FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

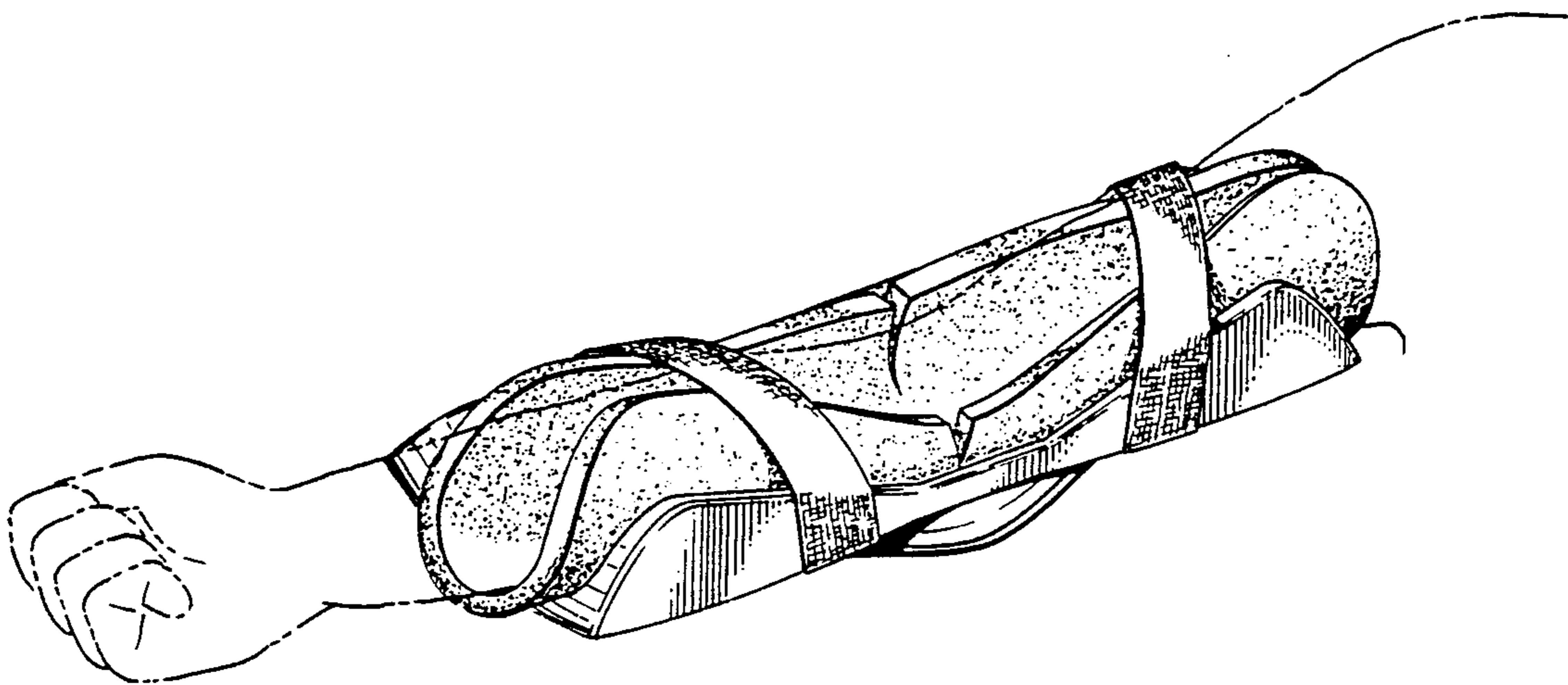
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; and,

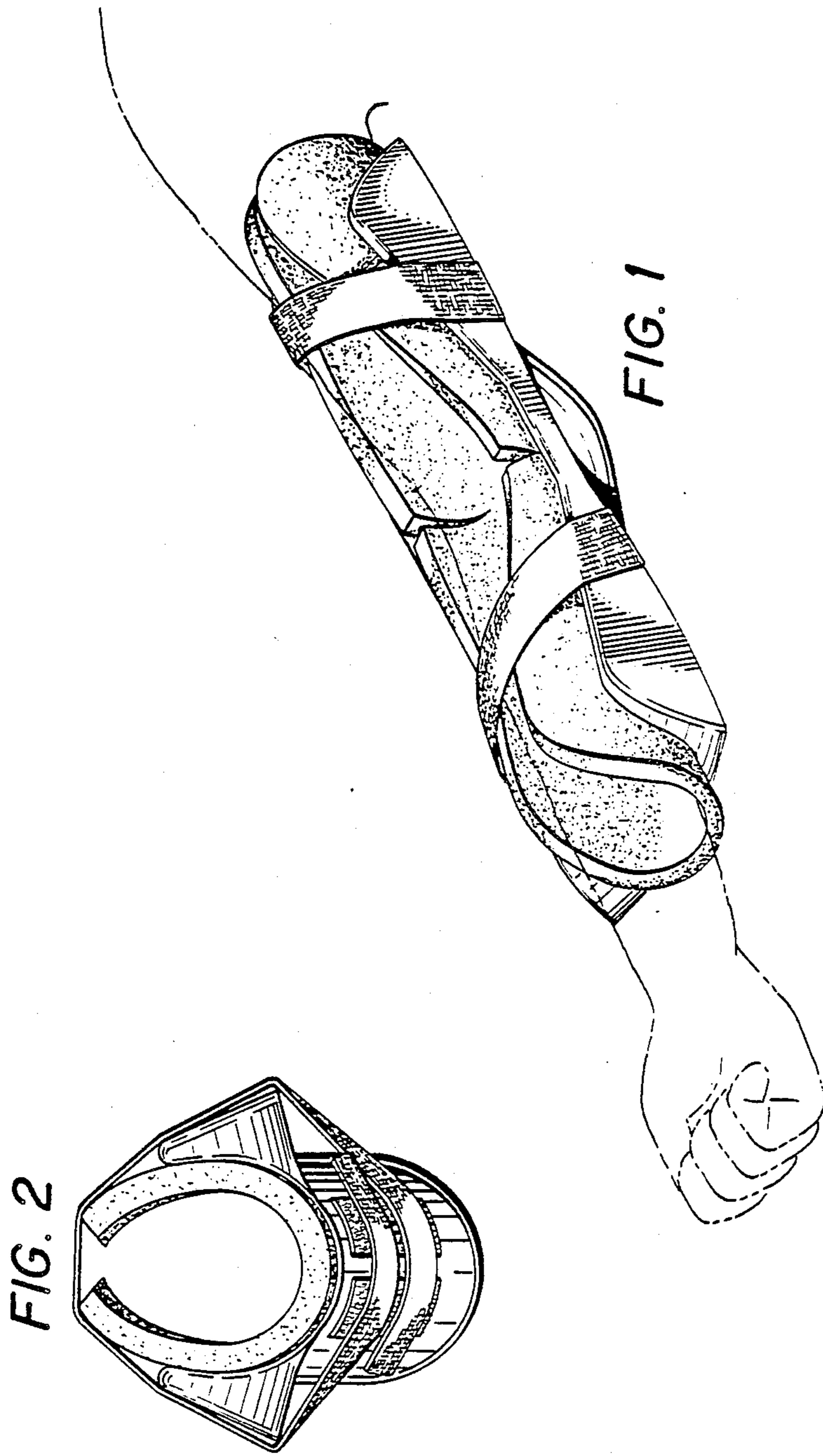
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

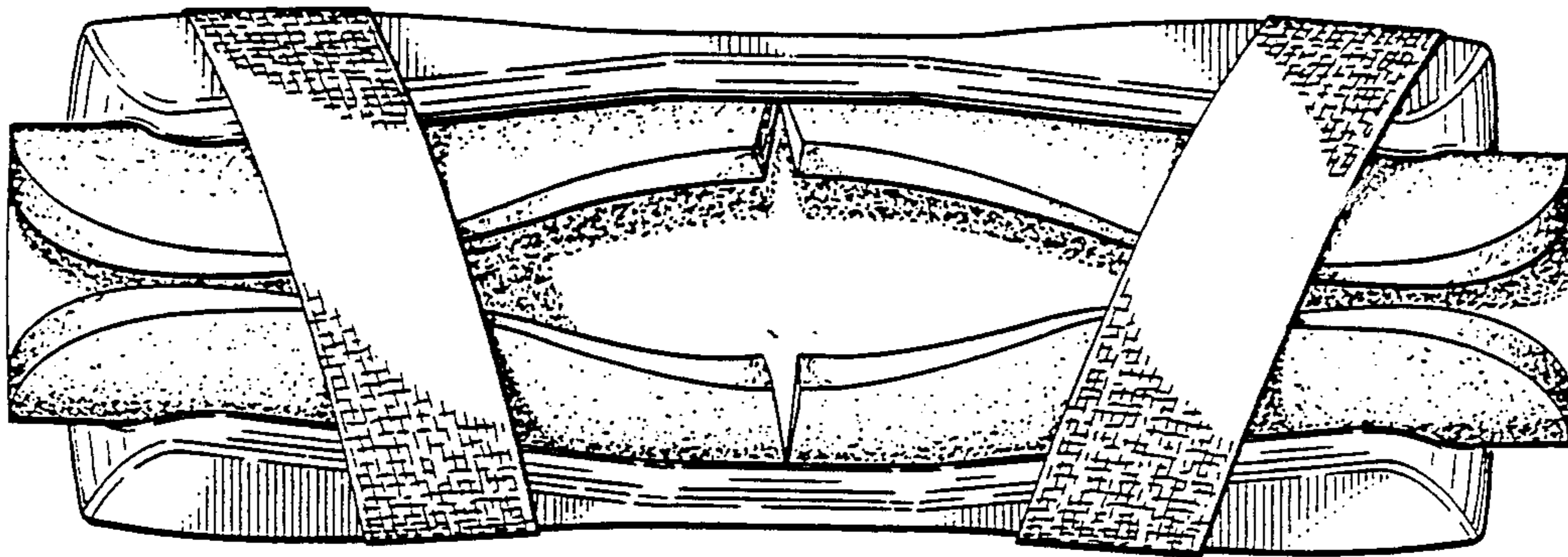

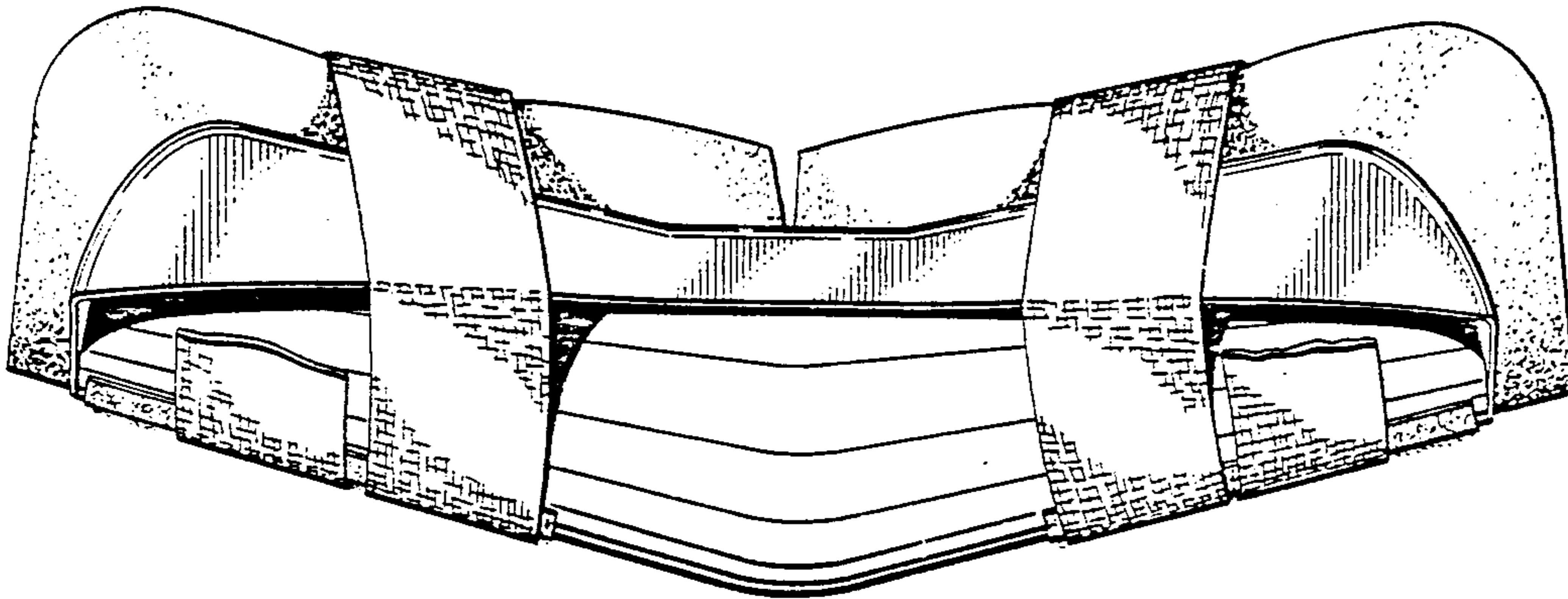

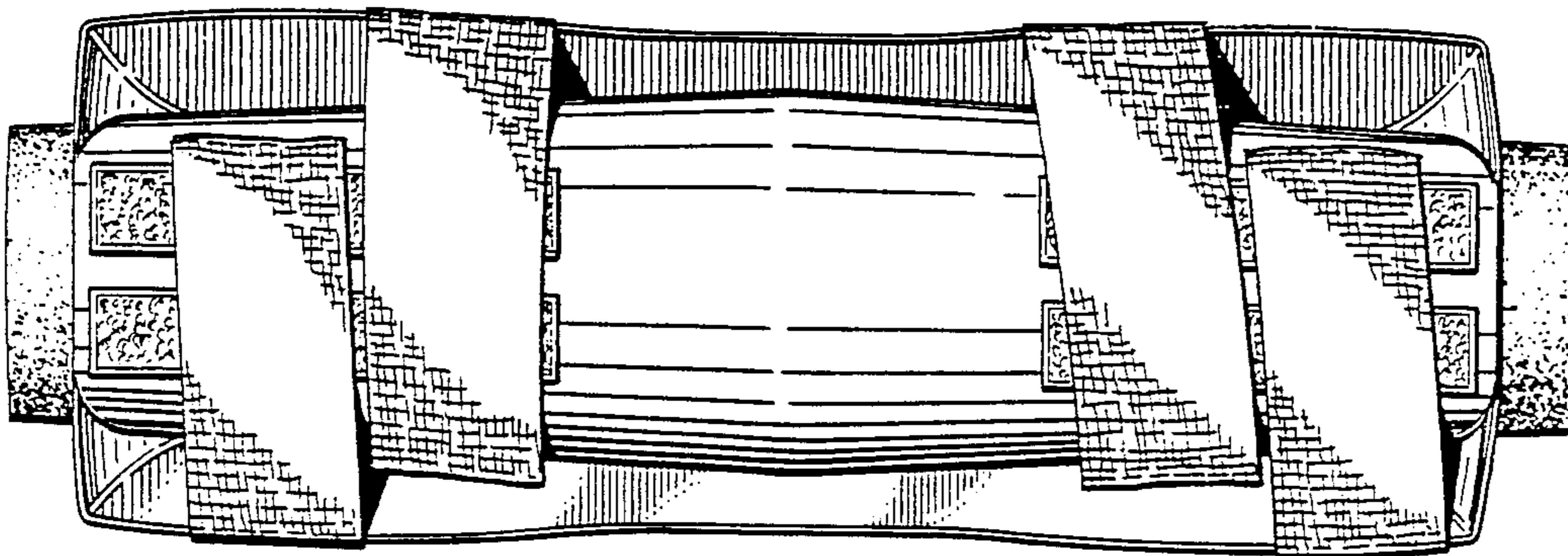
