DESCRIPTION

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

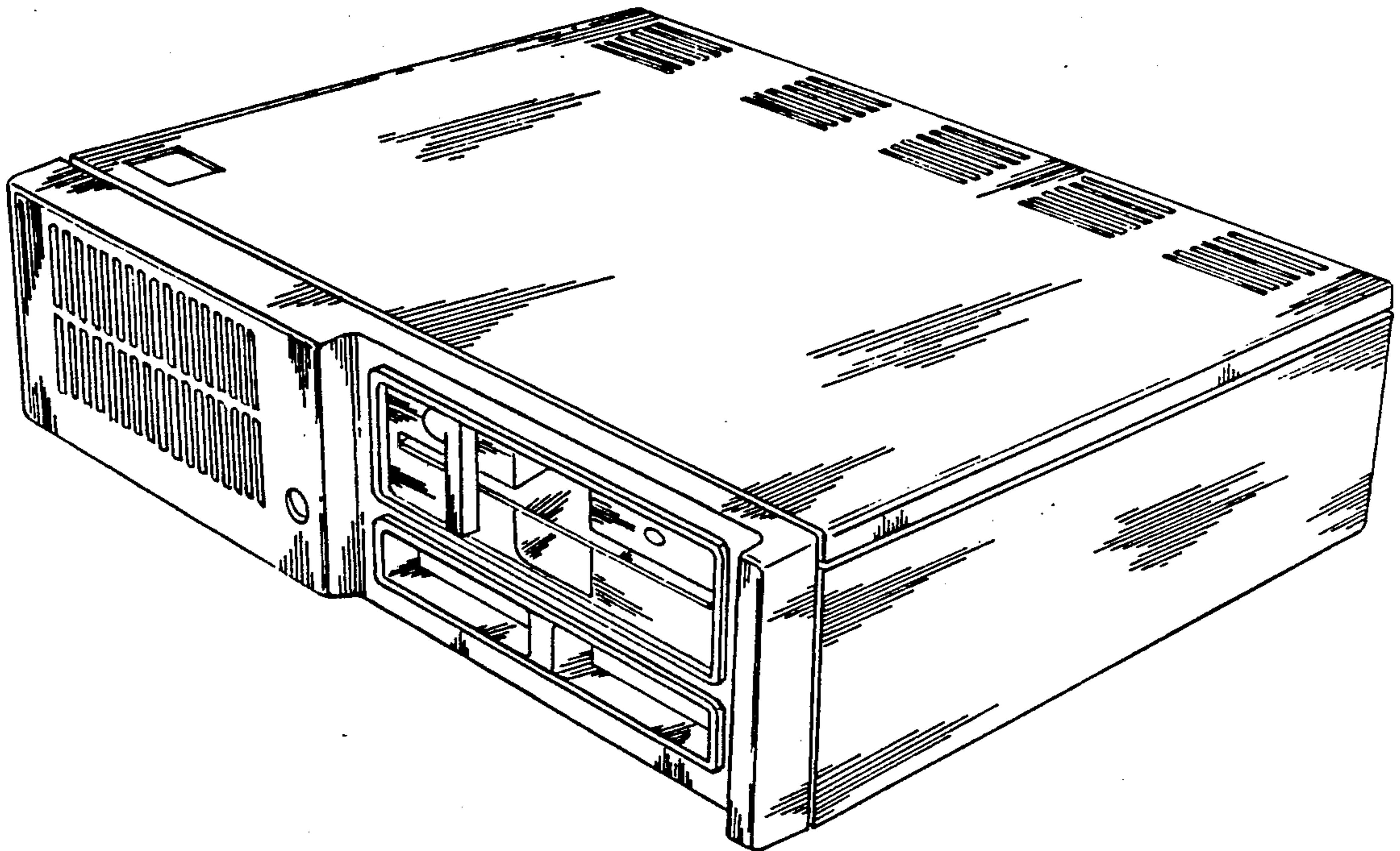

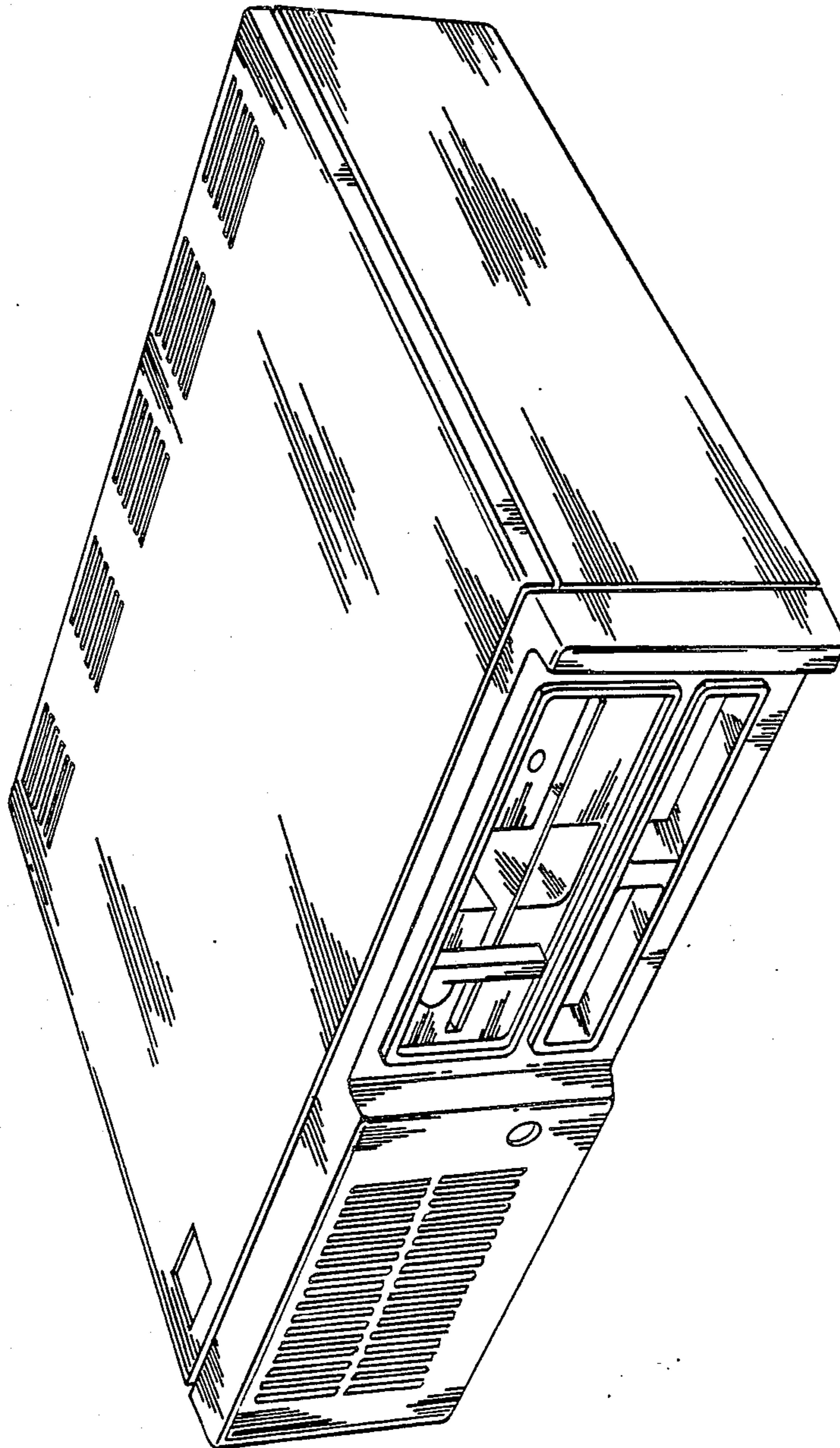

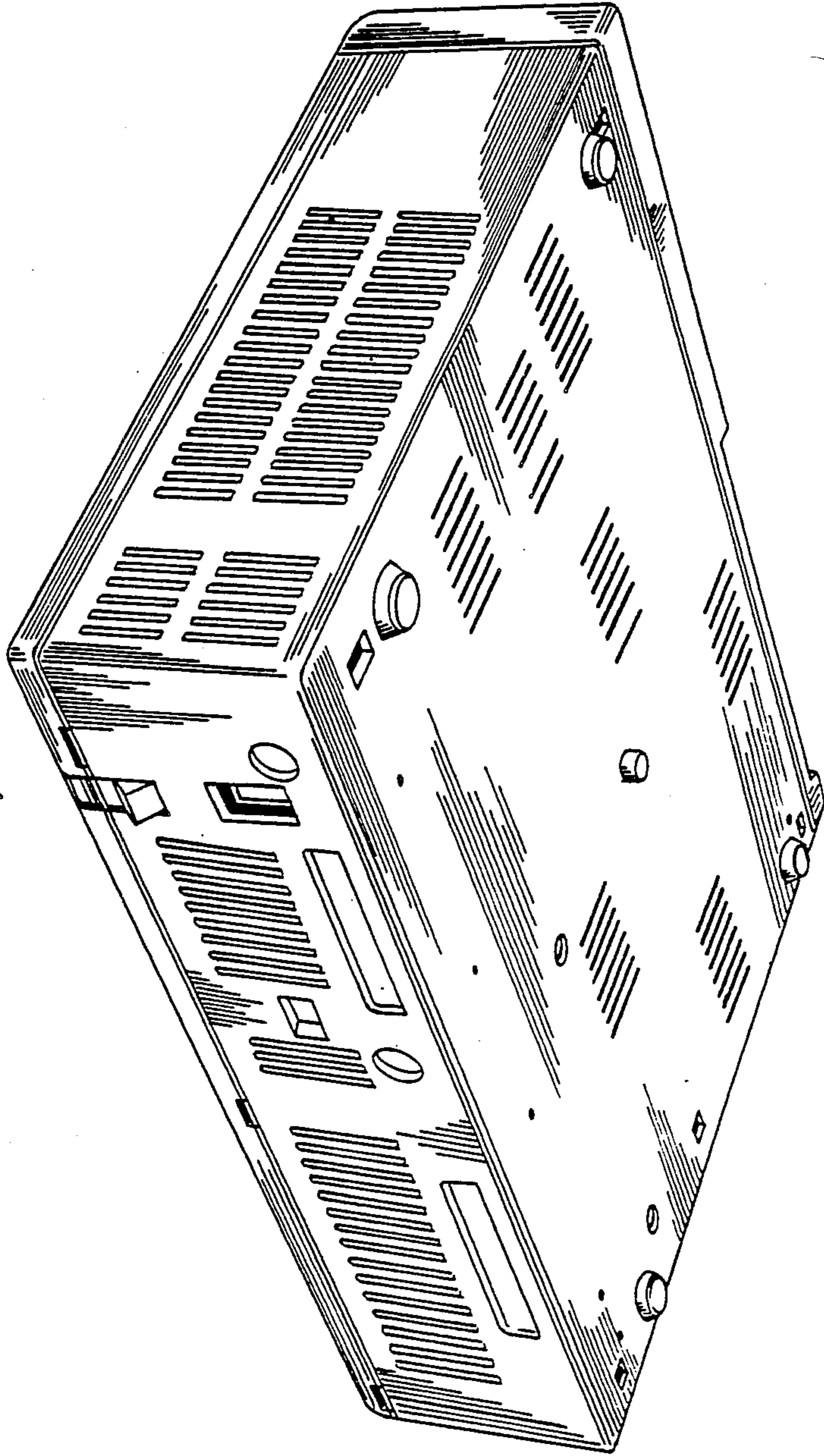

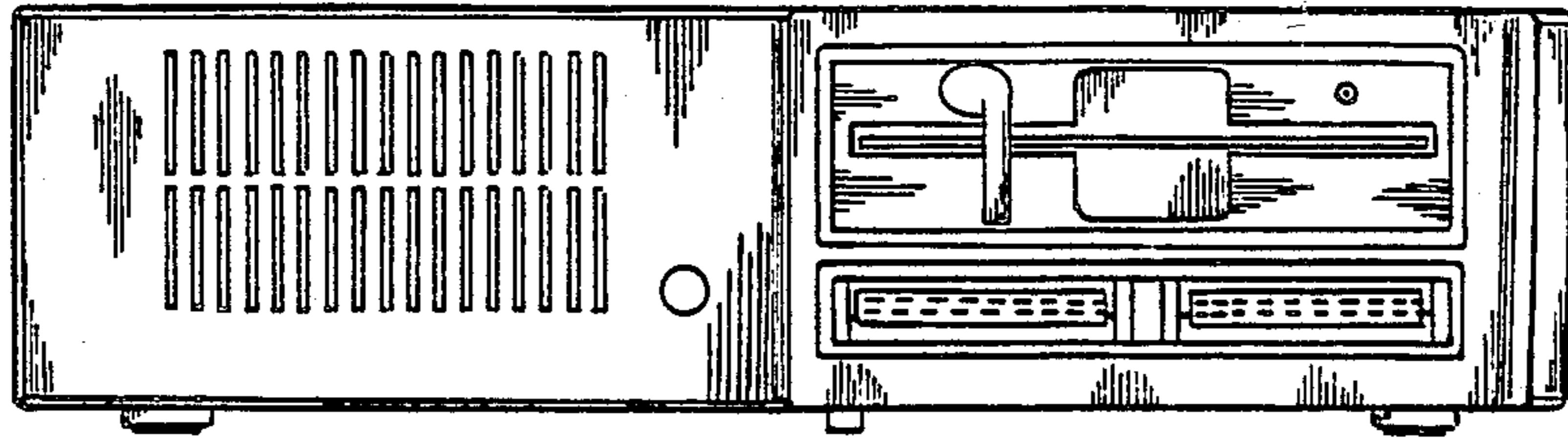

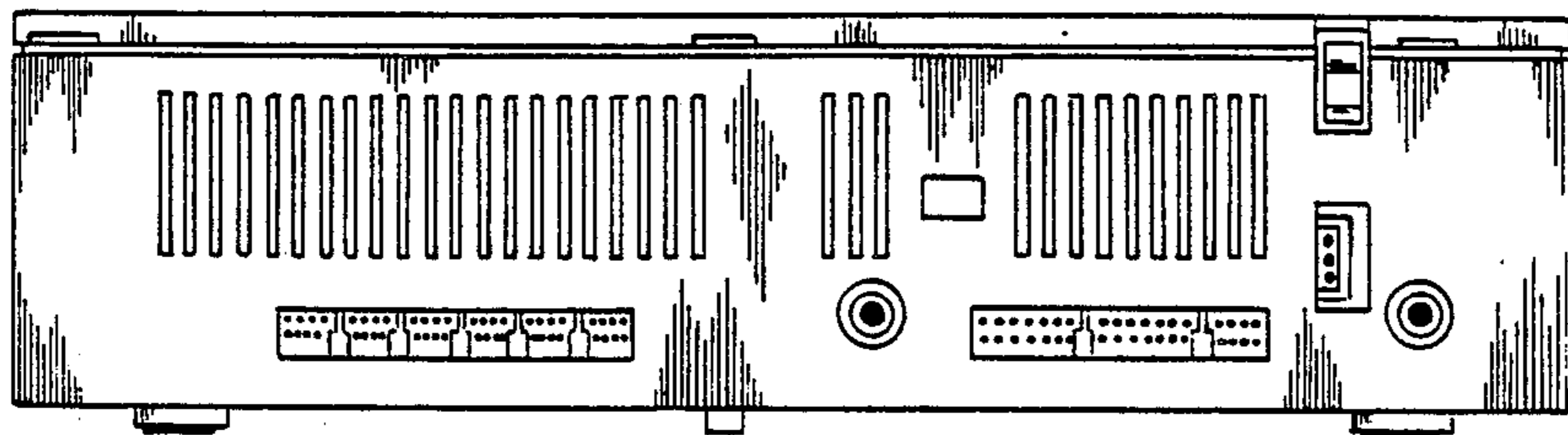

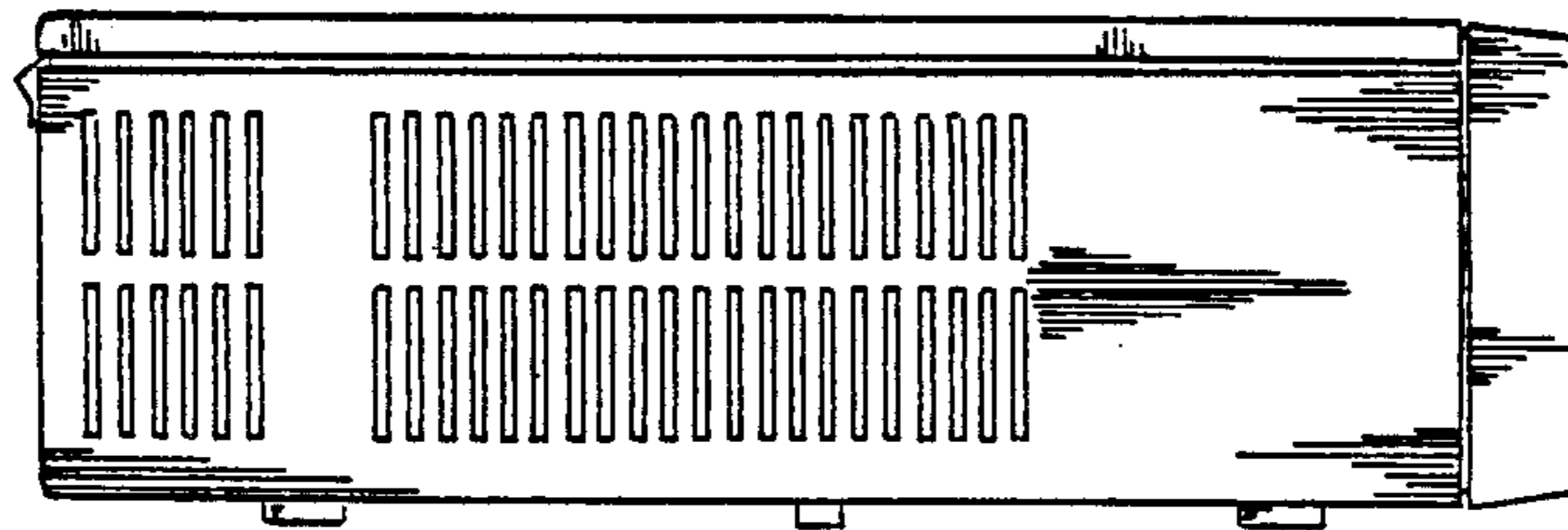

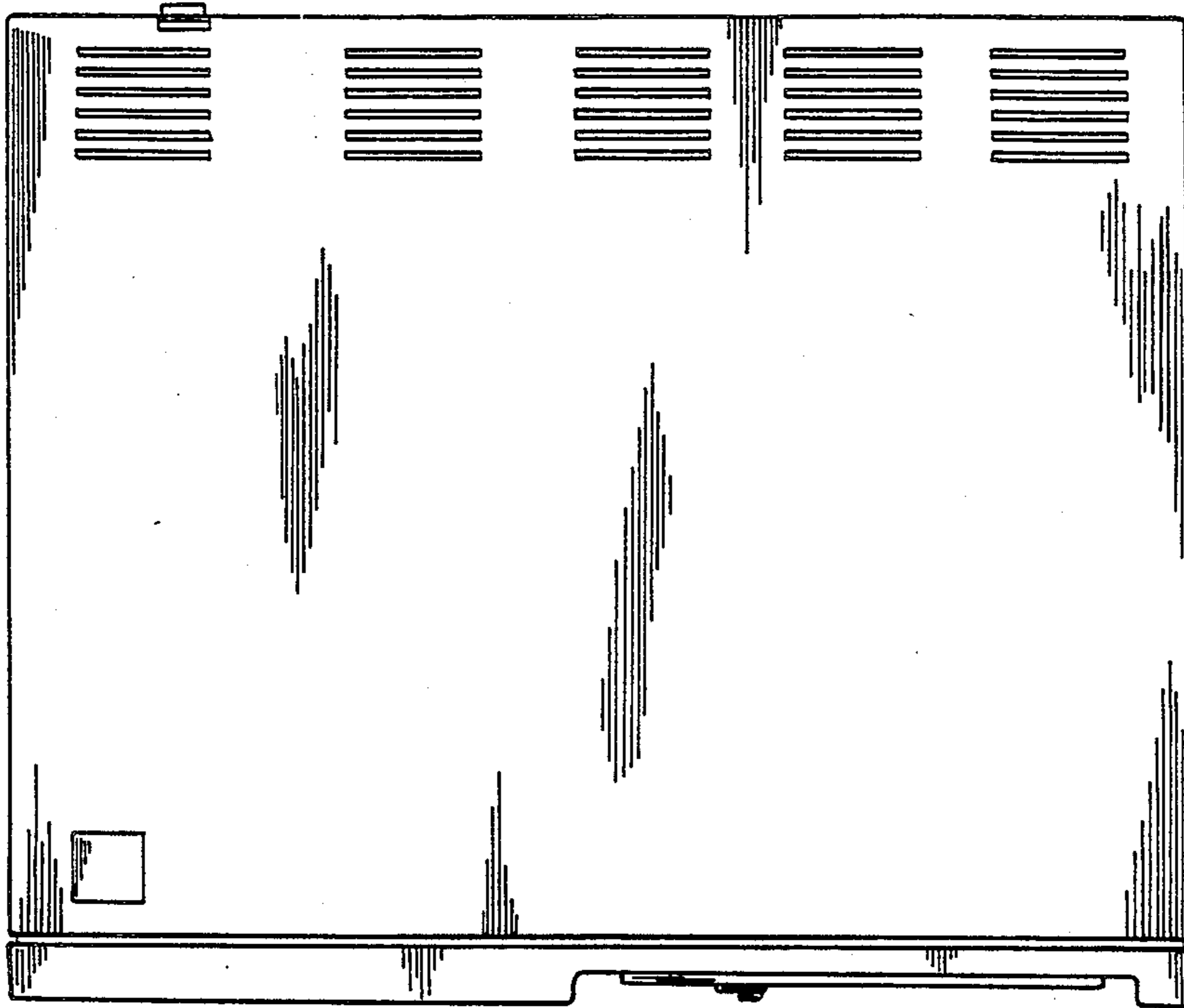
