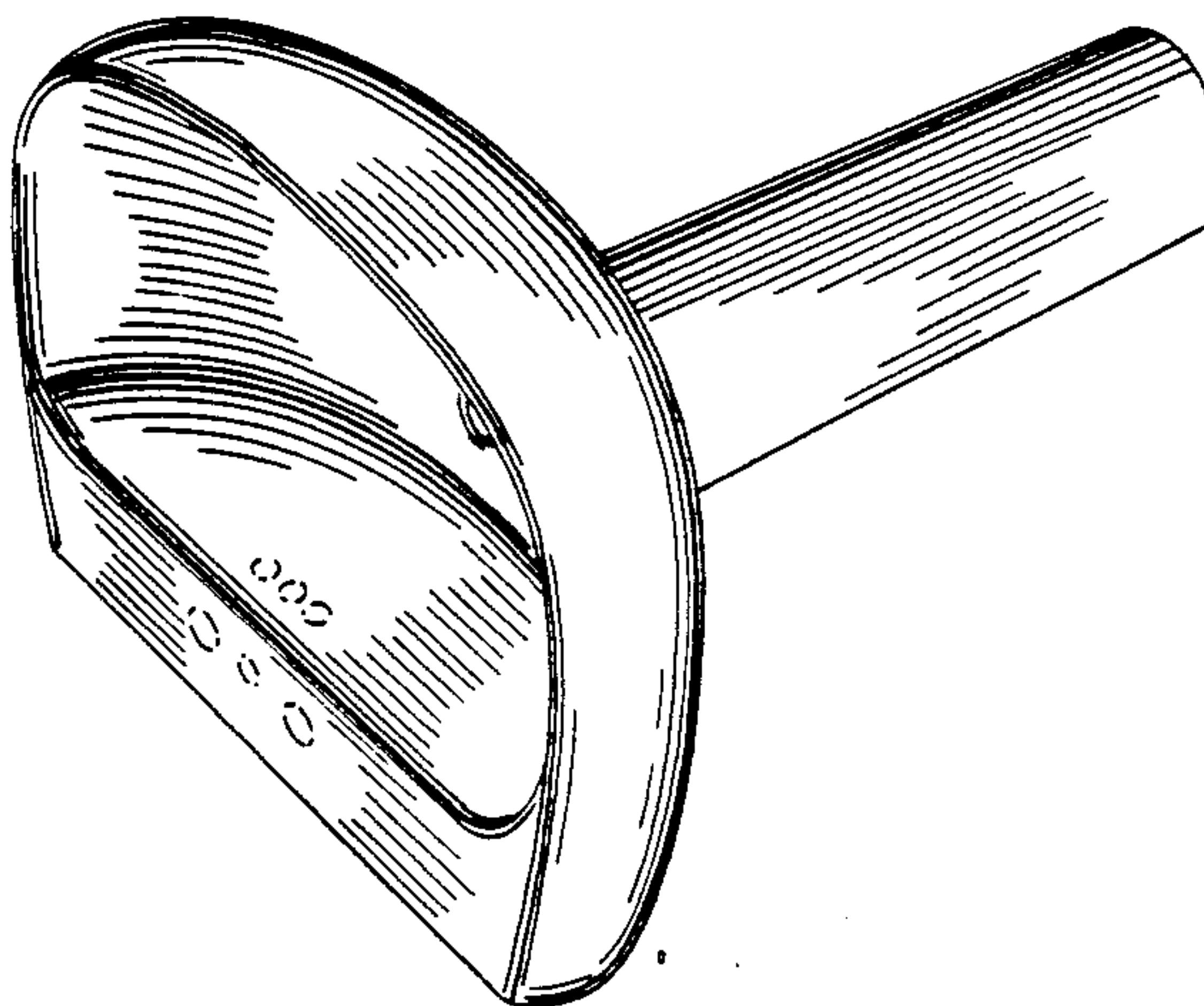

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pedestal lavatory, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a pedestal lavatory showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being the mirror image of the right side;
 FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 2; and
 FIG. 8 is a fragmentary rear elevational view thereof. The broken line representation of fitting holes in FIGS. 1, 3 and 4 are for illustration only.



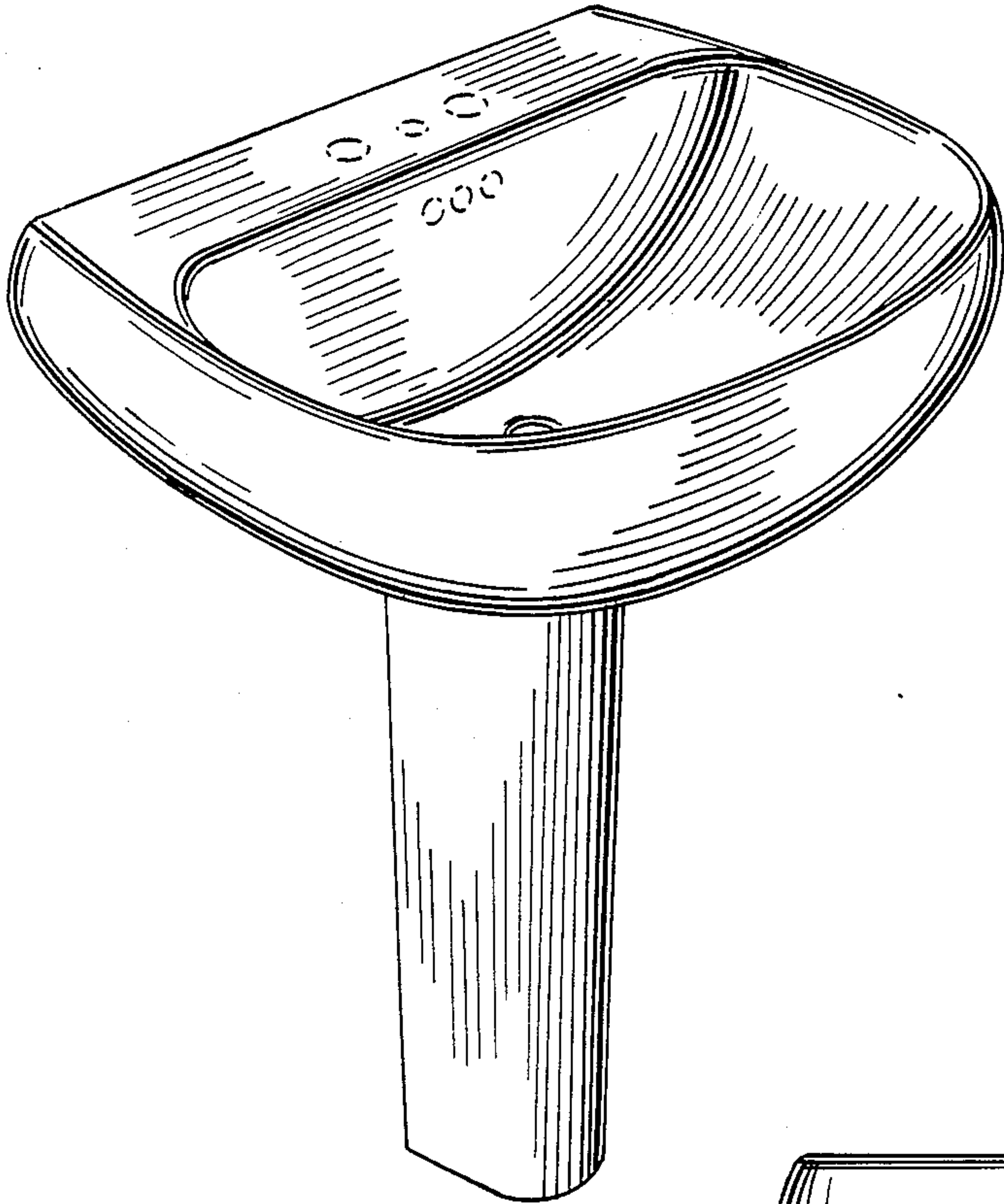

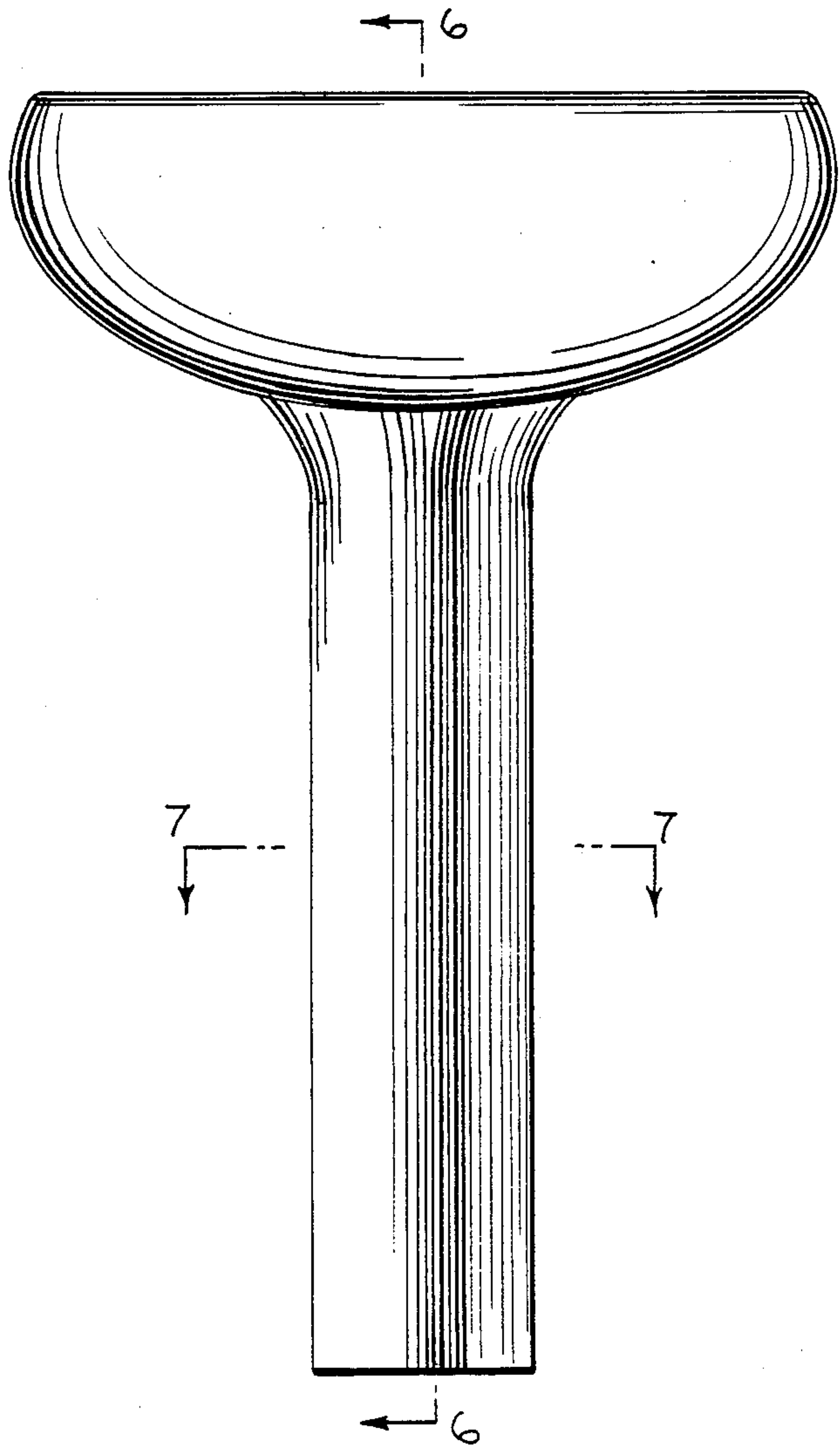

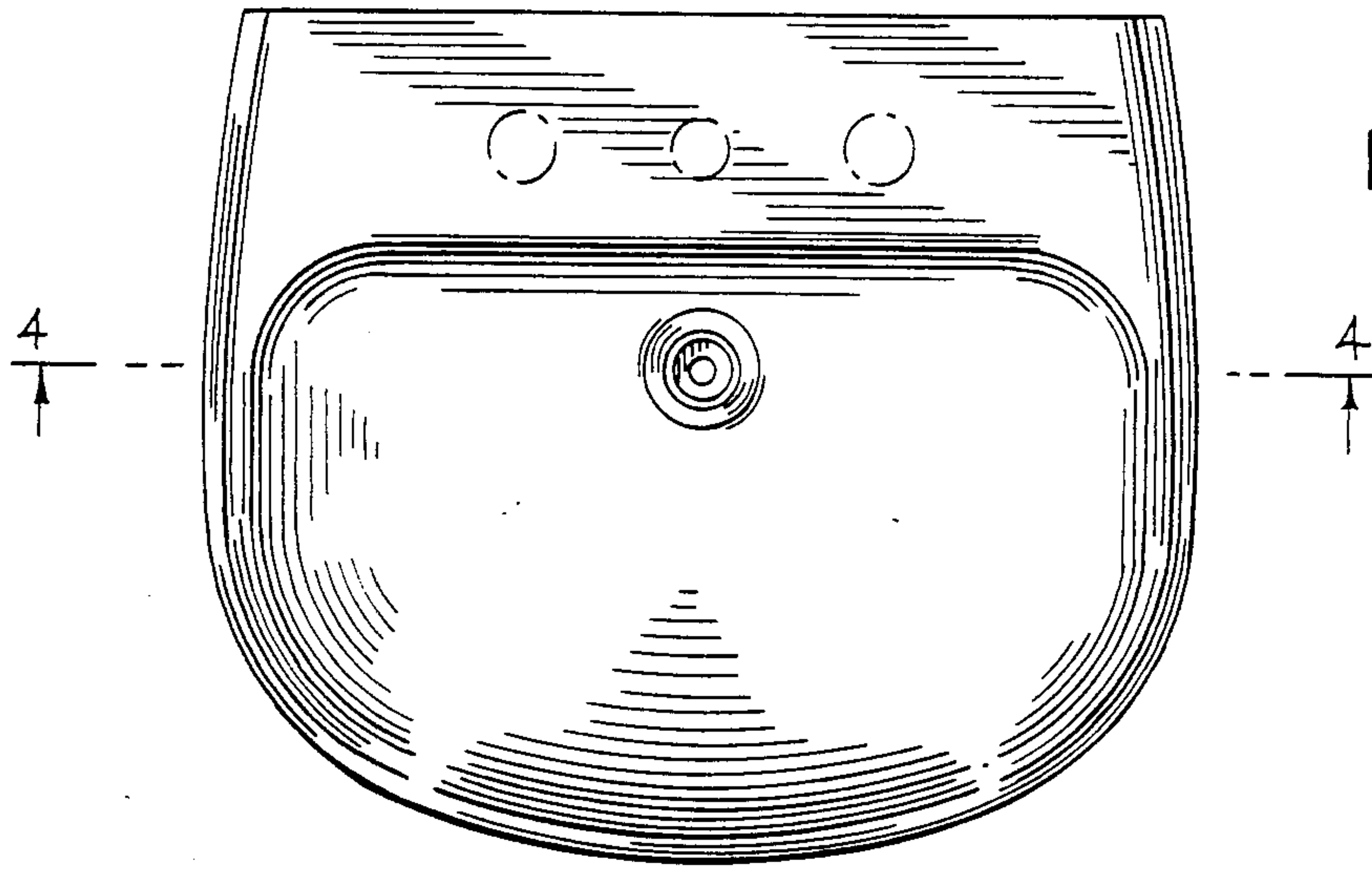

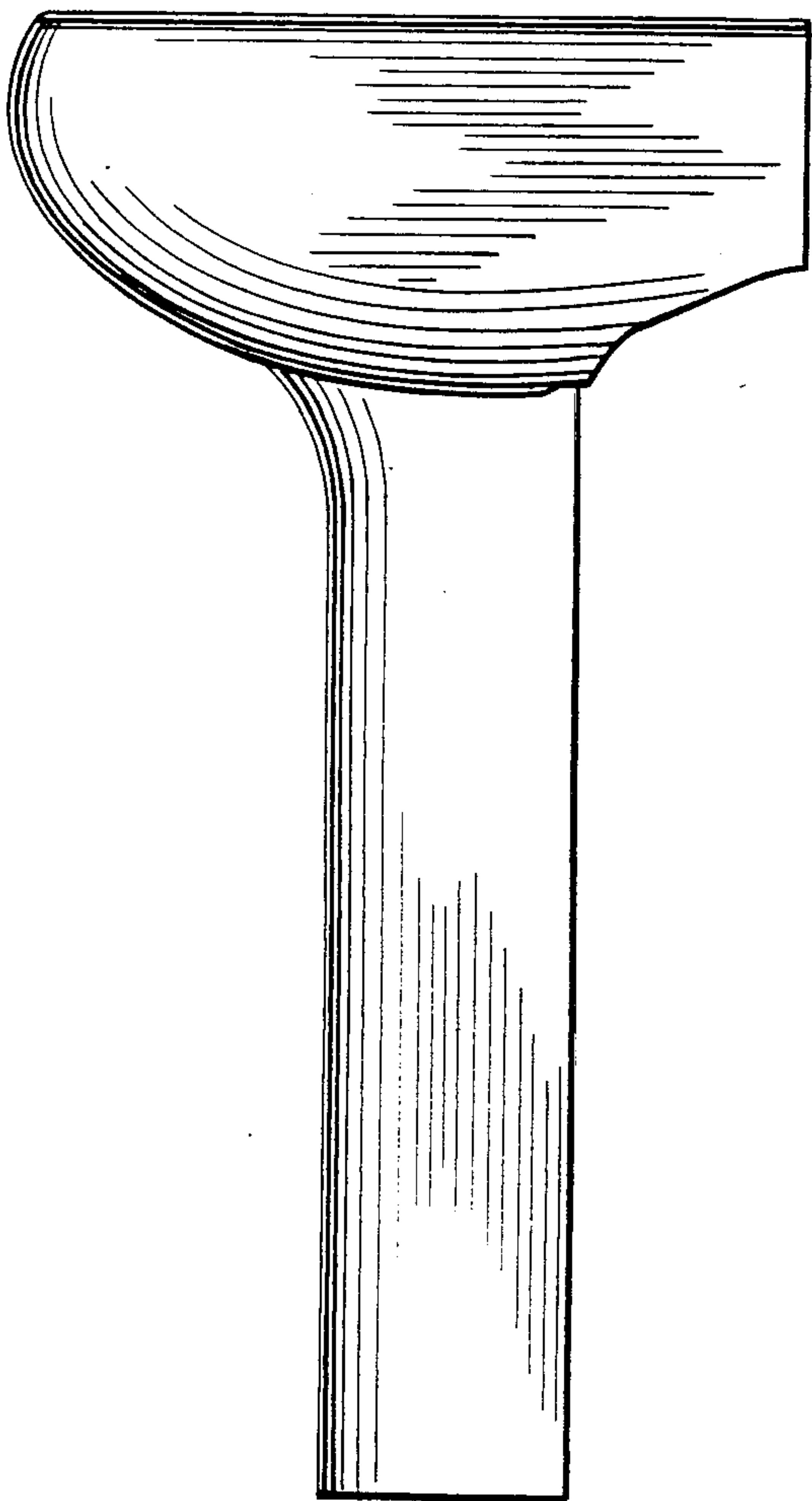
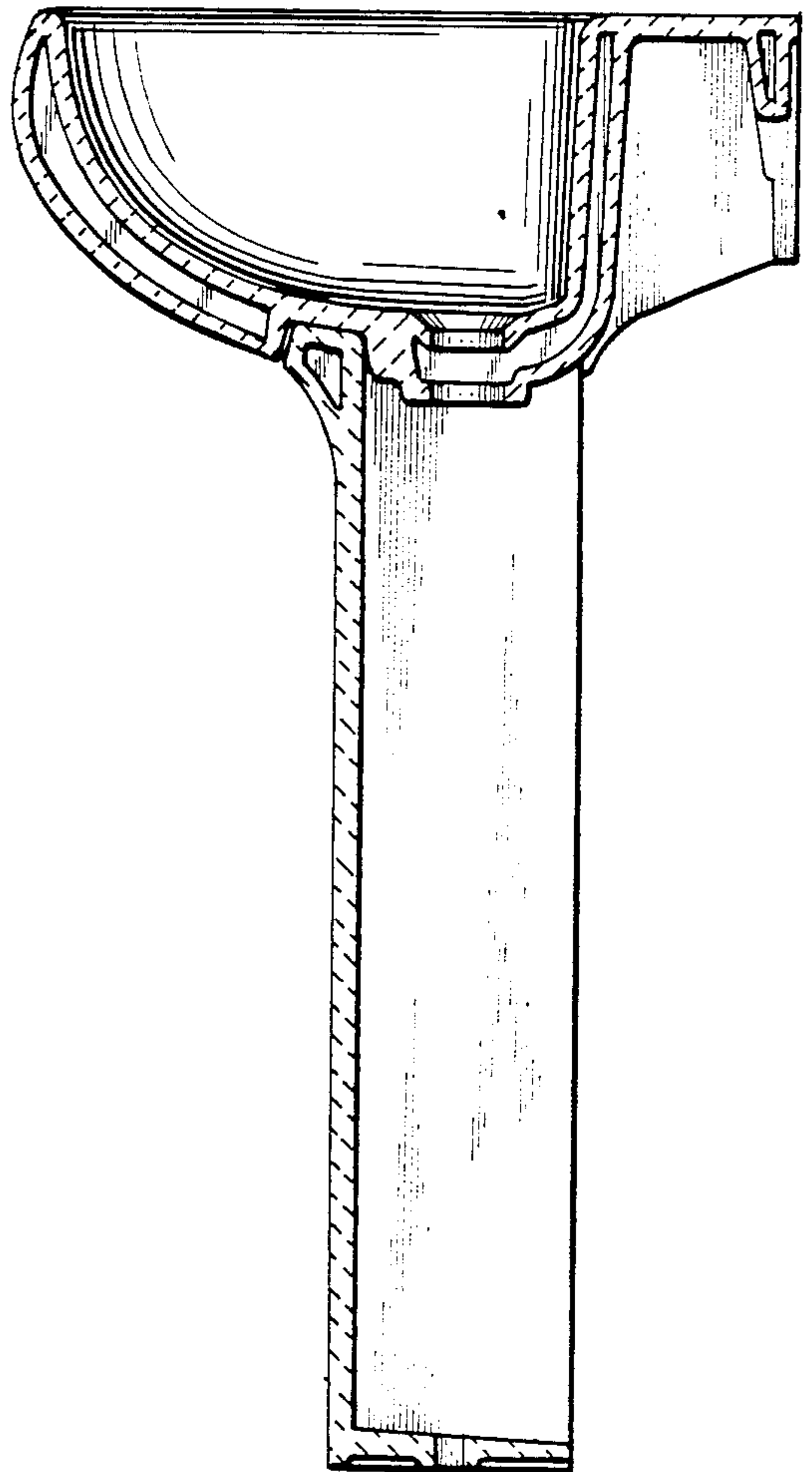

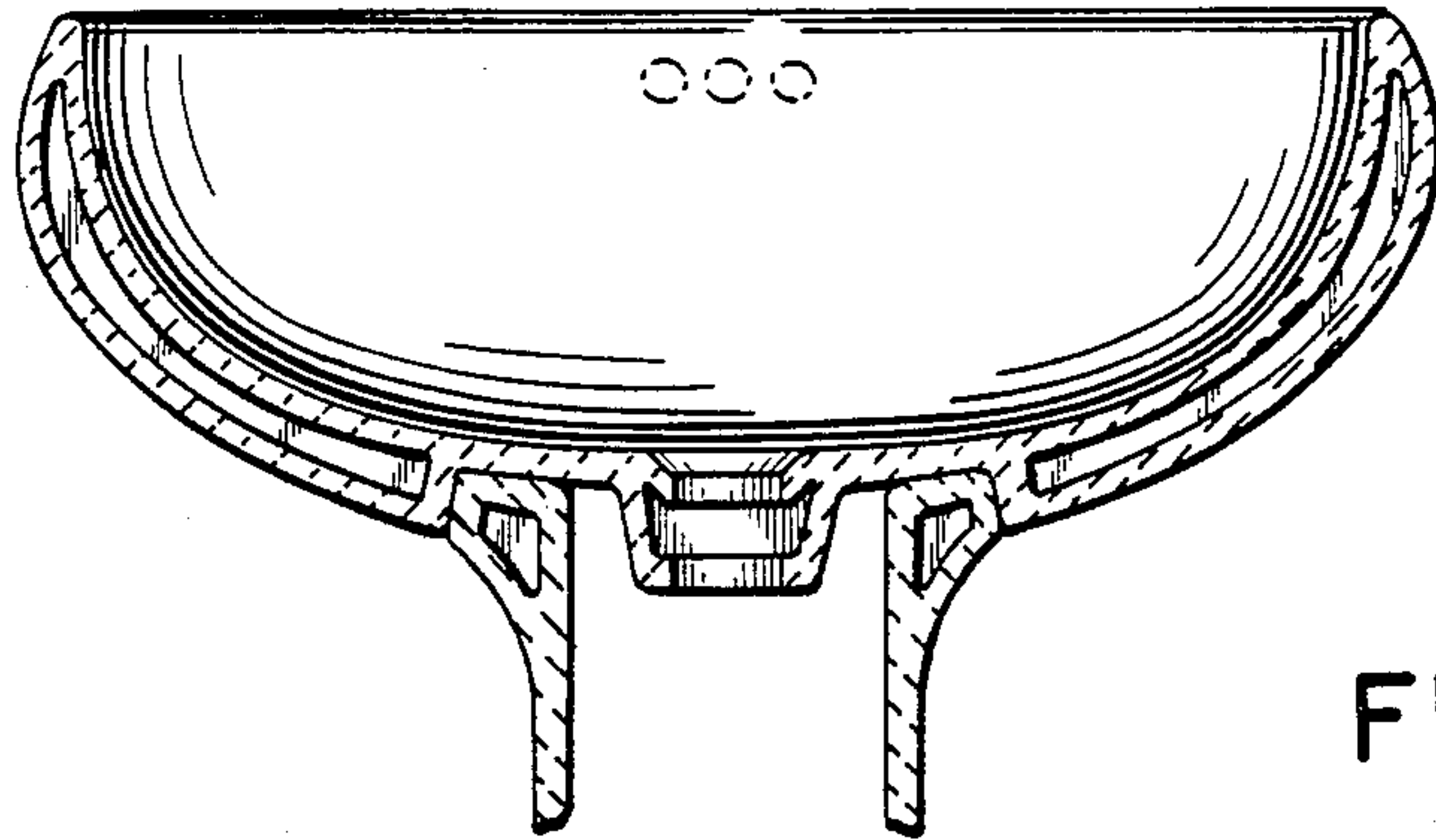

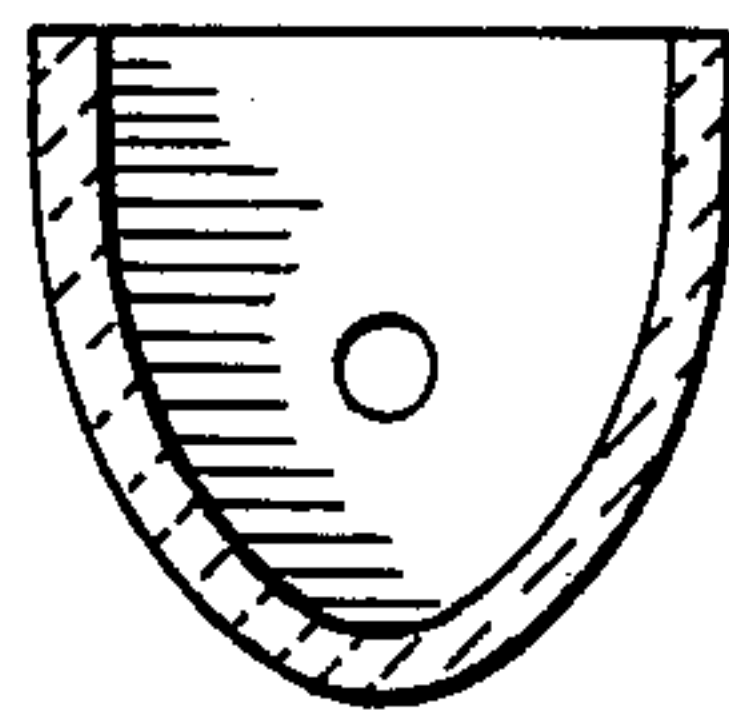

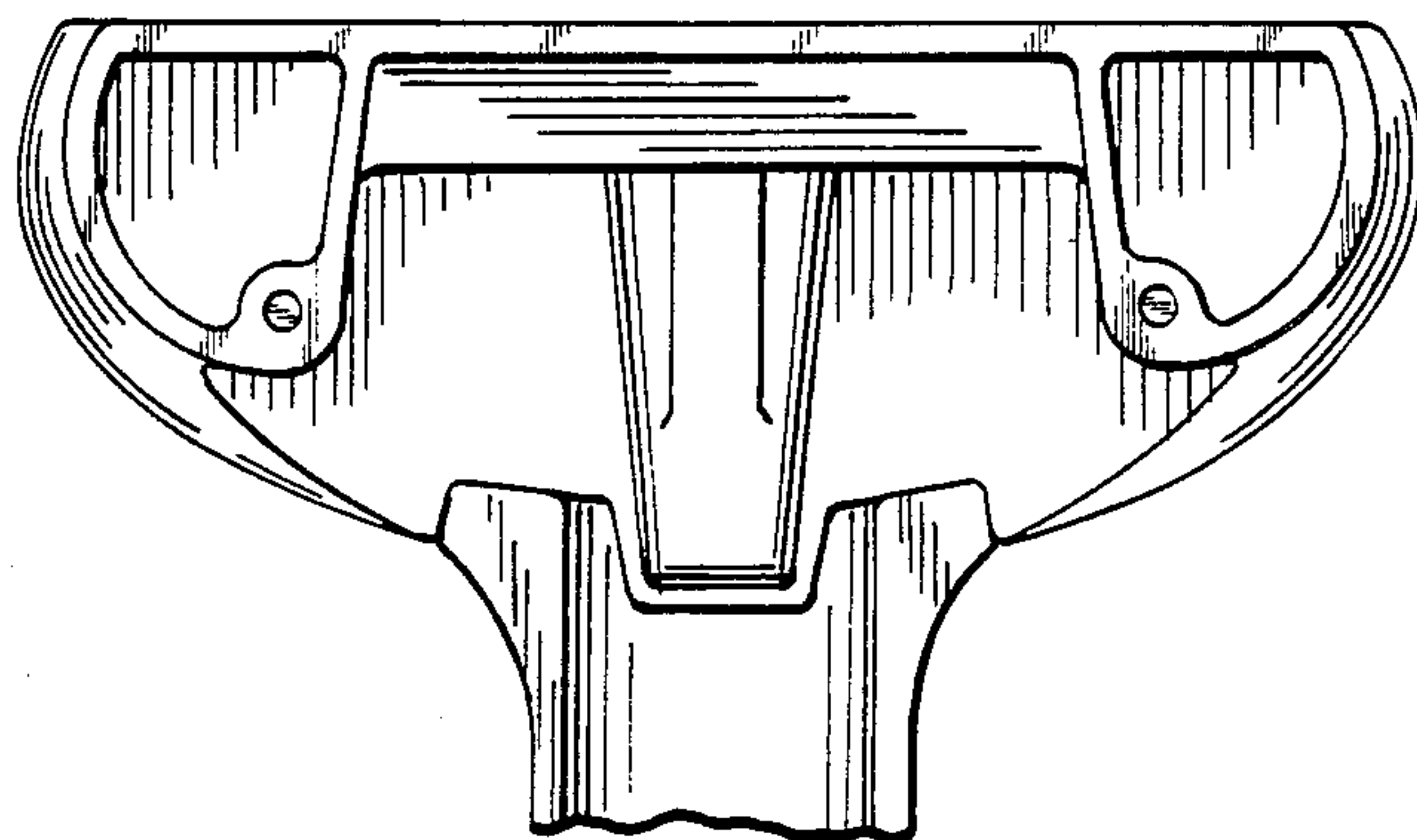
