FIG. 3;


FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being the mirror image of the right side;


FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 2;


FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 8 is a fragmentary rear elevational view thereof. The broken line representation of fitting holes in FIGS.








