

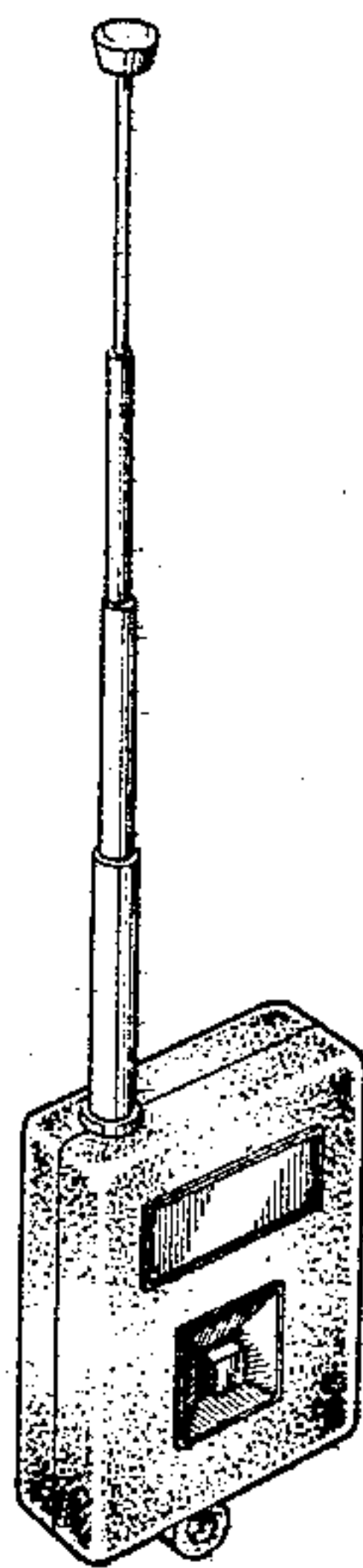

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a radio transmitter
showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right
side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a top, front and left side perspective view
thereof, shown with the antenna in the extended posi-
tion.



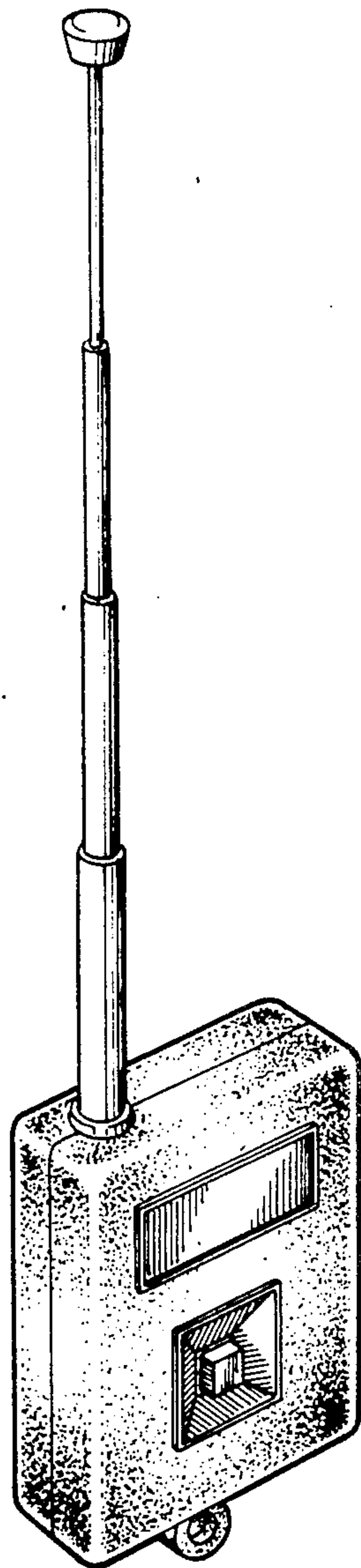

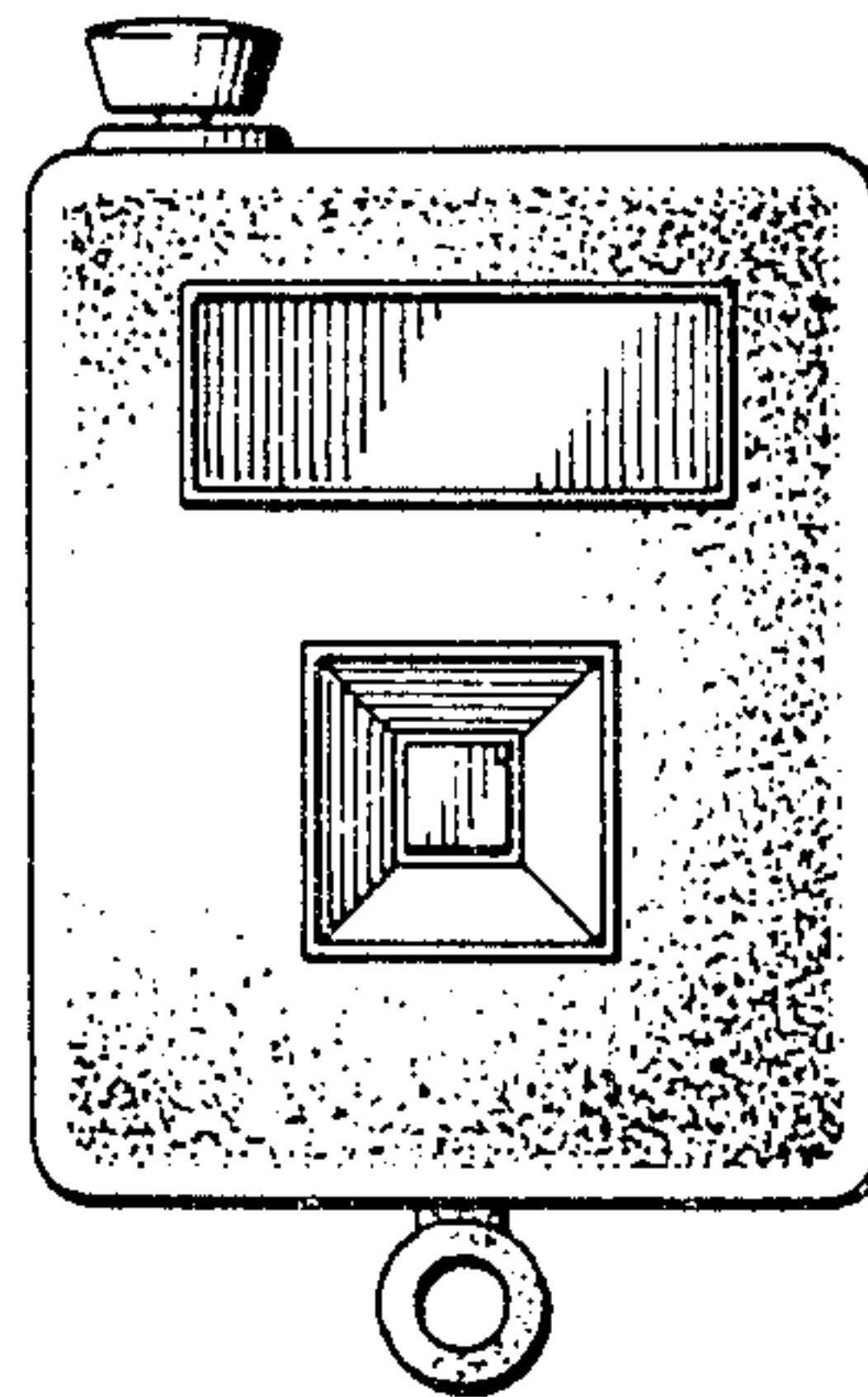

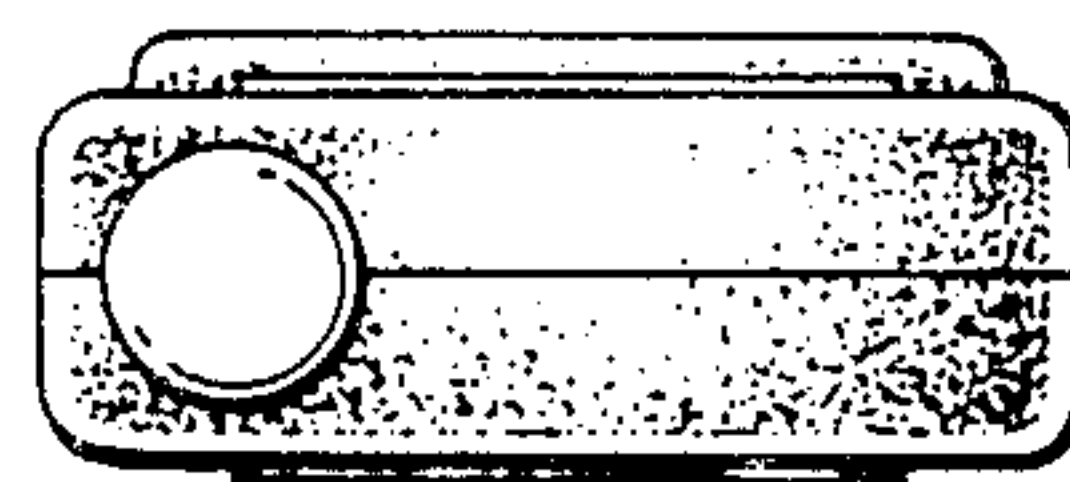

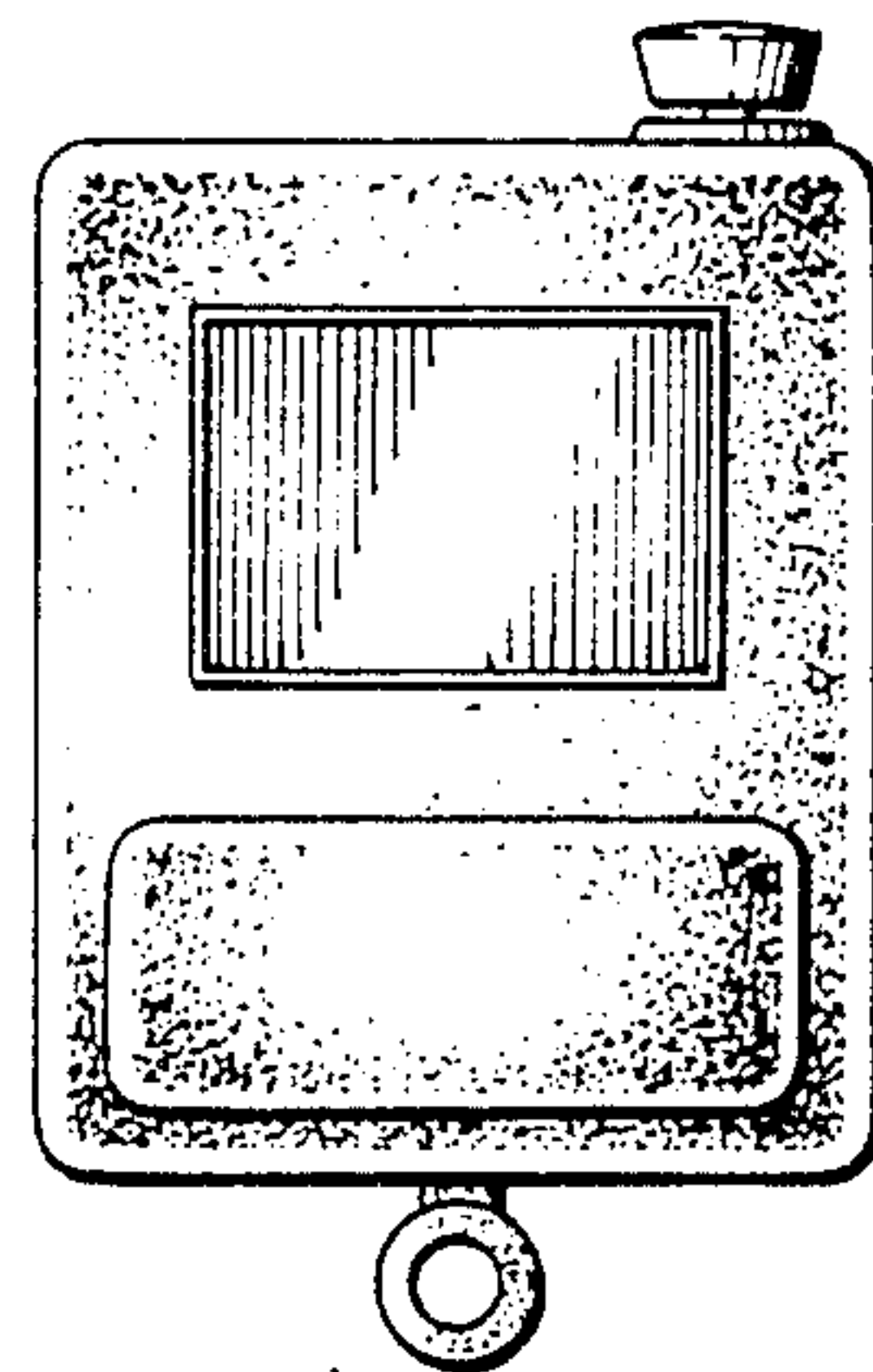

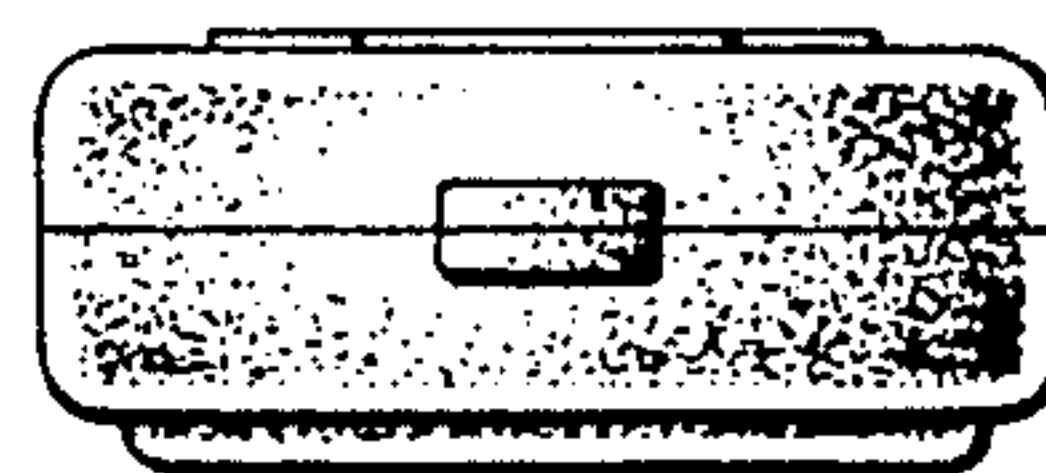
