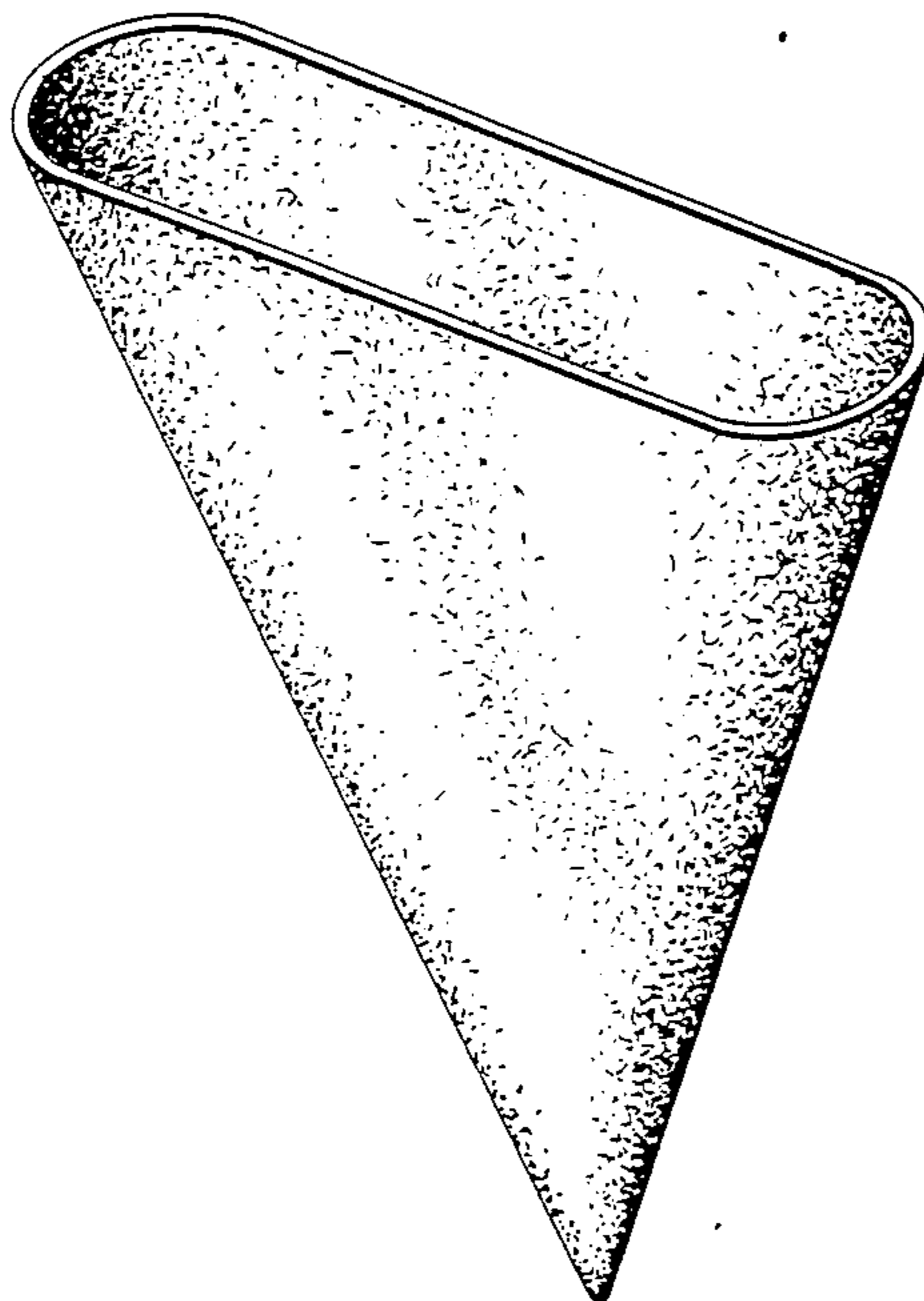
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a taco shell showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

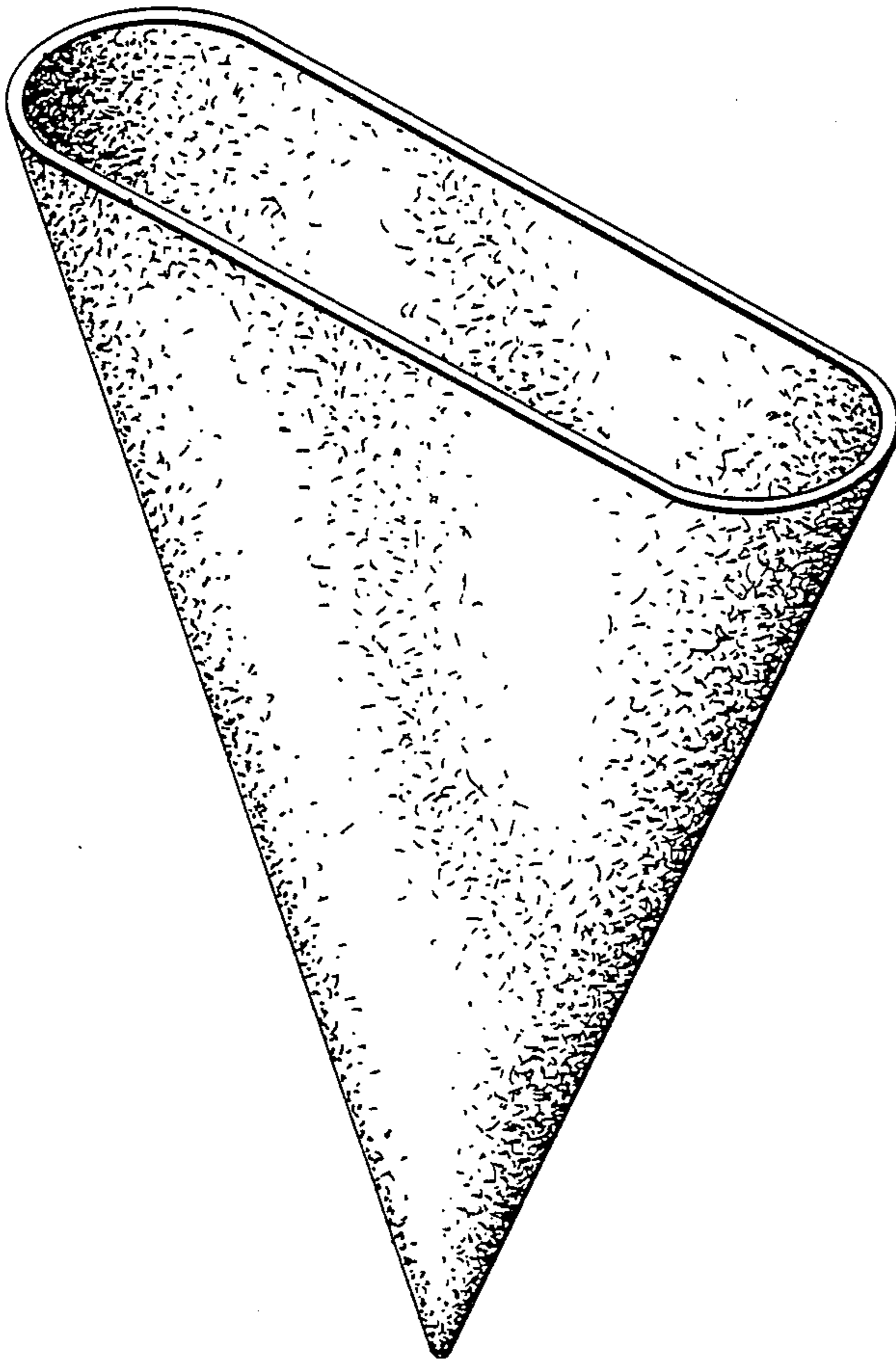

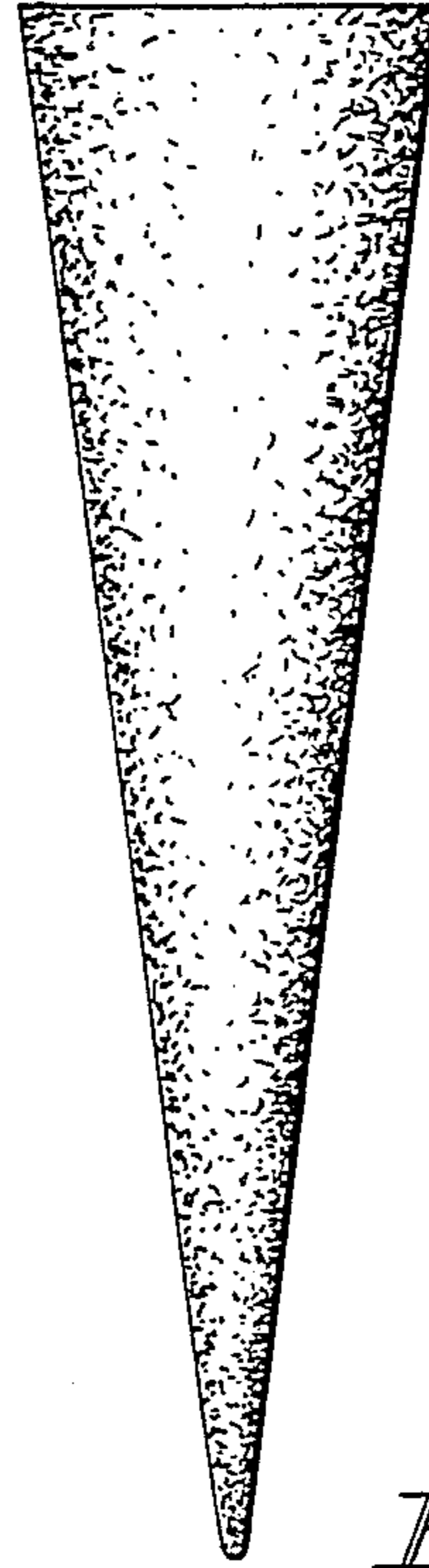

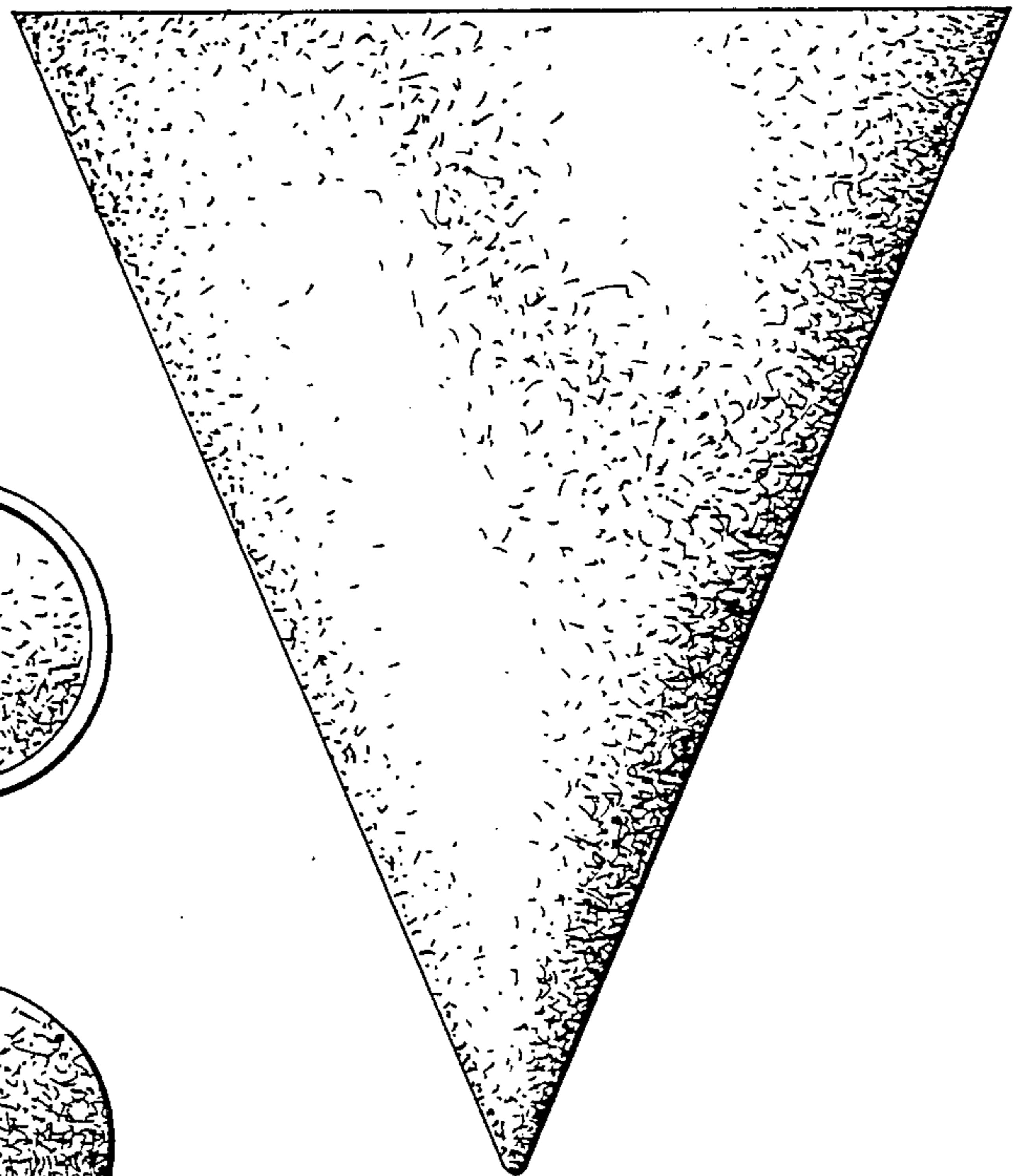
