FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof.

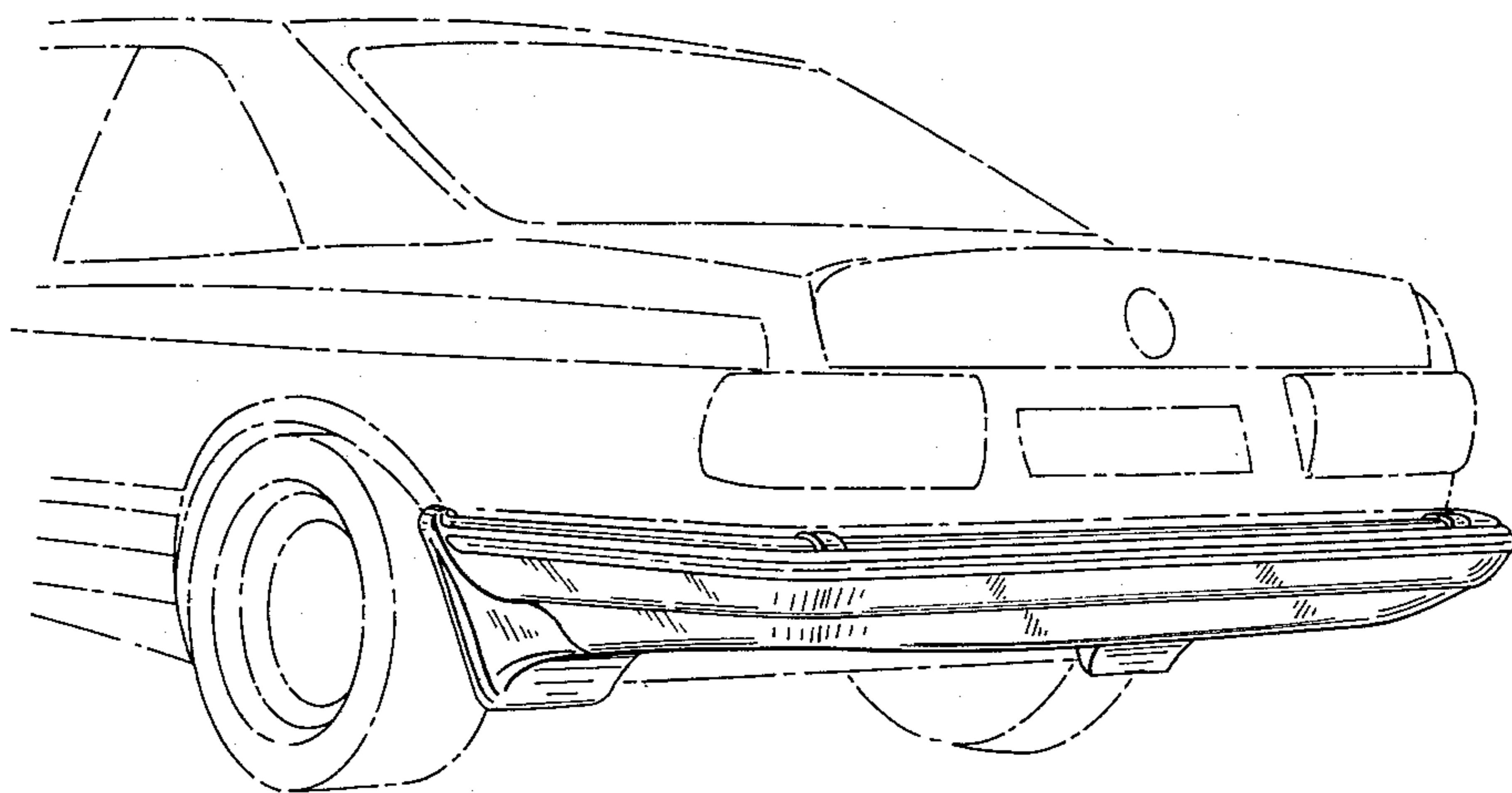
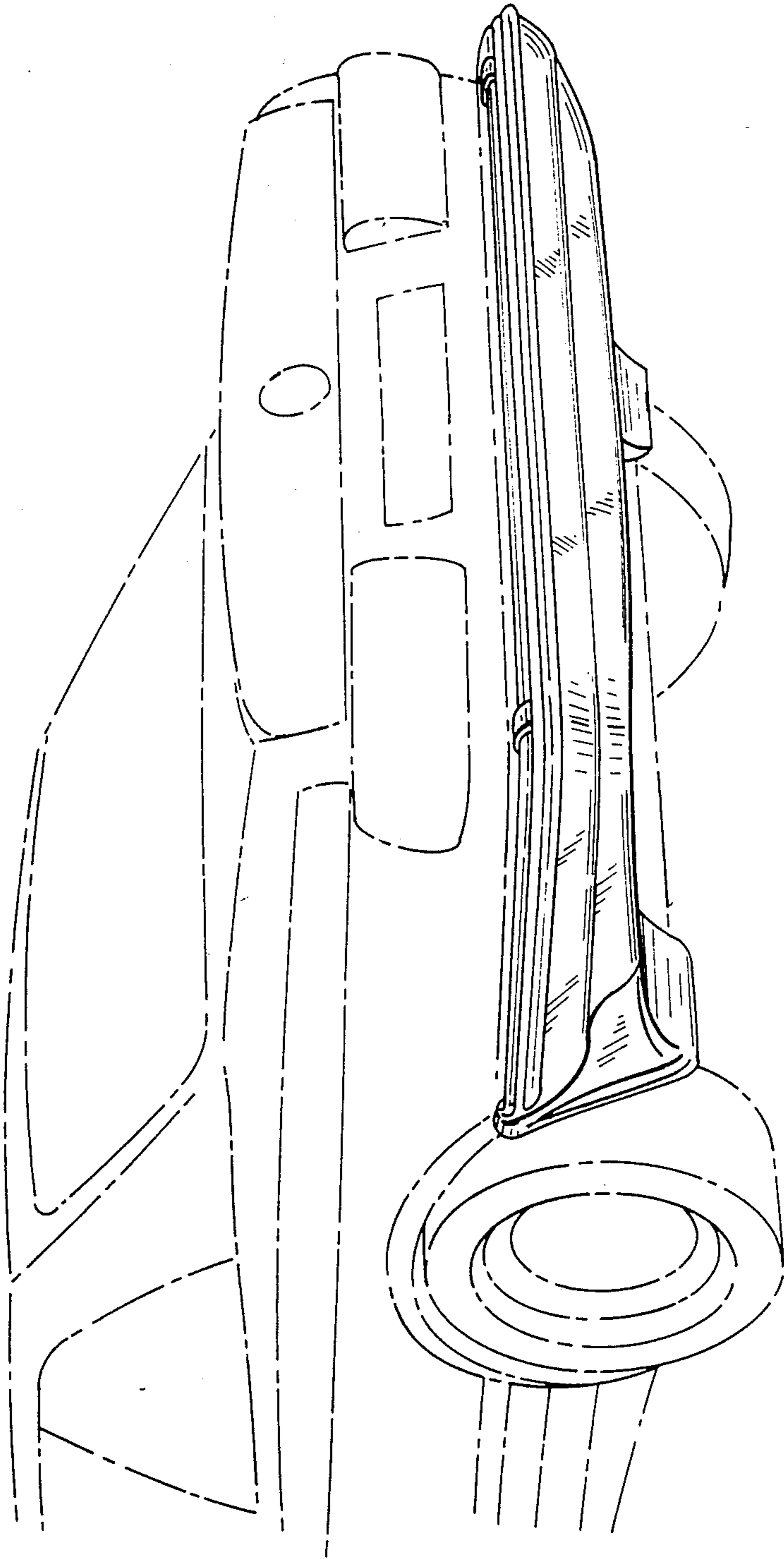

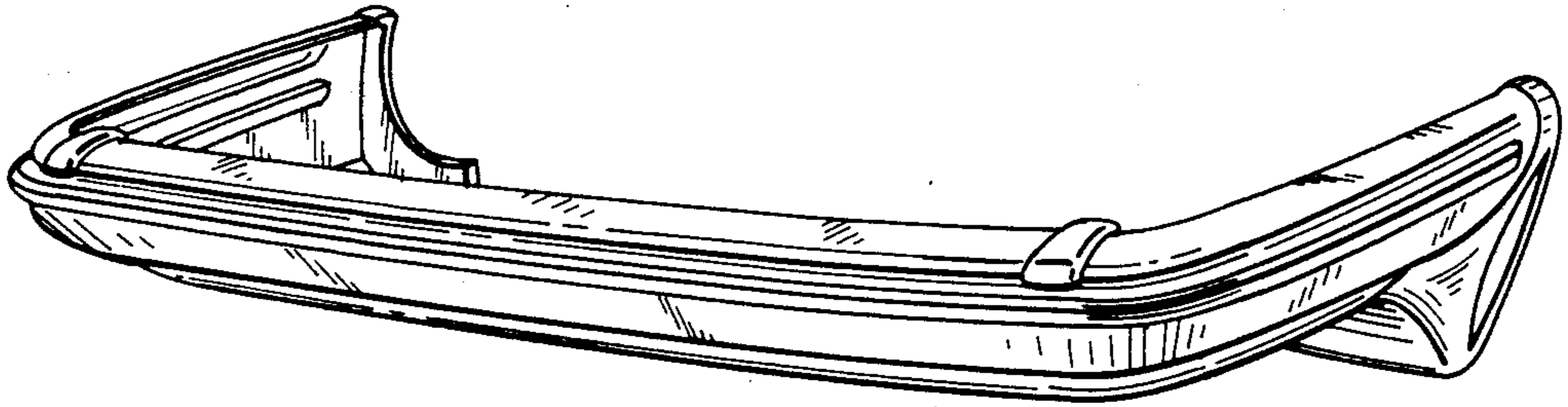

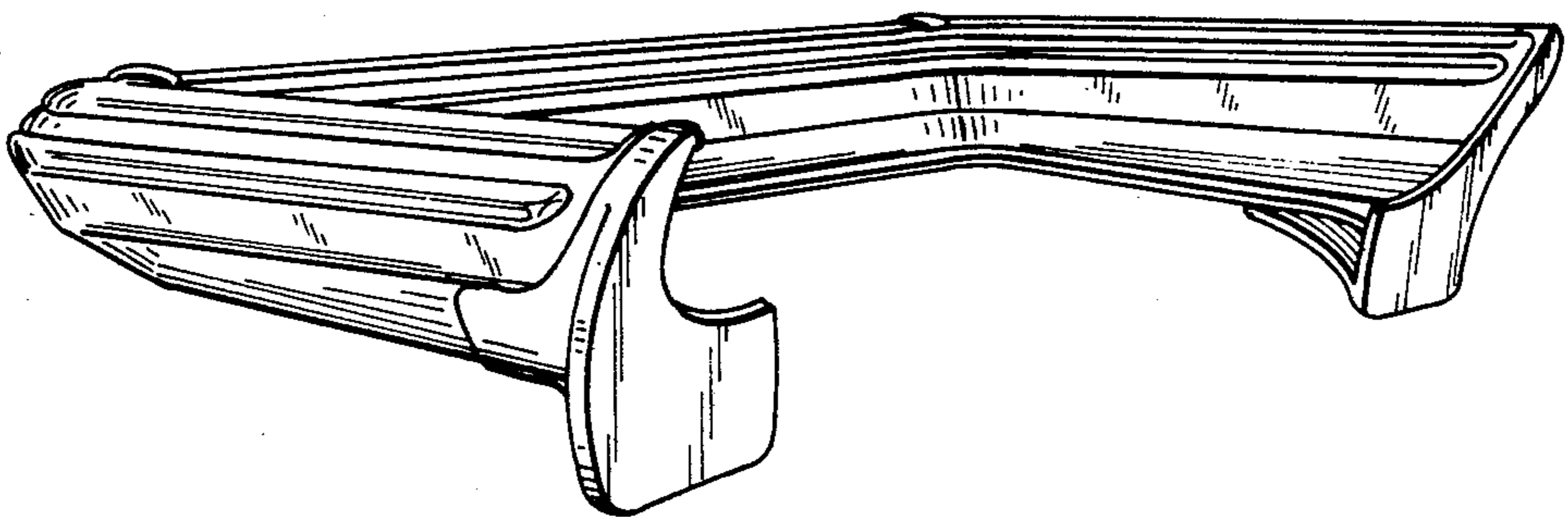

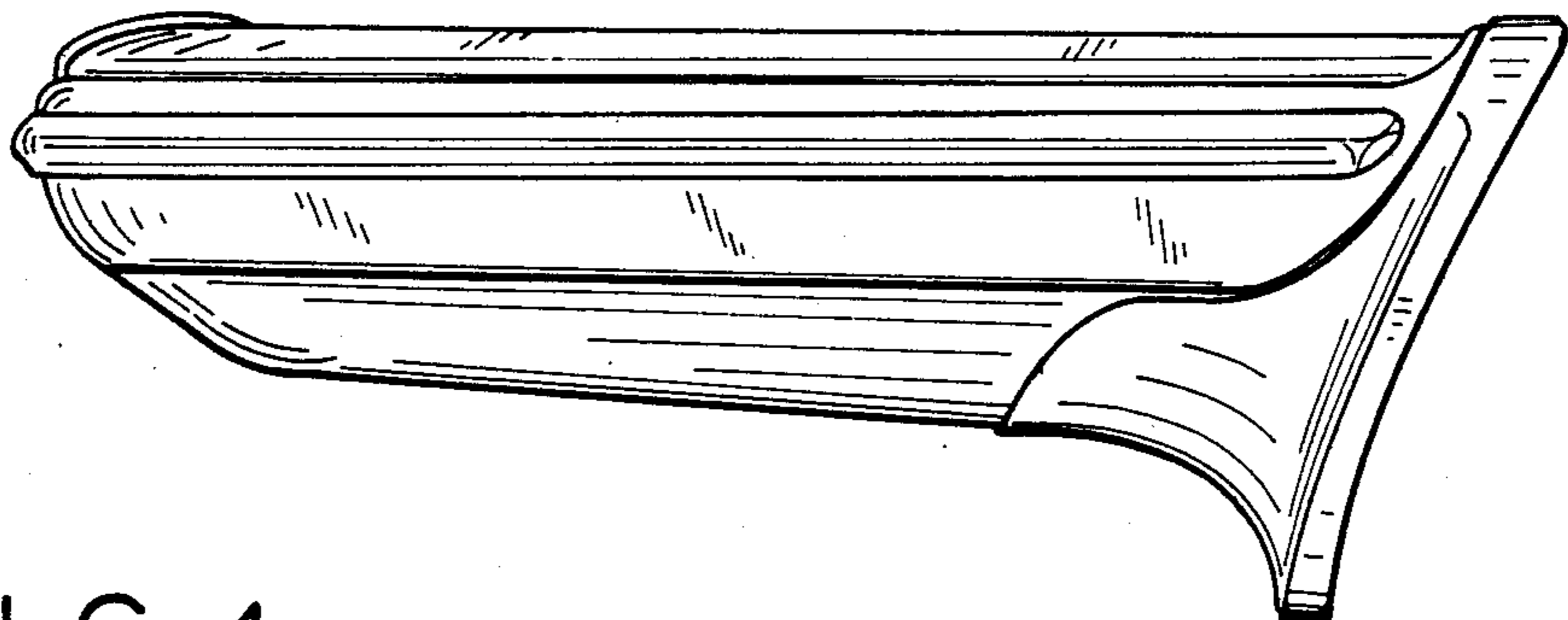
