DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a cabinet door or
similar article showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view, the left side being
a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof.

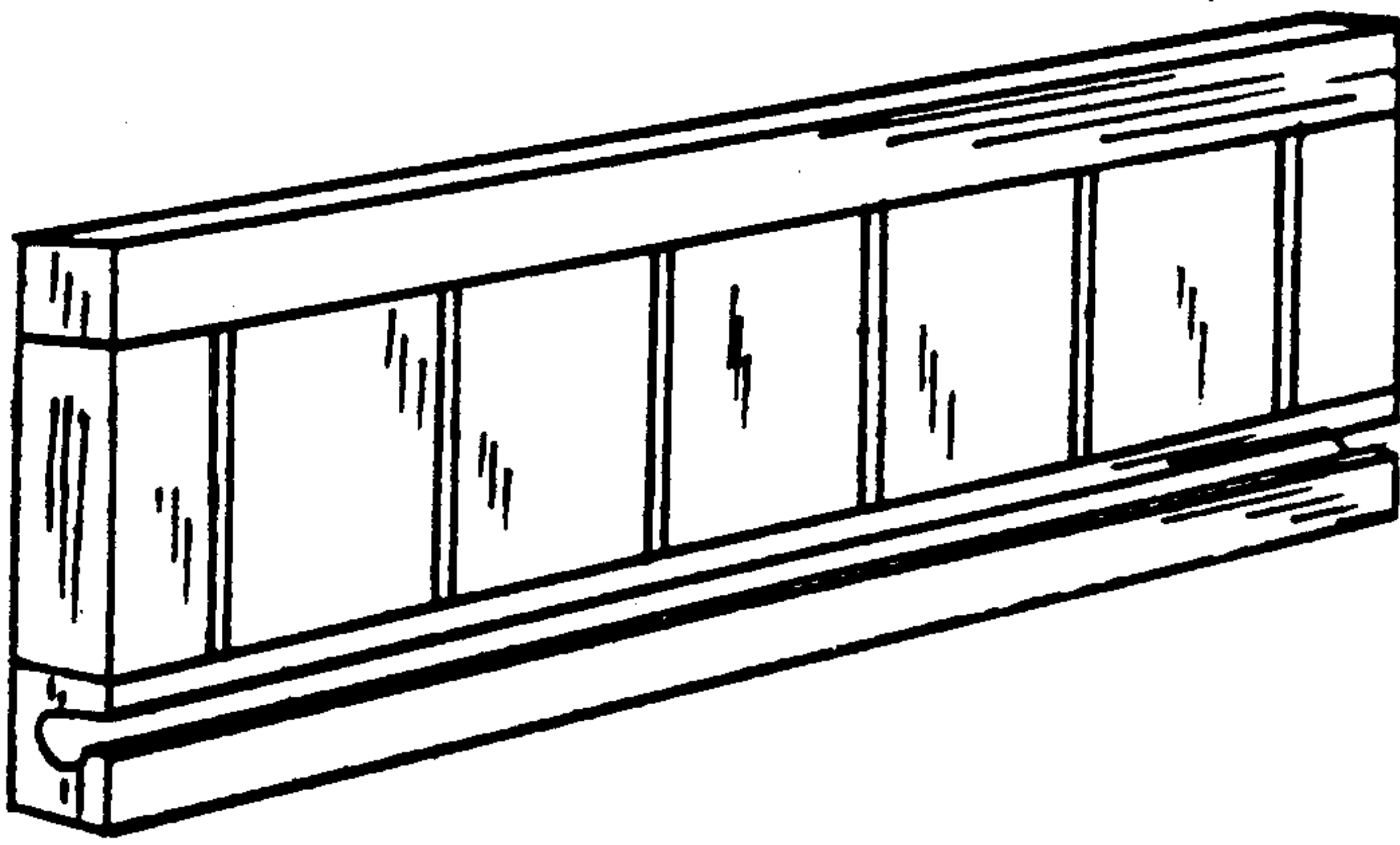

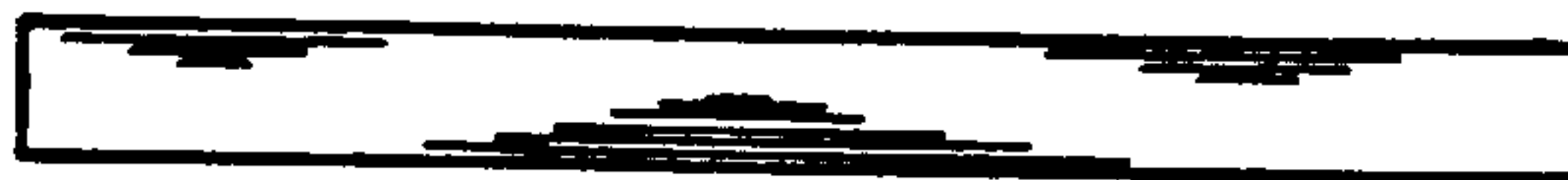

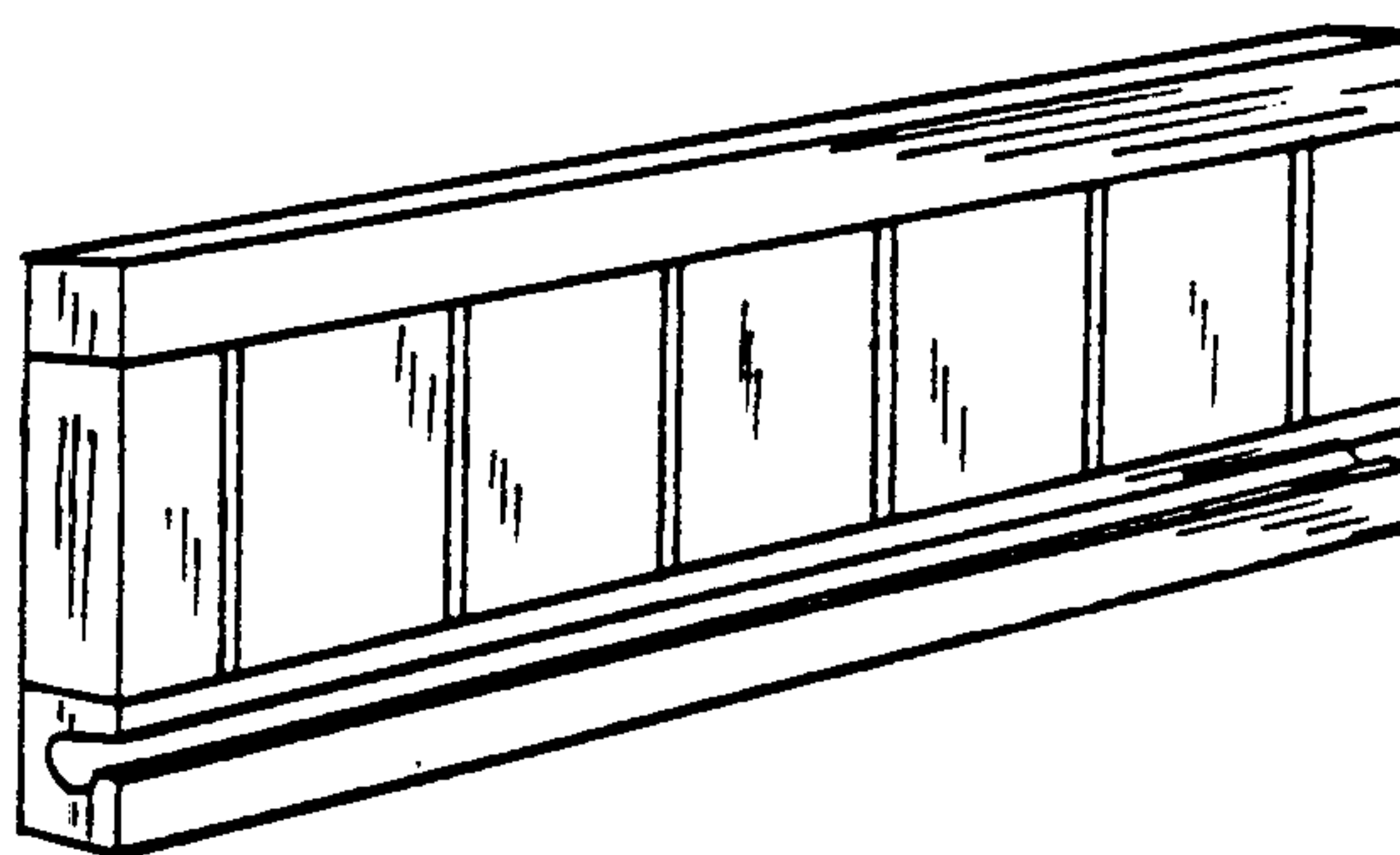
