The ornamental design for a novelty incandescent lamp, as shown and described.

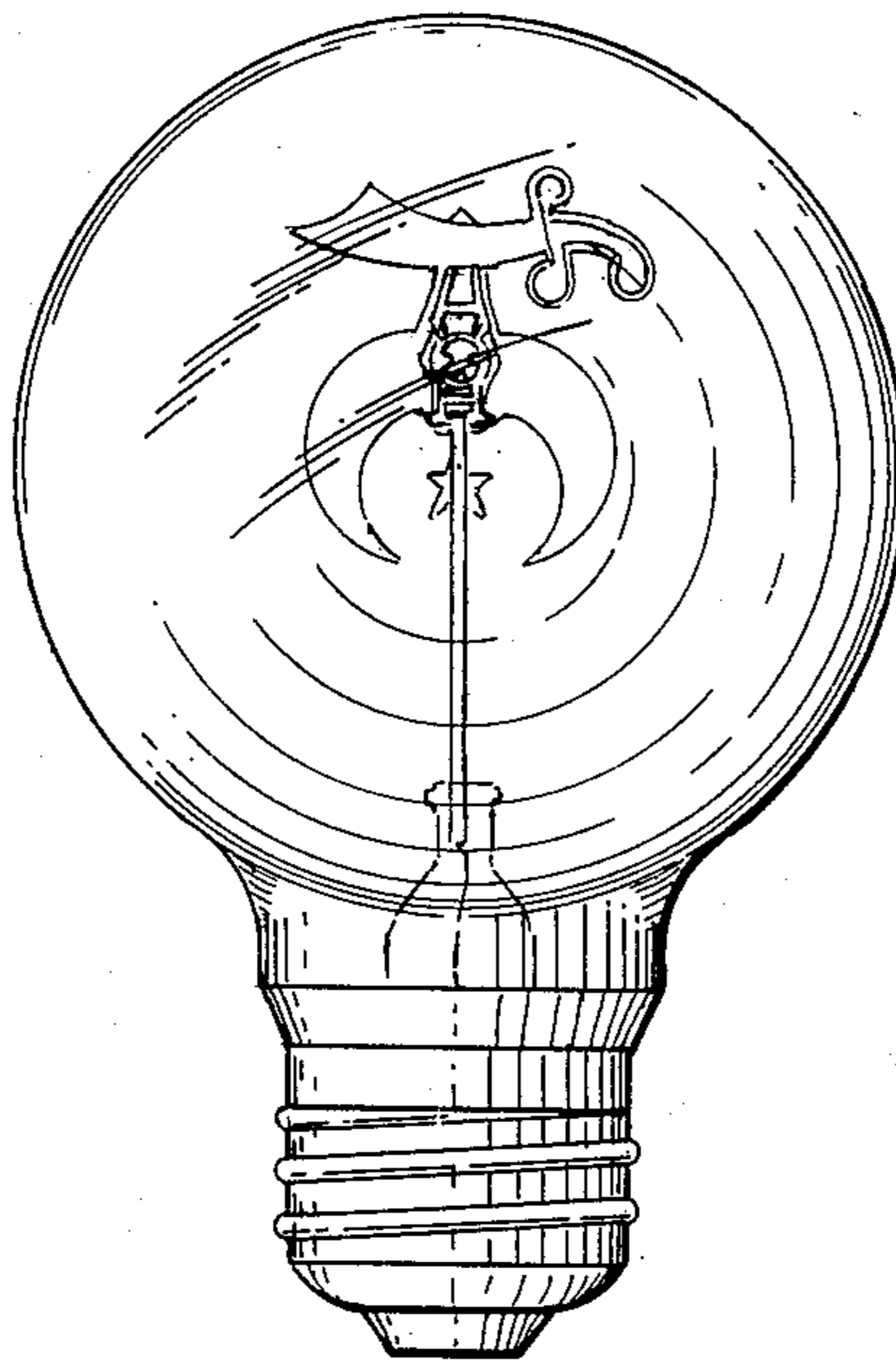
DESCRIPTION

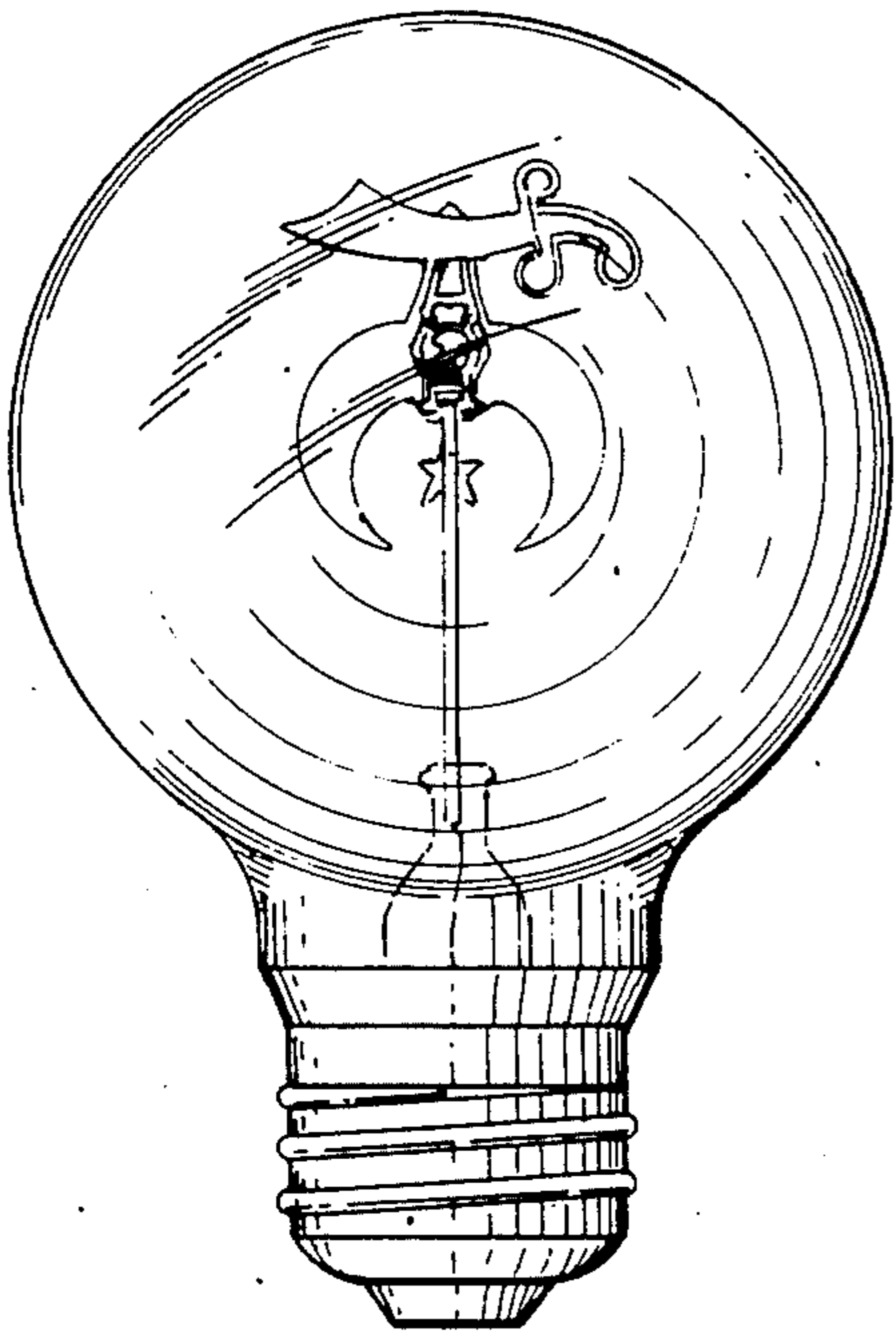
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the novelty incandescent lamp showing my new design;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

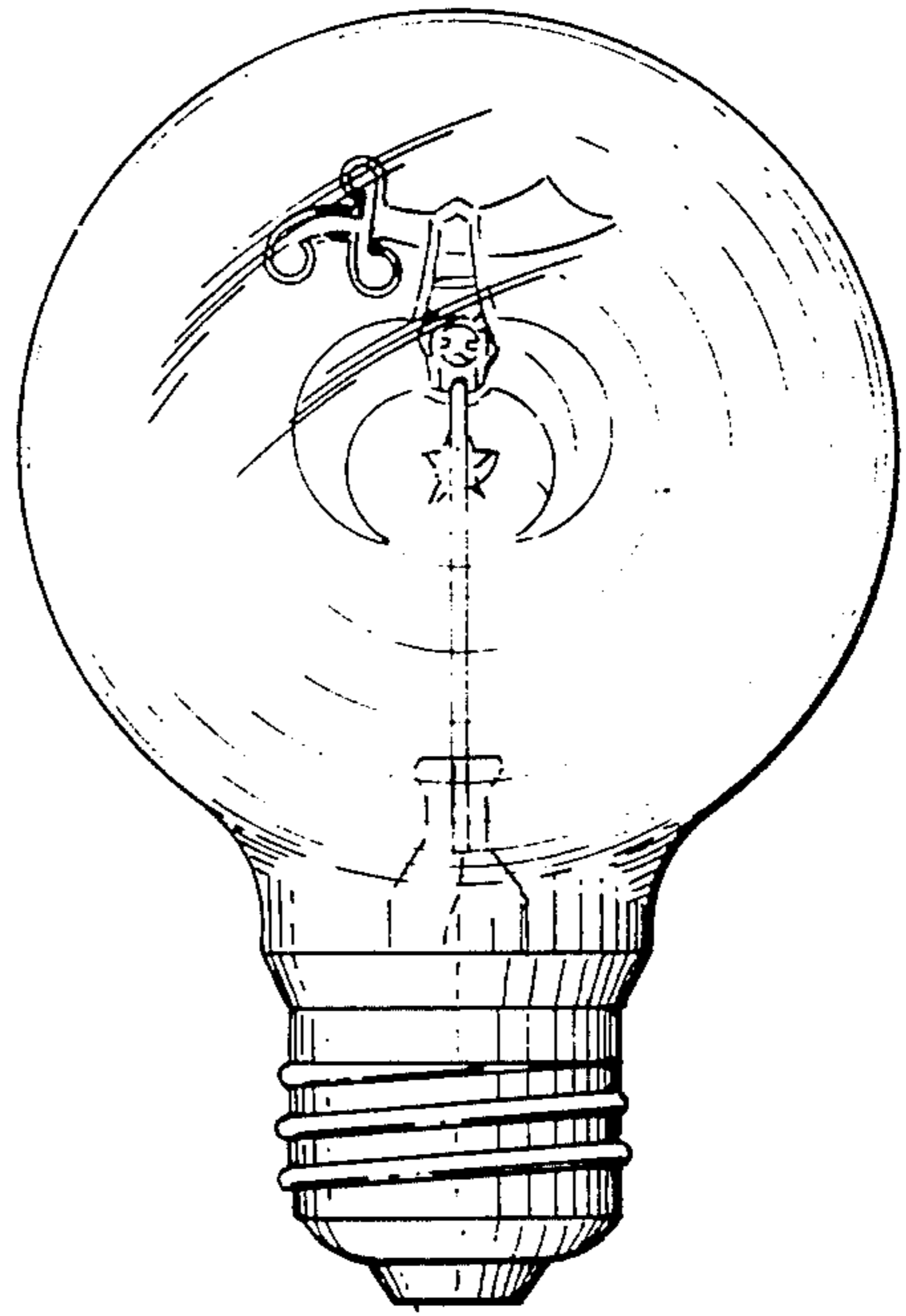
FIG. 4 is a fragmentary left side elevational view thereof, the lamp being fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration.



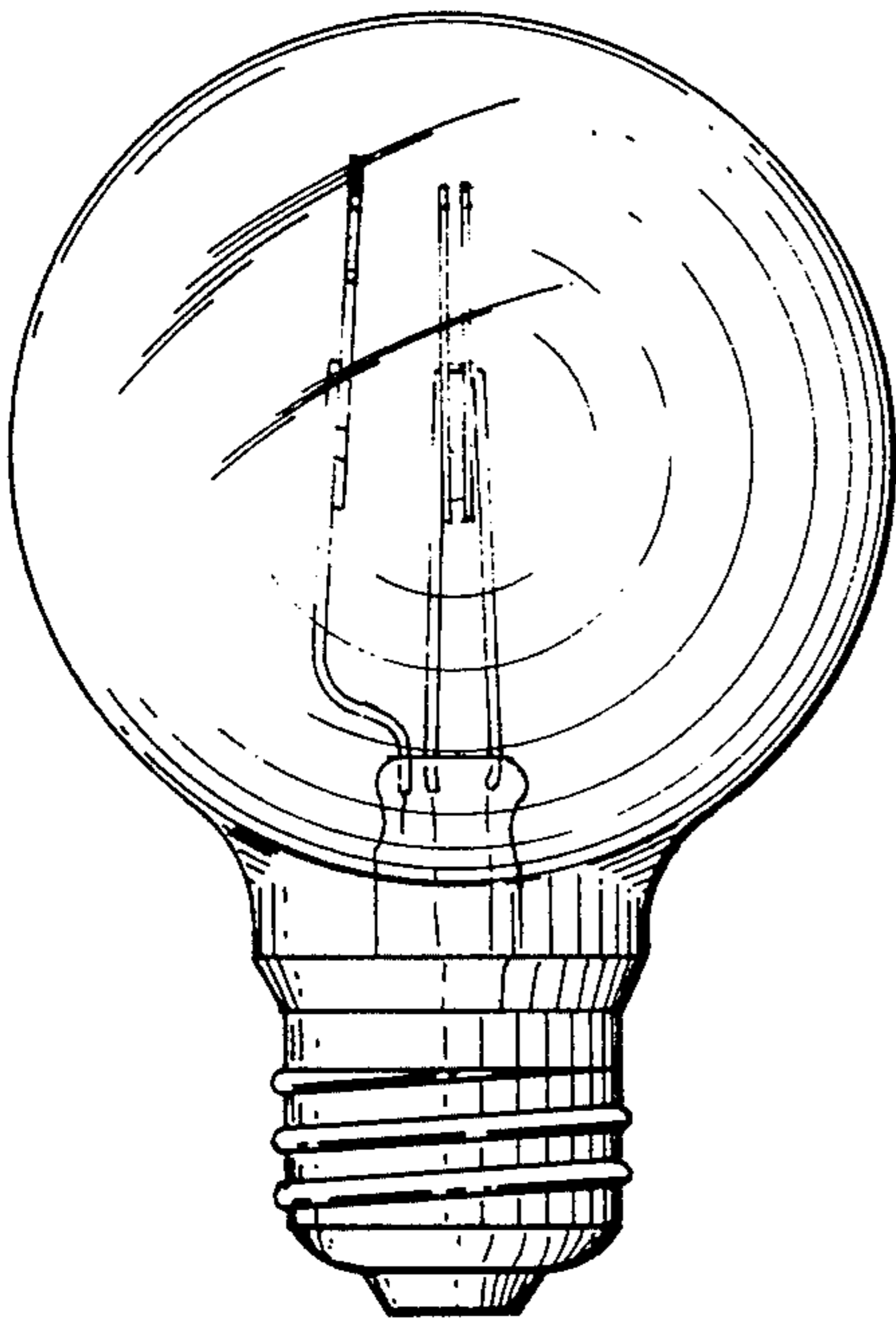
