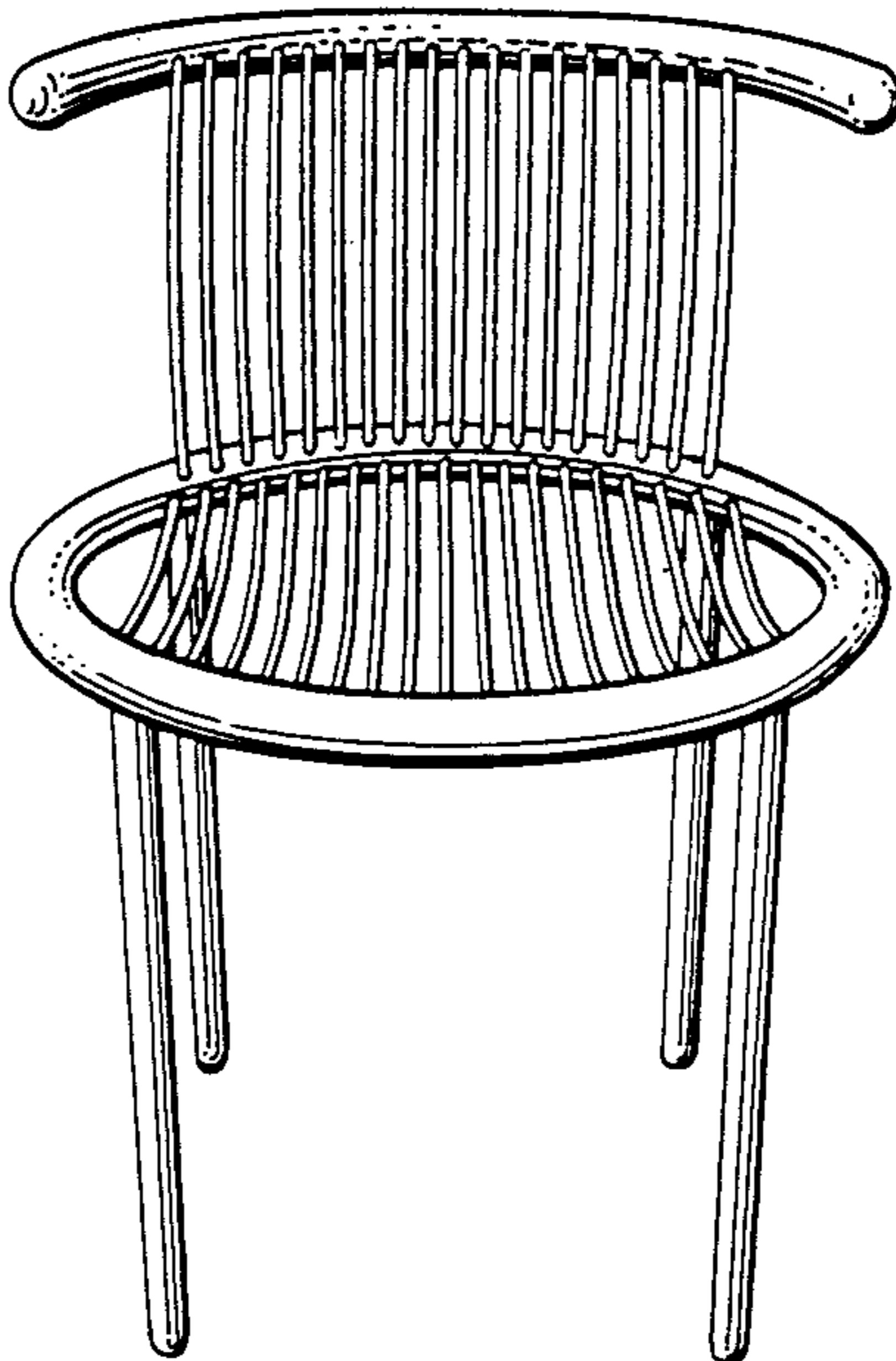

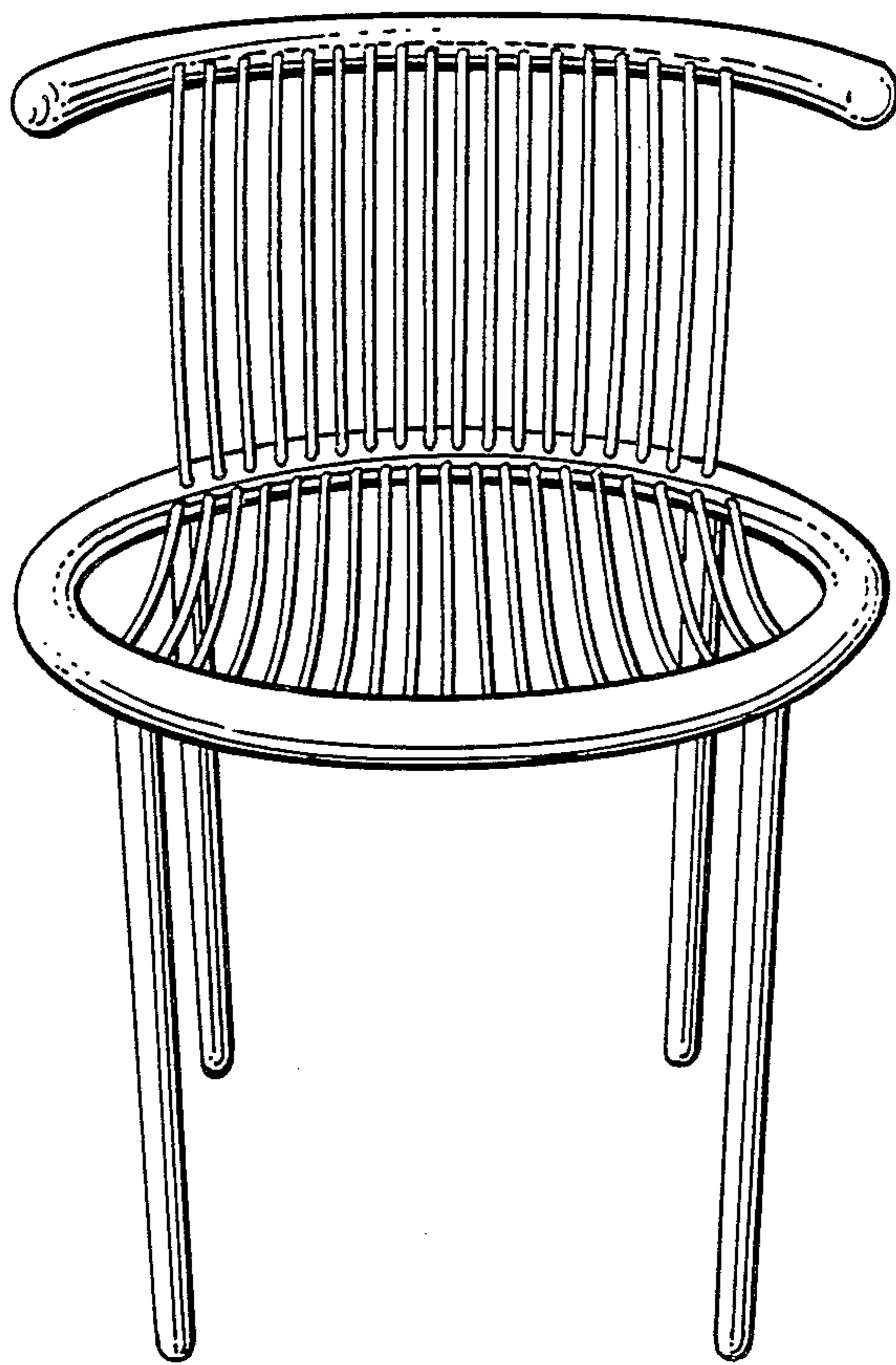

shown and described.

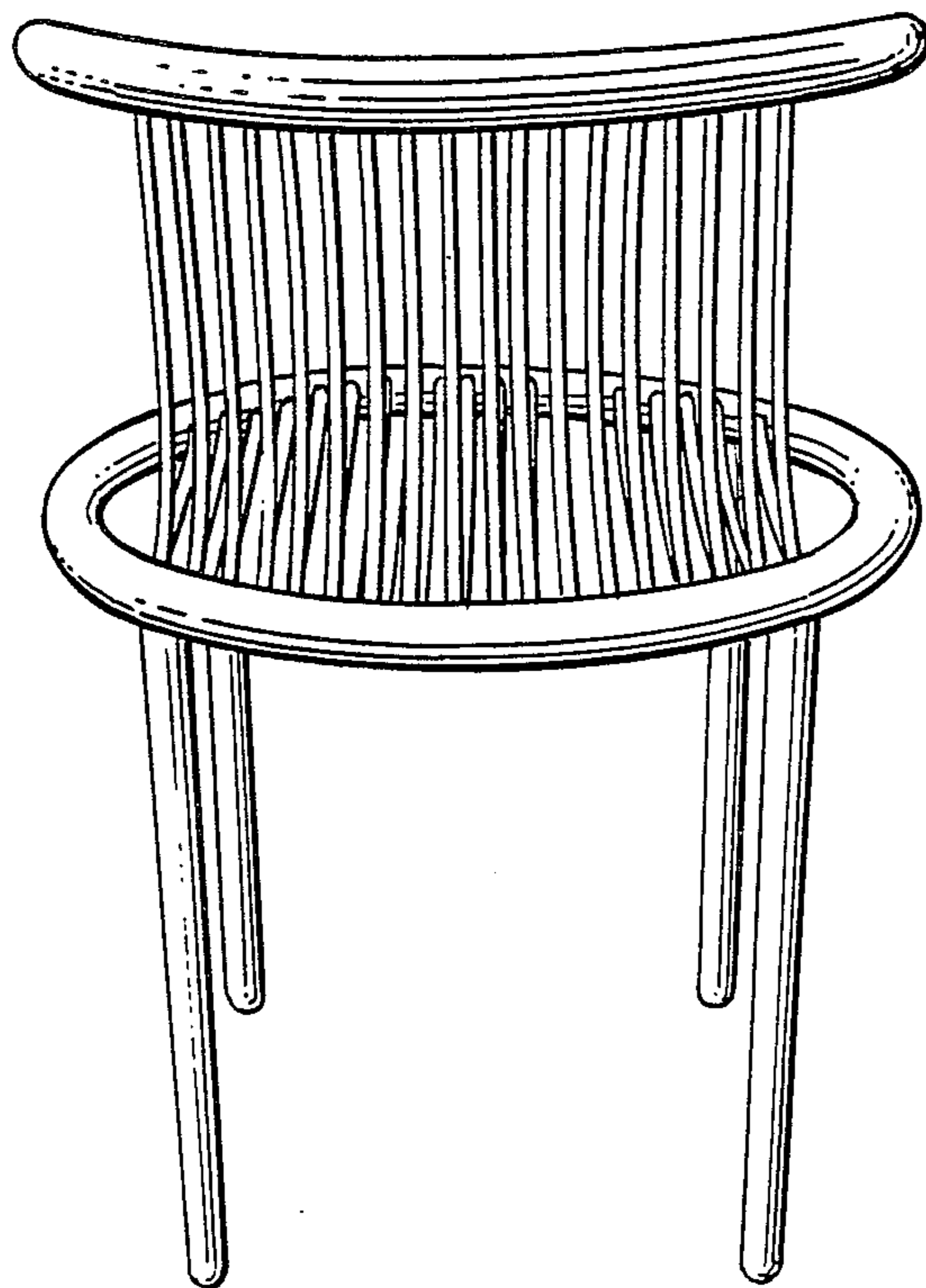
## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

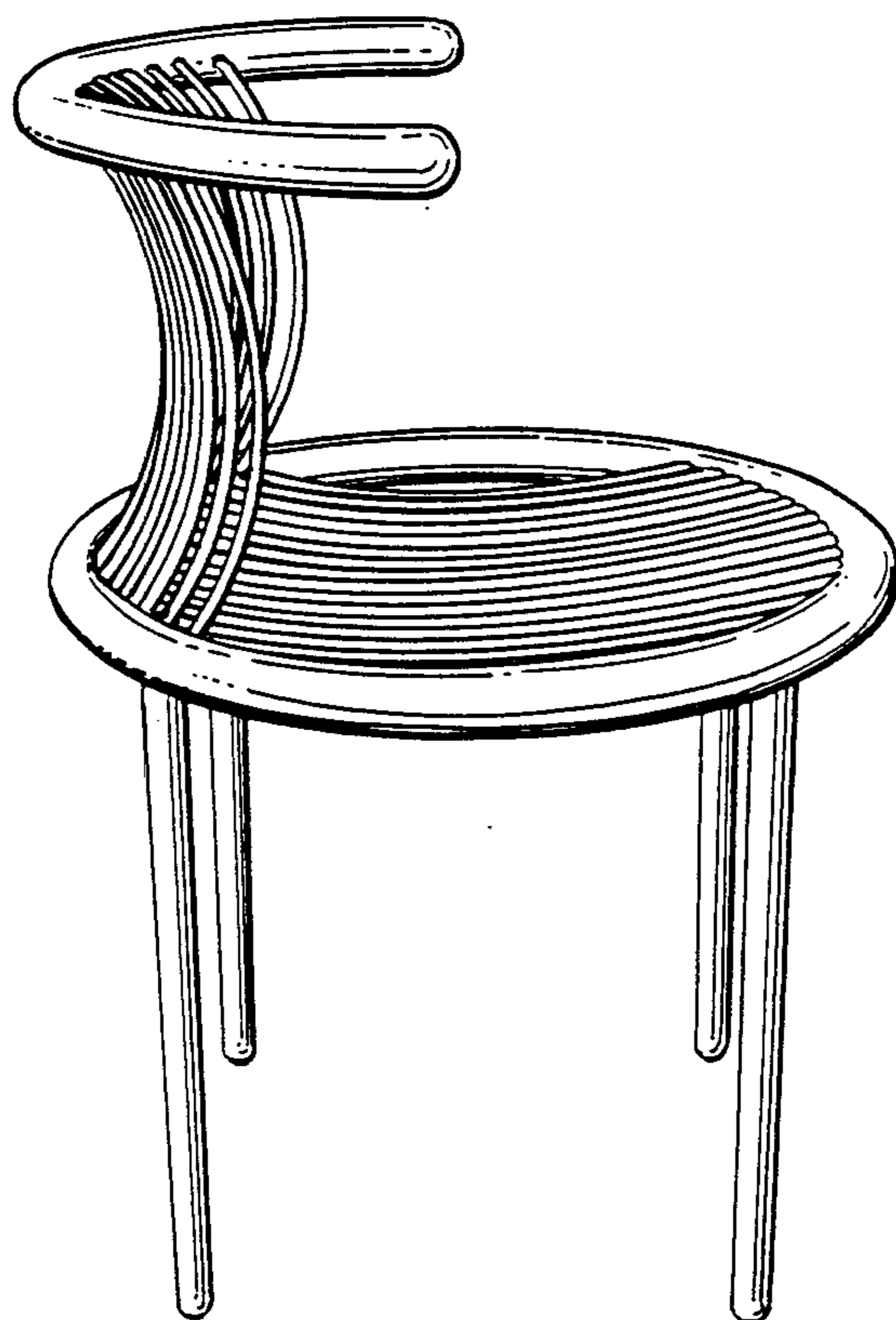




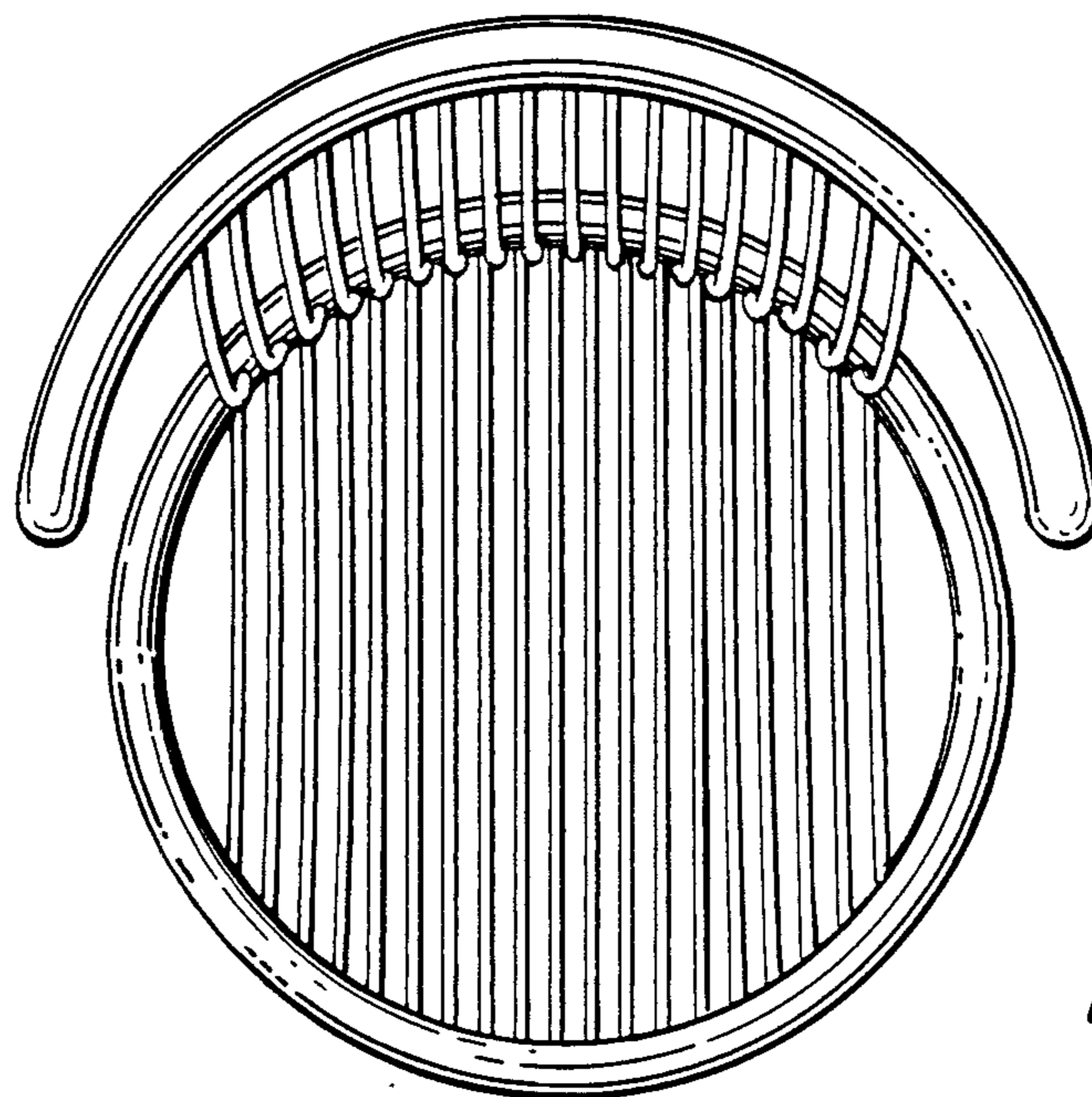

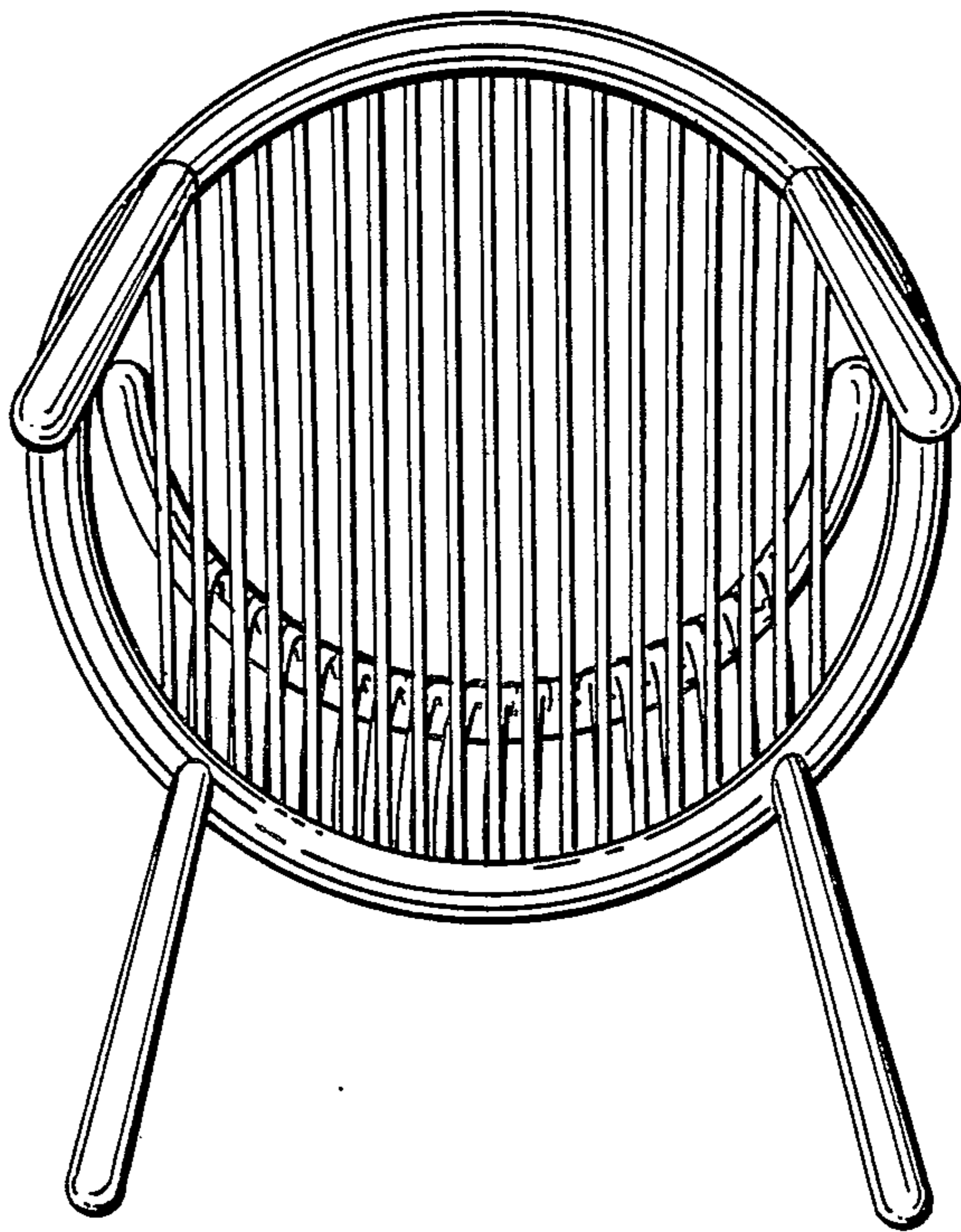
