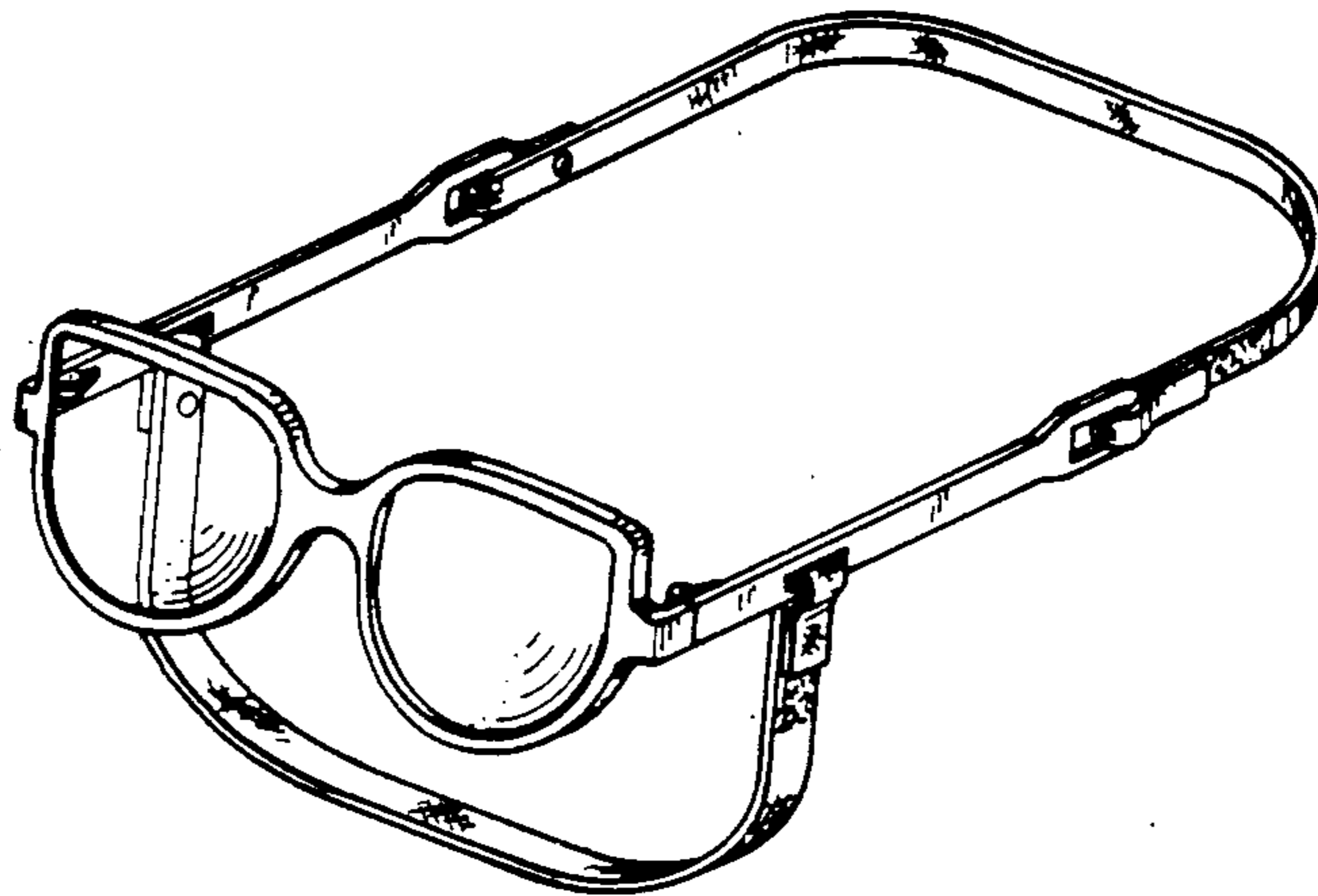

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the canine spectacles showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a rear view of FIG. 1.



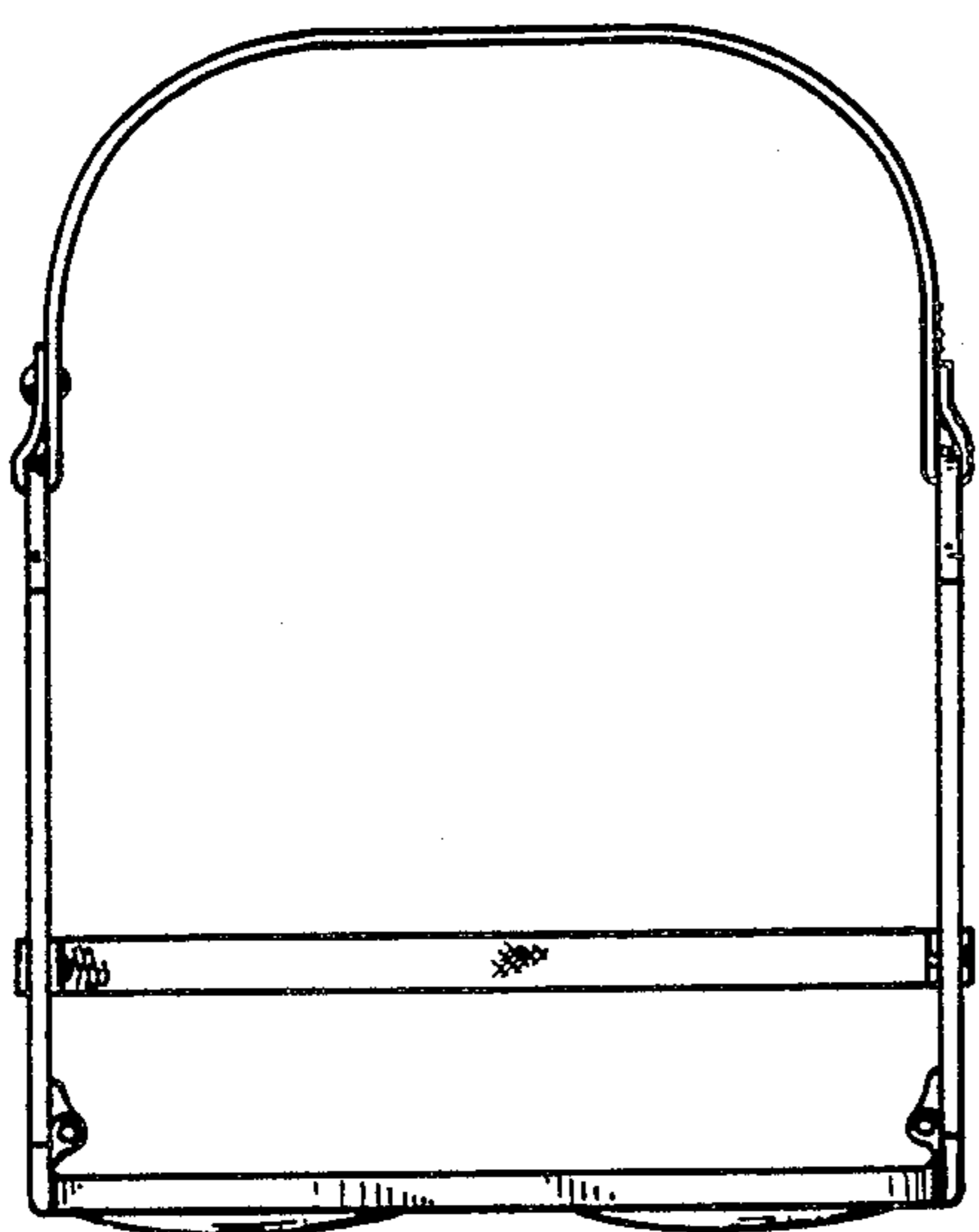

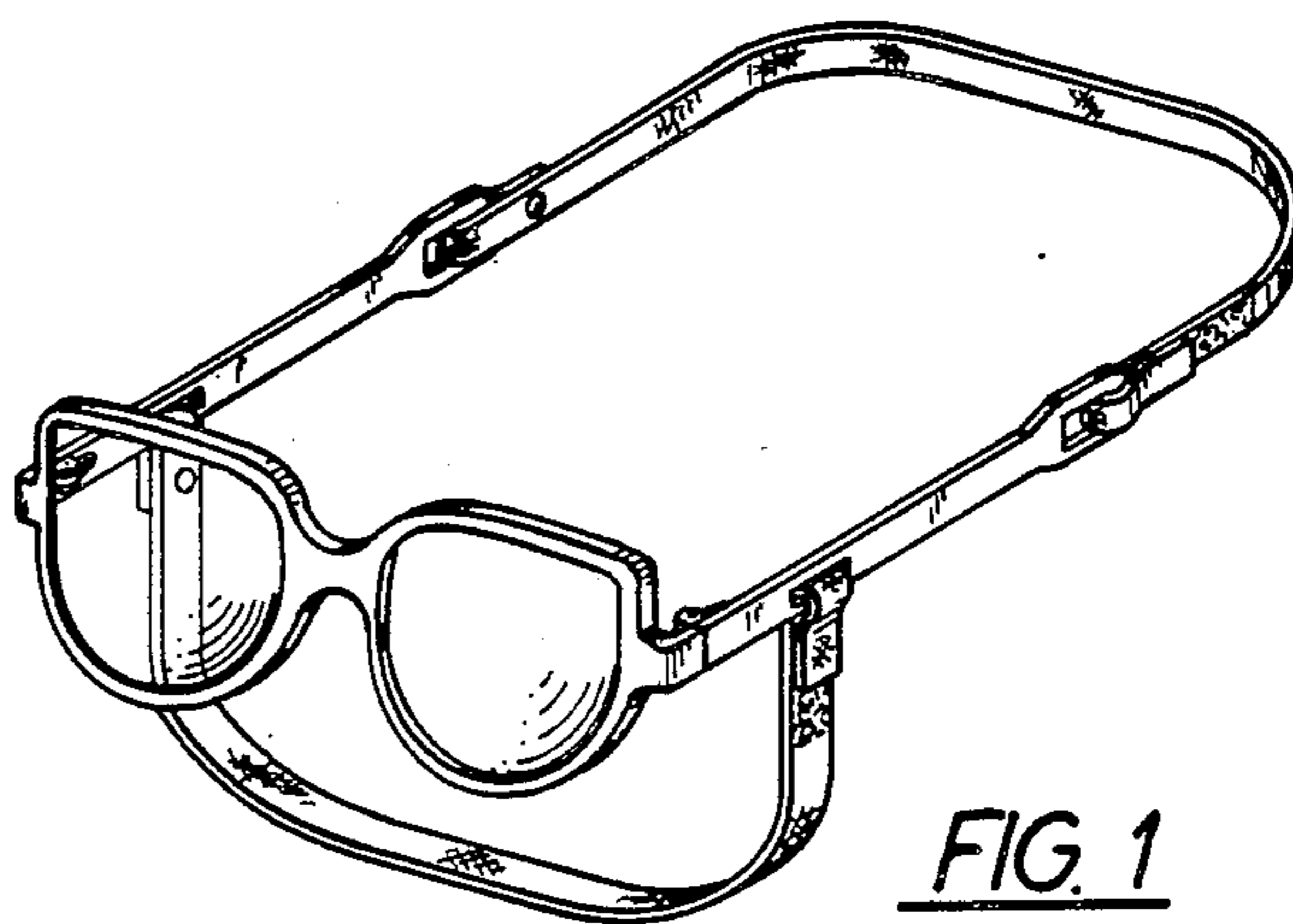

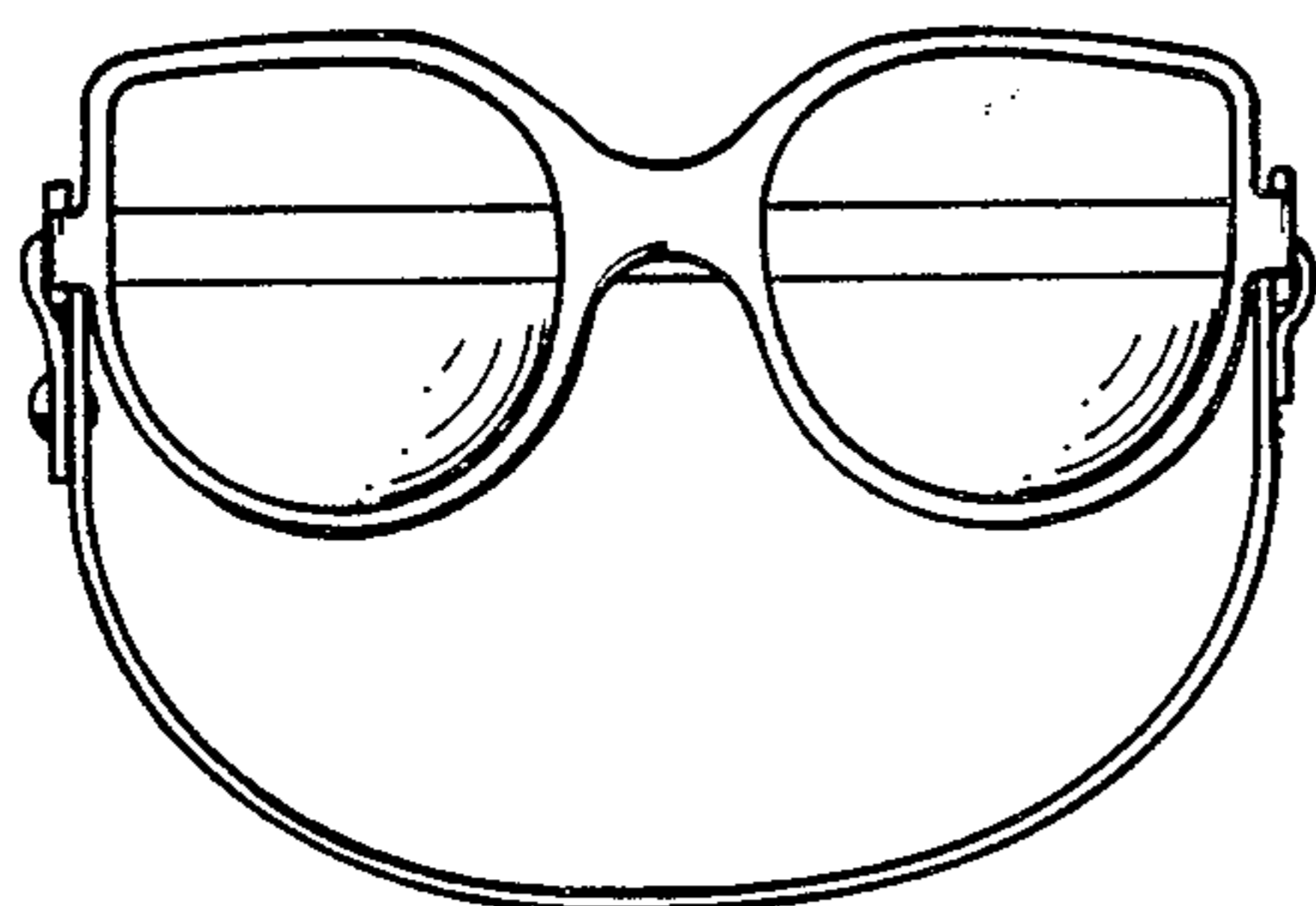

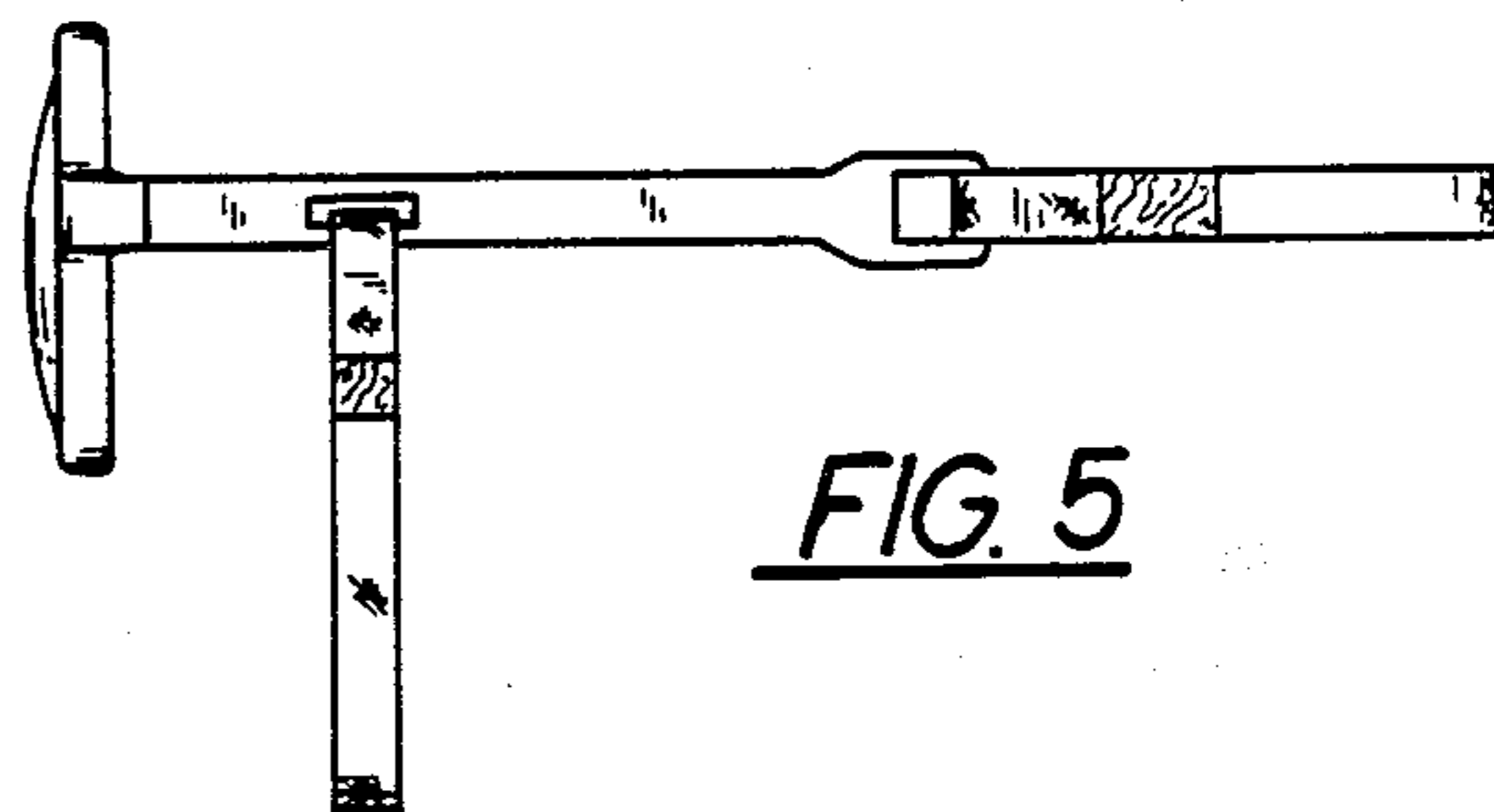

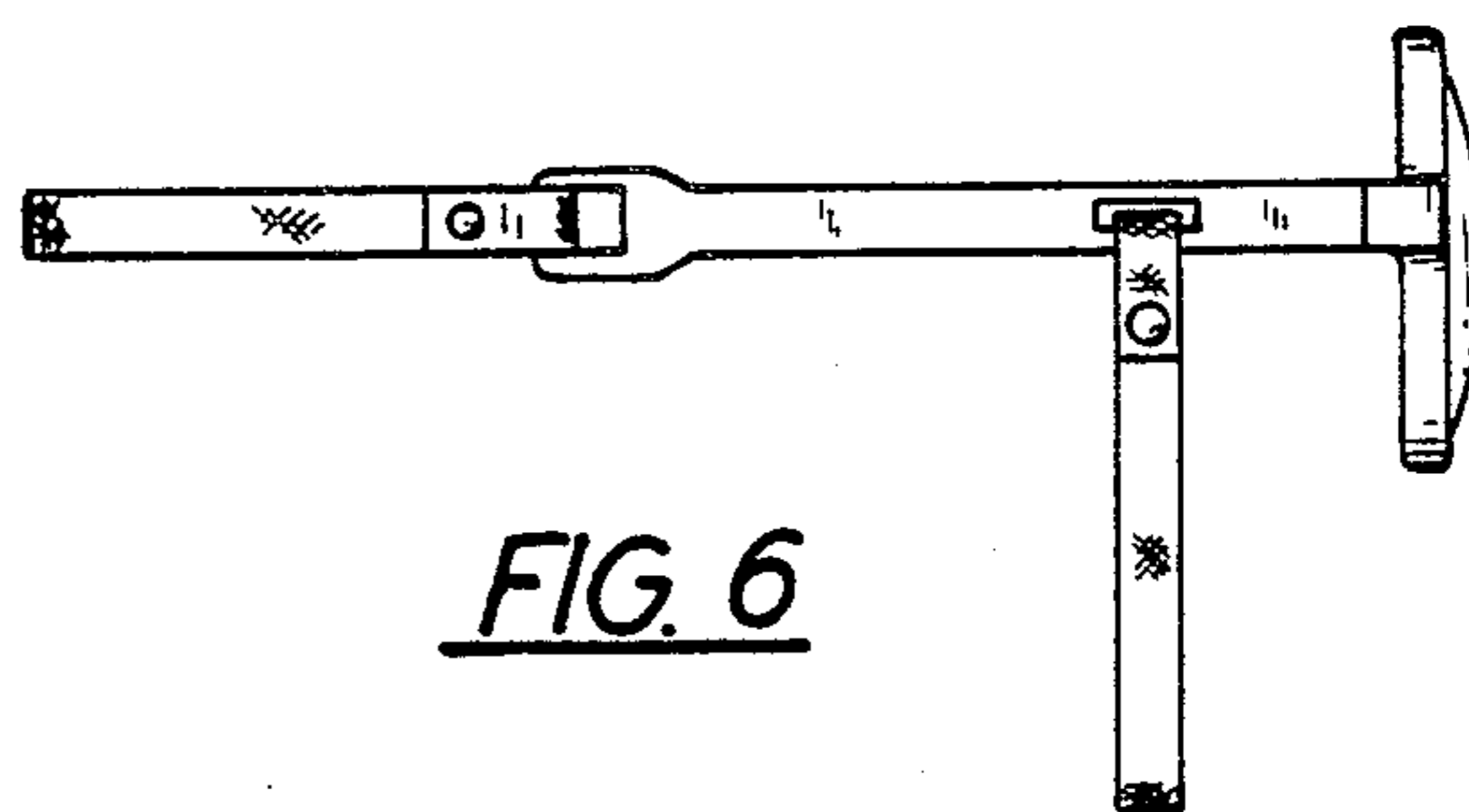

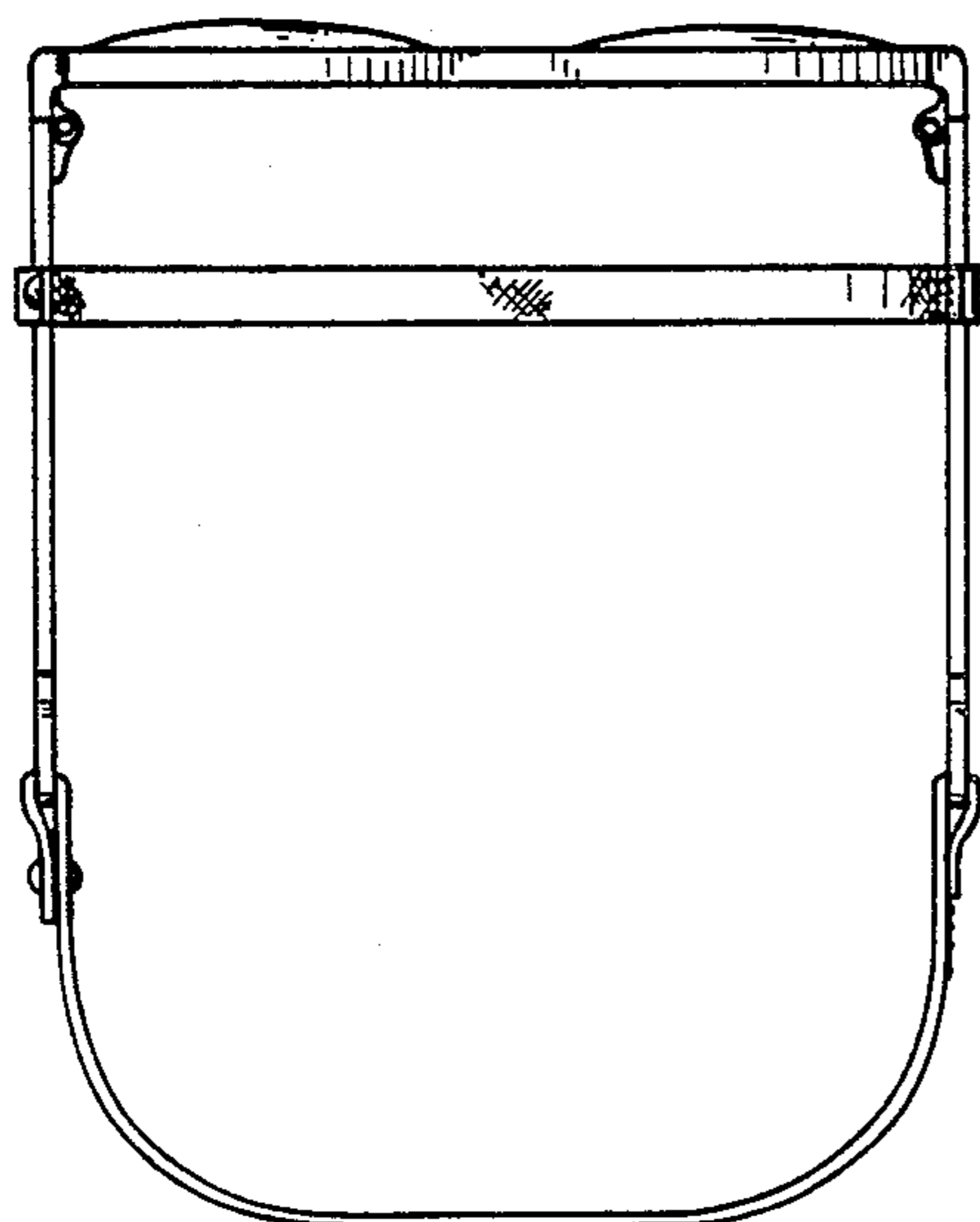

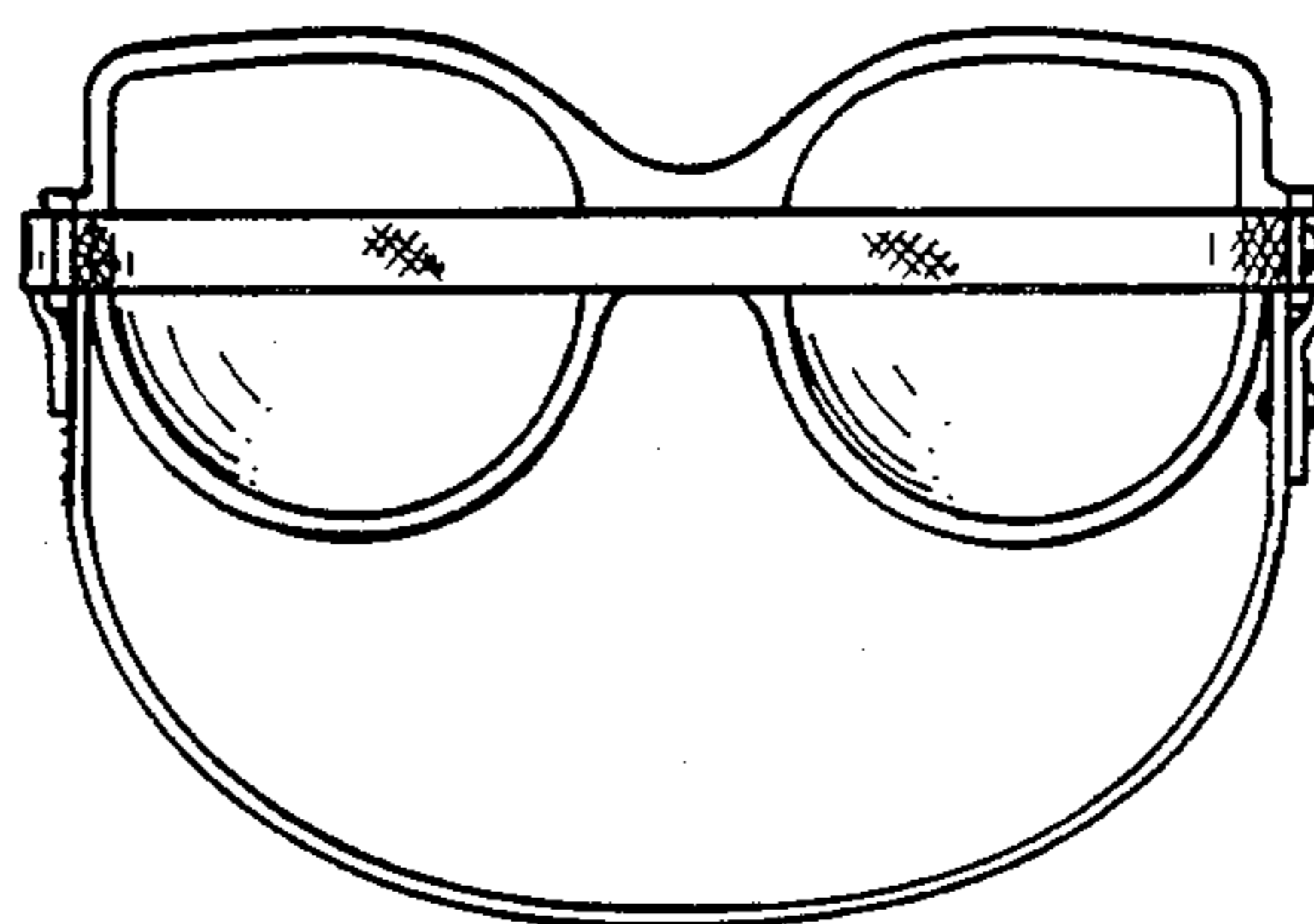
