The ornamental design for an activity desk, as shown.

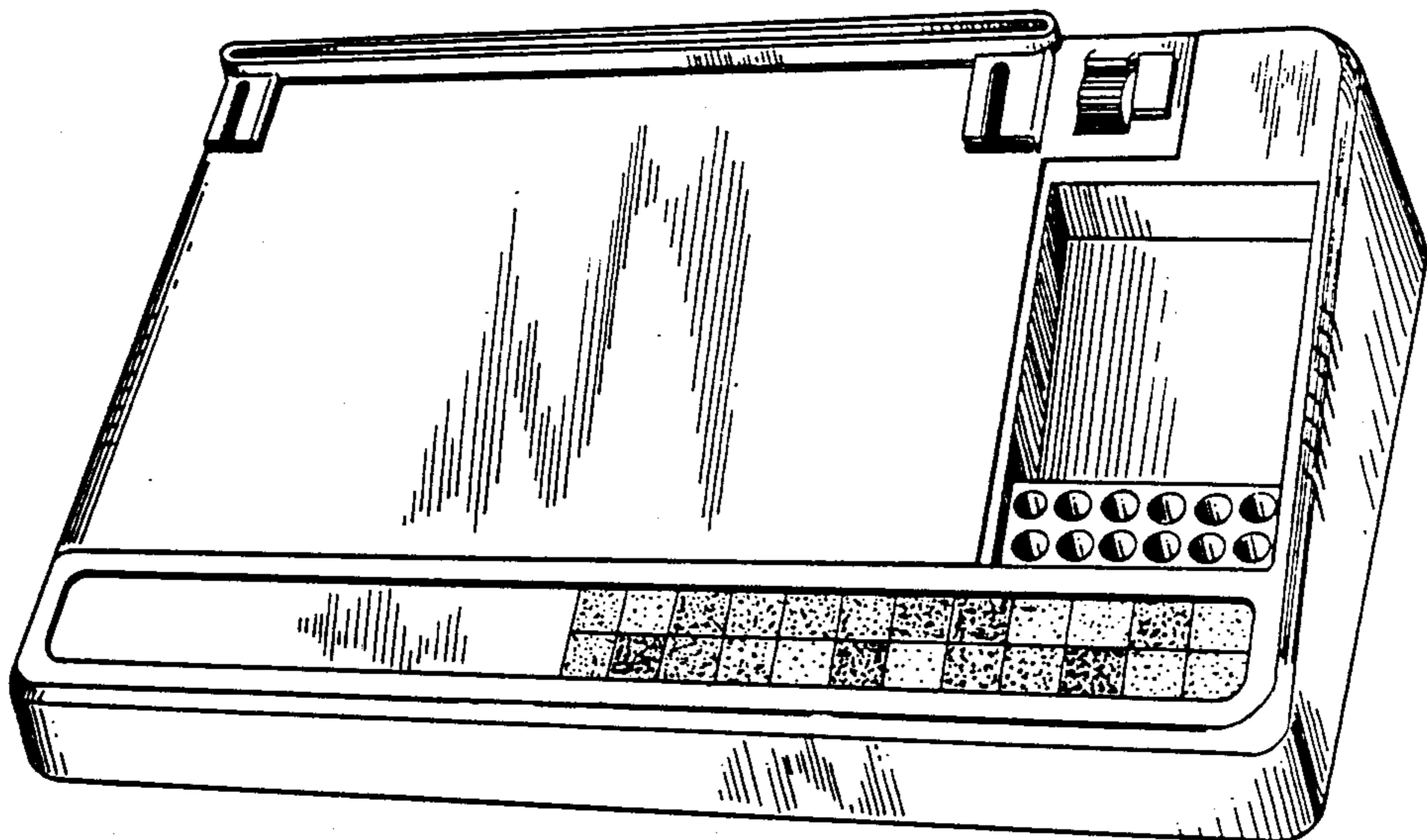
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.



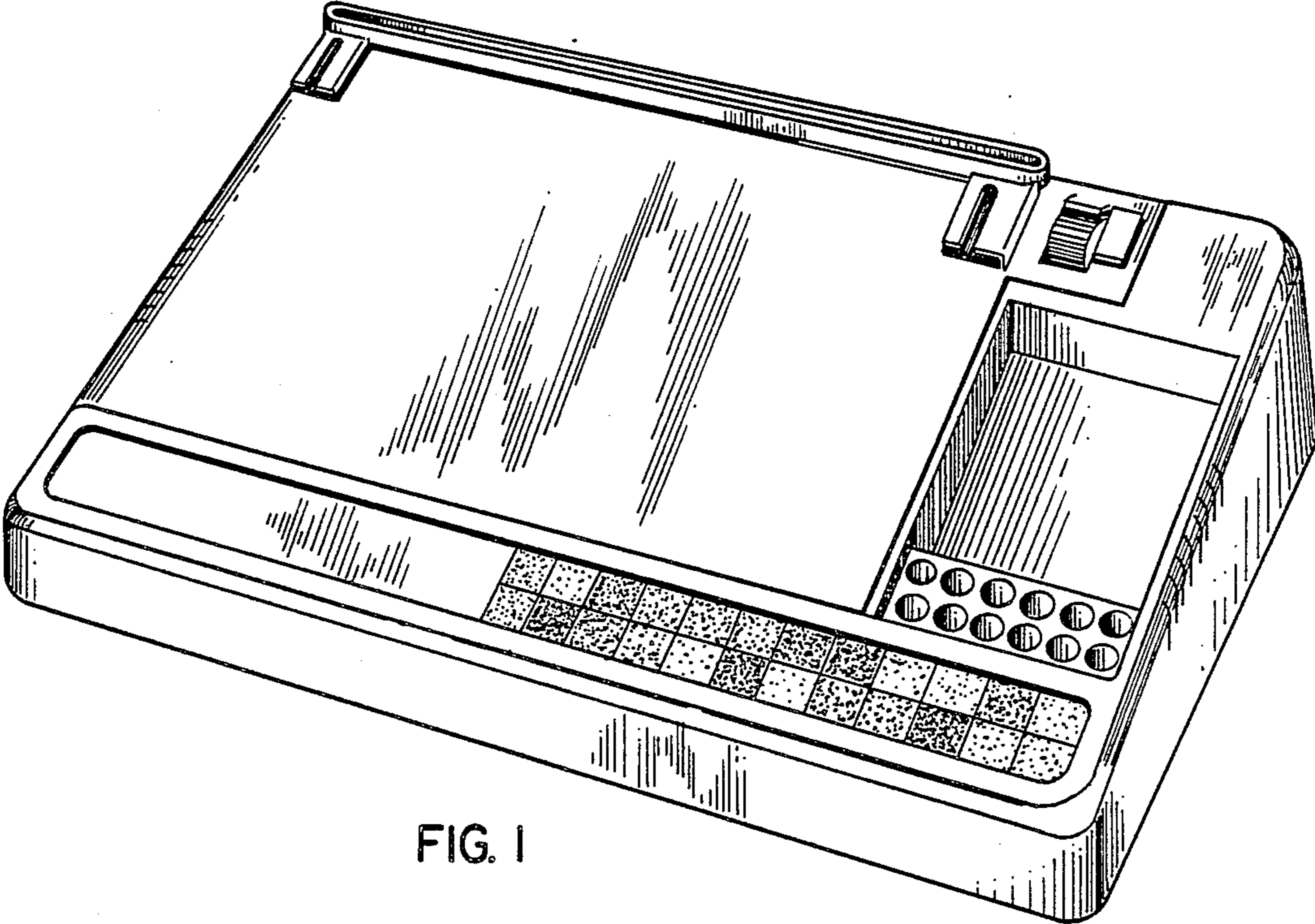

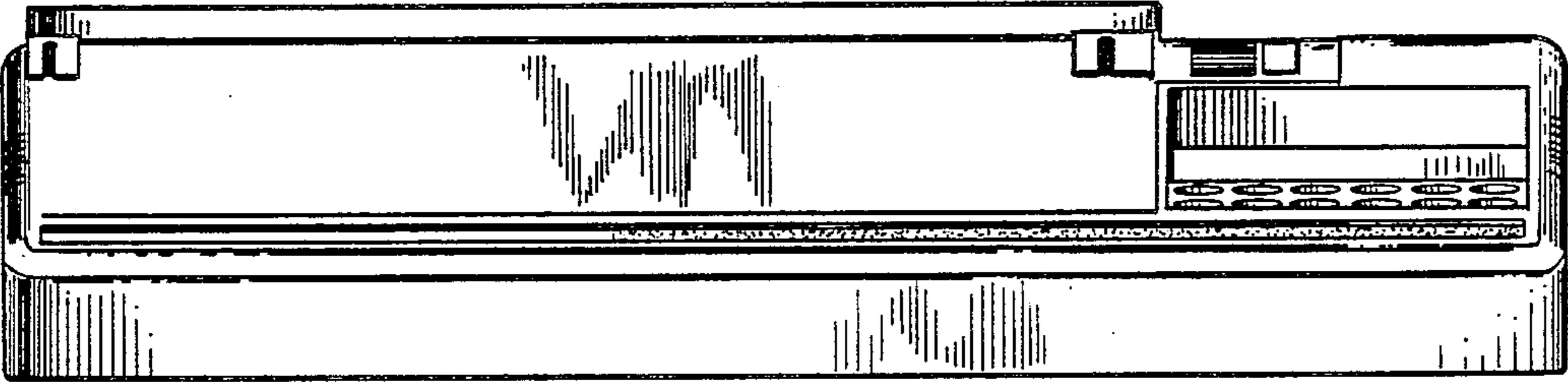

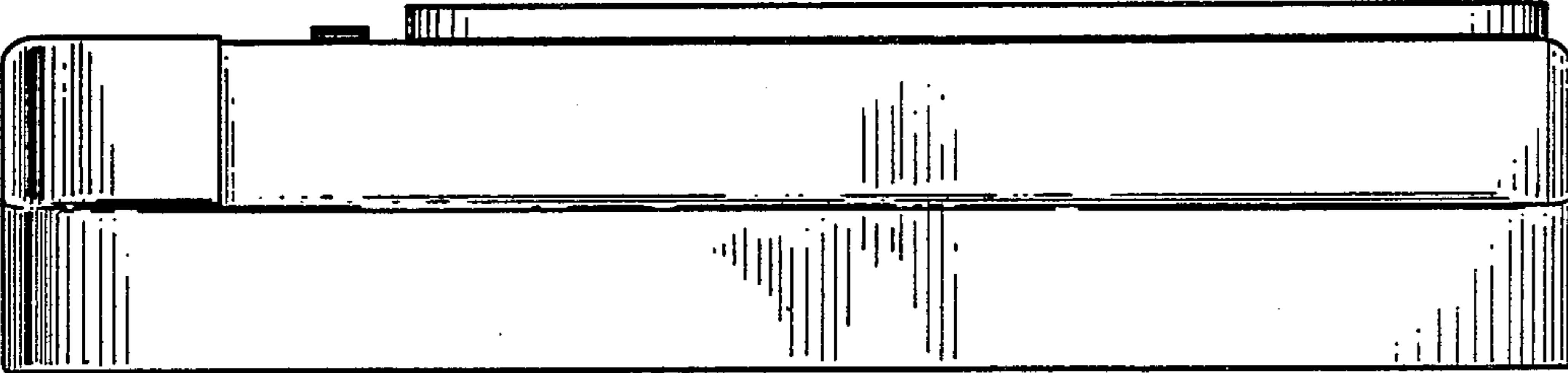

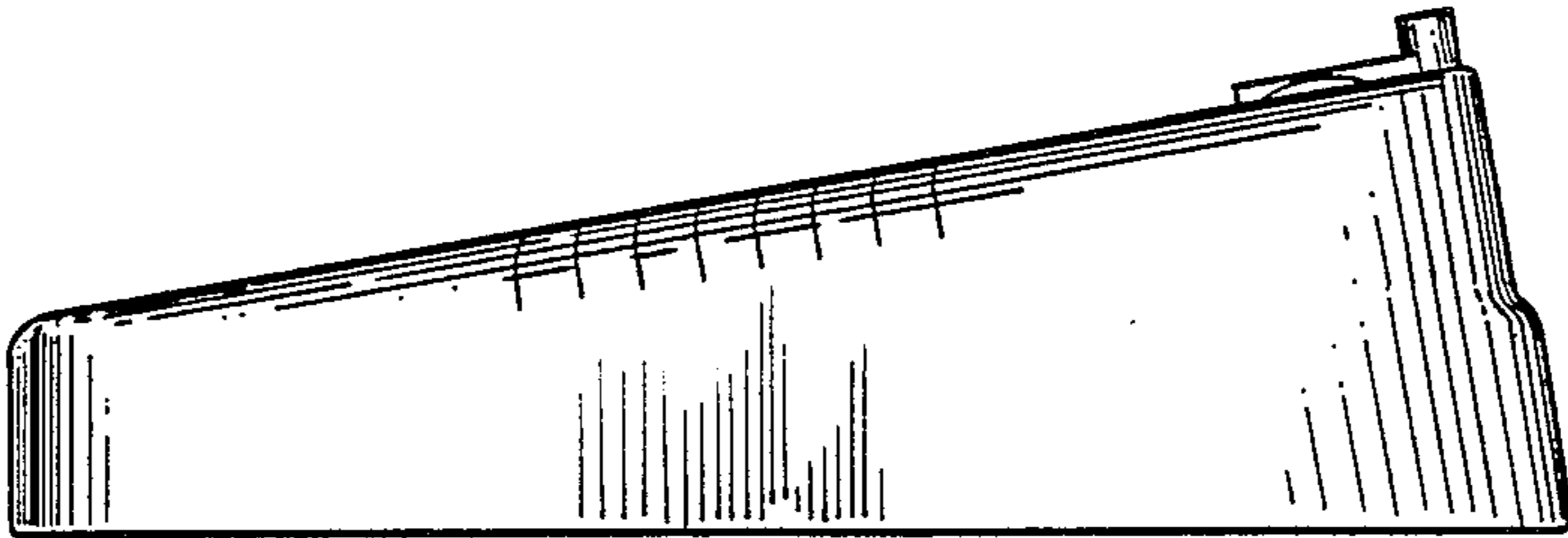
