[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a collapsible watering can or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left side perspective view of a collapsible watering can or similar article showing my new design, with the can shown filled with water; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, with the can shown empty; FIG. 3 is a front end elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear end elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof, showing the can collapsed; FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view thereof, showing the can collapsed; and FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

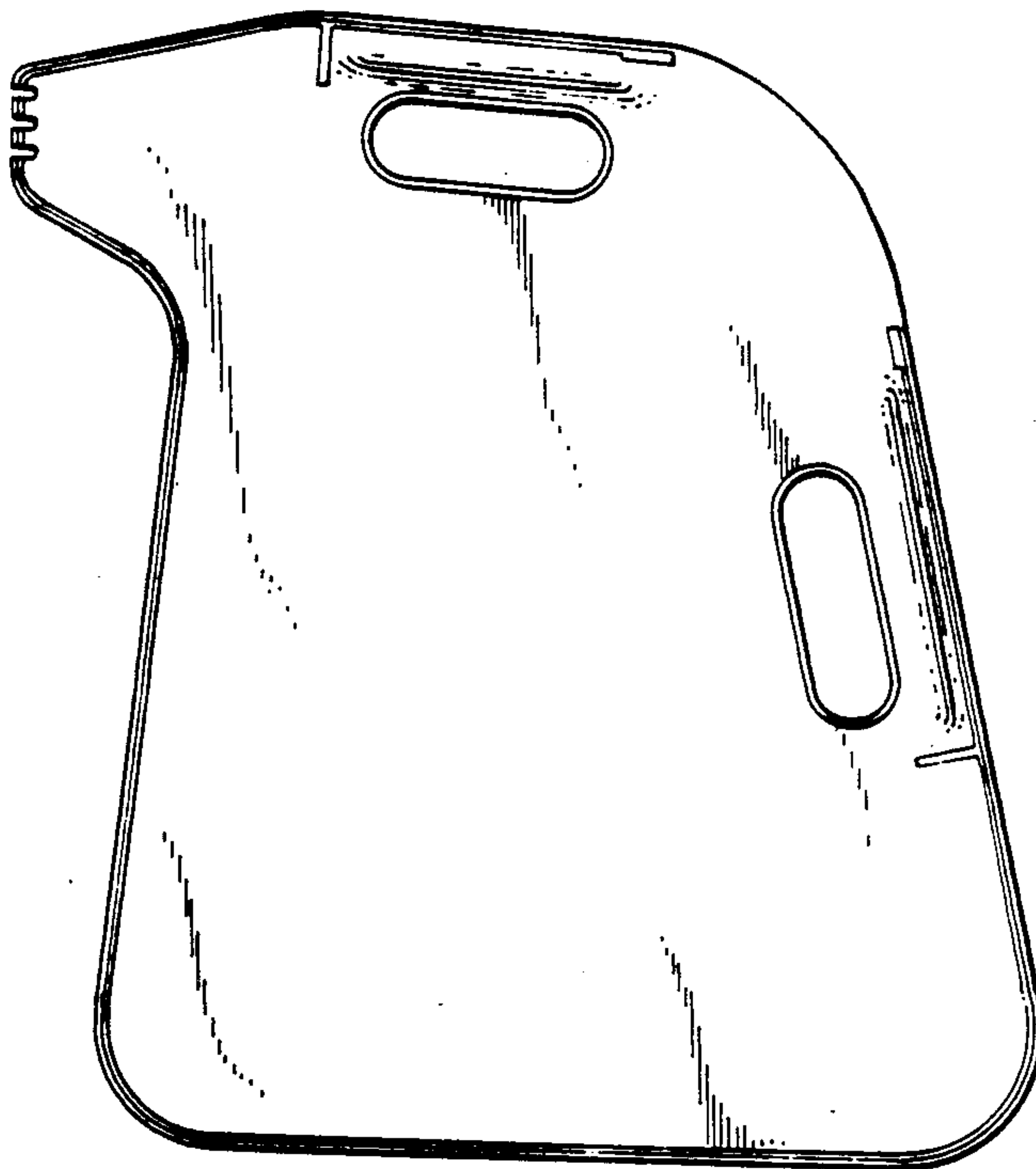

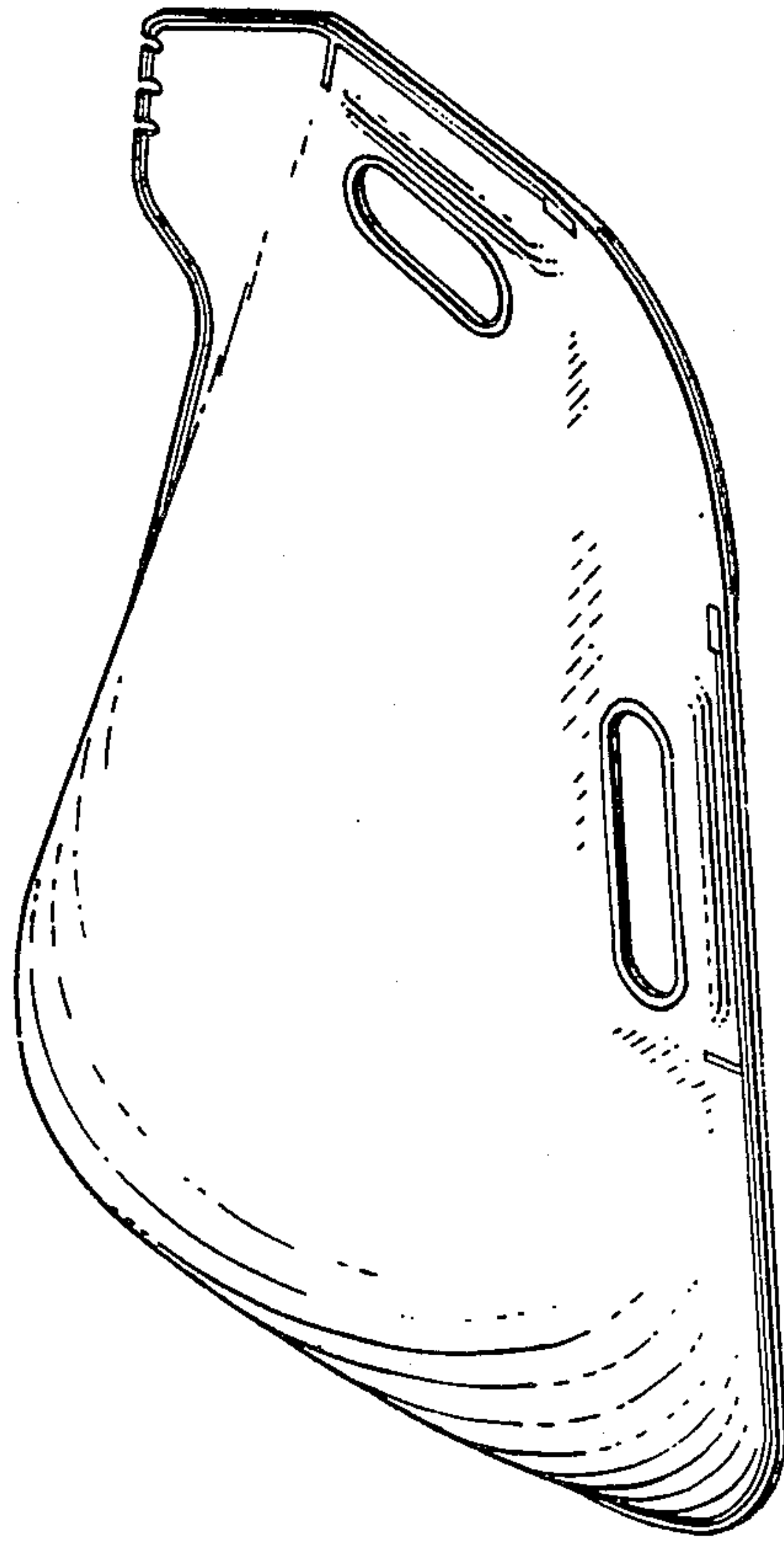

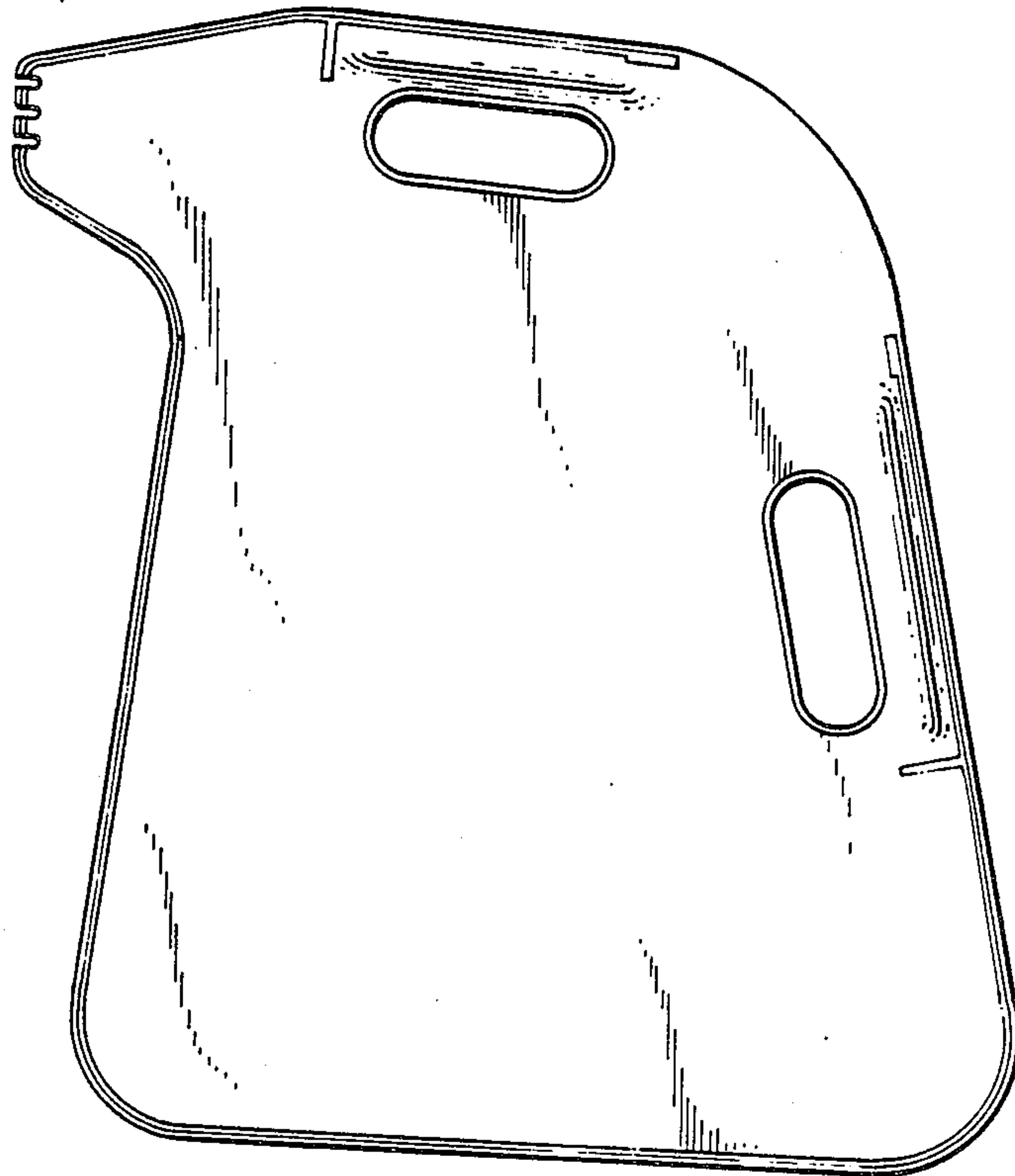

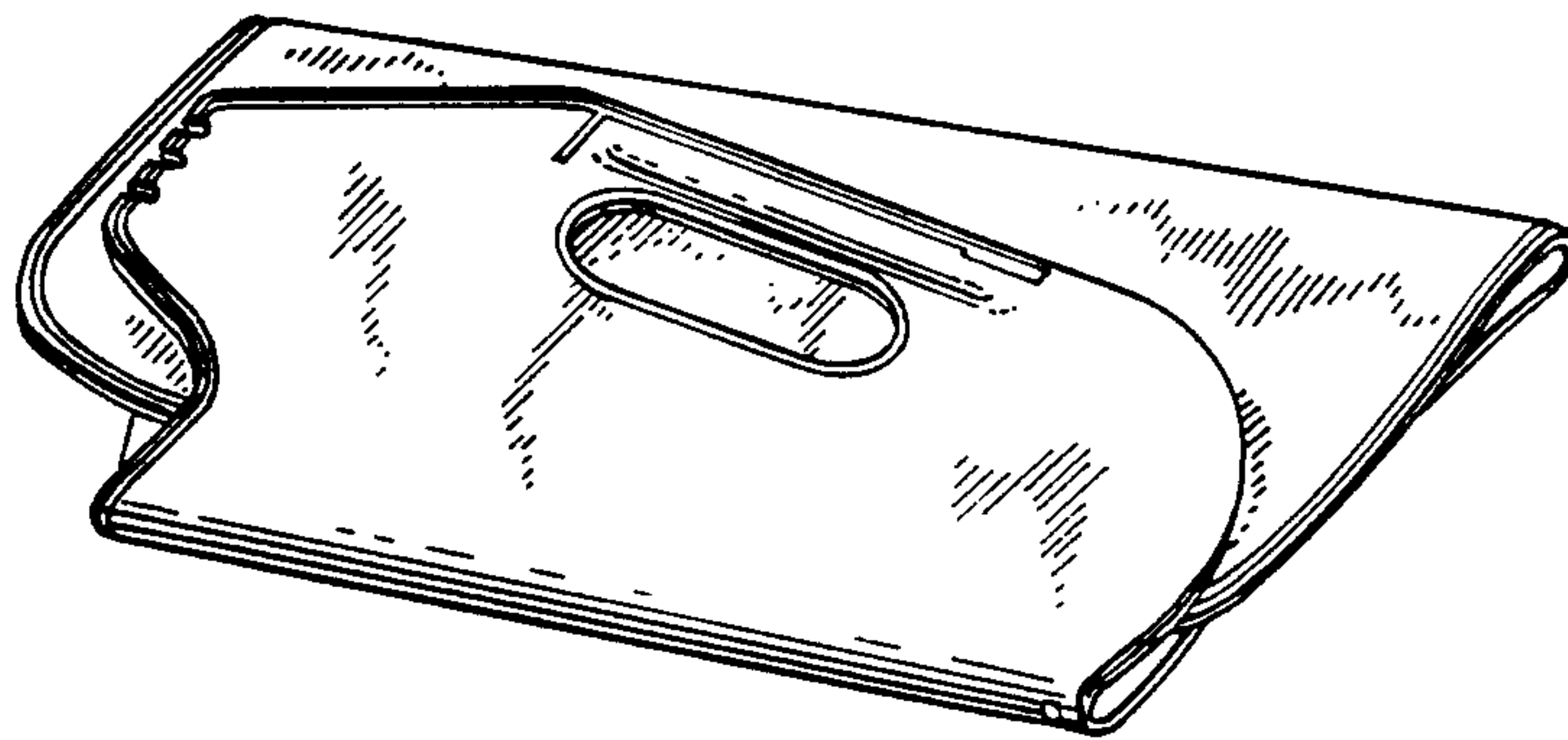

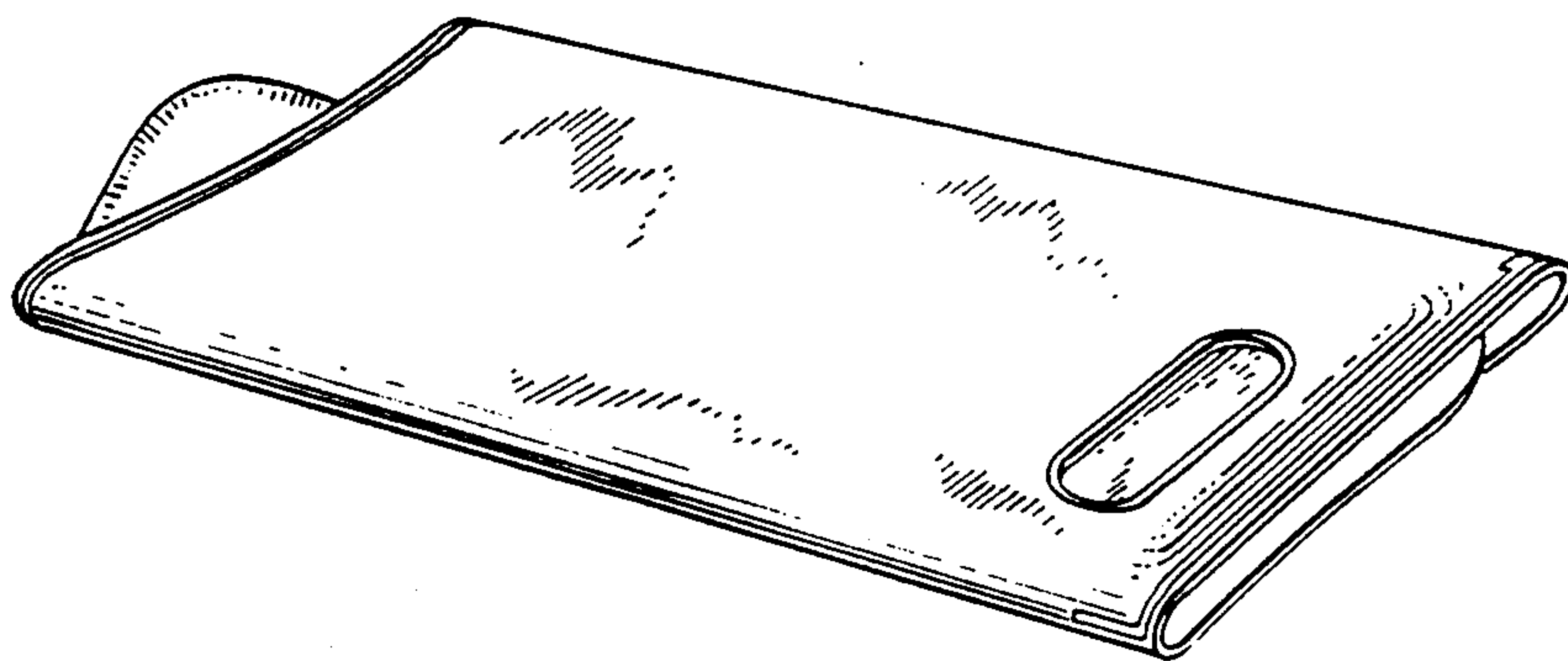
