[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of a bottle embodying our new design; and
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the second embodiment.
The right side, left side and rear elevational views of the first embodiment are not shown and are substantially identical to the front elevational view shown in FIG. 1. The bottom plan view of the second embodiment is not shown and is identical to the bottom plan view shown in FIG. 3. The right side, left side and rear elevational views of the second embodiment are not shown and are substantially identical to the front elevational view shown in FIG. 4.

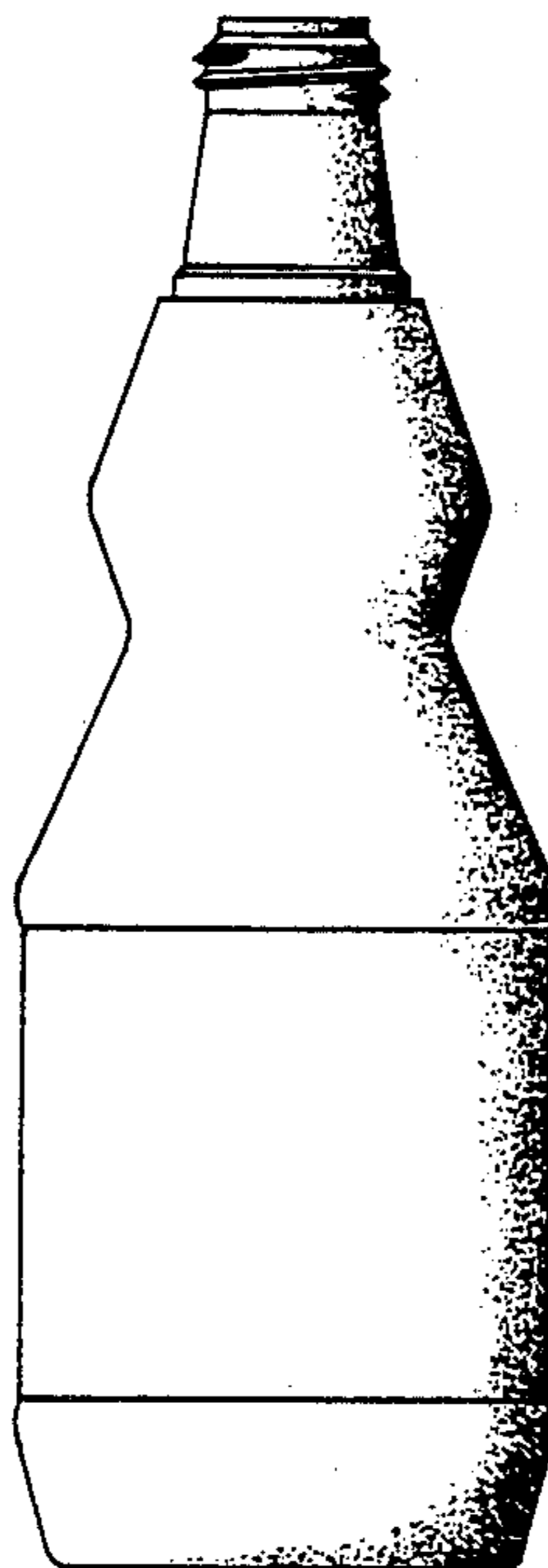

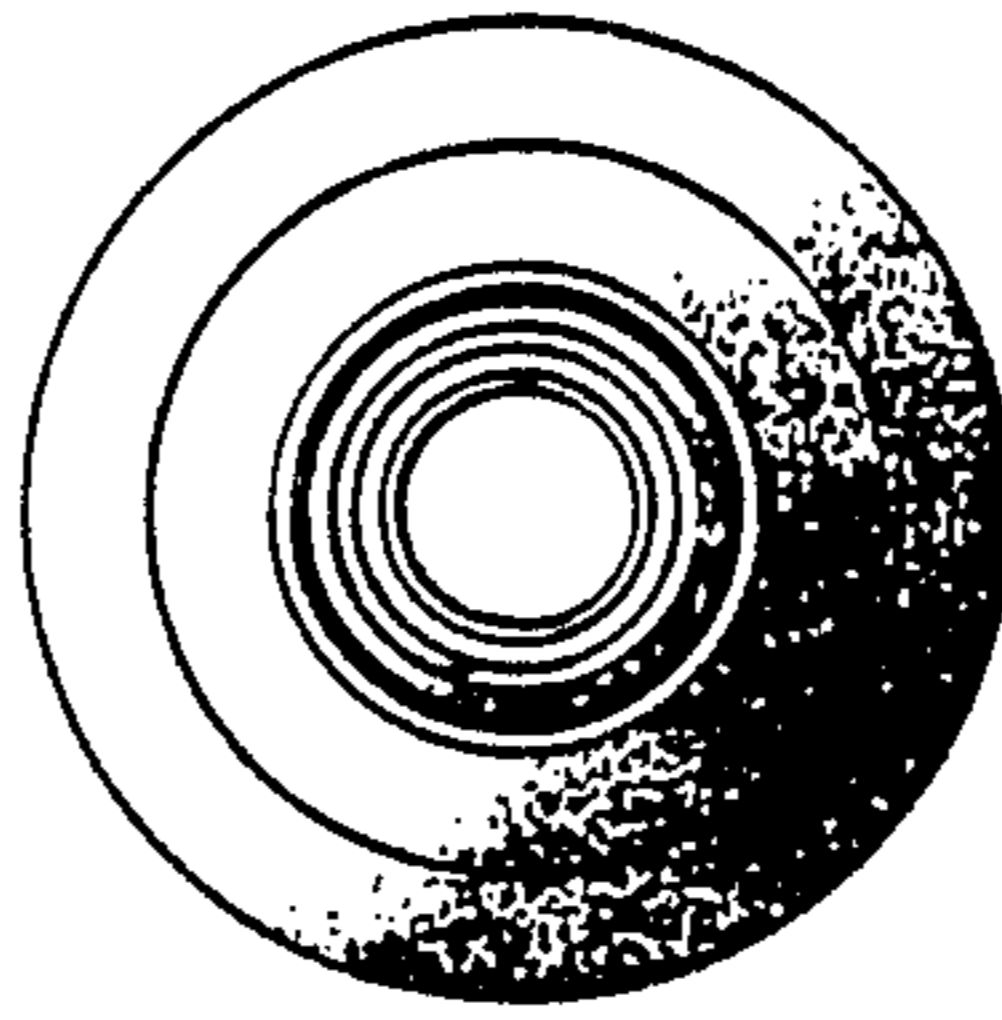

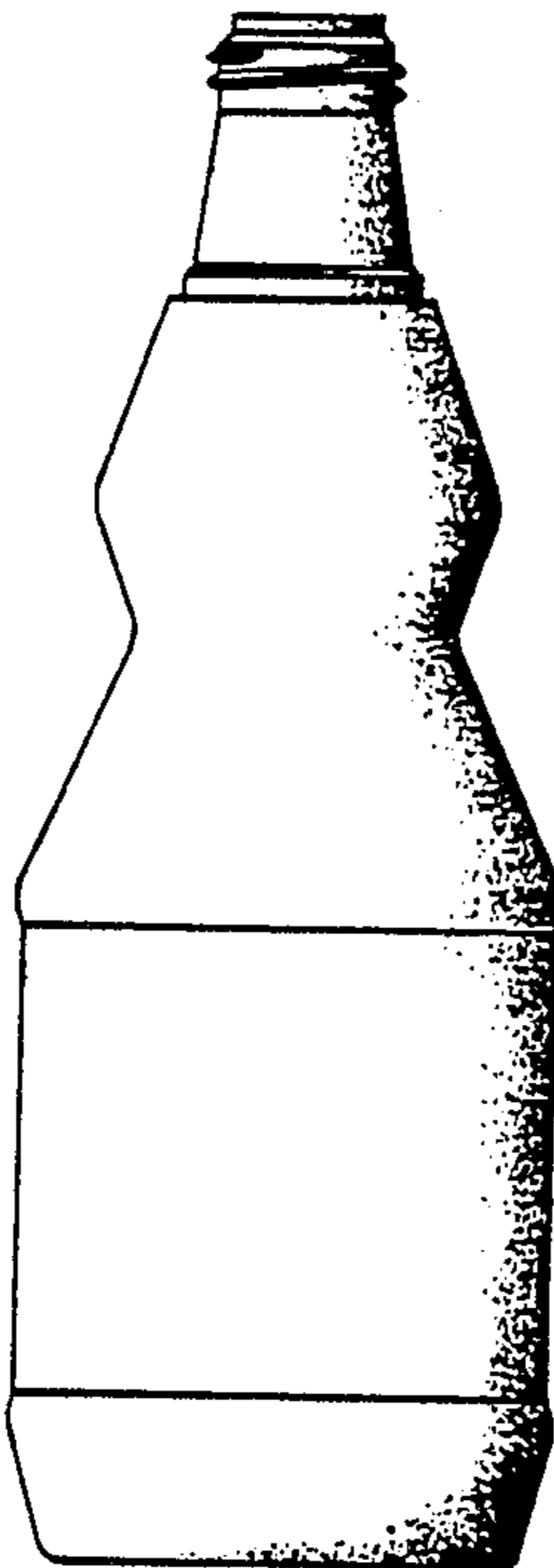

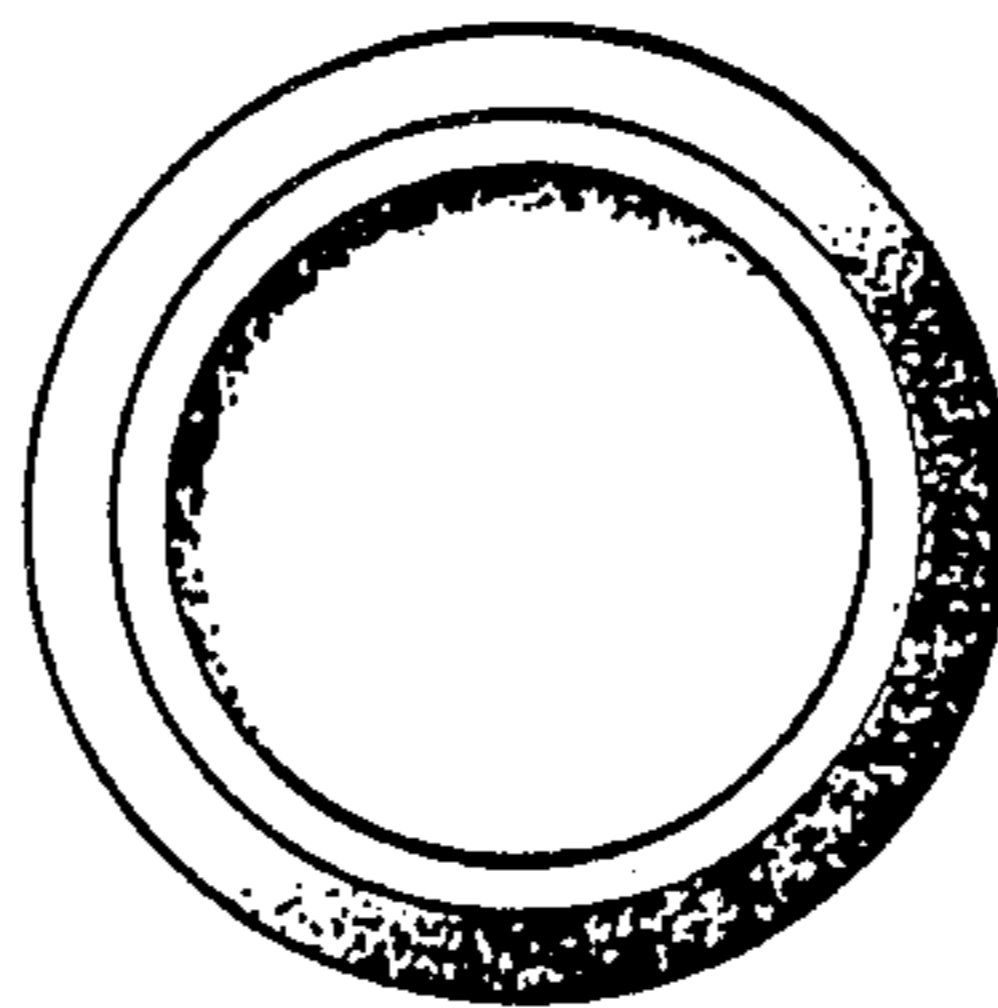

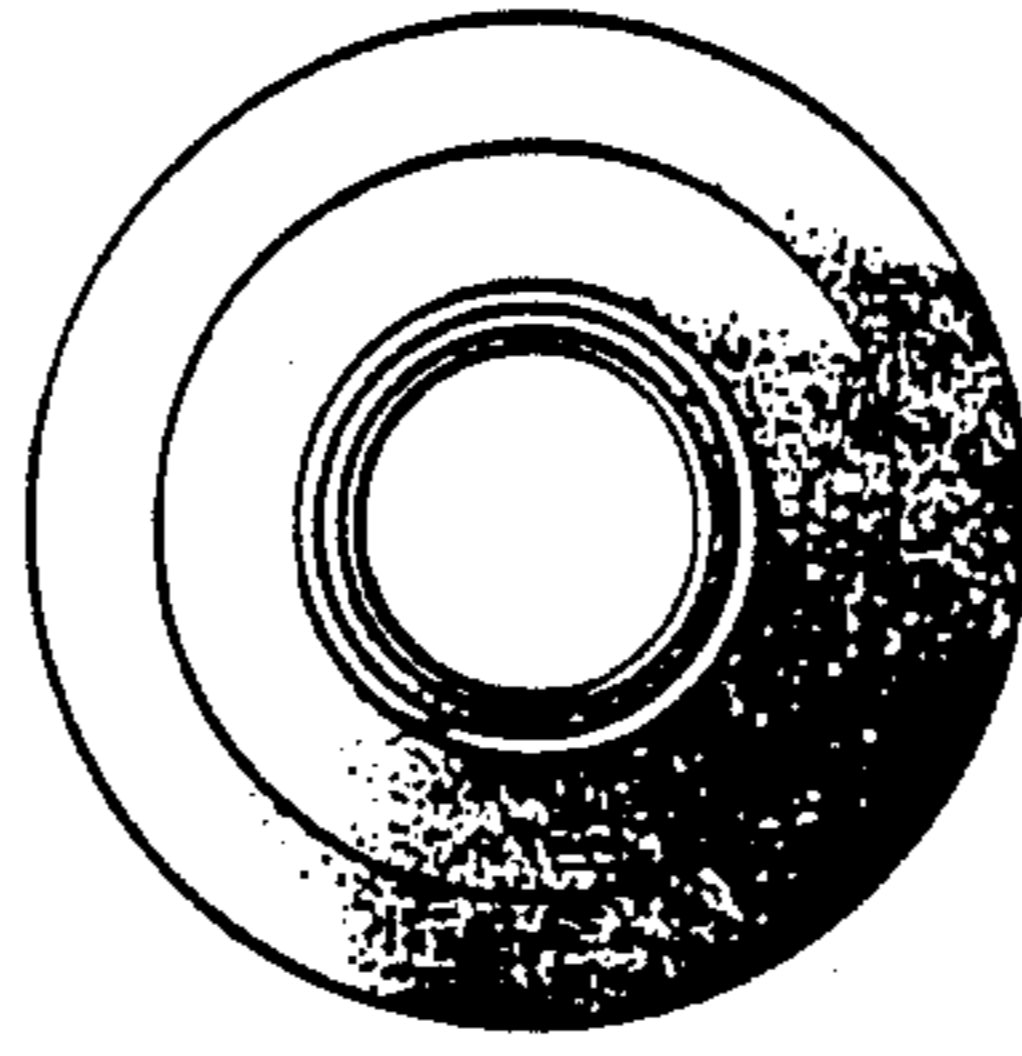
