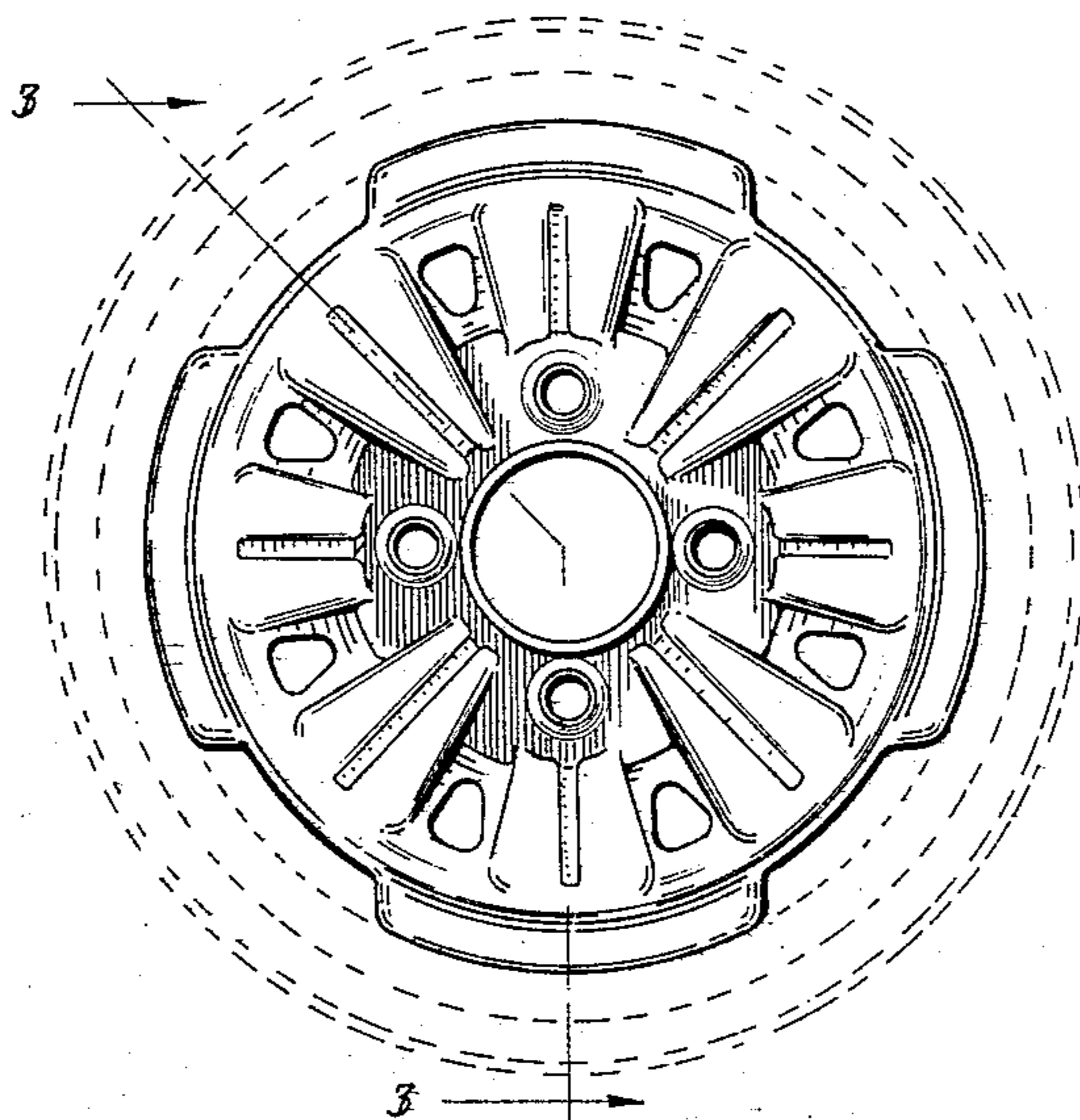
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a wheel spider showing a second embodiment of my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only;

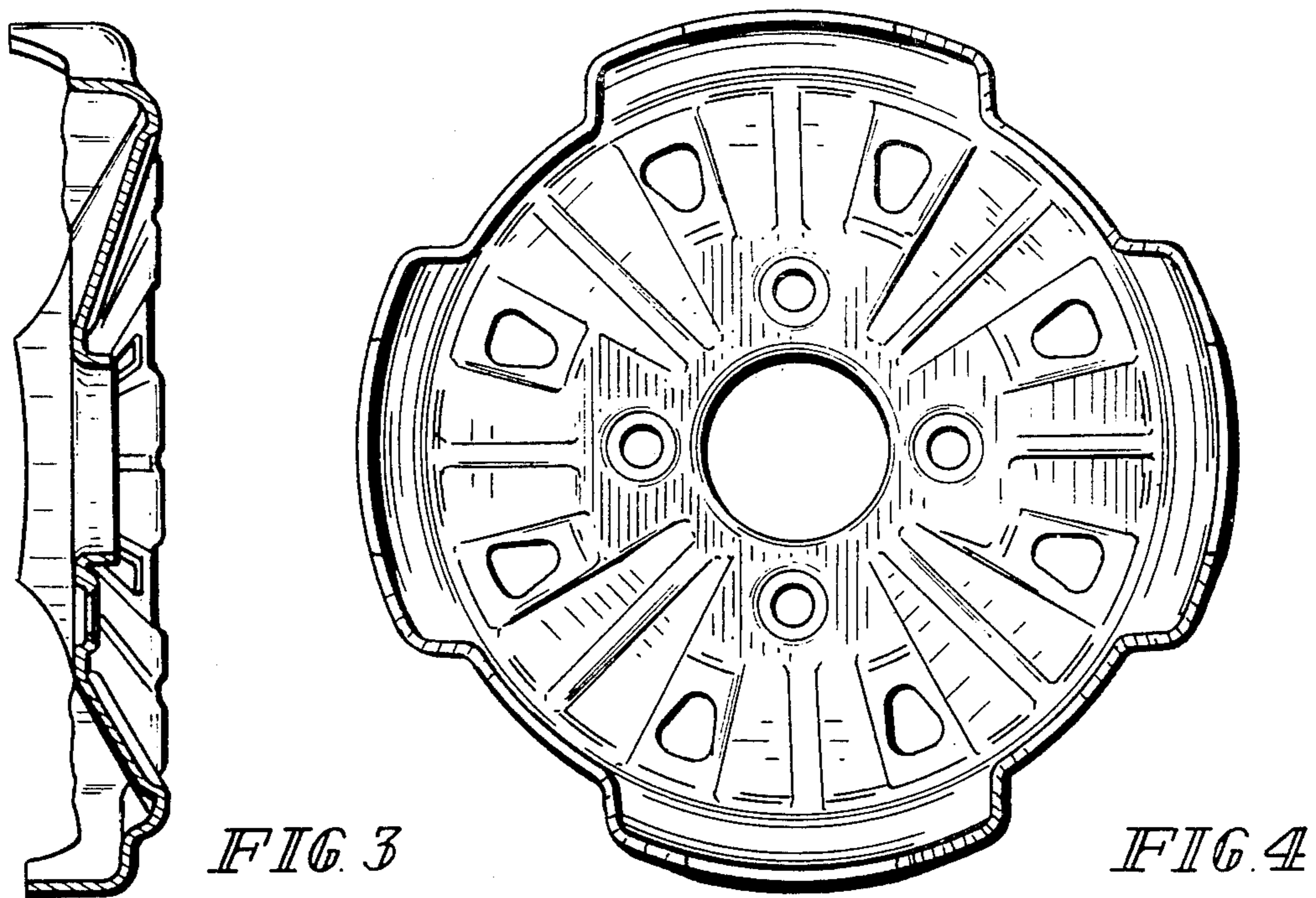
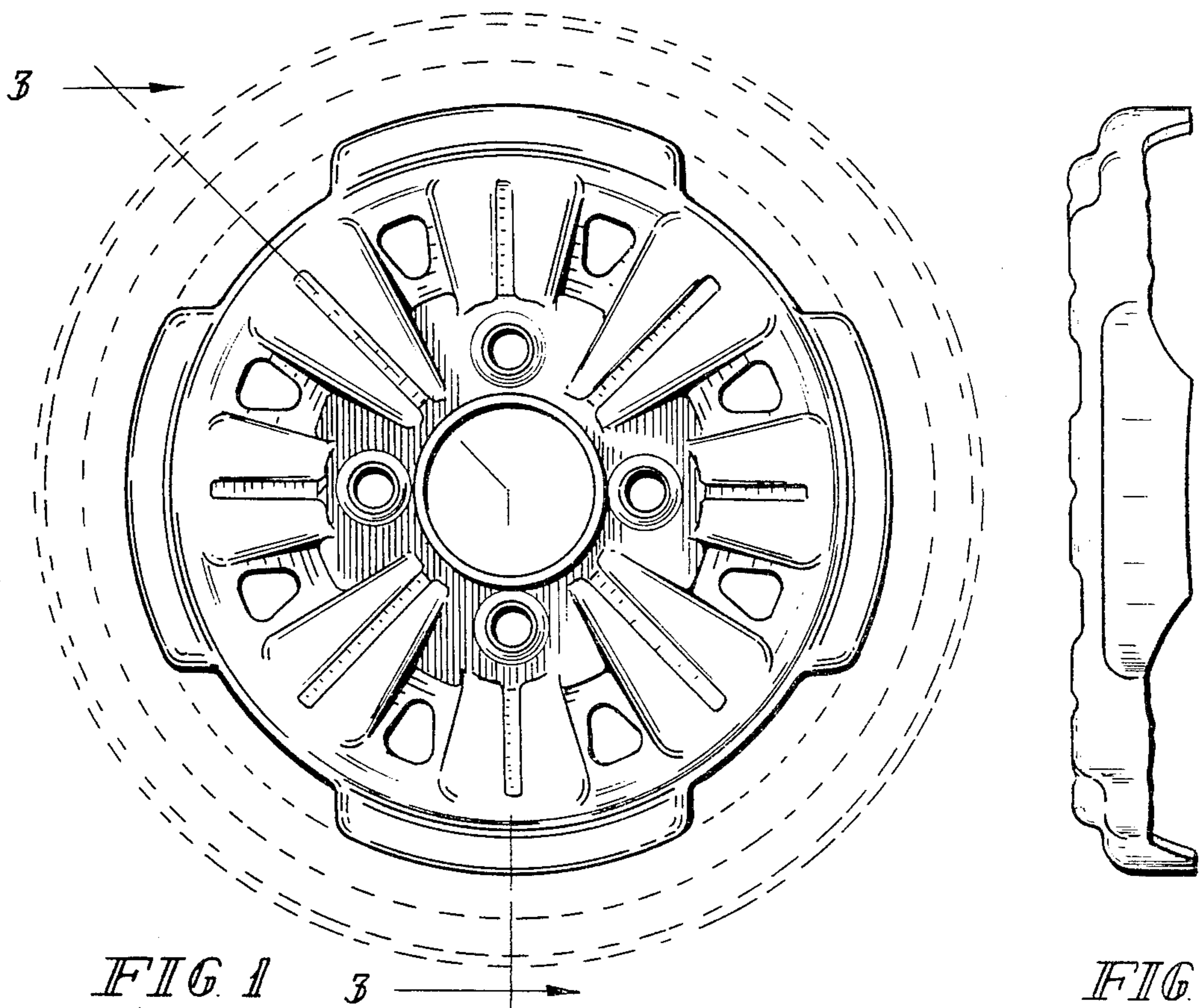
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 5;

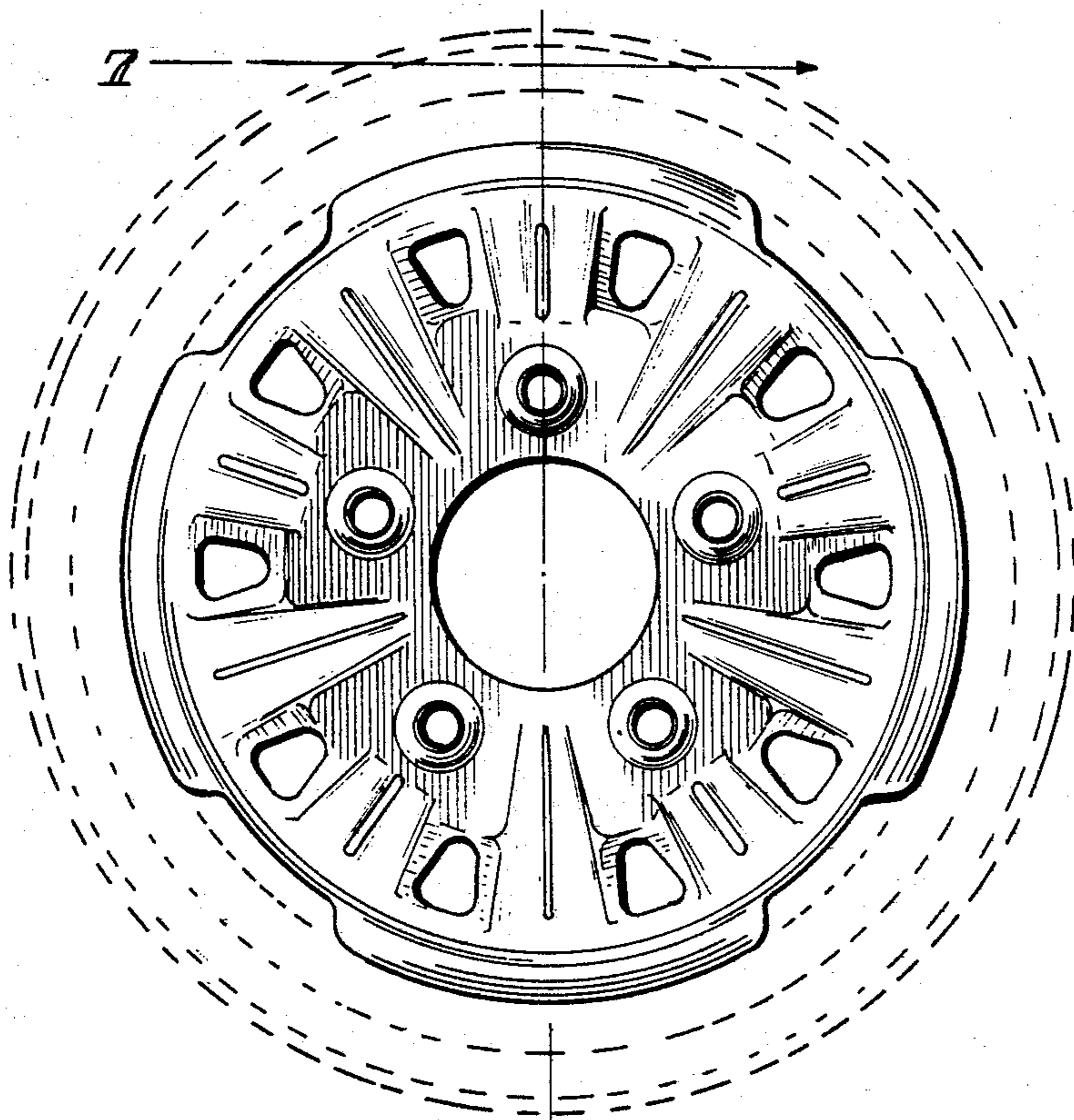

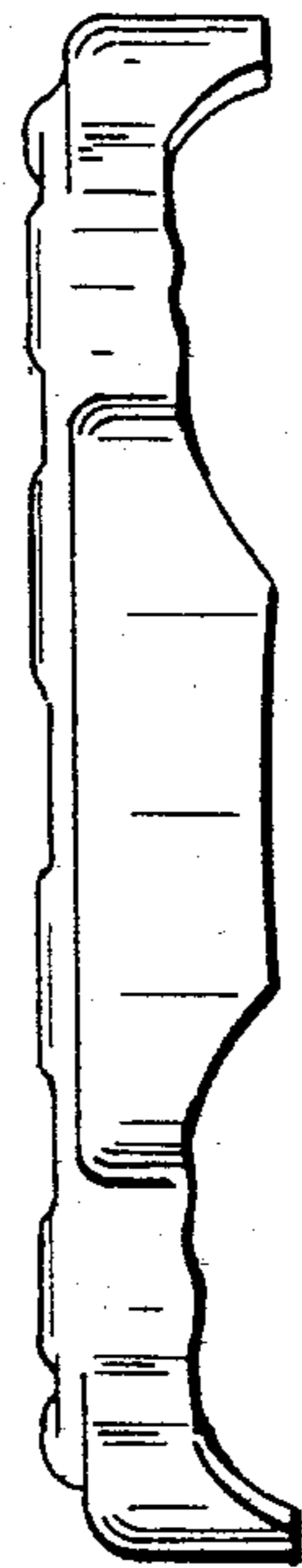

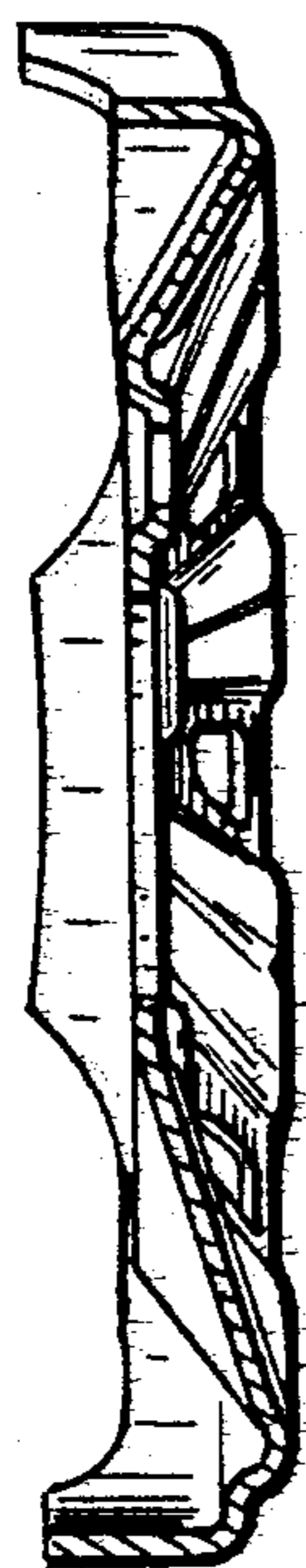

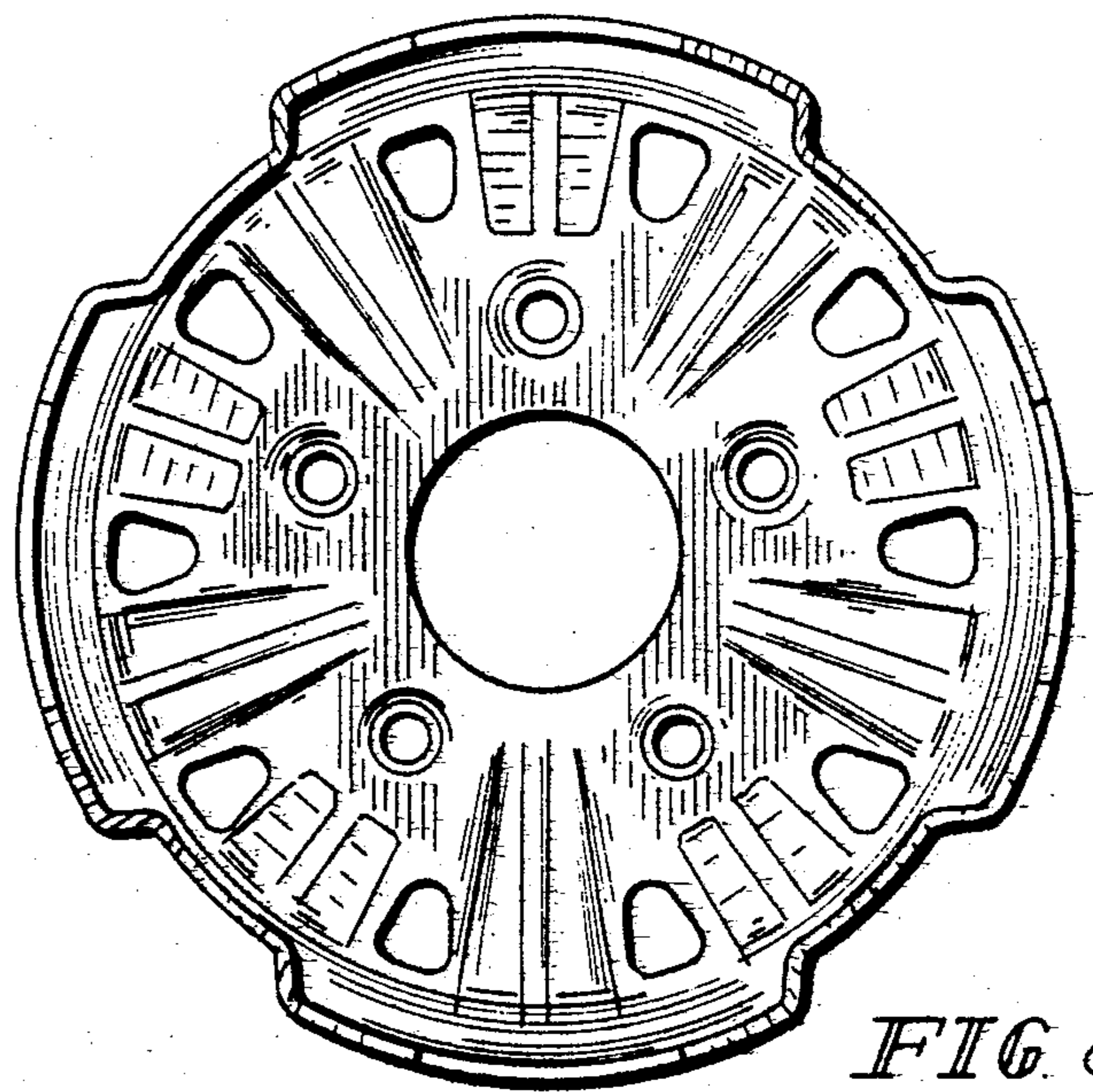
