DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the eyeglass frame showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

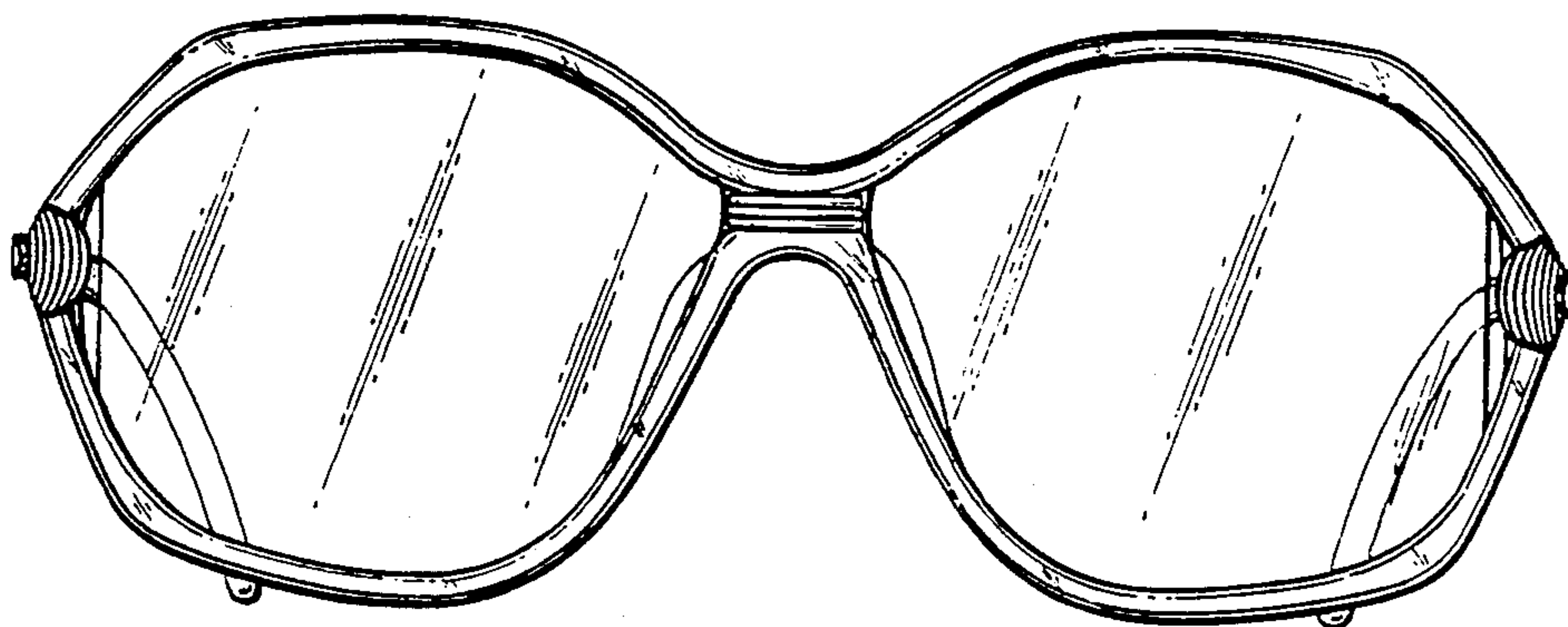

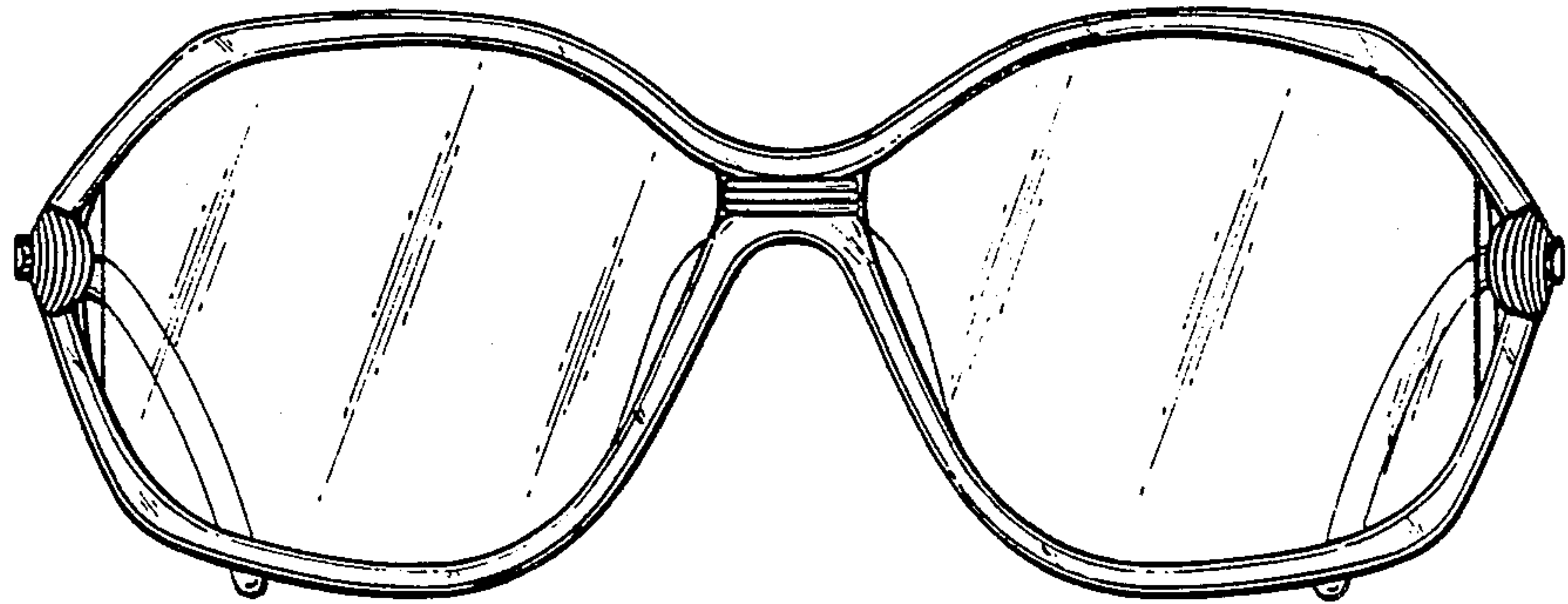

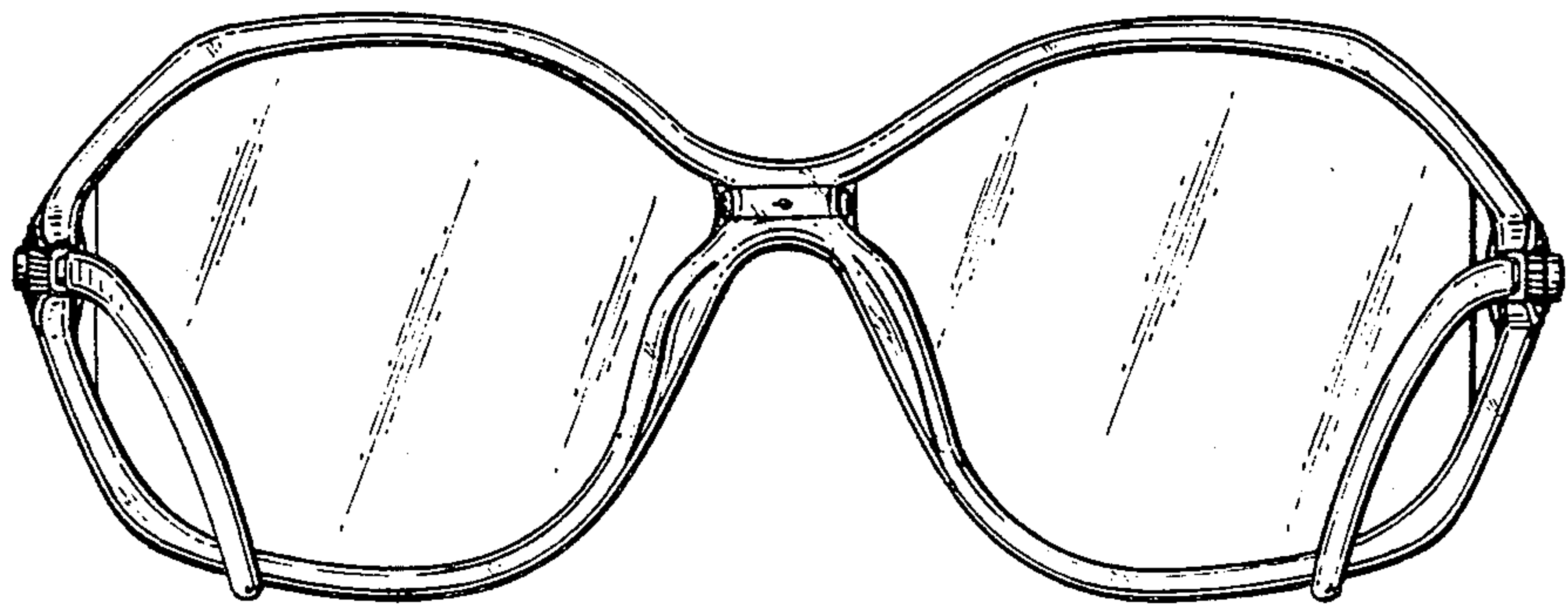

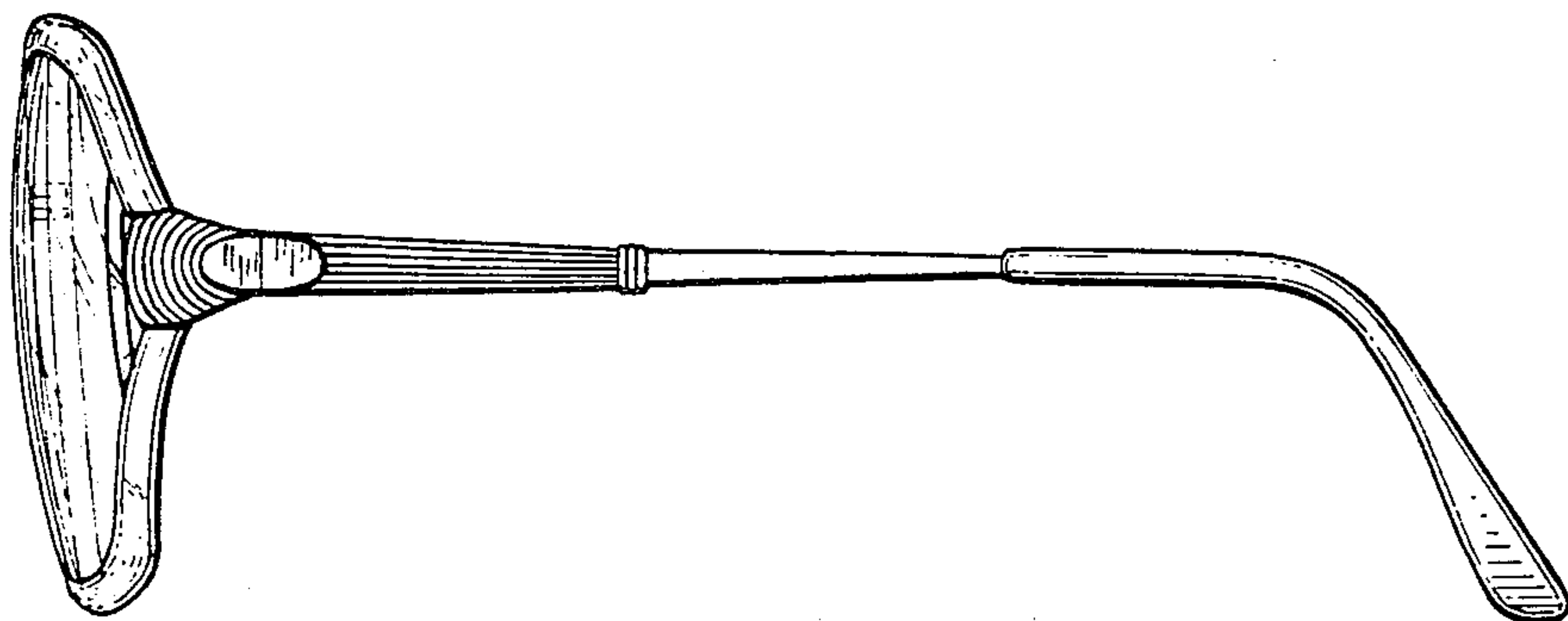

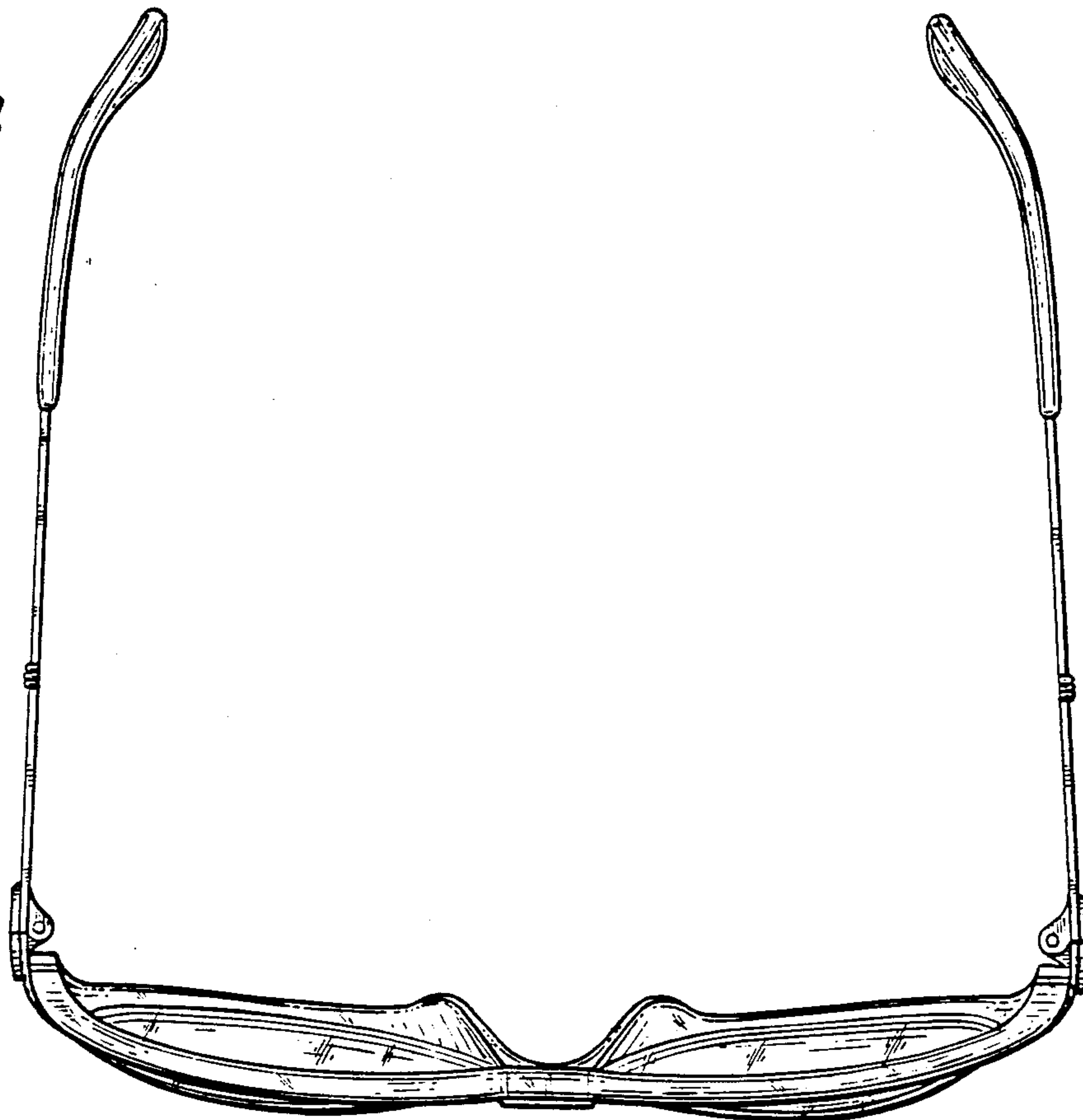
