The ornamental design for a water ski, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a water ski showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image of that shown;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



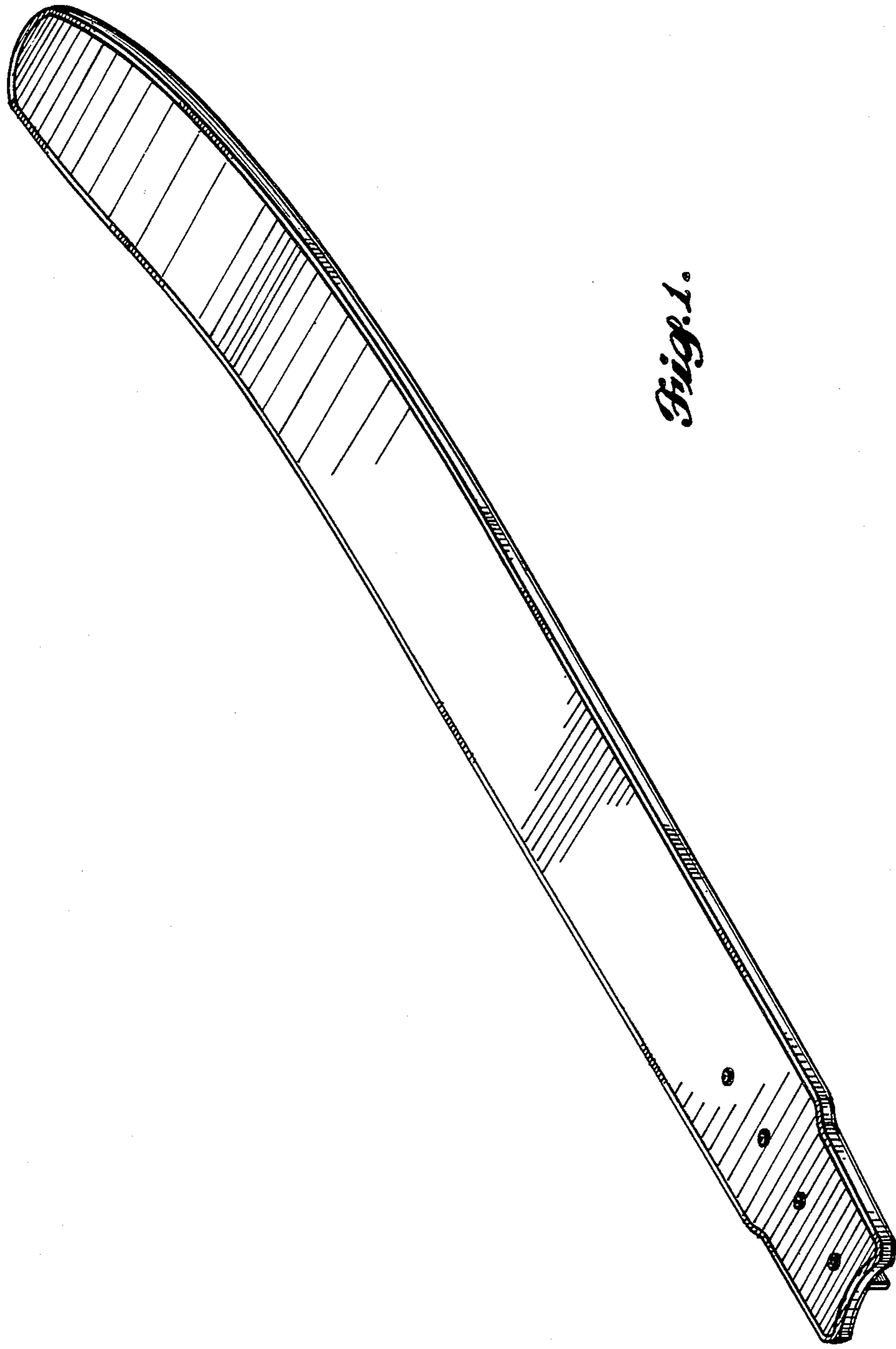

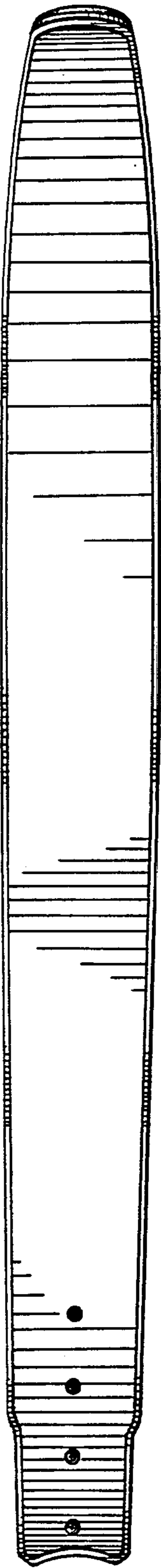

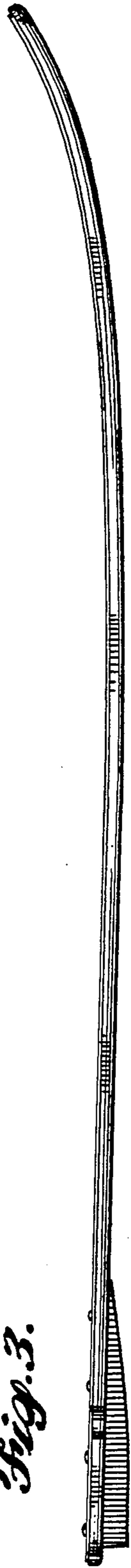

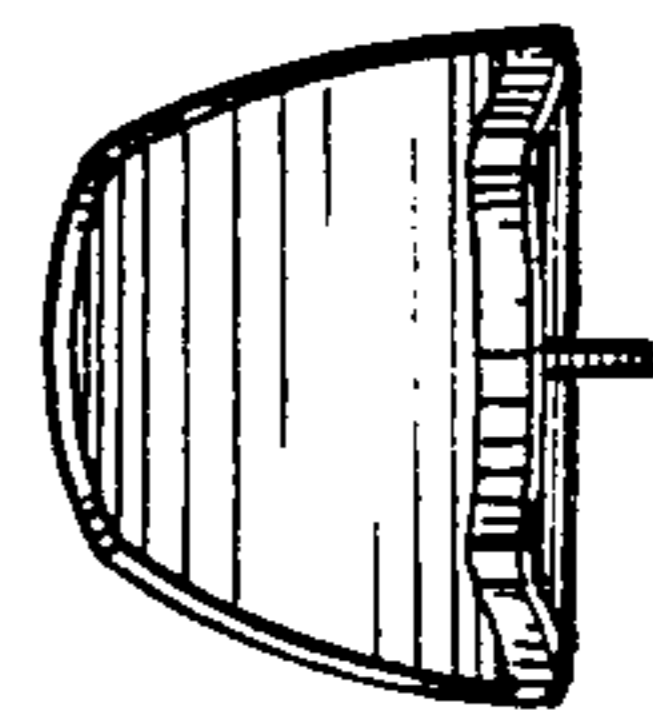
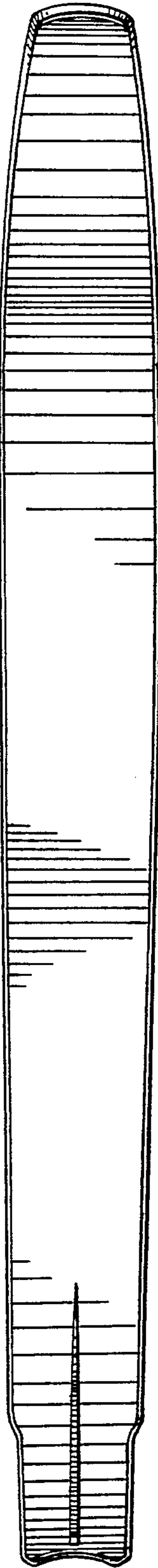

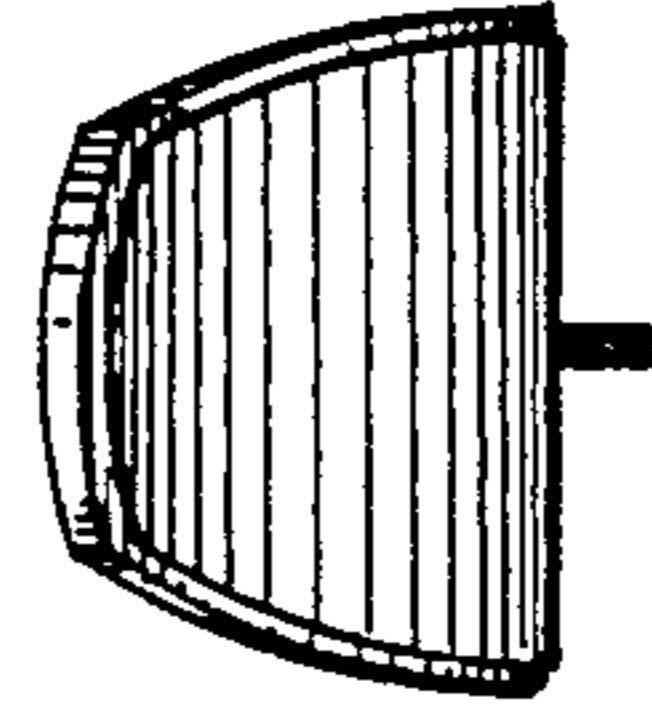
