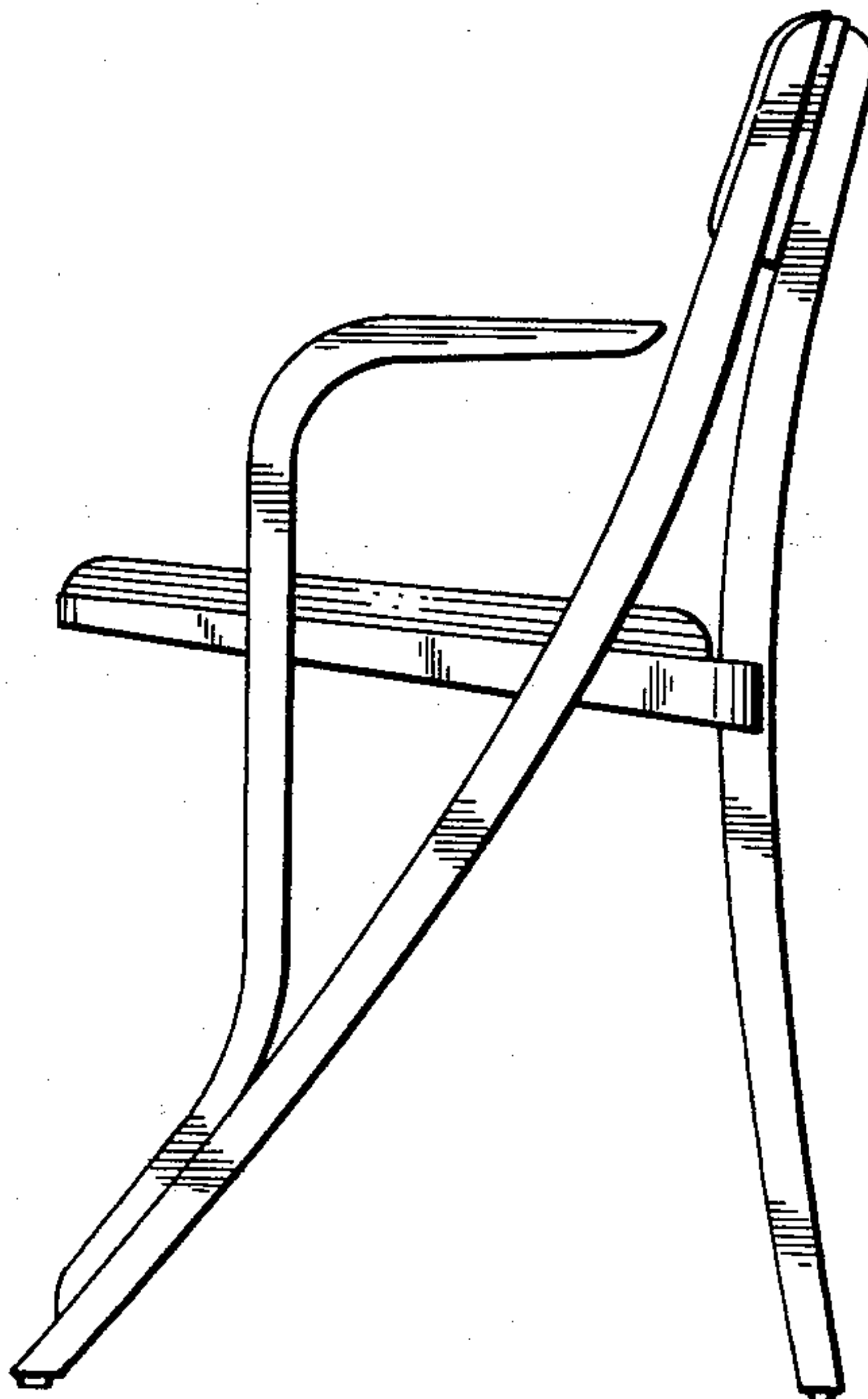

The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a chair showing a second embodiment of my design;
 FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a chair showing a third embodiment of my design;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof.
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a chair showing a fourth embodiment of my design;
 FIG. 9 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of a chair showing a fifth embodiment of my new design; and
 FIG. 11 is a side elevational view thereof.
 The sides of the chair embodiments not shown are mirror images of the respective sides shown while the undisclosed rear surfaces thereof are conventionally plain.



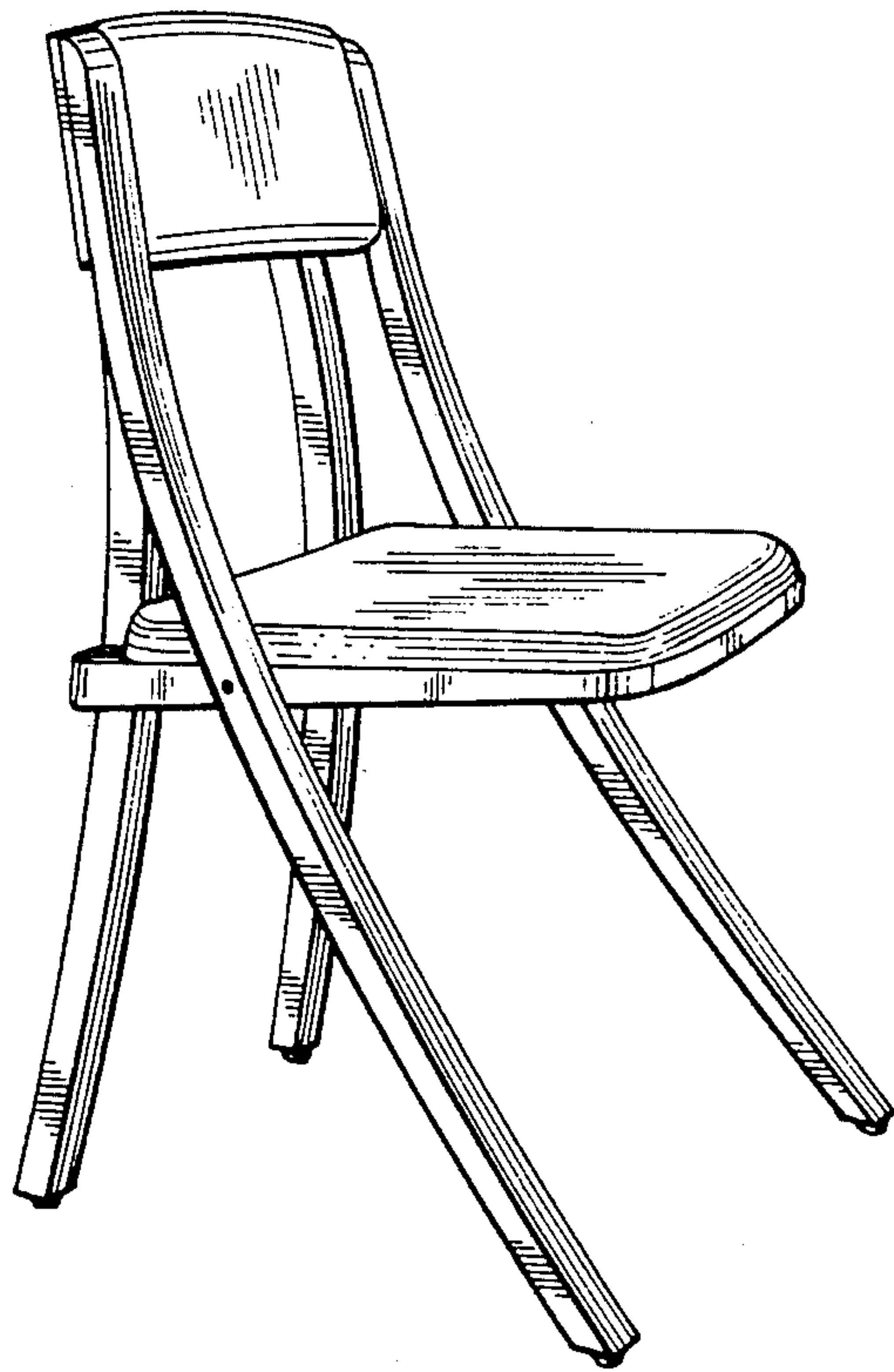

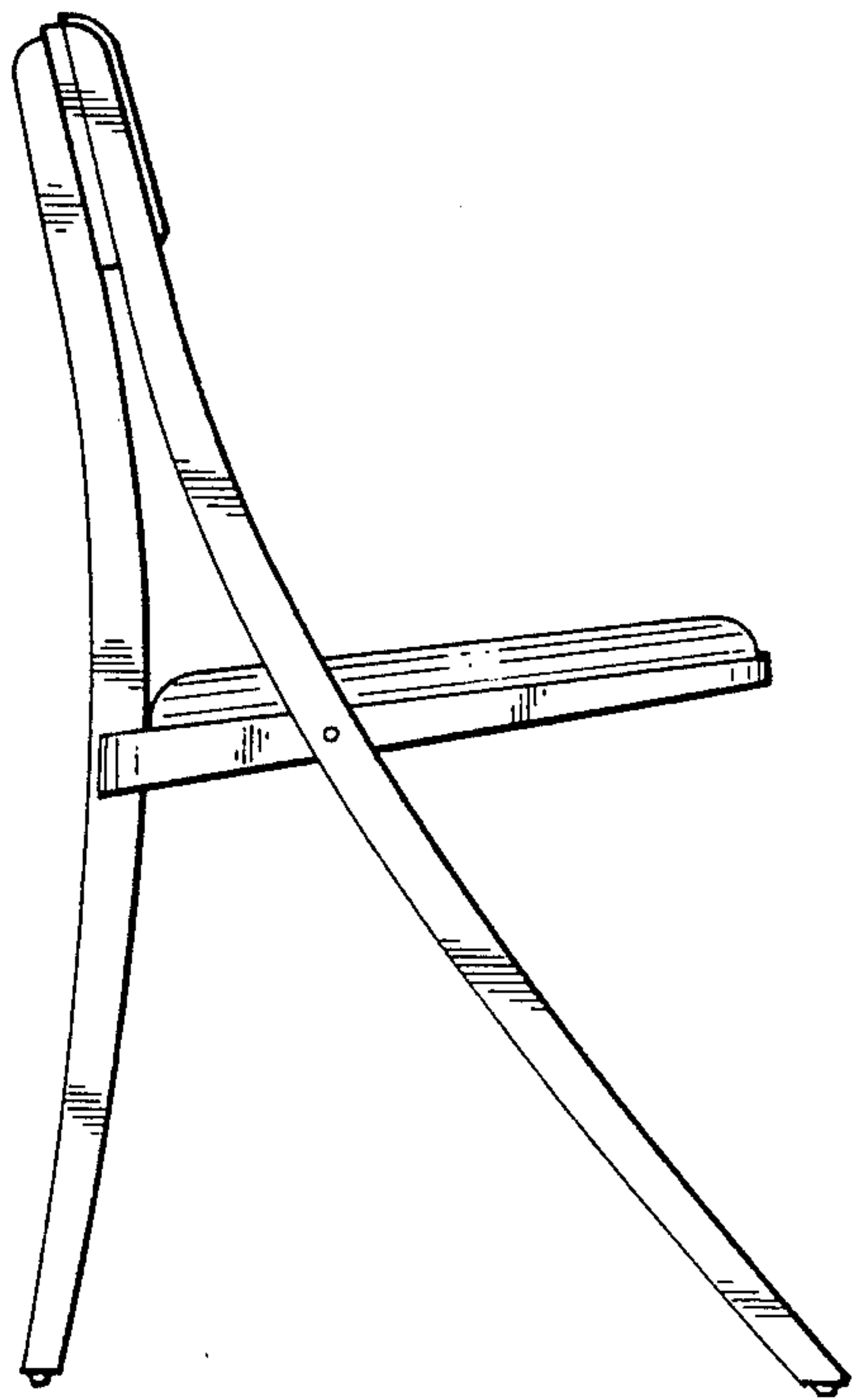

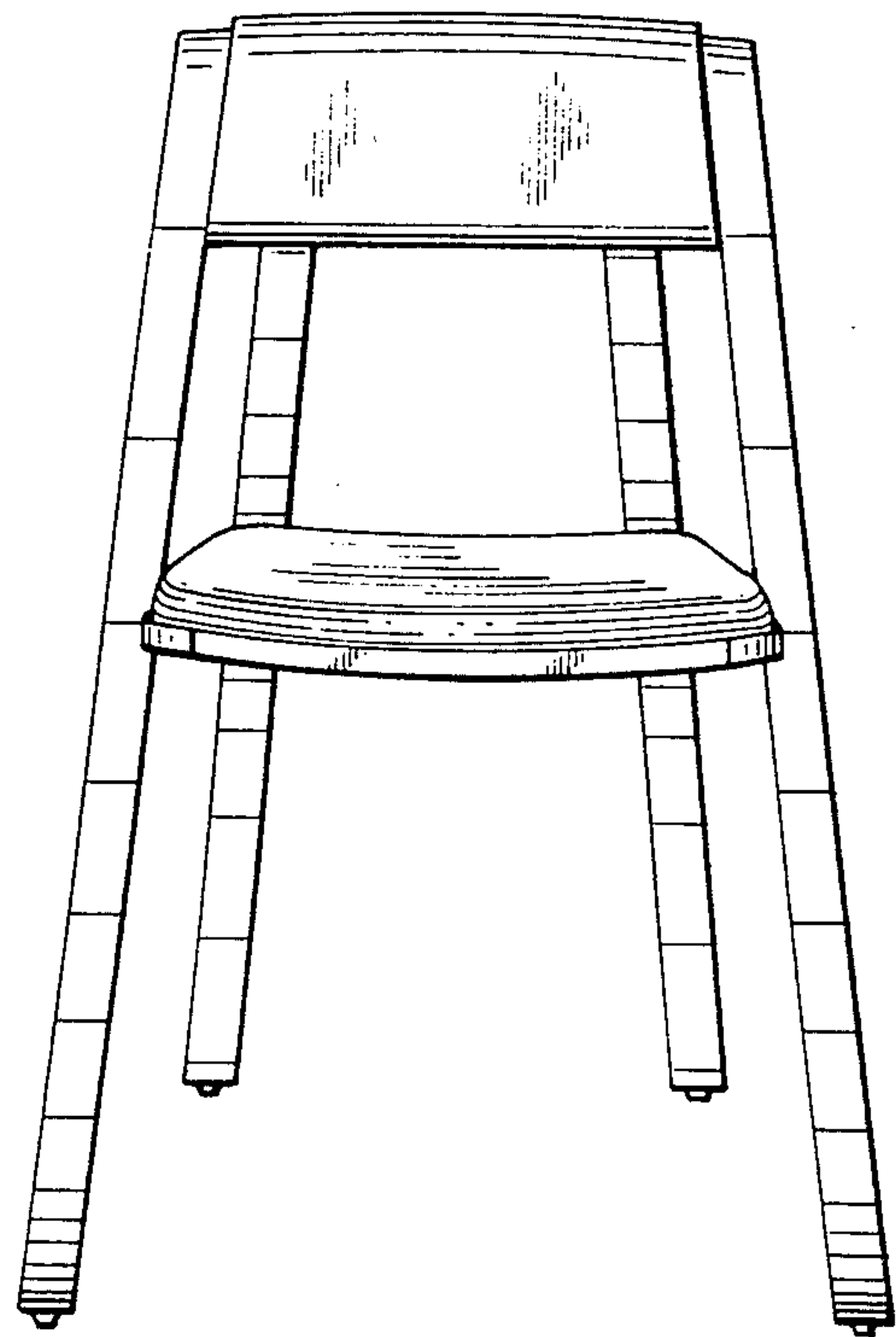

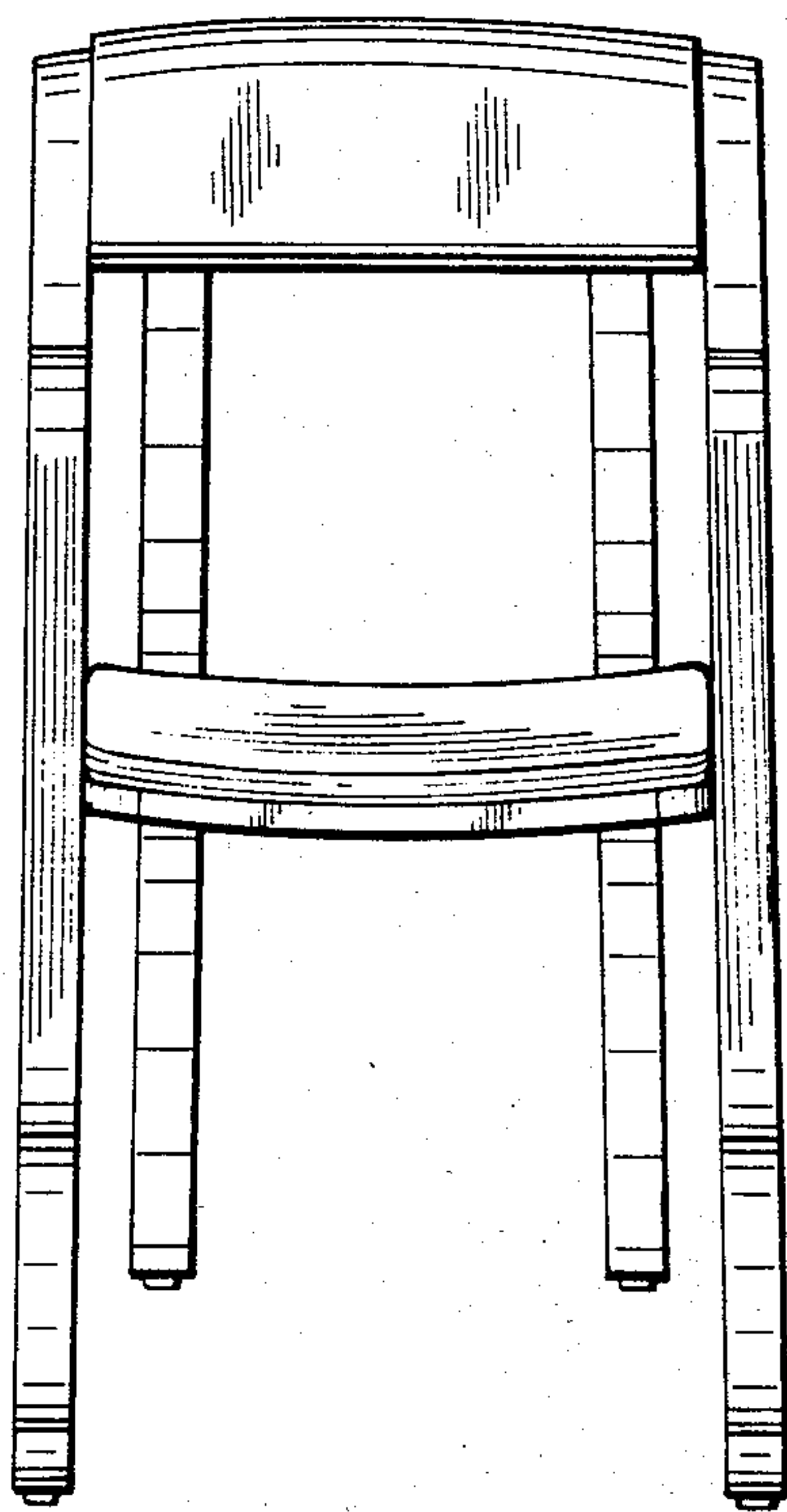

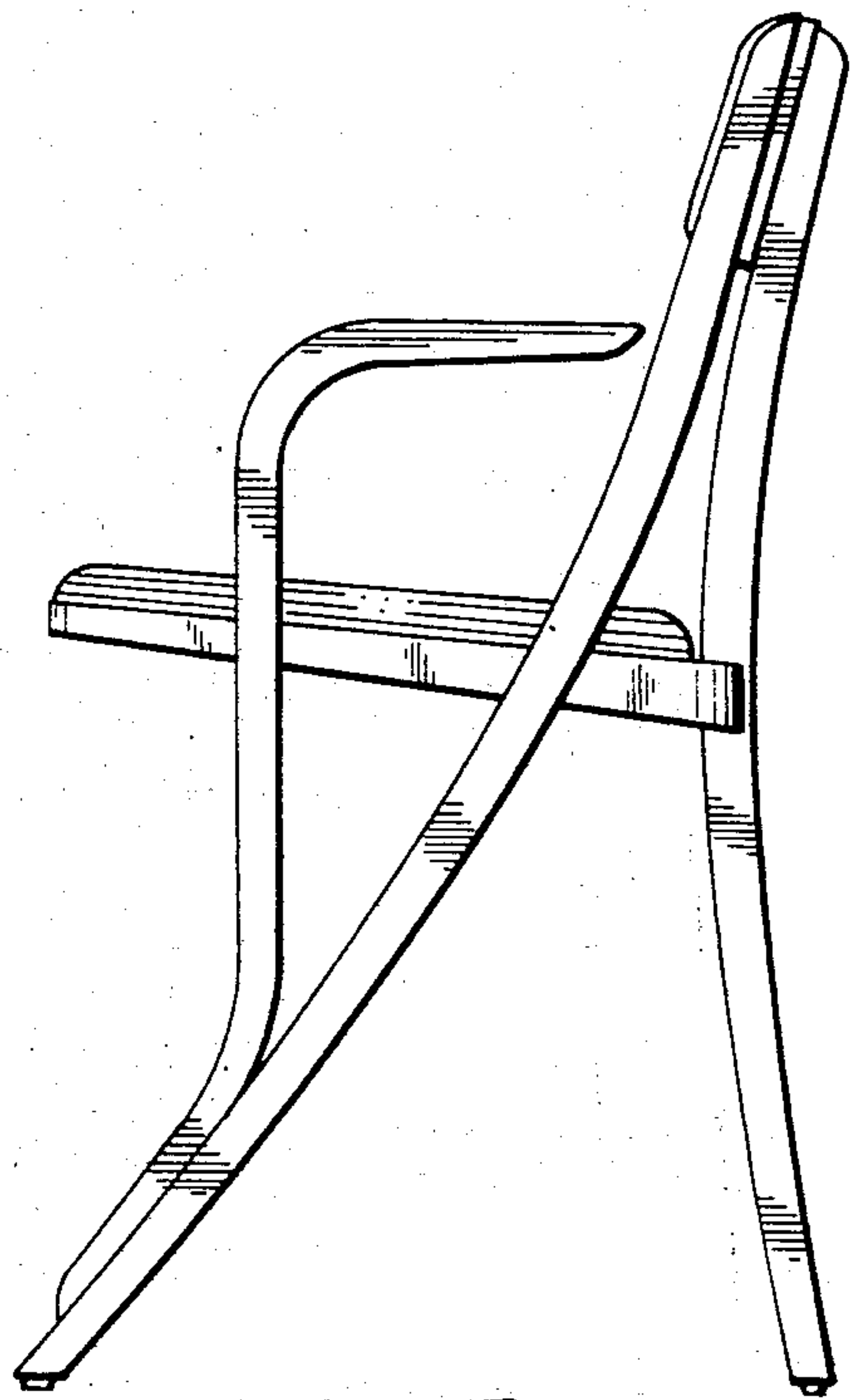

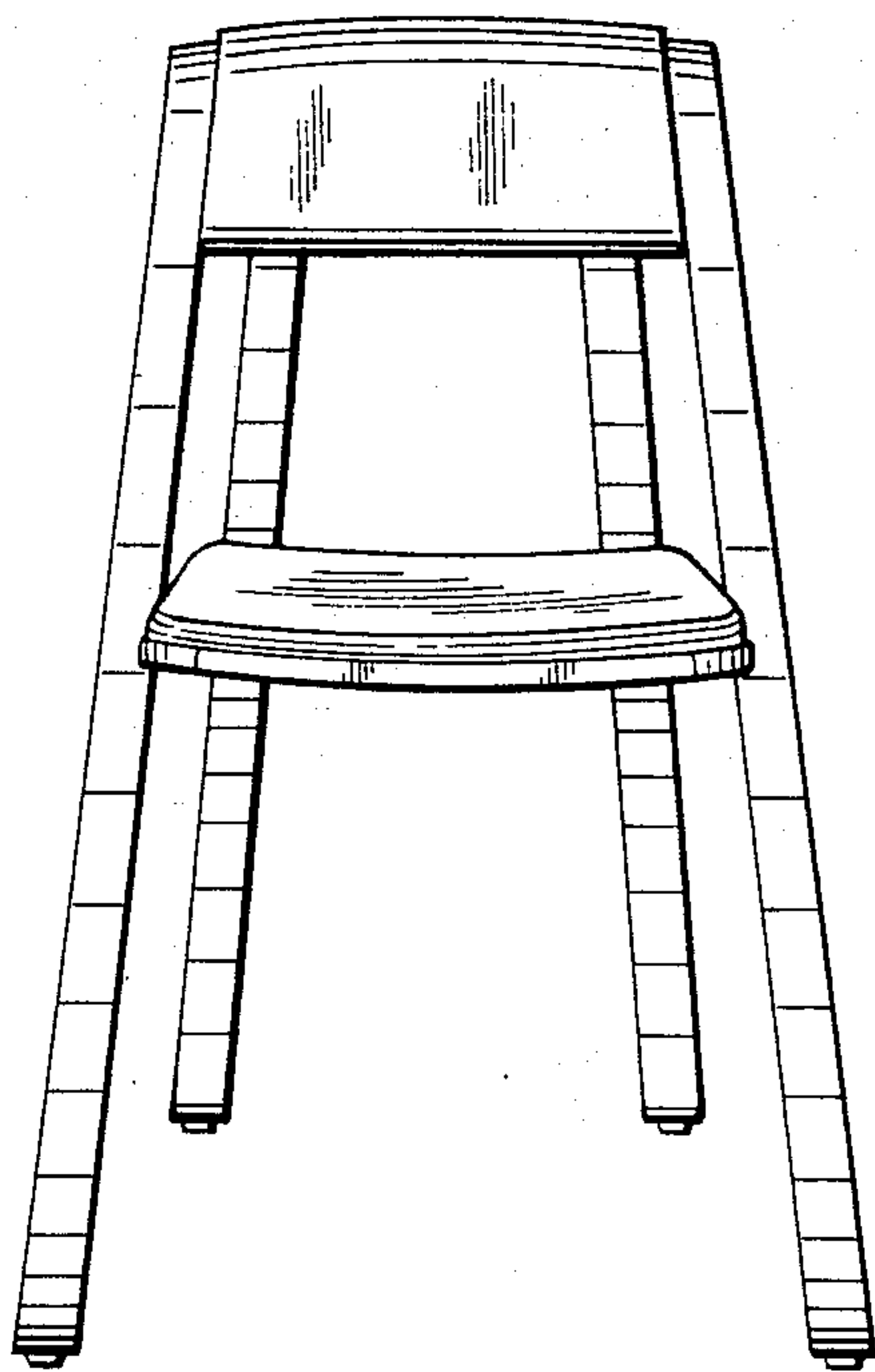

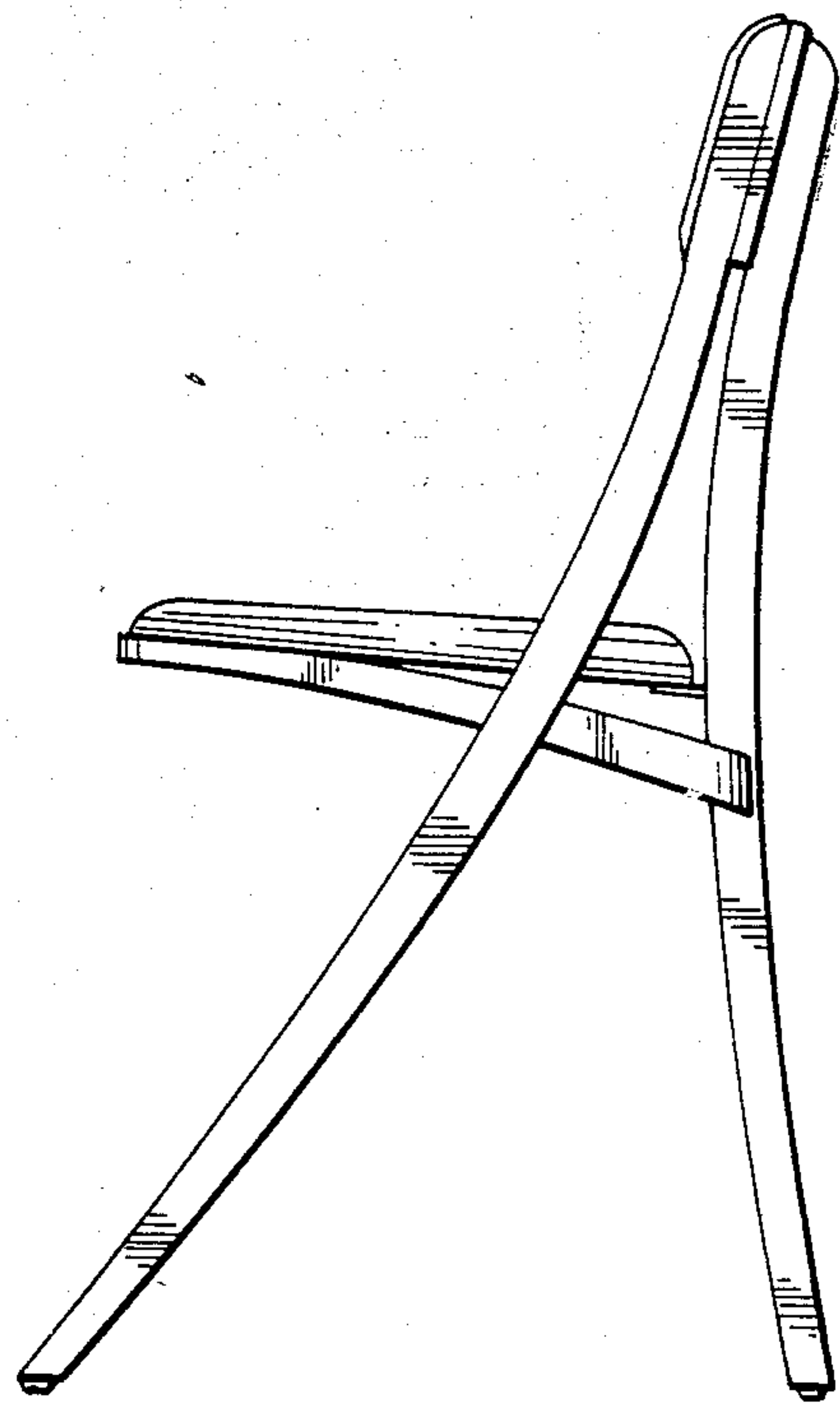

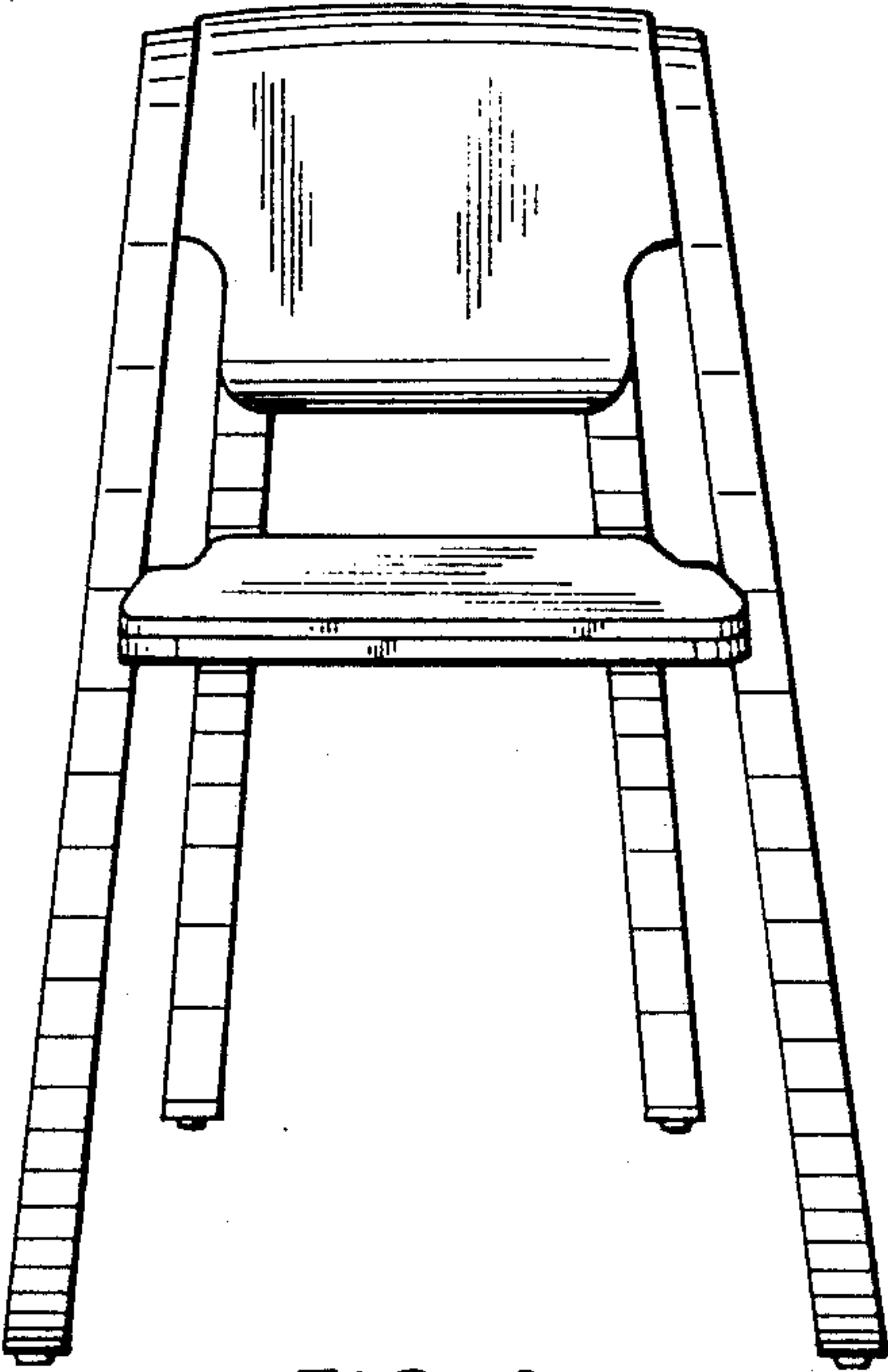

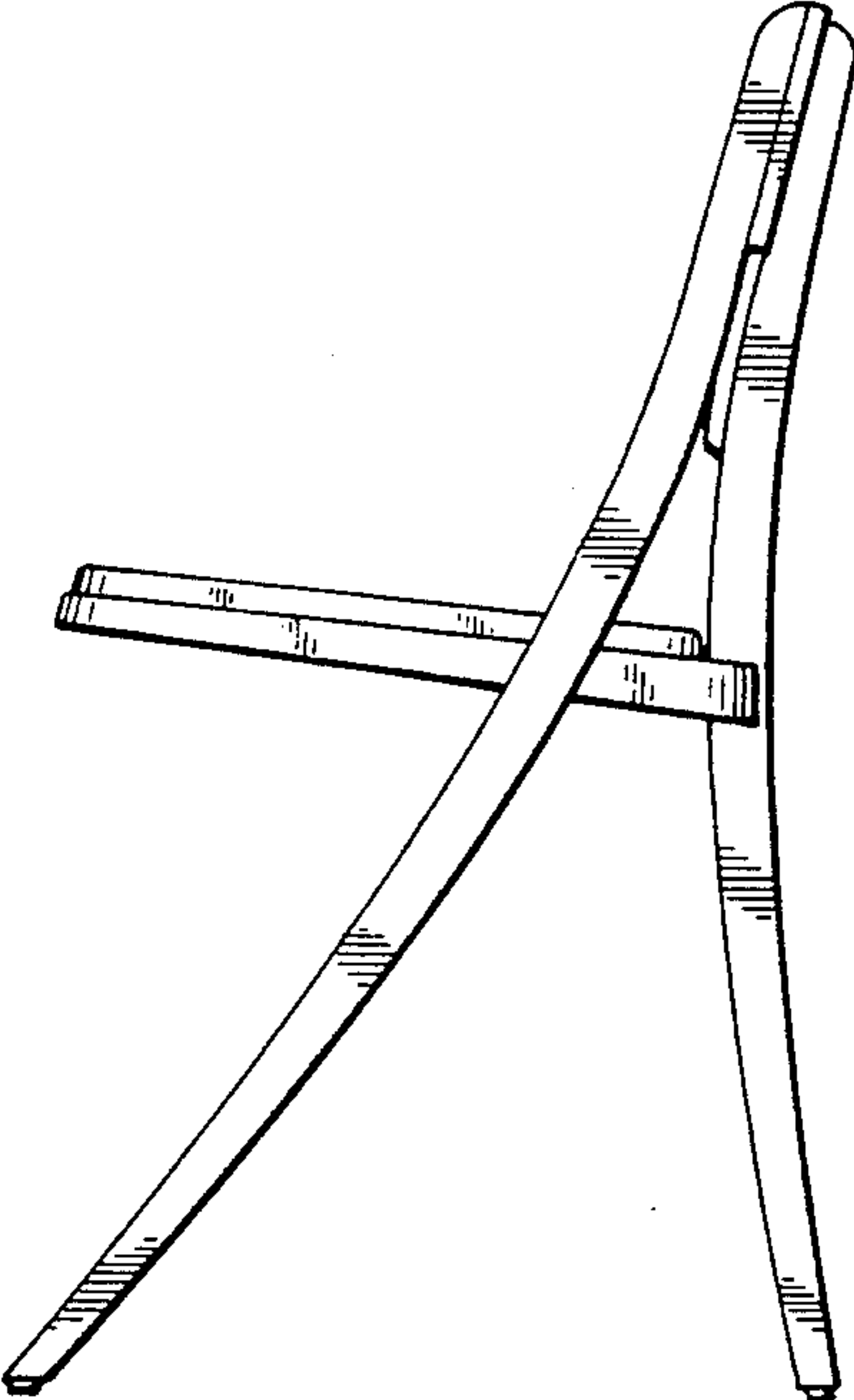

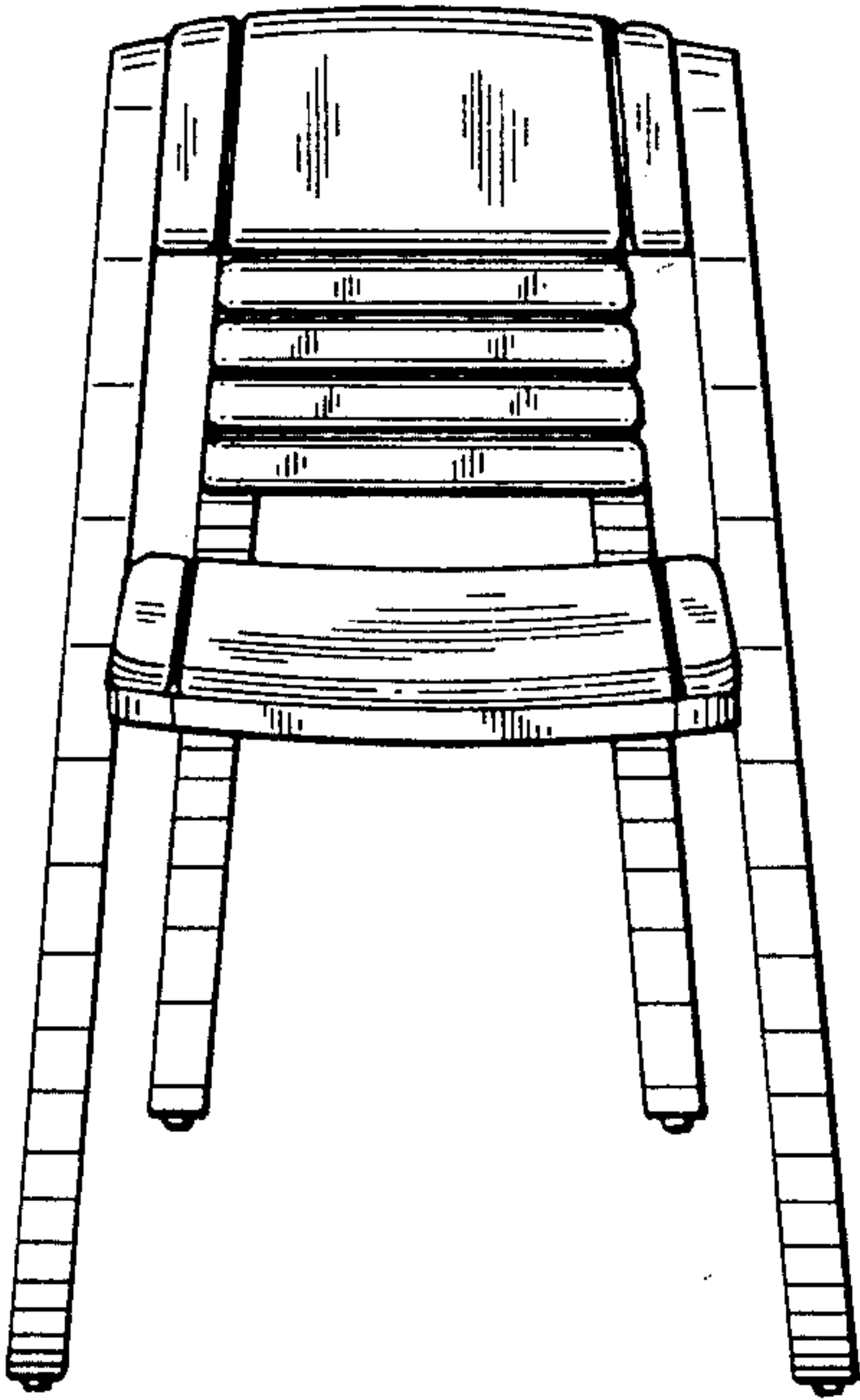

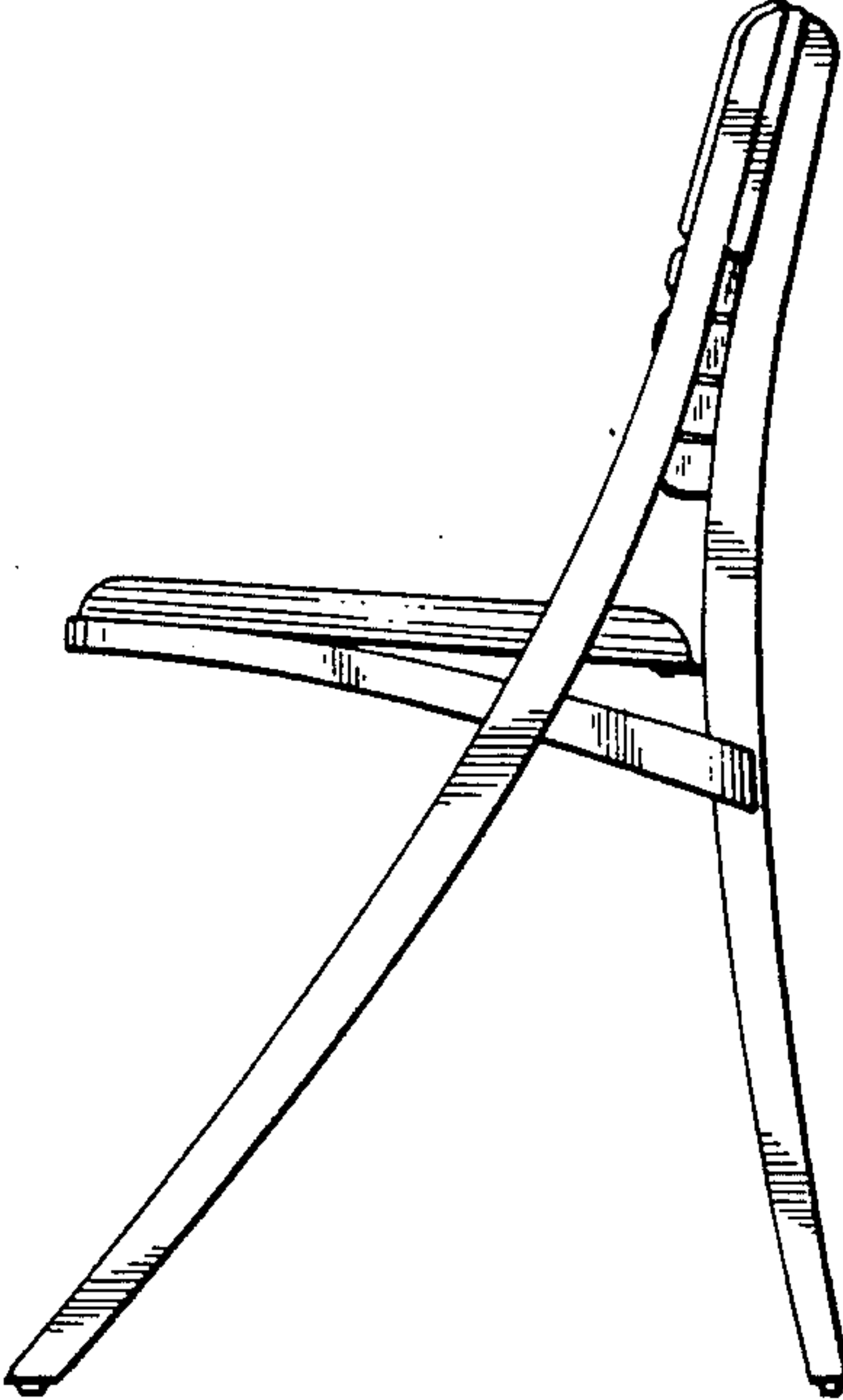
