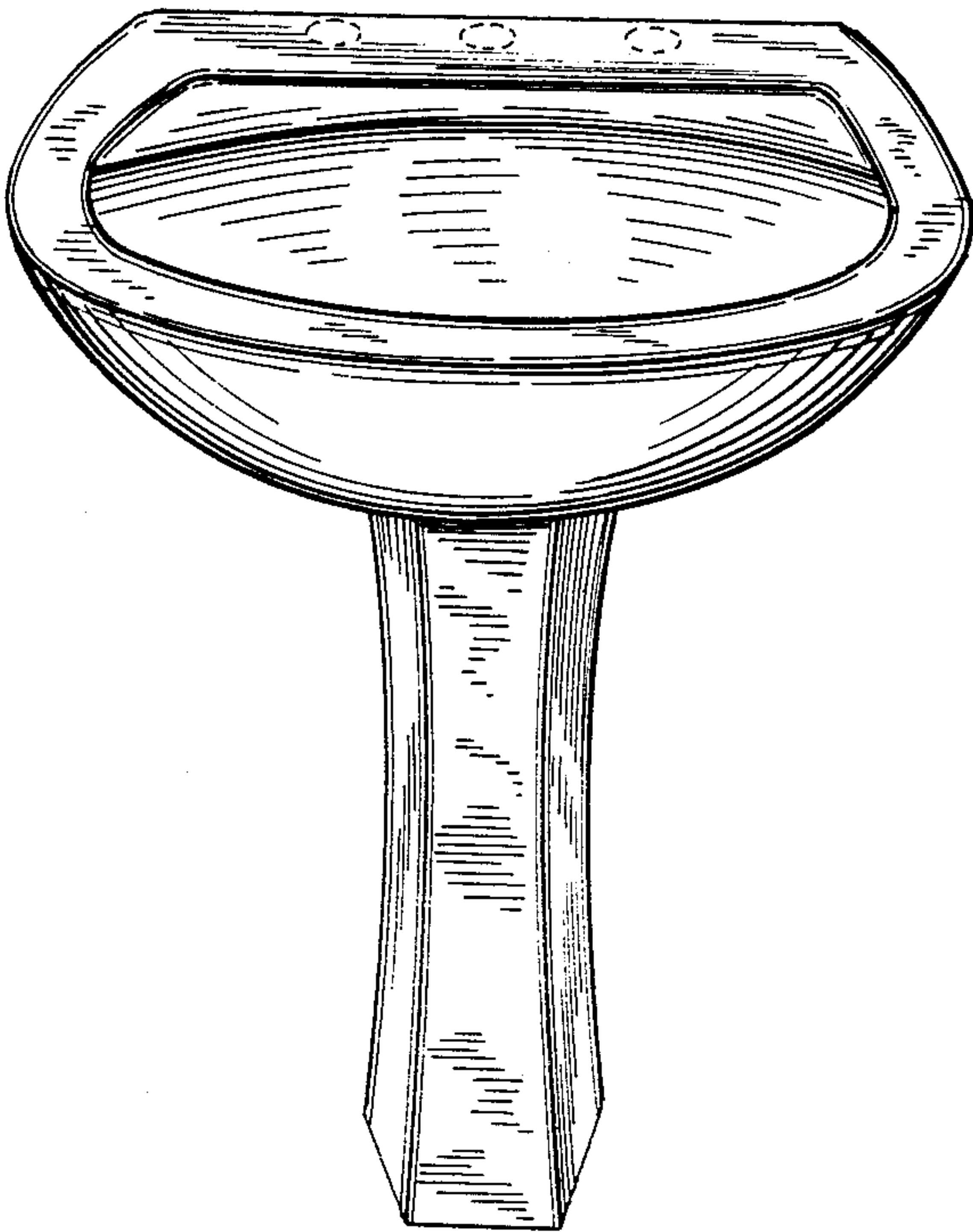

[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a pedestal lavatory, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a pedestal lavatory showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being the mirror image of the right side;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 5;
FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 5;
FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 4;
FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 10—10 of FIG. 5; and
FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 11—11 of FIG. 5.
The broken line representations of holes in FIGS. 1, 5, 6 and 9 are for purposes of illustration only.



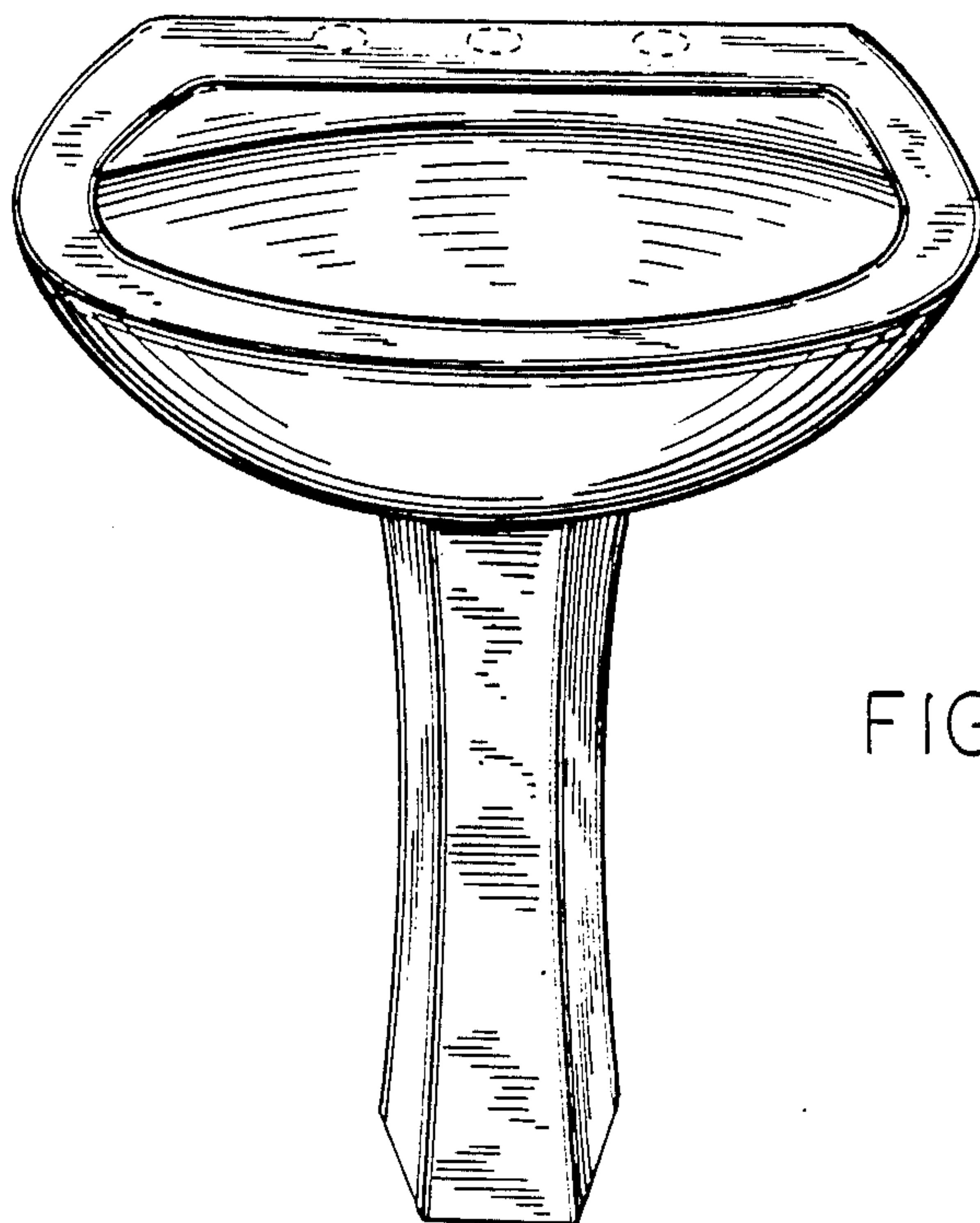

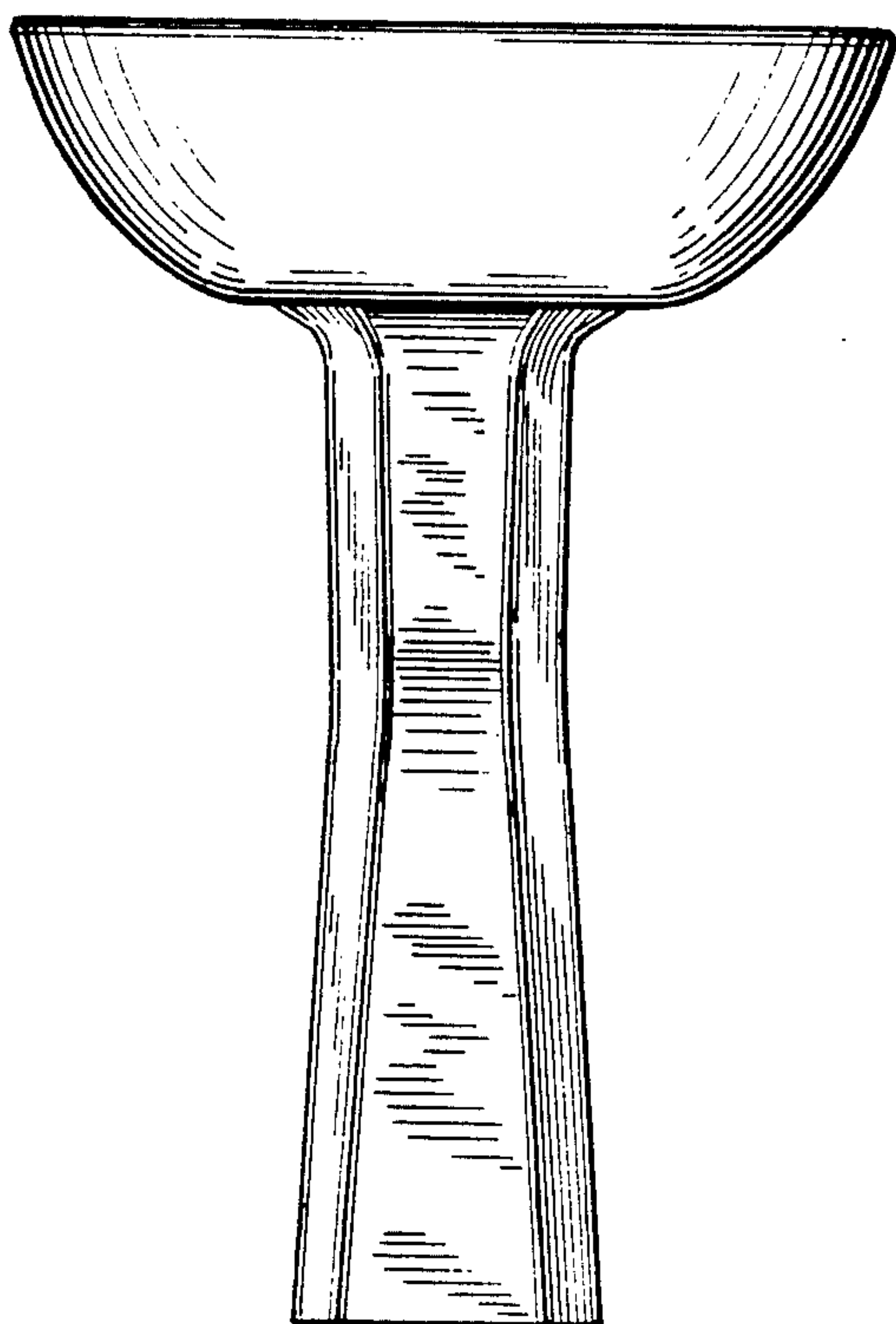
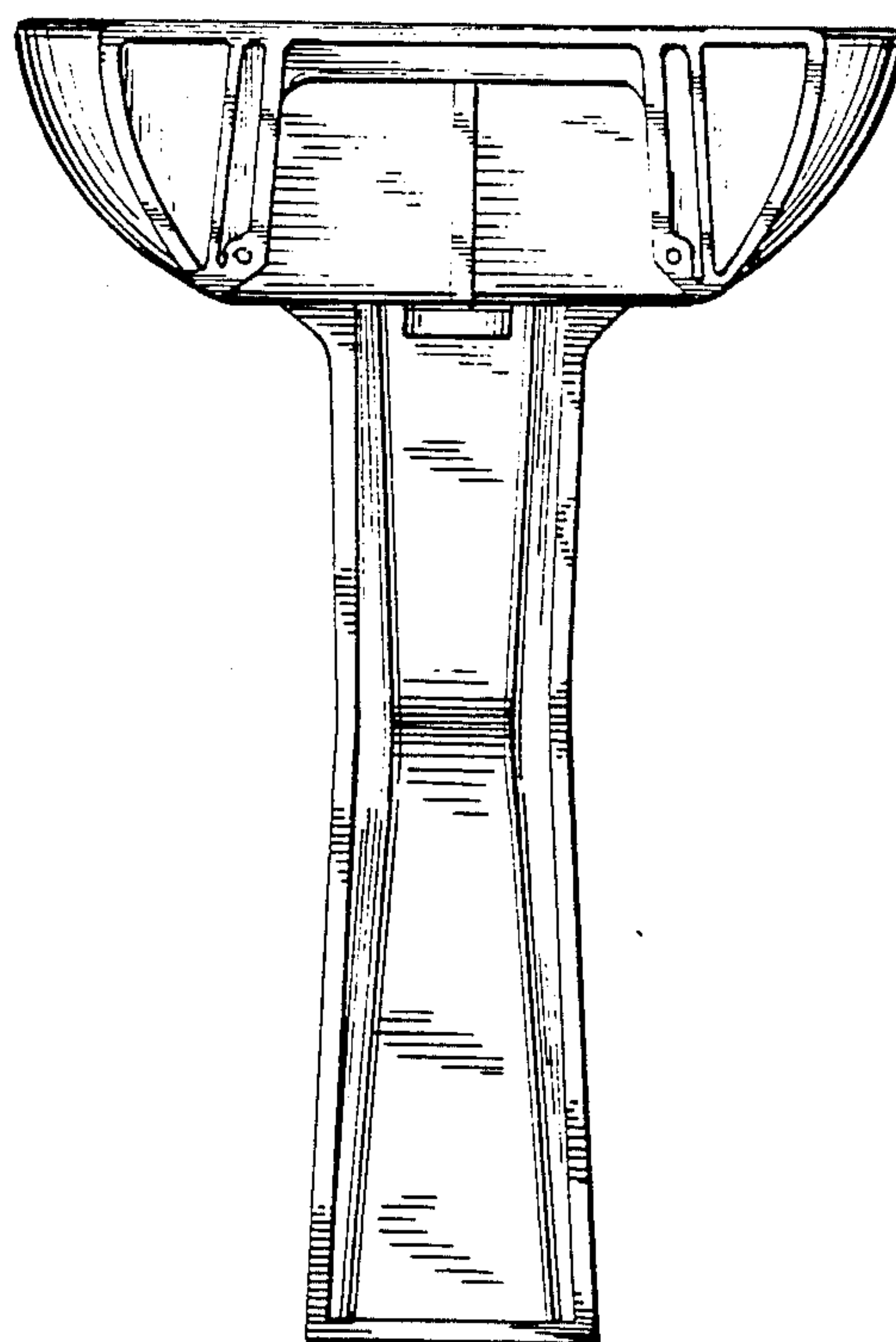

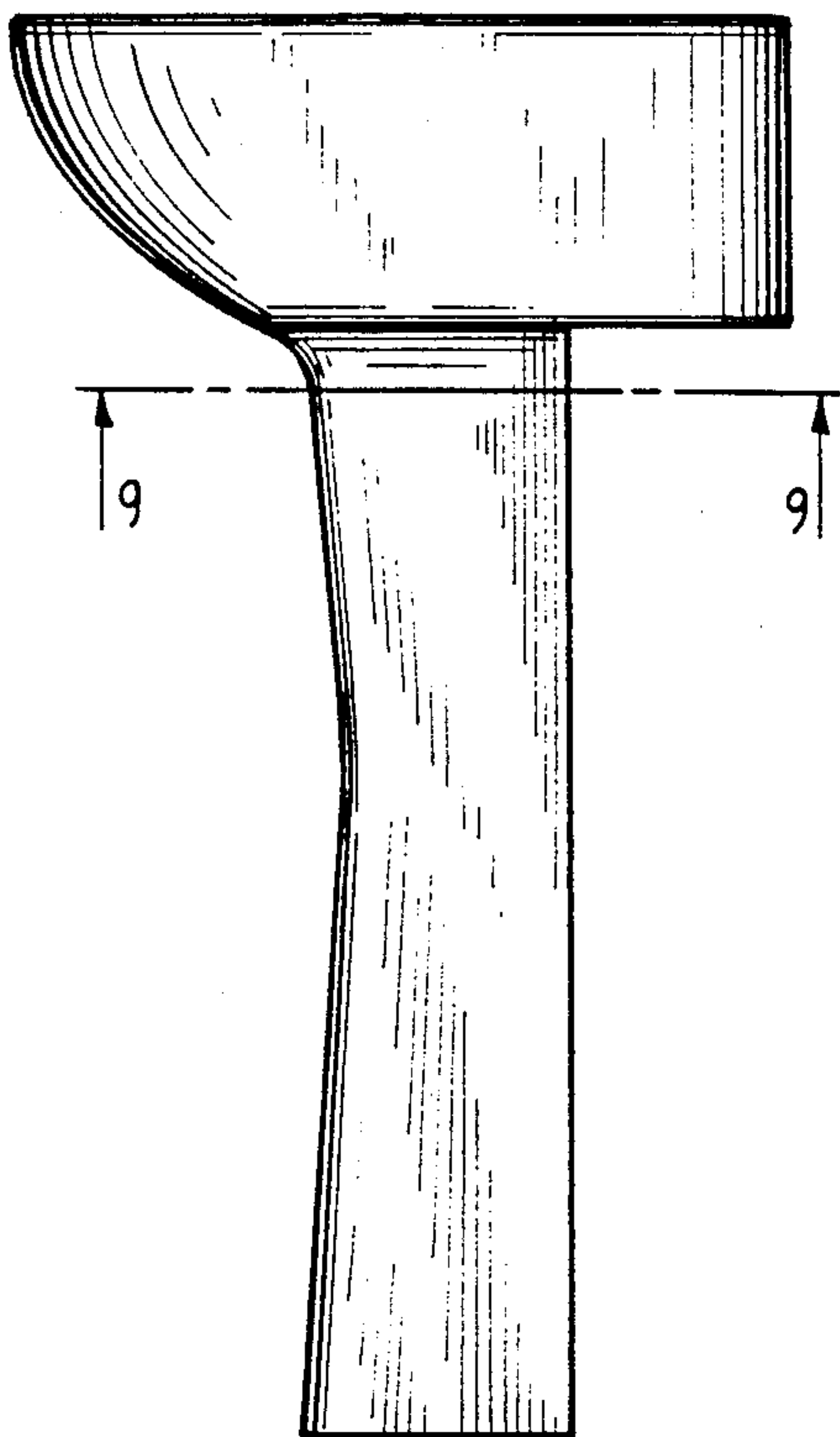

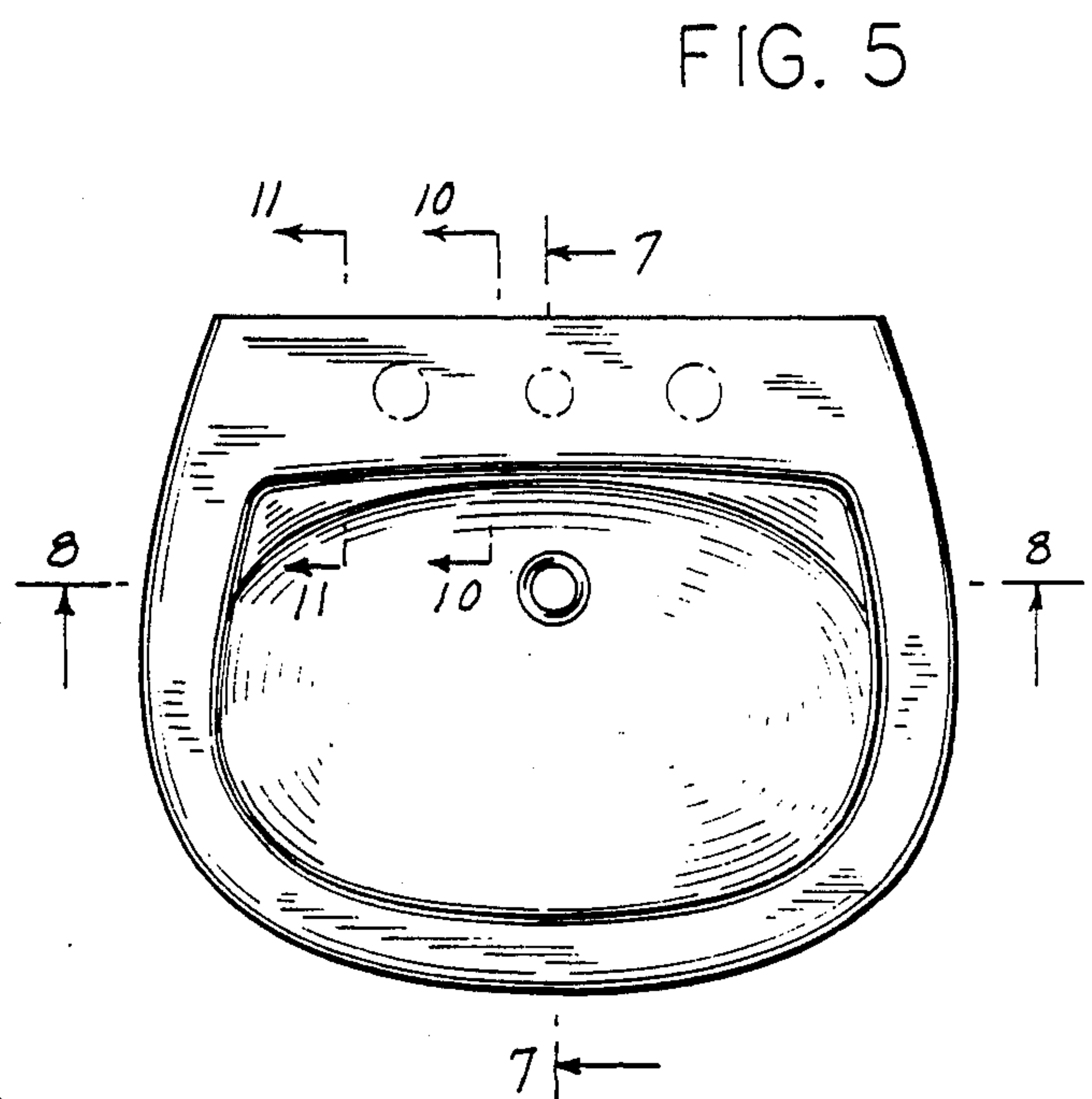

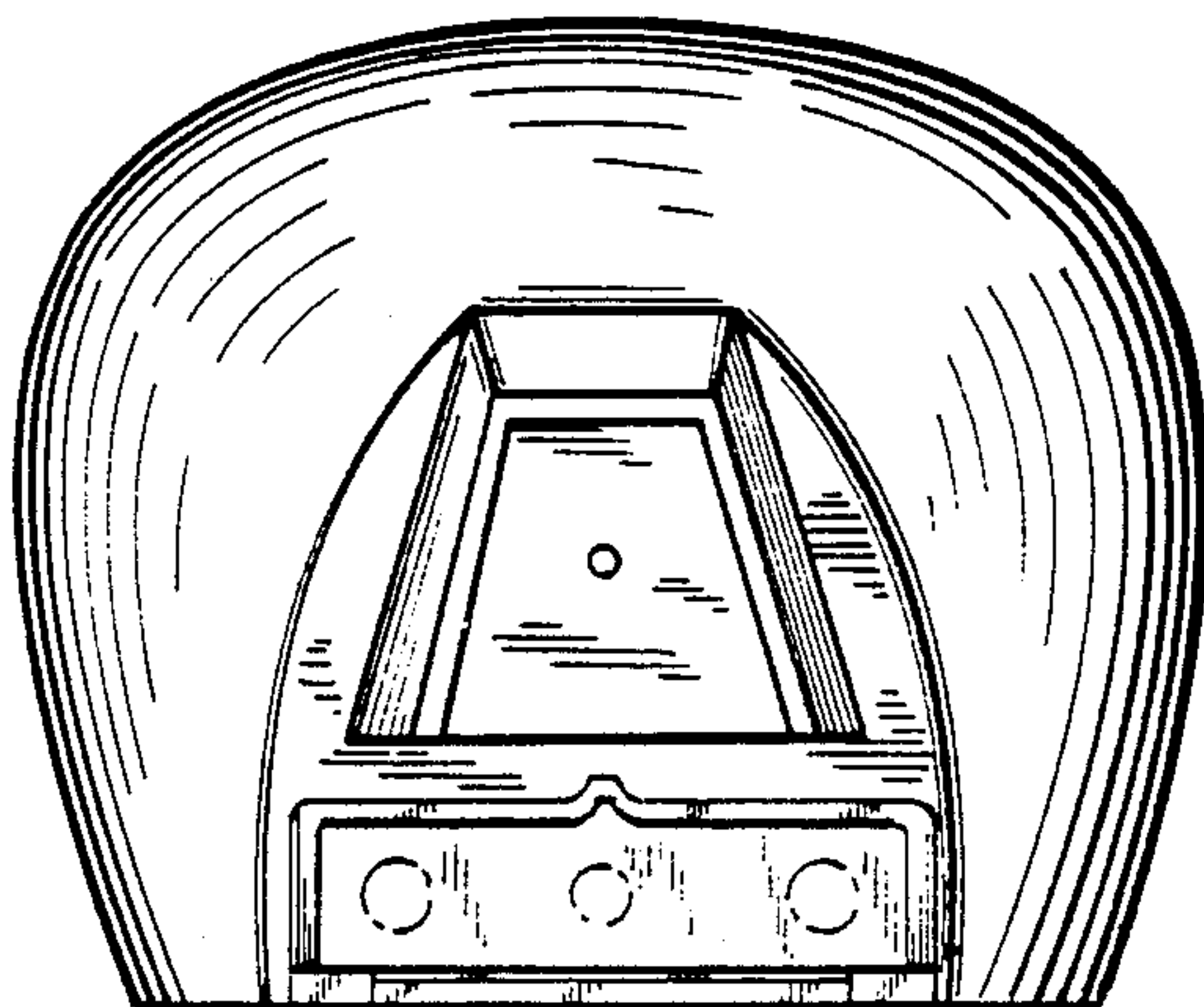

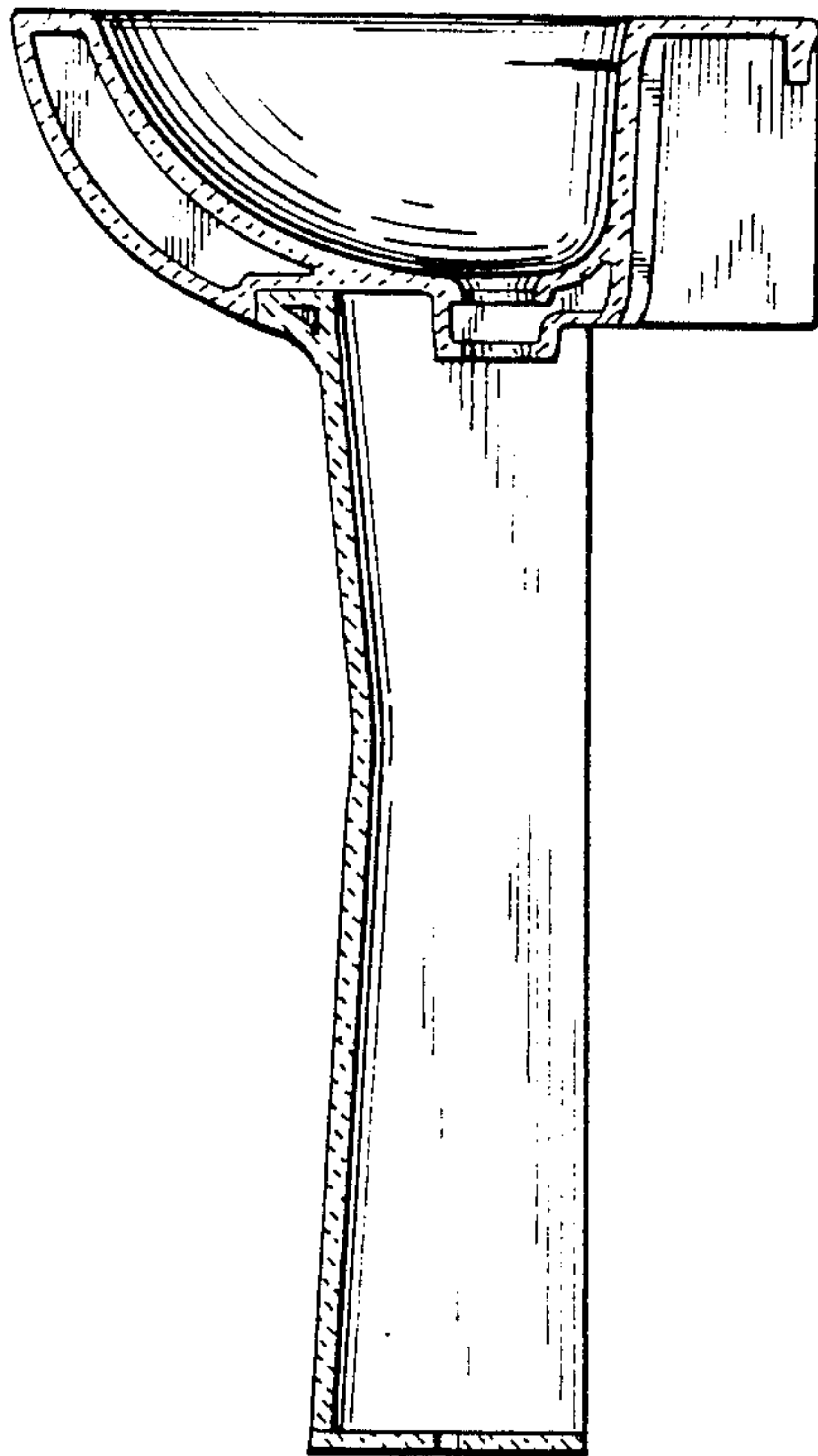

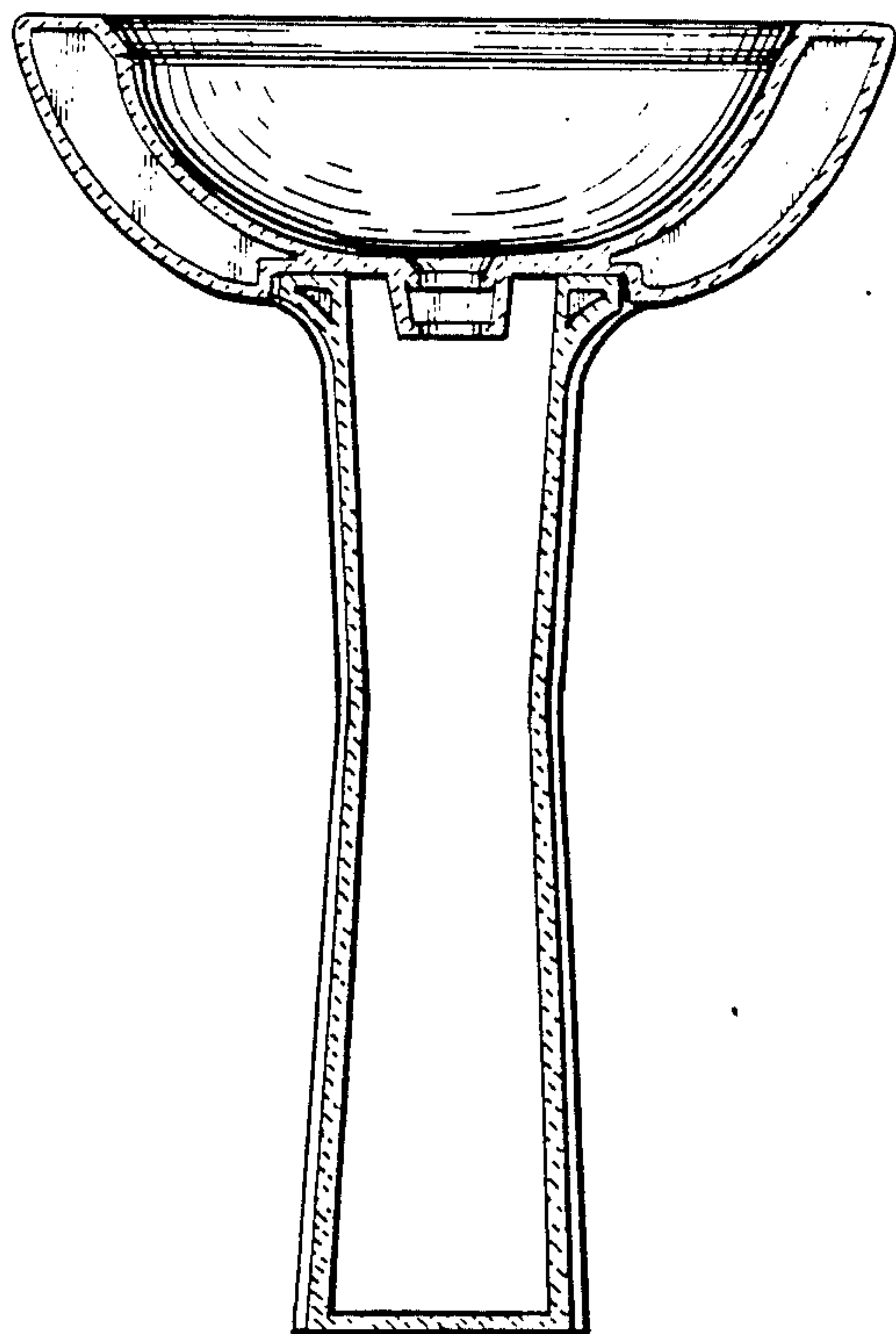

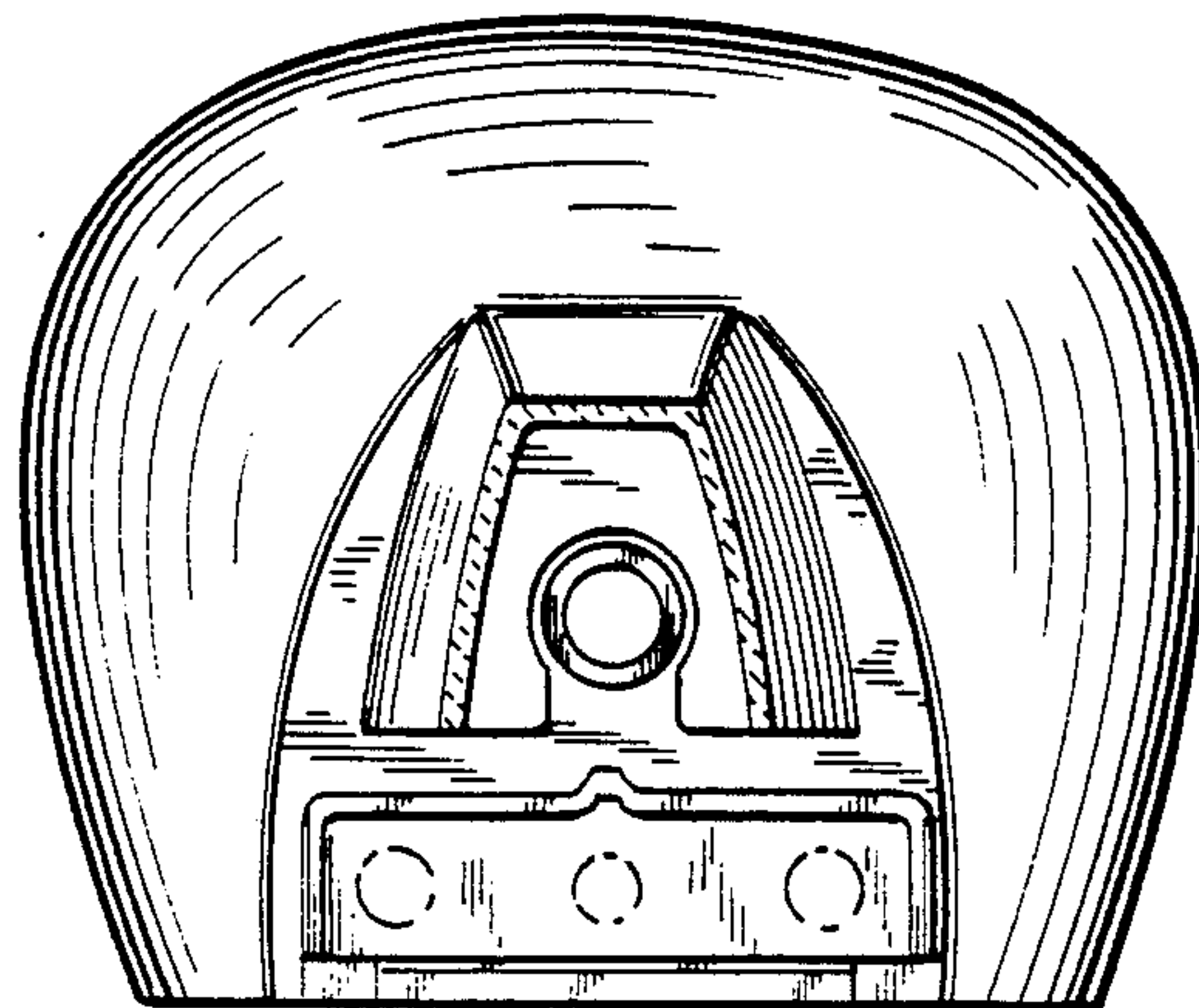

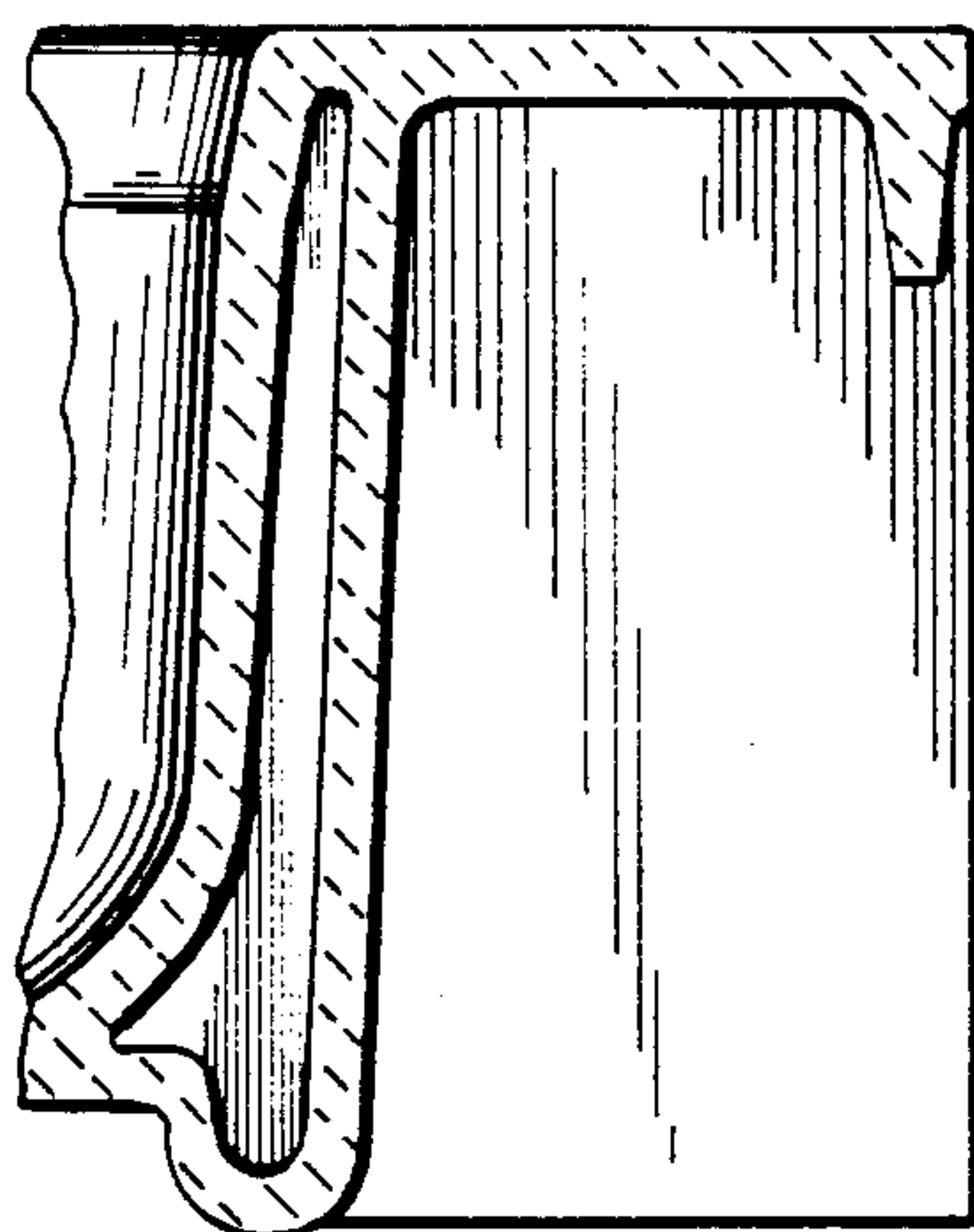

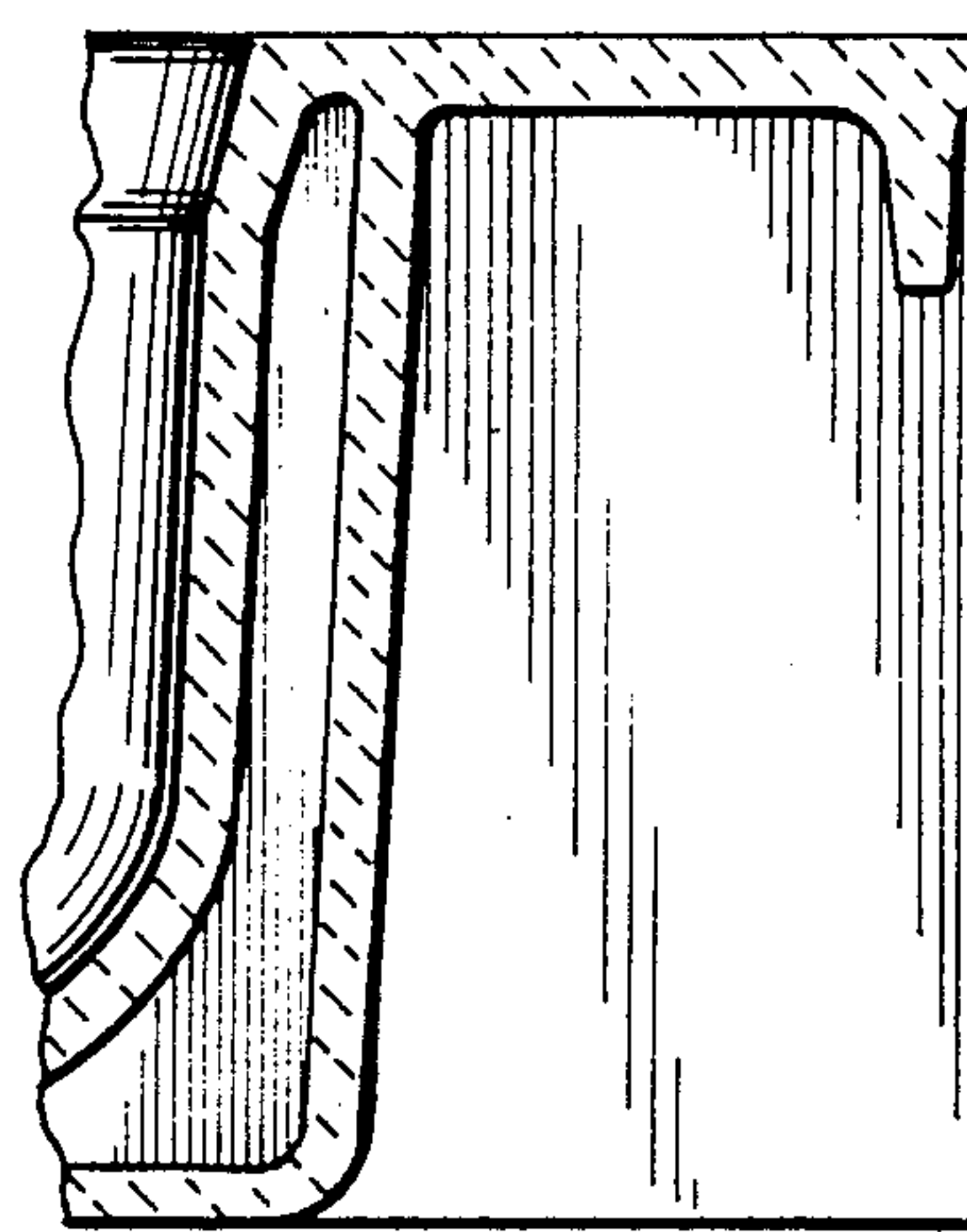
