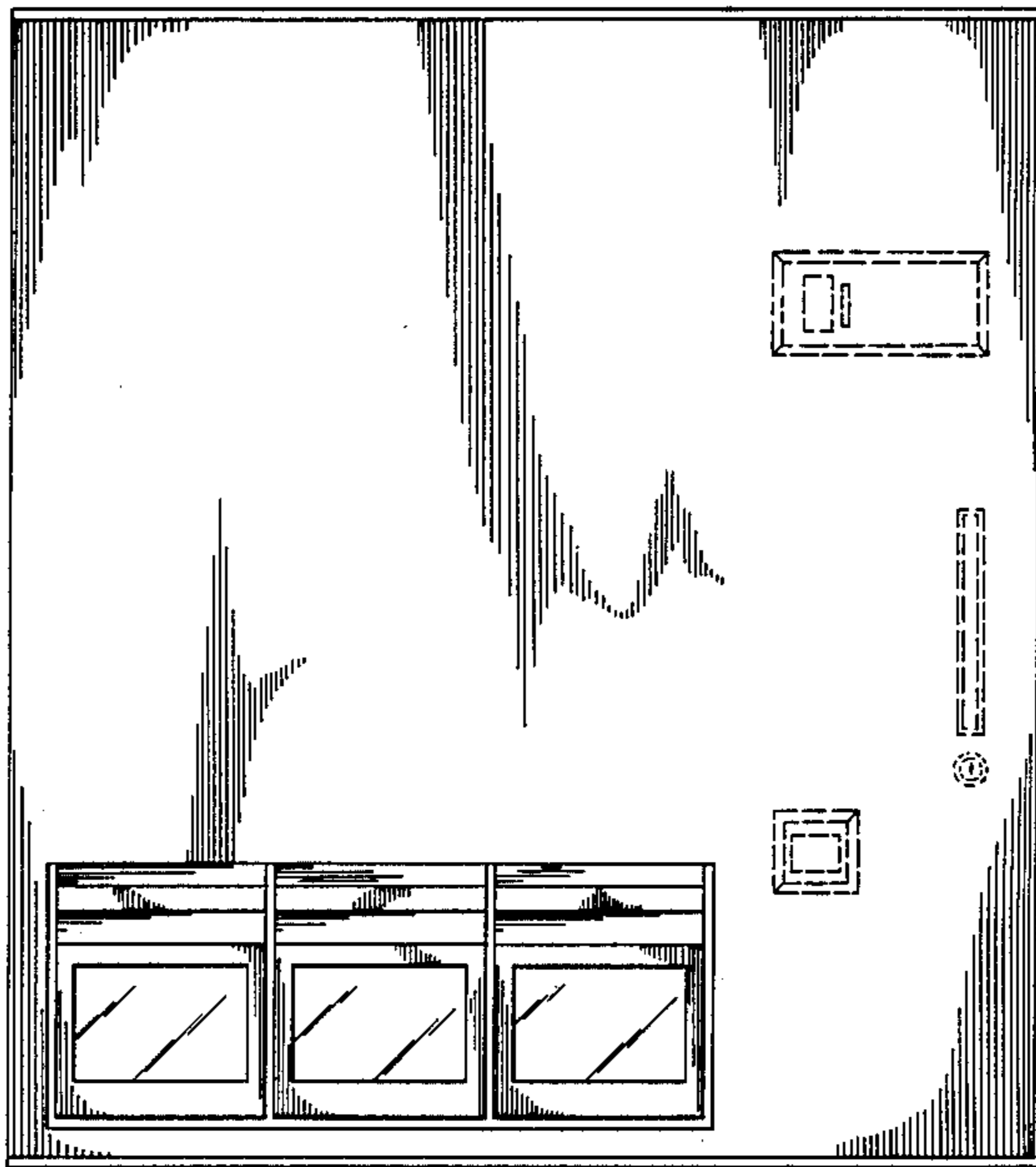
[57] CLAIM

The top plan, bottom plan, right and left side elevational, and rear elevational views are flat and unornamented.



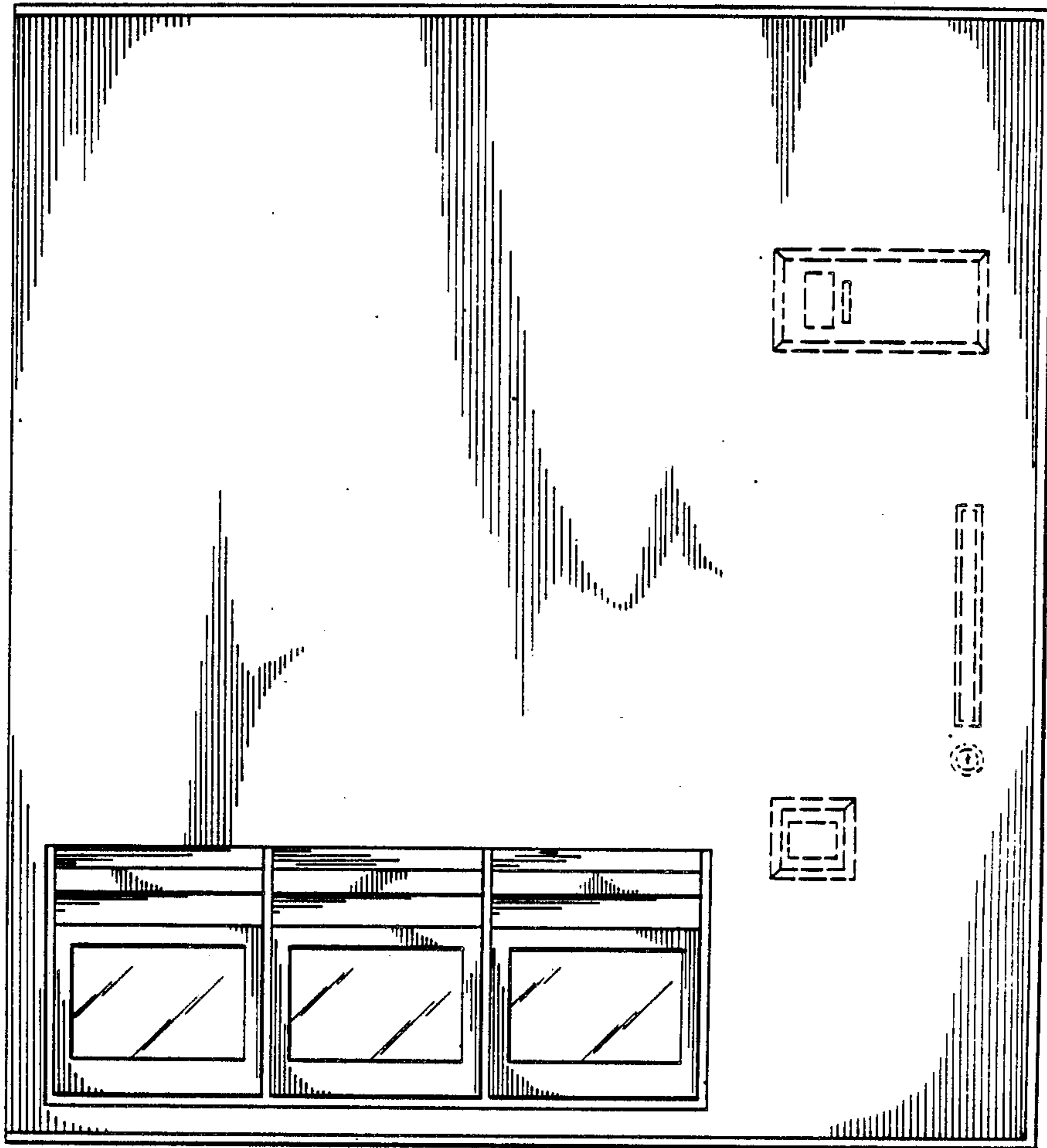
