The ornamental design for a separable multi-level chess board package or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front top perspective view of the separable multi-level chess board package or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

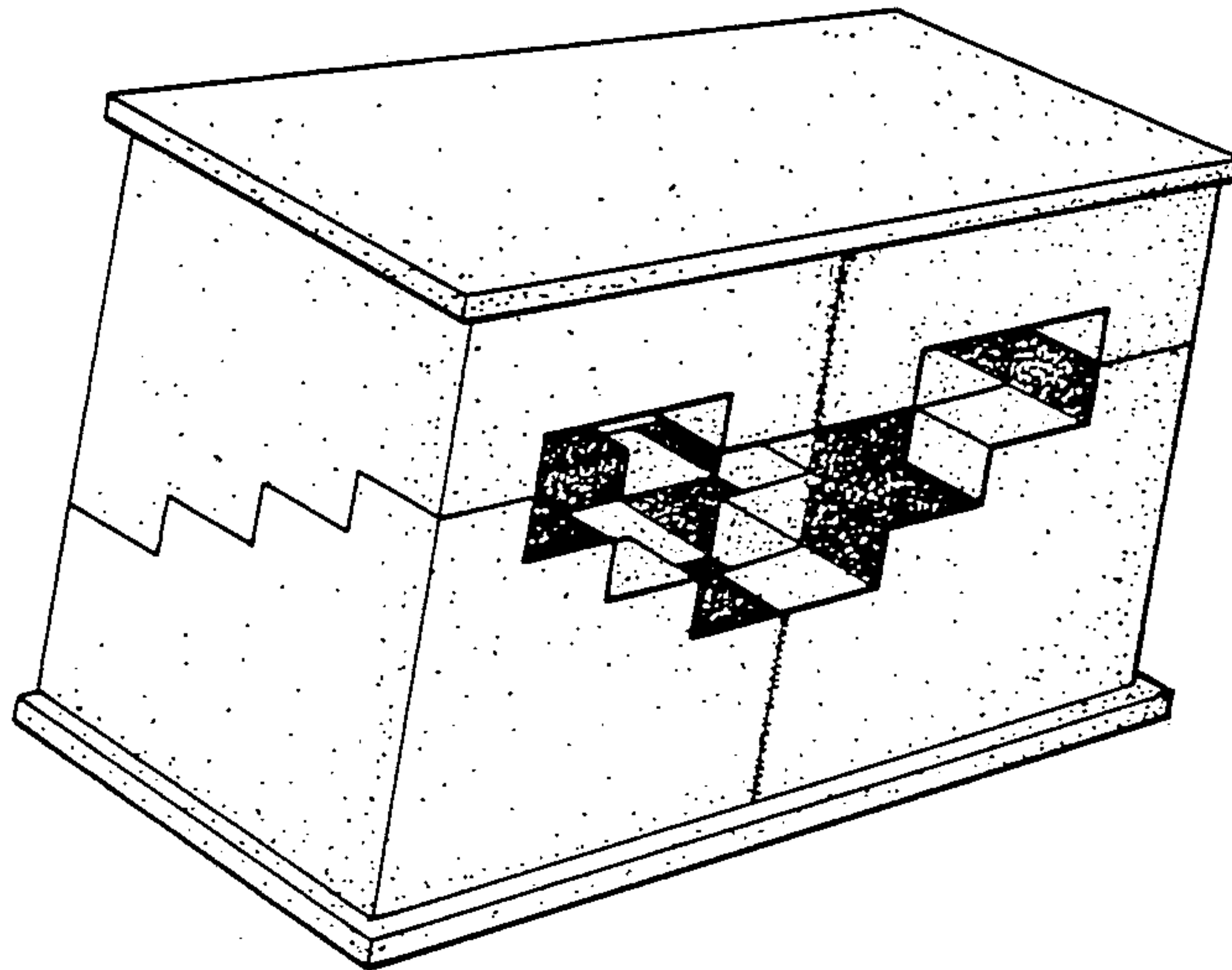
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being substantially a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 11 is a sectional view taken through lines 11—11 of FIG. 6.



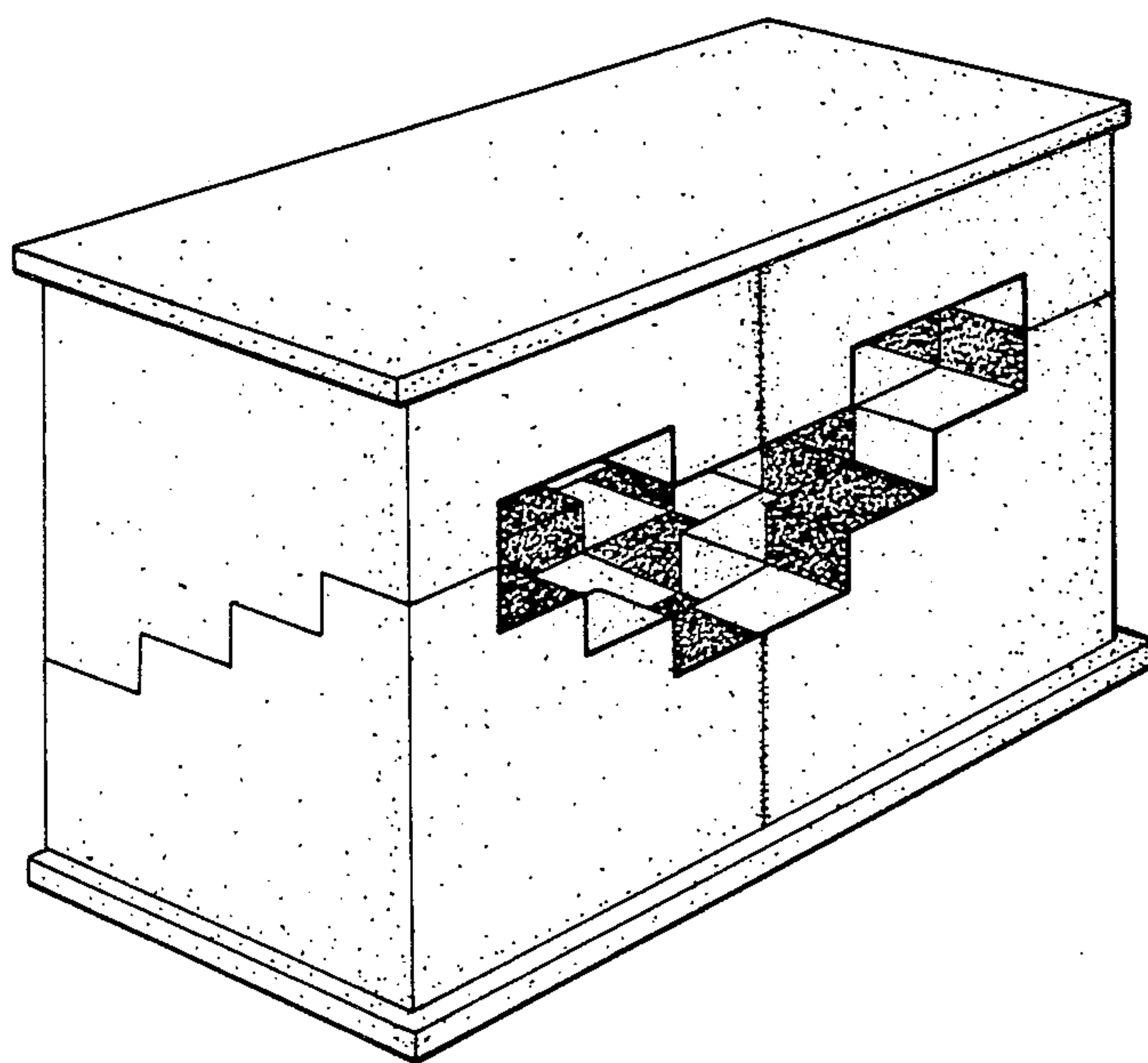

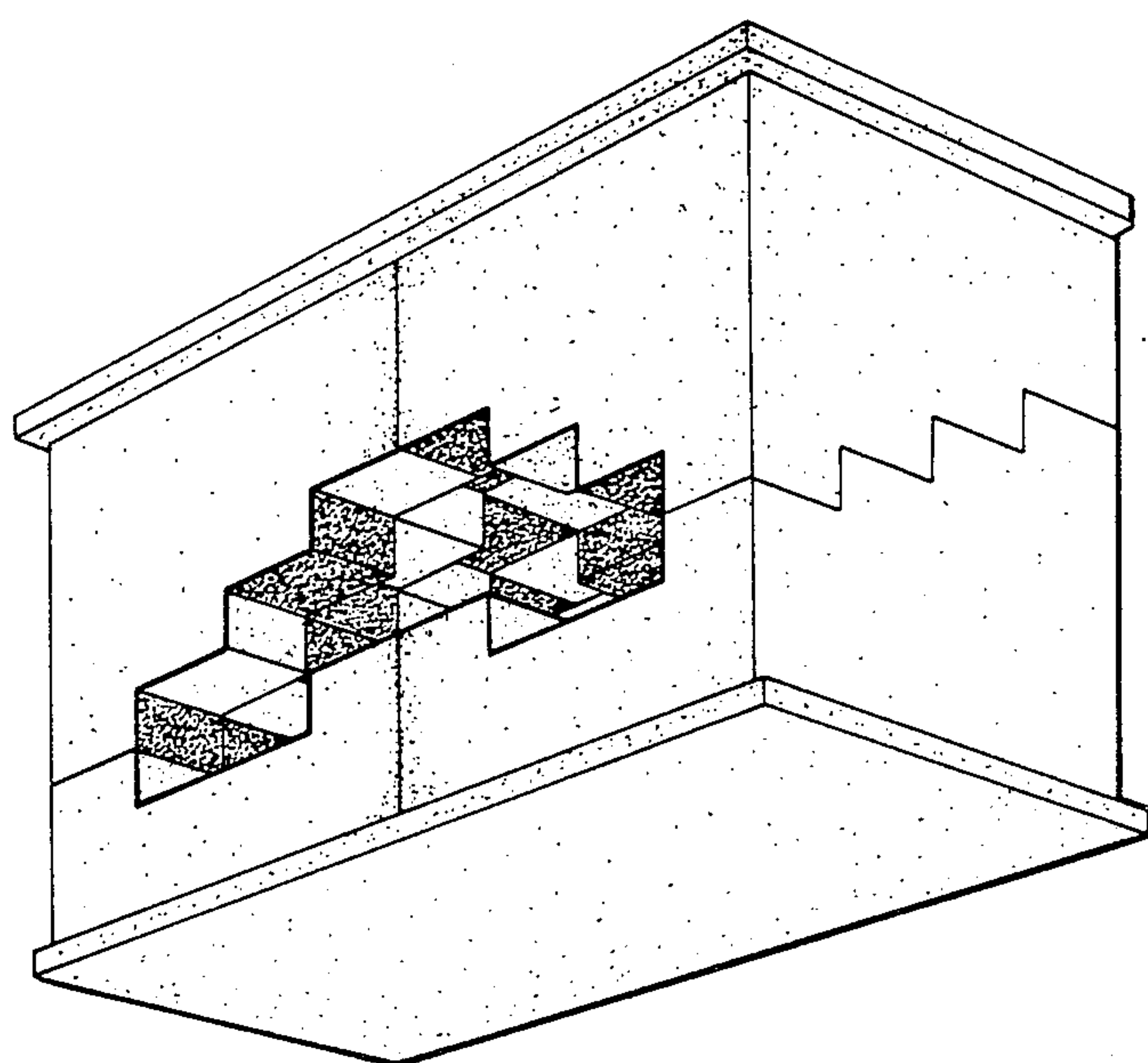

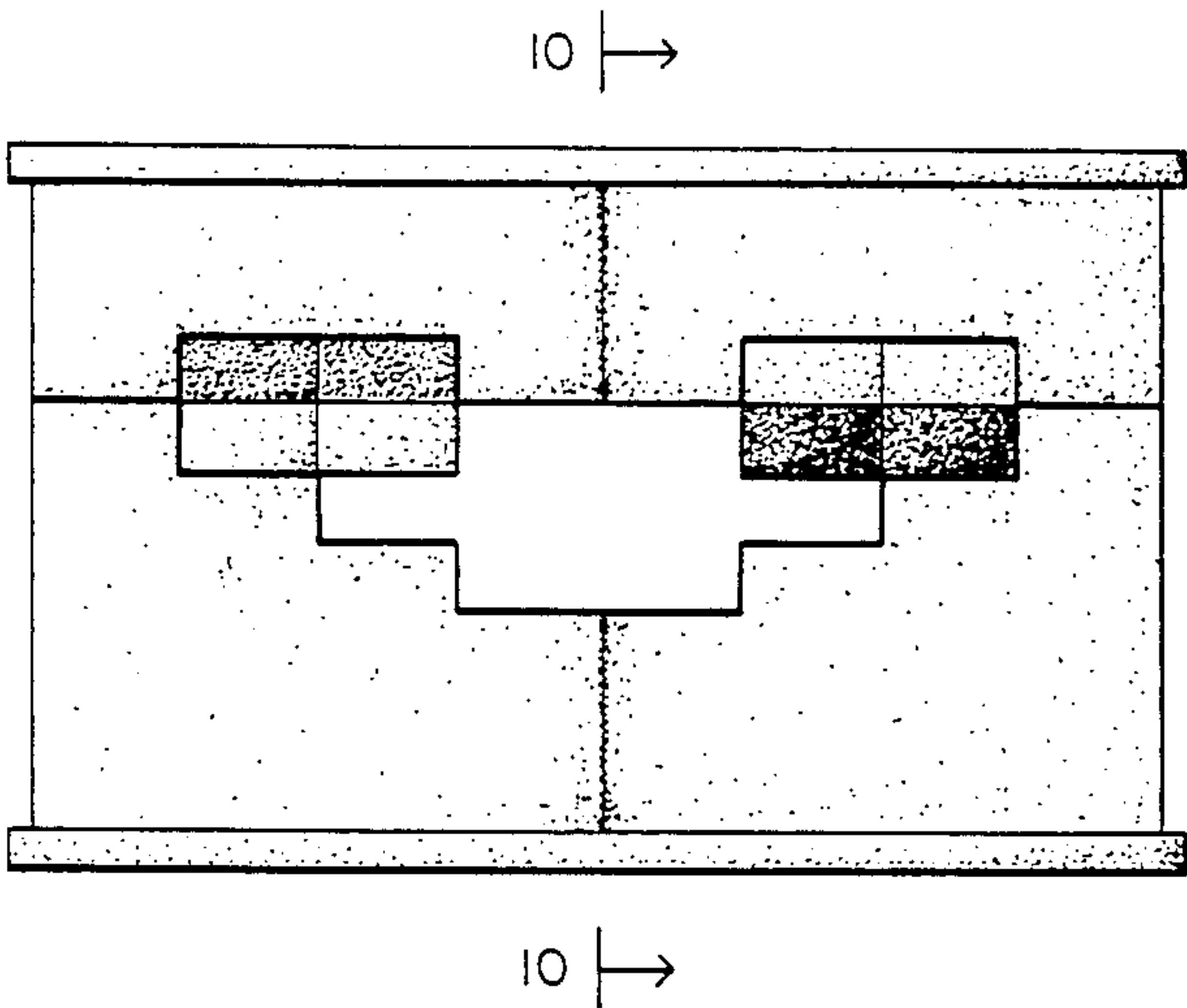

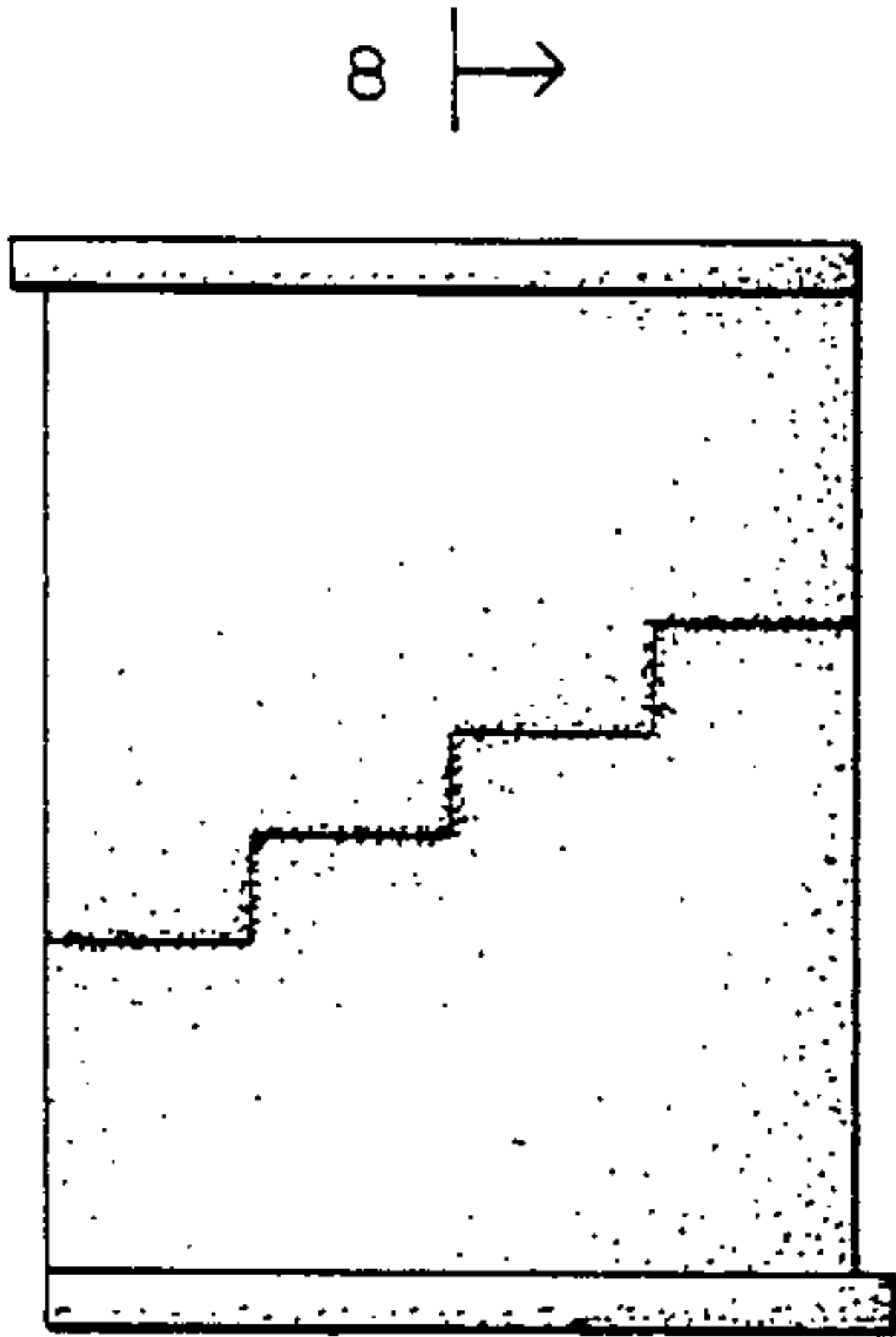

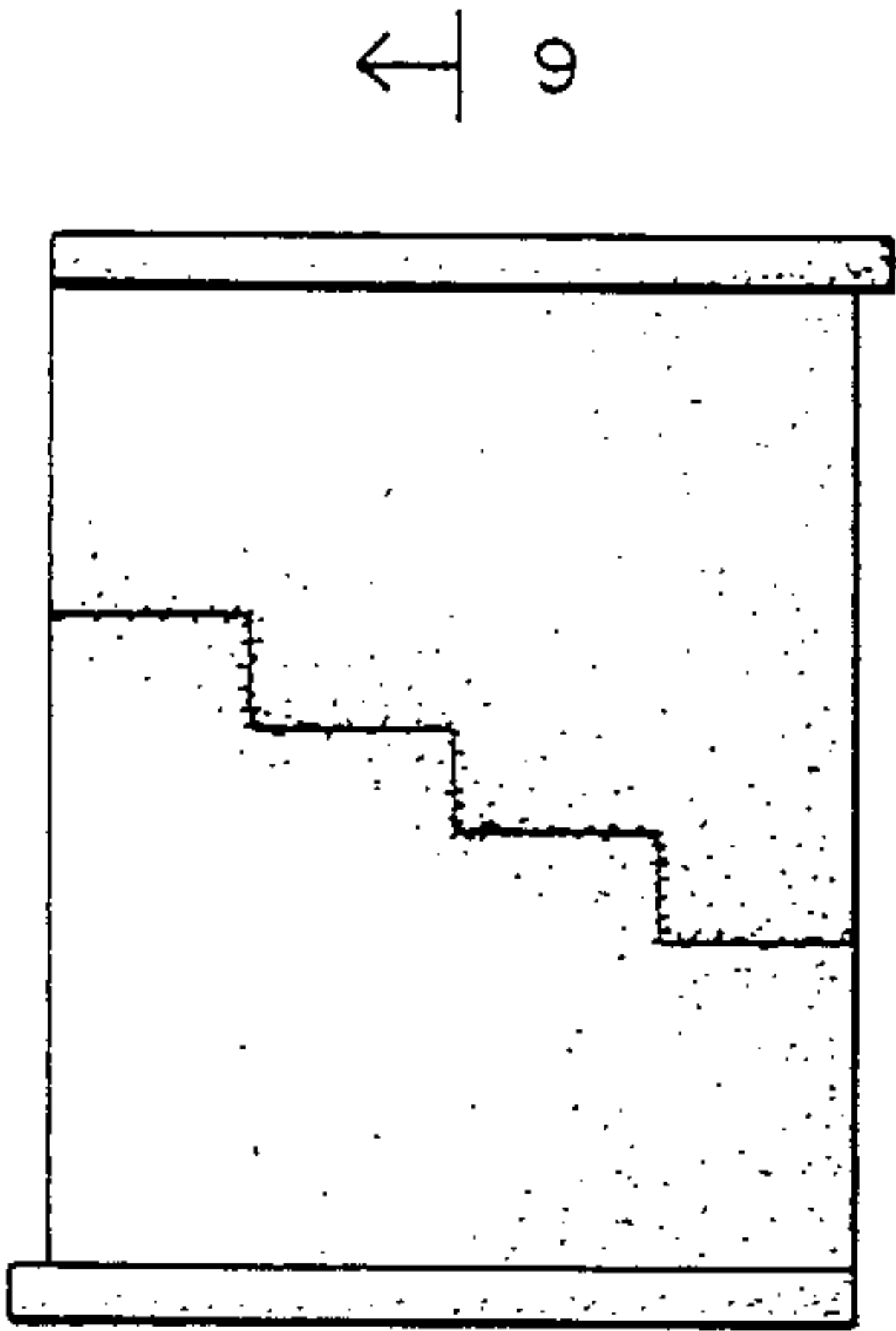

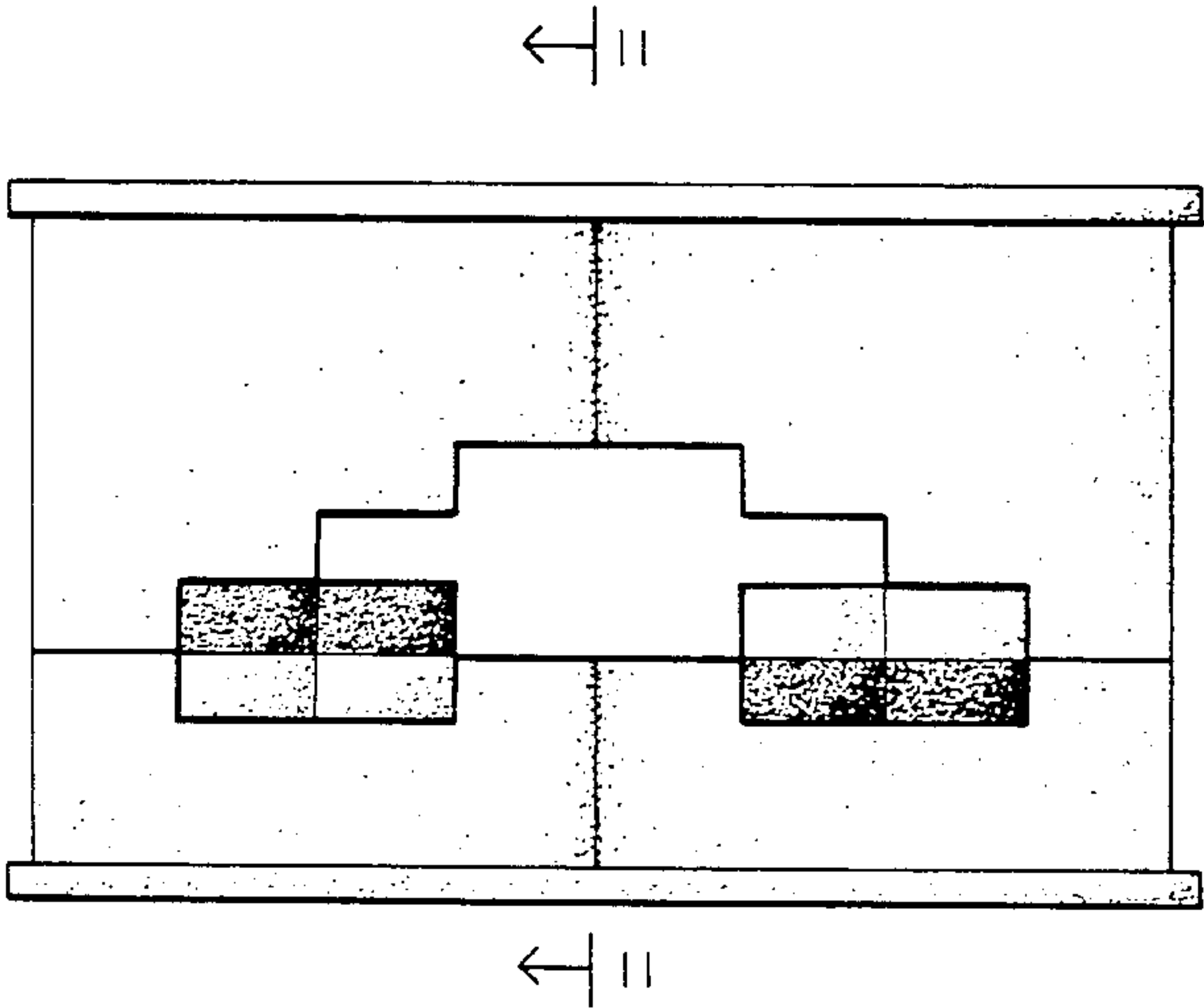

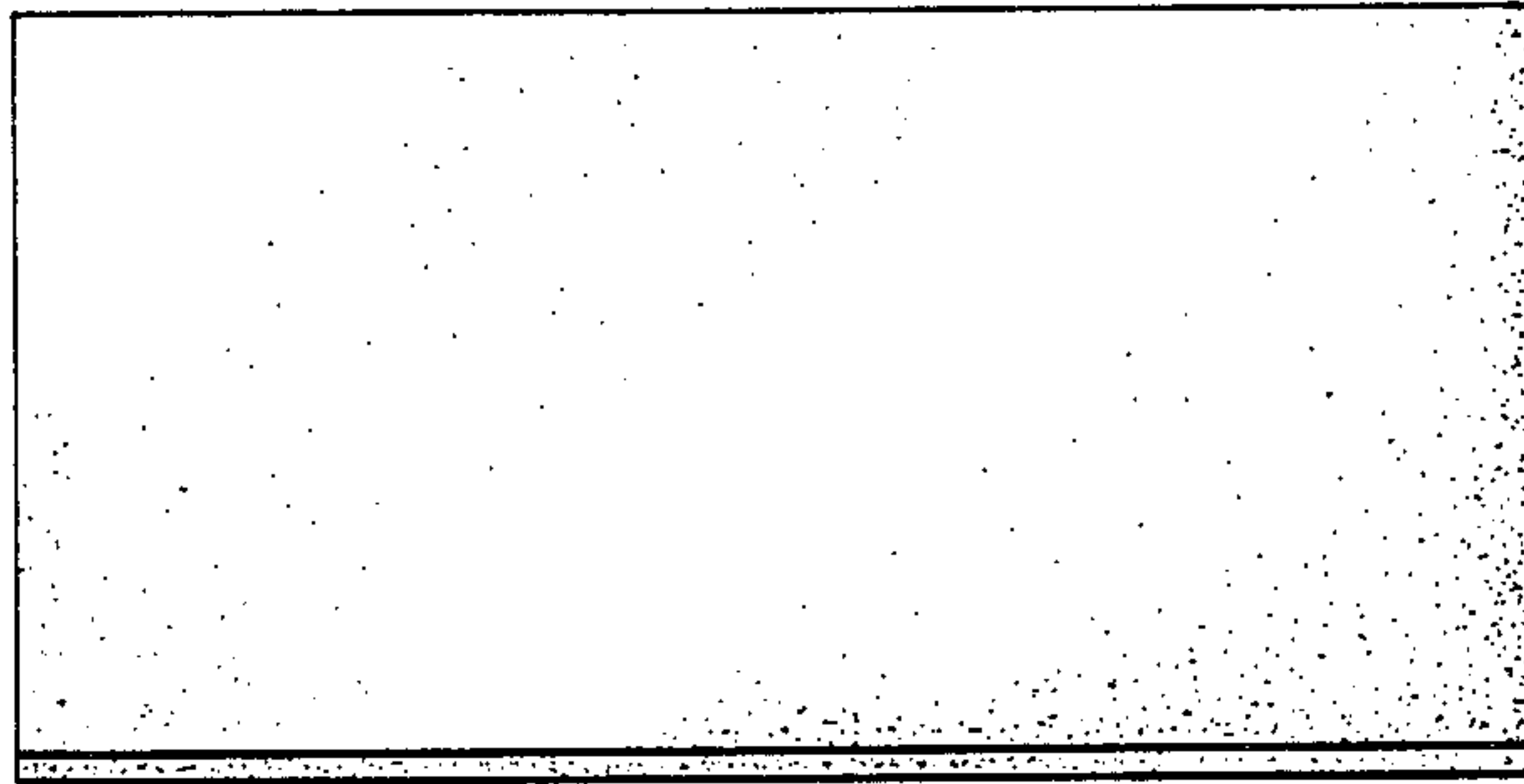

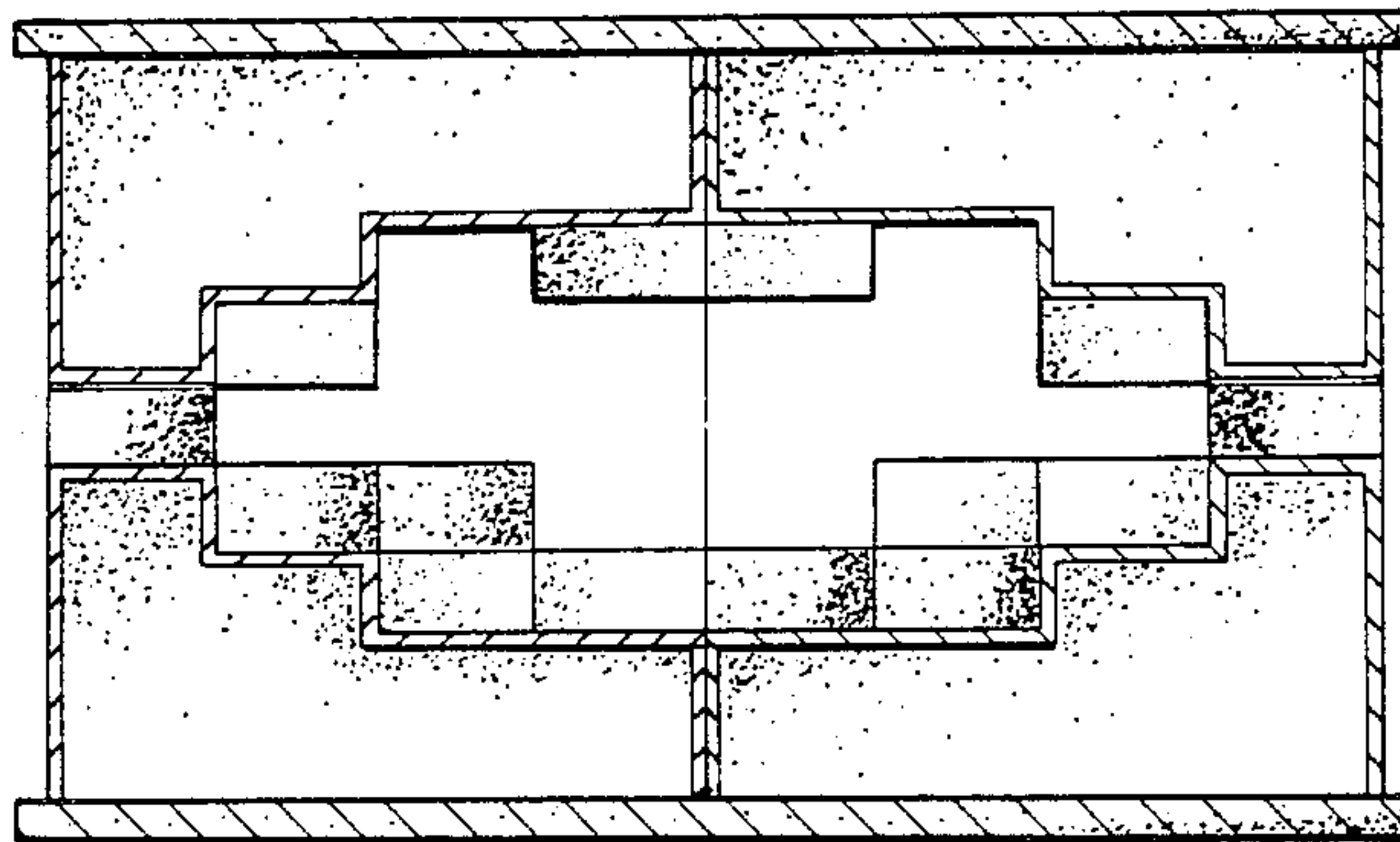

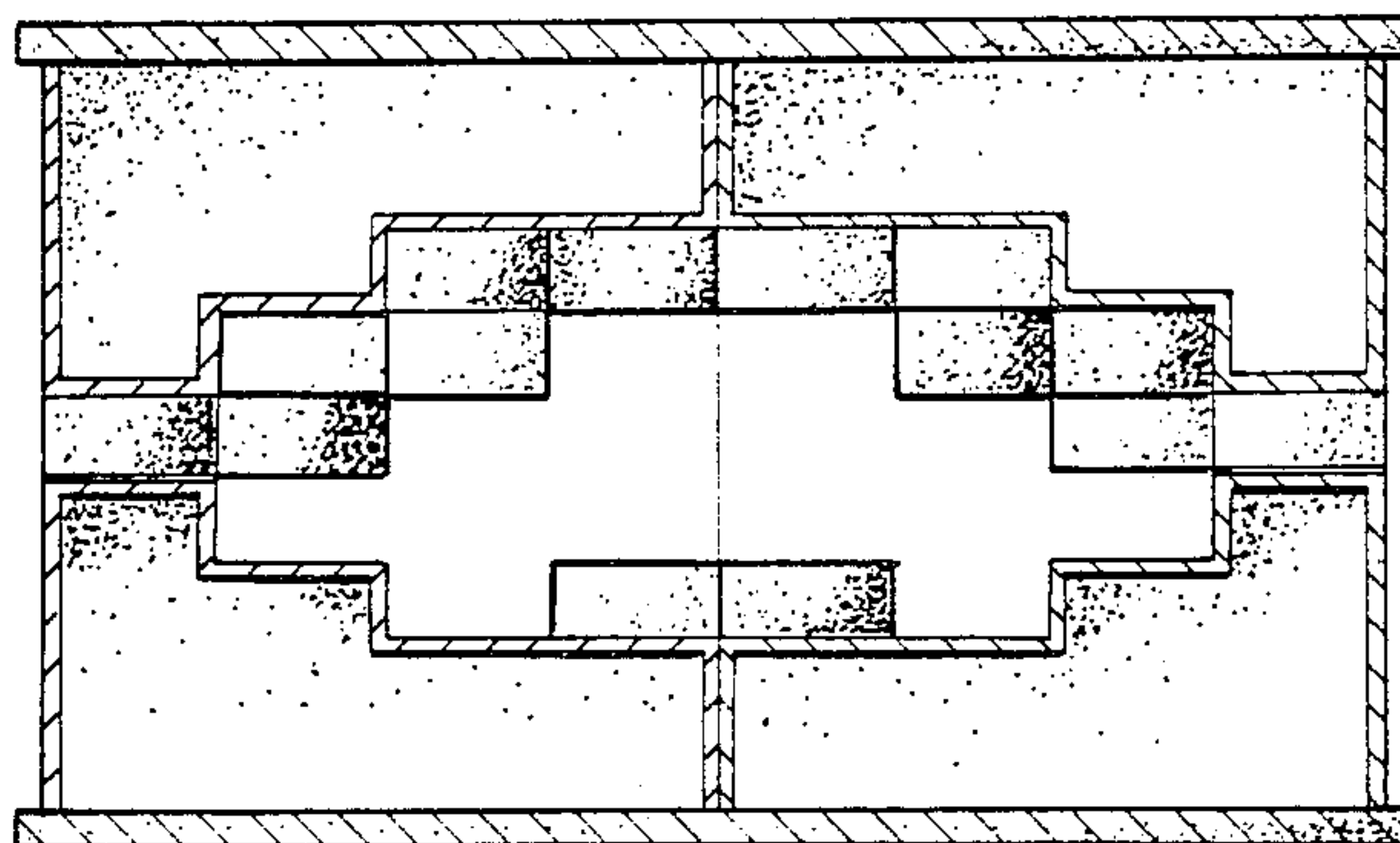

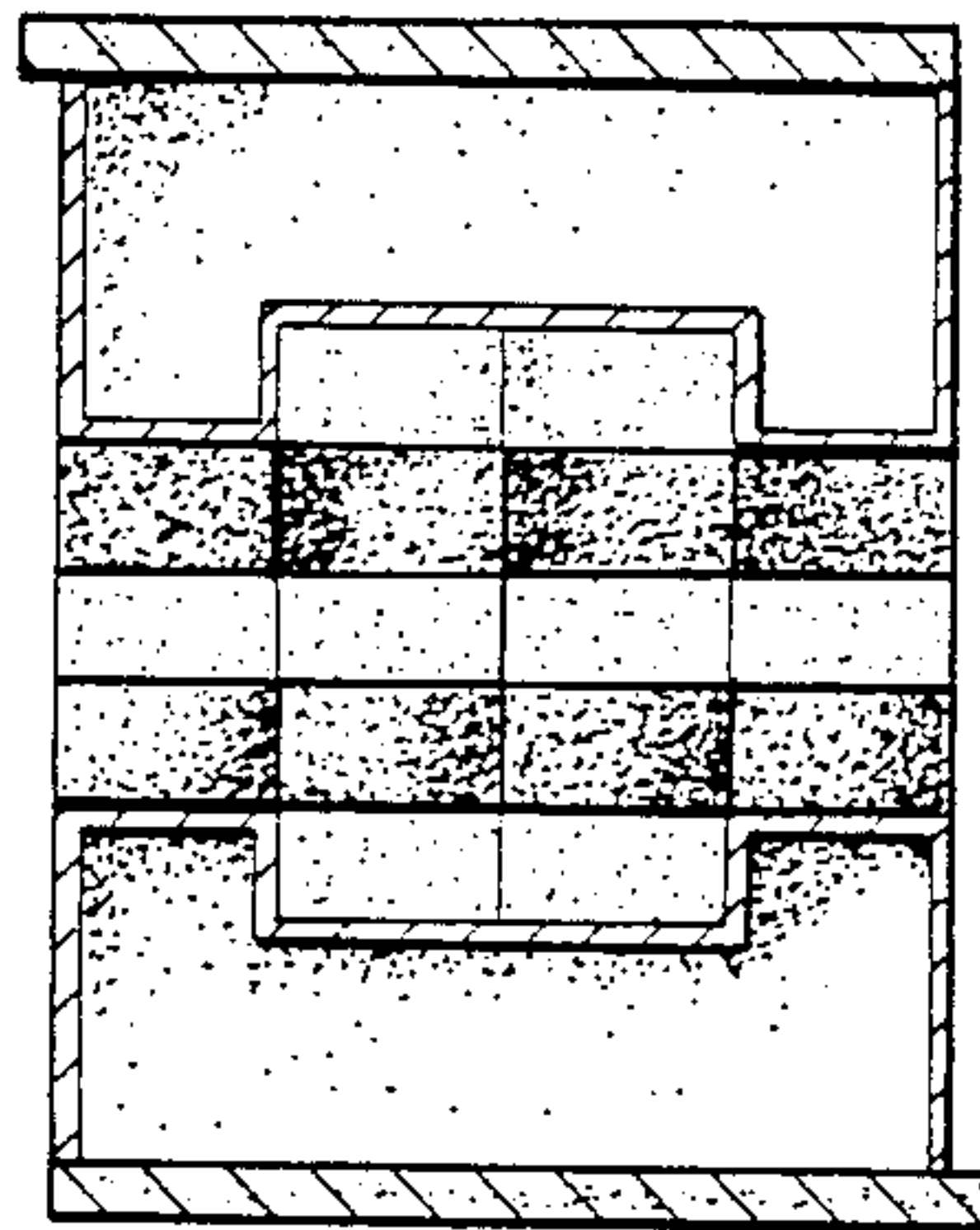

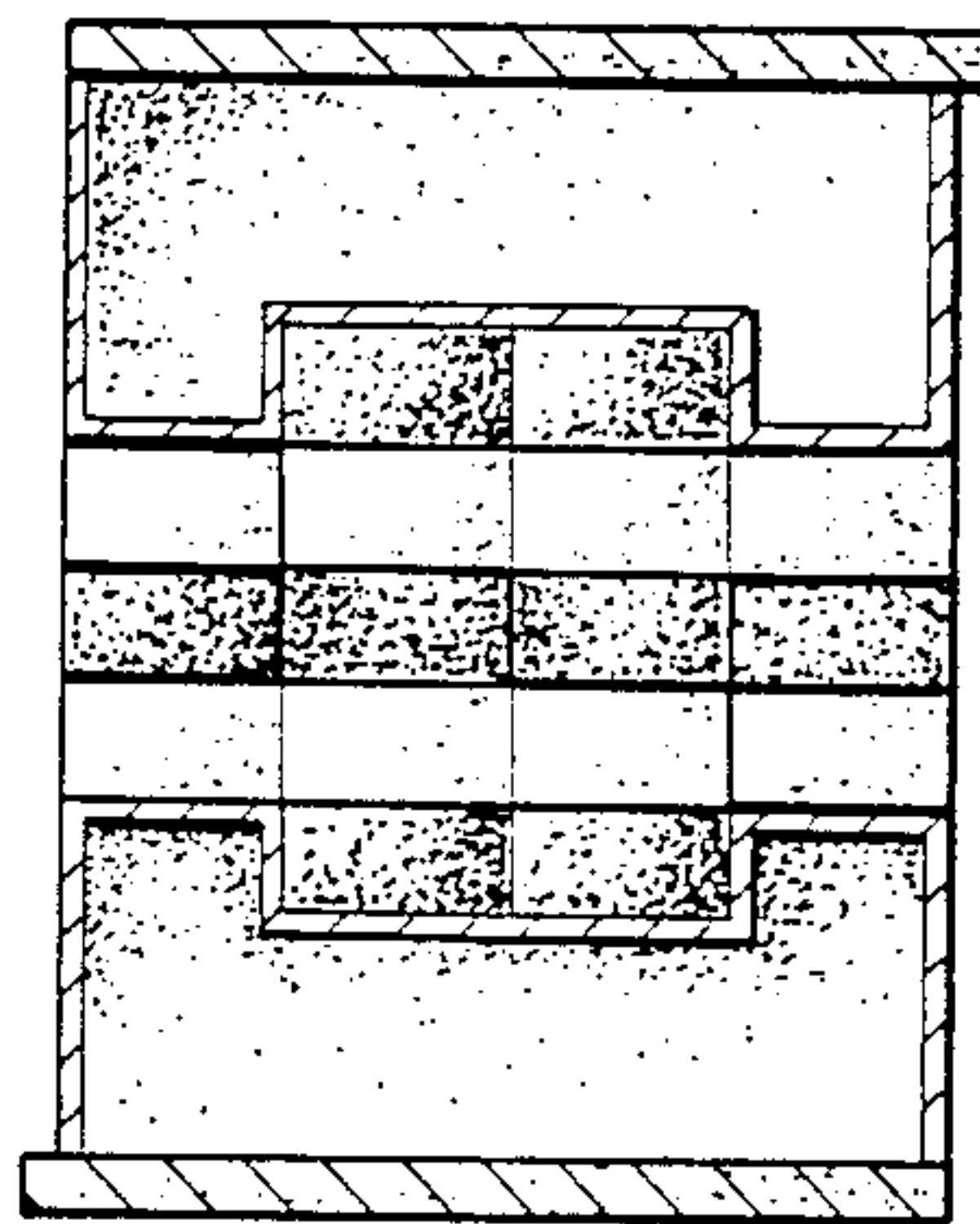
