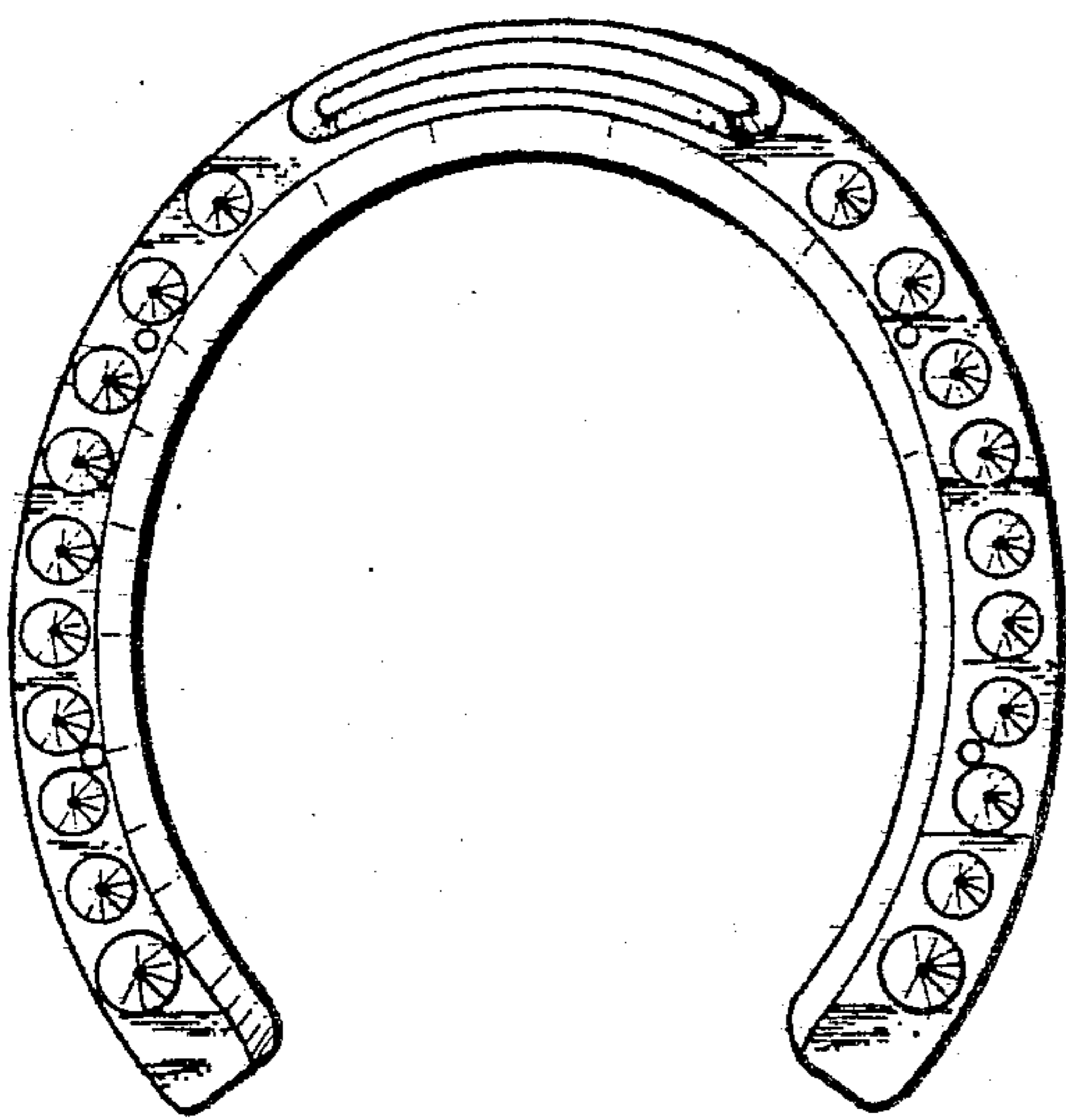

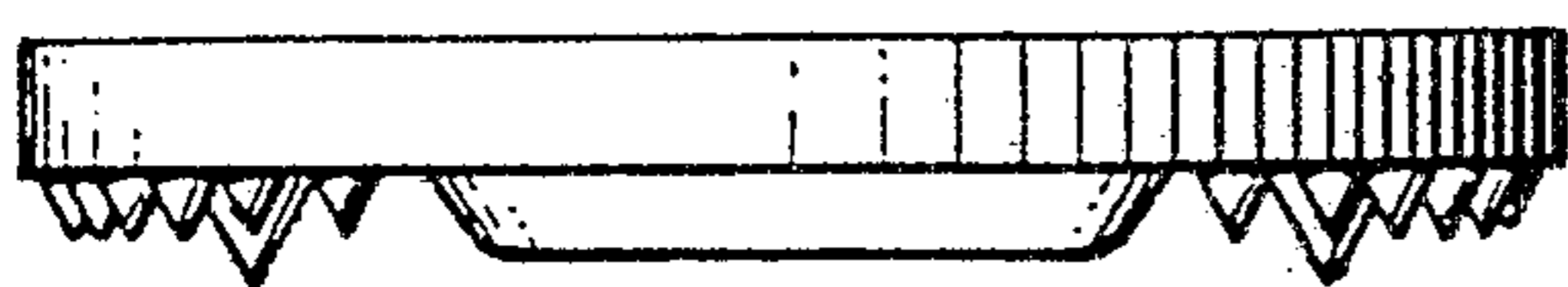
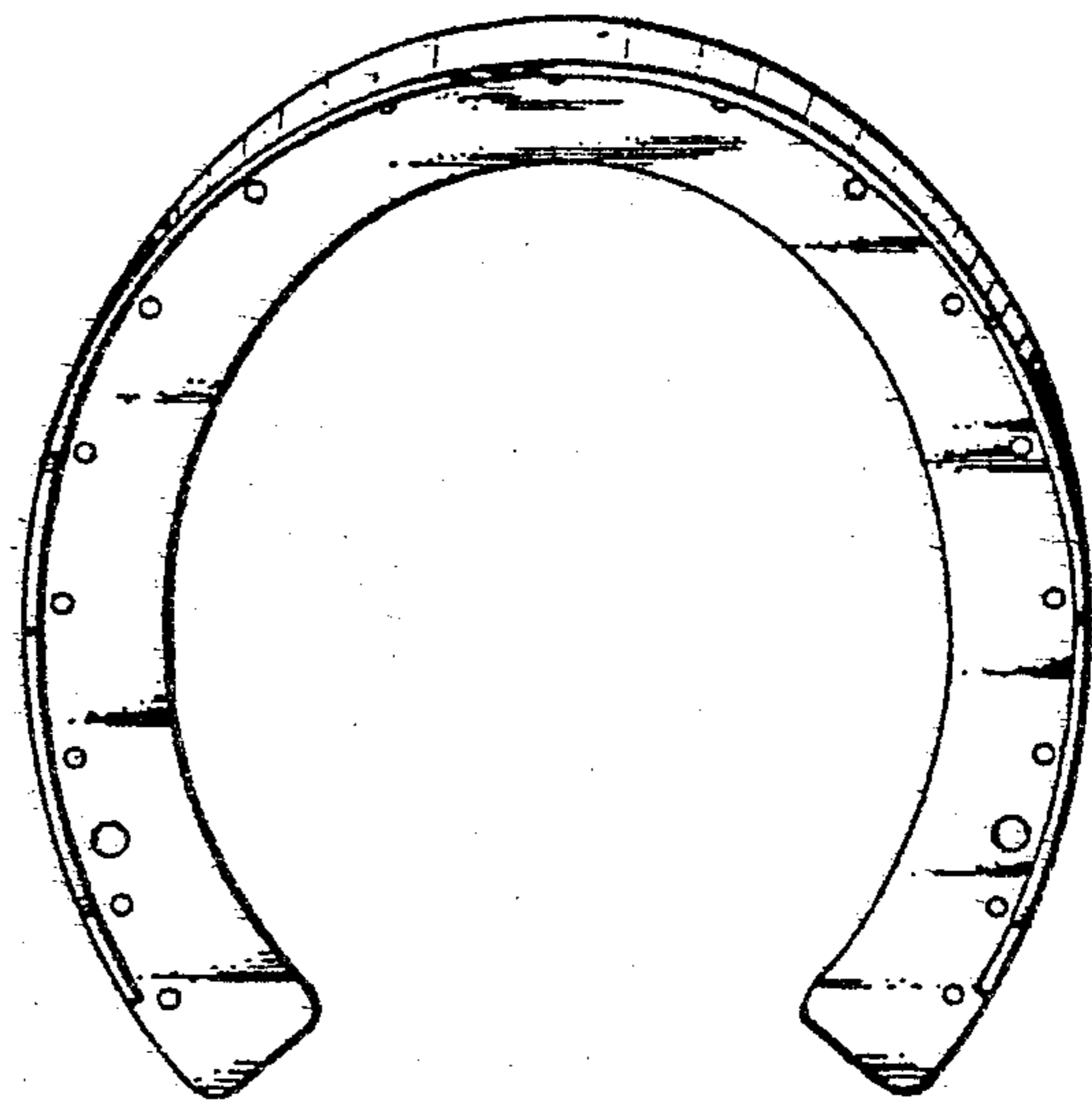

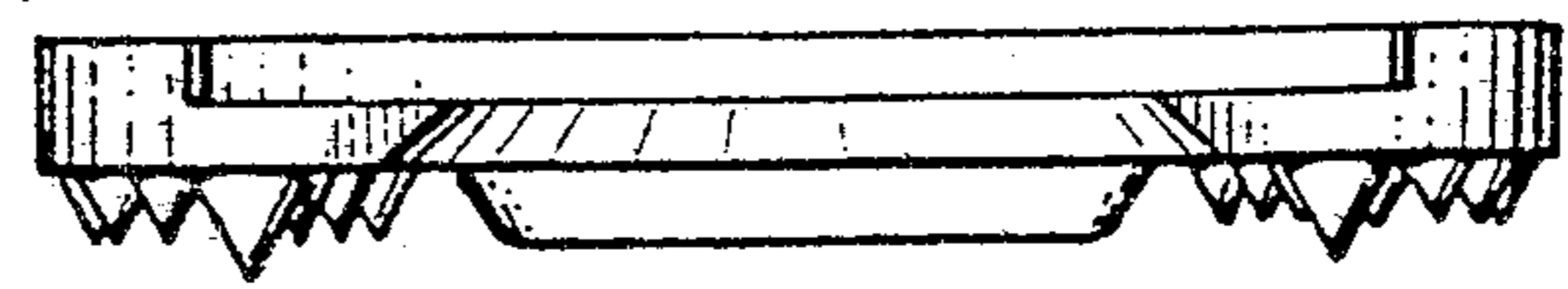
