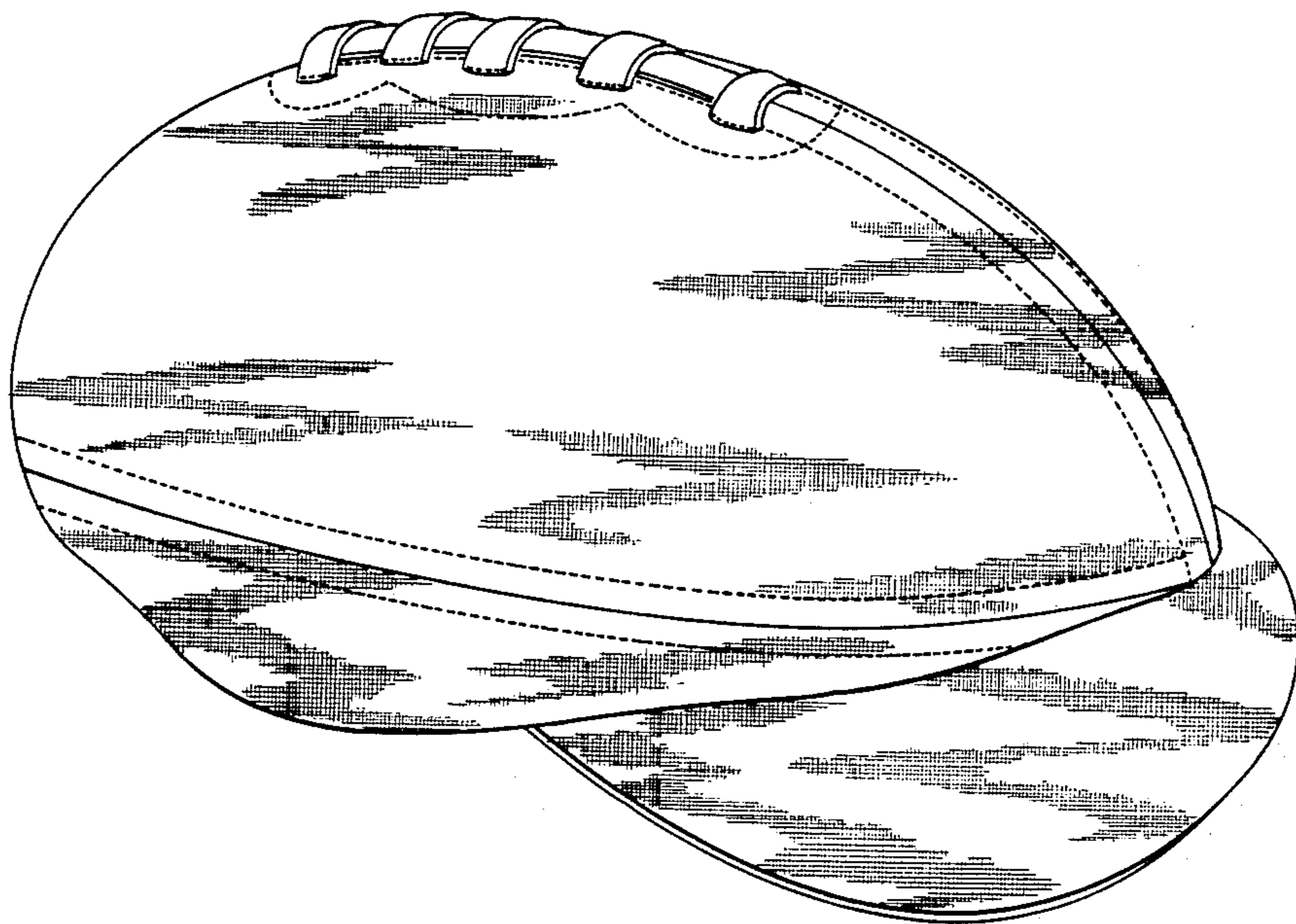

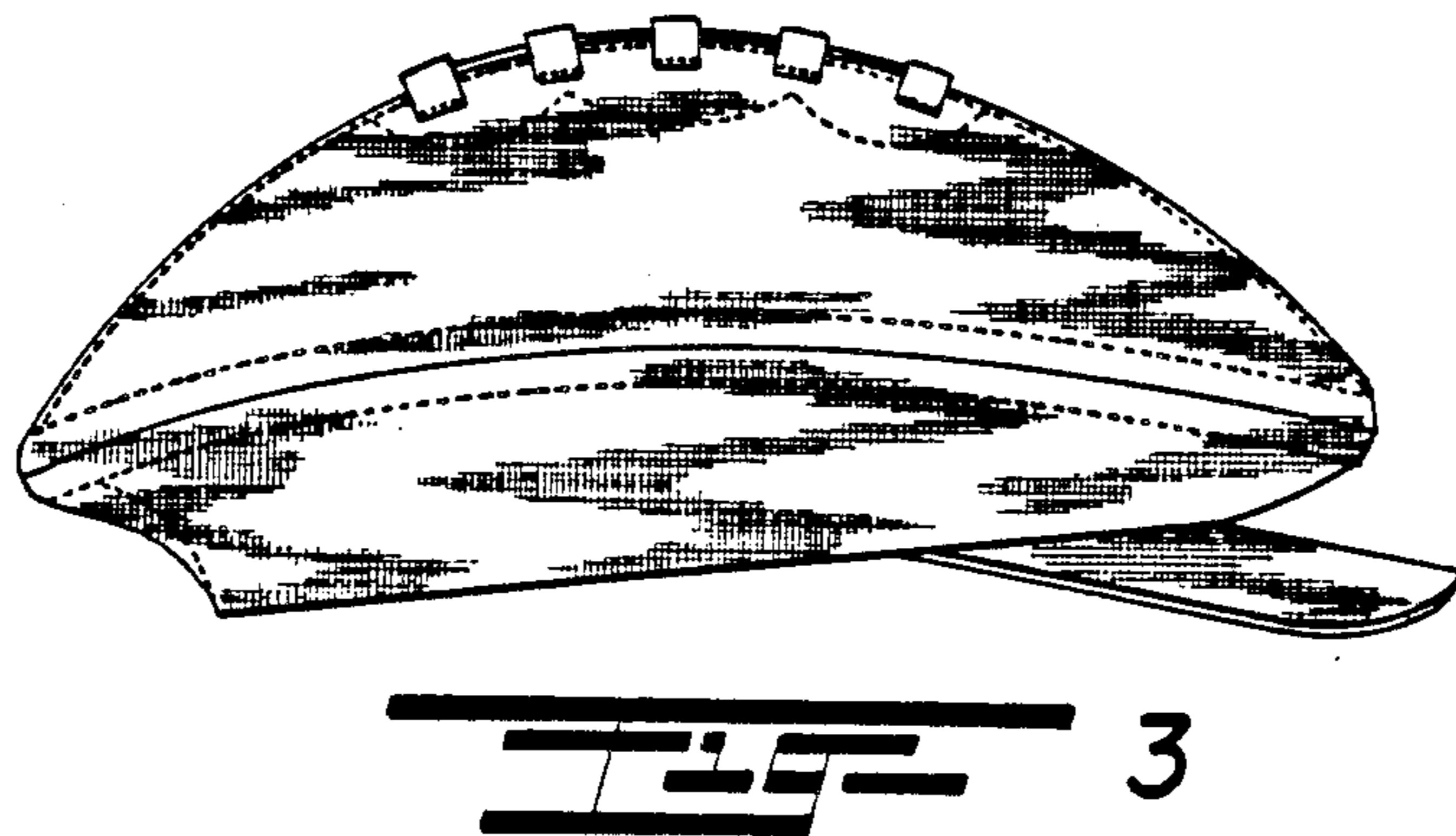
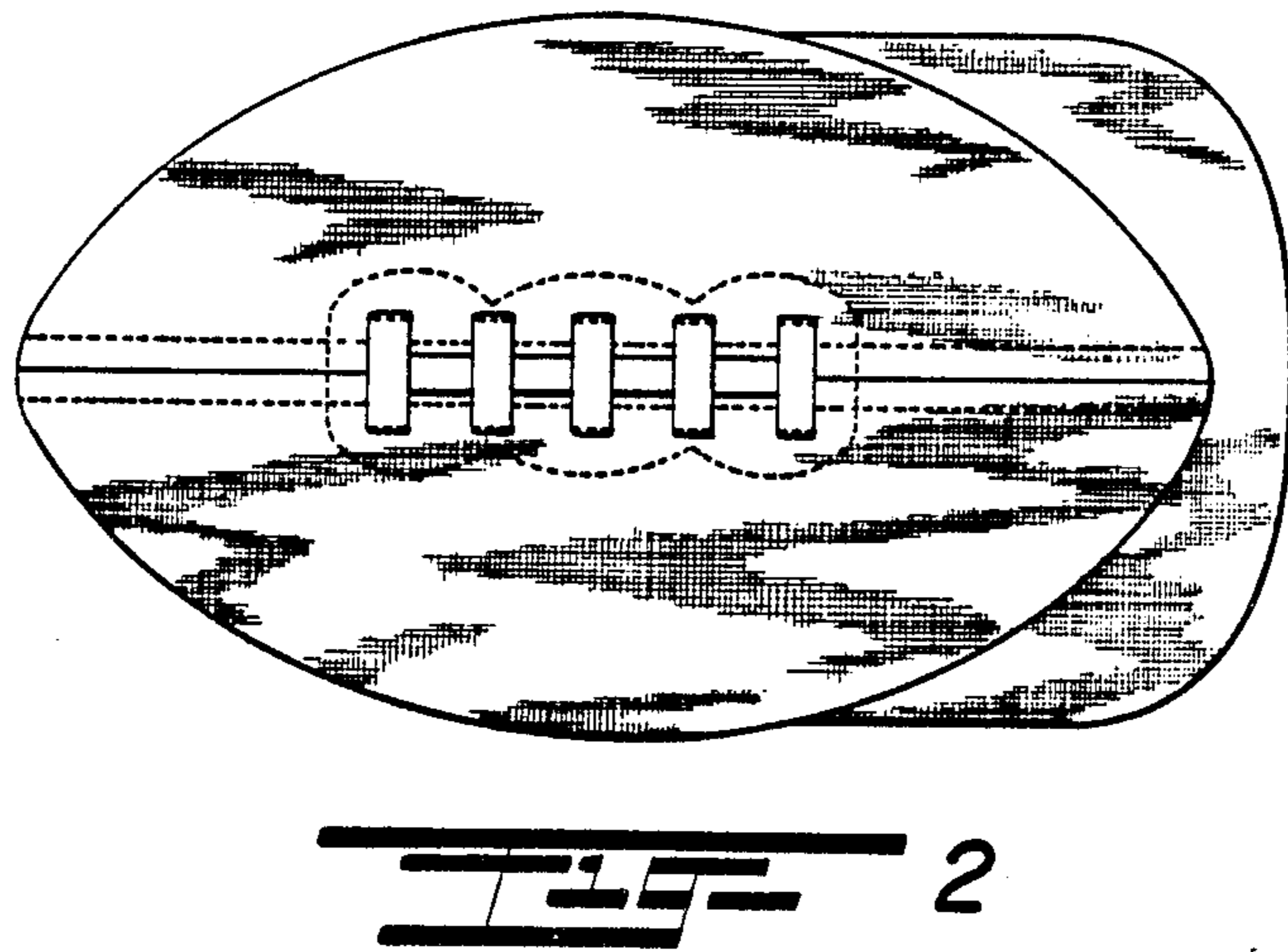
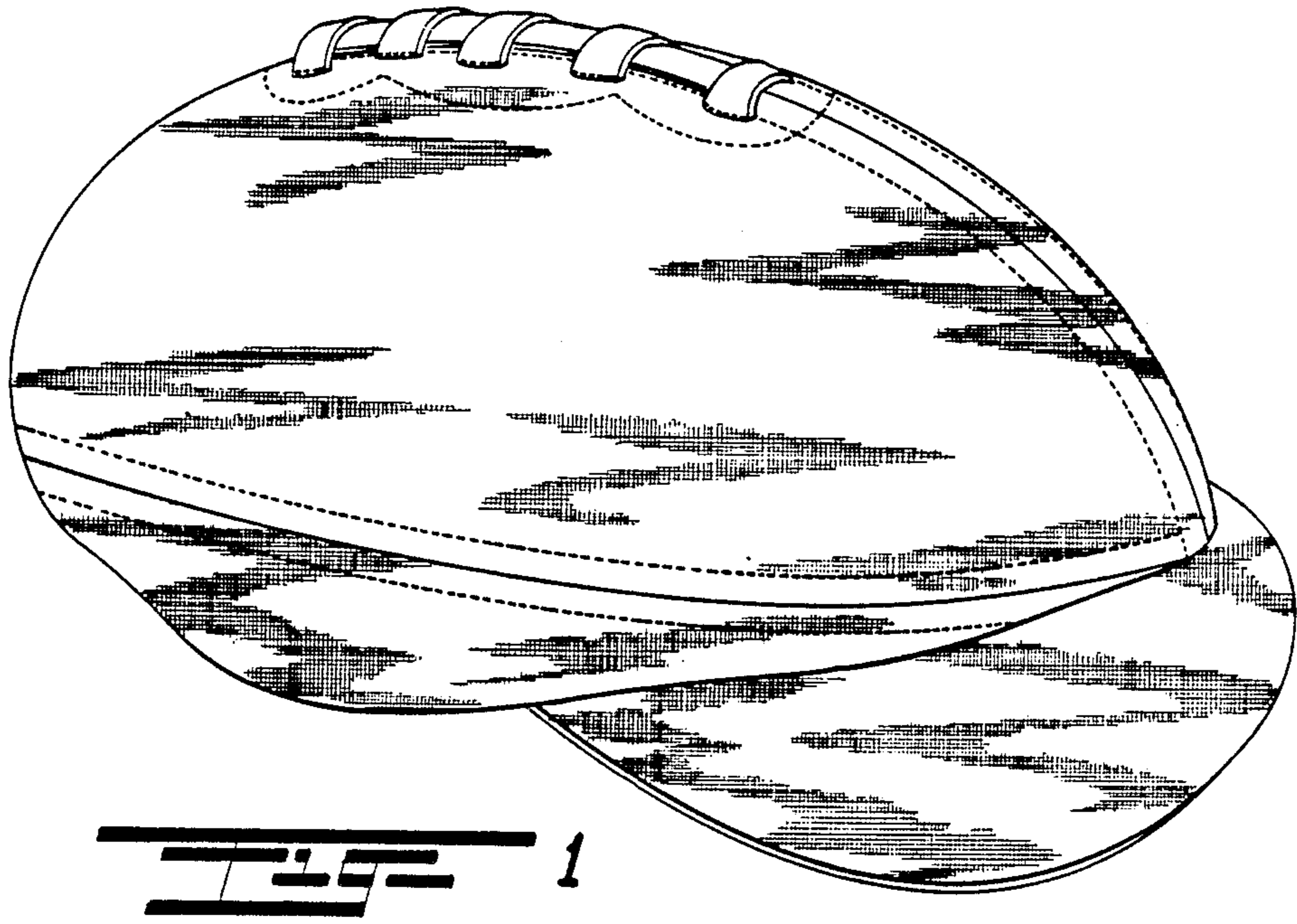

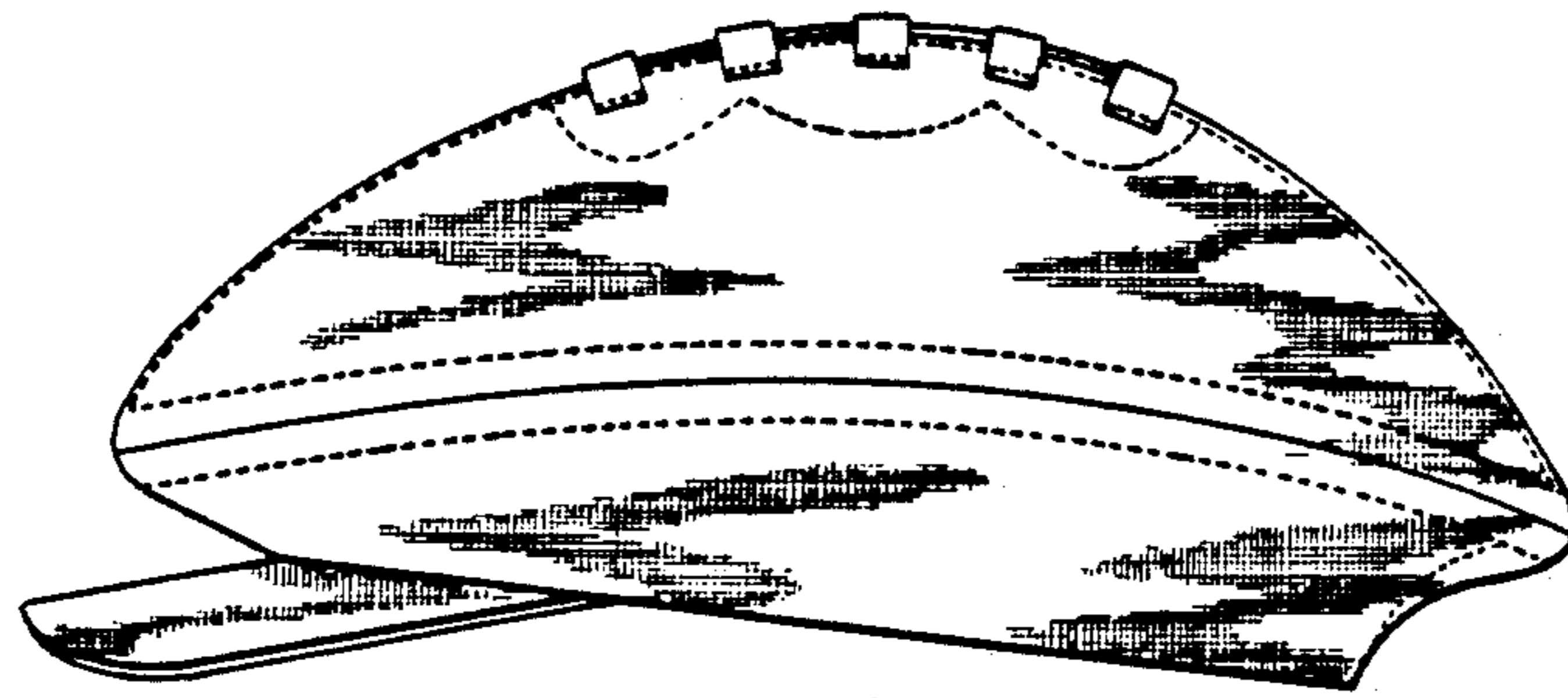
The ornamental design for a football cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

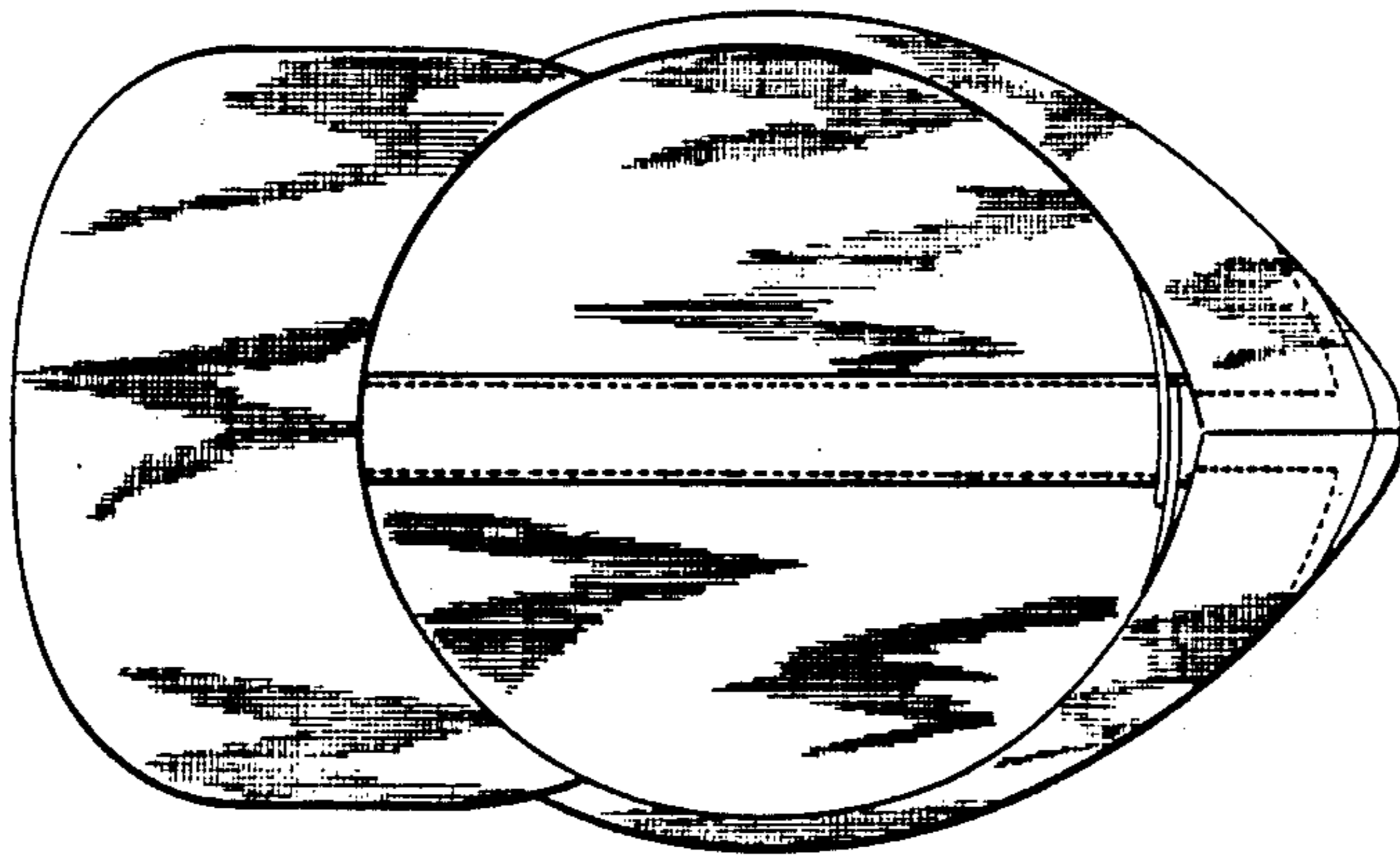
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a football cap showing my new design;

 FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.



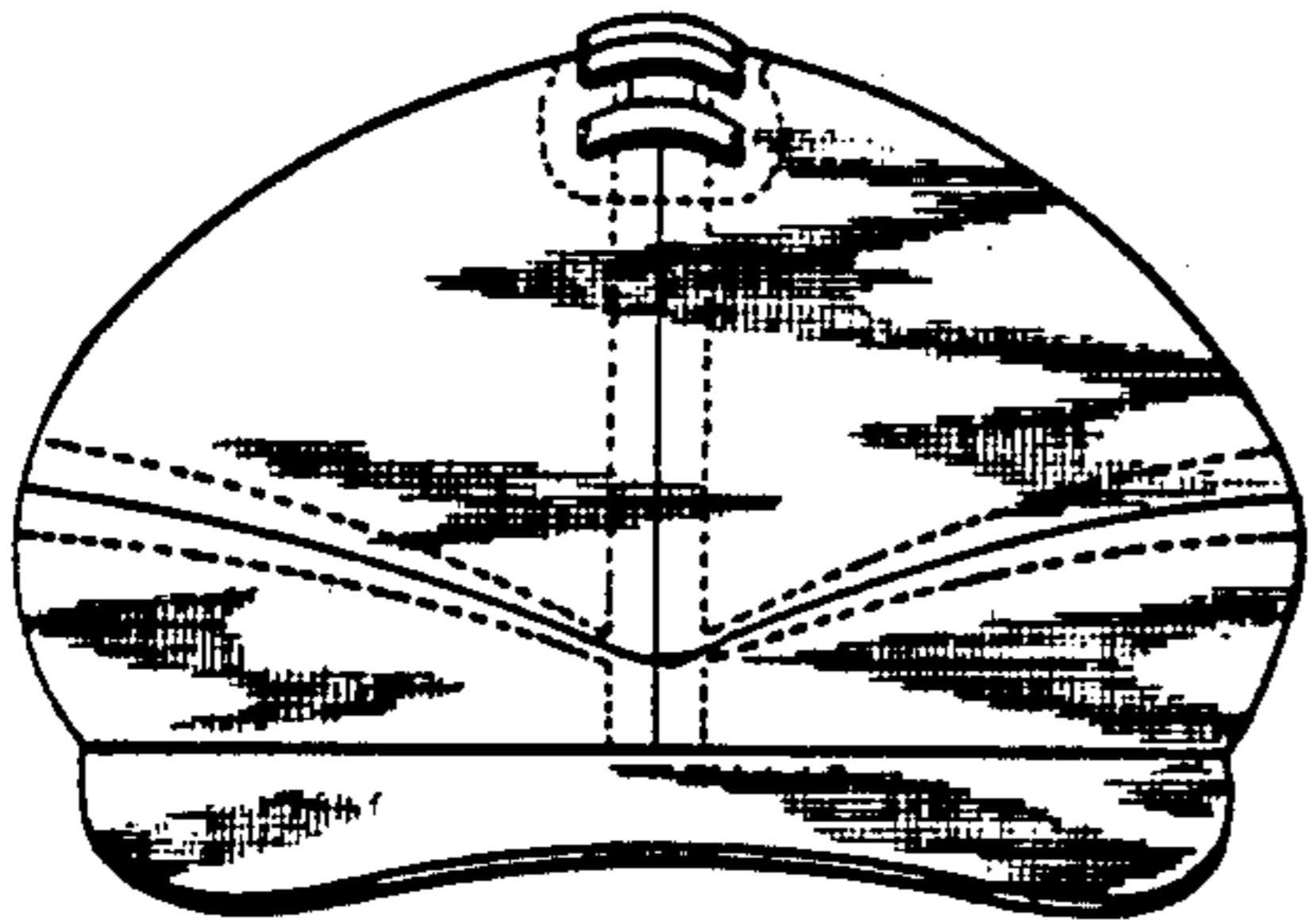




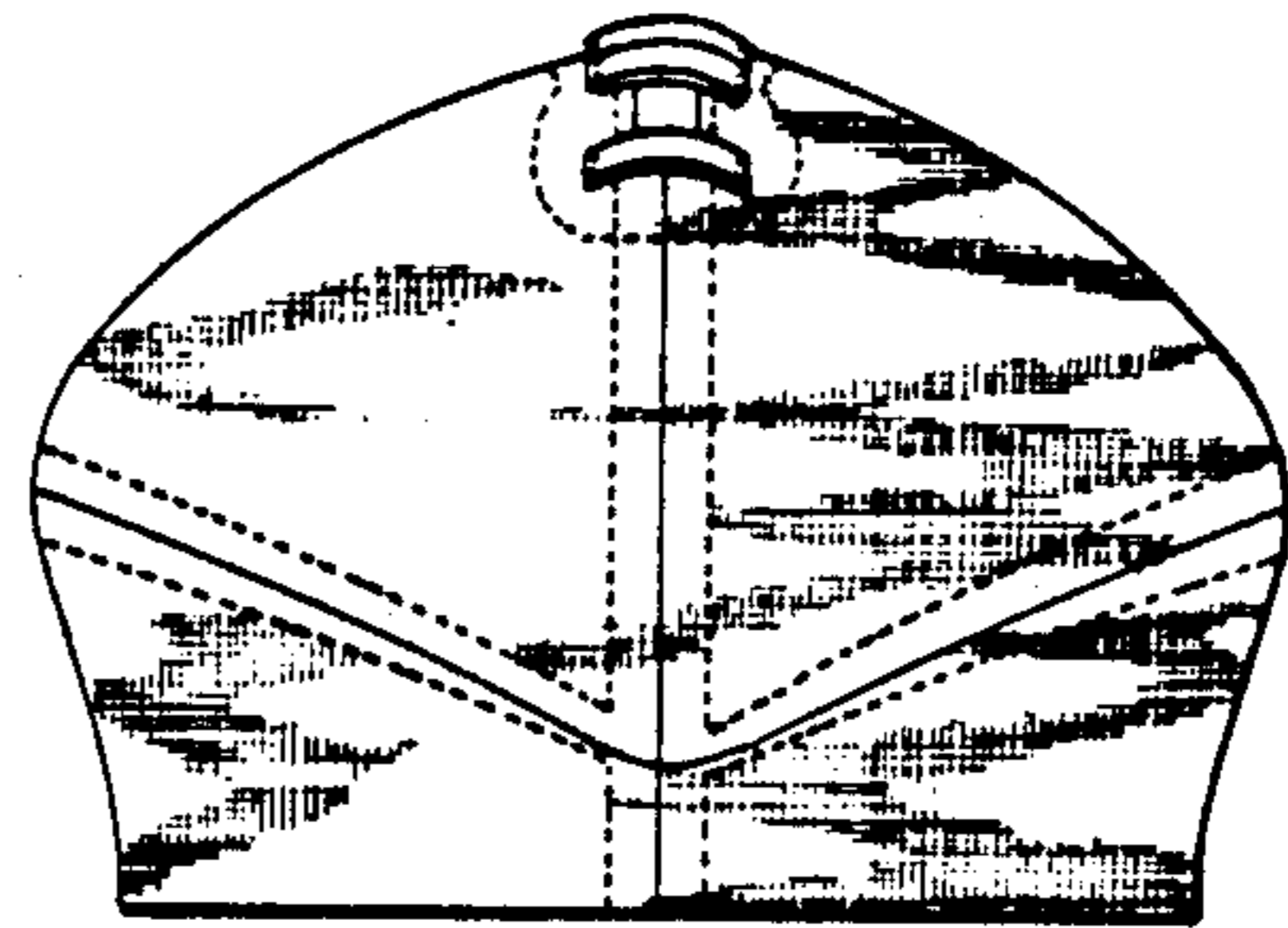
