DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair panel showing my design;

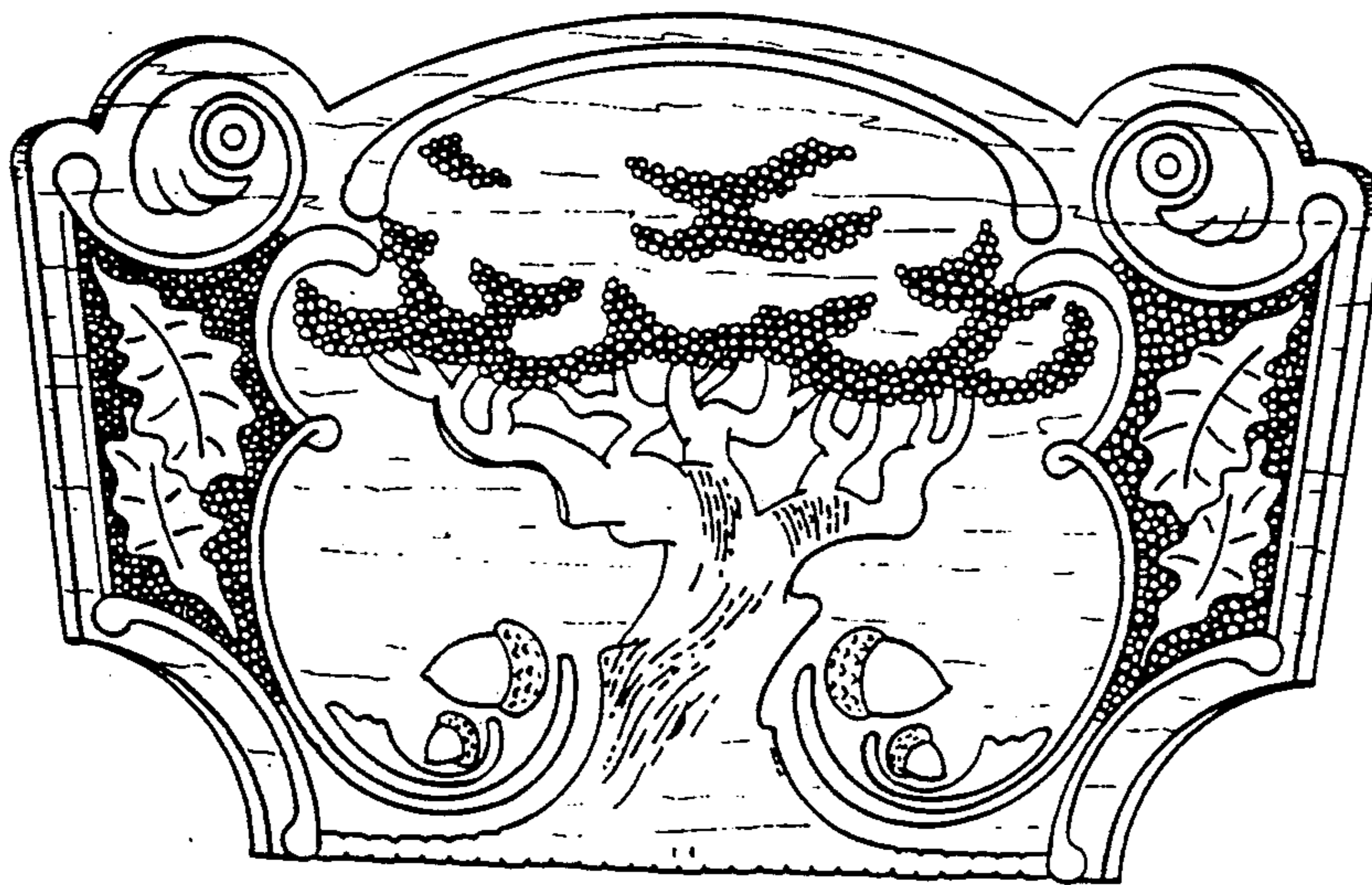
FIG. 2 is a top view of the chair panel of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the chair panel of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an end view of the chair panel of FIG. 1.

The end view opposite FIG. 4 (not shown) is the mirror image of FIG. 4.

The undisclosed rear surface of the chair panel is essentially unadorned.



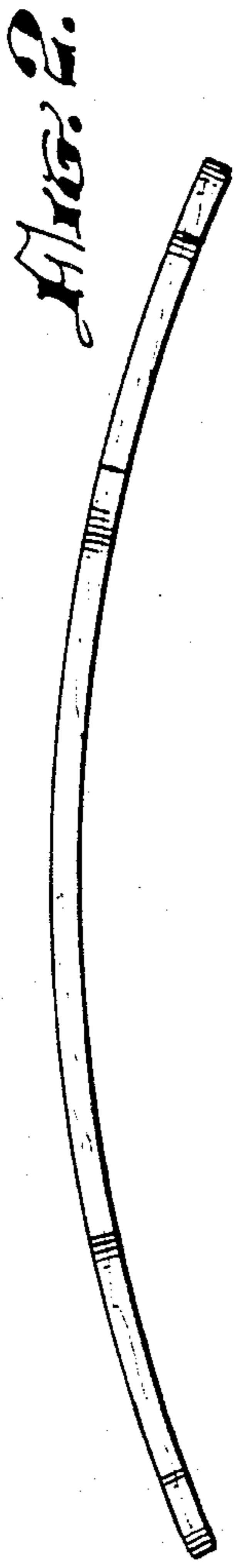

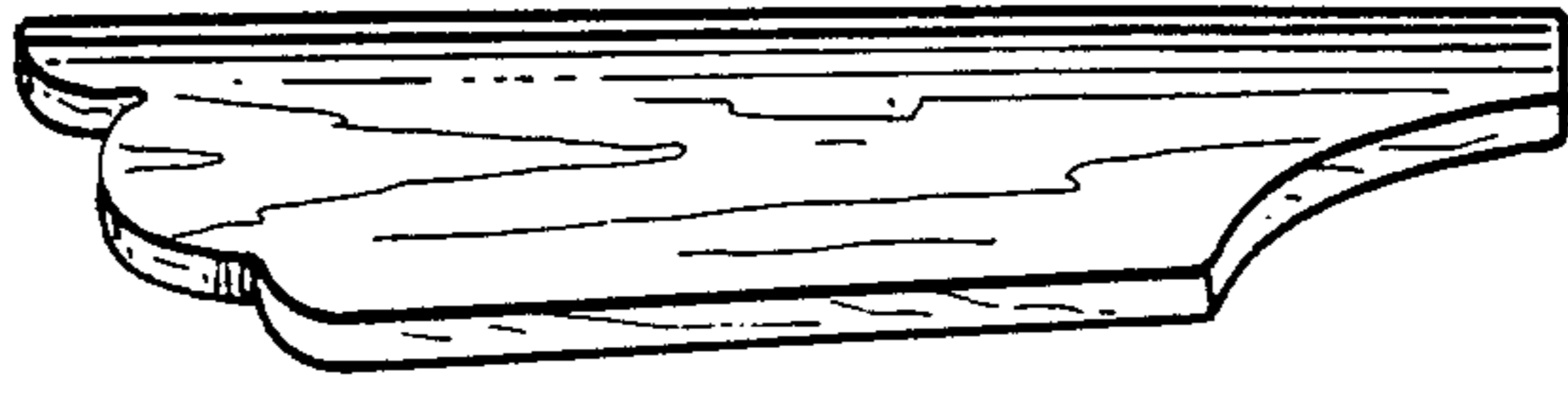

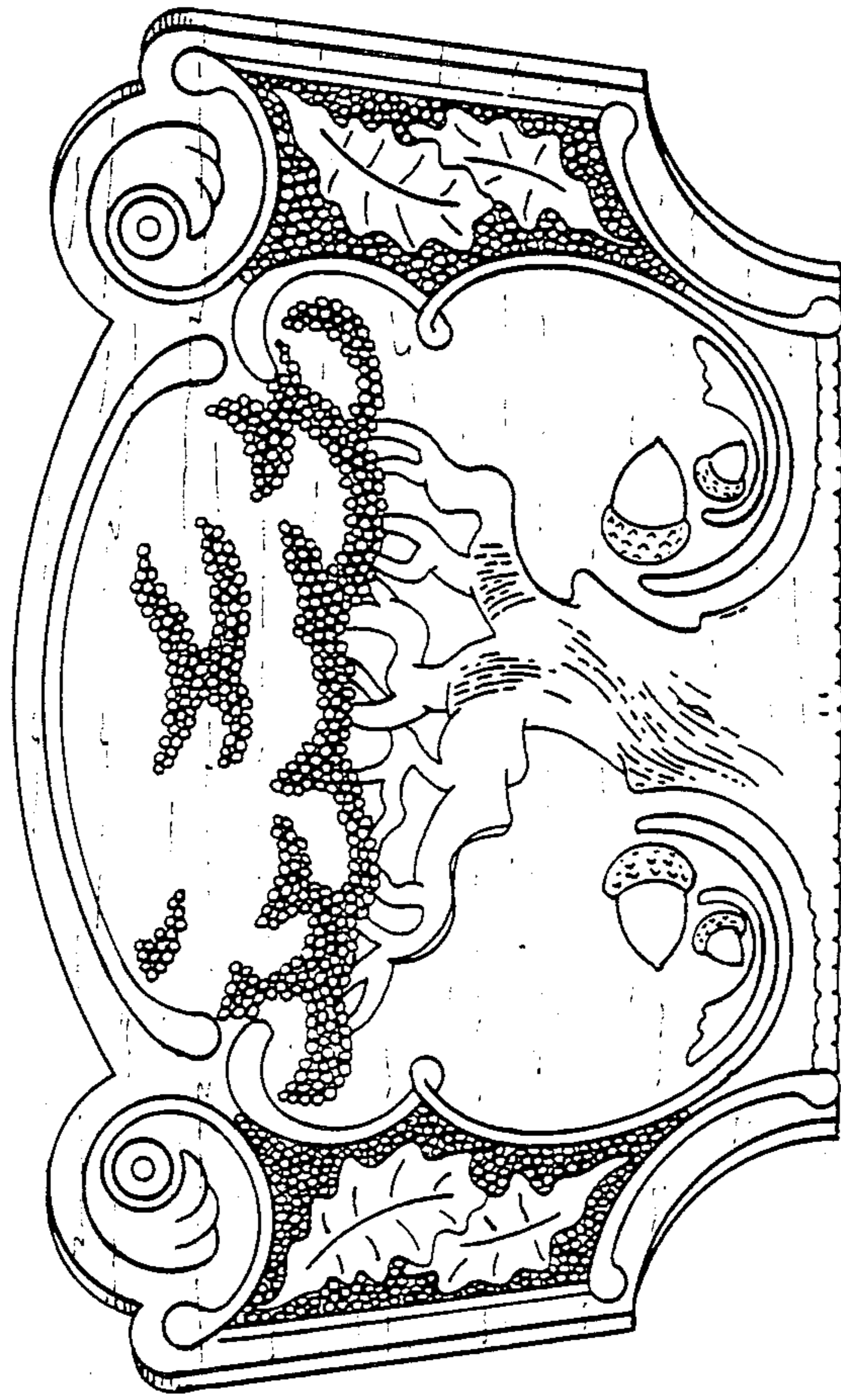
