FIG. 6 is a front elevational view;

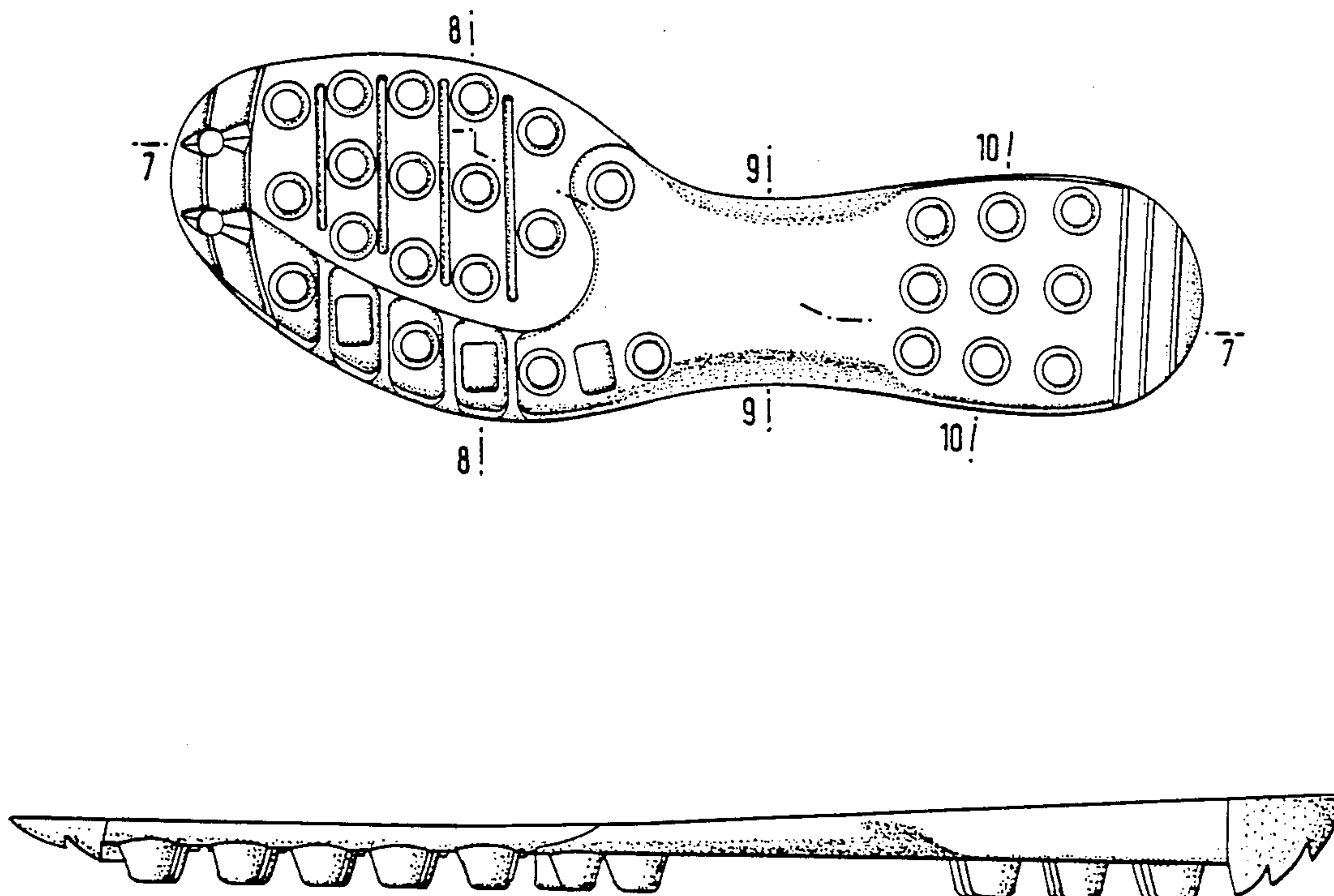
FIG. 7 is a cross-section taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 1;

tration.



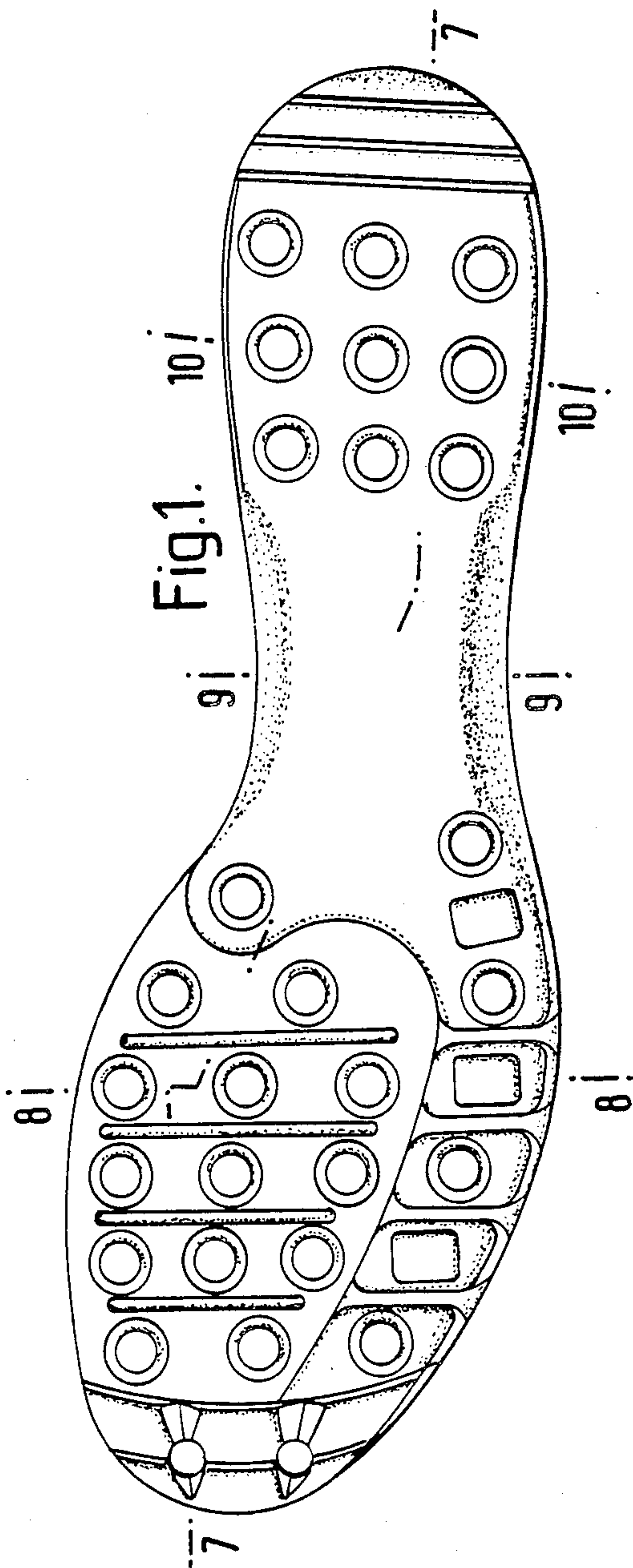
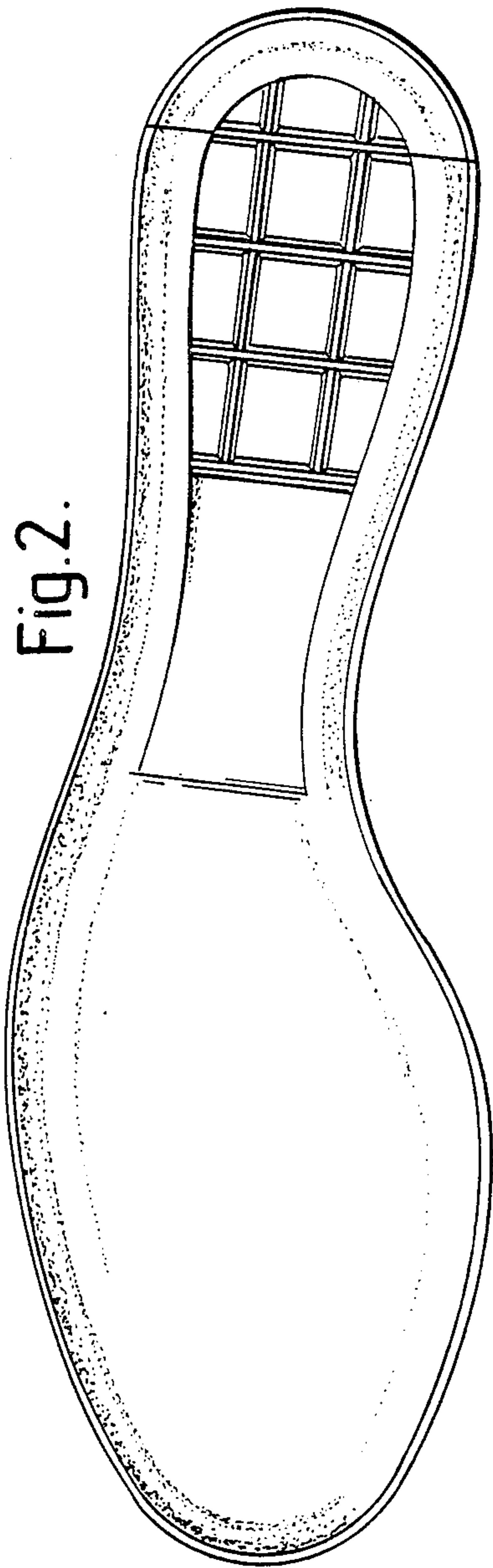

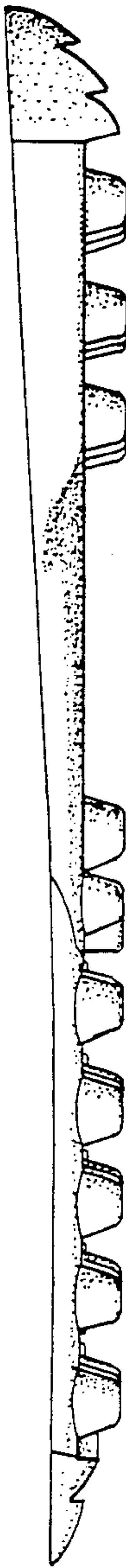

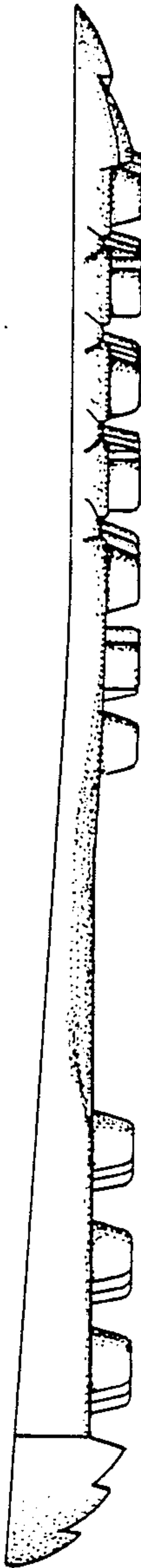

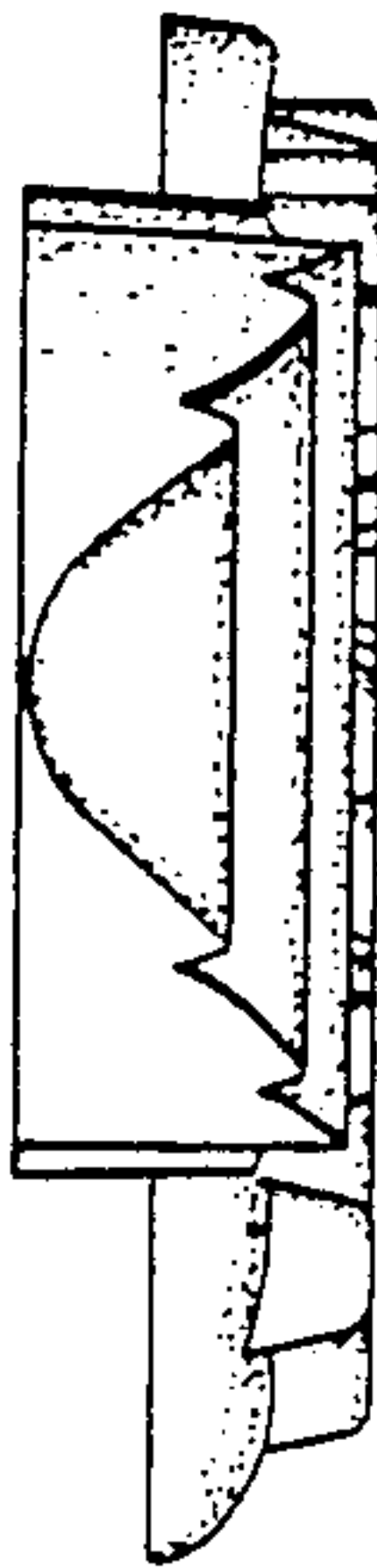

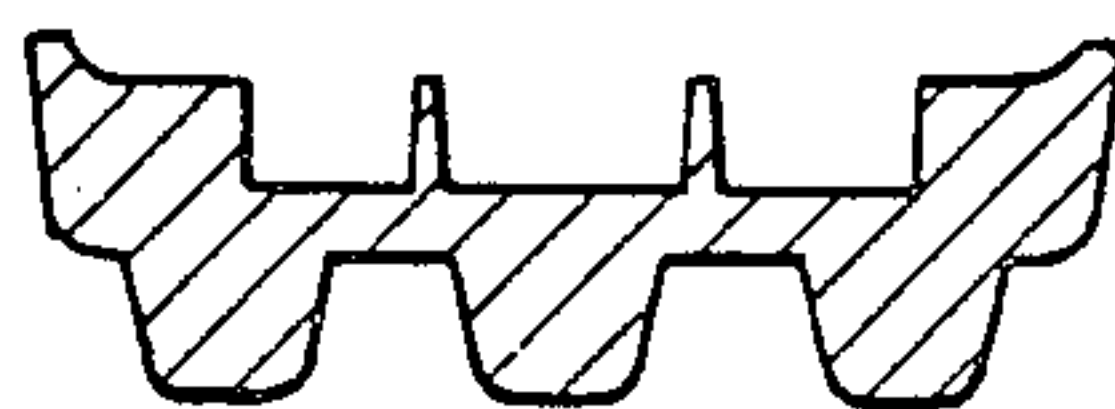

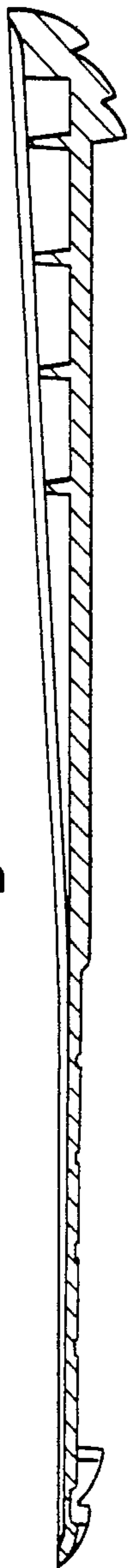
