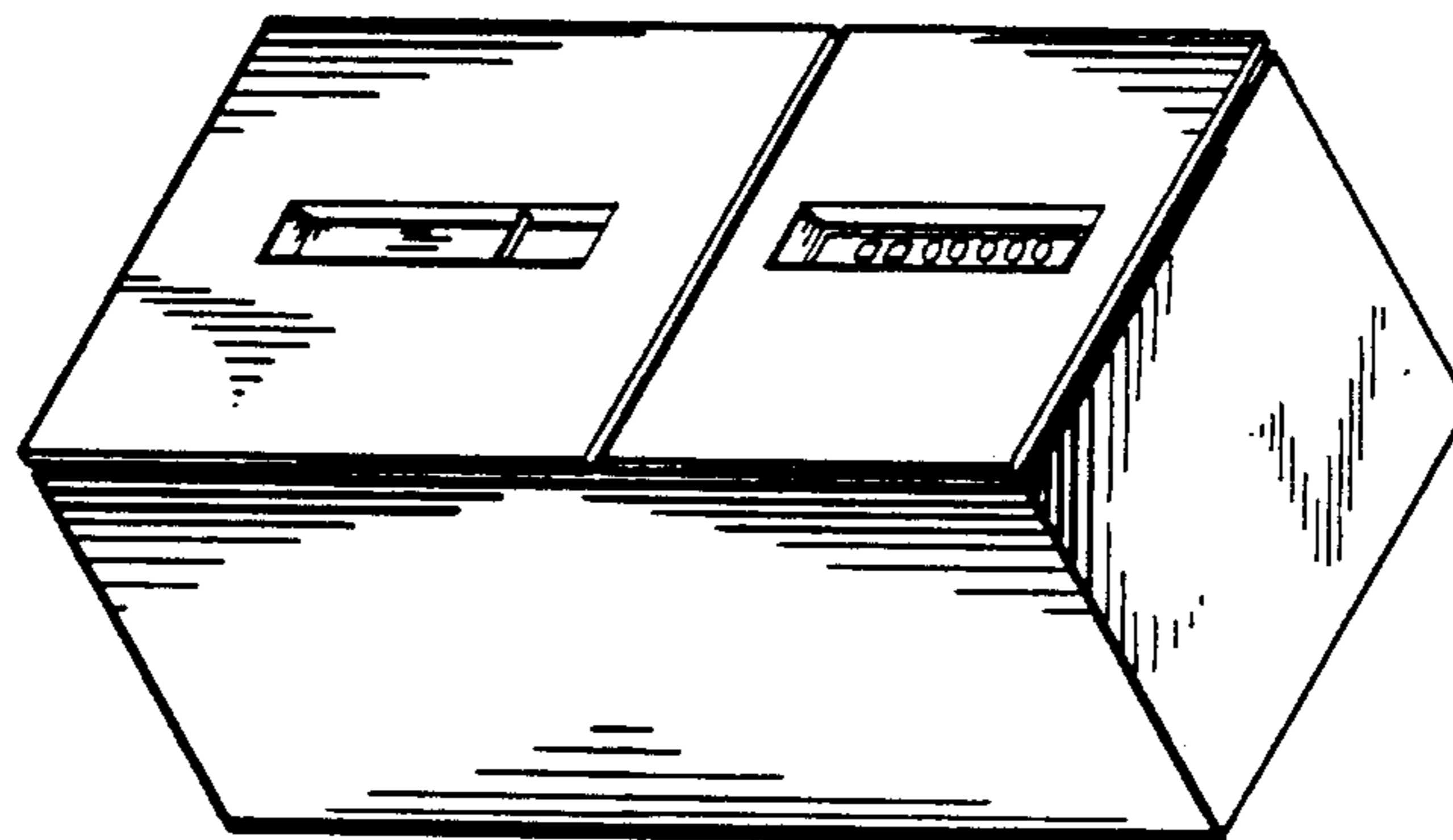

[57] **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a waste compactor cabinet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a waste compactor cabinet showing my new design, FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the side opposite from that shown in FIG. 1, FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view of the control panel for the waste compactor cabinet, and FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken substantially through line 4—4 of FIG. 3. The rear and bottom of the waste compactor cabinet are plain and unornamented.

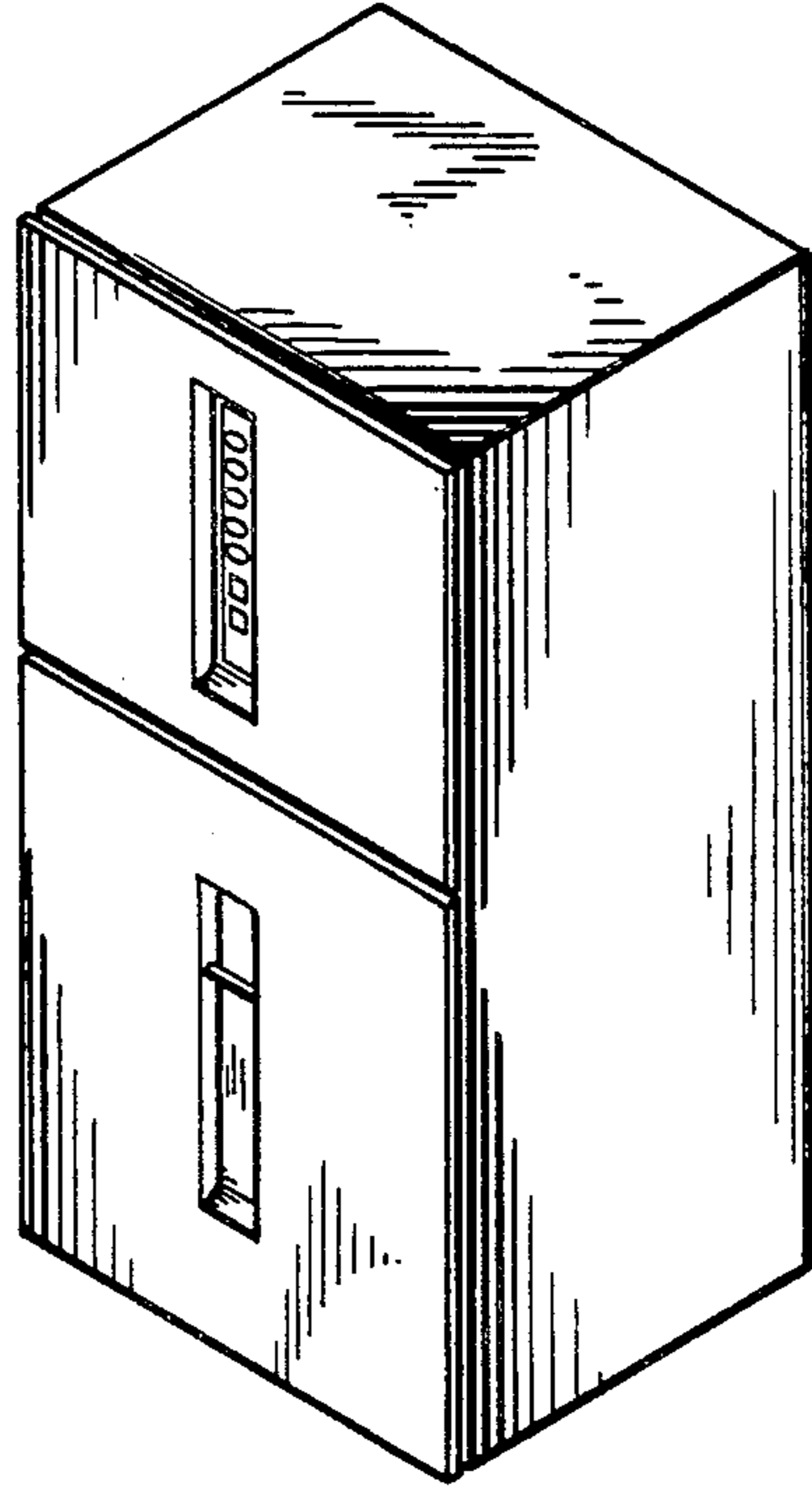

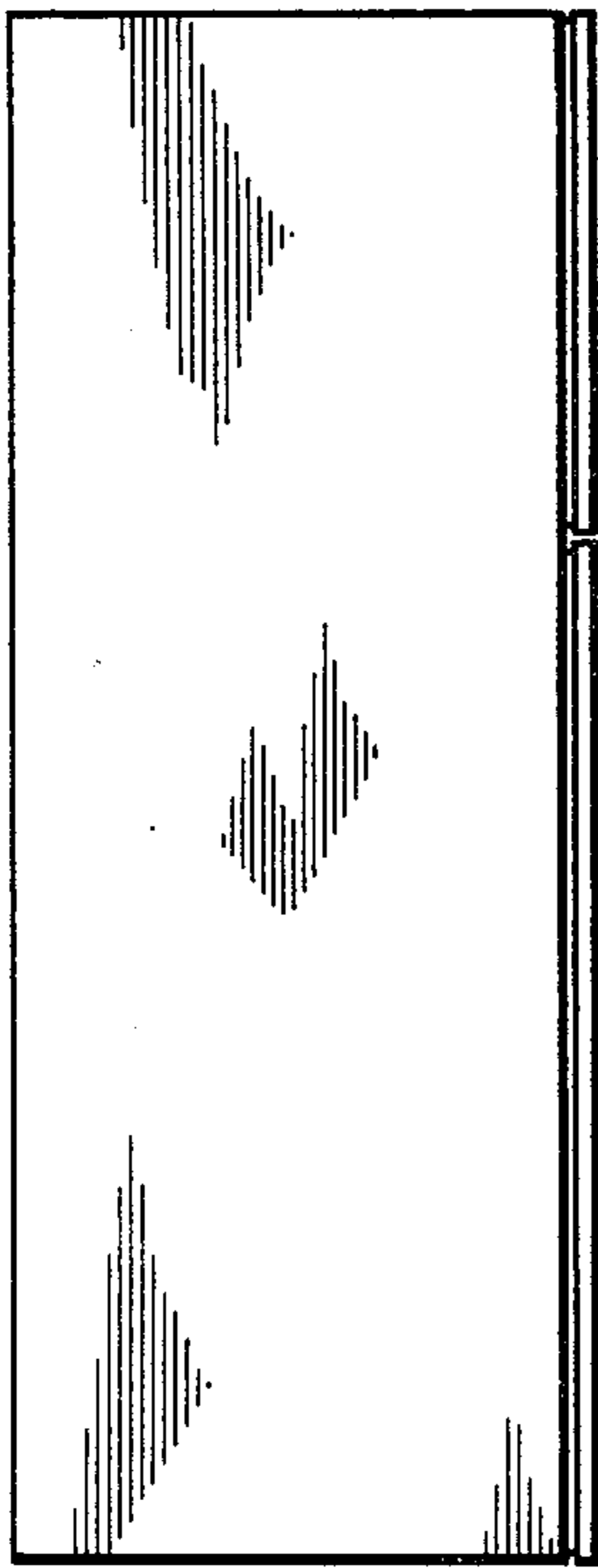

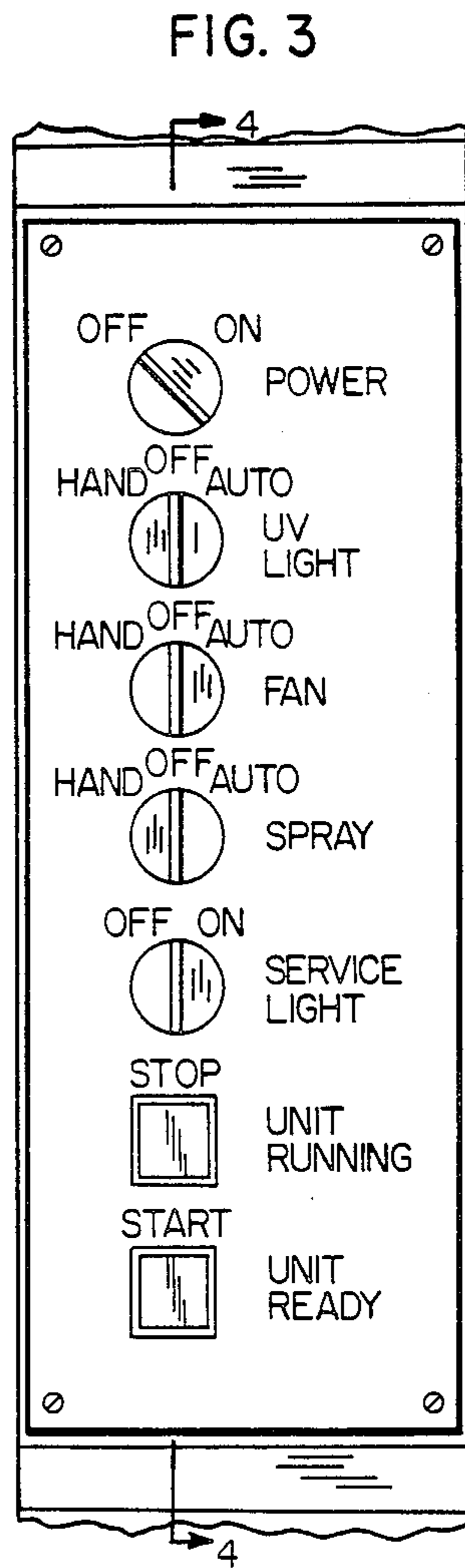

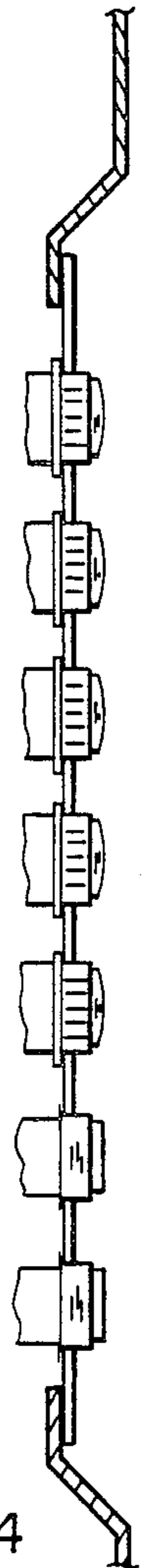
