The ornamental design of an athletic shoe sole, as shown and described.

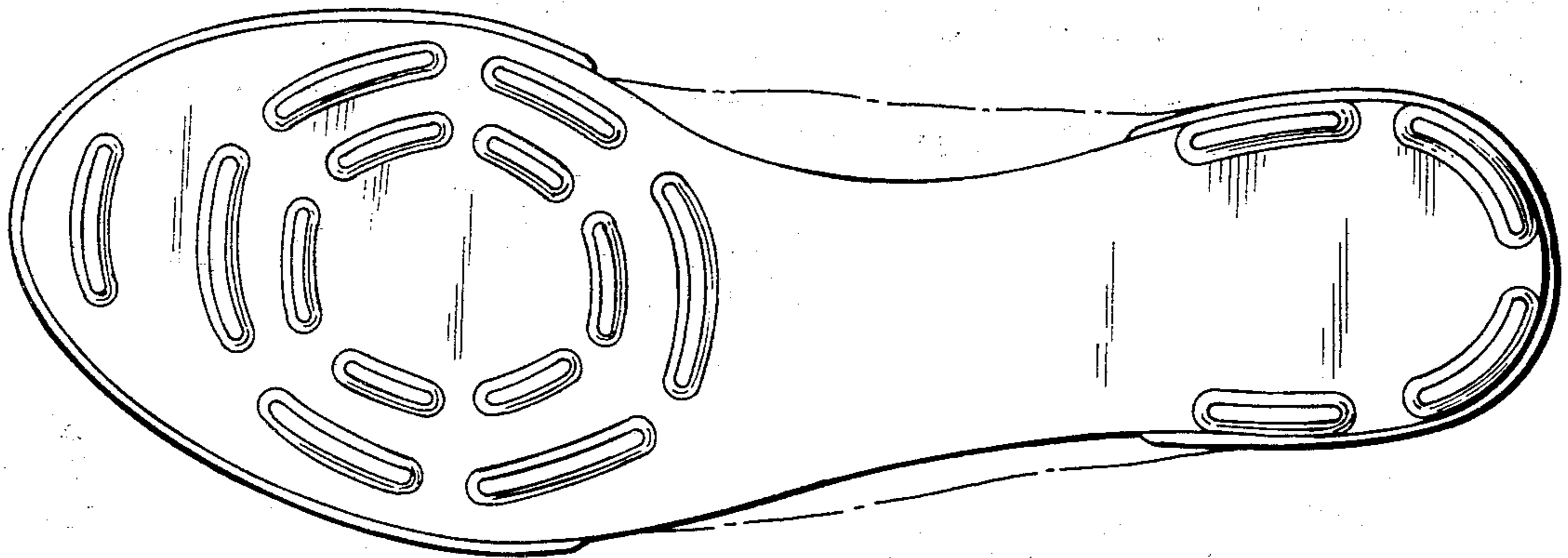
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of an athletic shoe sole showing my new design;

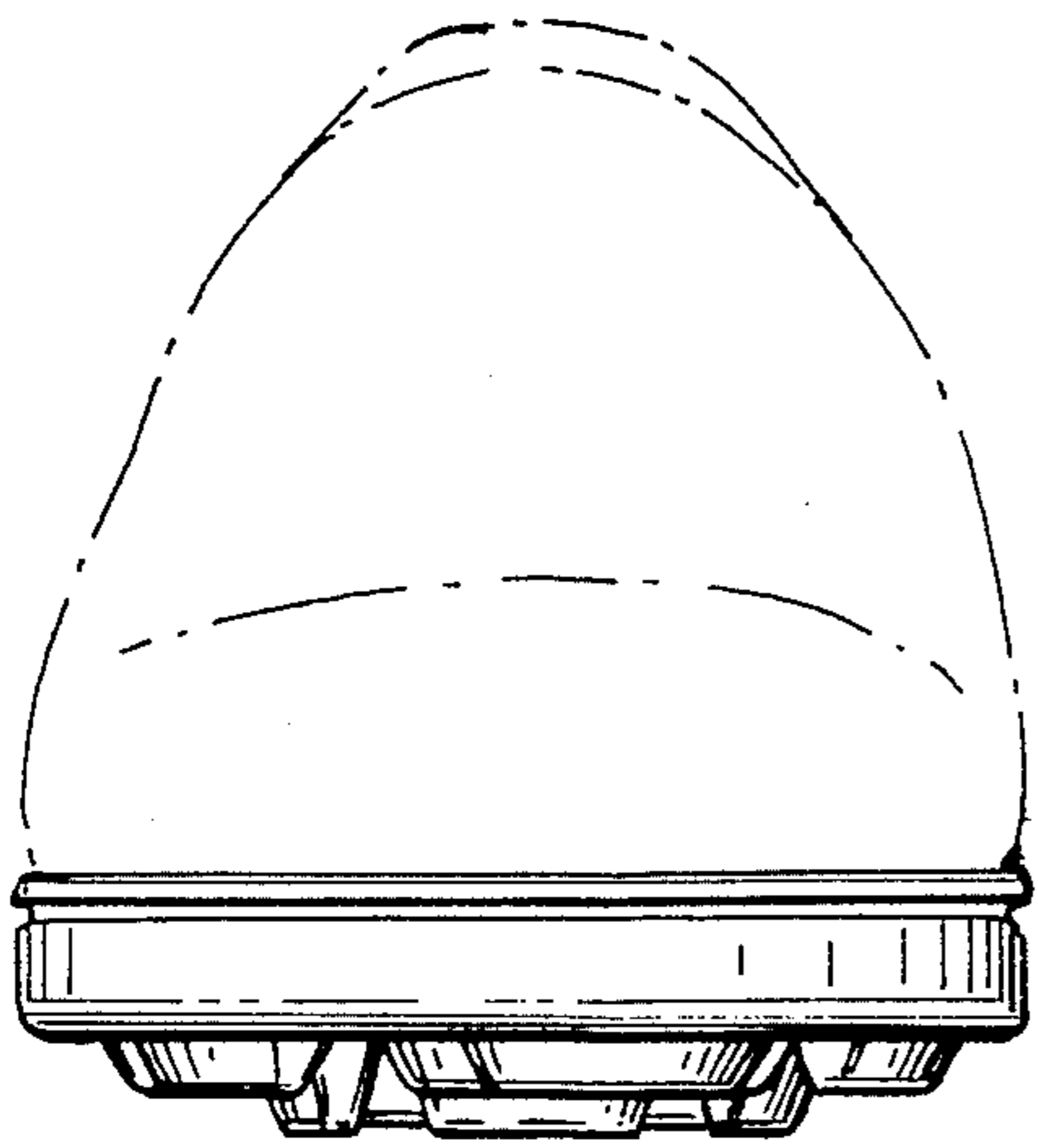

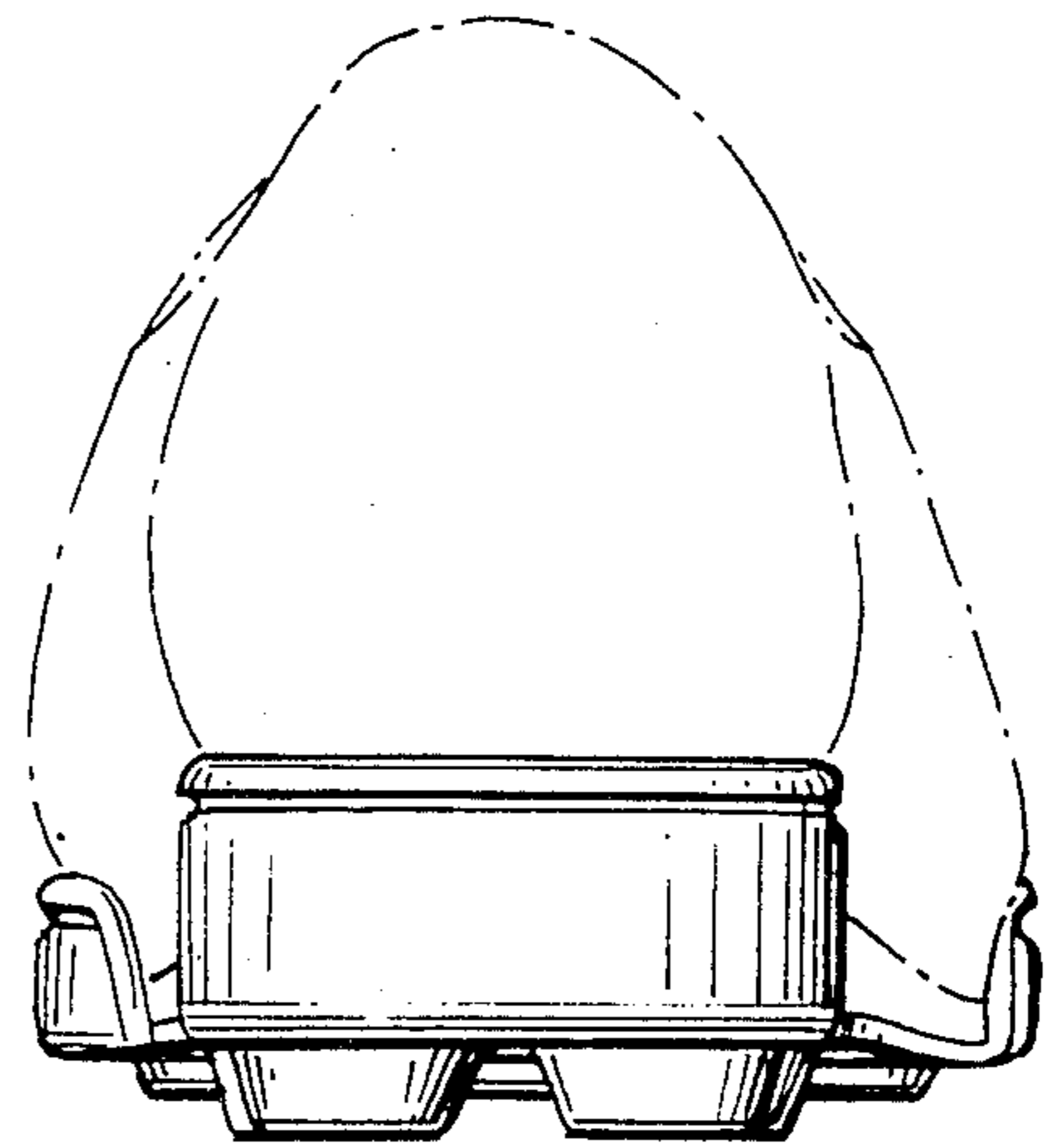

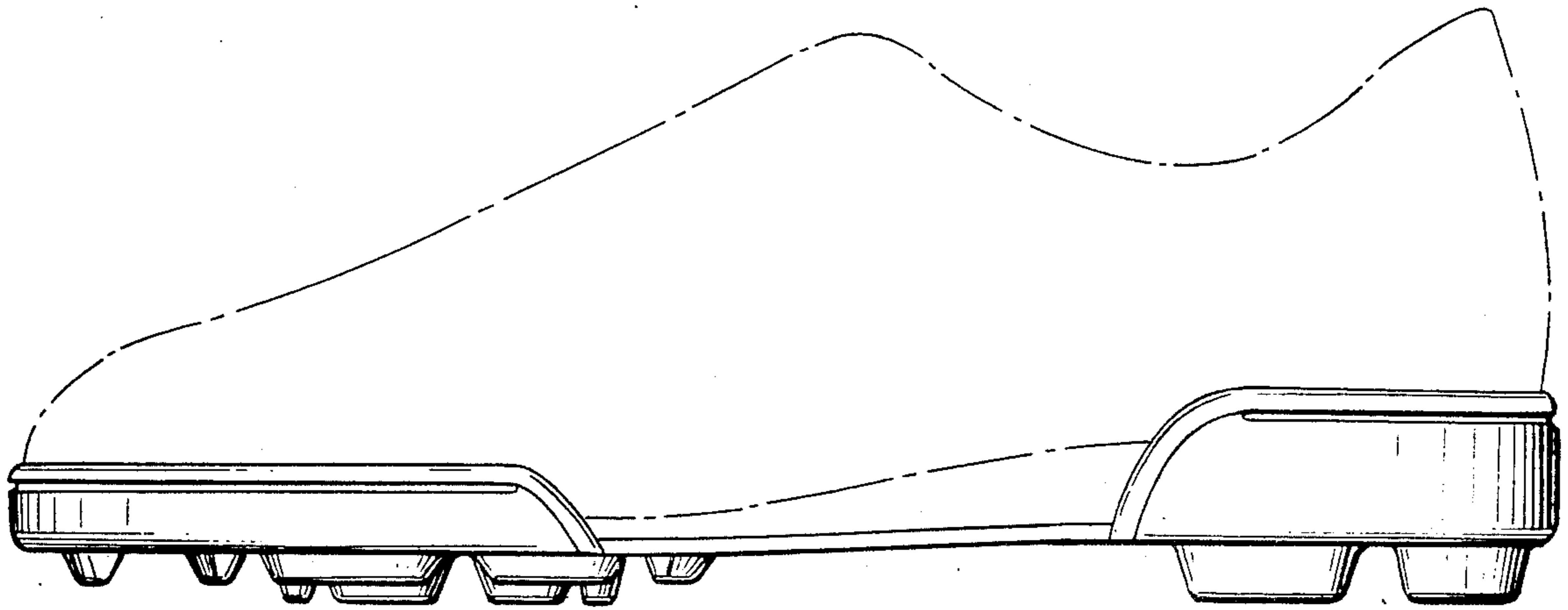

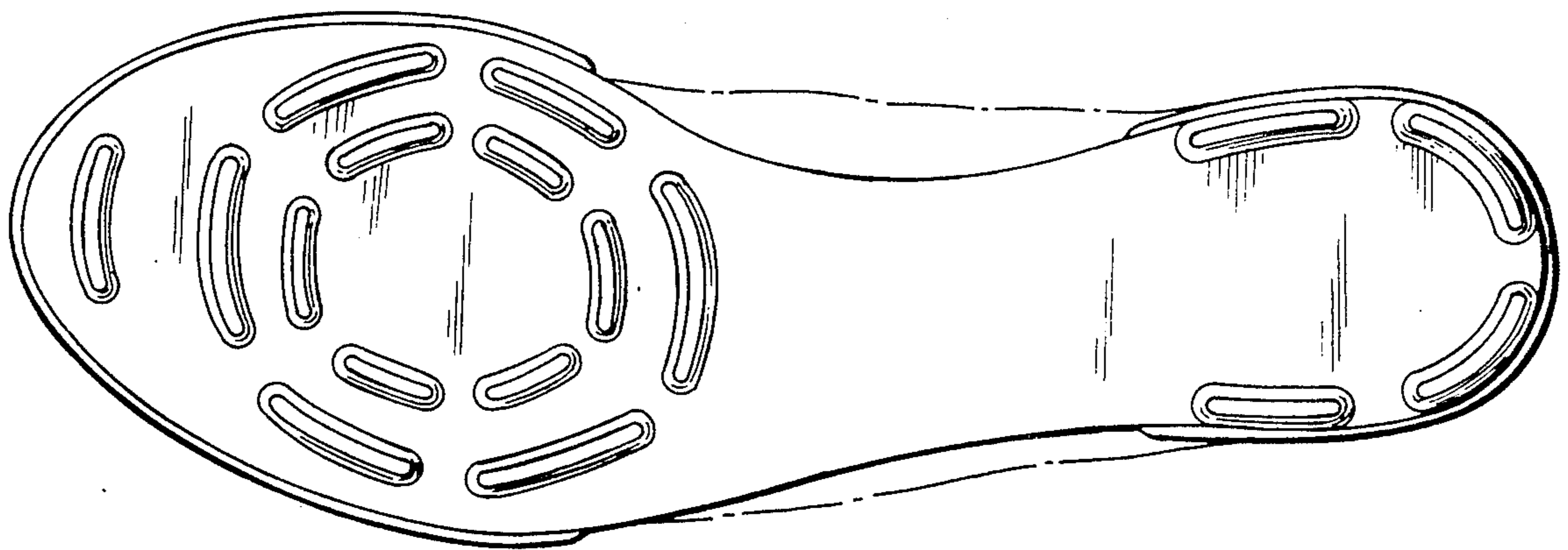
