FIG. 6 is an opposite side elevational view thereof.

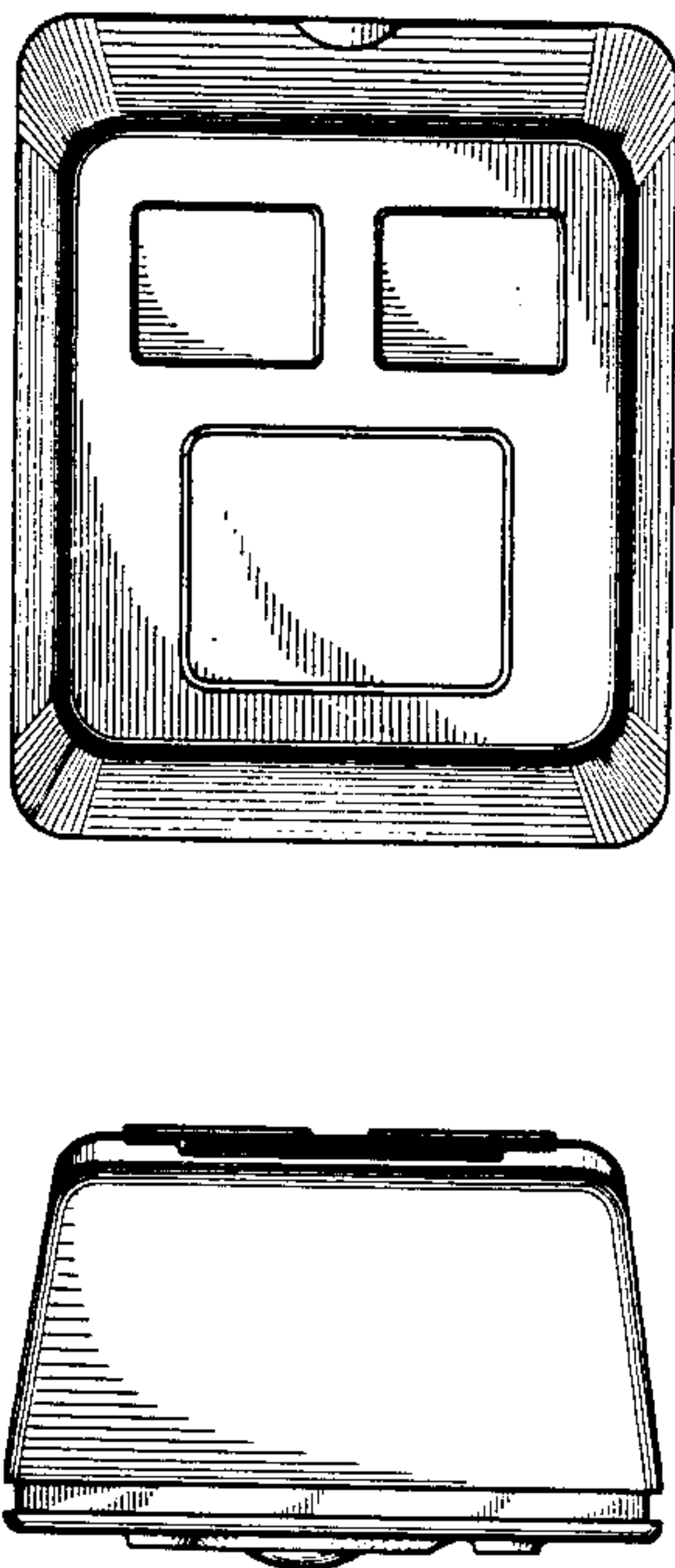

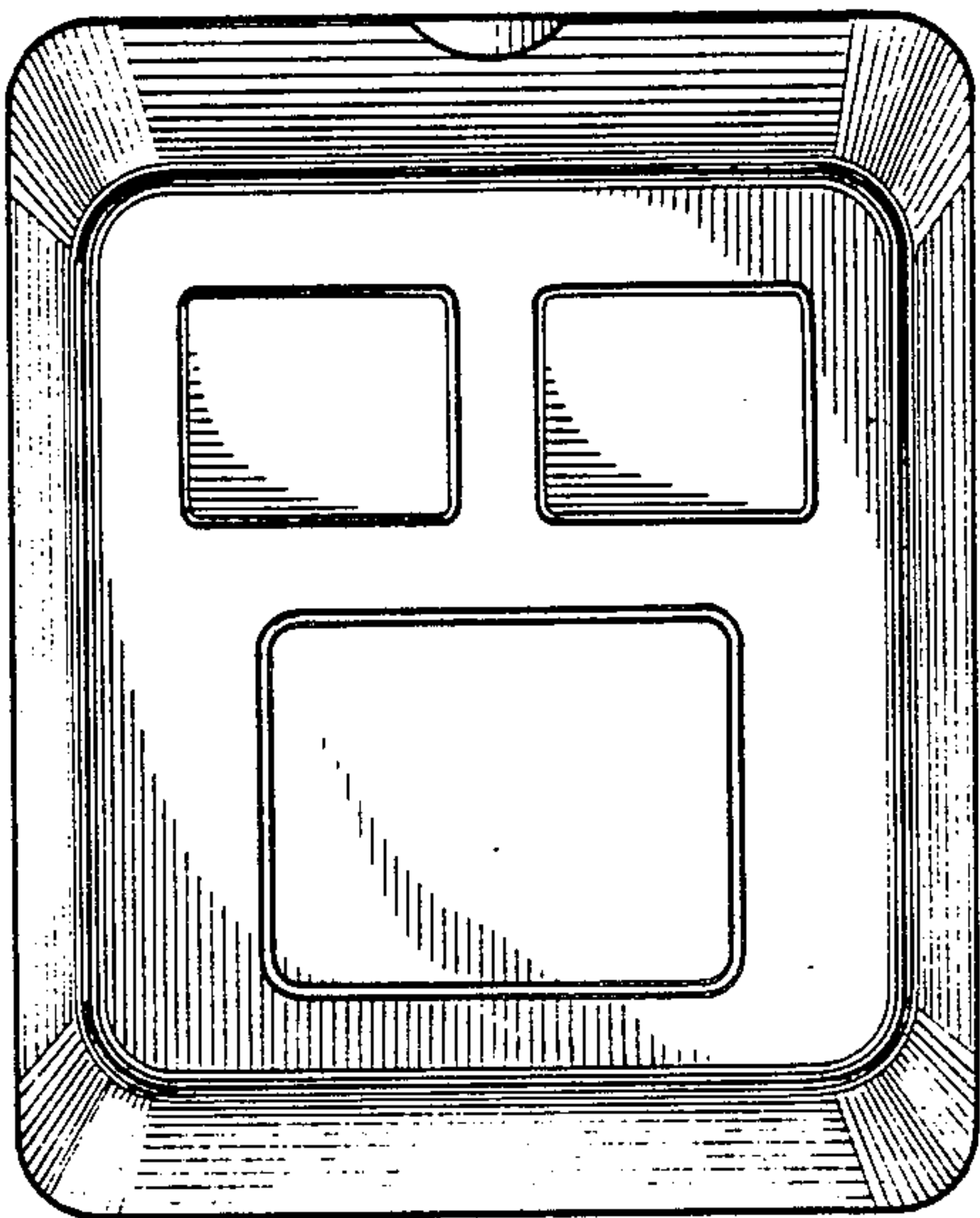

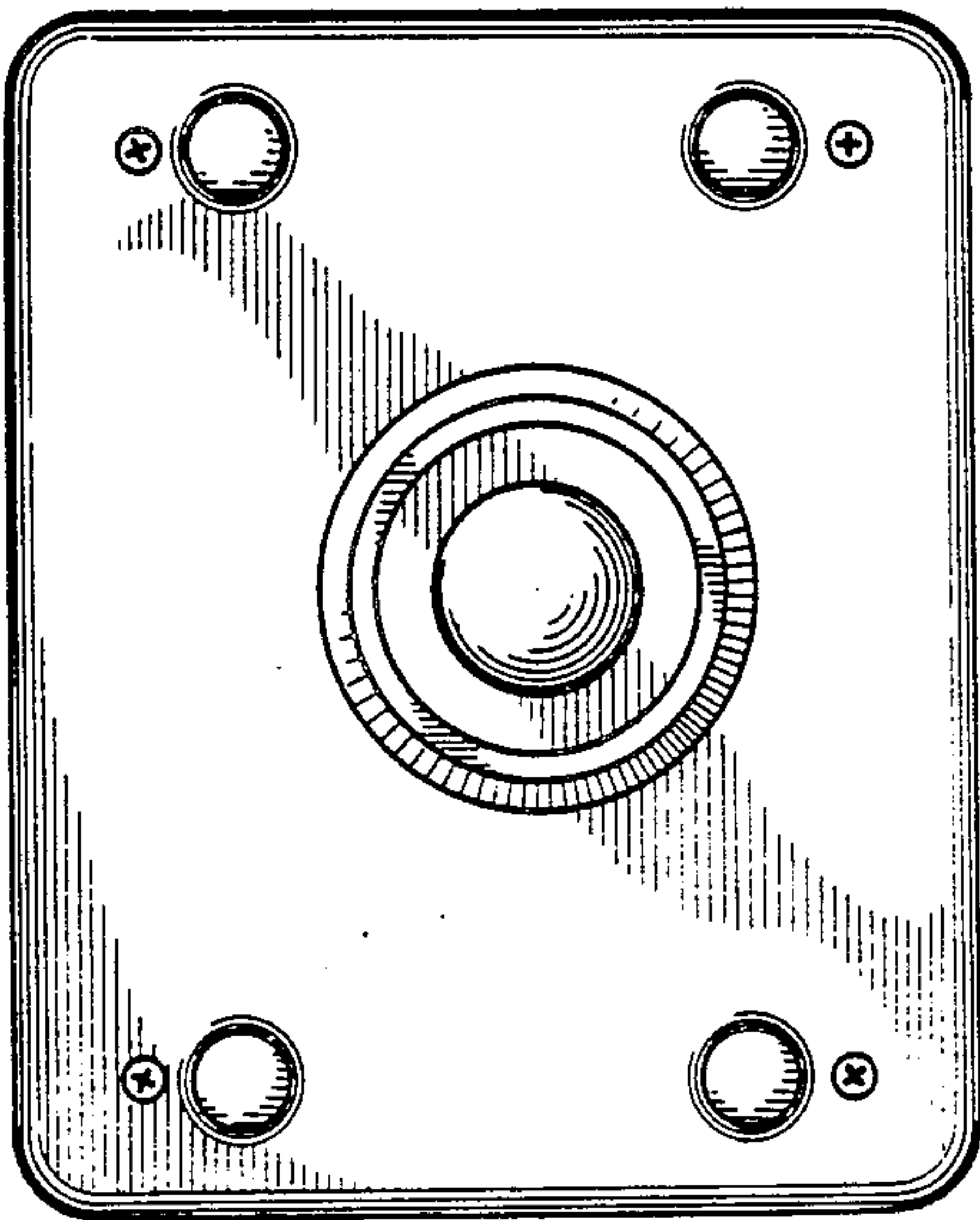

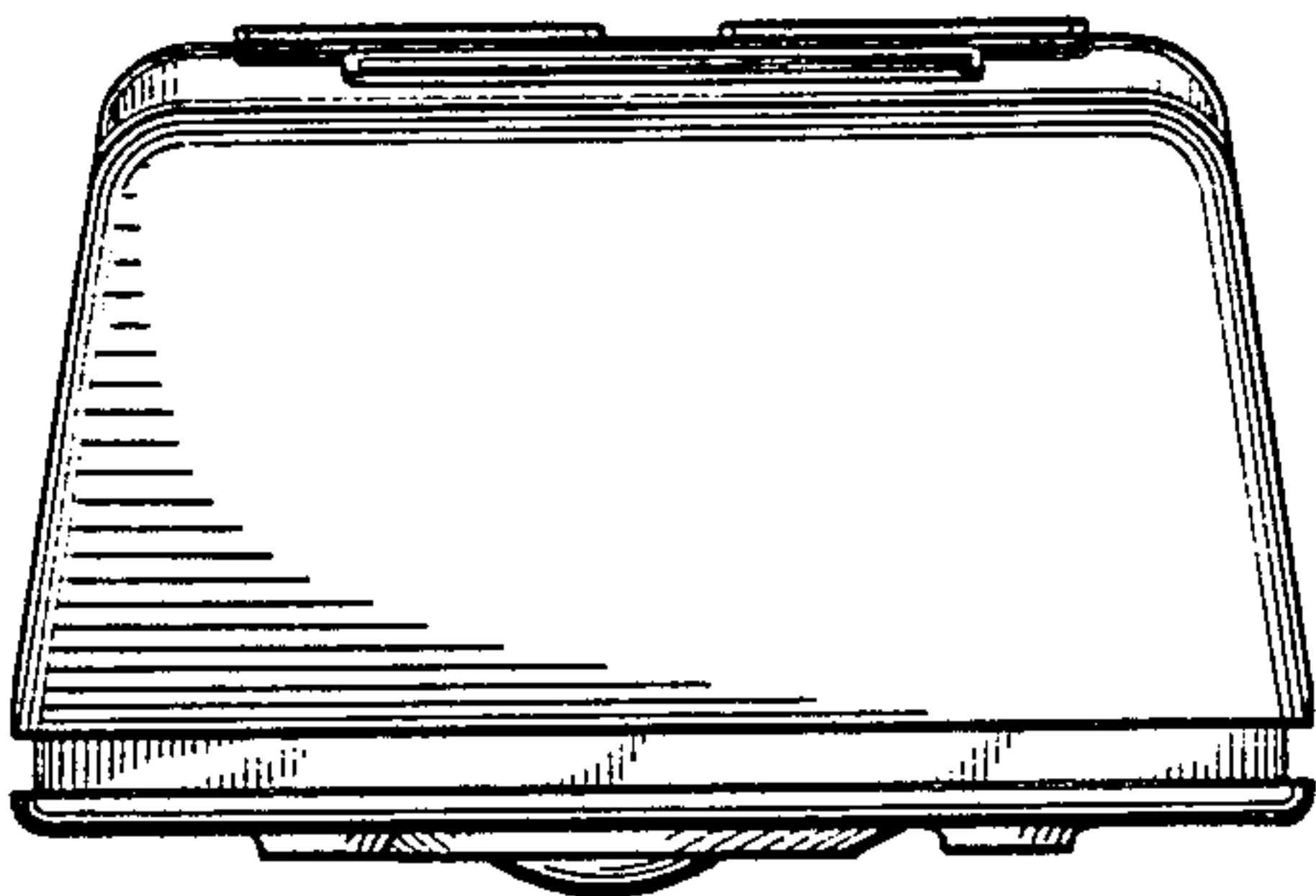

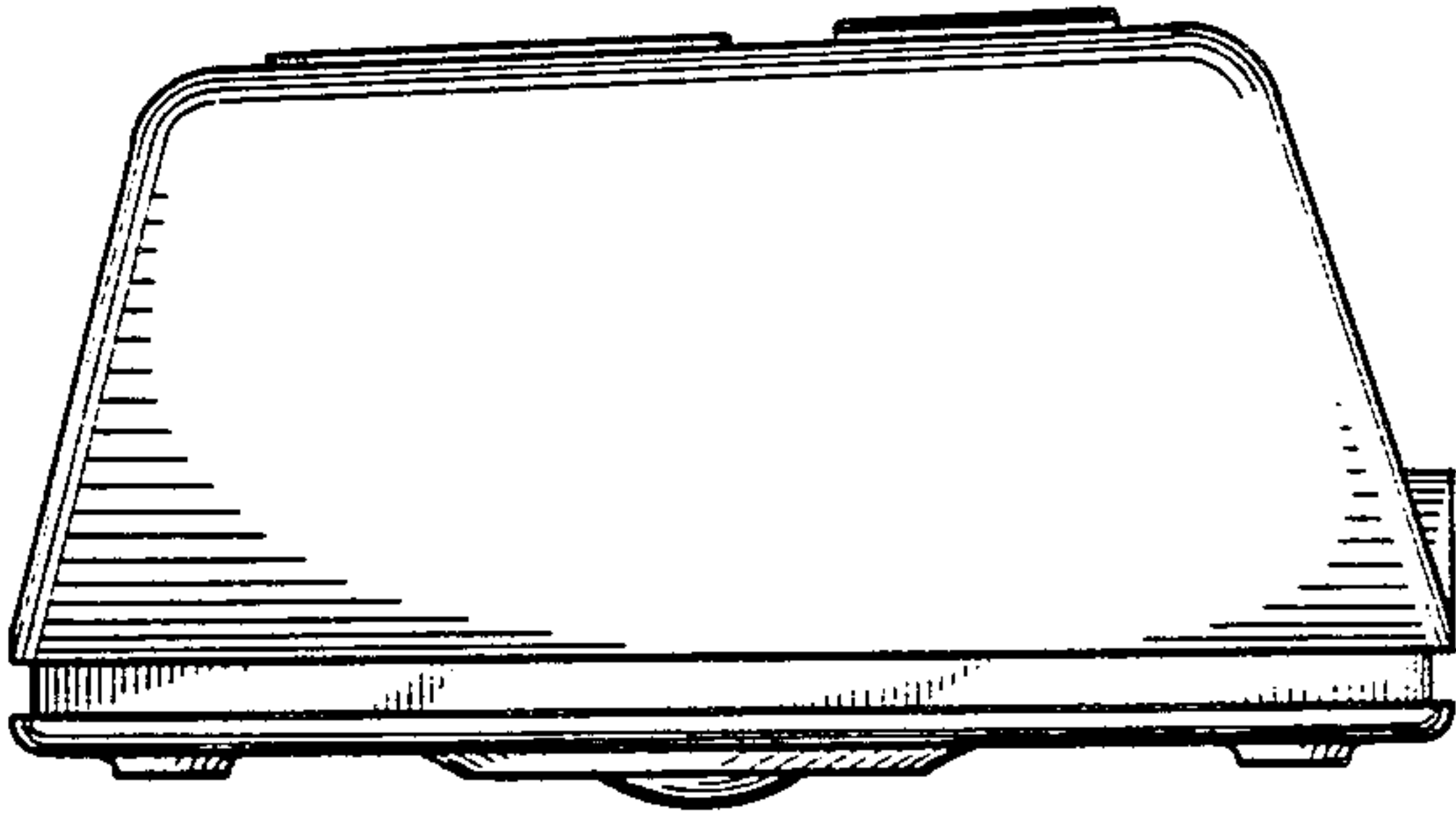

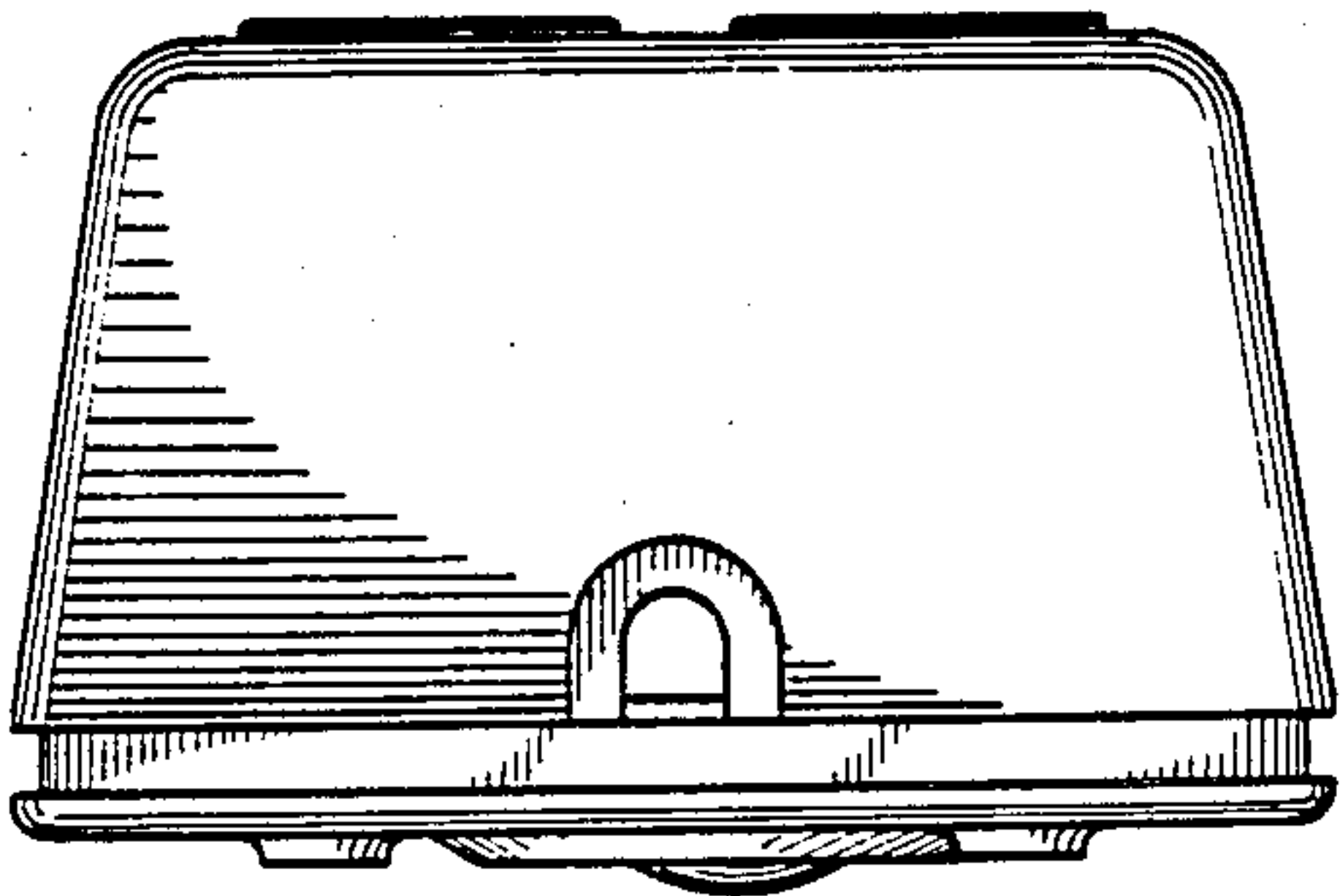
