The ornamental design for a sign, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a sign, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of a sign.

The sign has no substantial thickness. The rear face of the sign is substantially unornamented.

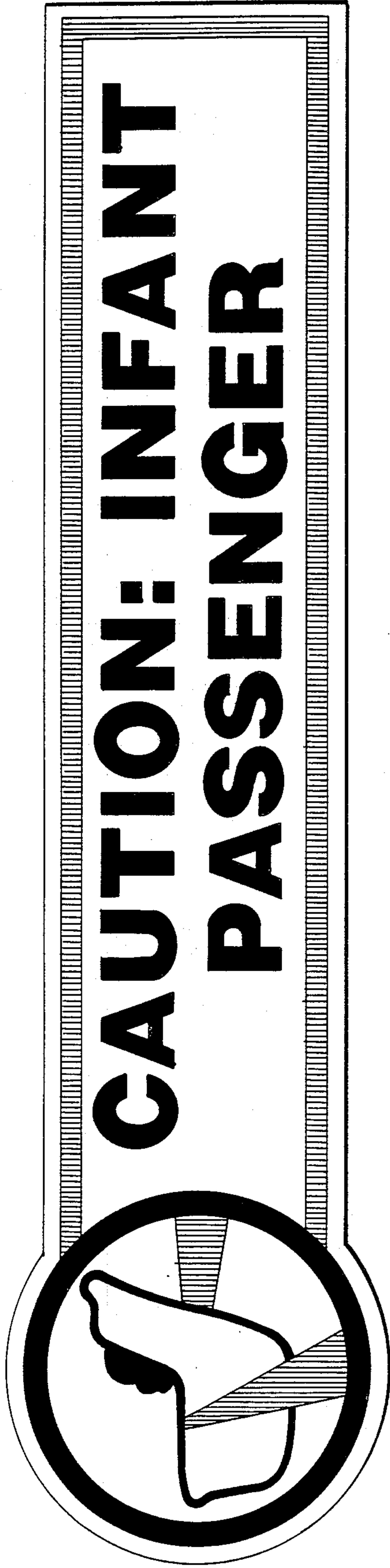
