DESCRIPTION

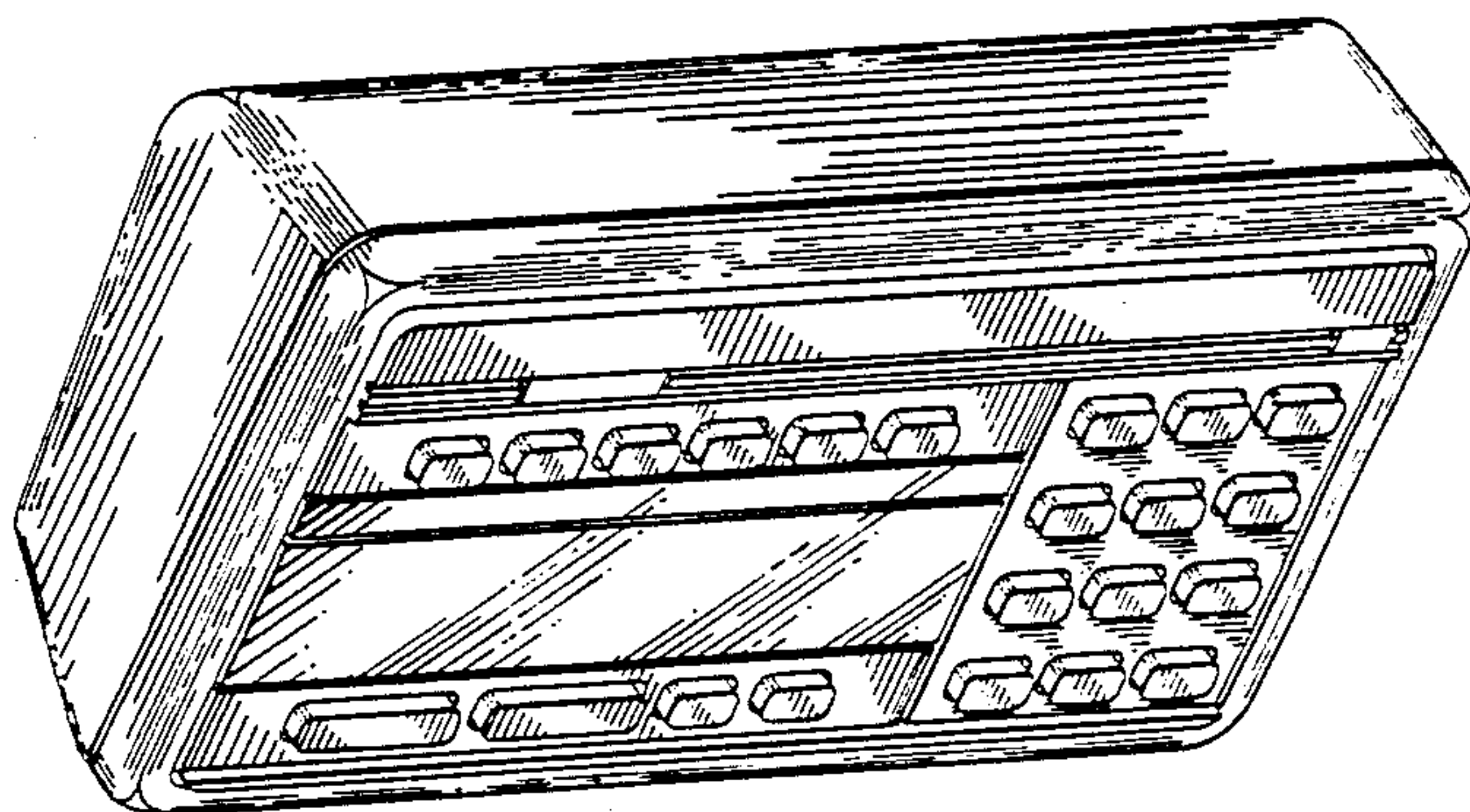
FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a radio control unit or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a second embodiment of the radio control unit illustrated in FIG. 1.



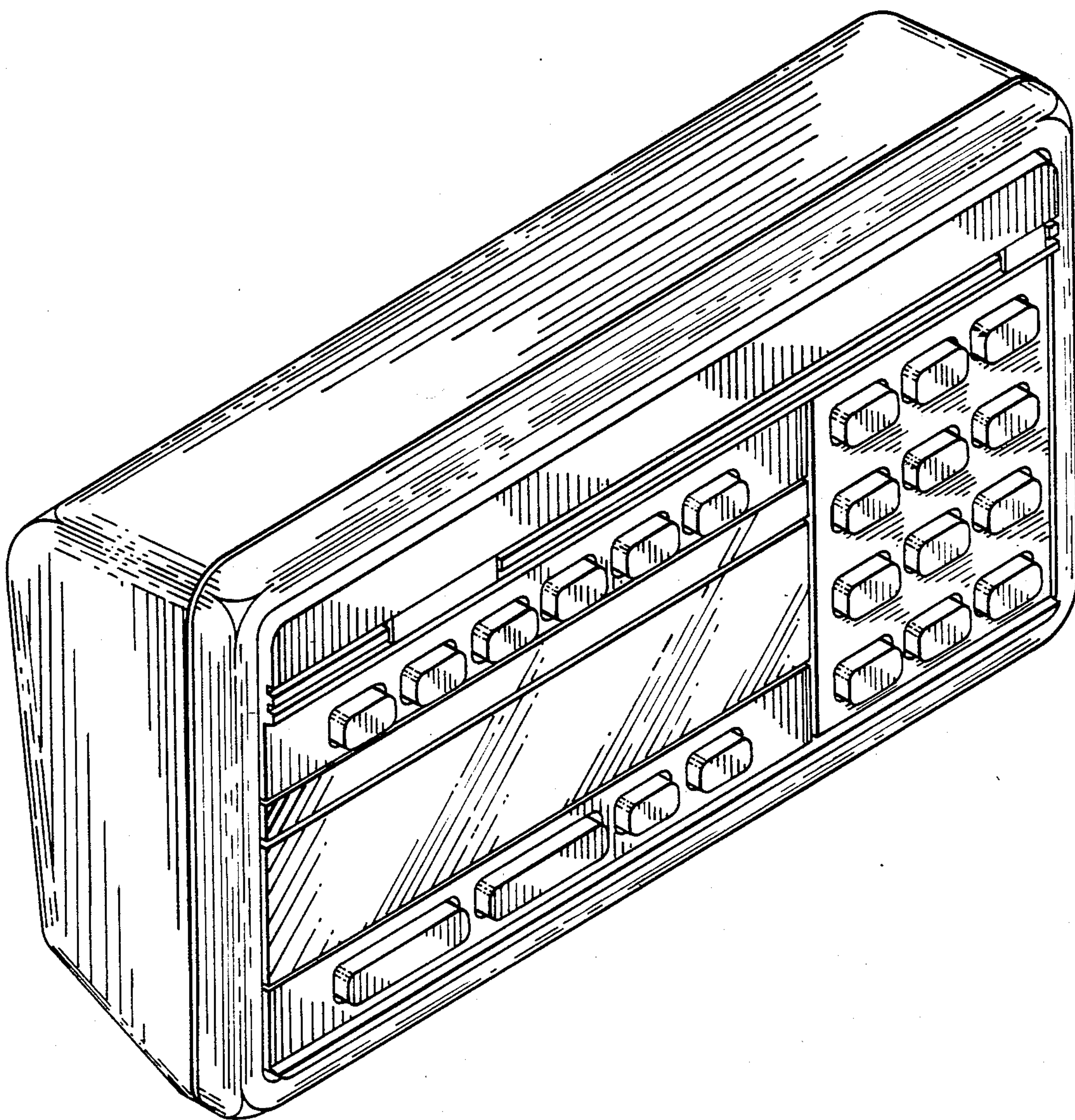

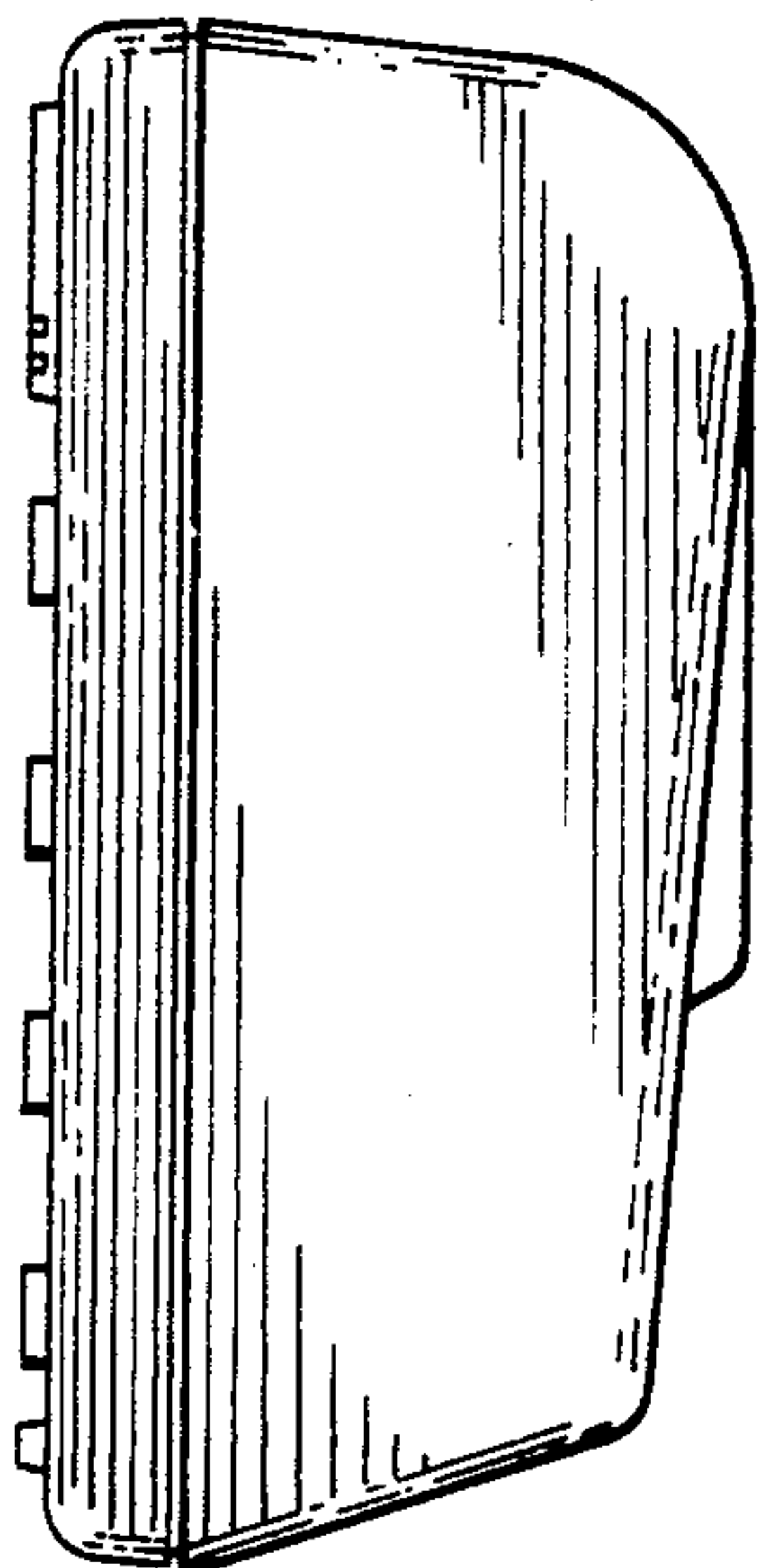

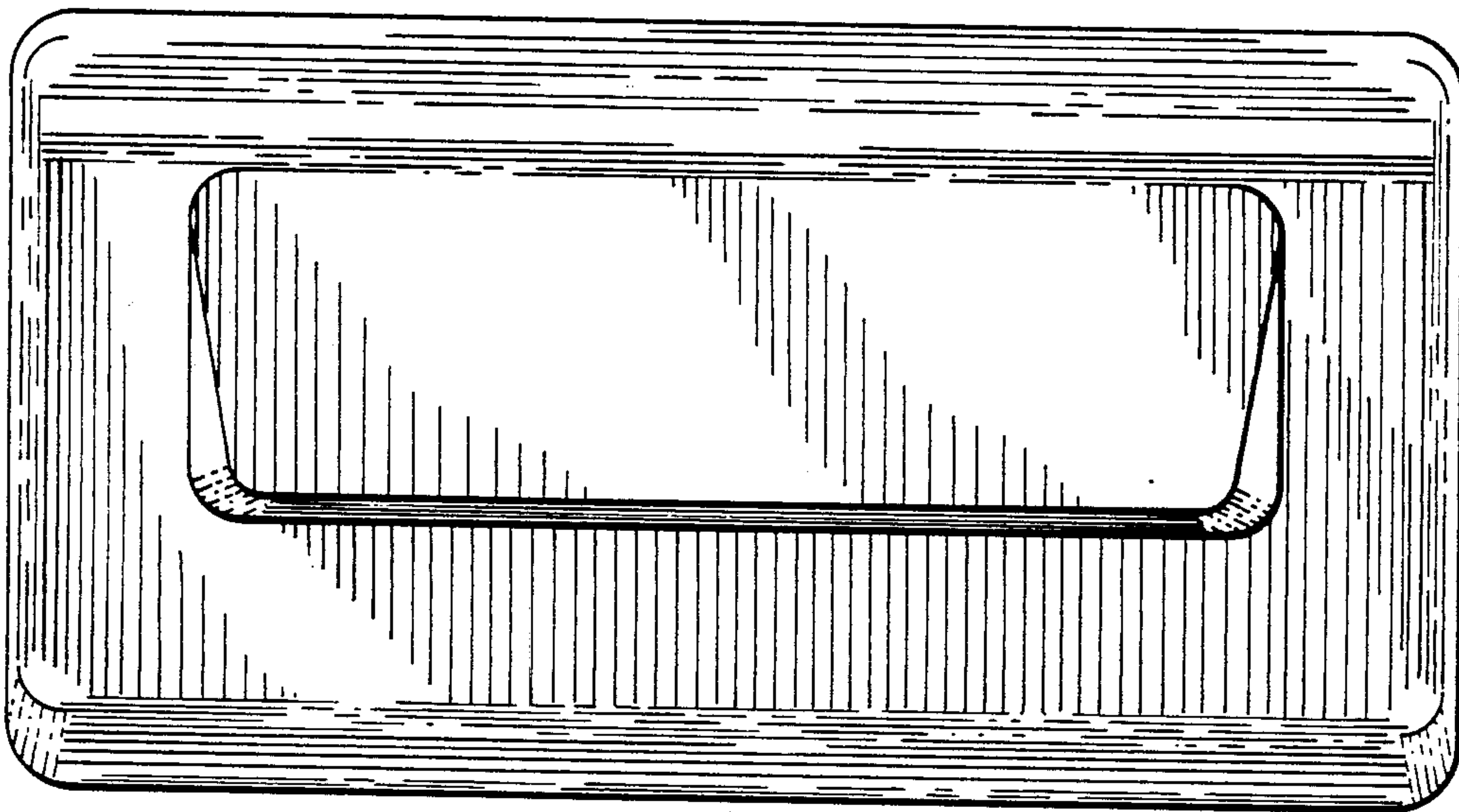
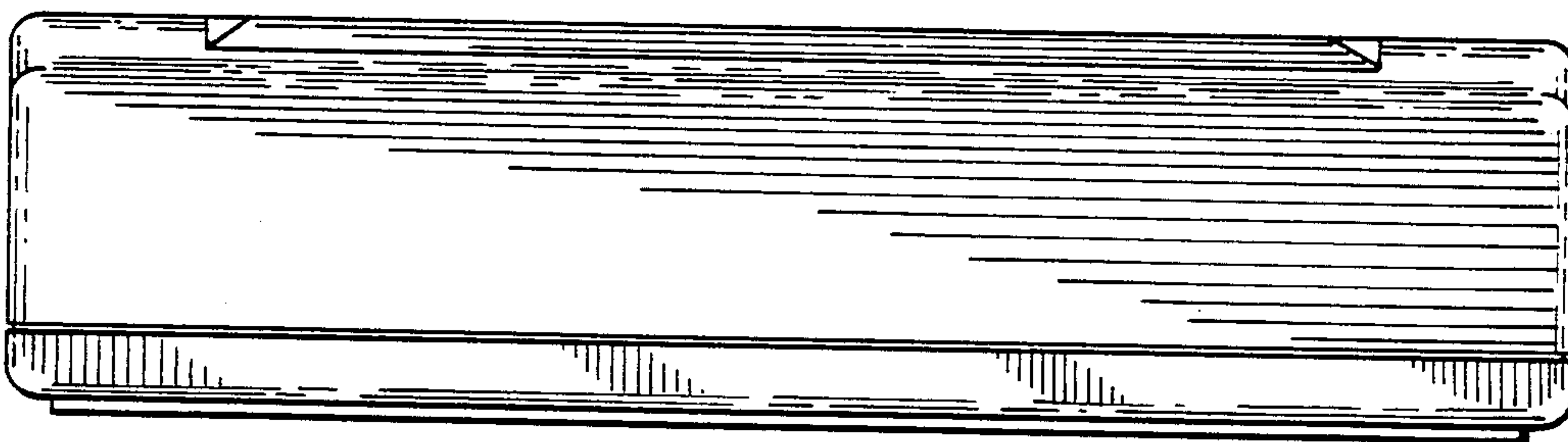

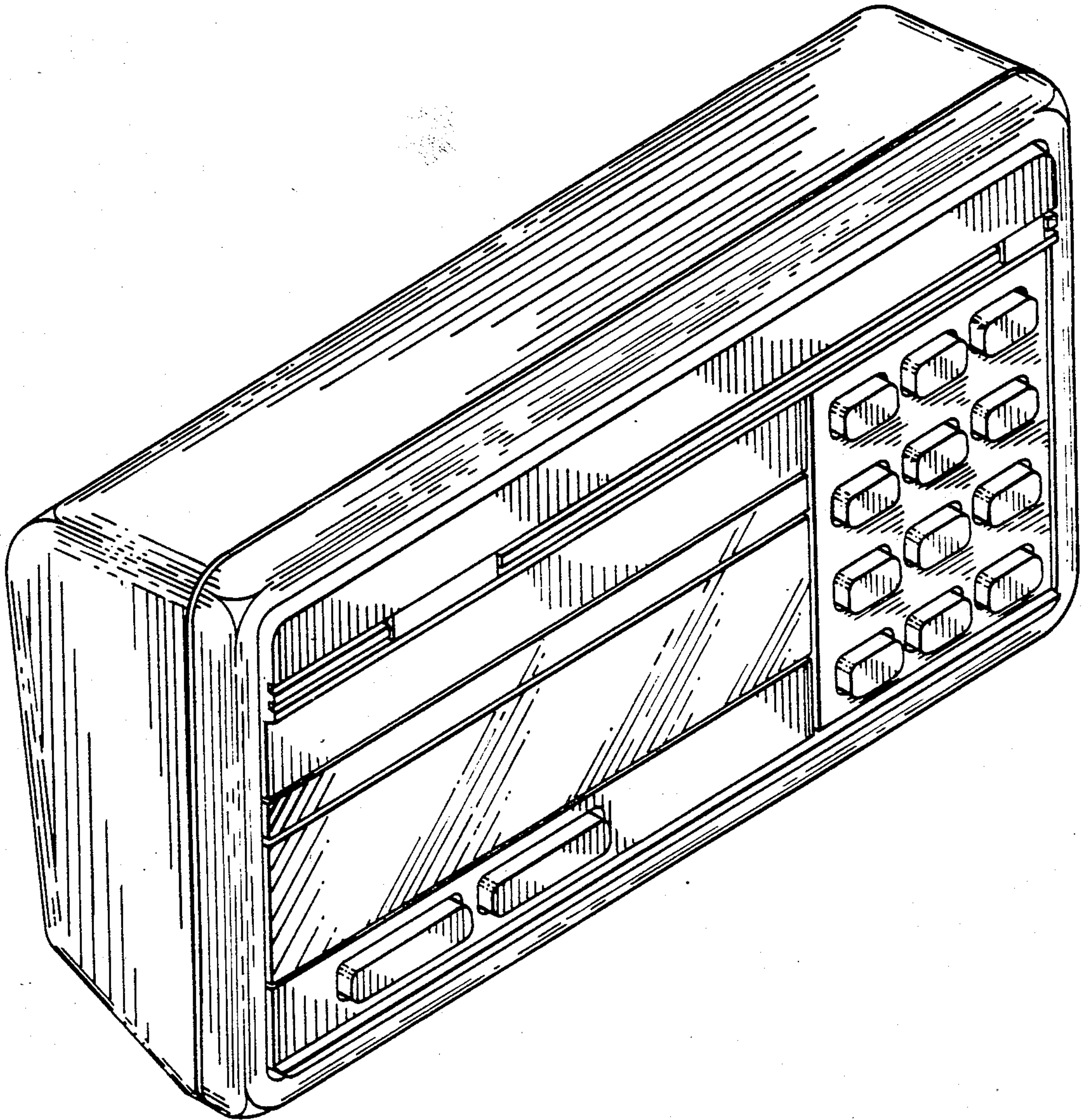
