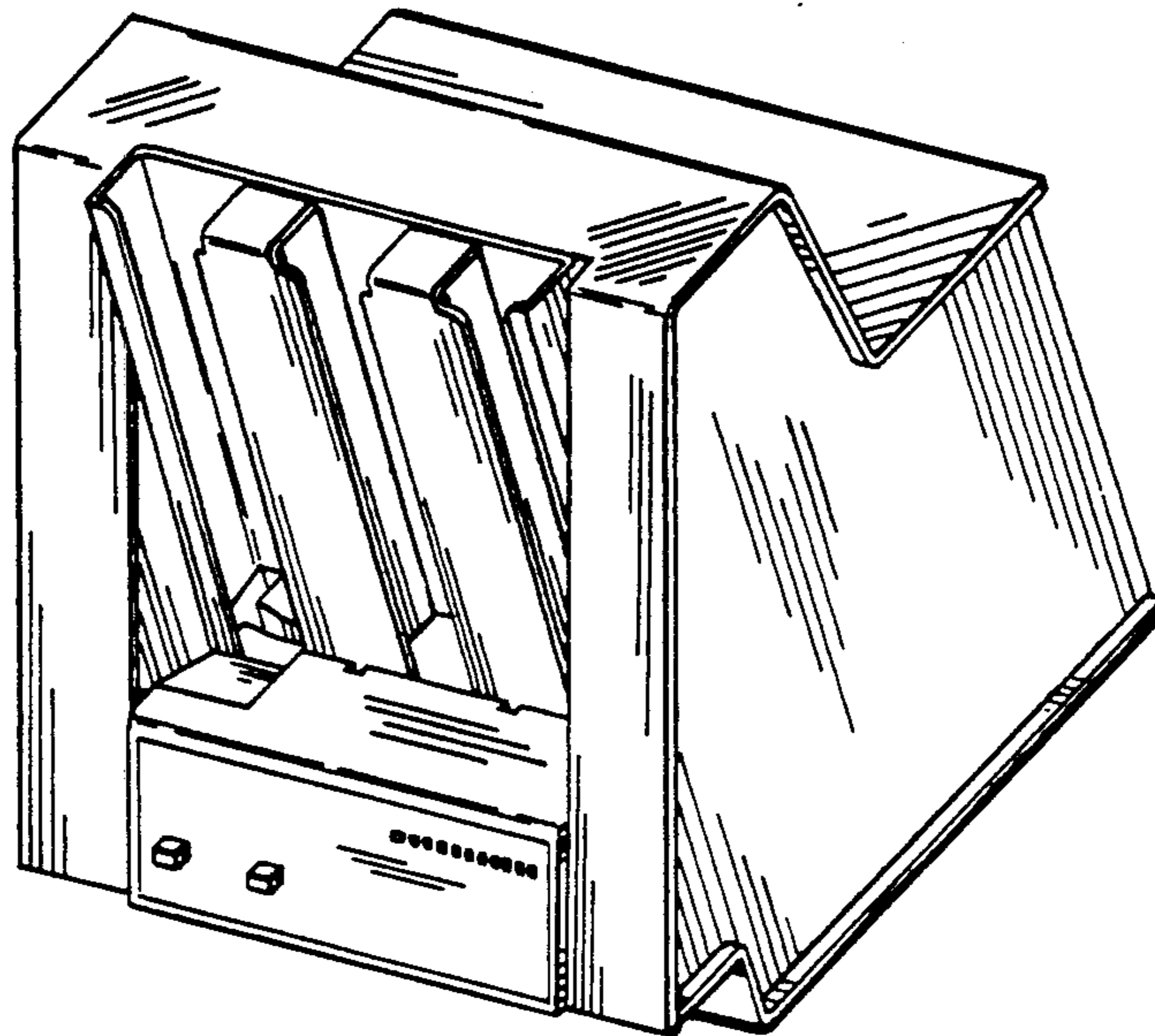

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cassette changer showing our new design;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.



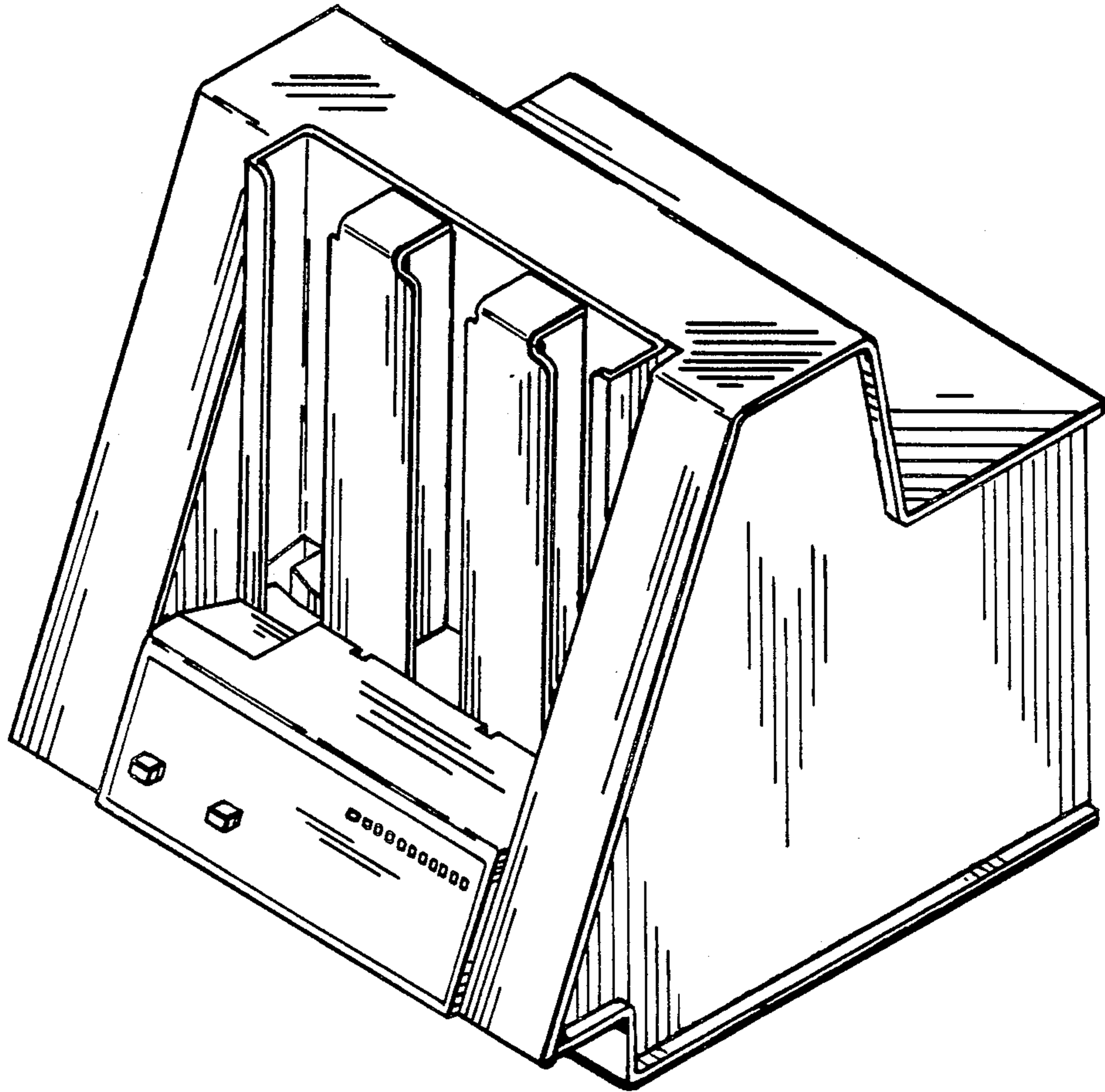

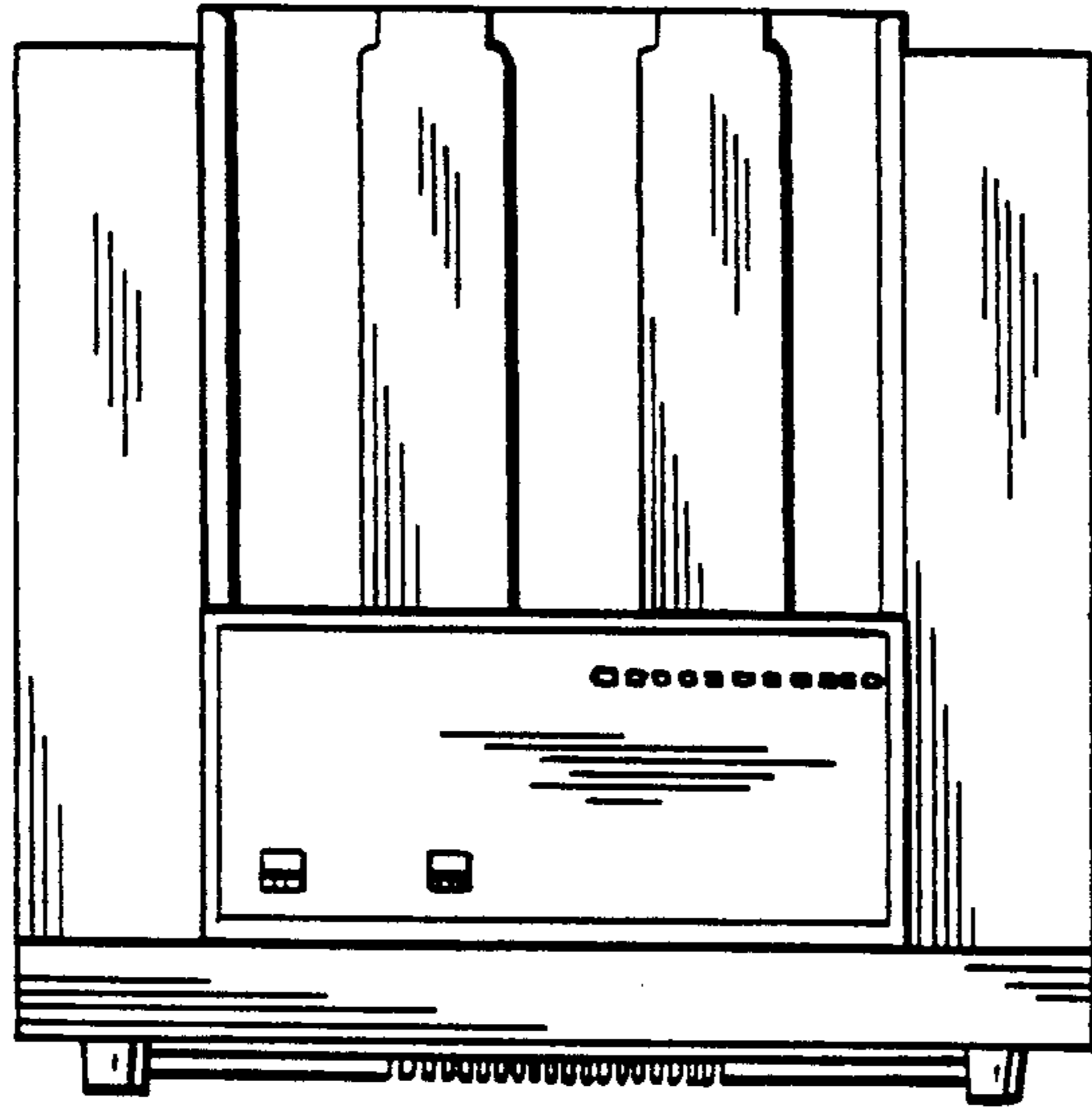

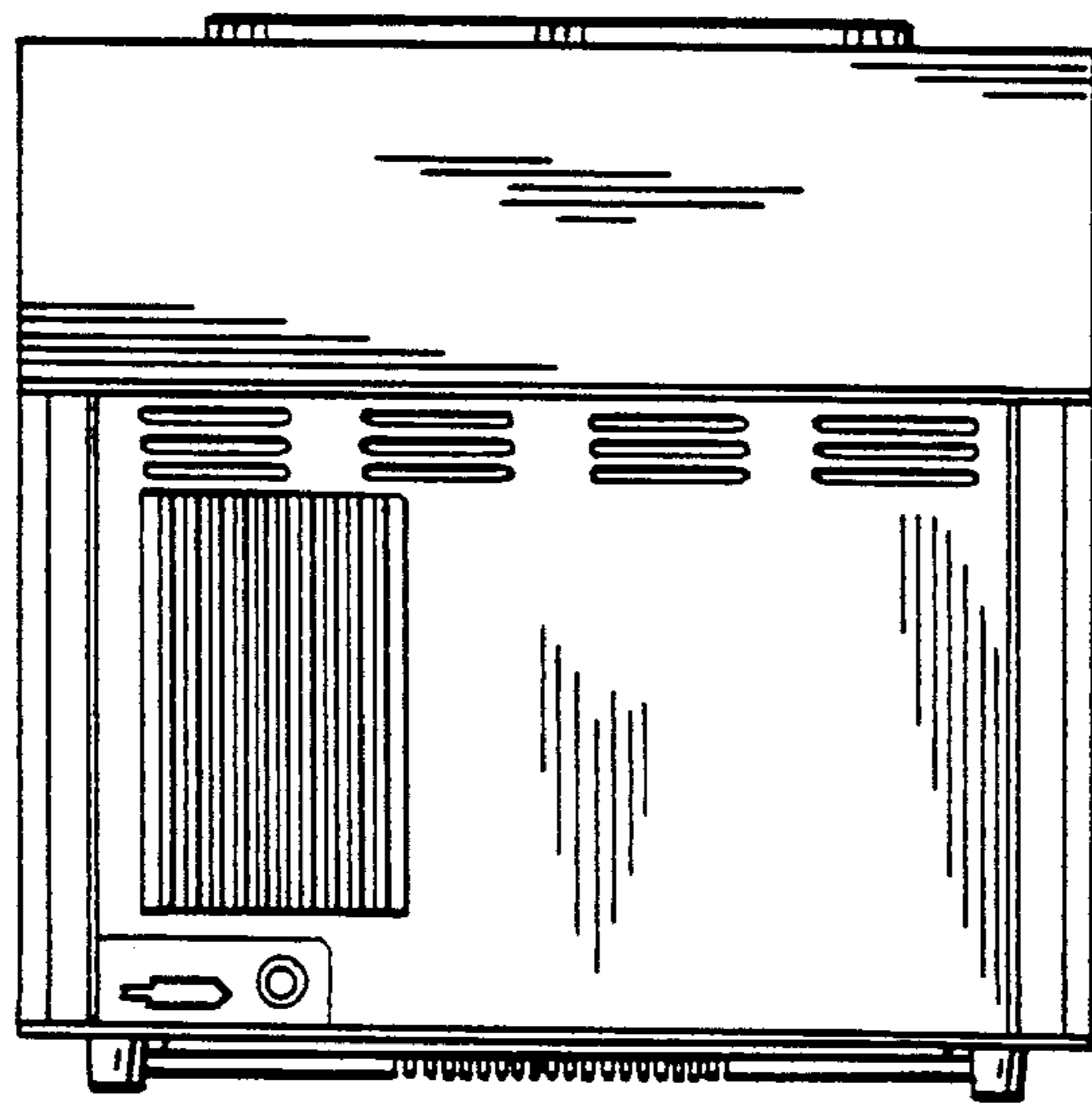

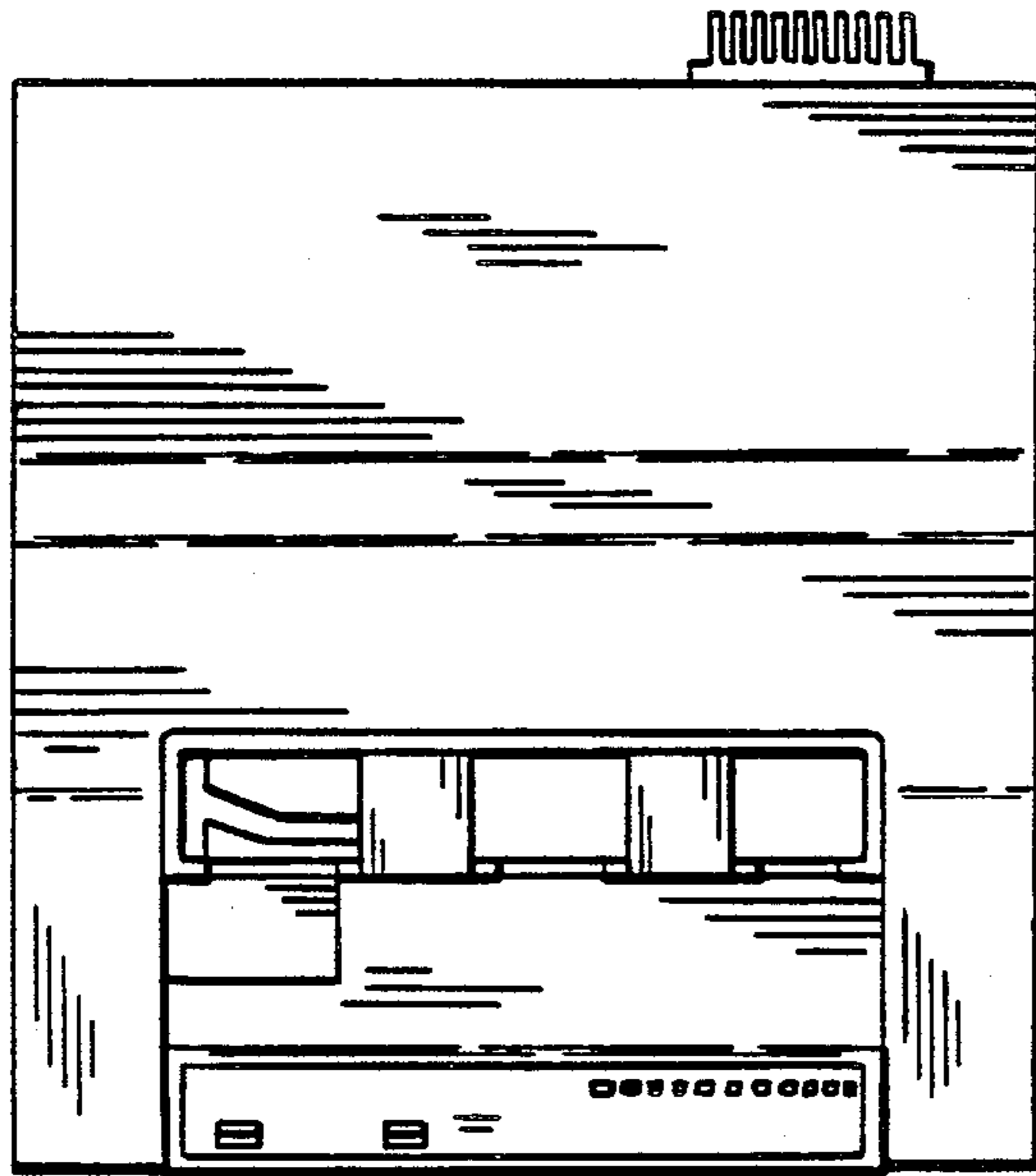

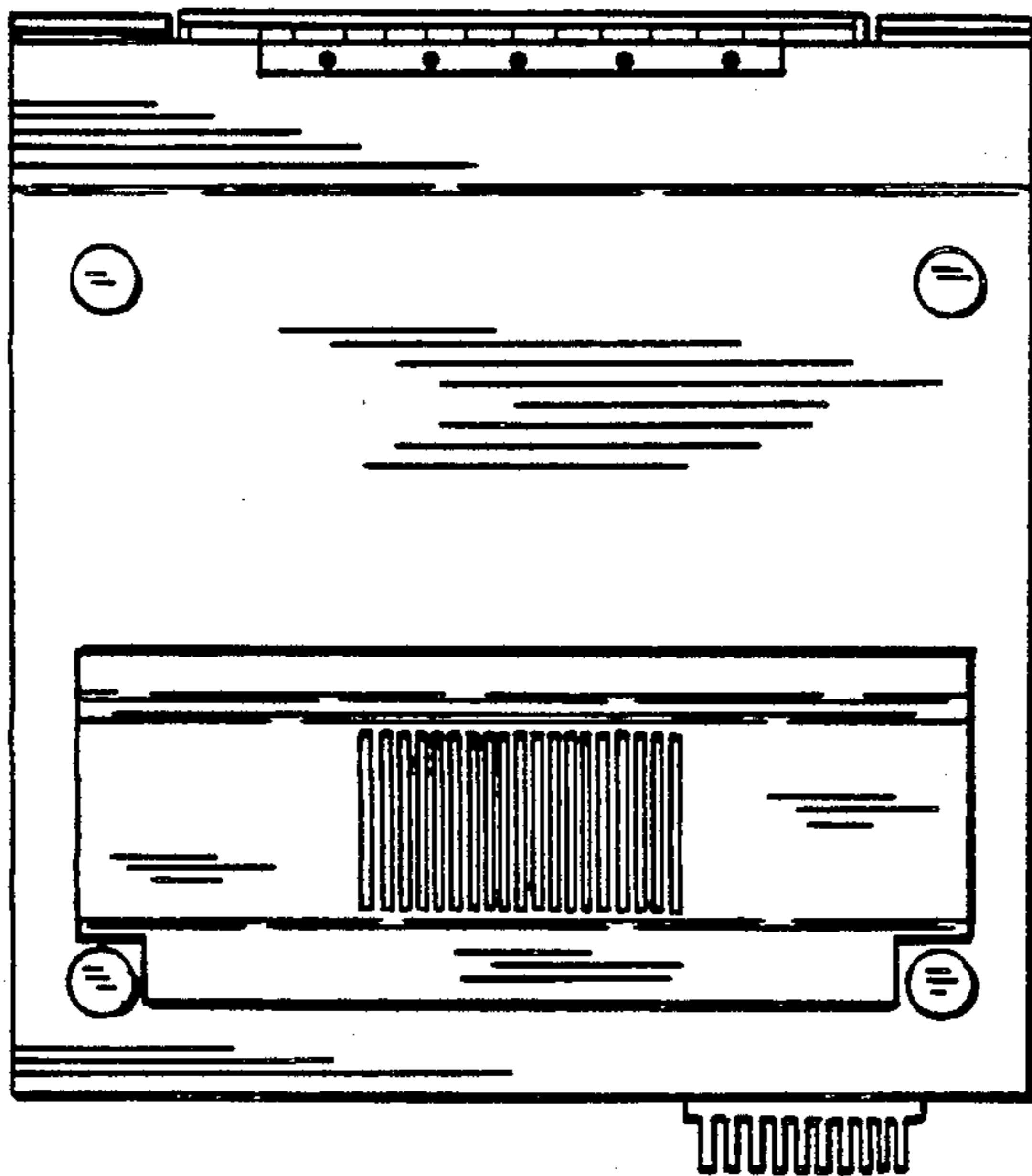

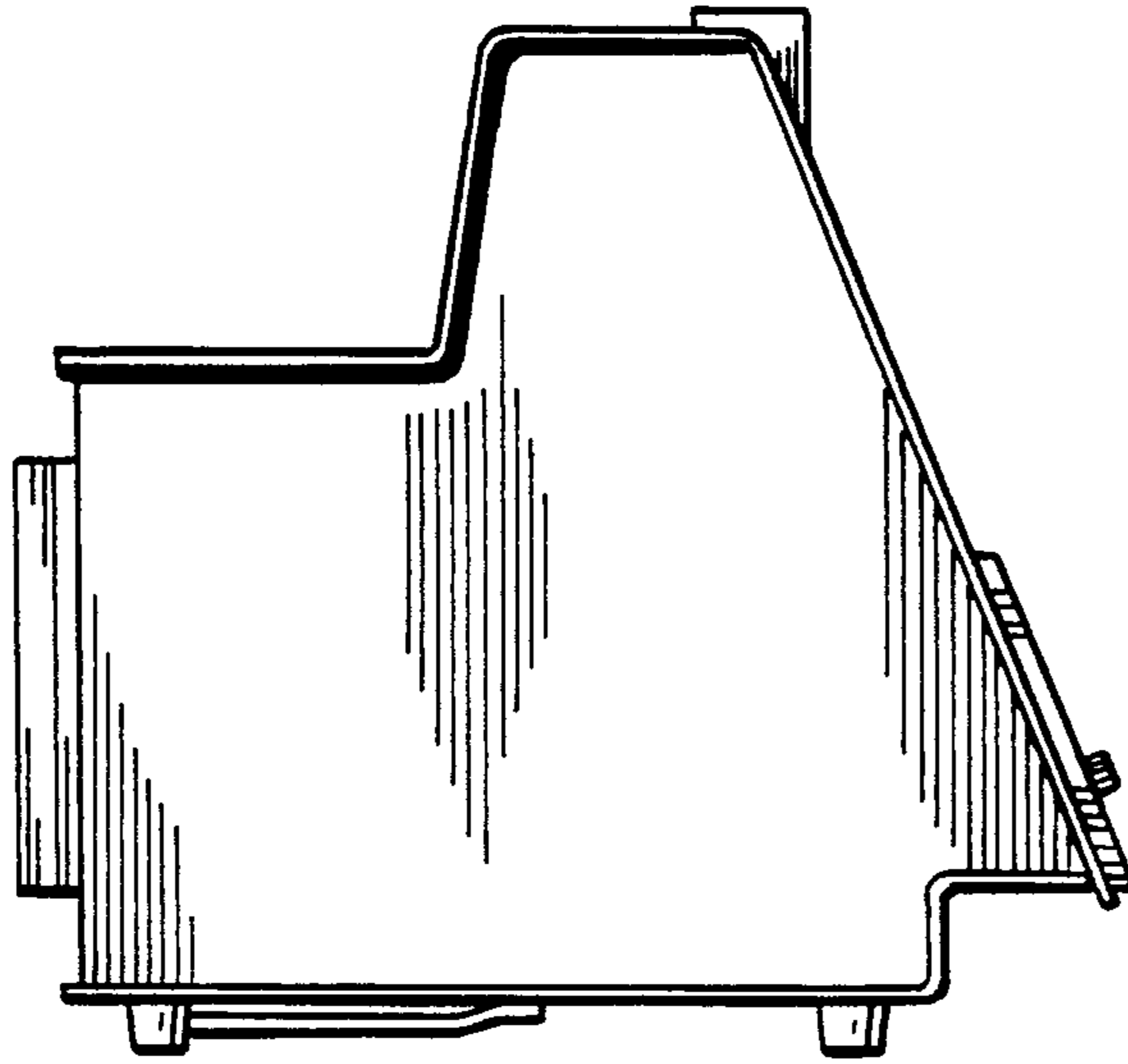

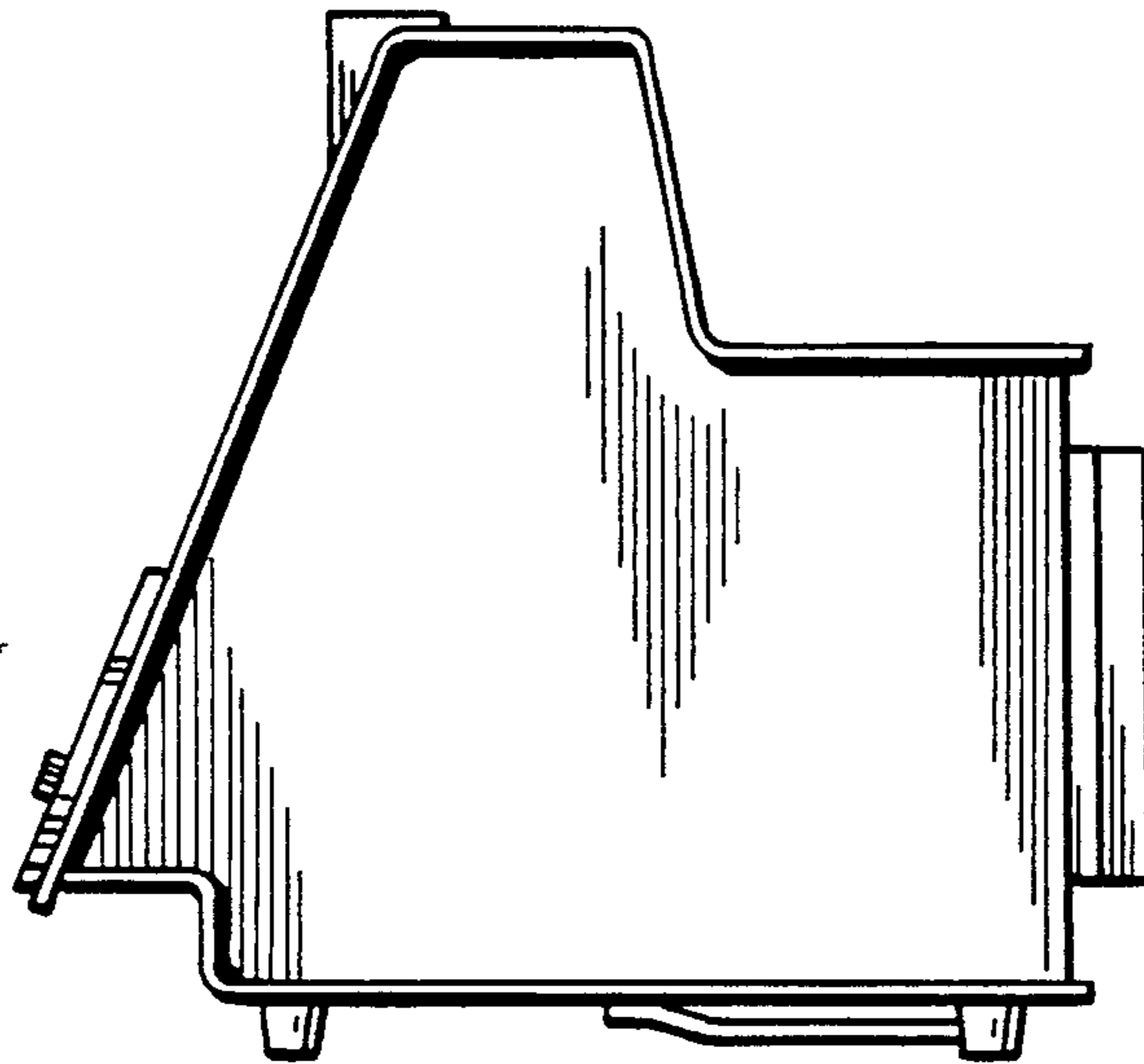
