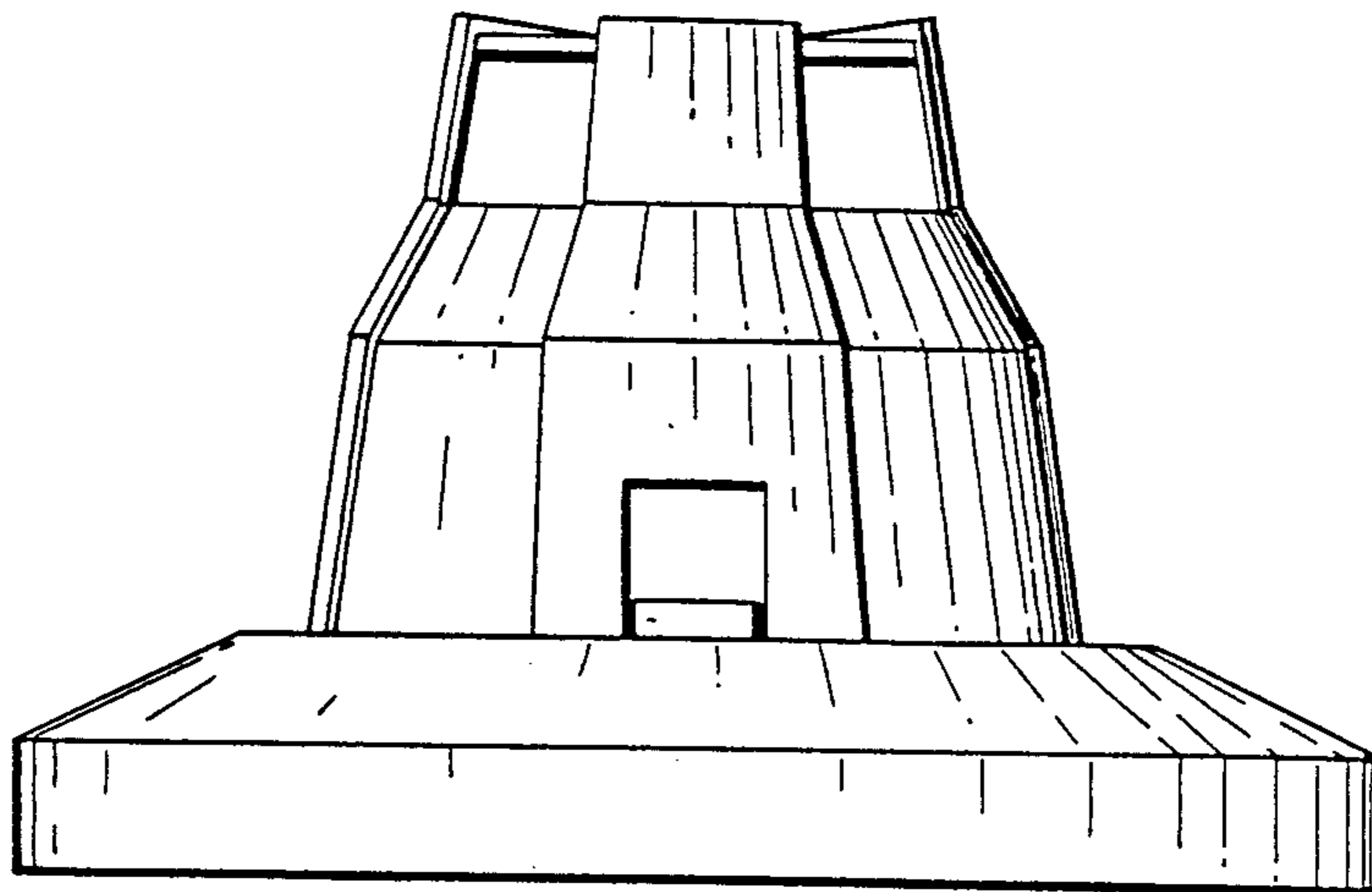

The ornamental design for a smoke detector housing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a smoke detector housing, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear elevation being identical thereto;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view, the left side being identical thereto.



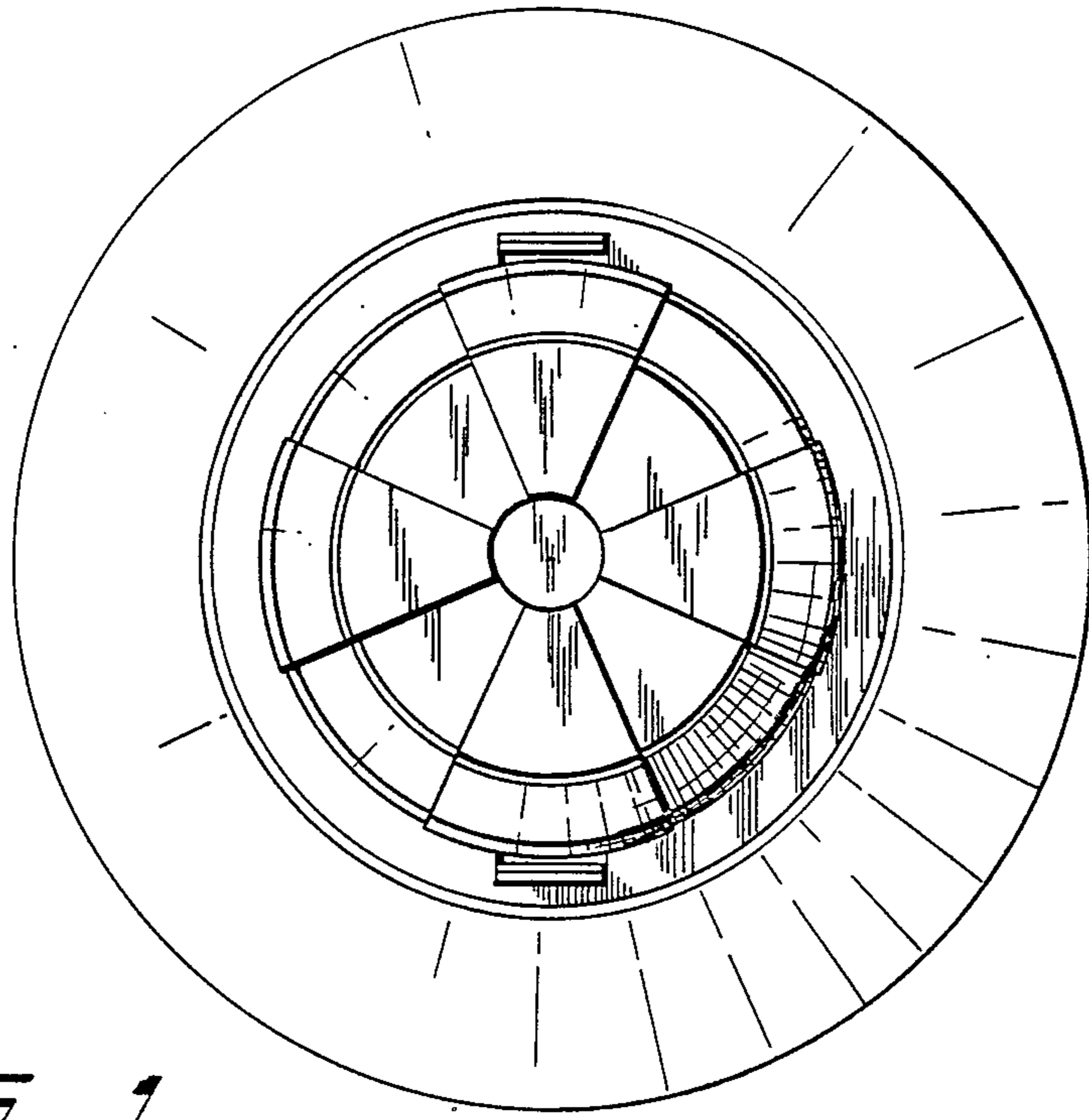

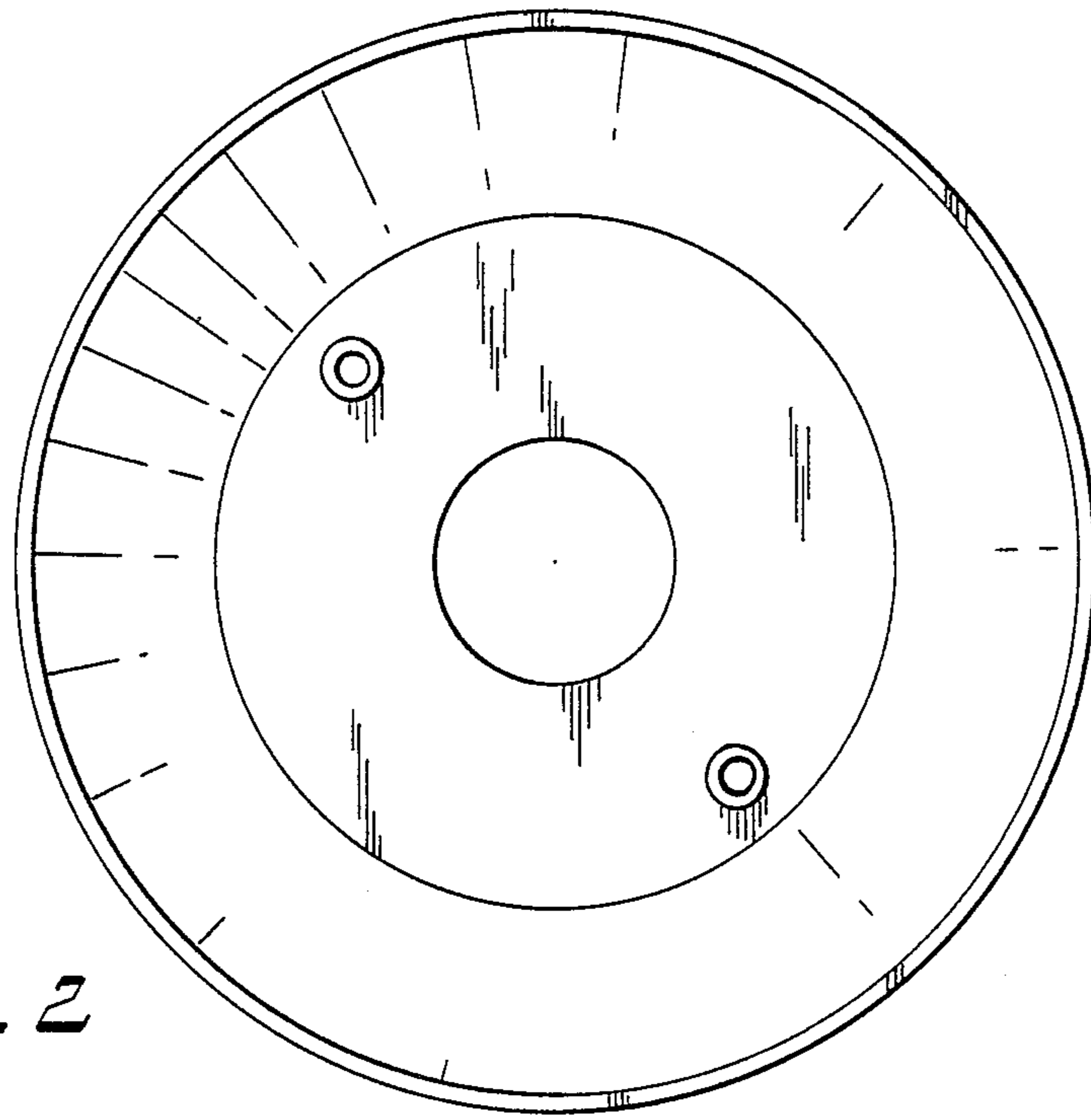

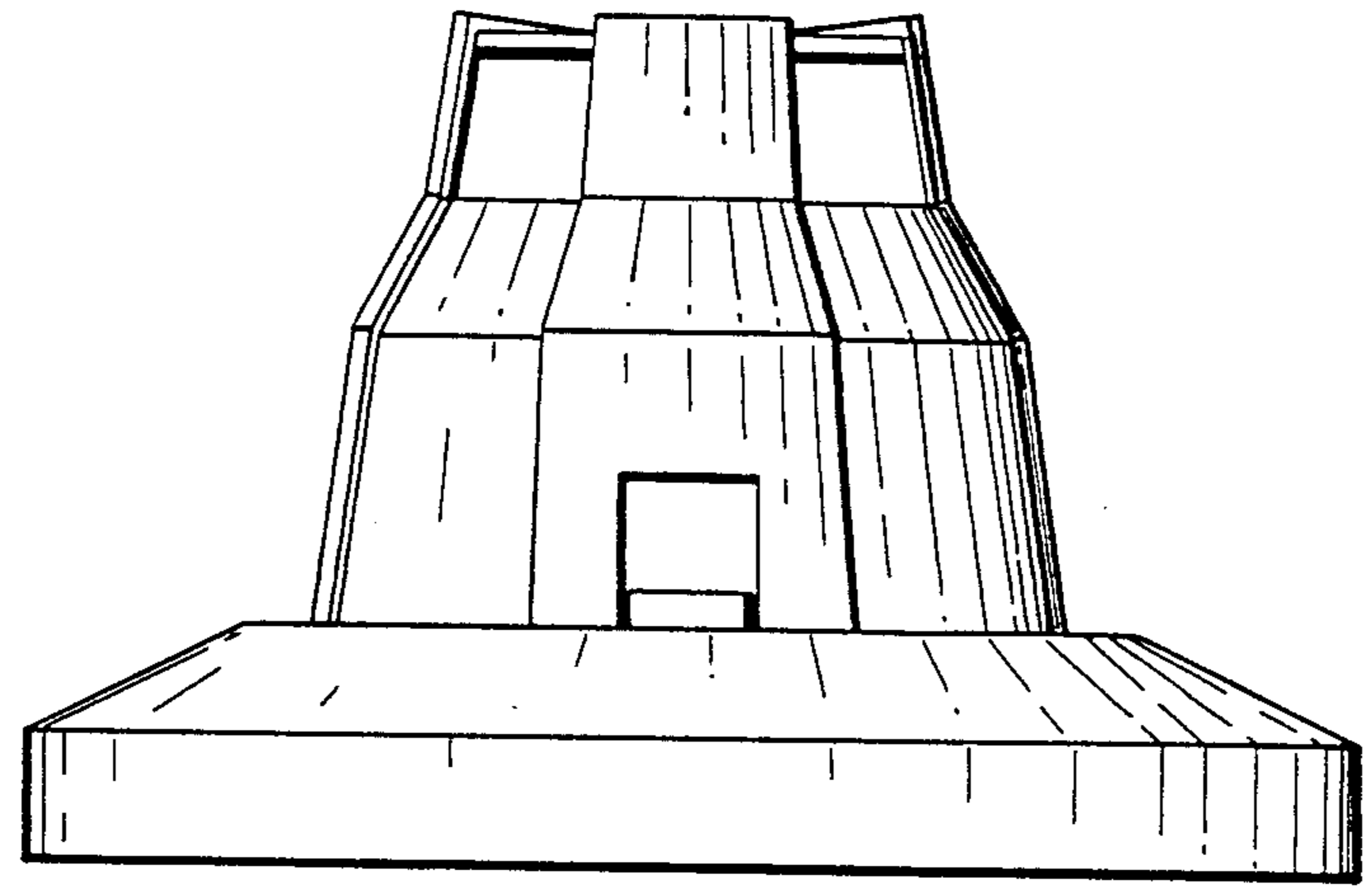

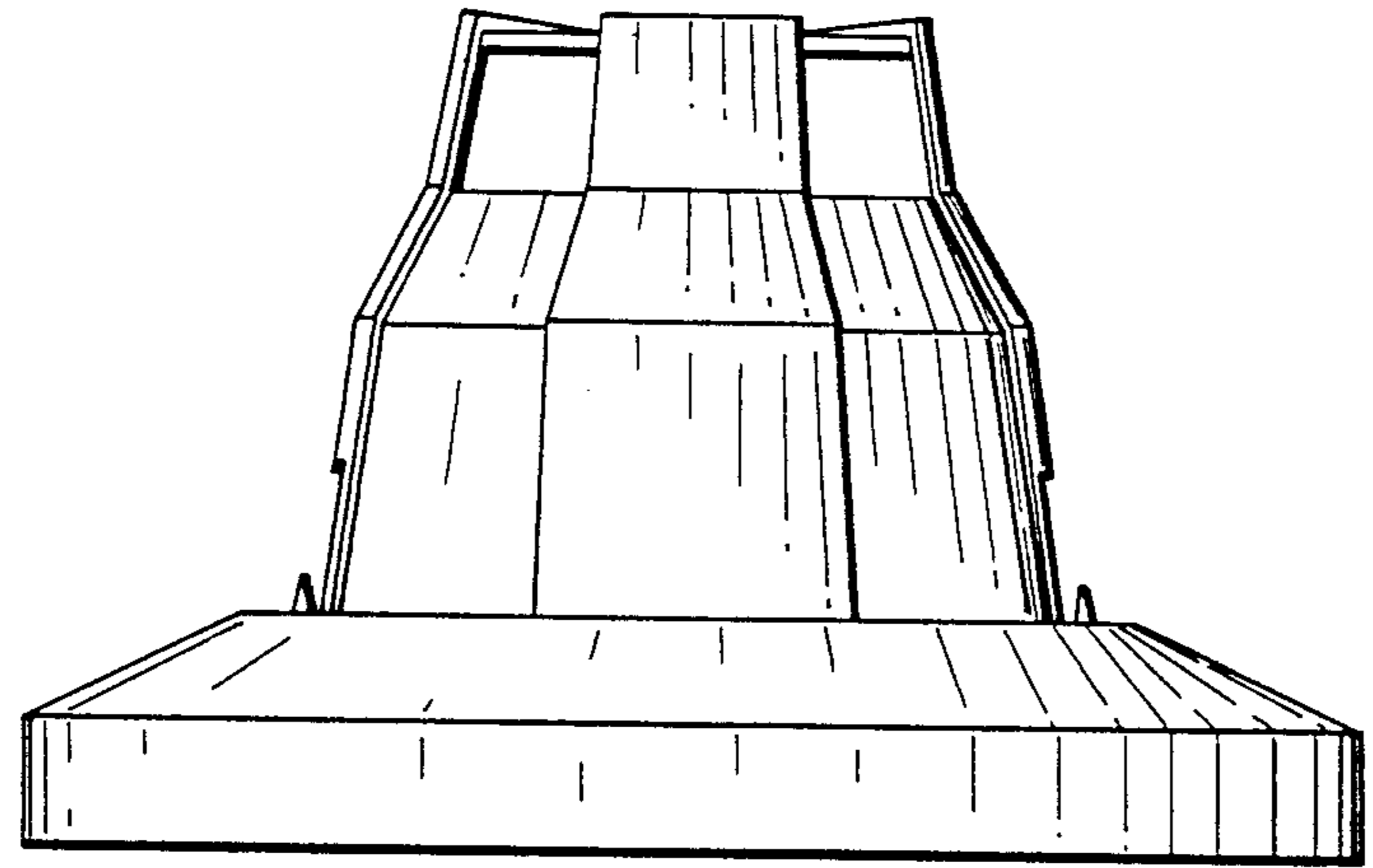
