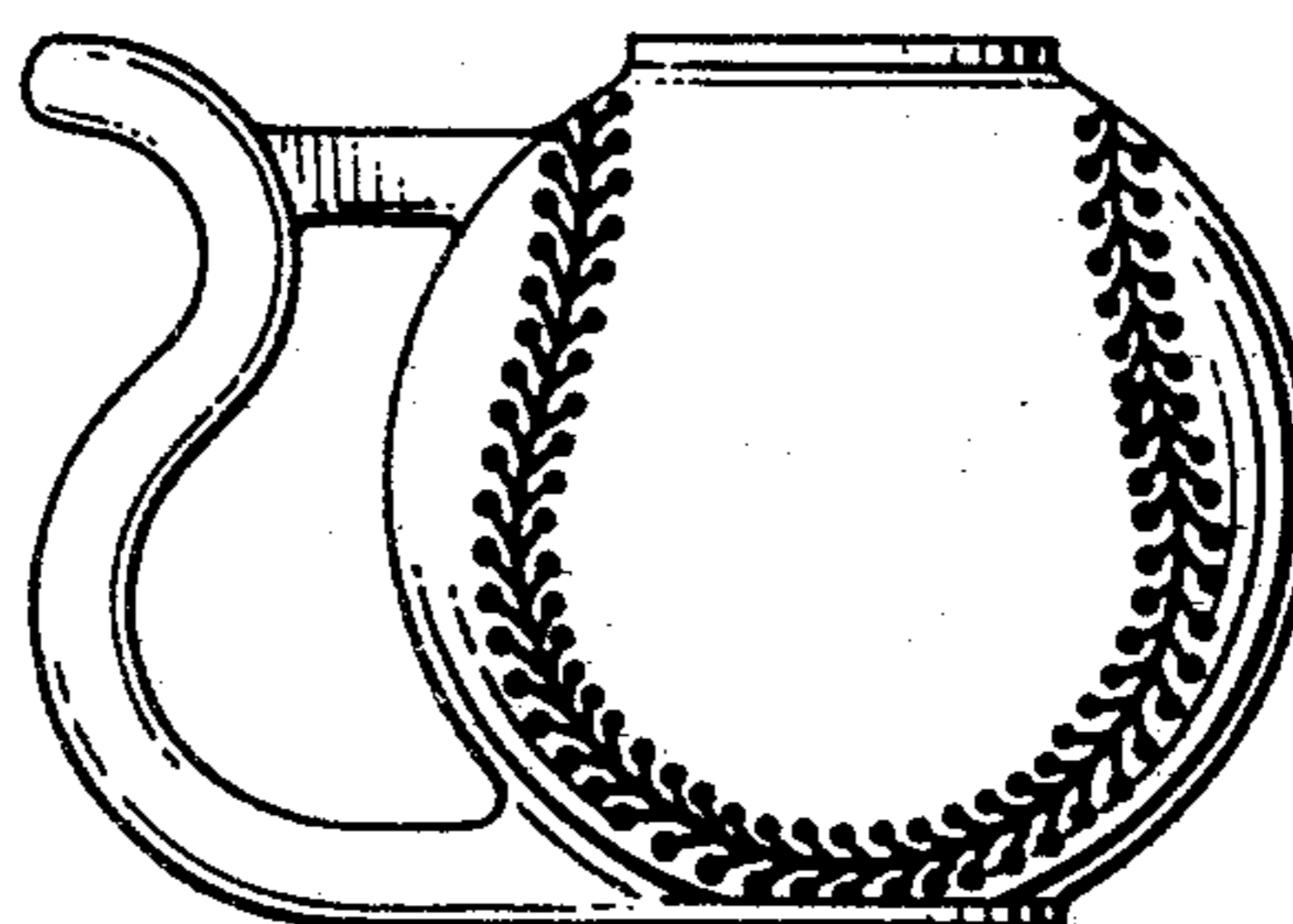
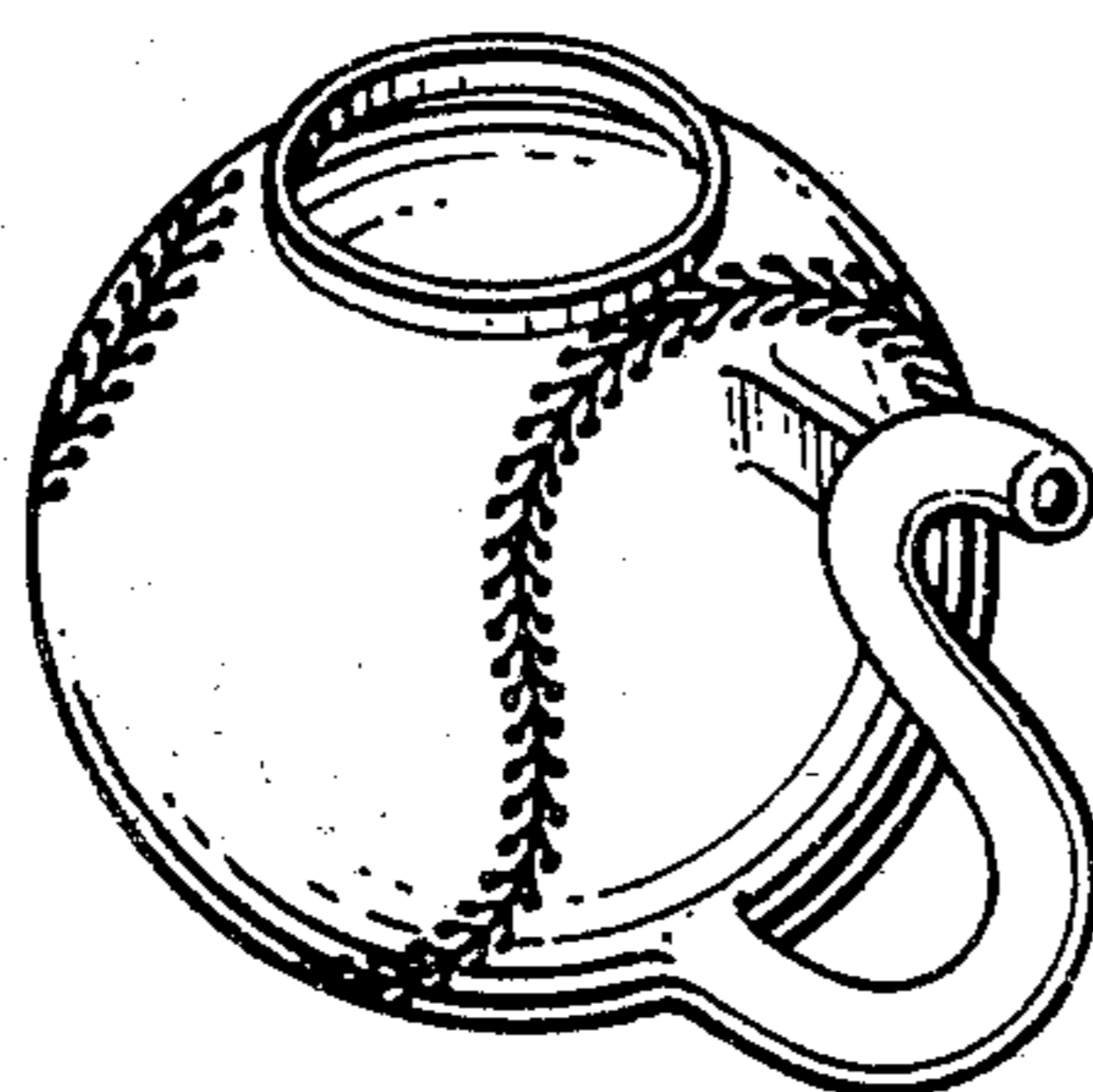

[57] CLAIM

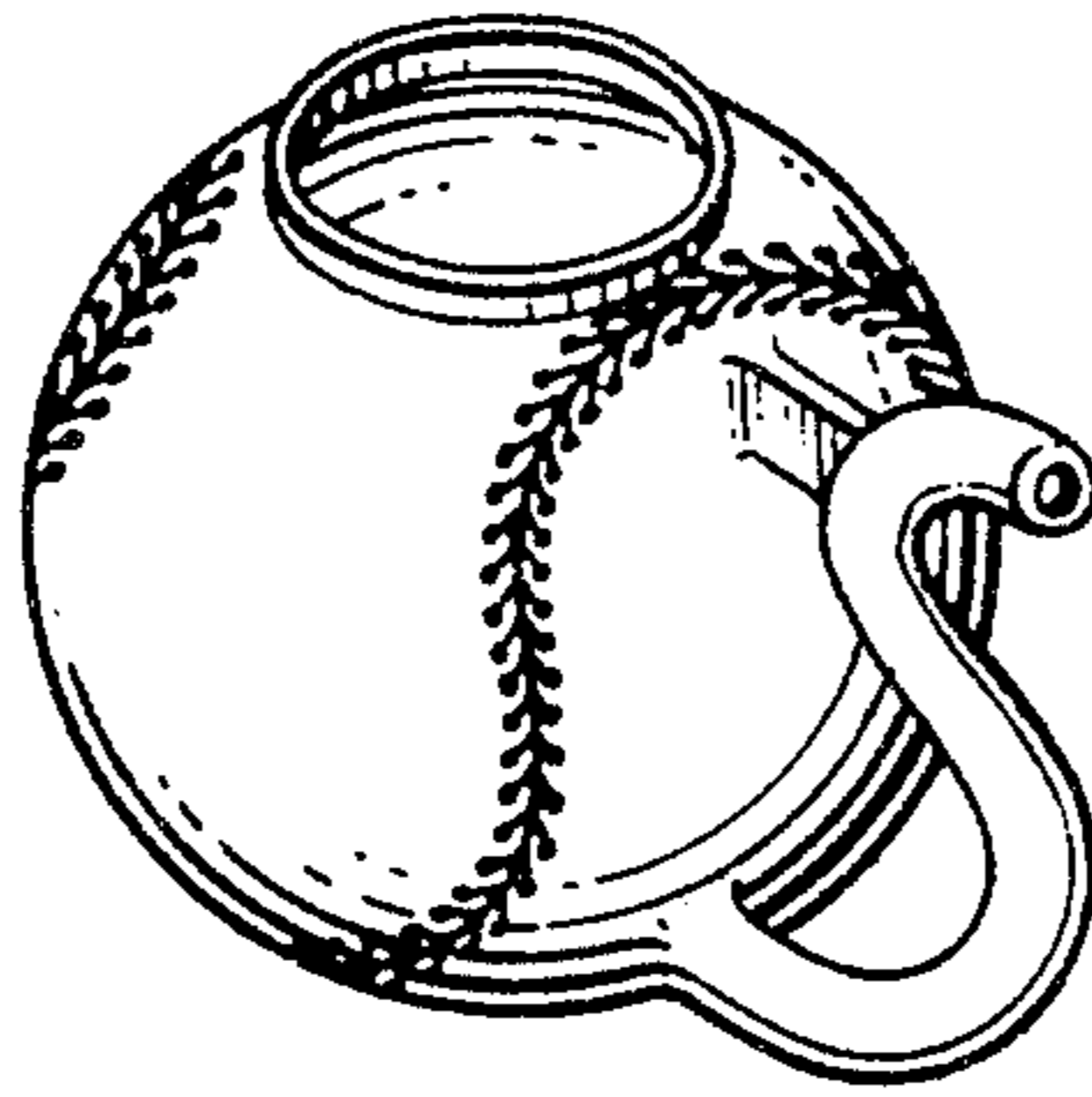
The ornamental design for a drinking cup, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

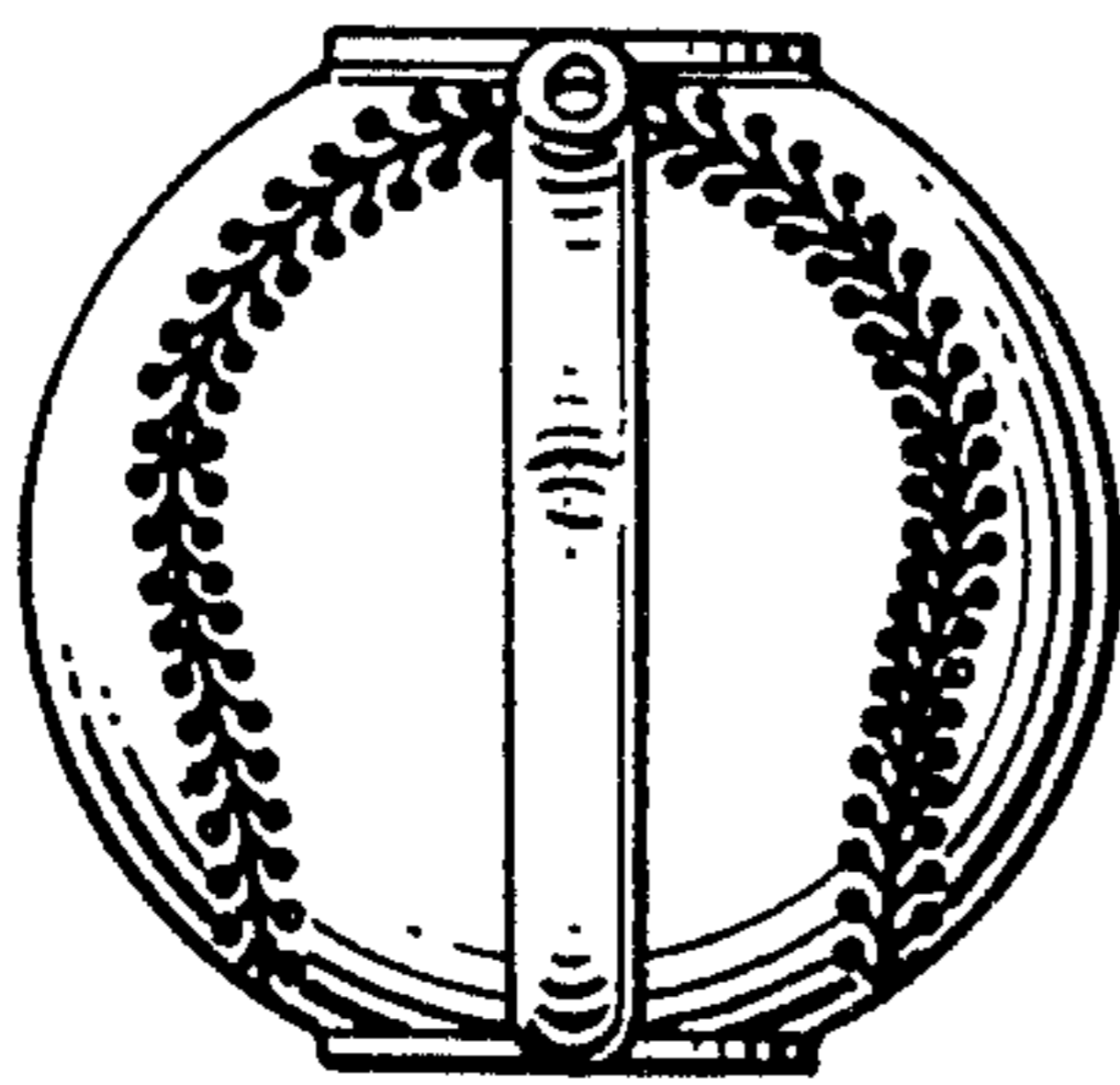
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a drinking cup embodying my new design and showing the front, top, and left sides thereof;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side as shown;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 7 is a vertical section thereof, taken generally on line 7—7 of FIG. 5.



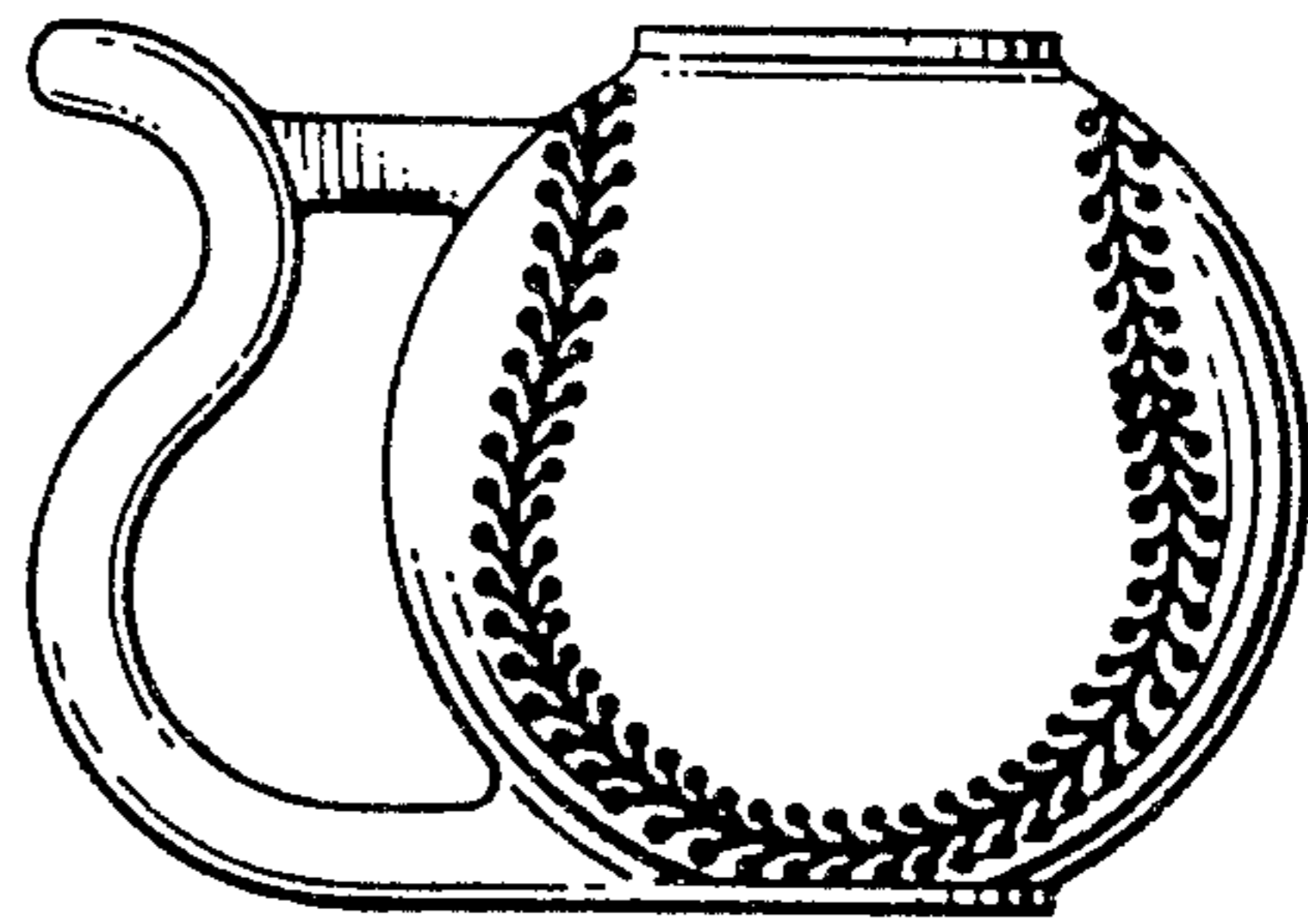

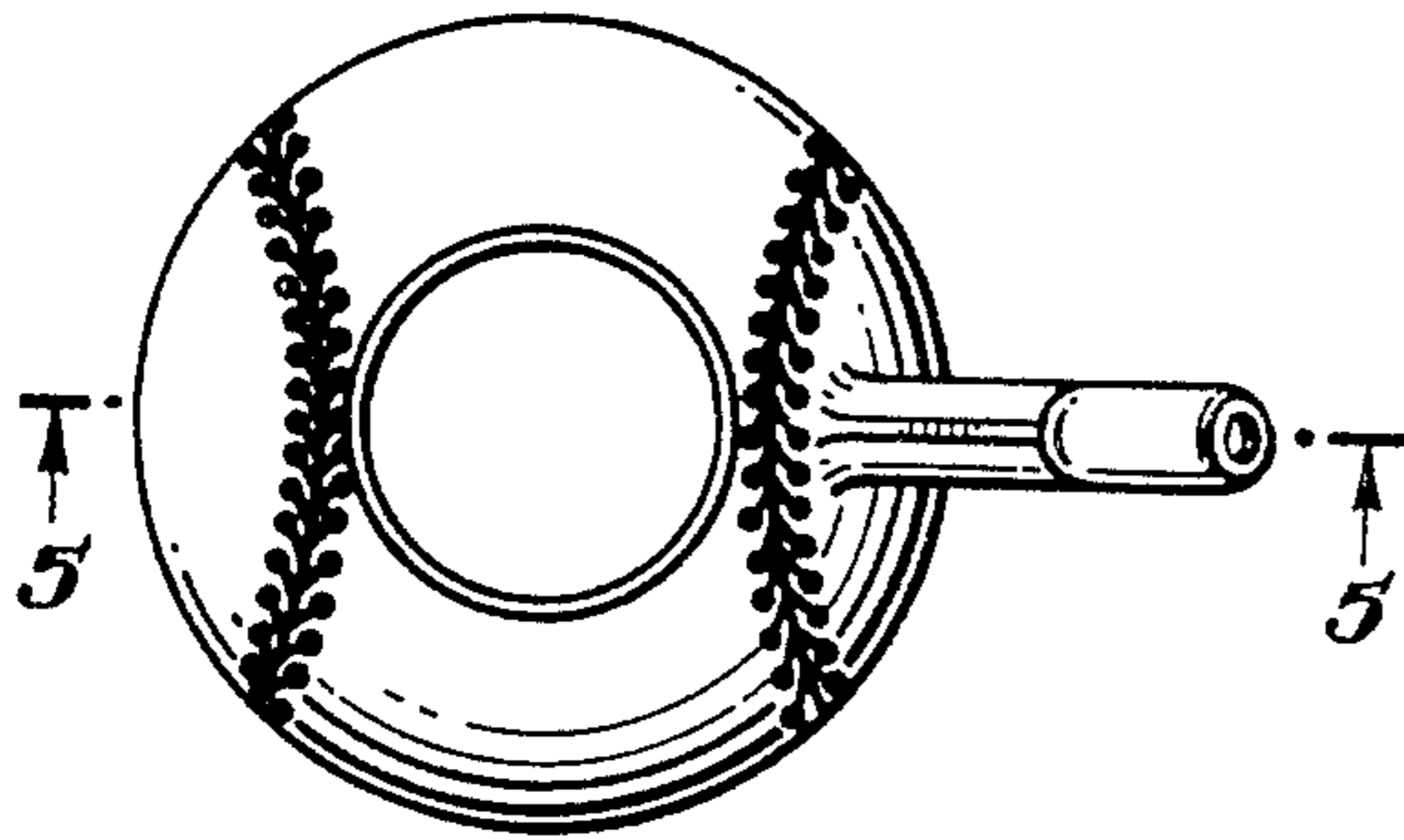

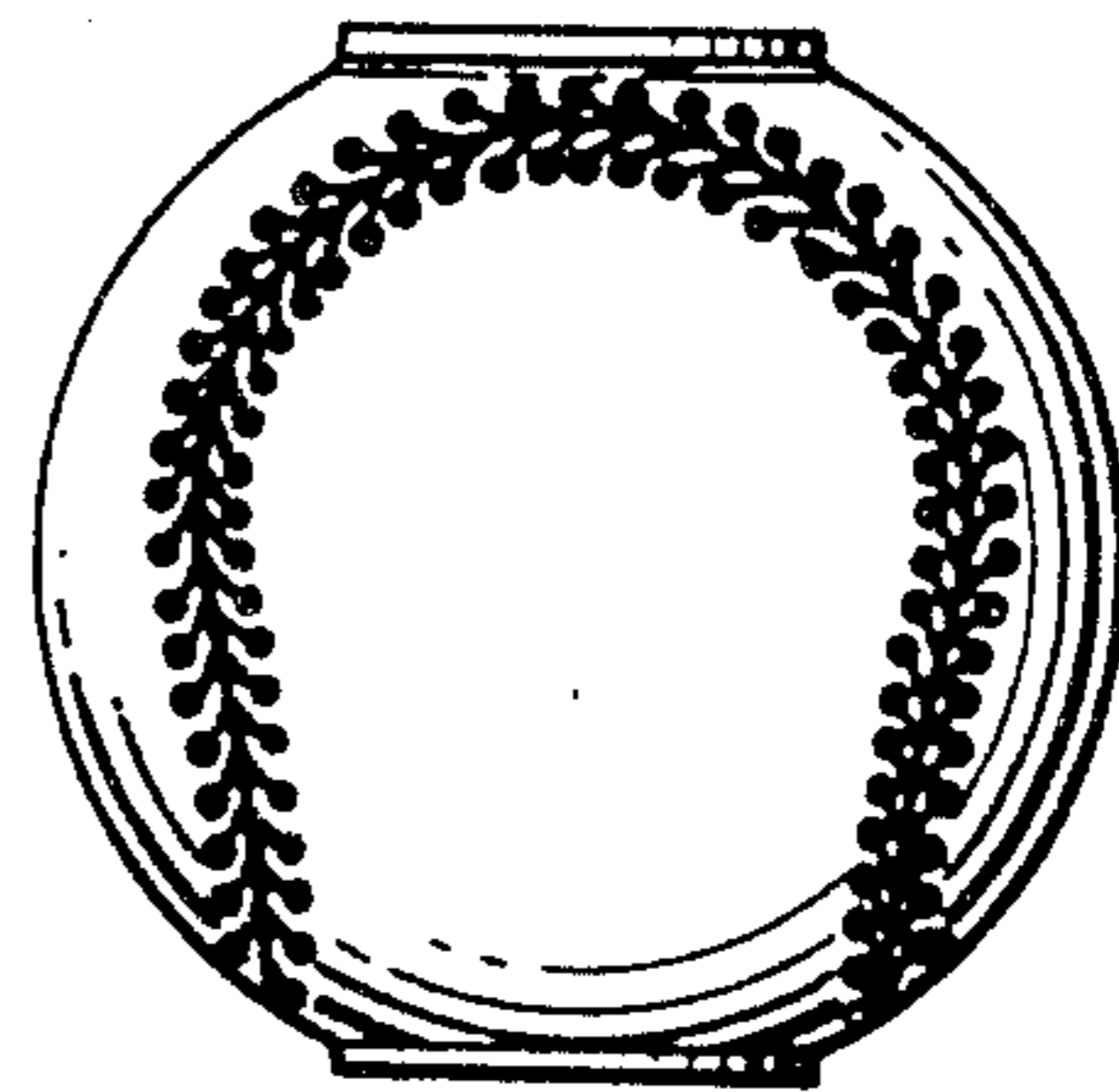

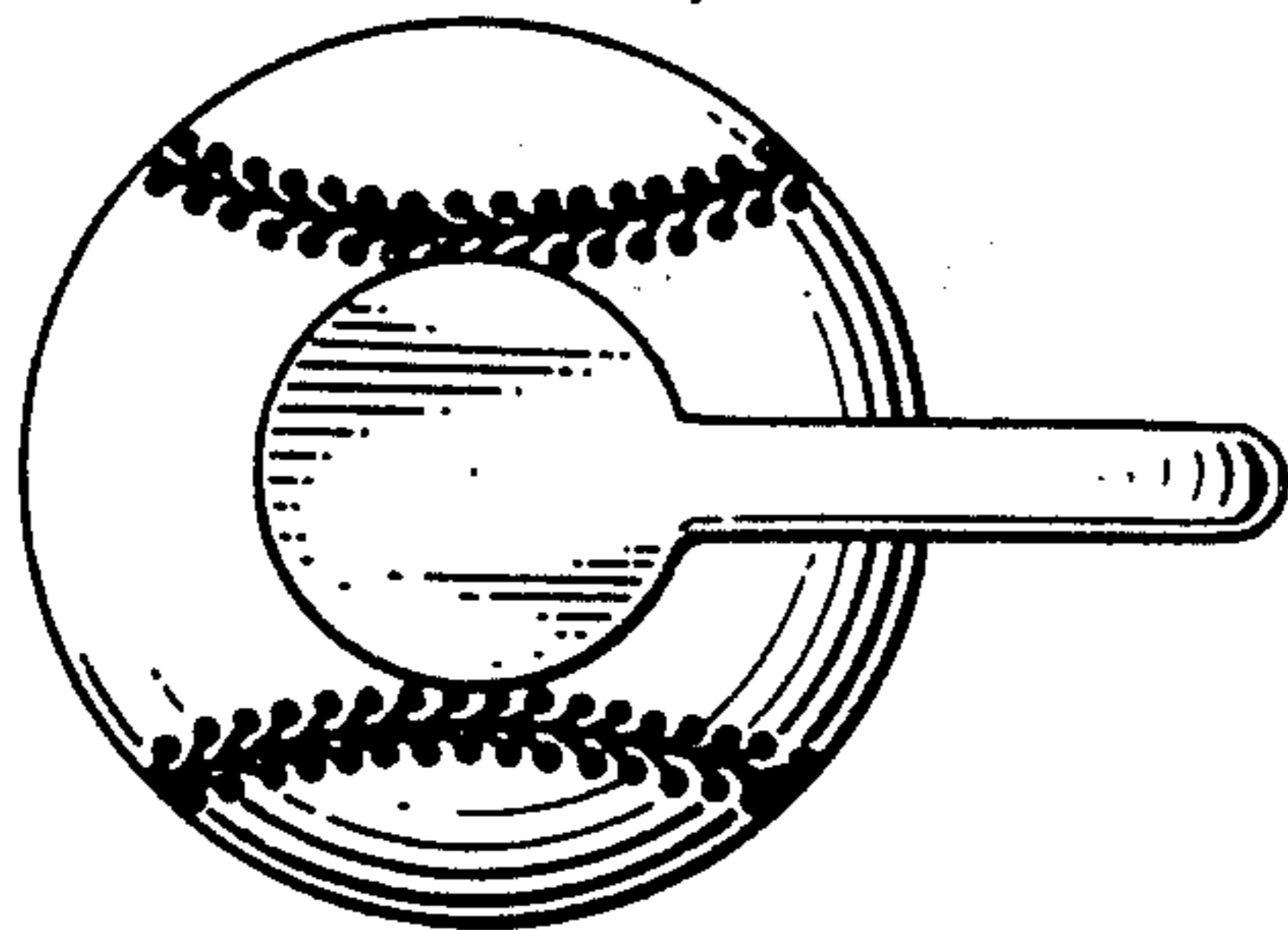
