

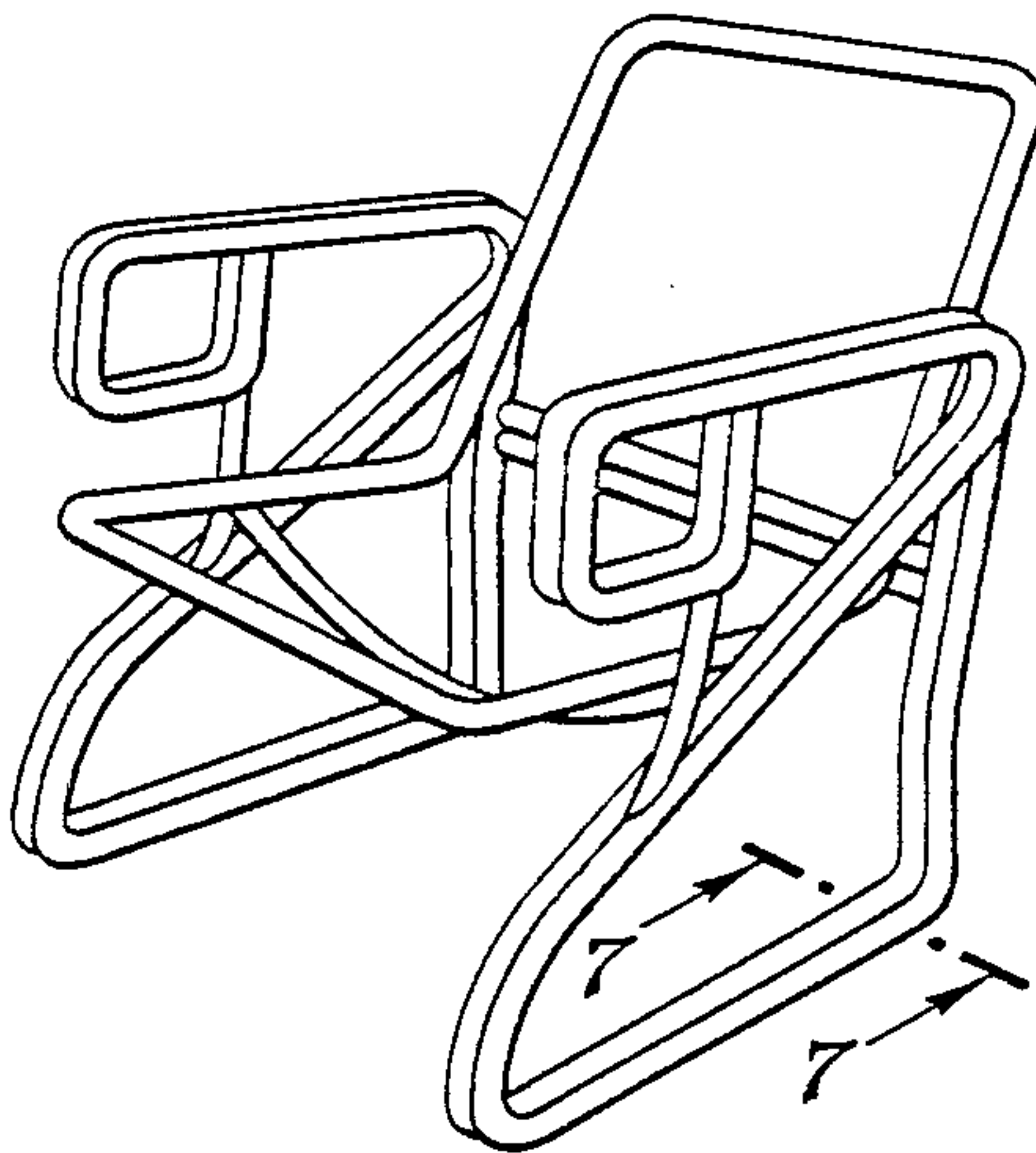

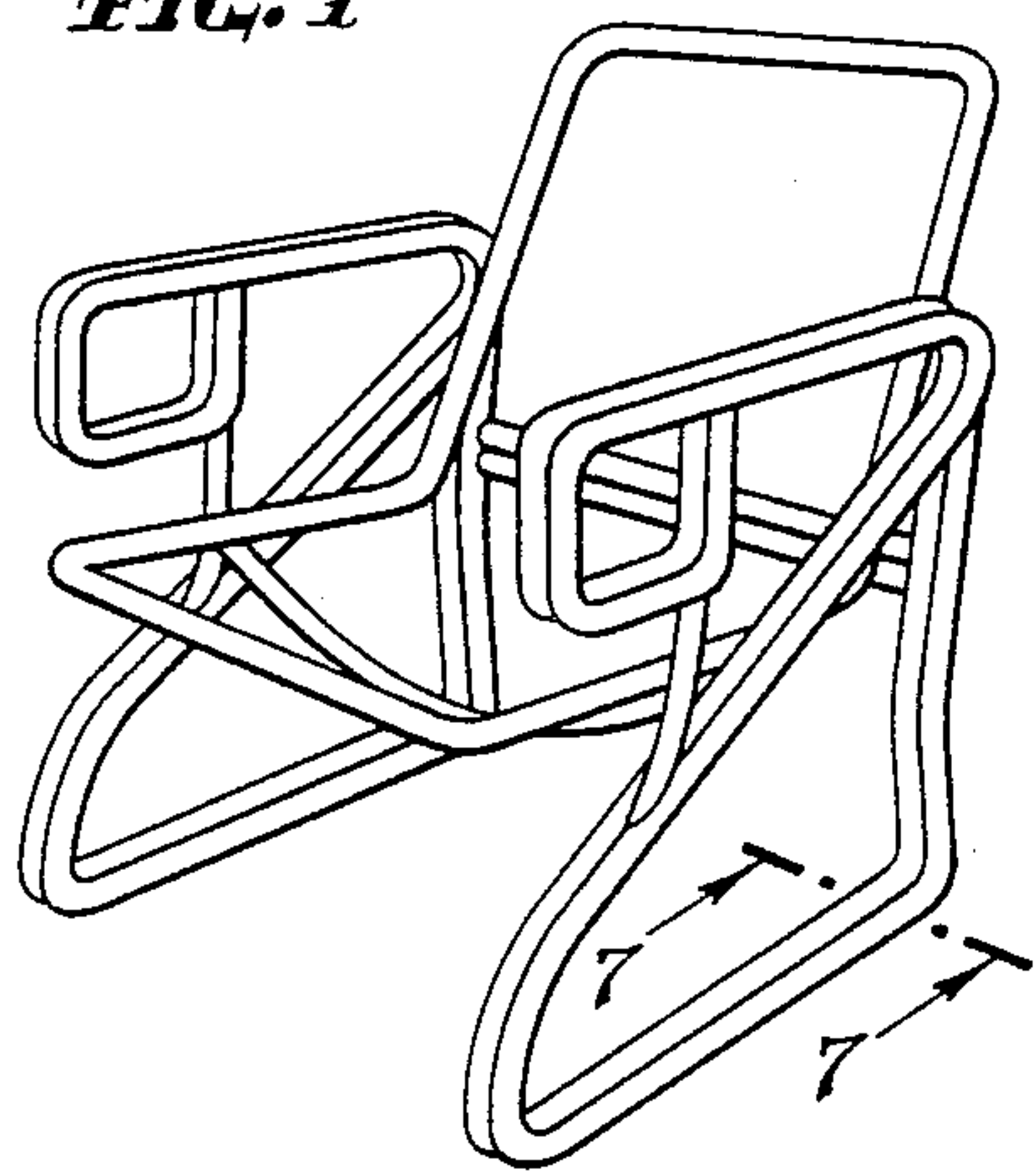

 The ornamental design for a chair frame or the like, as shown and described.

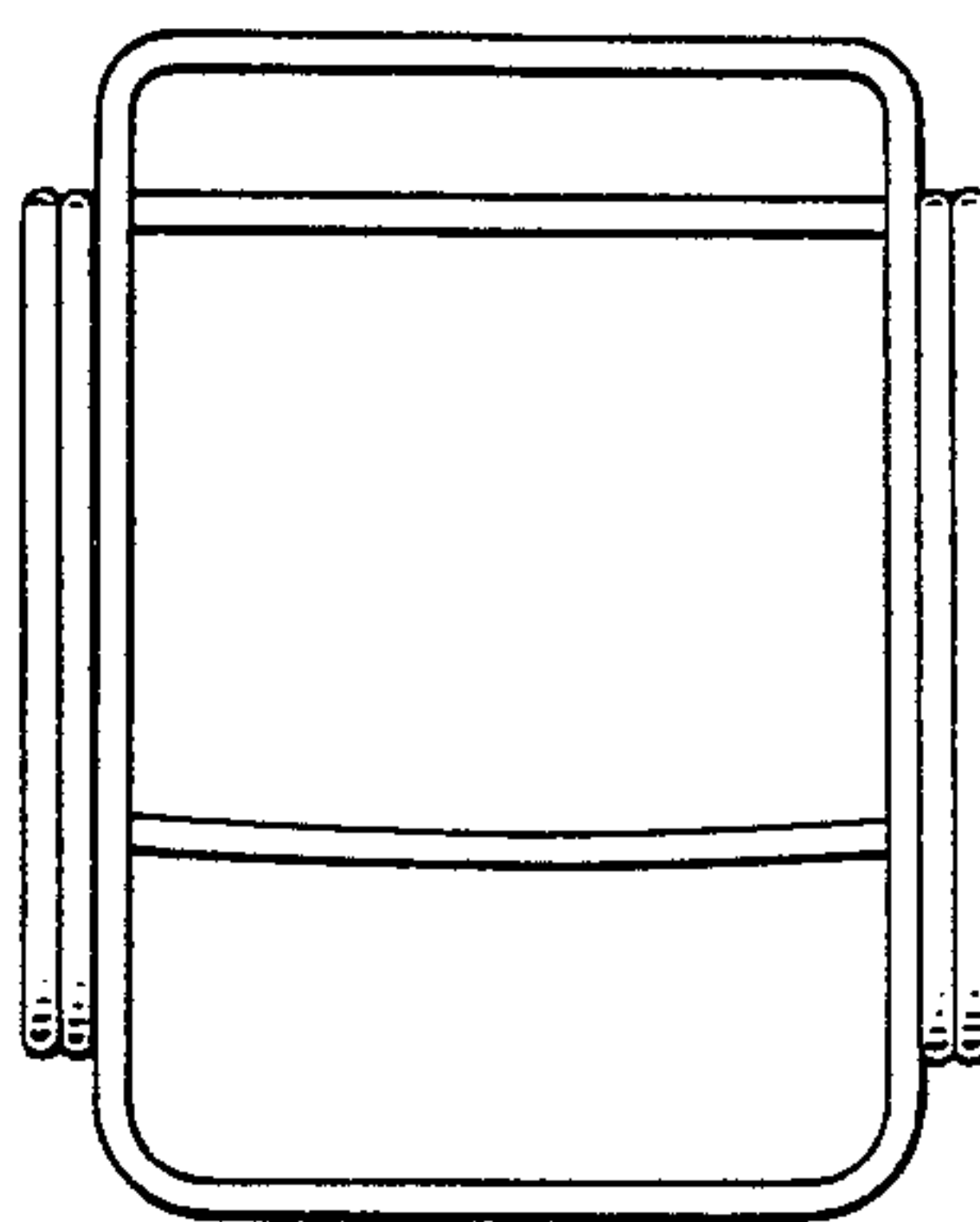
**DESCRIPTION**  
 FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair frame or the like showing my design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

 FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 1 and looking in the direction of the arrows thereof.



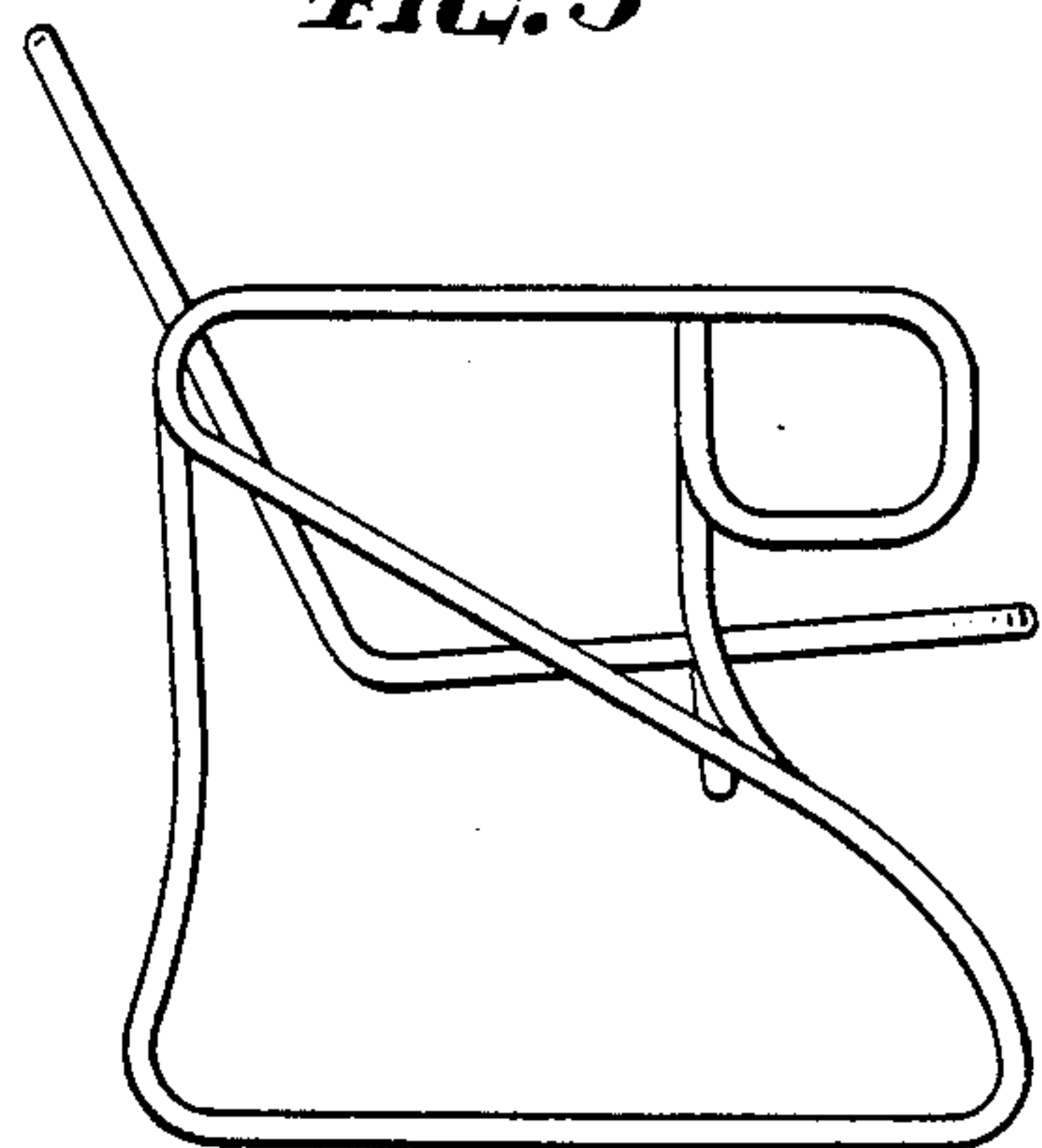

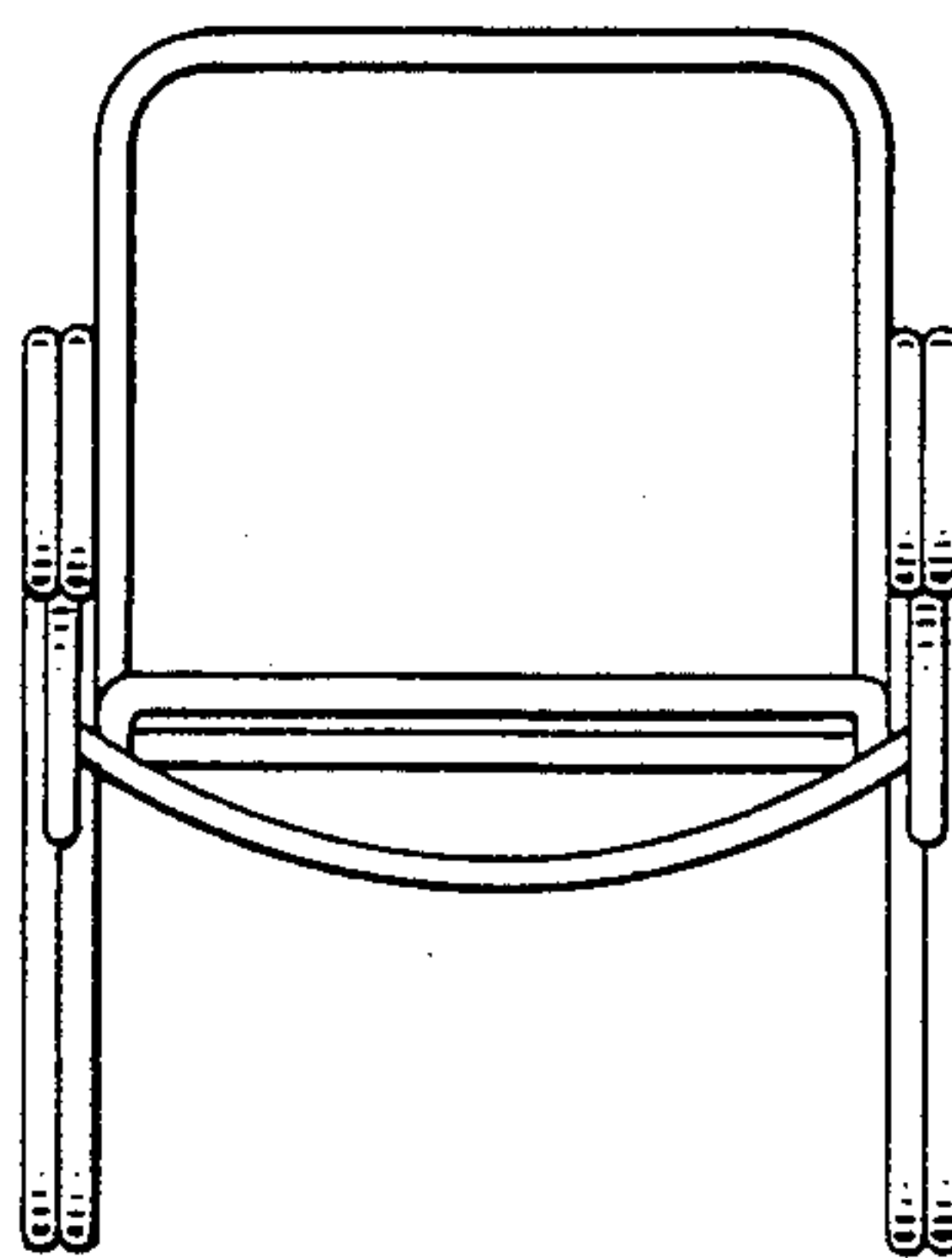

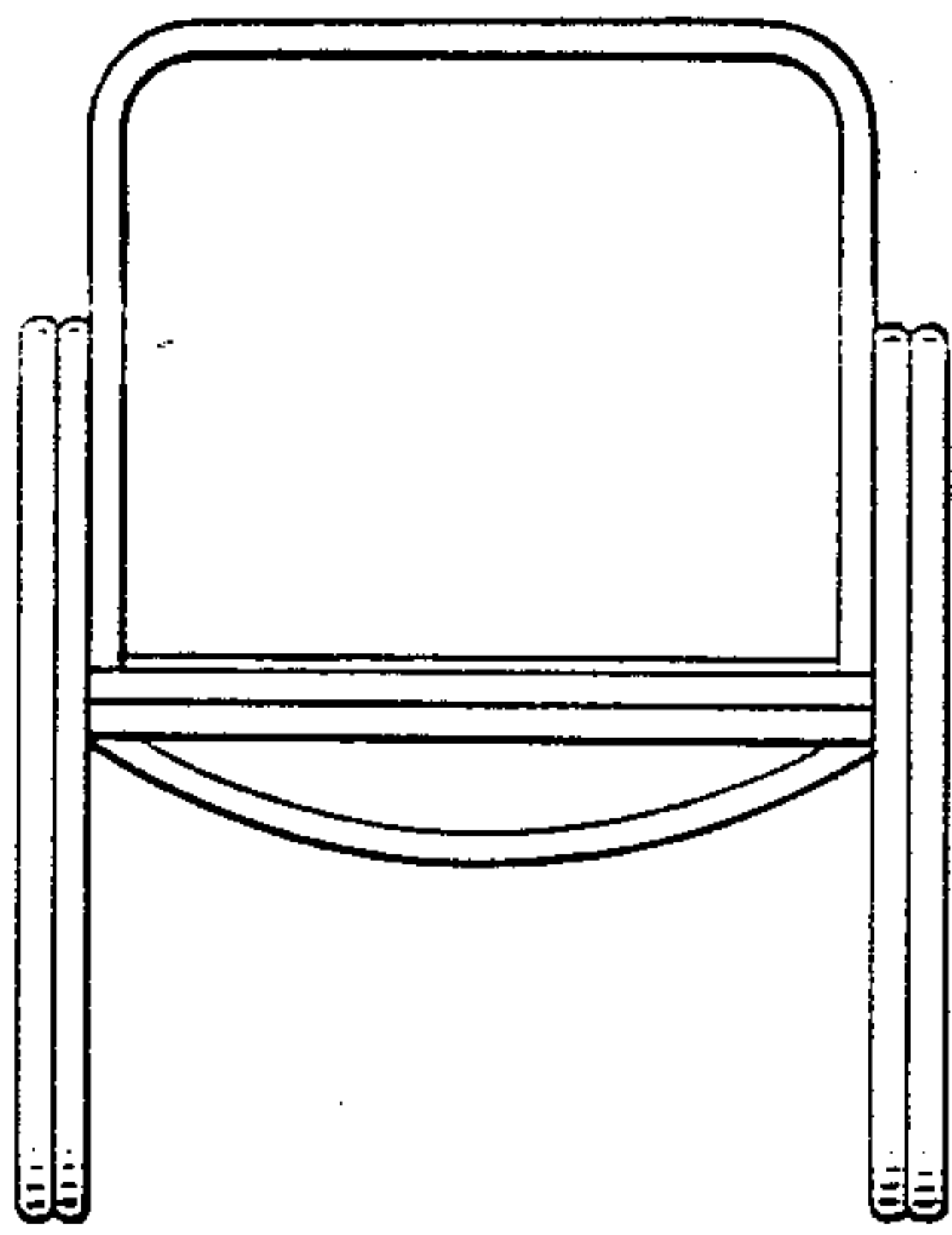

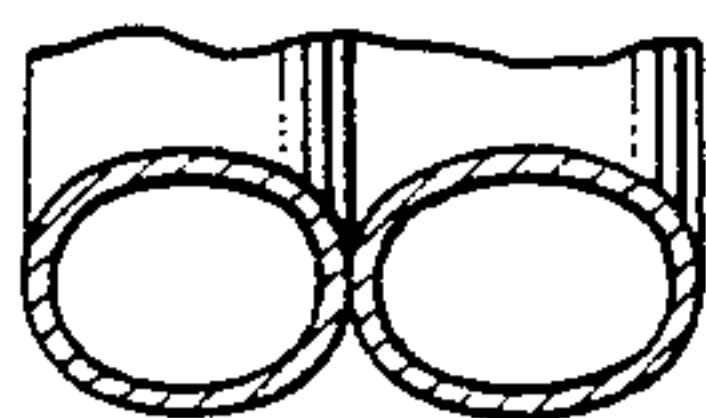
