The ornamental design for a combined latch lock and cover, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined latch lock and cover, showing my new design, with the cover closed and the broken-line showing of the latch element being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof with the cover open;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof with the cover closed;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof with the cover open;


FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof with the cover closed;


FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof with the cover open;


FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof with the cover open; and


FIG. 9 is a right elevational view thereof with the cover open, and the left side being a mirror image.



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







