DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and right front perspective view of a thermometer showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an exploded bottom and right front perspective view of the thermometer withdrawn from its lower casing.

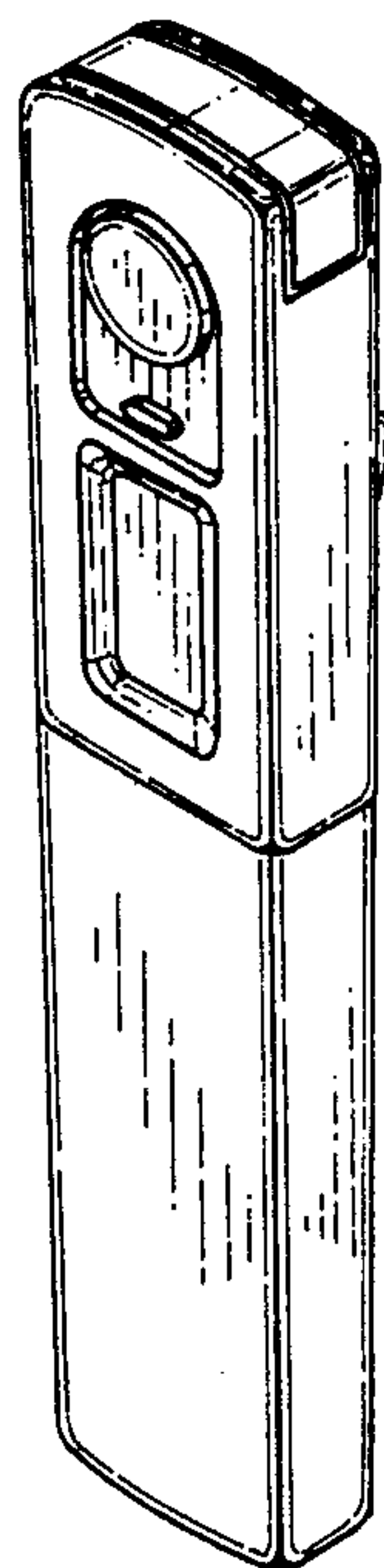

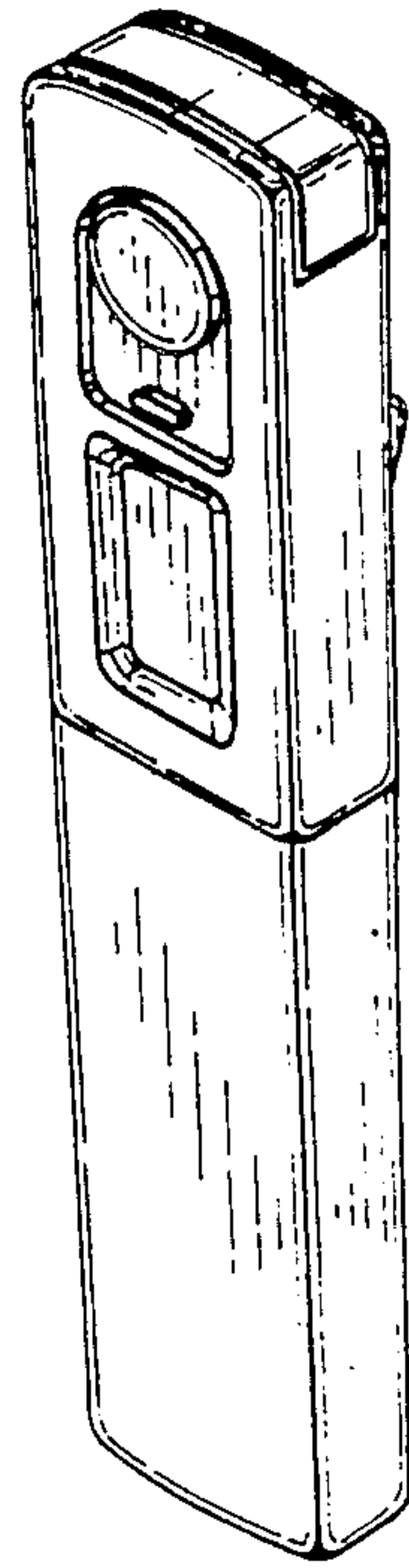

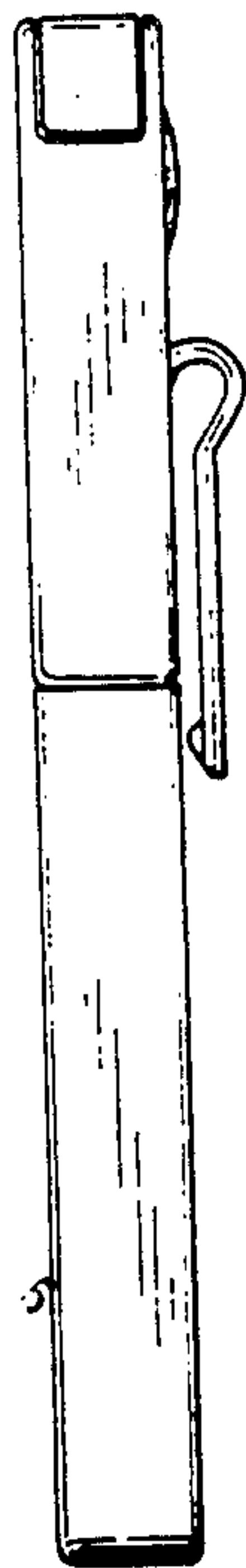

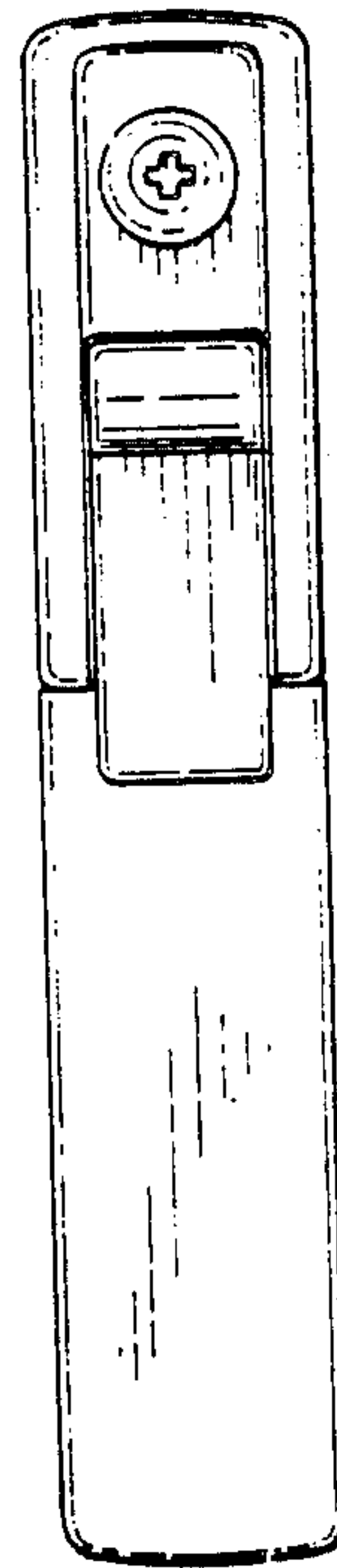
