described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the lampshade
showing my new design, the rear being mirror-identical
thereto;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the other side
being mirror-identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

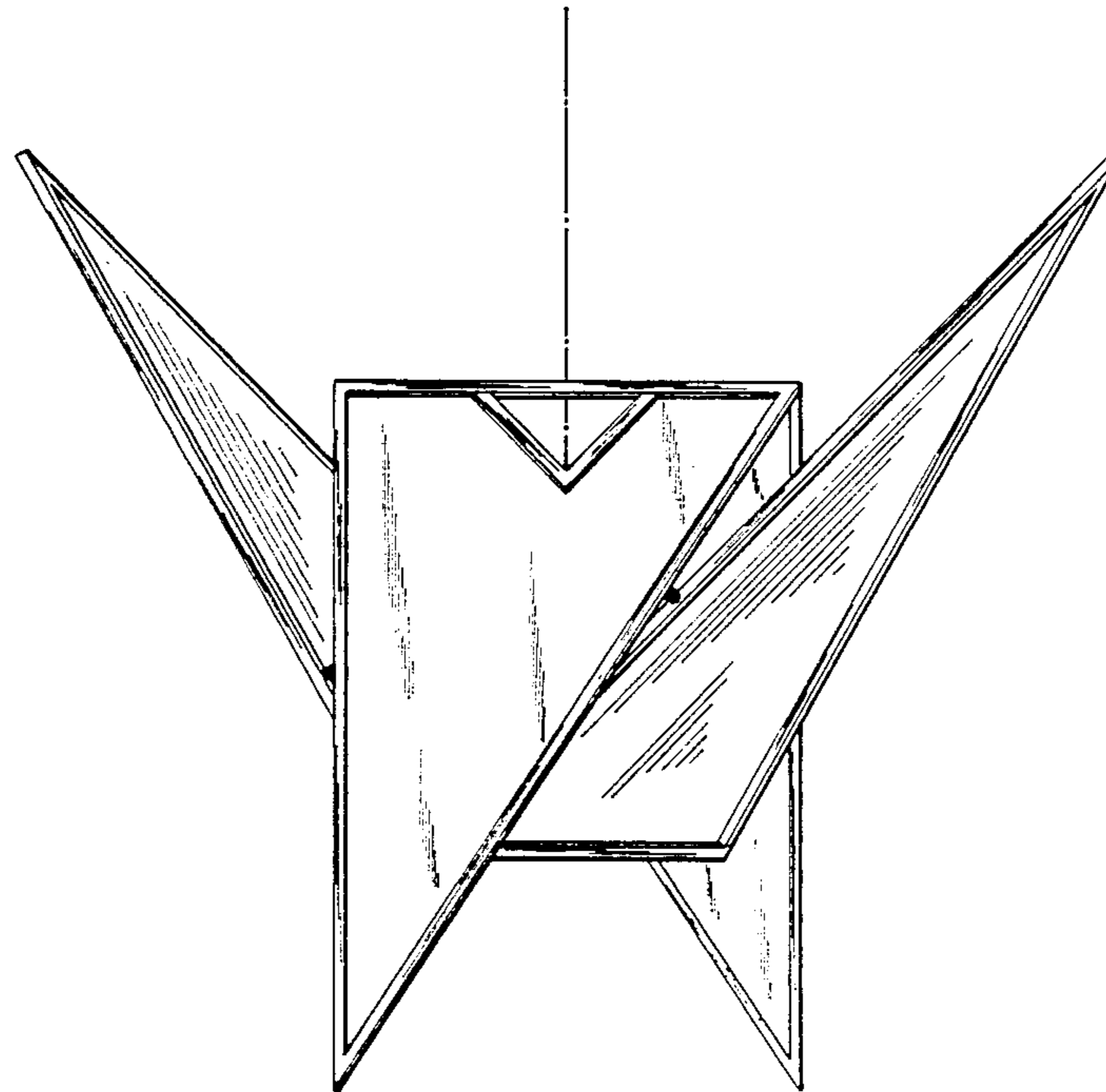
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of another embodi-
ment of the lampshade showing my new design, the rear

only.



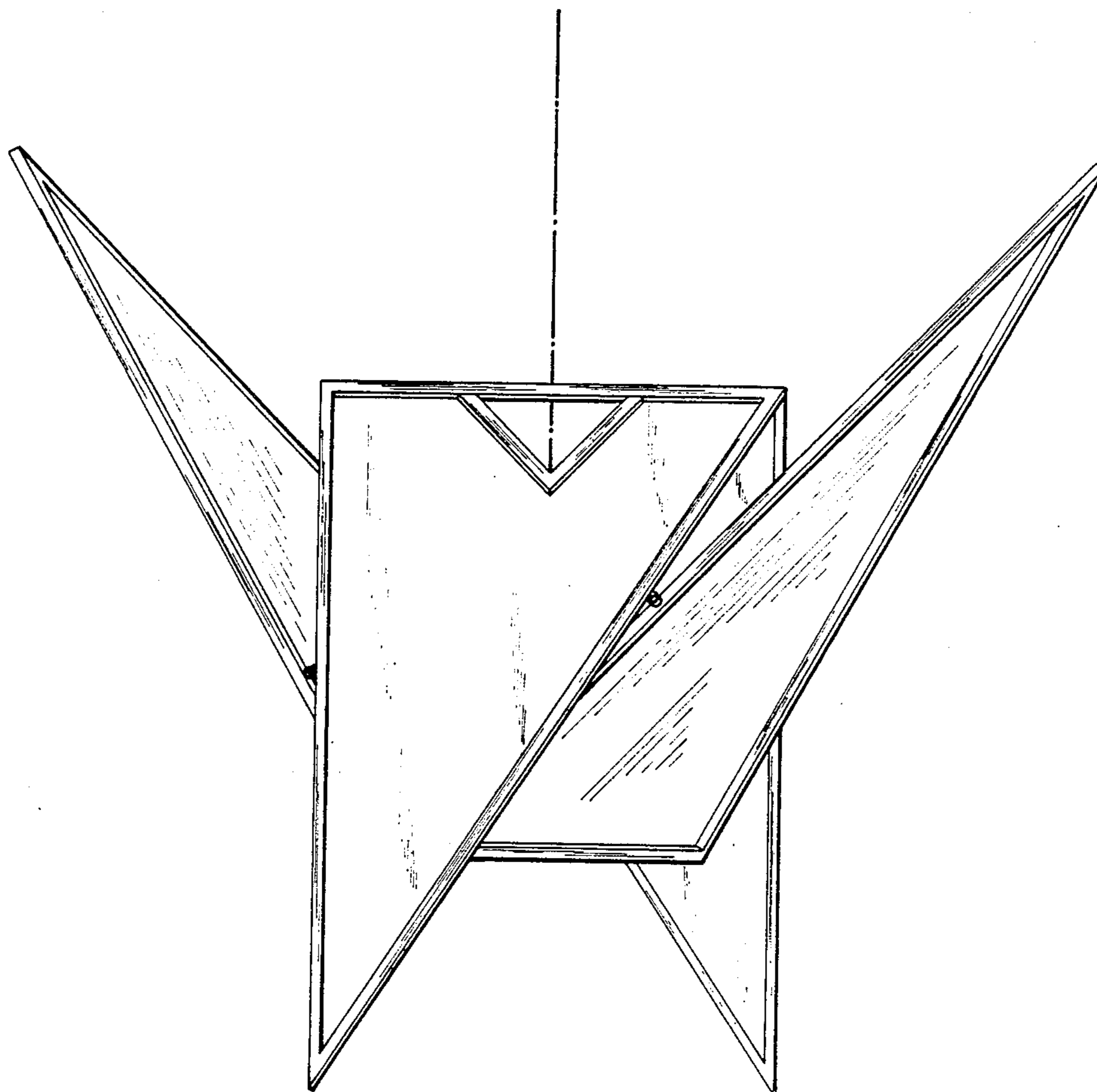

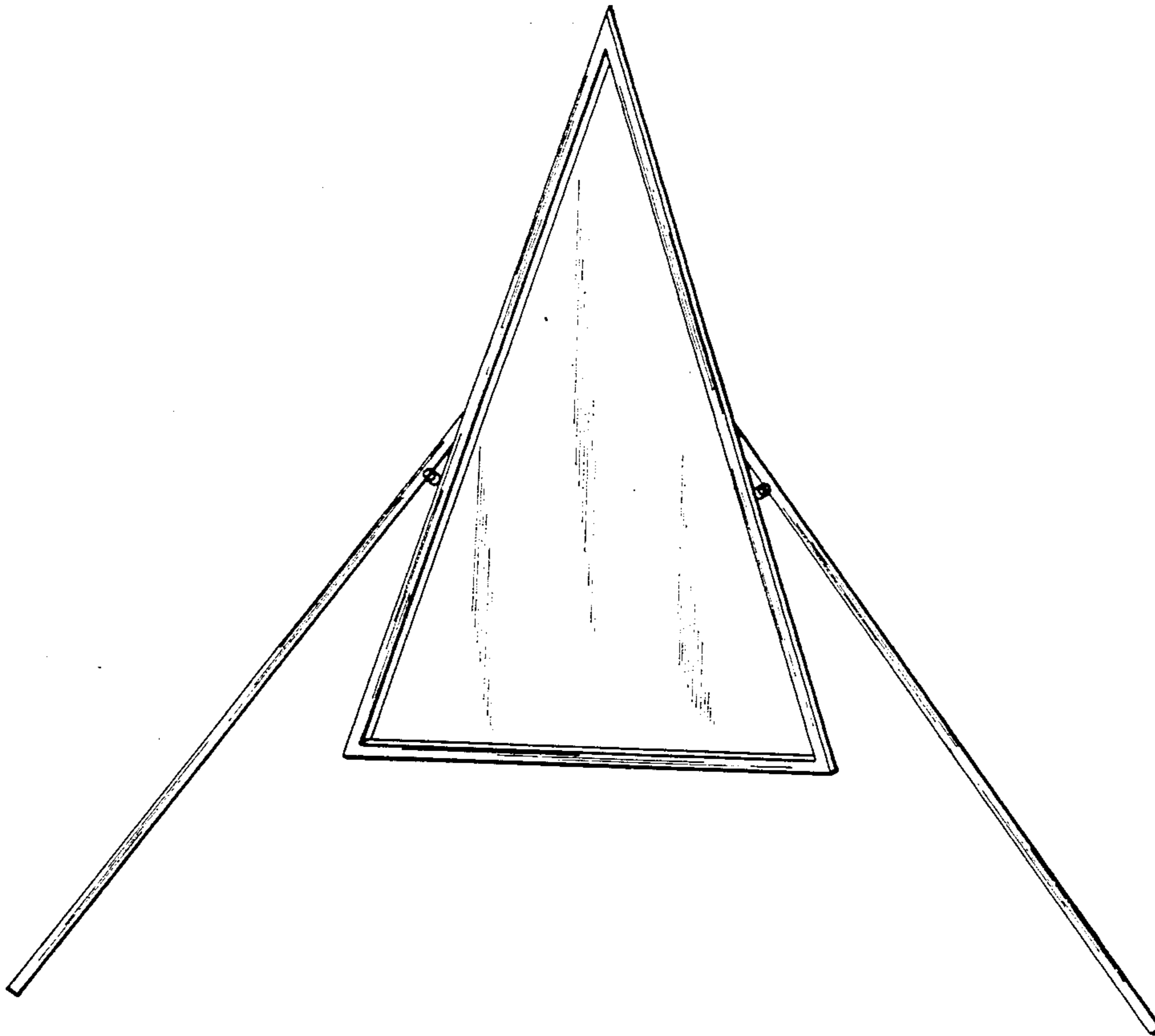

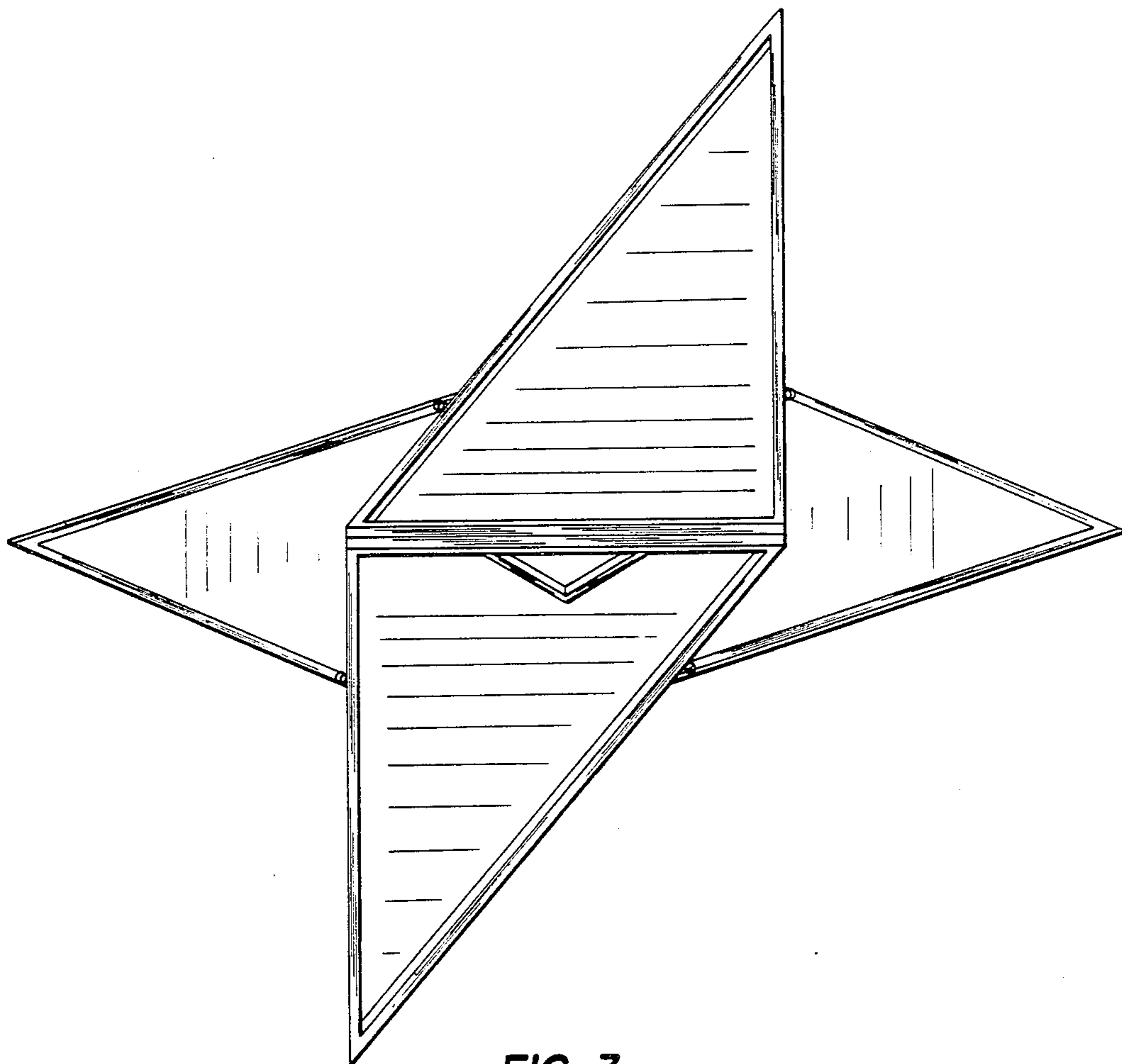

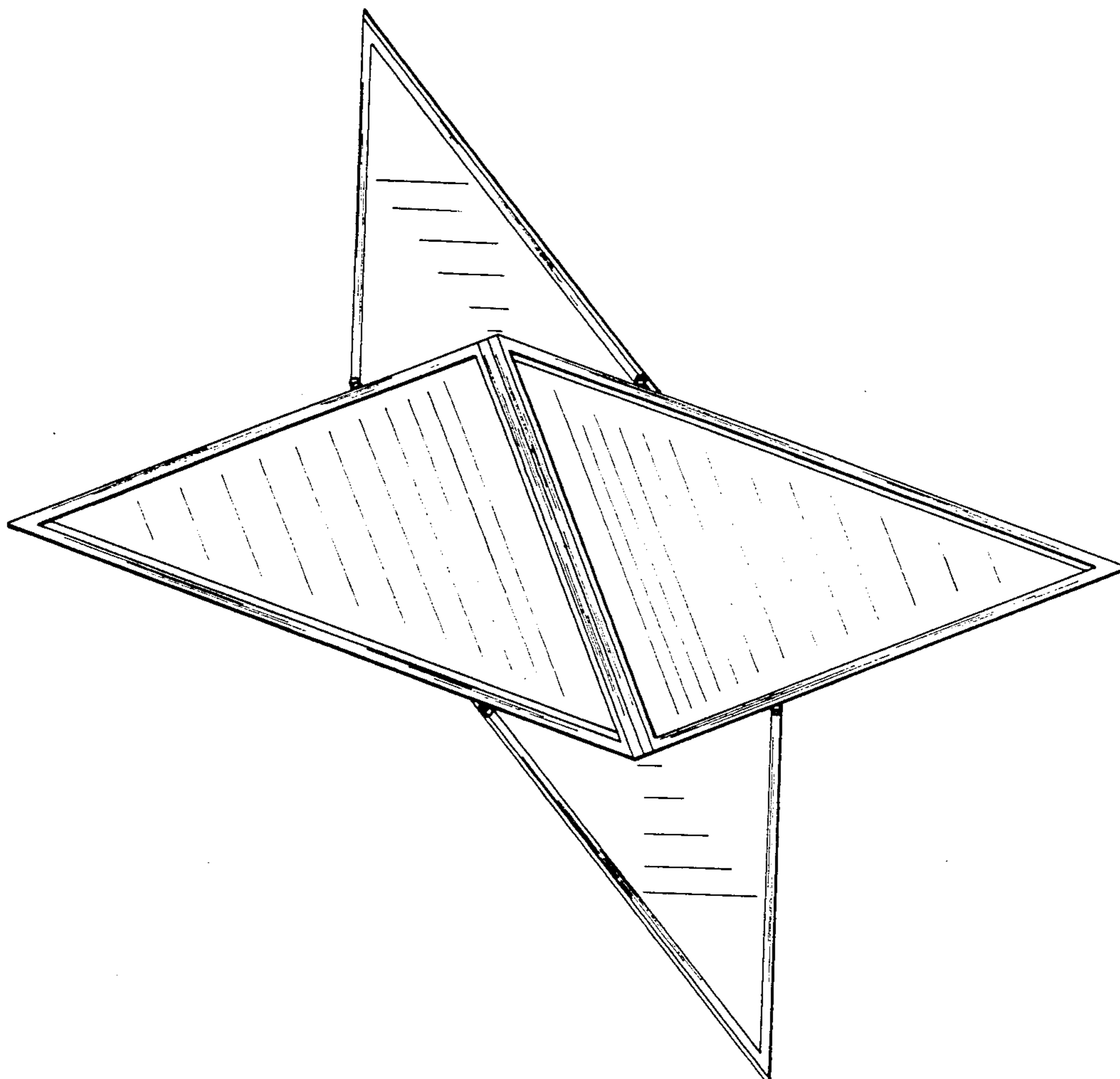

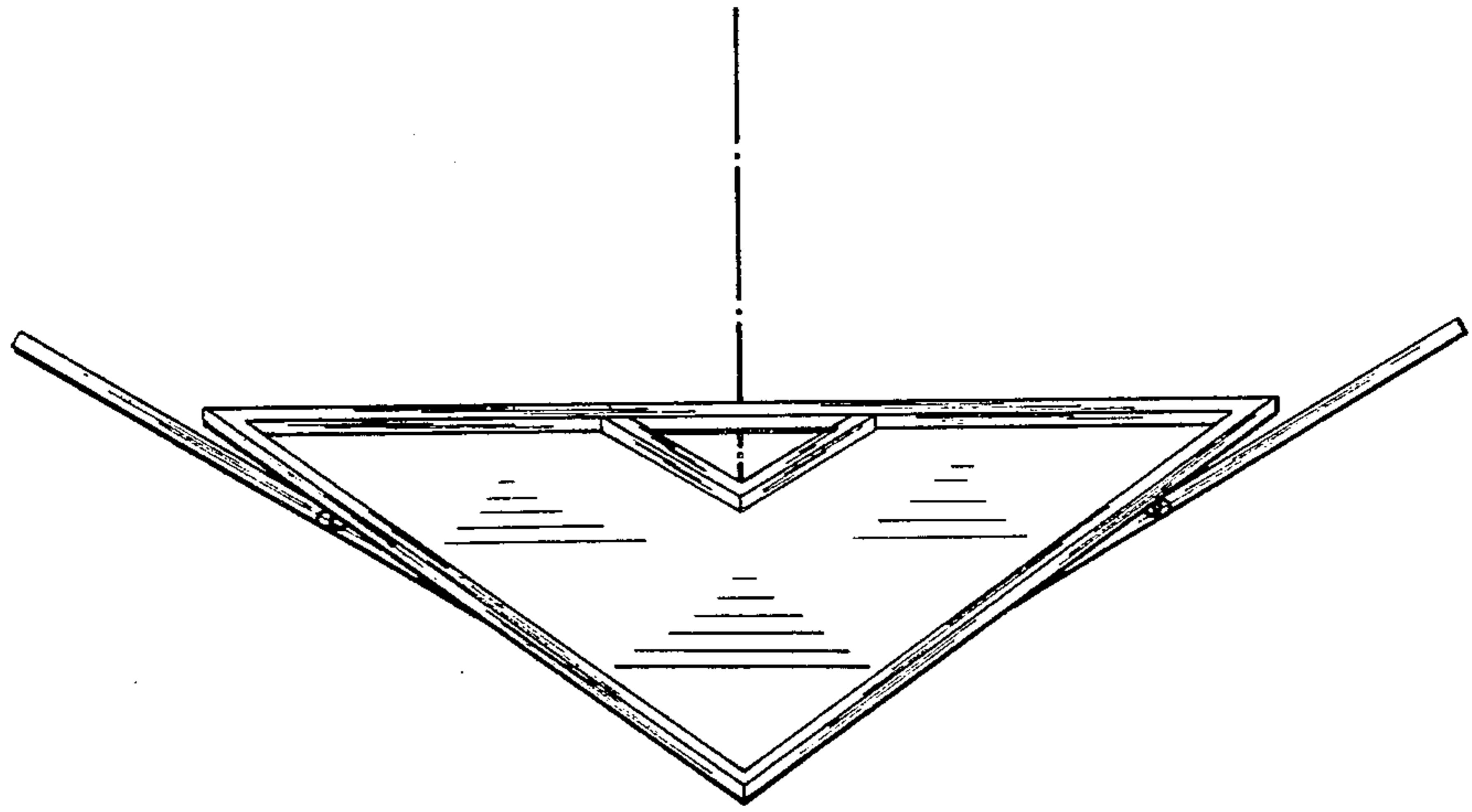

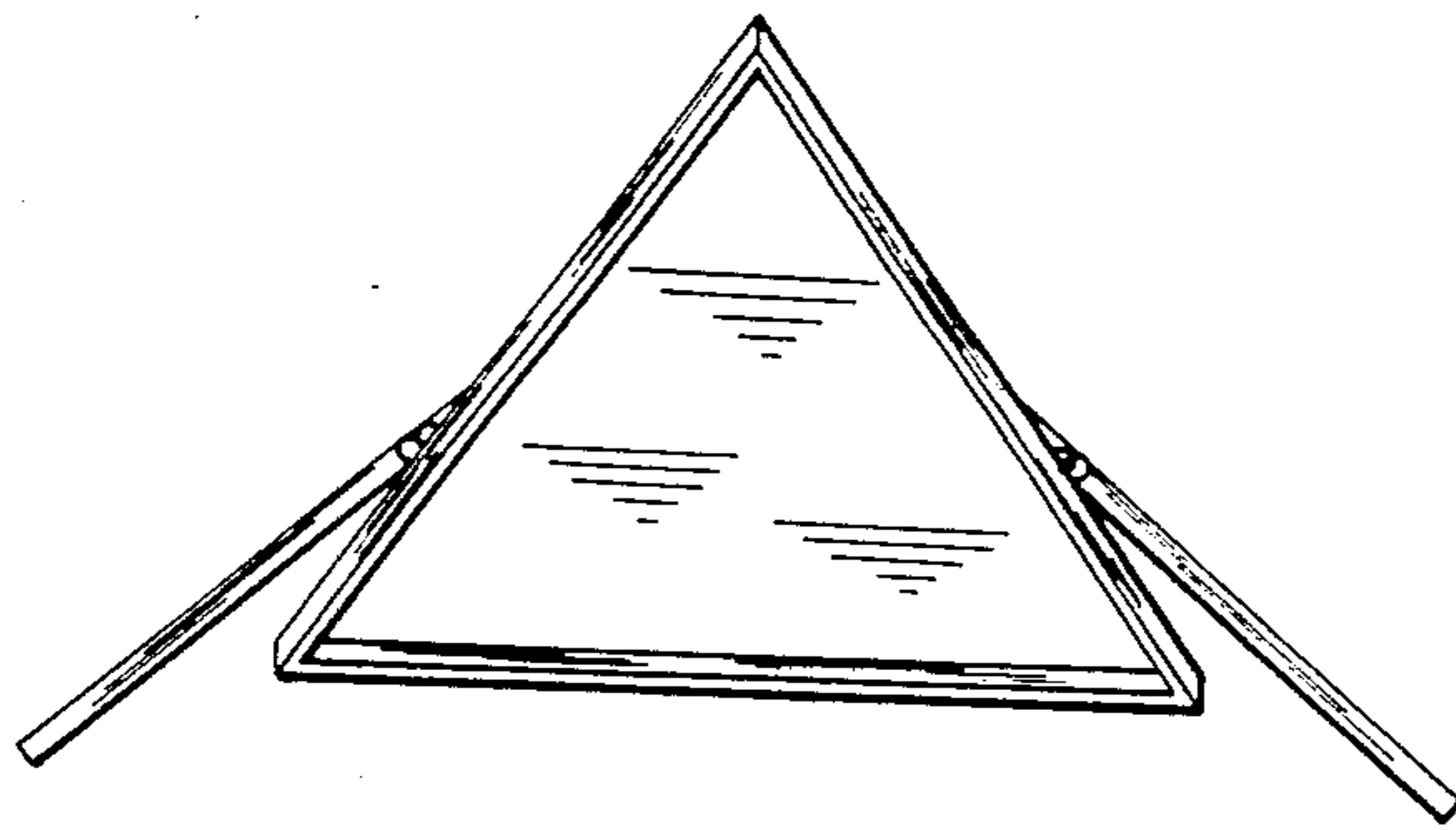

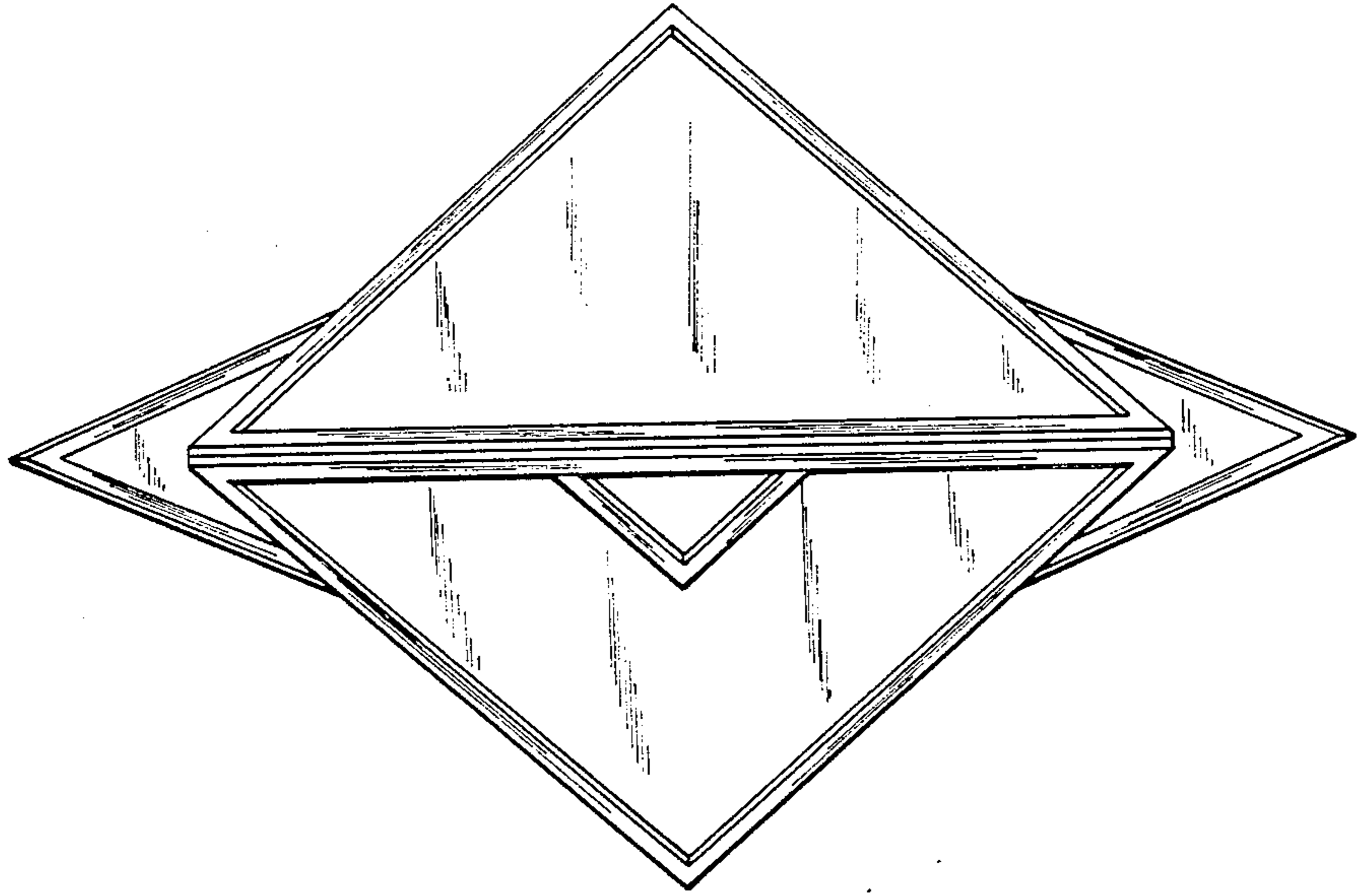

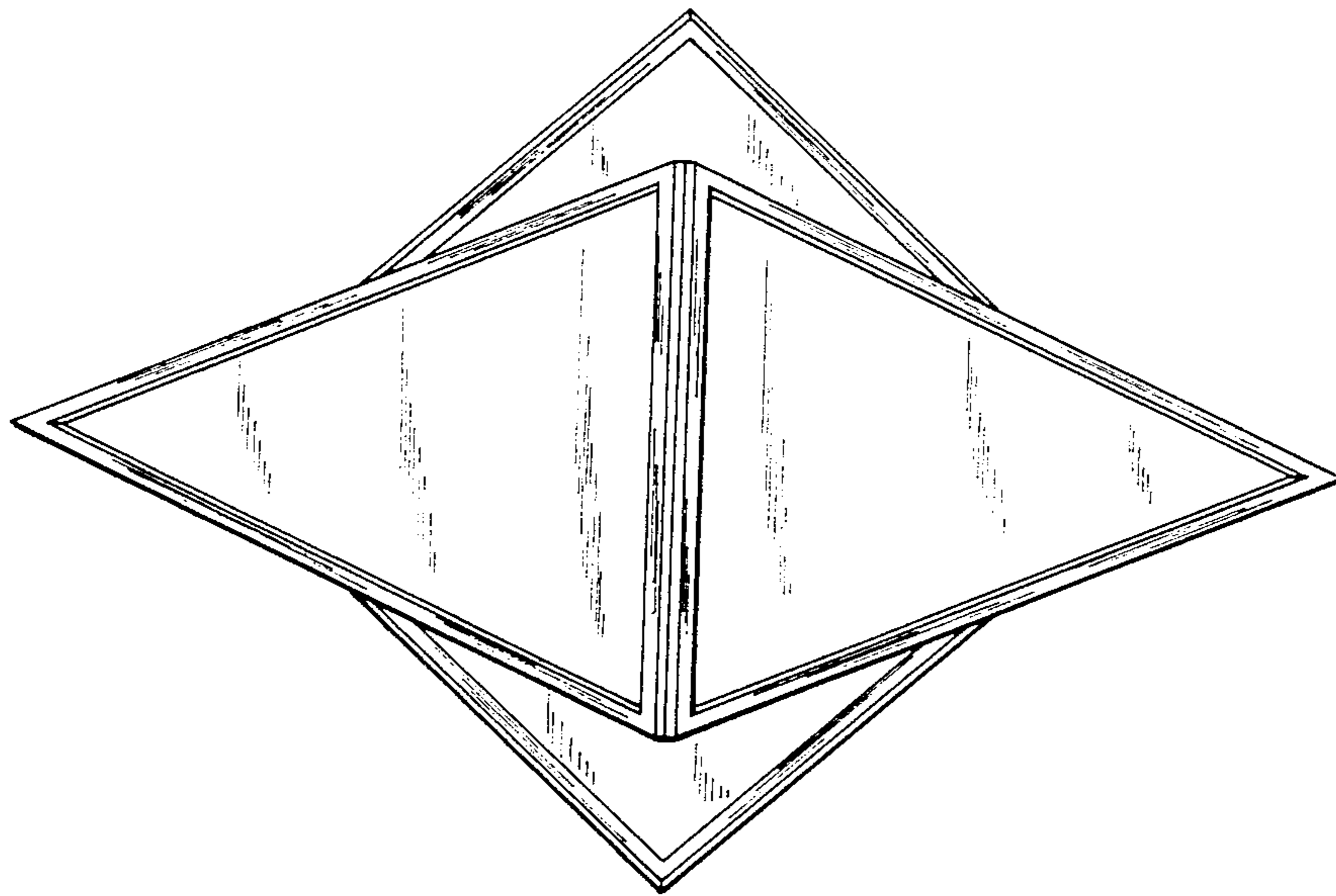
