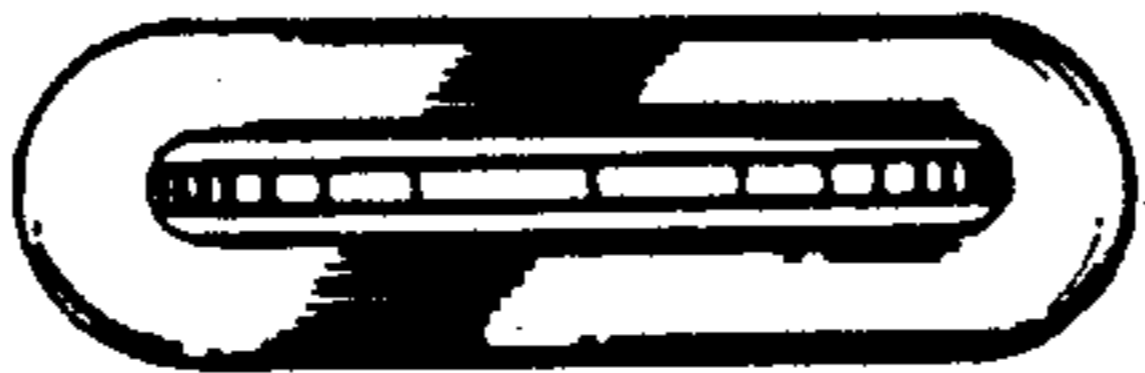
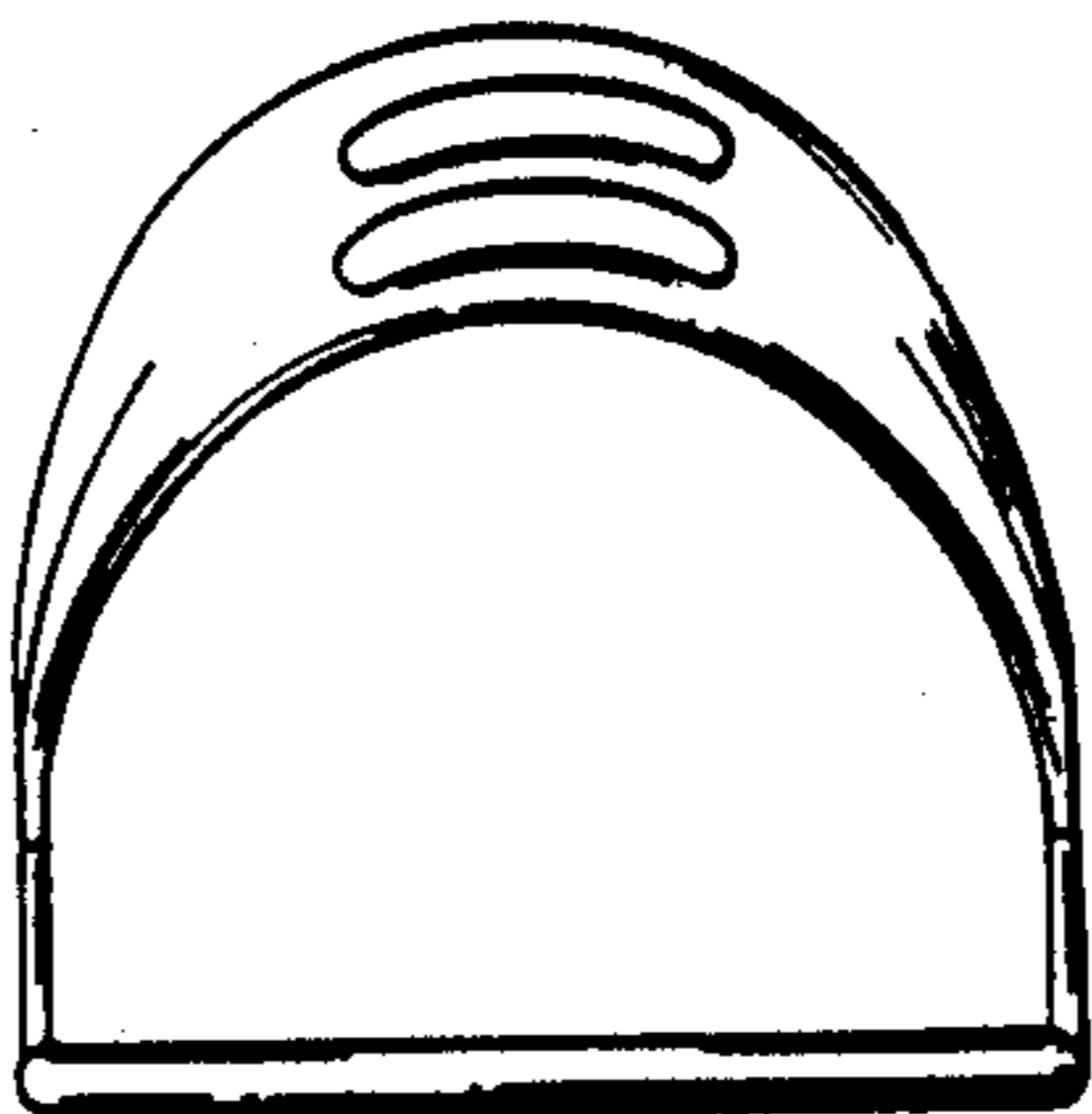
The ornamental design for a stirrup iron, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a stirrup iron showing my new design, the rear elevation being identical in appearance;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical in appearance.



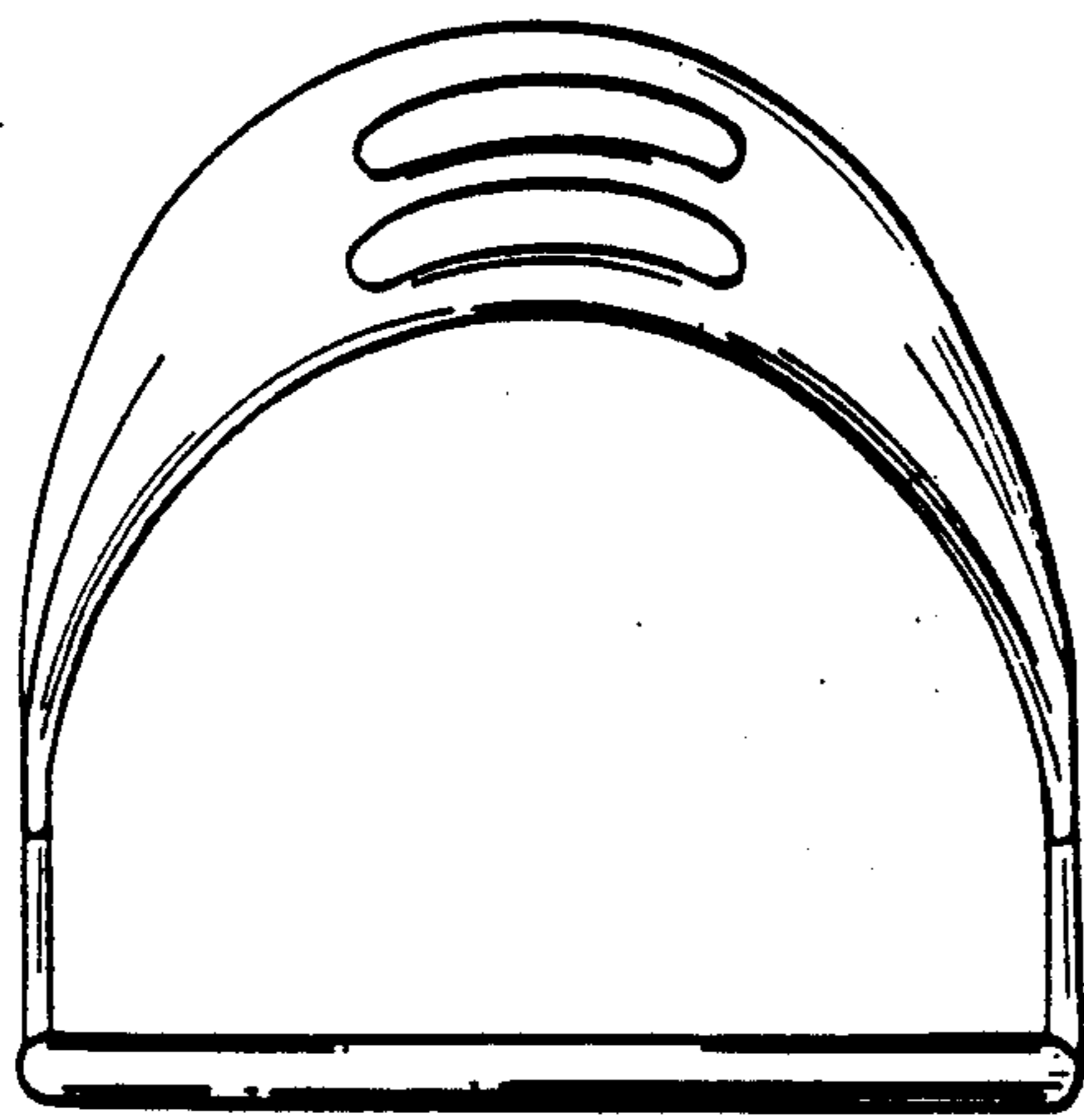

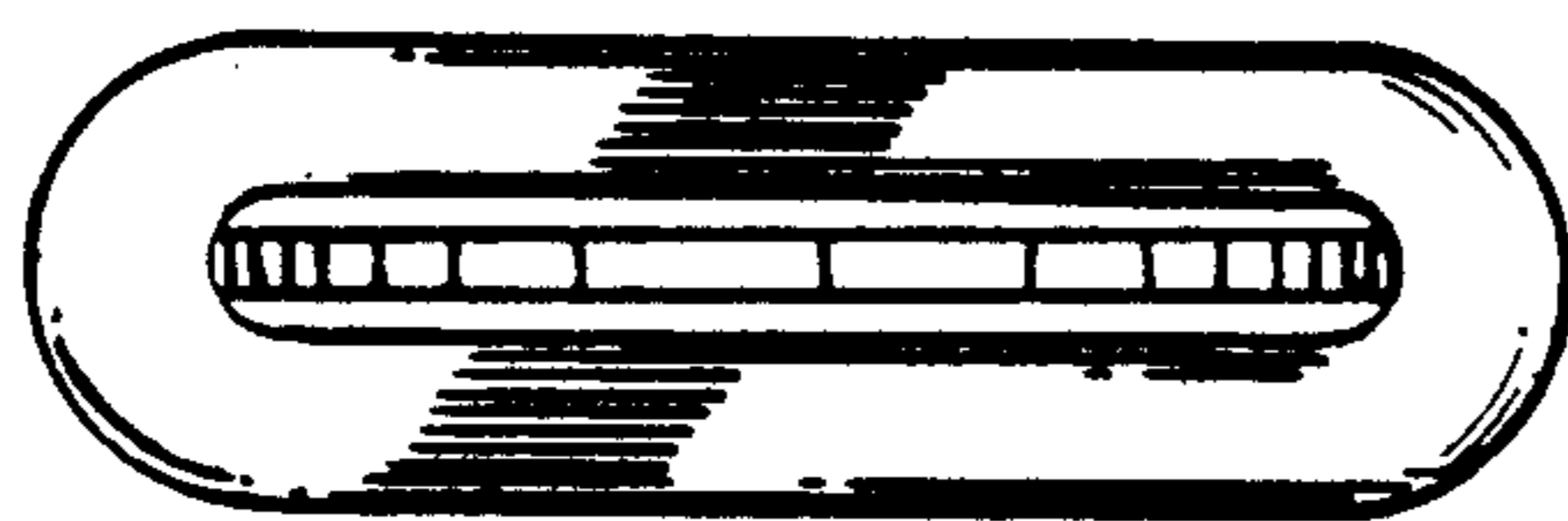

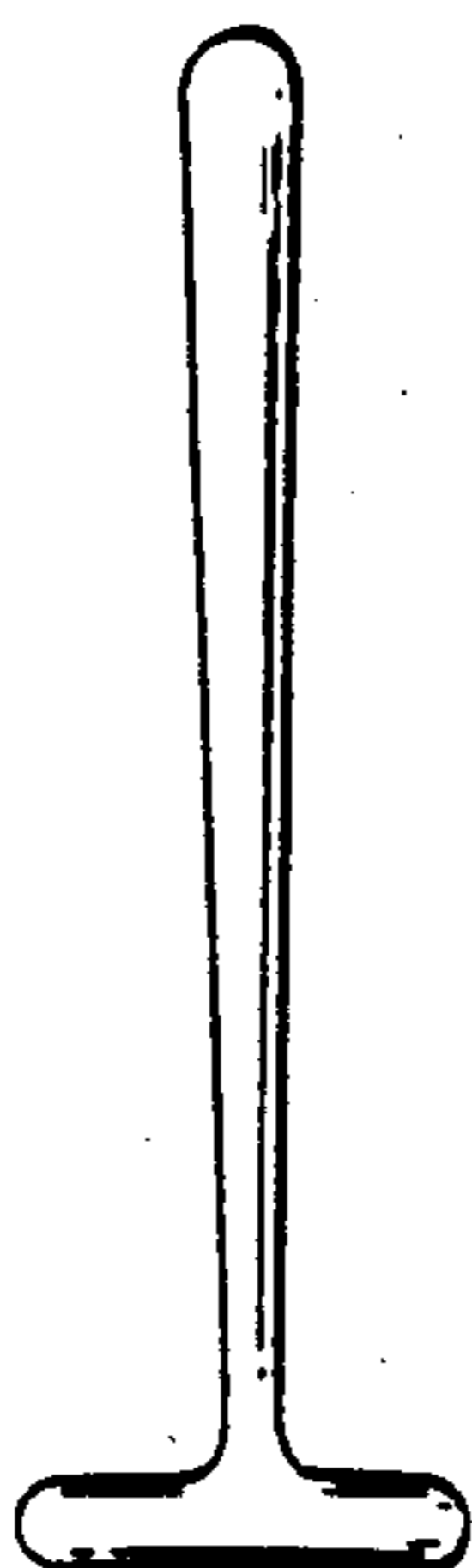
