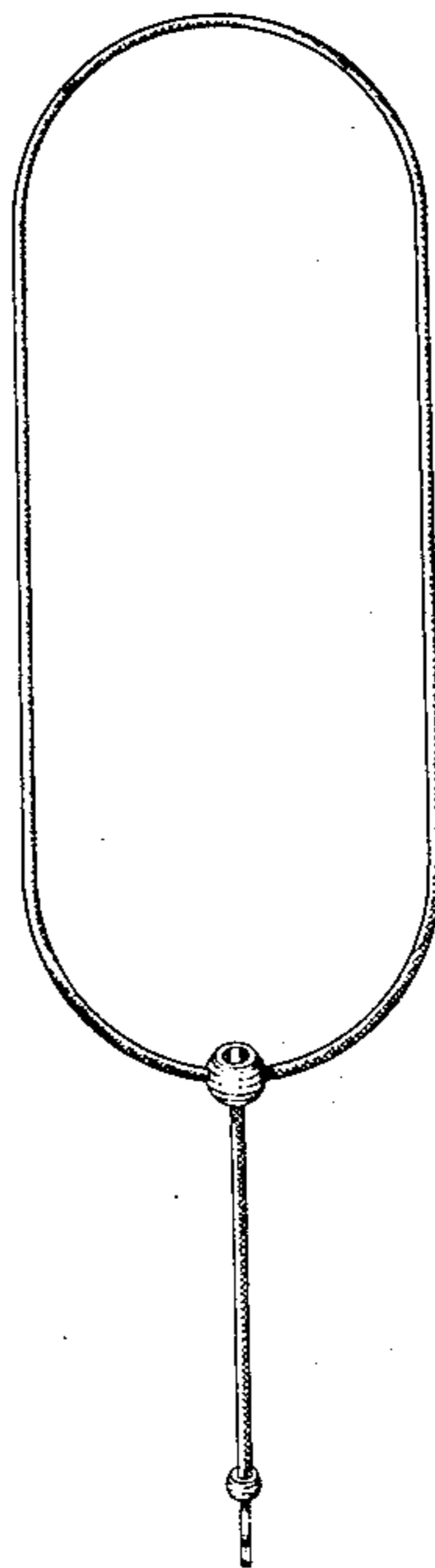

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a whistle lanyard for use by sports' official, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a whistle lanyard for use by sports' officials showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged side elevational view, the cord broken away for convenience of illustration; FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view, the cord broken away for convenience of illustration; and FIG. 4 is an enlarged rear elevational view, the cord broken away for convenience of illustration.



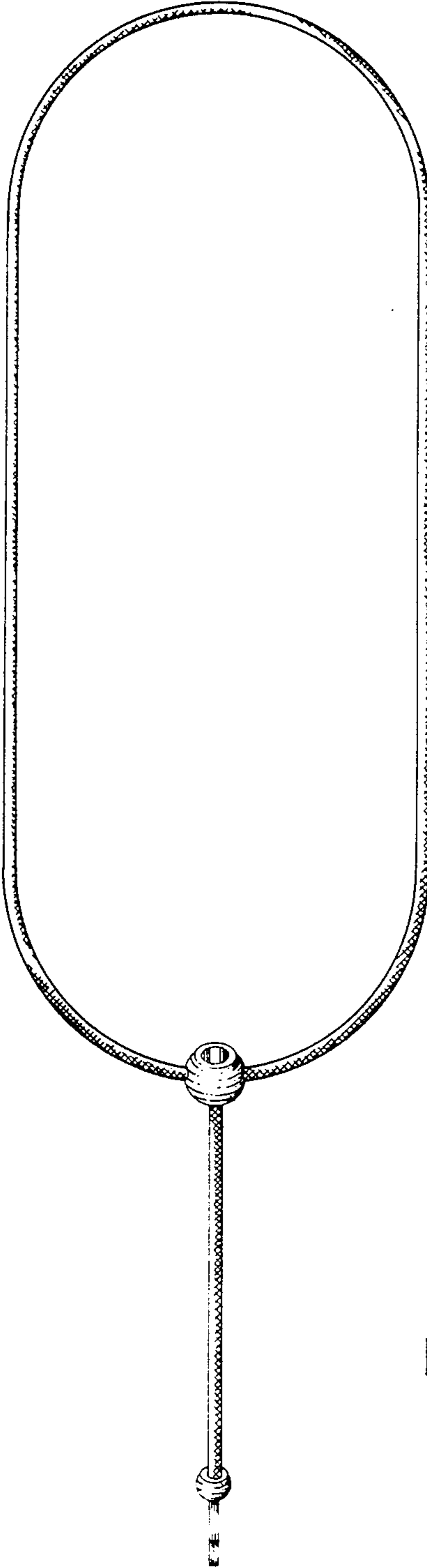

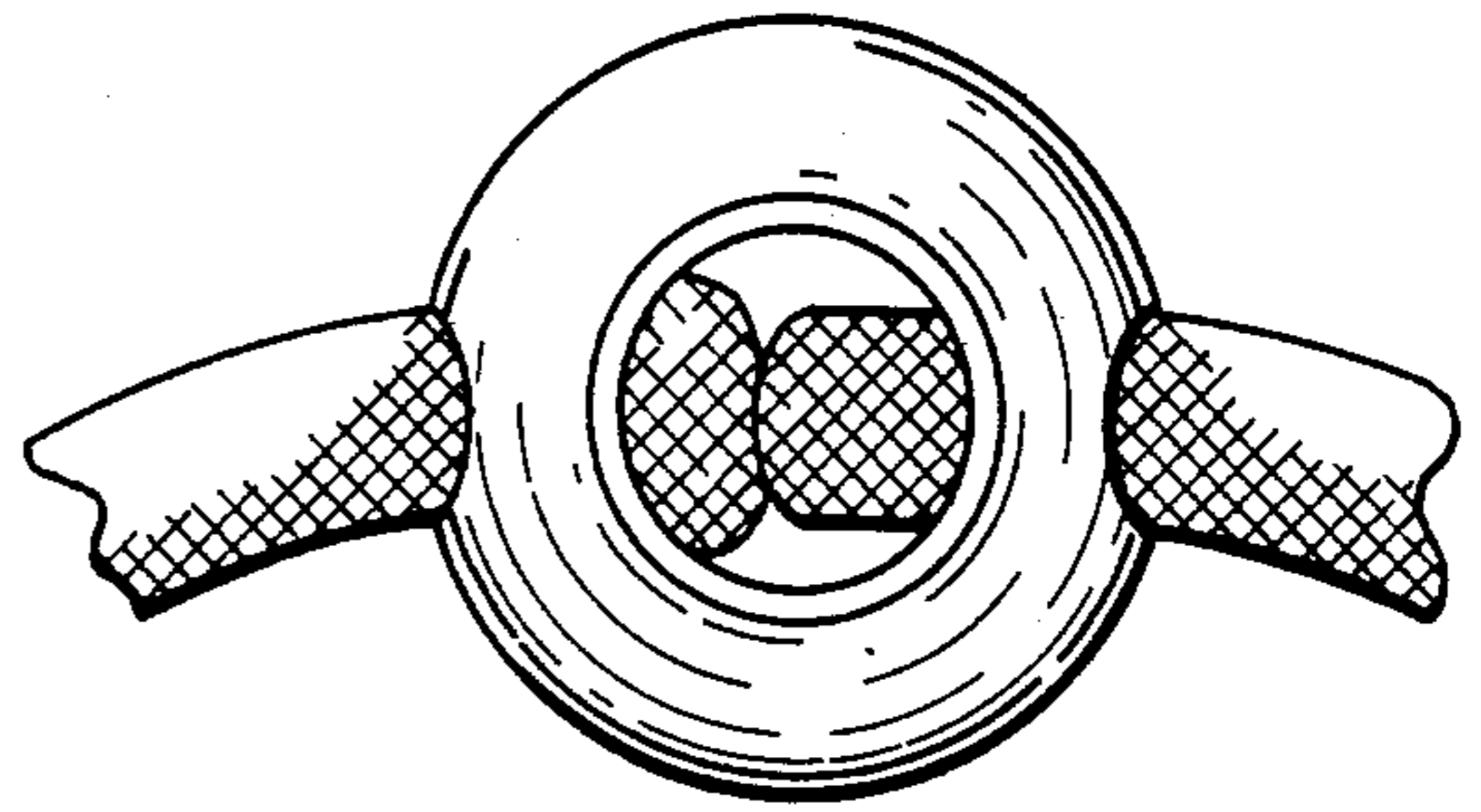

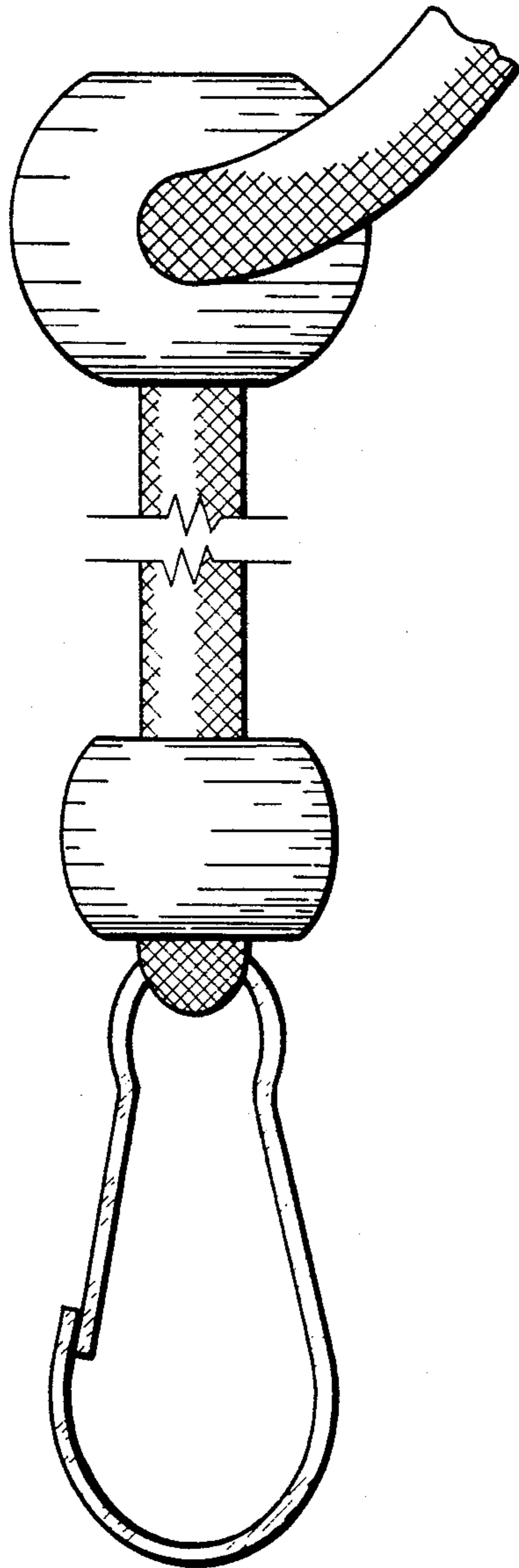

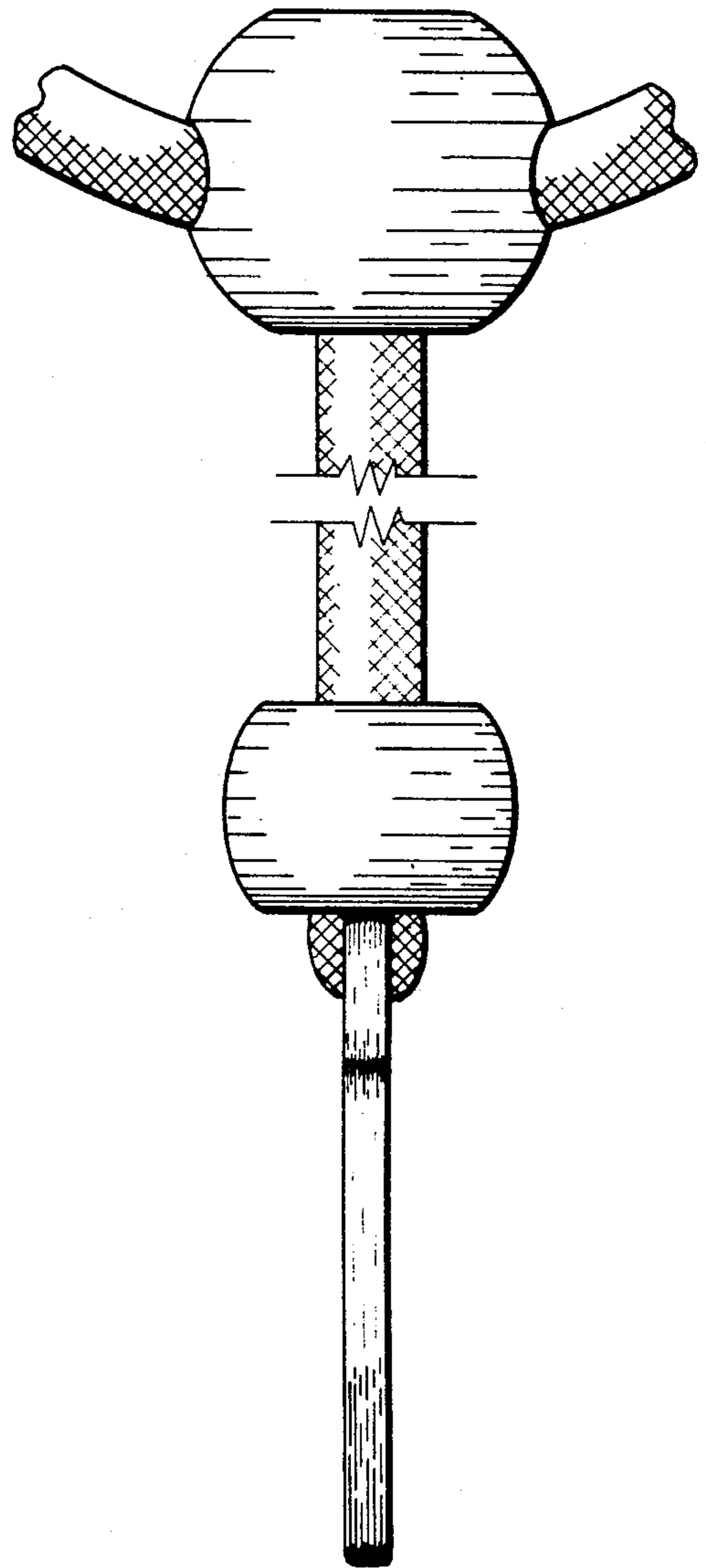
