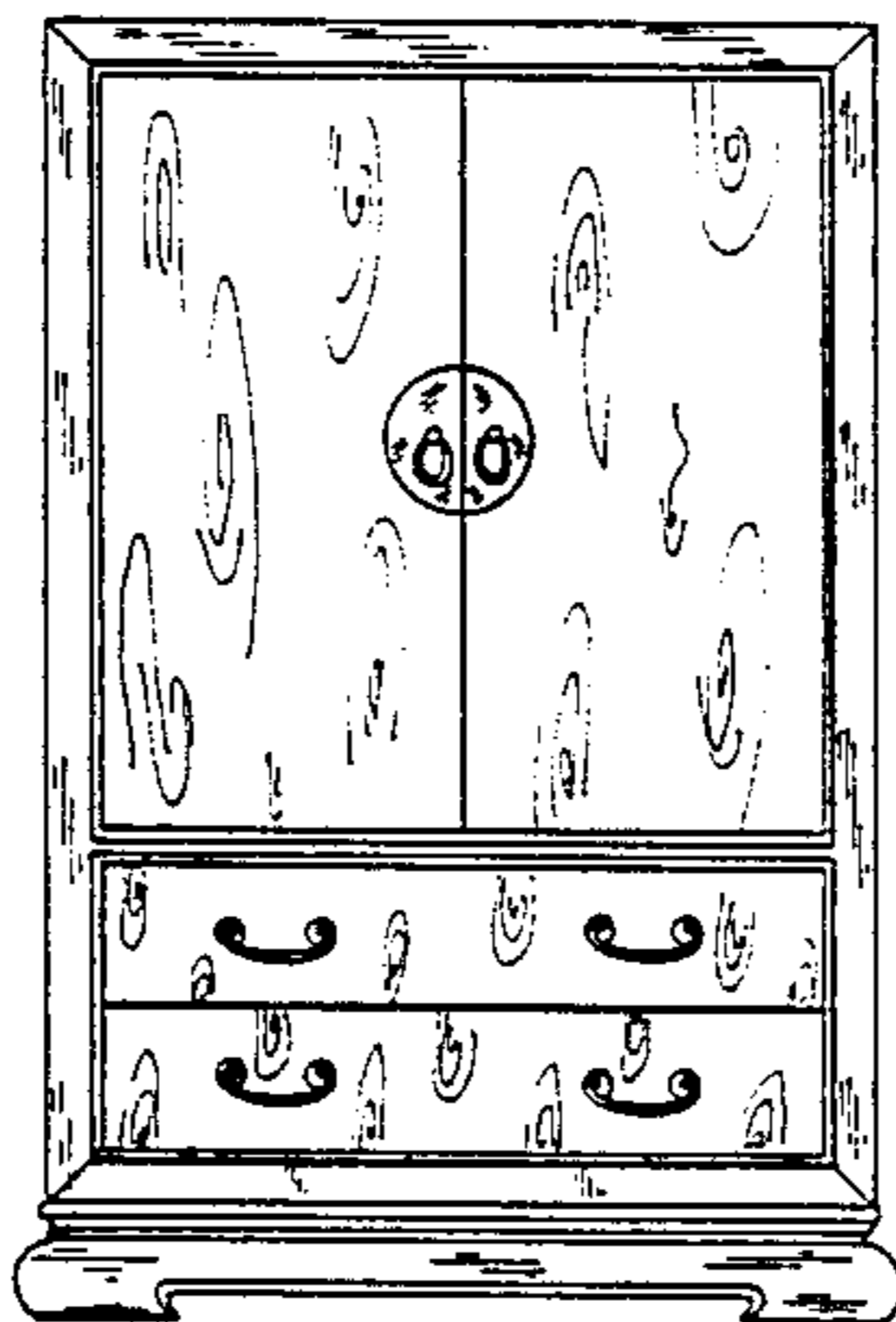
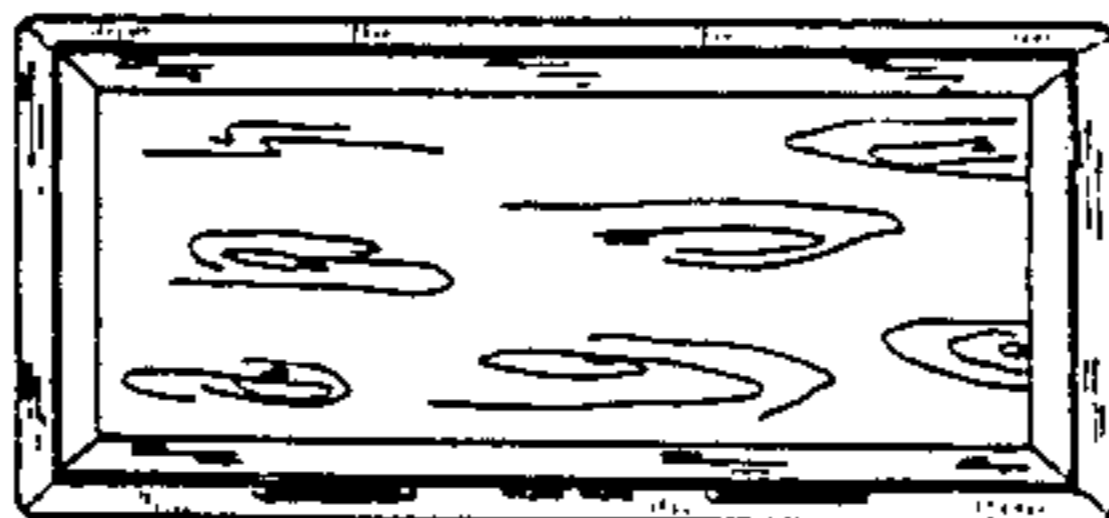
[57] CLAIM

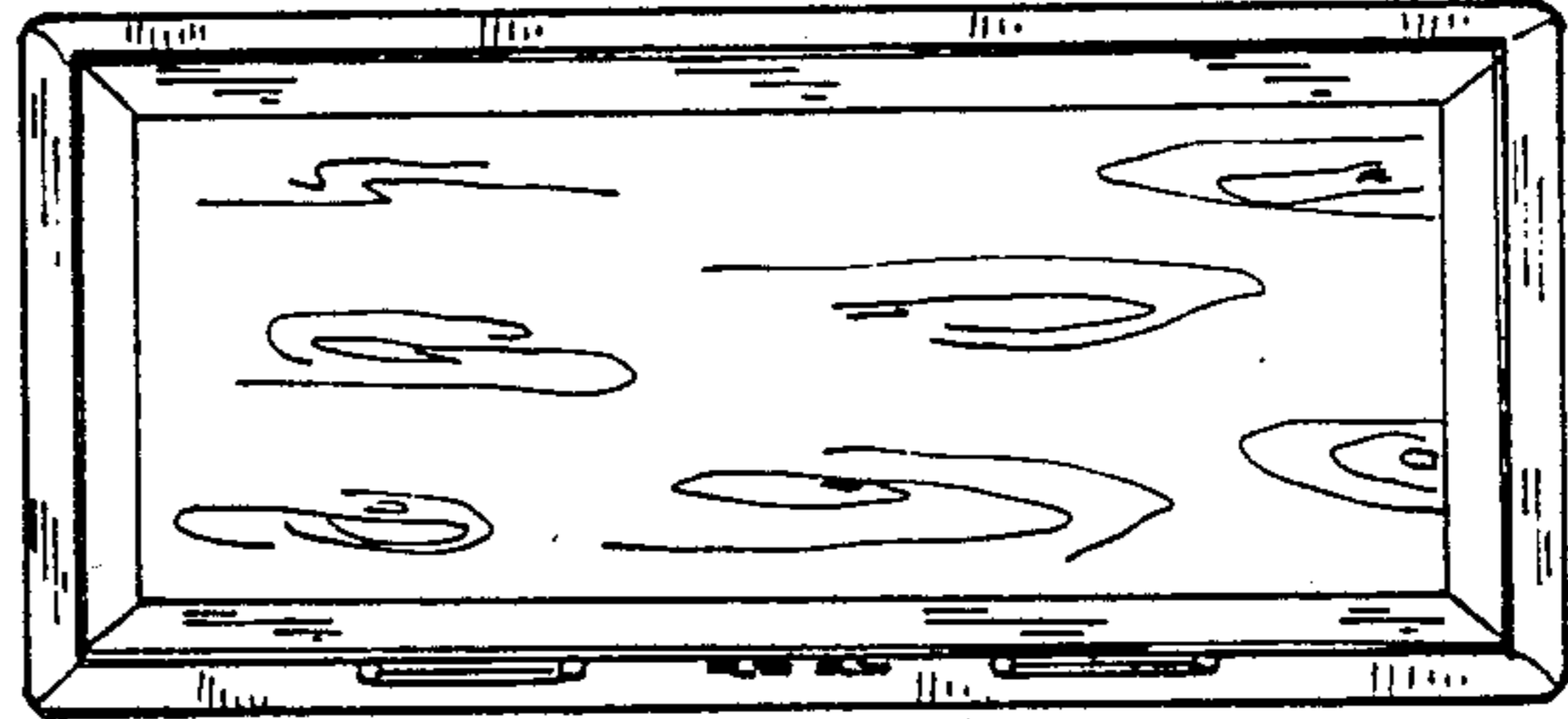

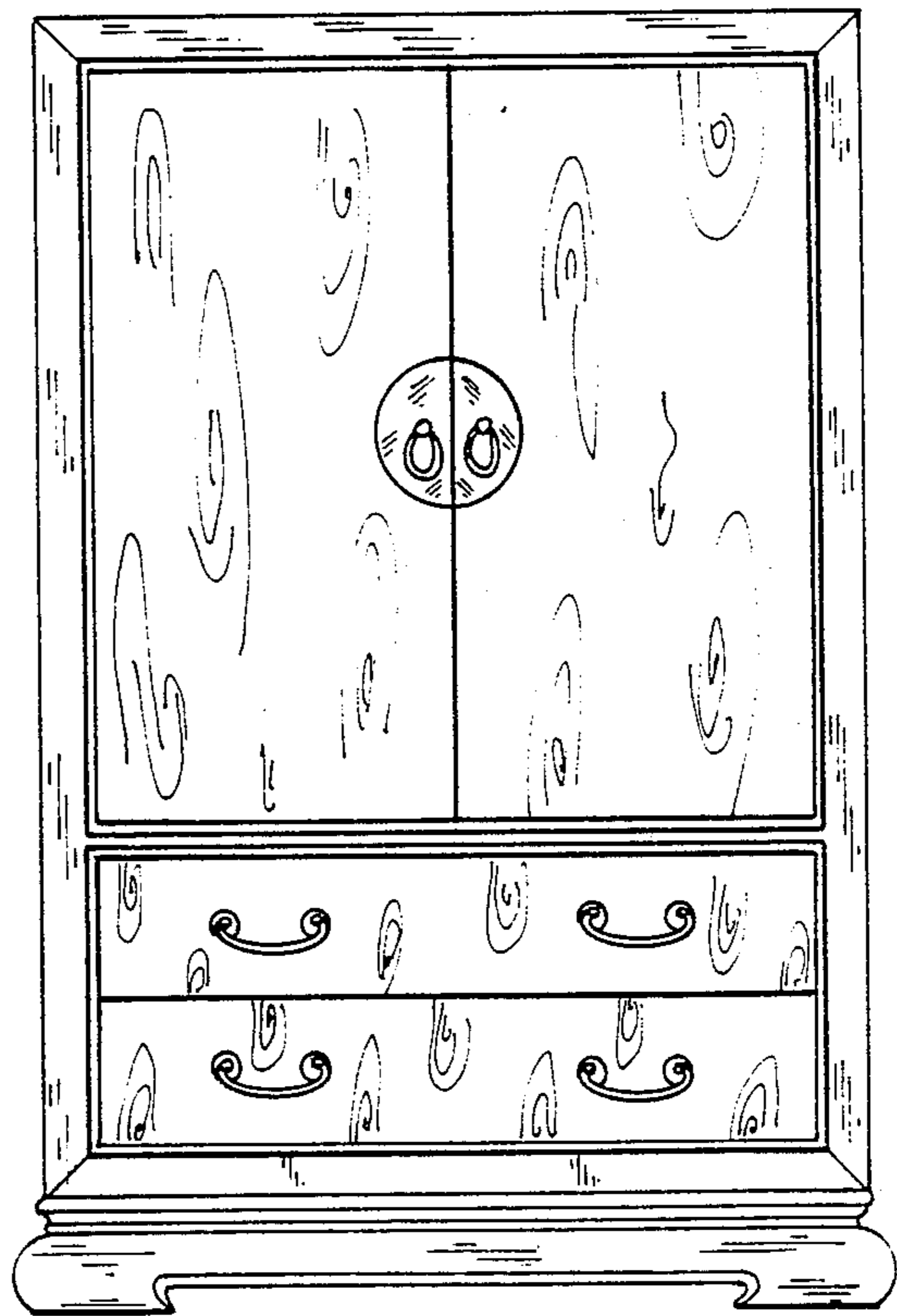
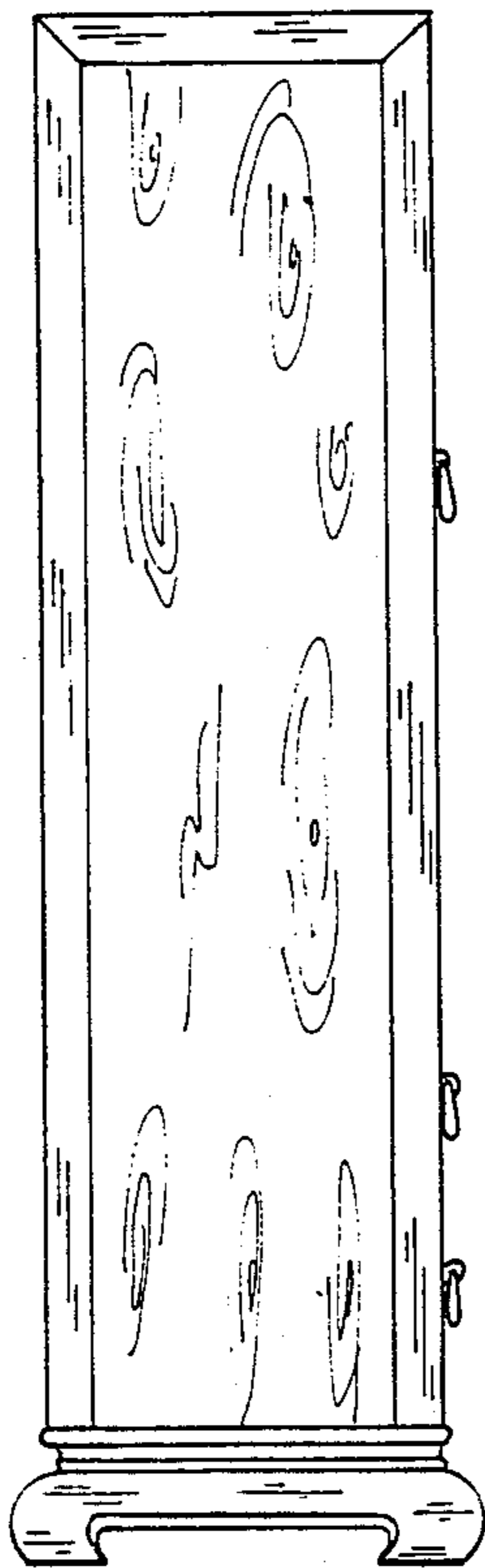
