FIG. 5 is a rear elevation;

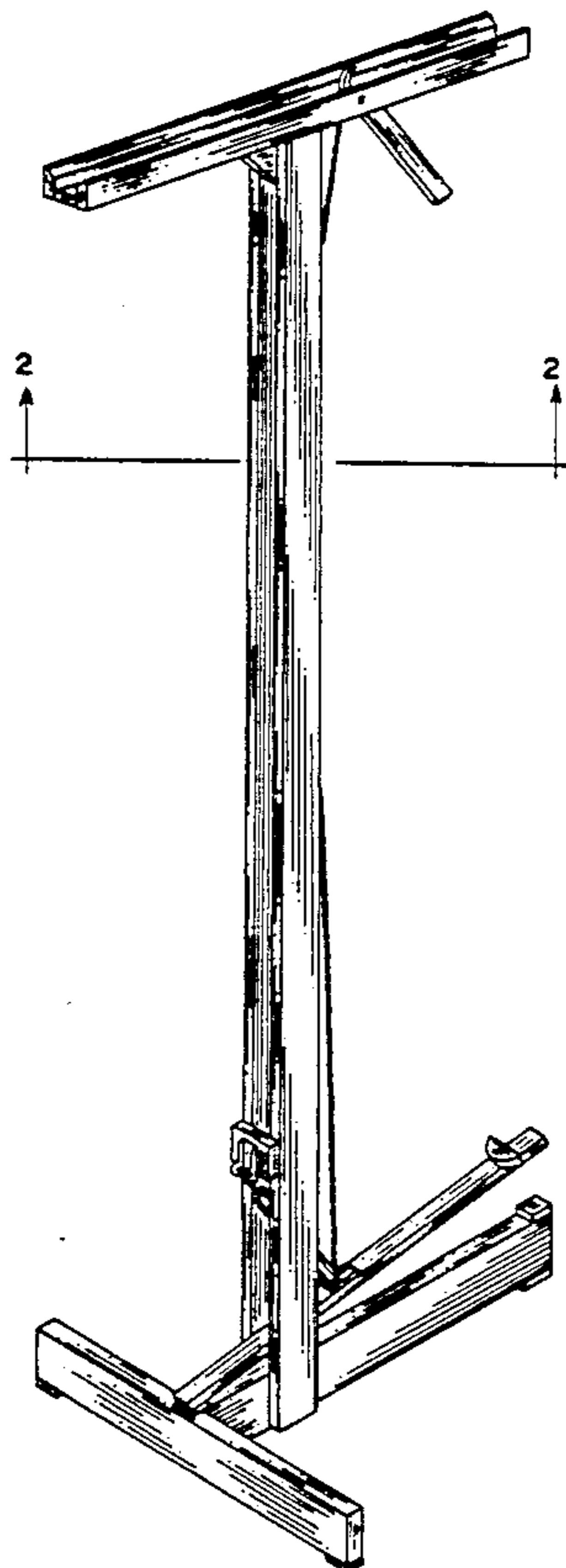
FIG. 6 is a side elevation opposite FIG. 3;

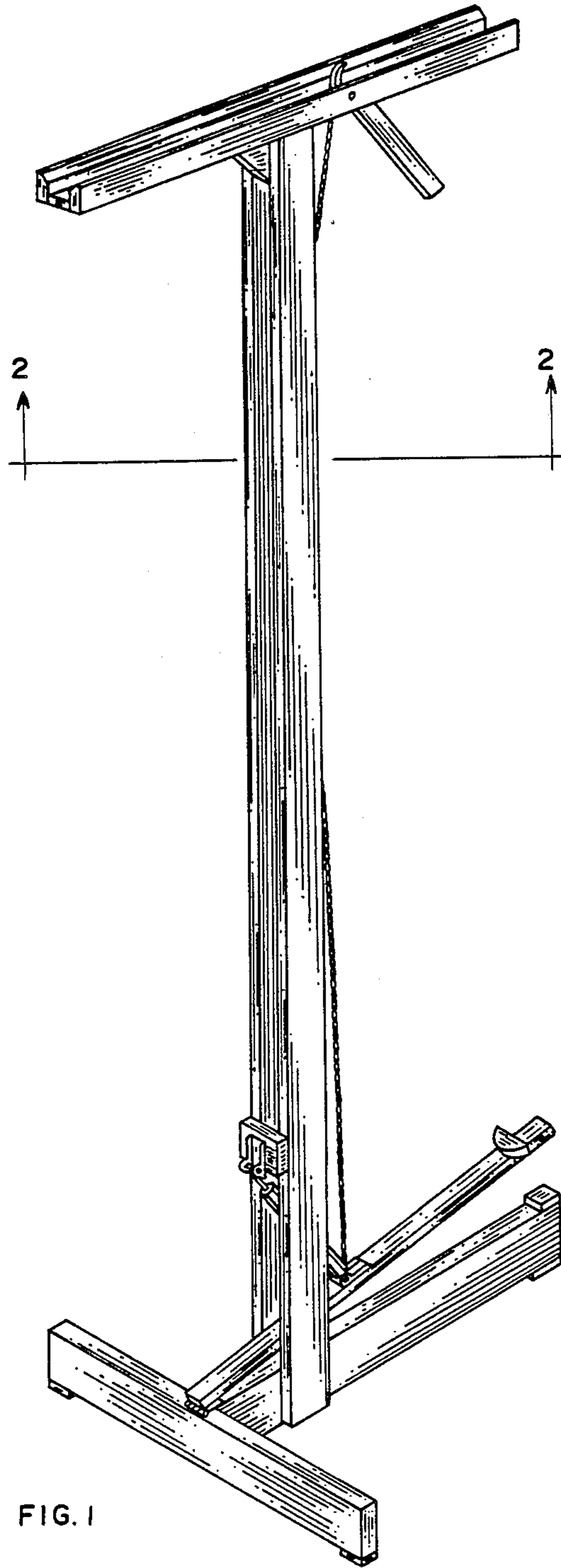

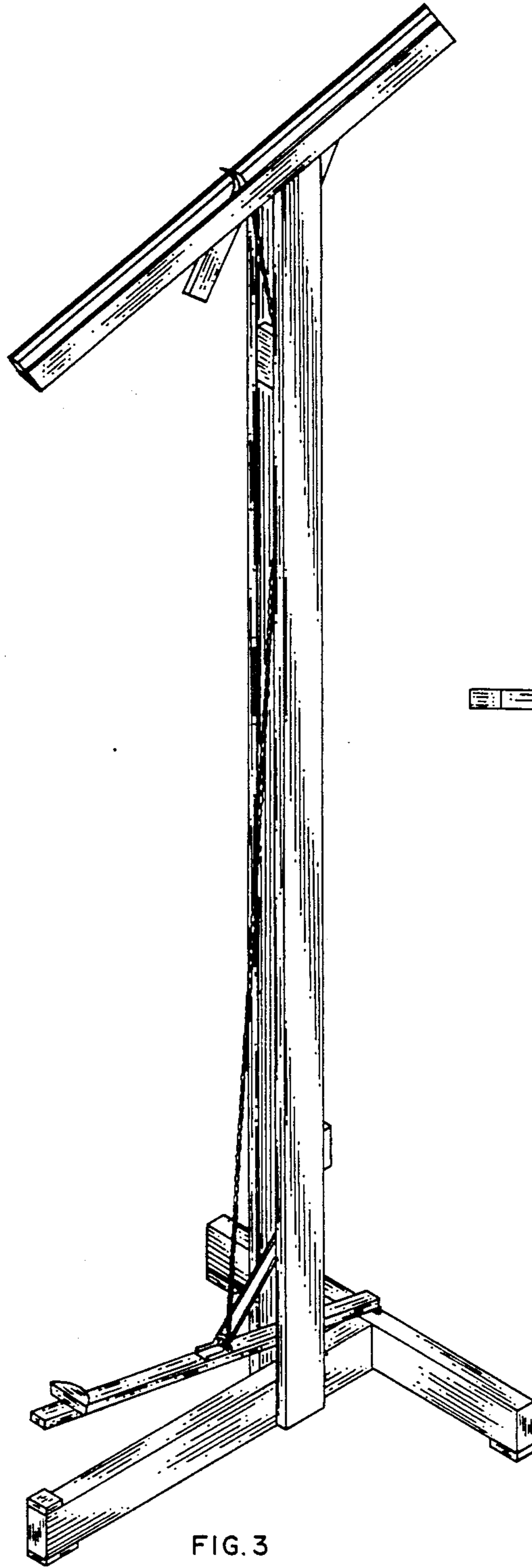

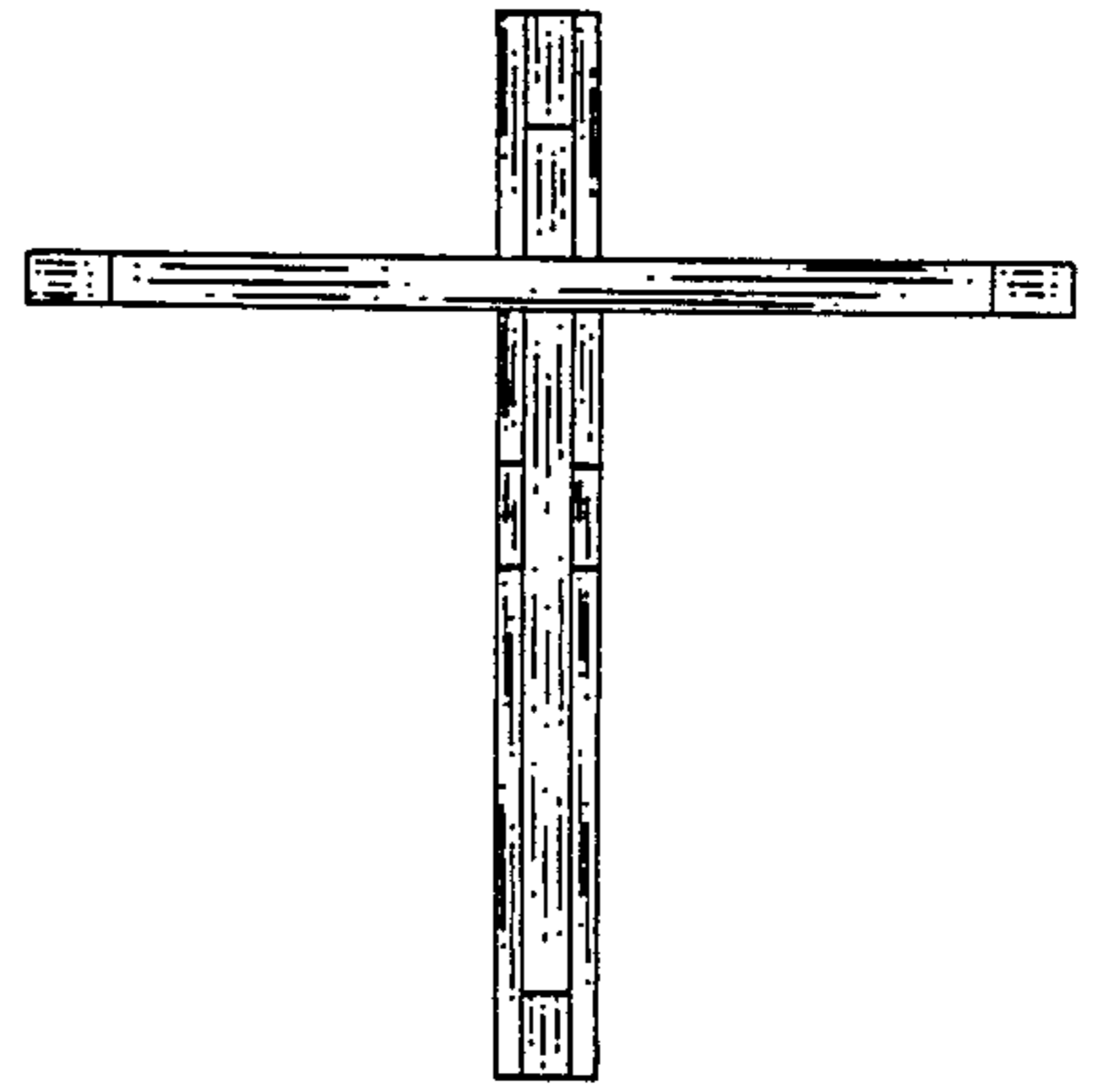

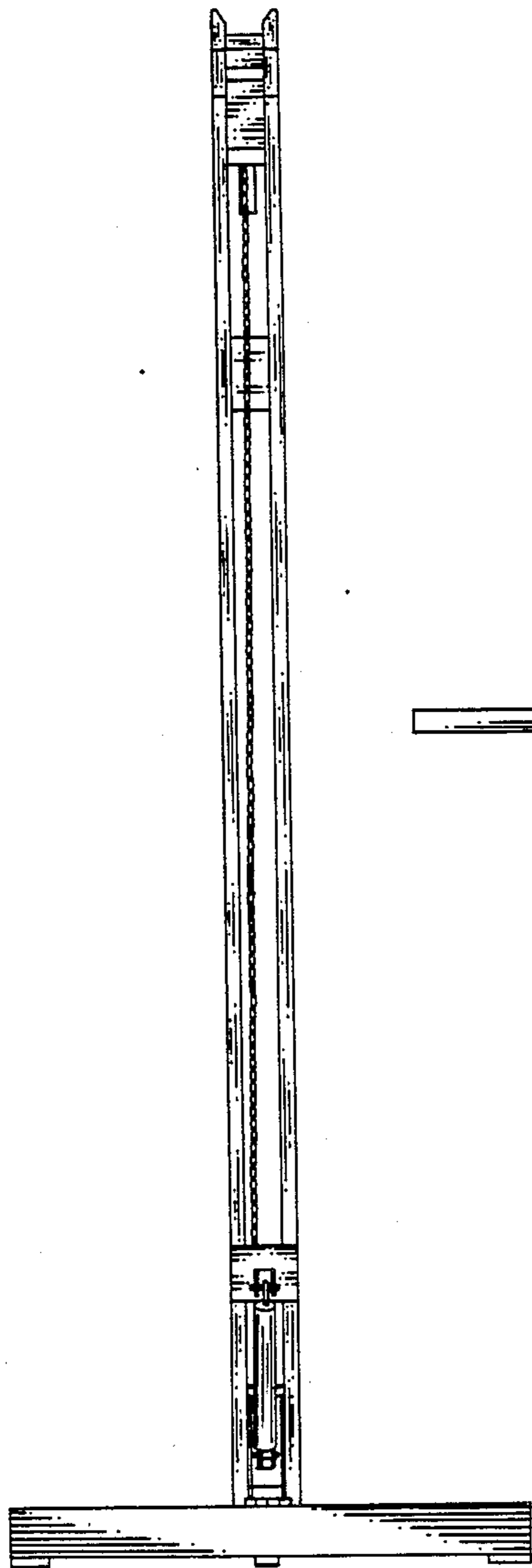

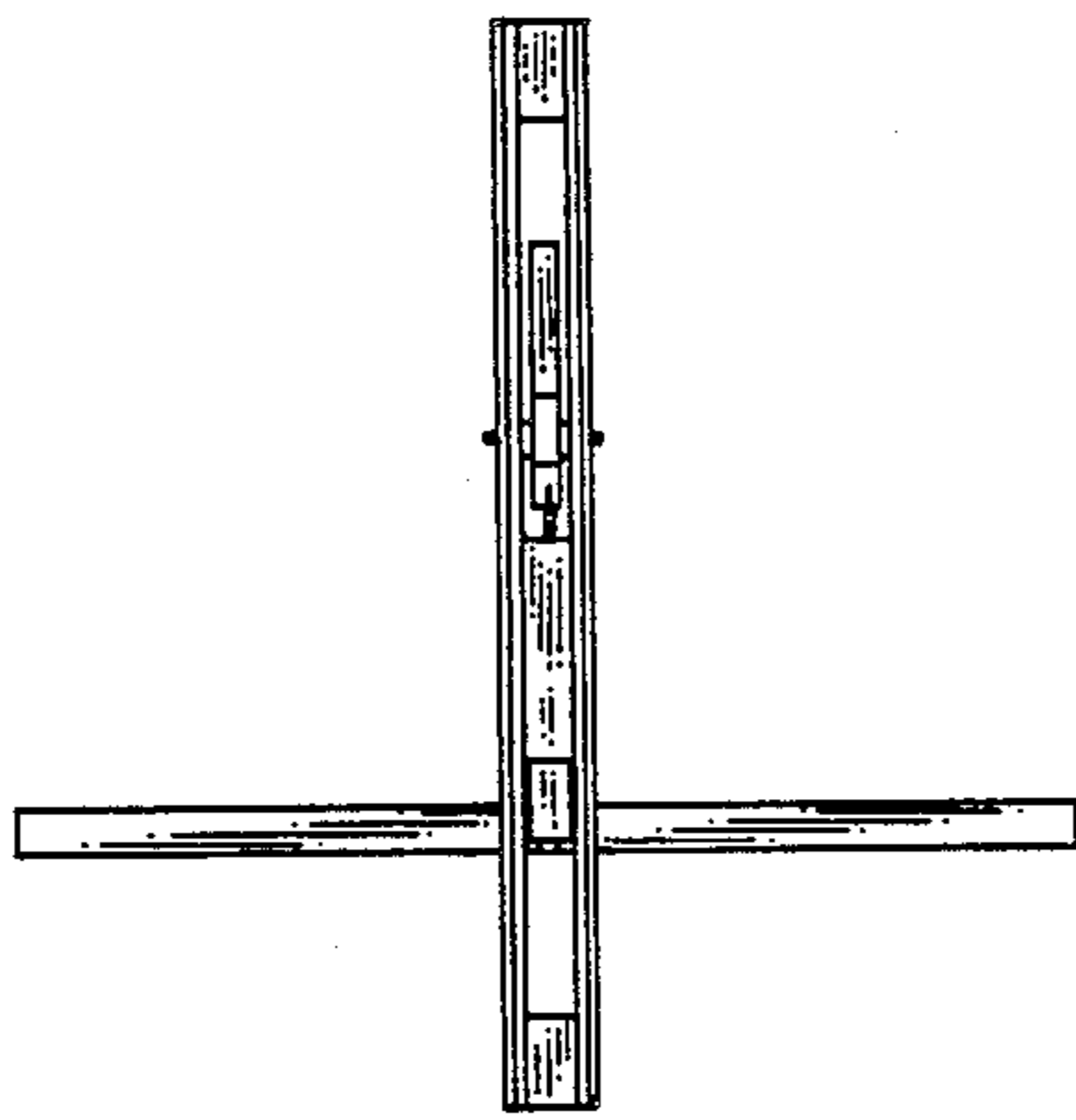

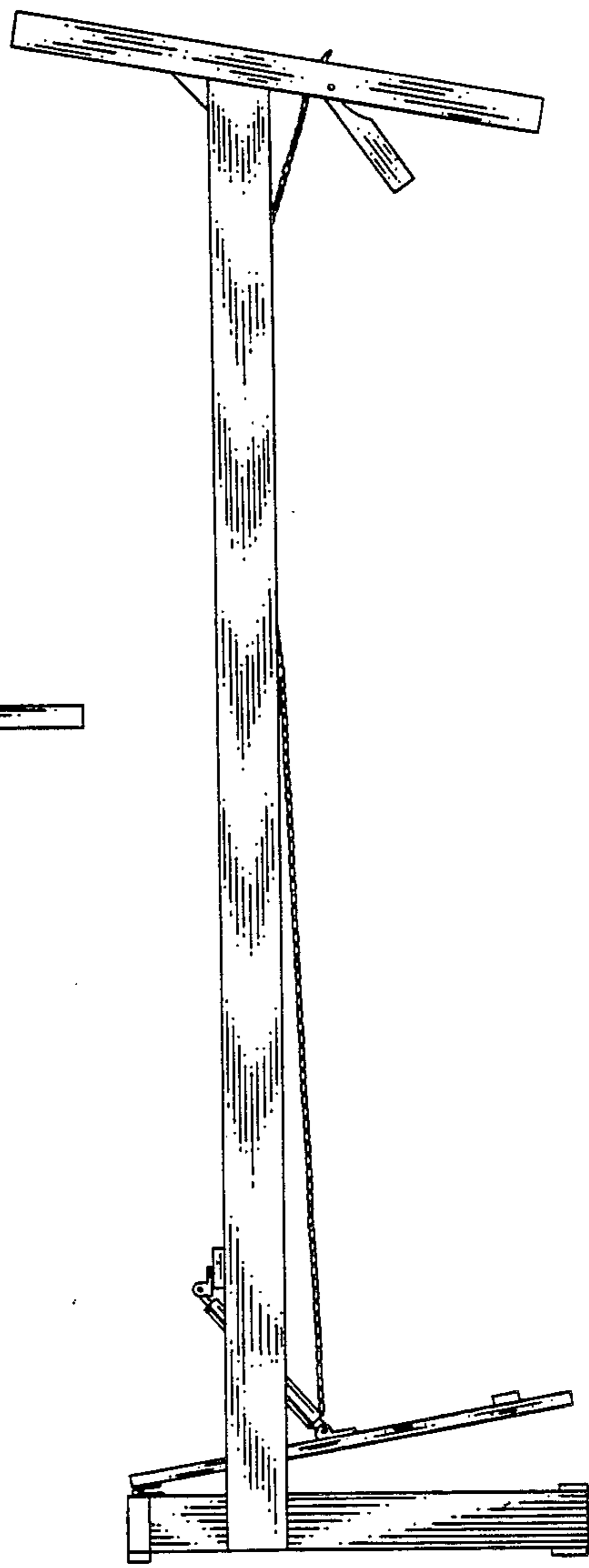
