[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for ventilated splash goggles, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the ventilated splash goggles showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a front, top and left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a back, bottom and right side perspective view thereof shown on a reduced scale; and

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof.

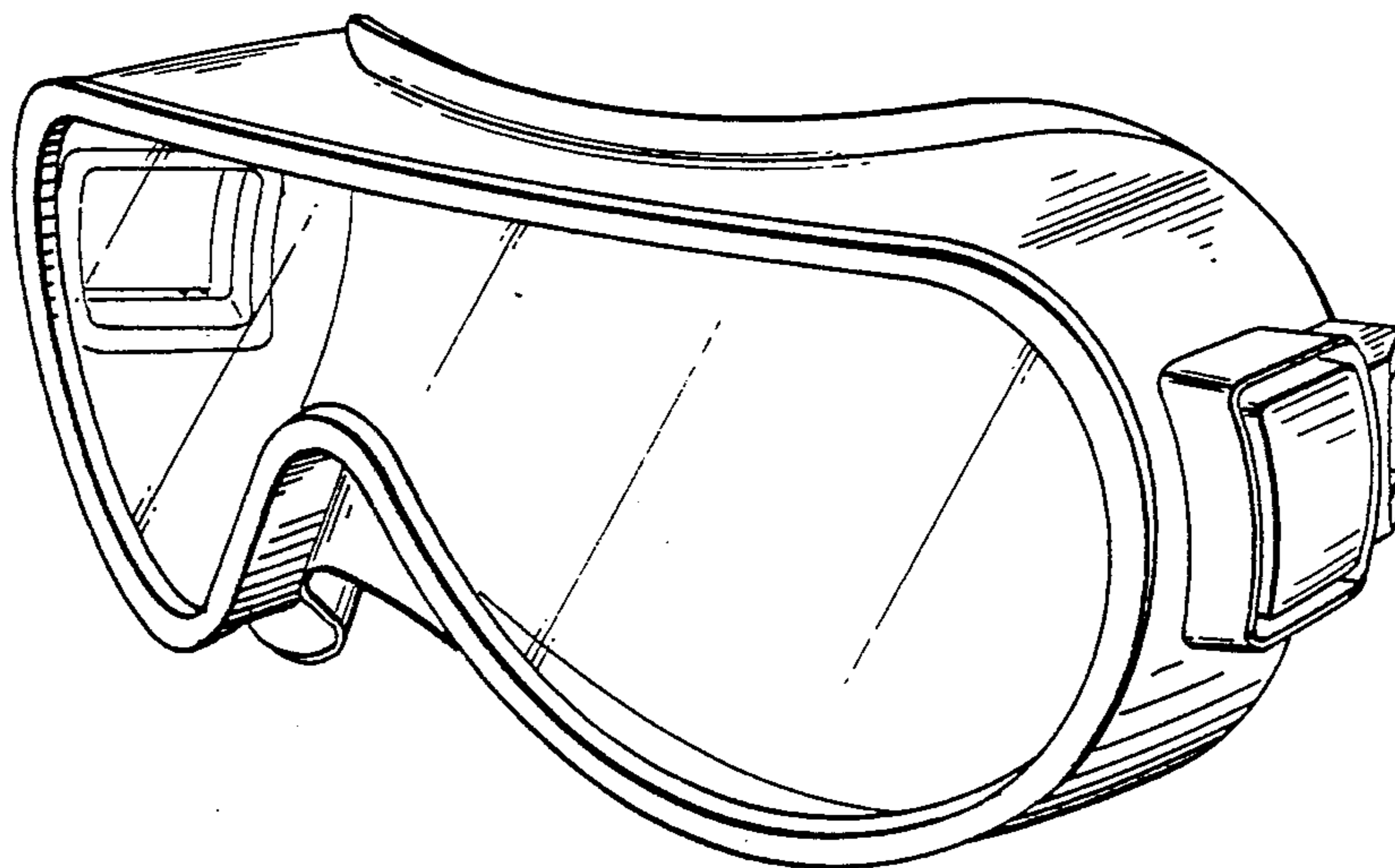

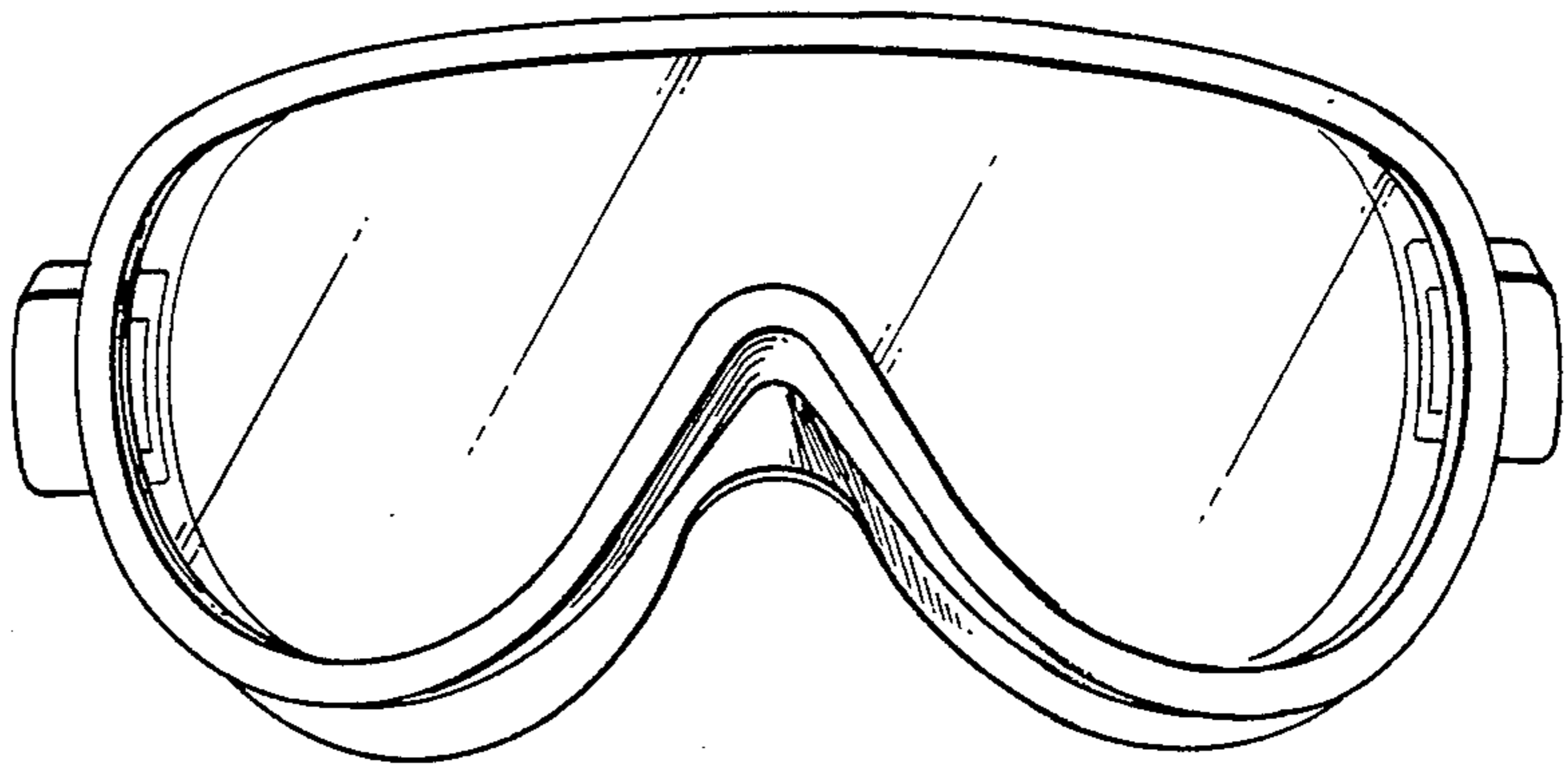

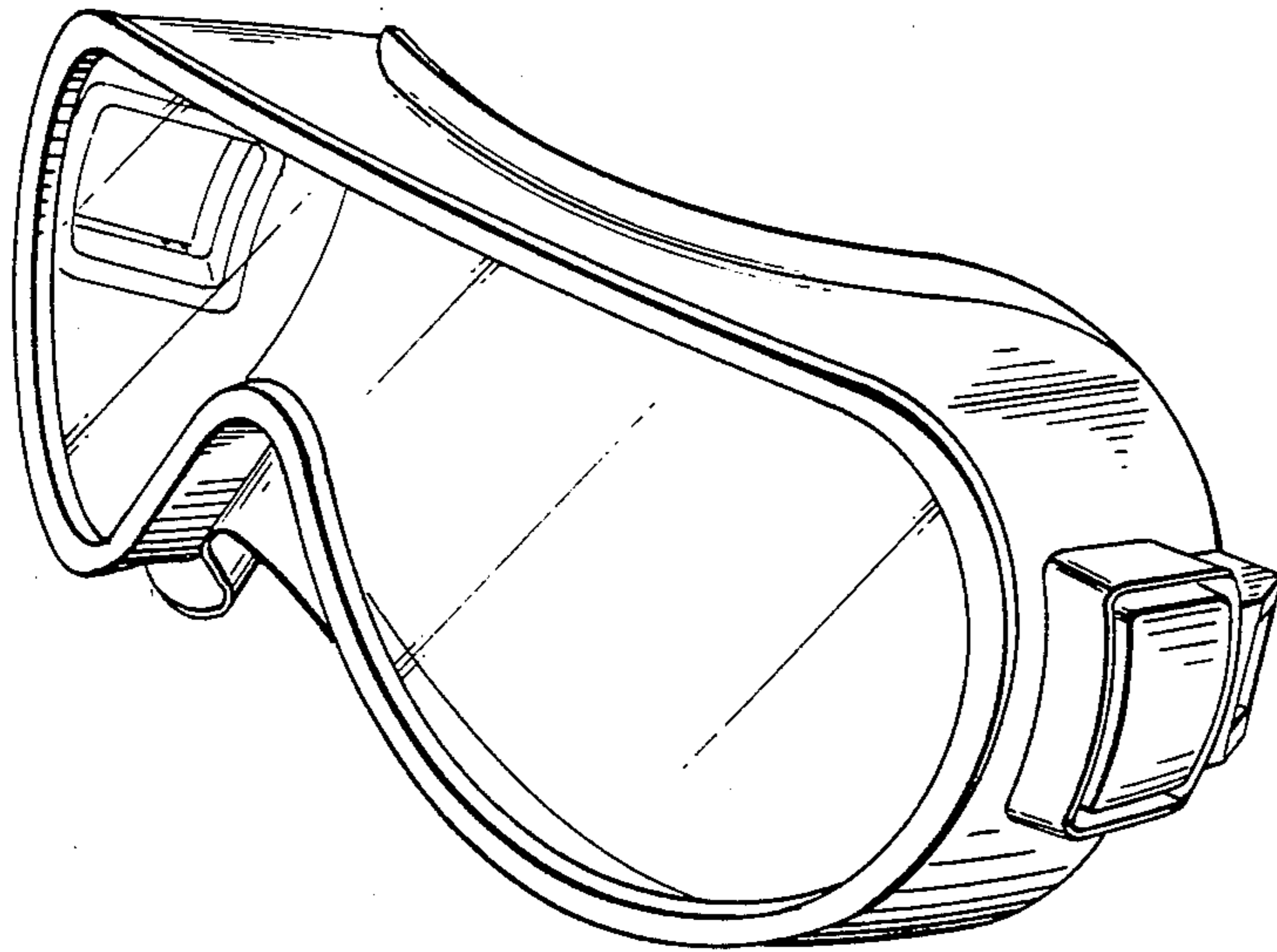
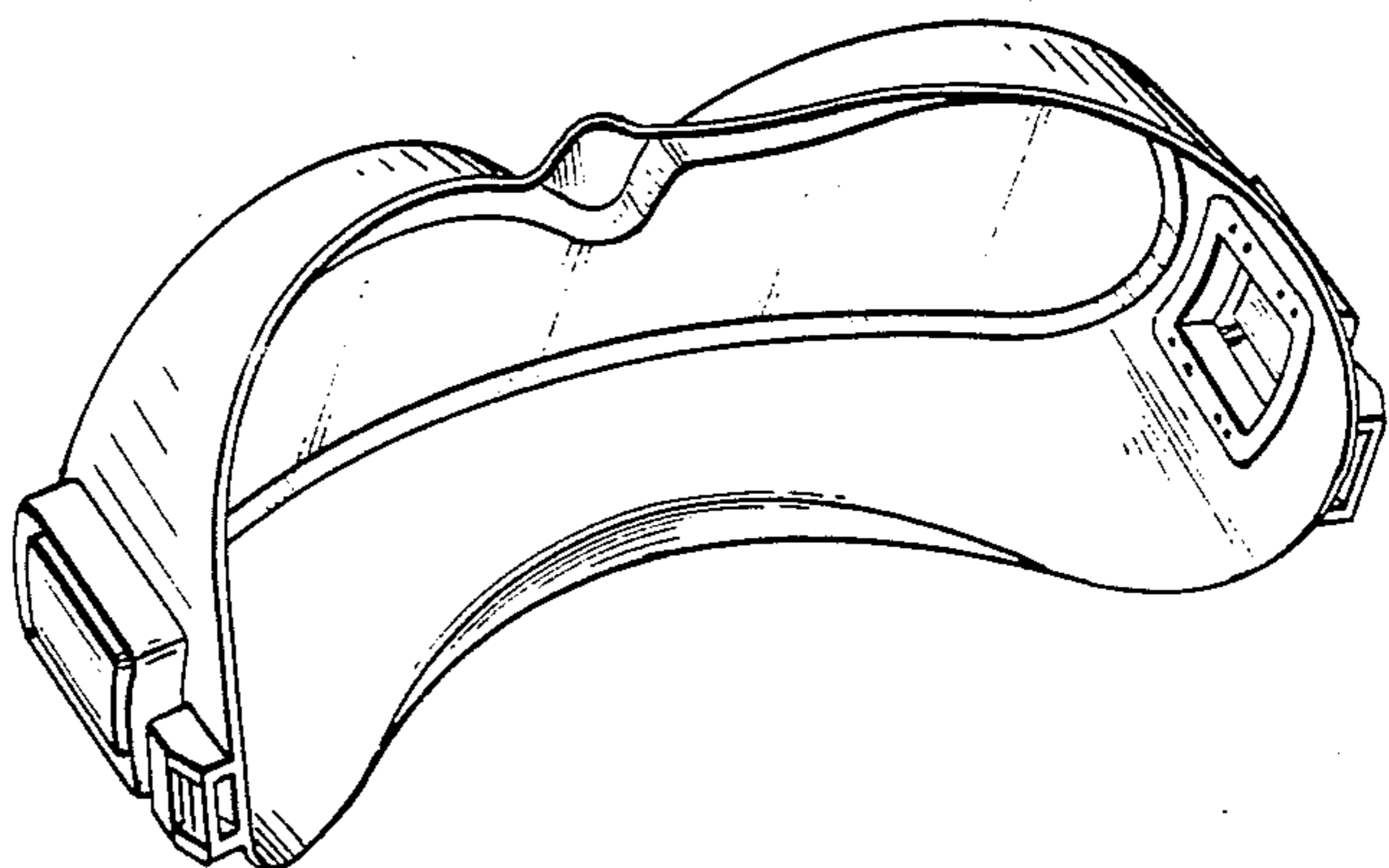

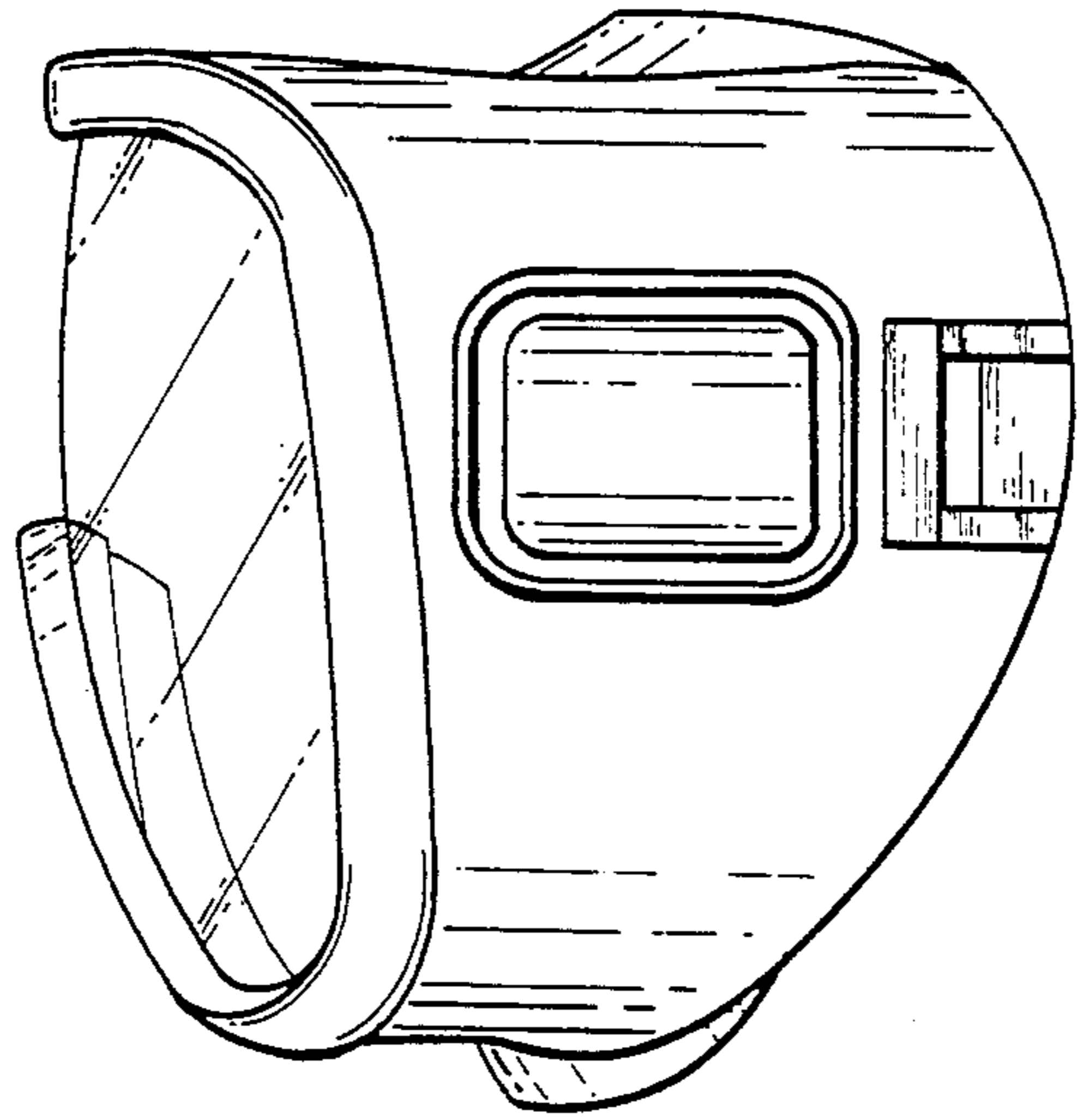
