DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of an oriental chest showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view as seen on display, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

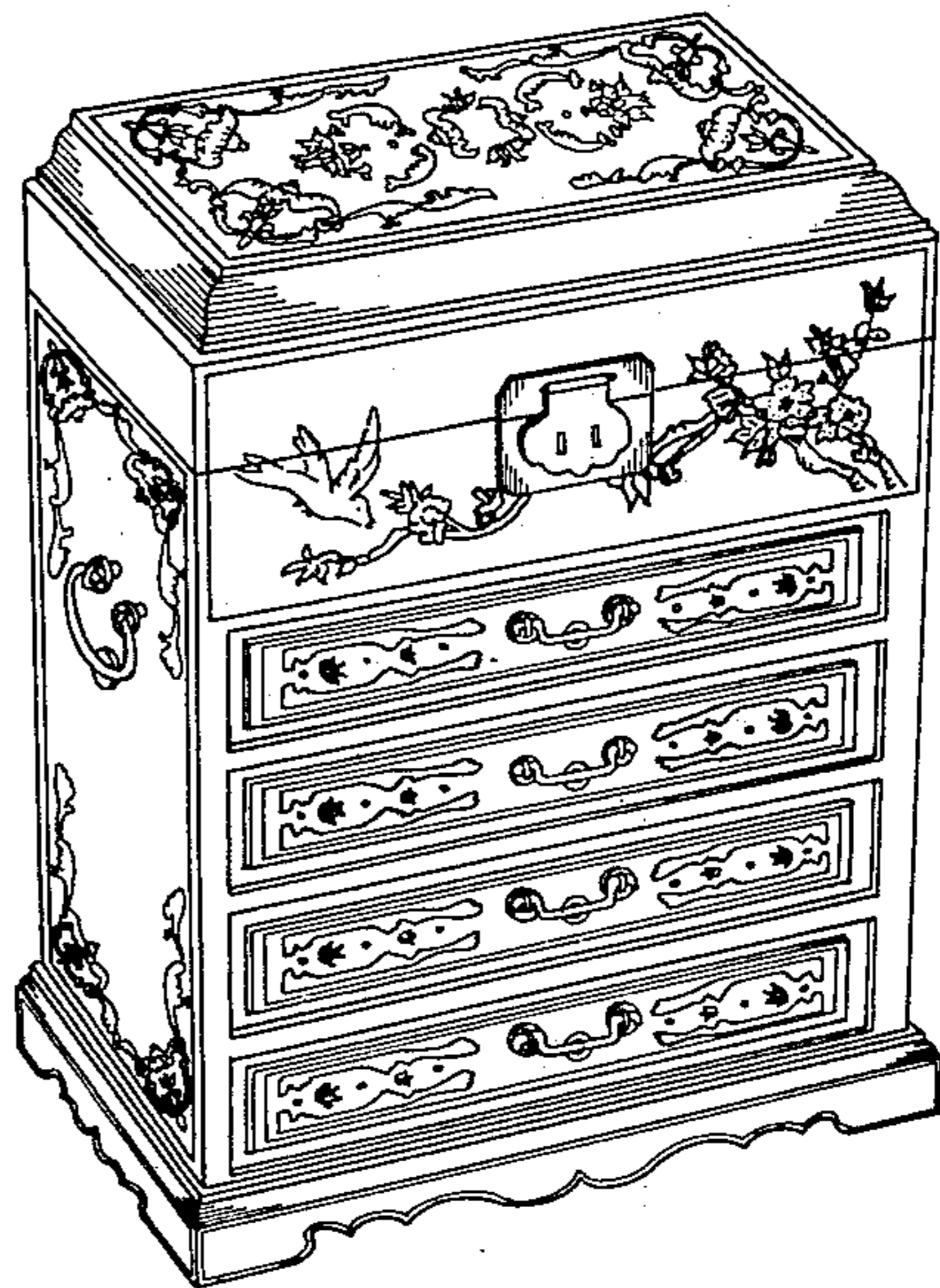
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof.



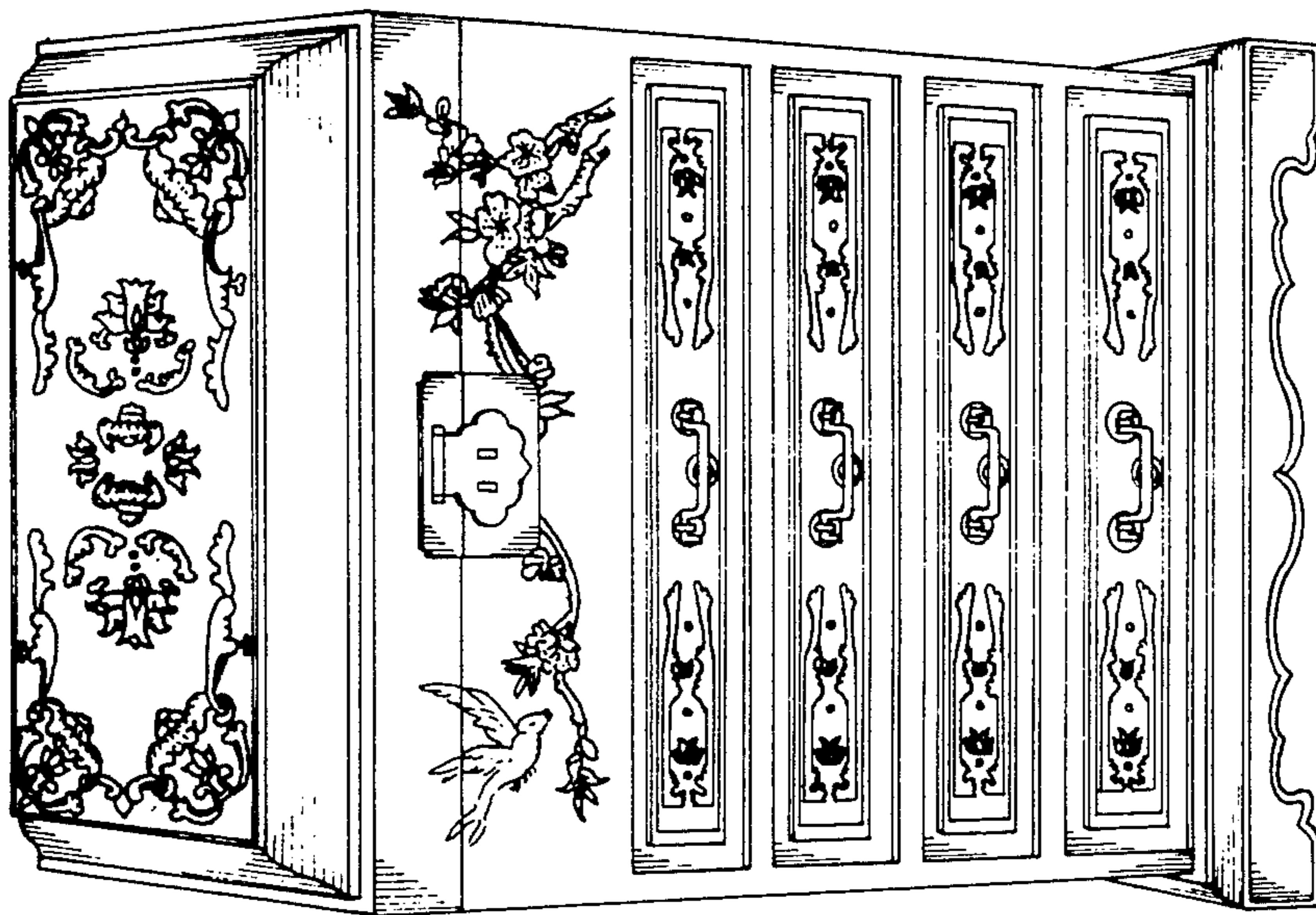

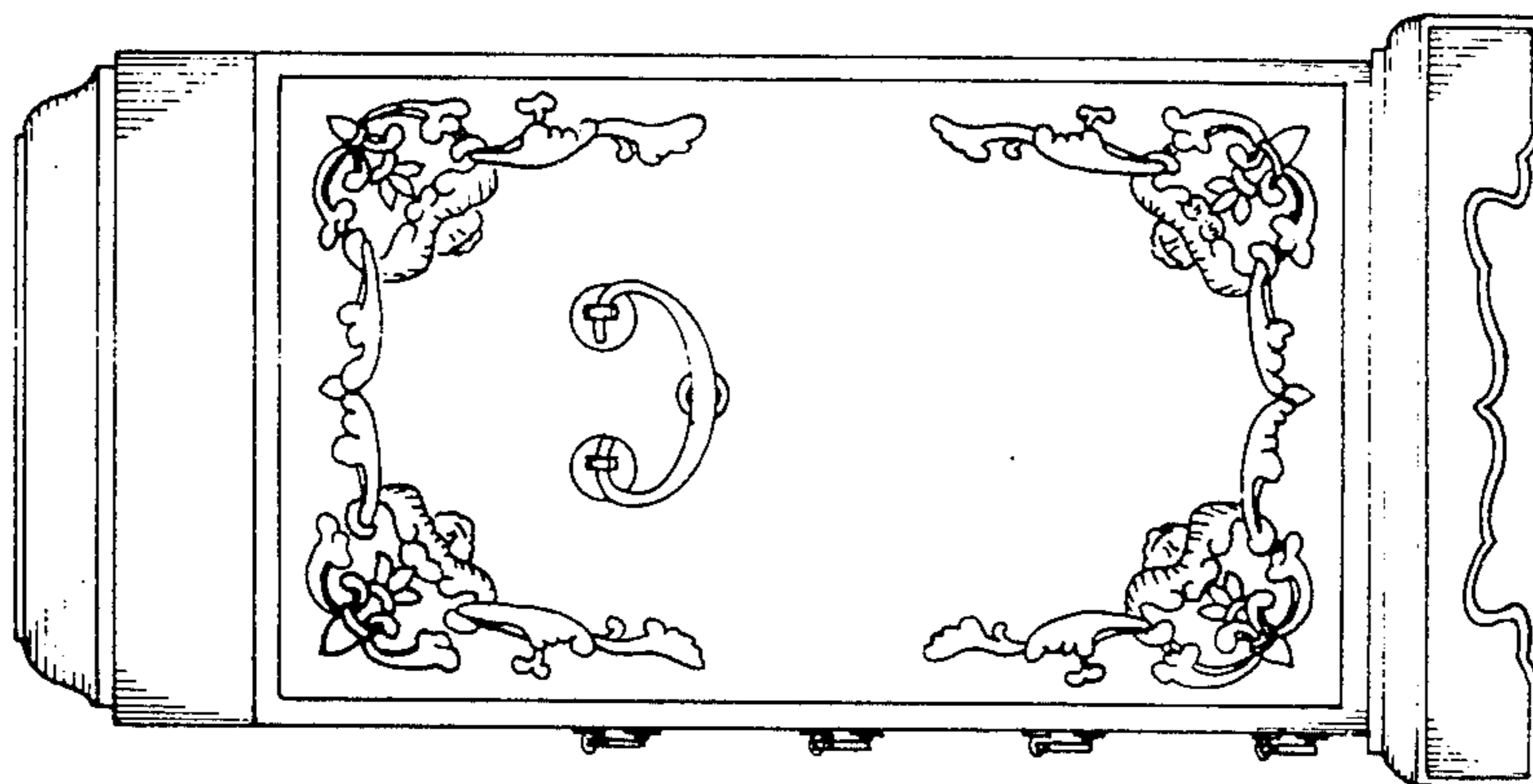

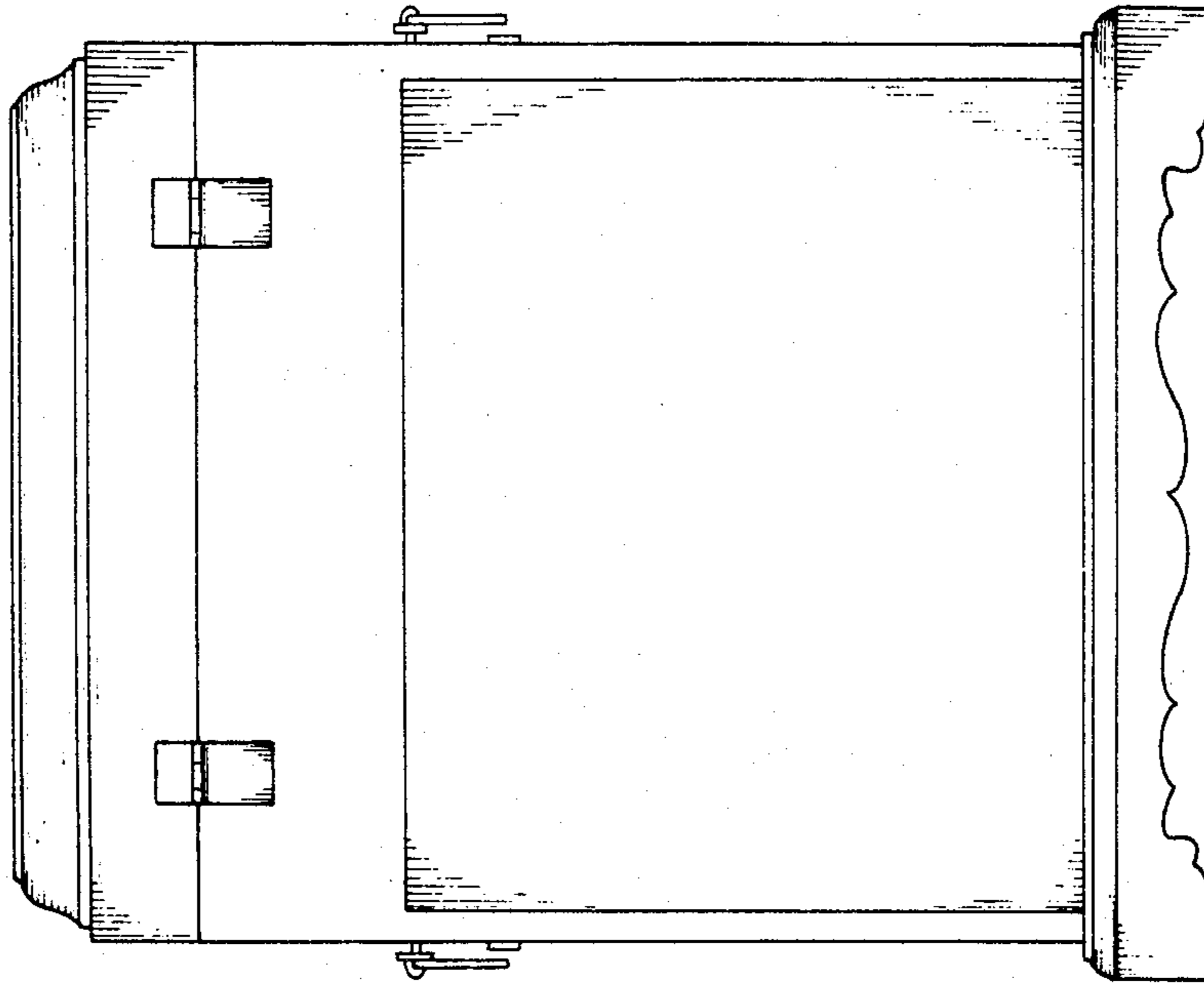

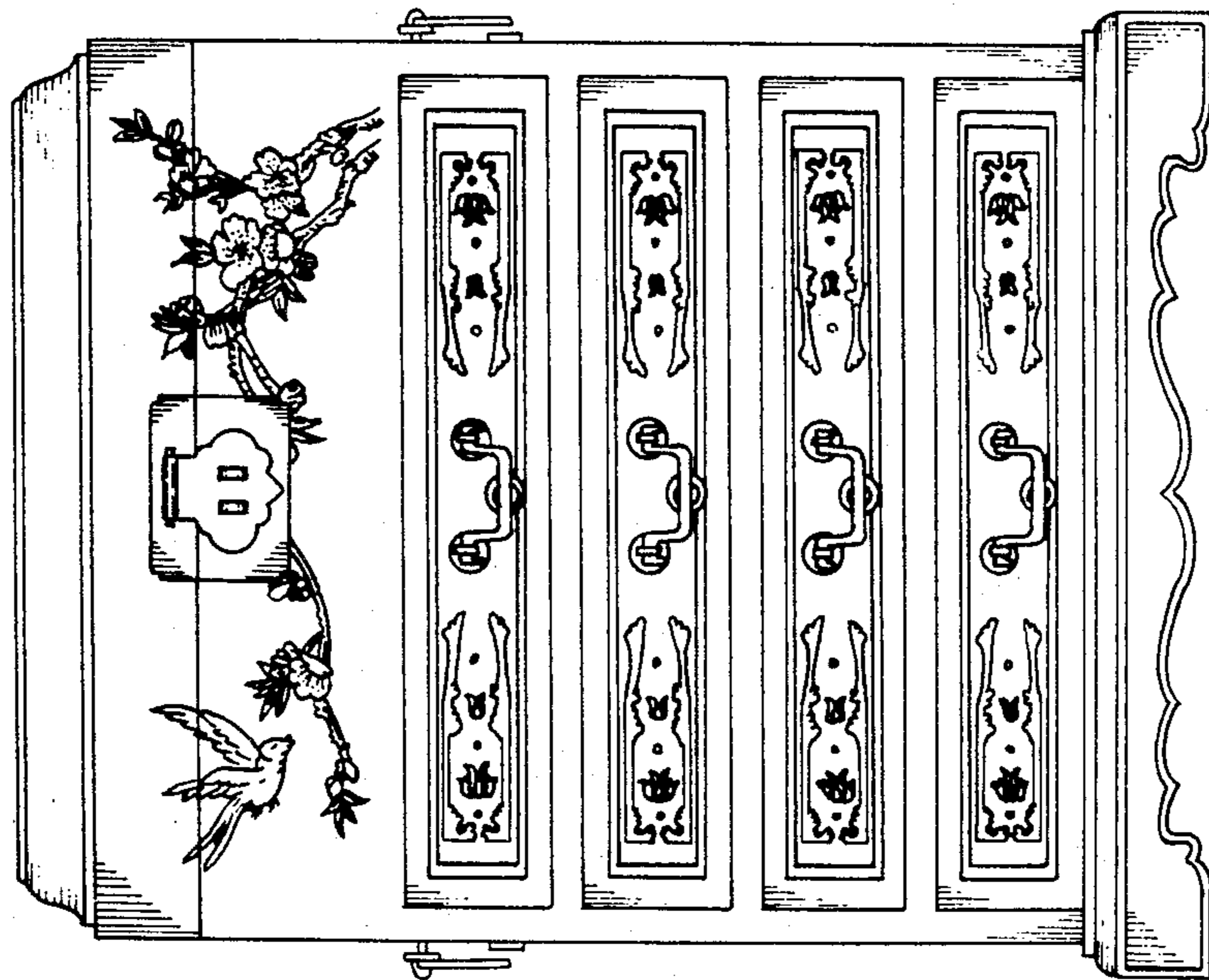

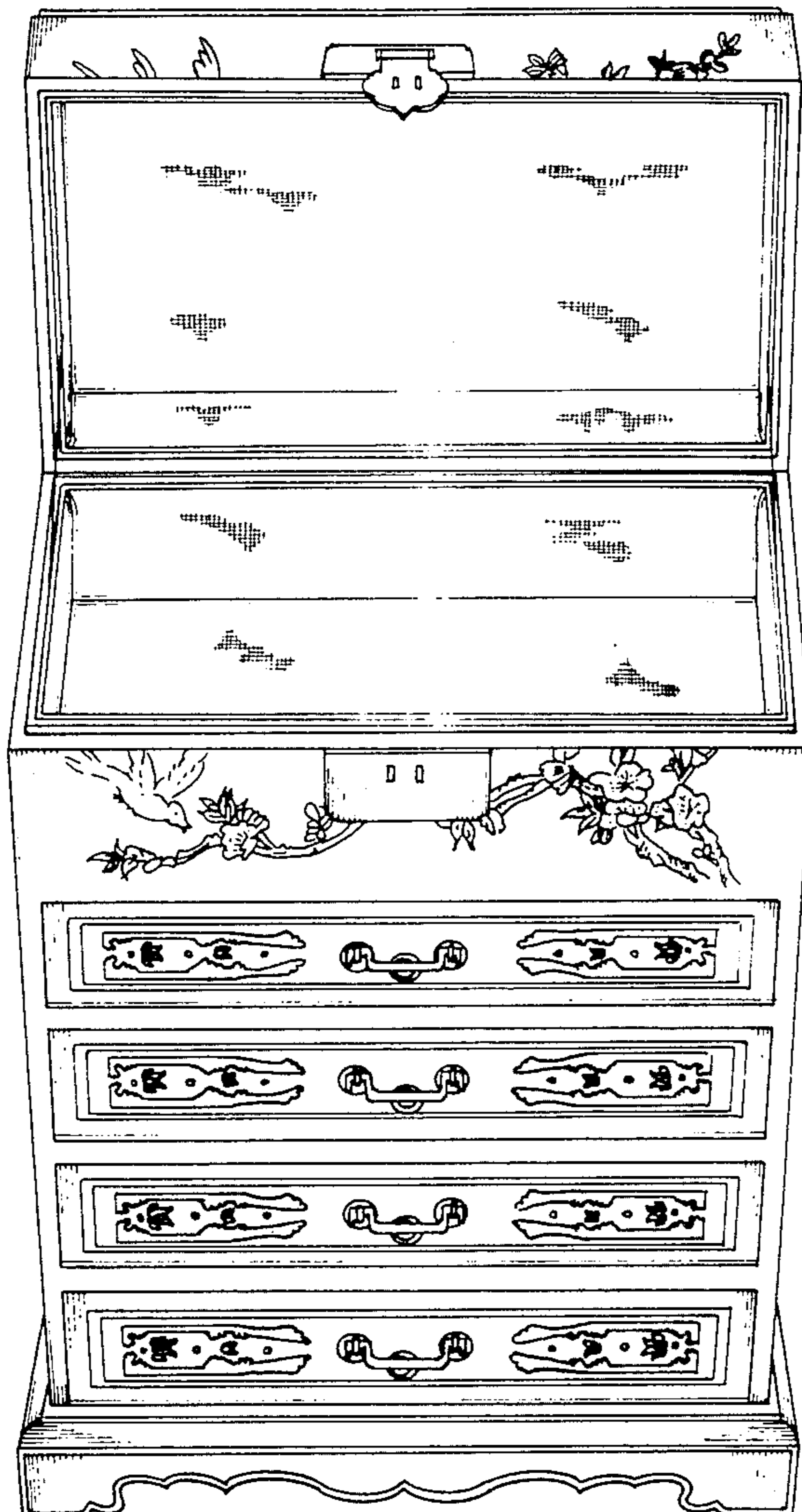

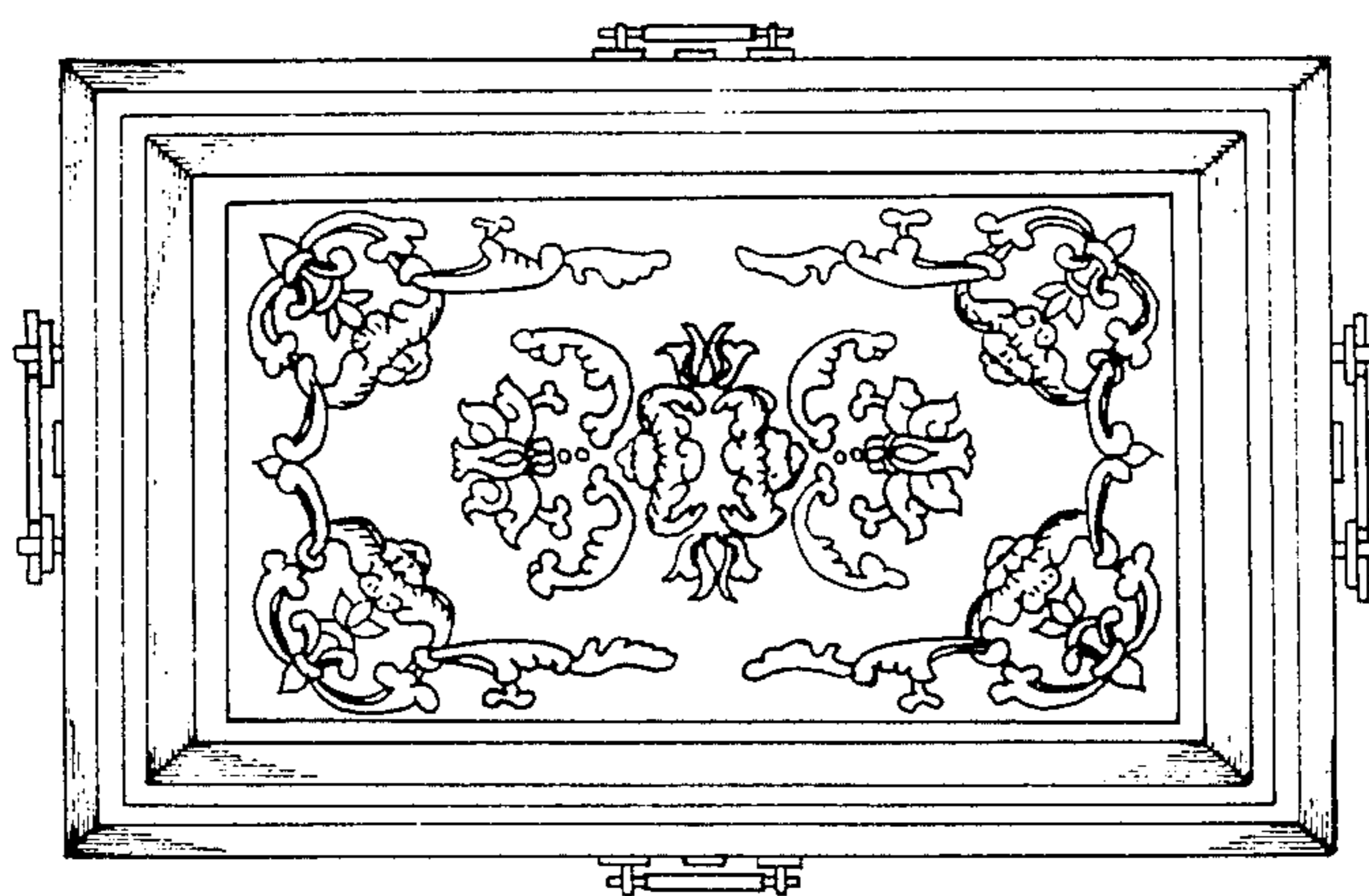

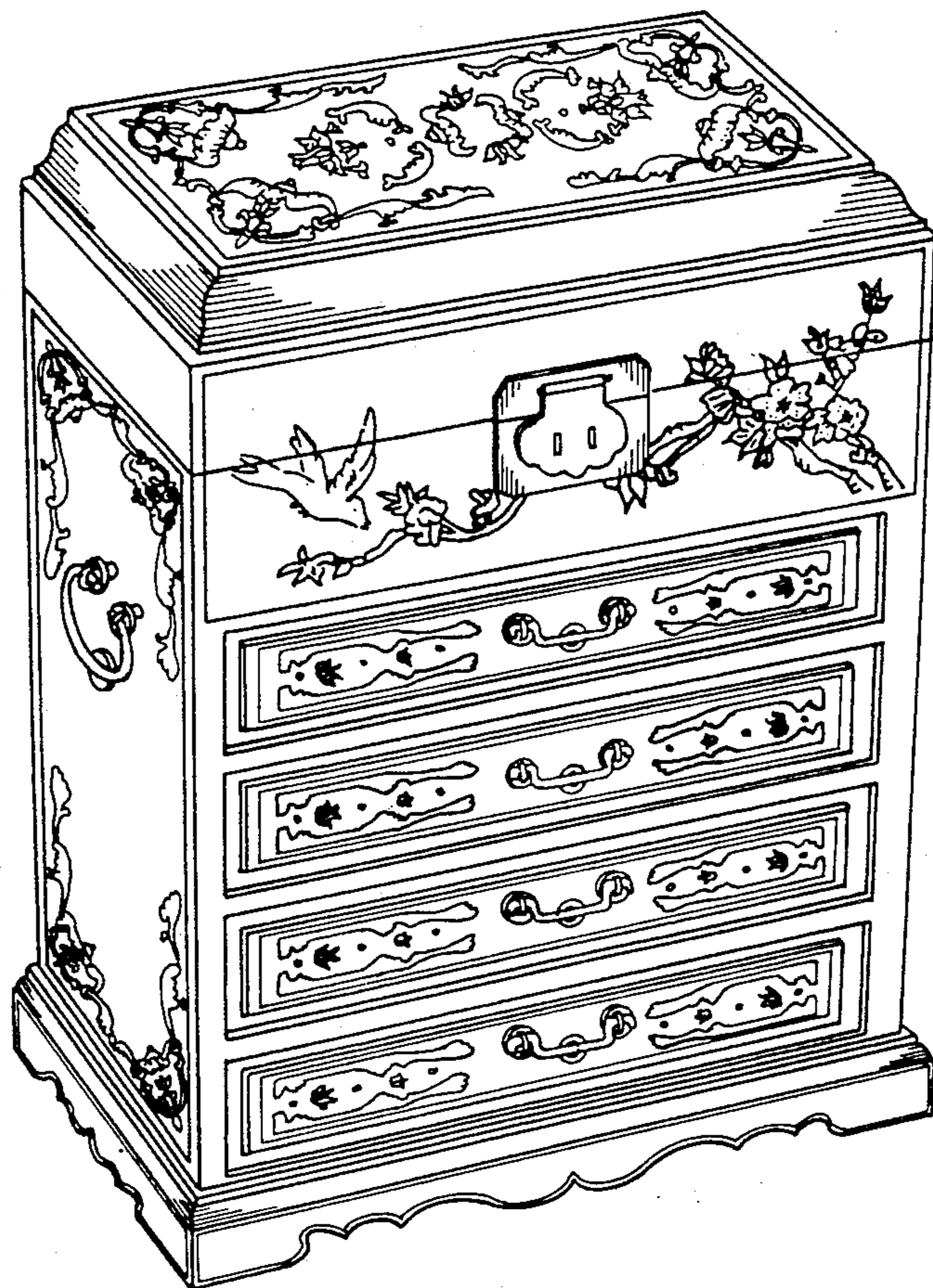
