DESCRIPTION

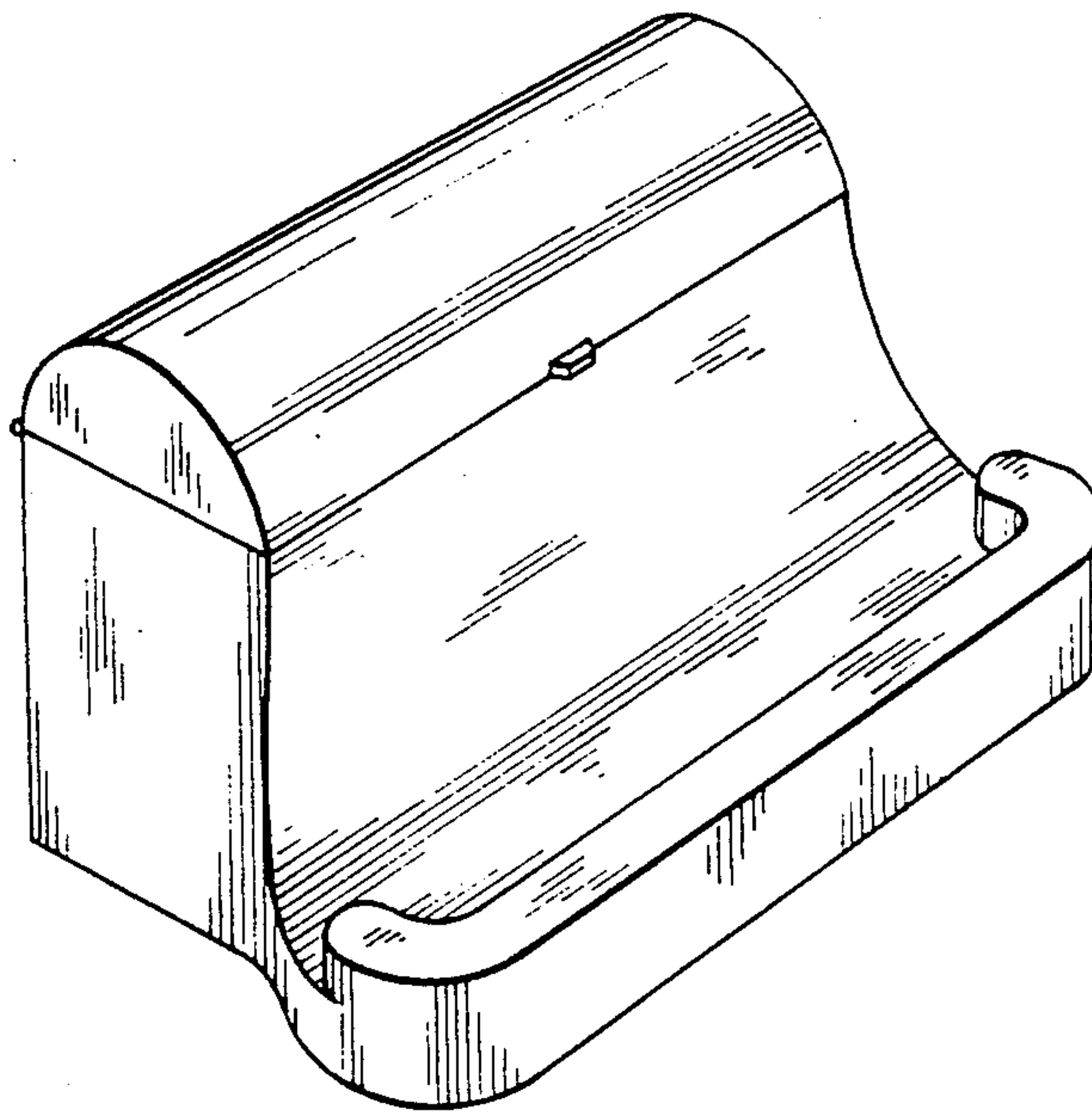
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the combined service

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



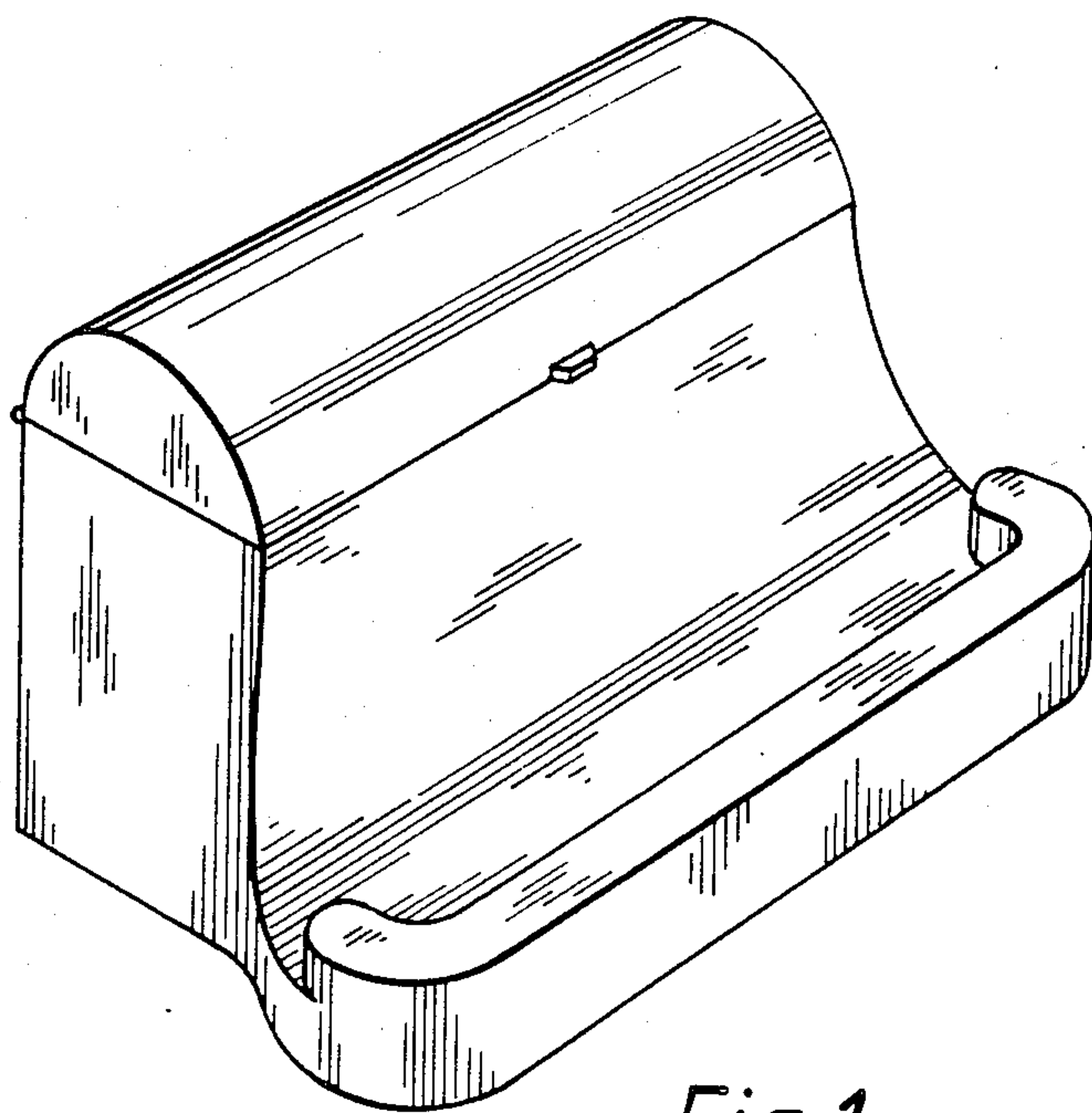

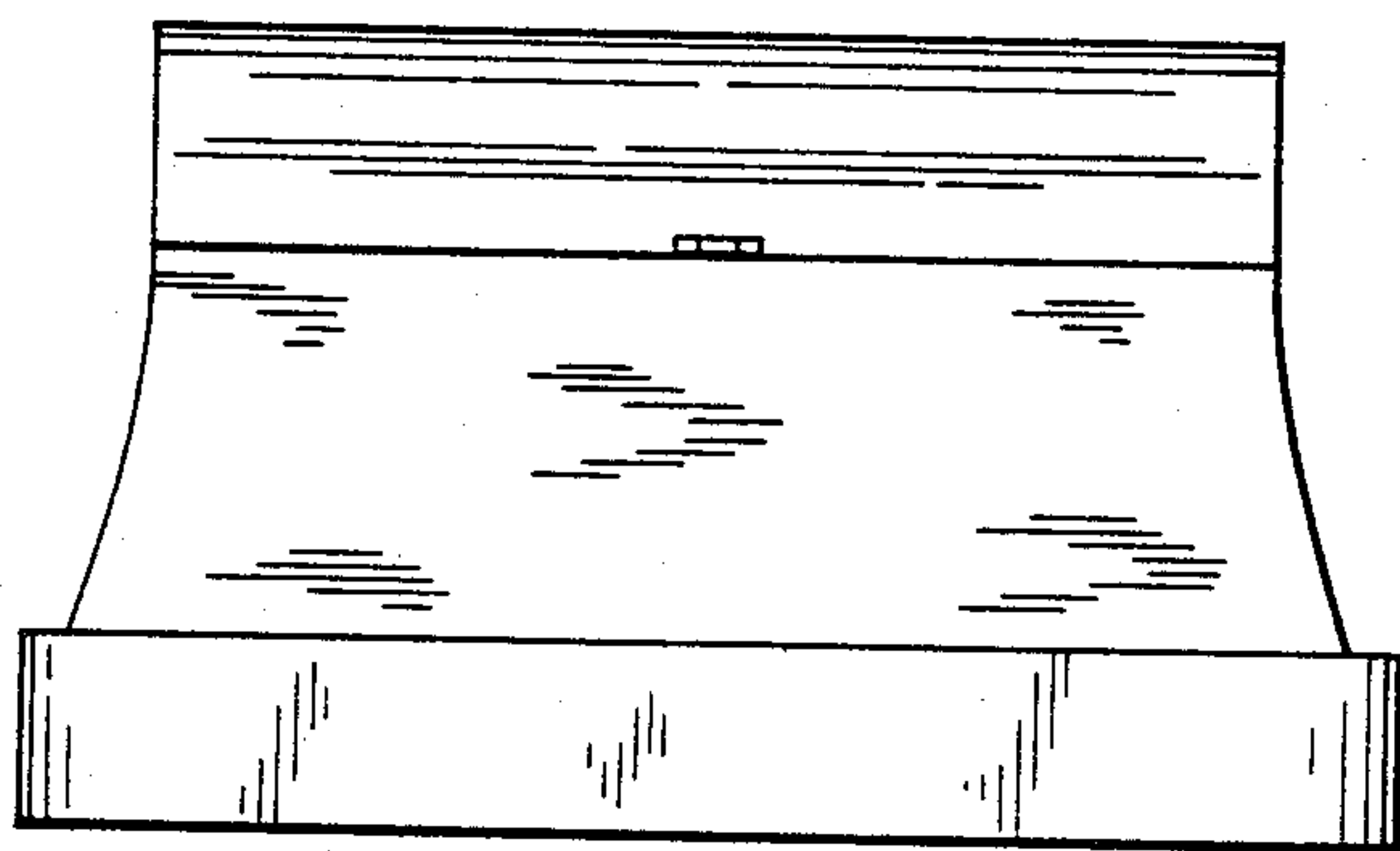

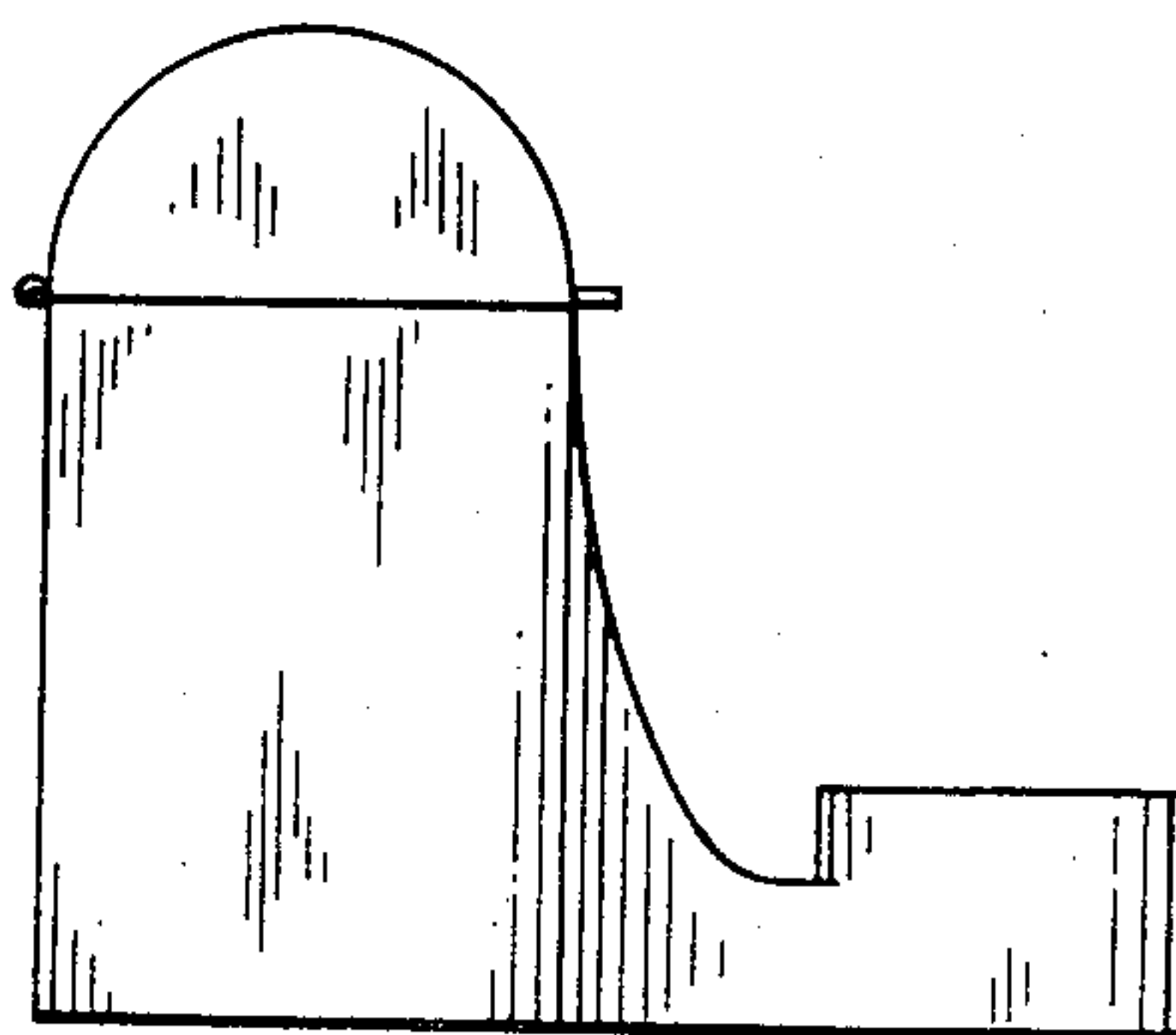

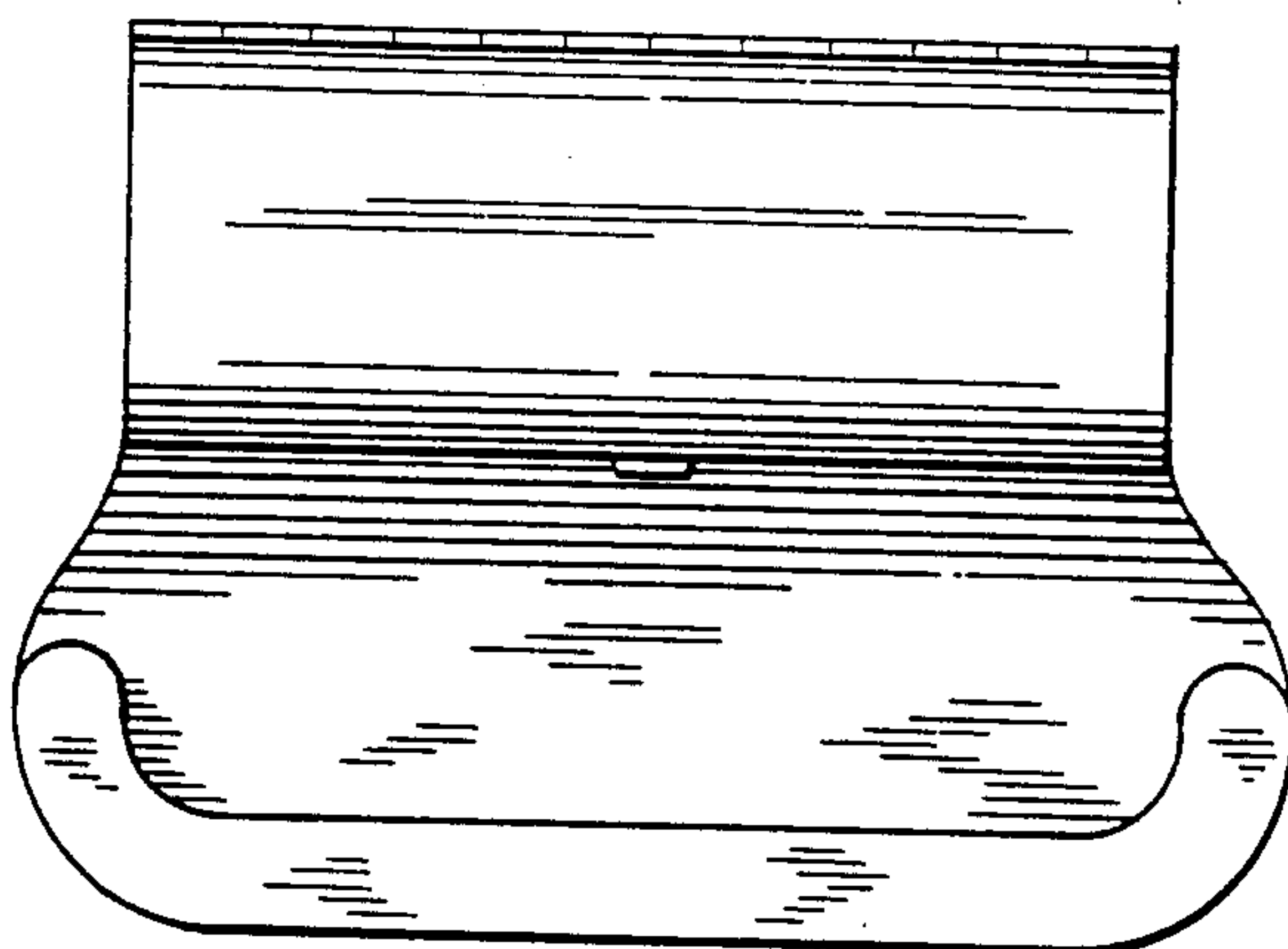

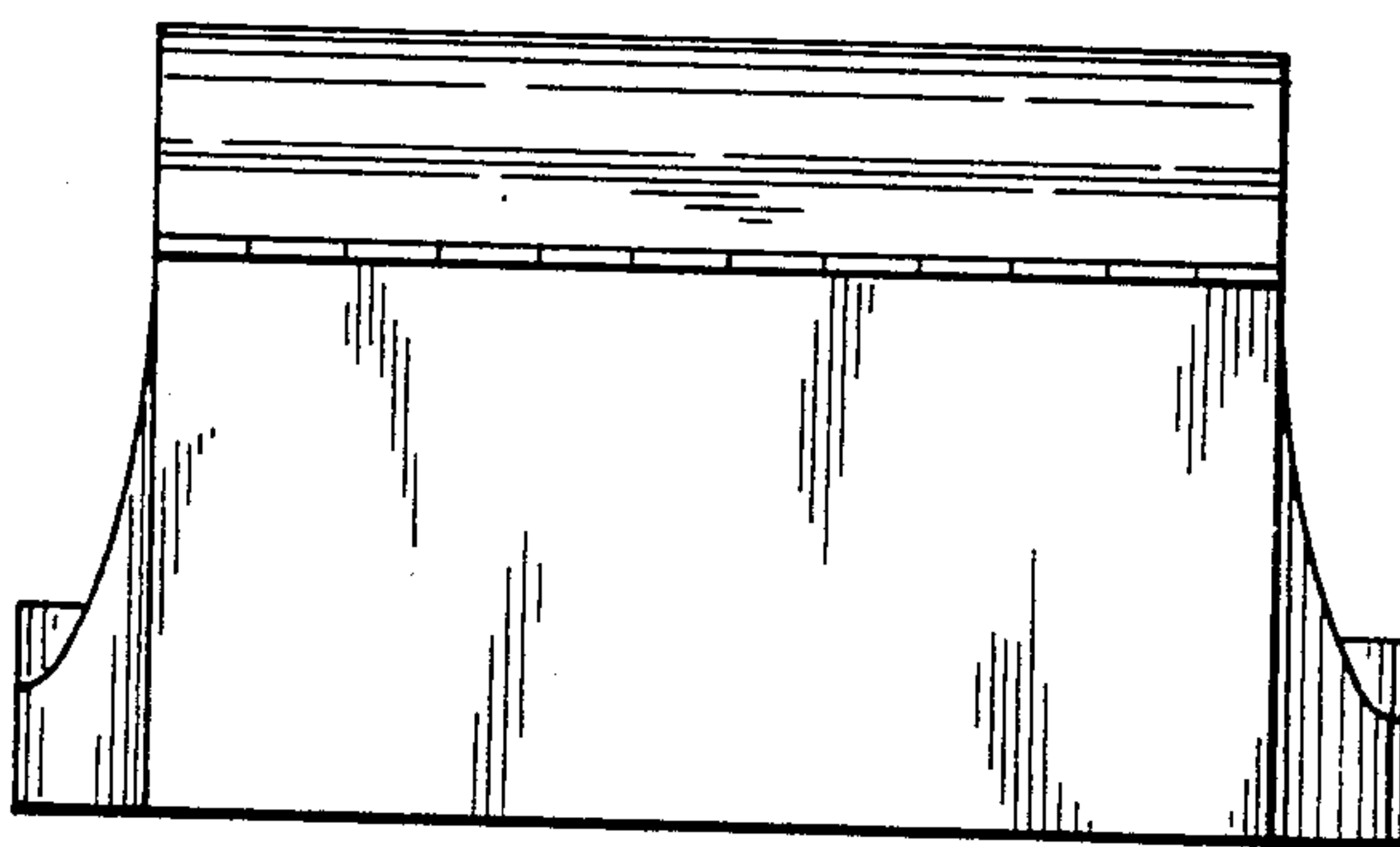
