[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a motorcycle front fender extension, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a motorcycle front fender extension embodying my new design in position of use, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustration purposes only, the right side elevational view being substantially a mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

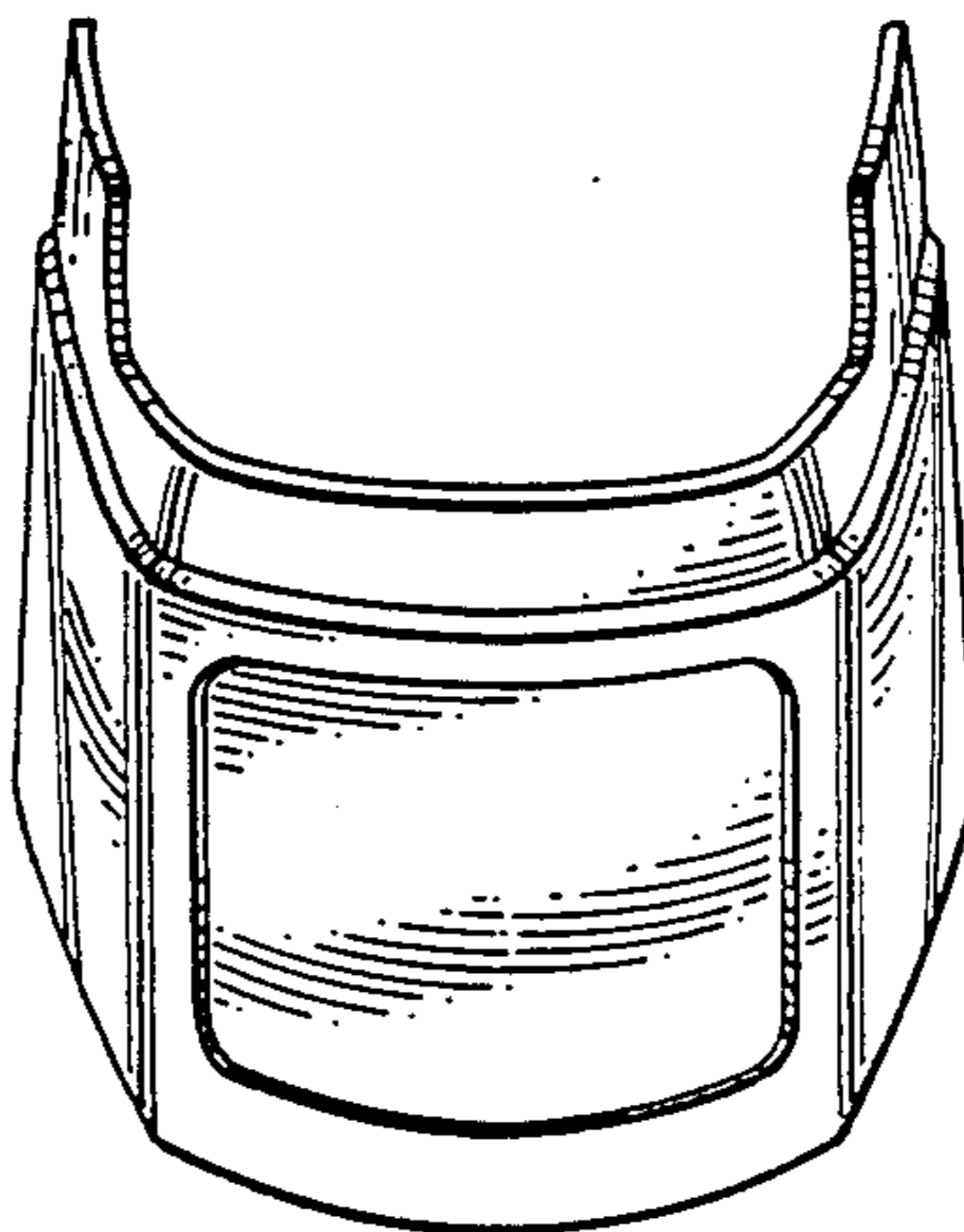

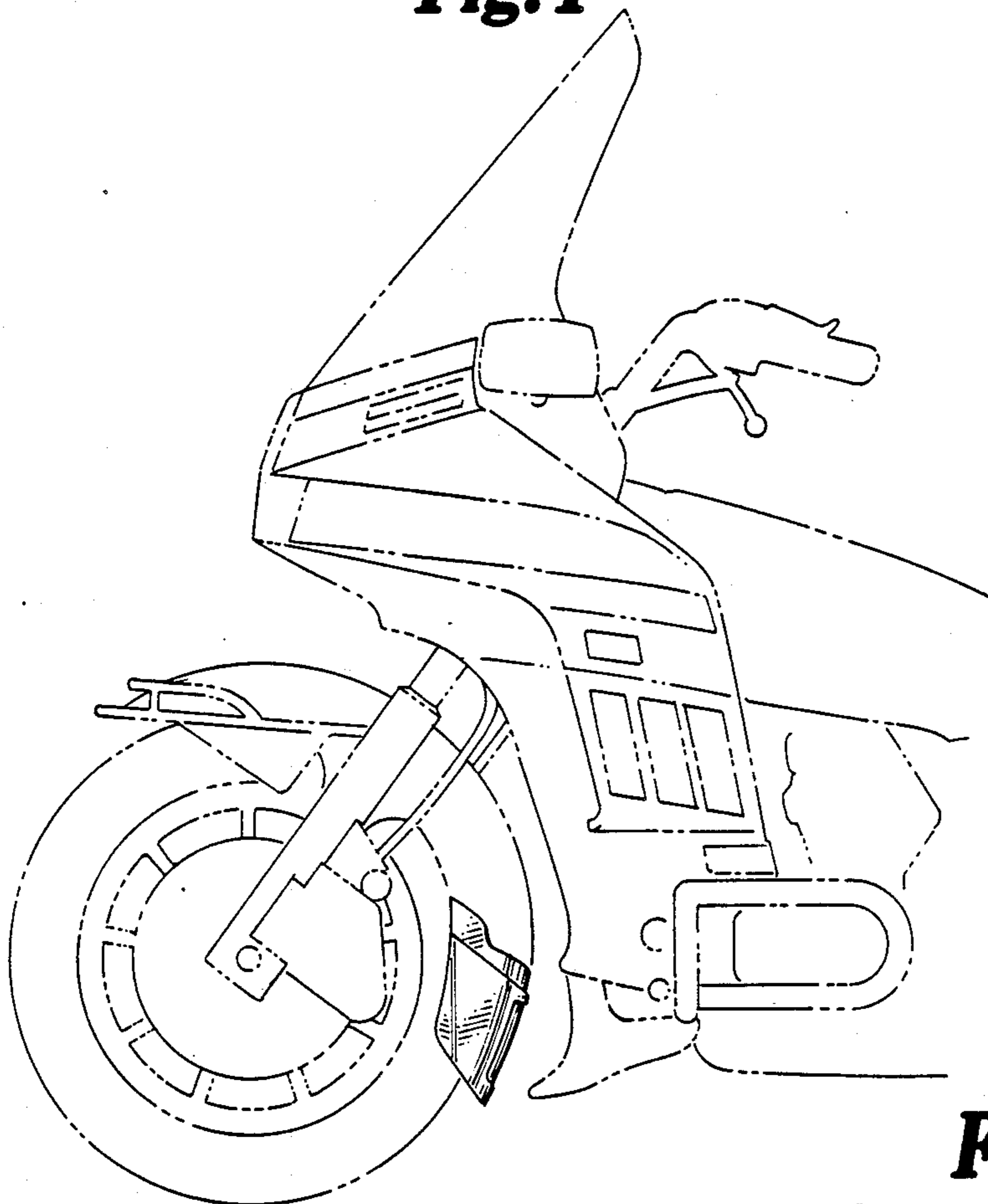

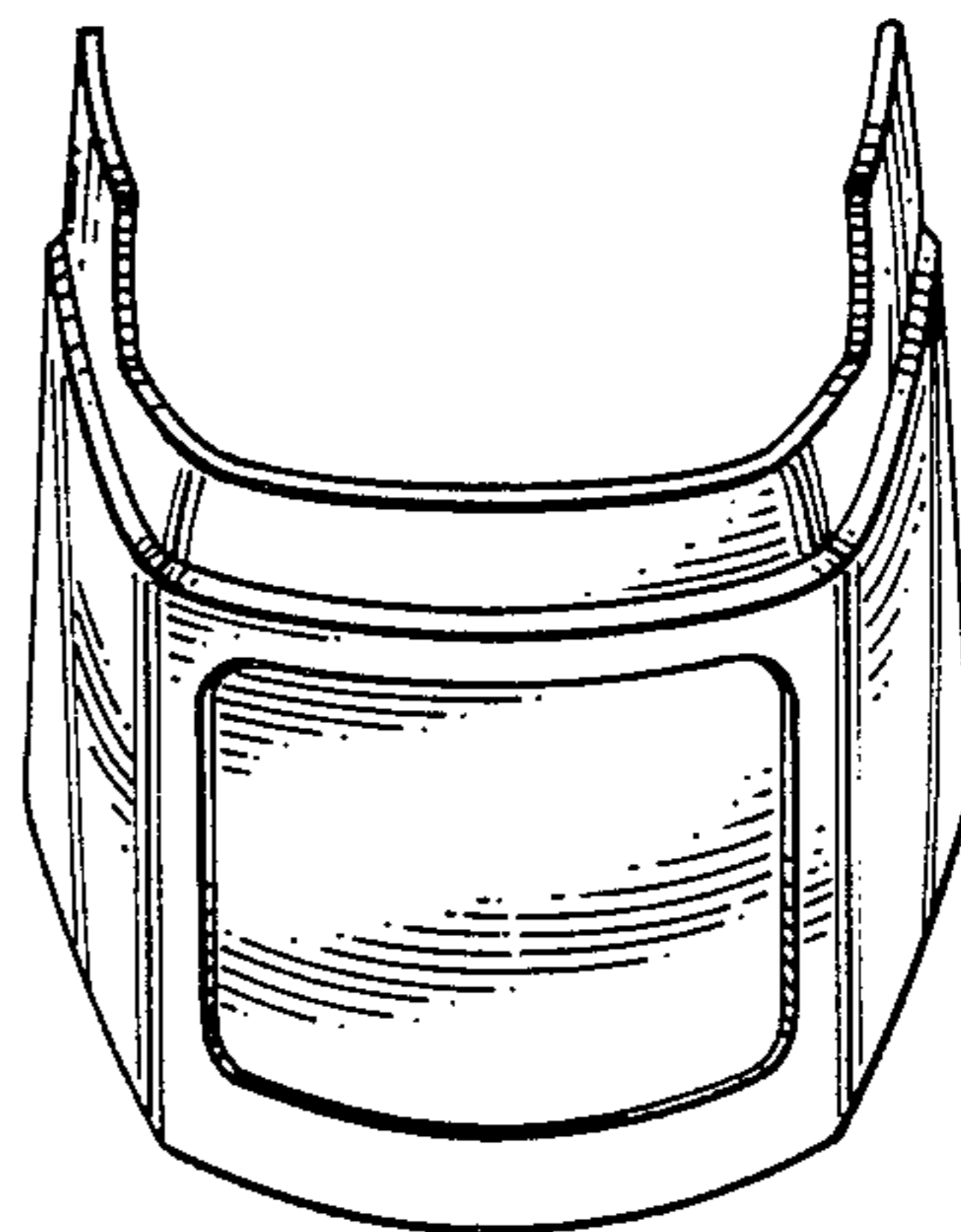

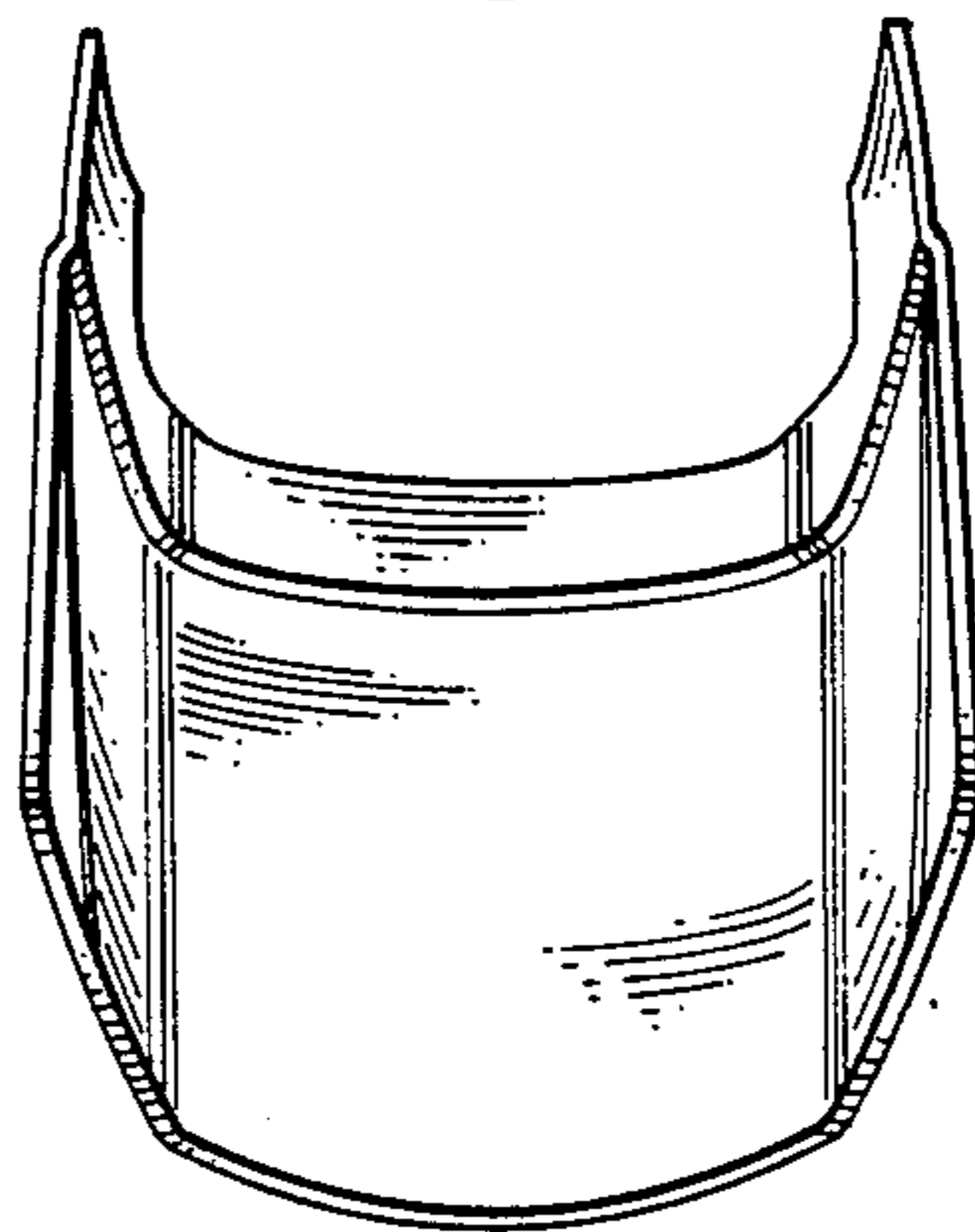

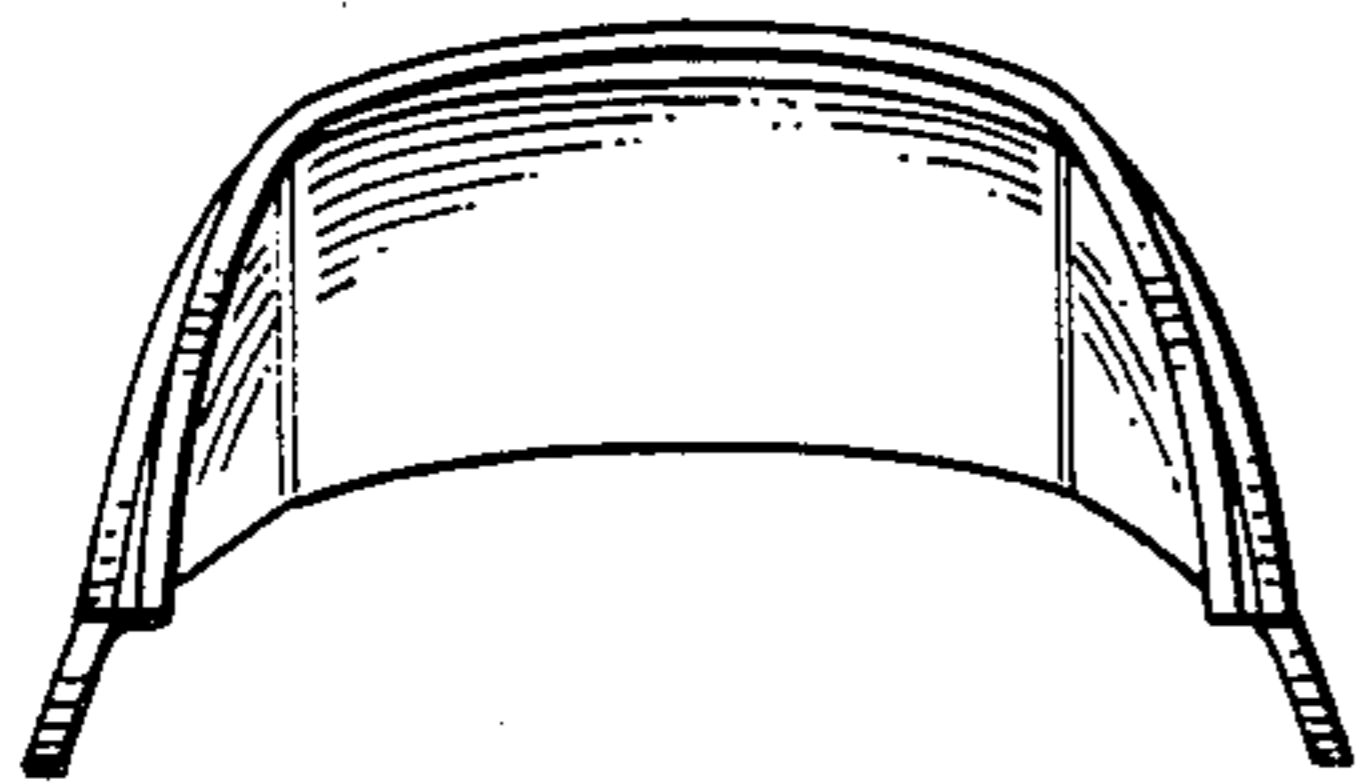
