The ornamental design for a spoon, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a spoon showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite is identical to the side shown;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left end elevational view of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is a right end elevational view of FIG. 1.

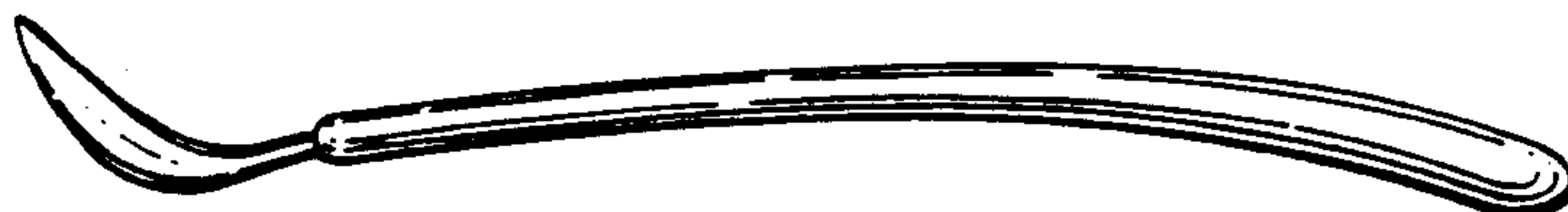
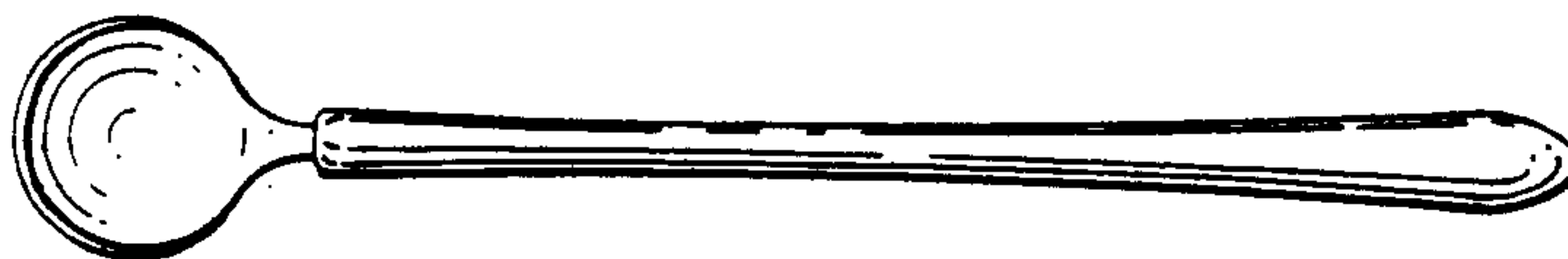

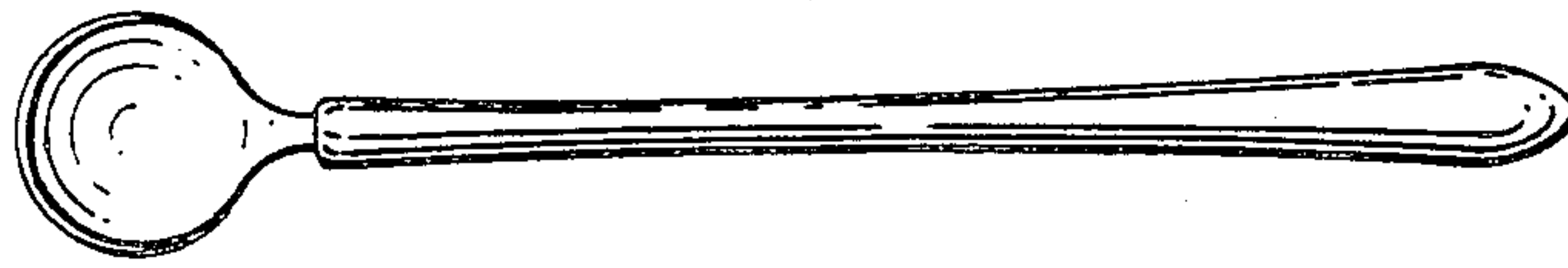

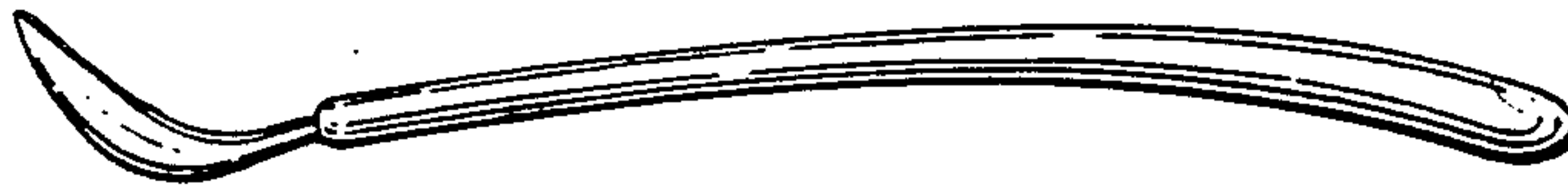

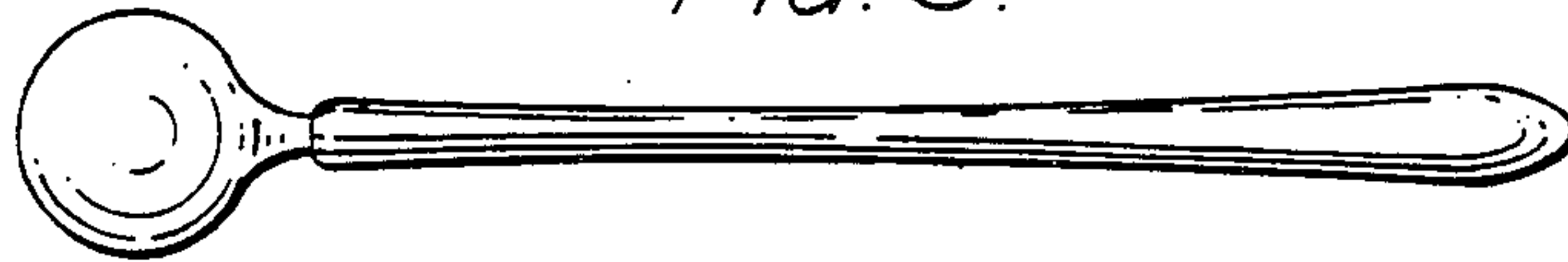
