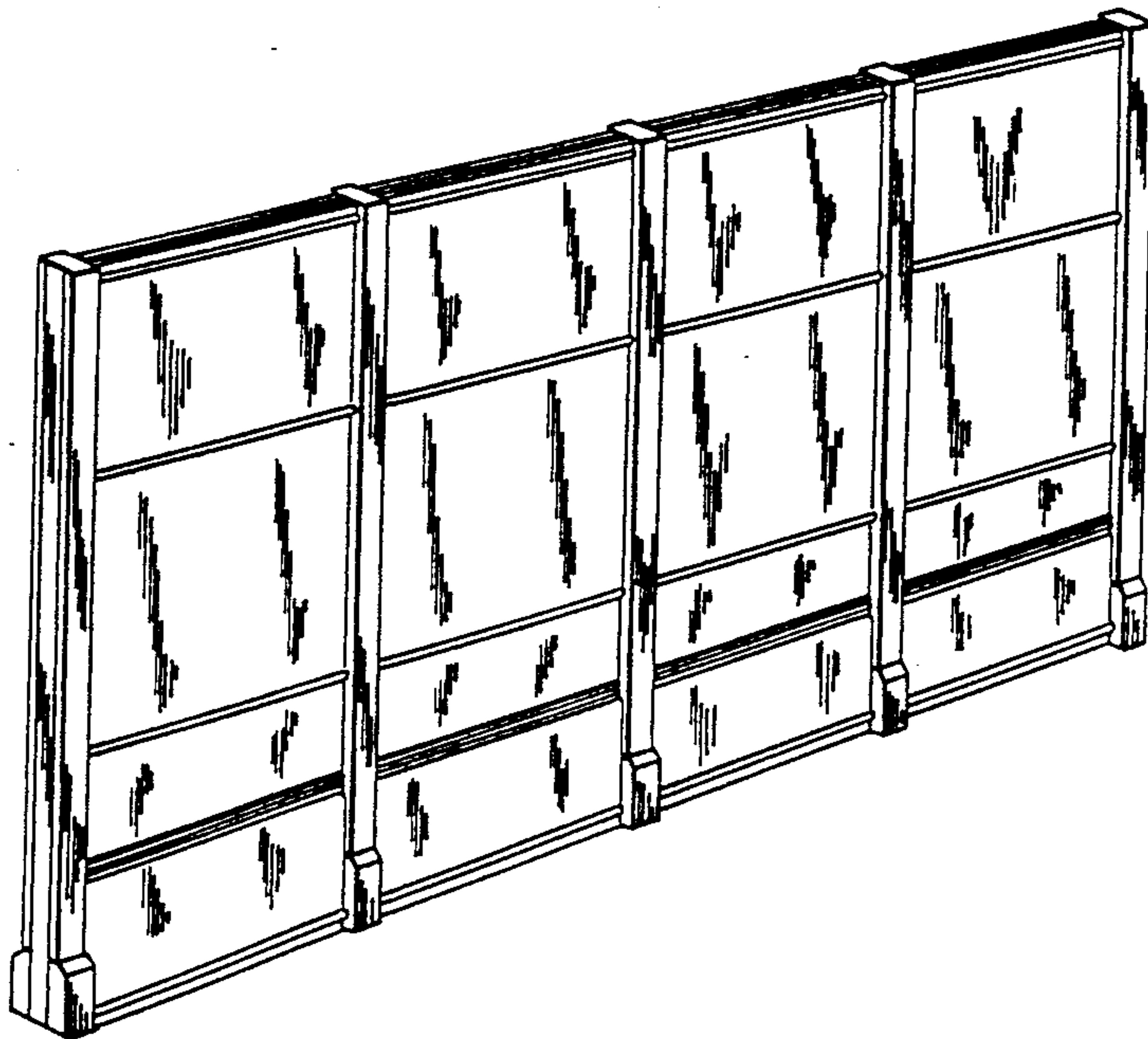
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a partition unit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a partition unit showing my new design; the opposite side being identical thereto; and,

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a modified form of the unit shown in FIG. 1 the opposite side being flat and unornamented.



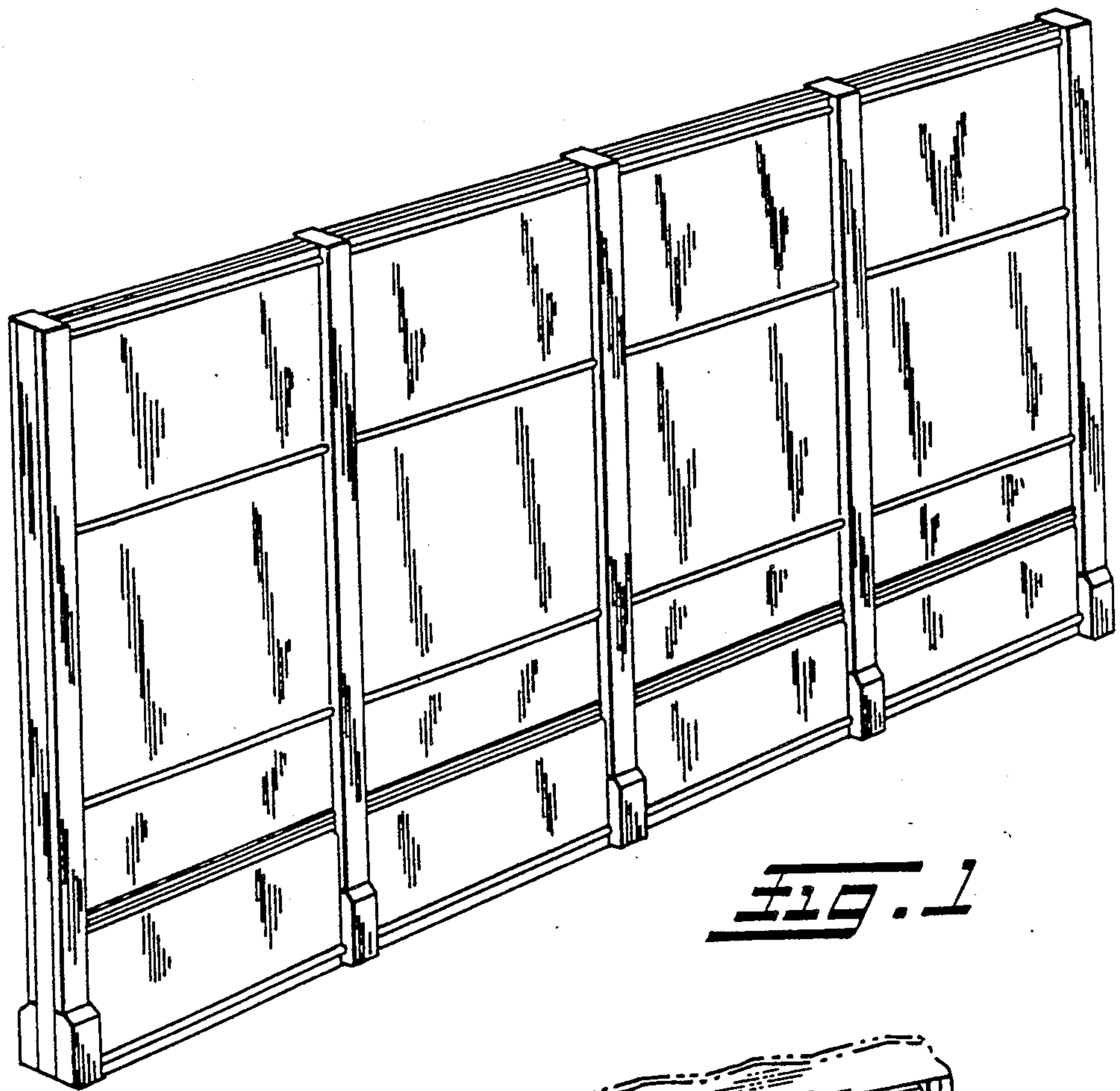

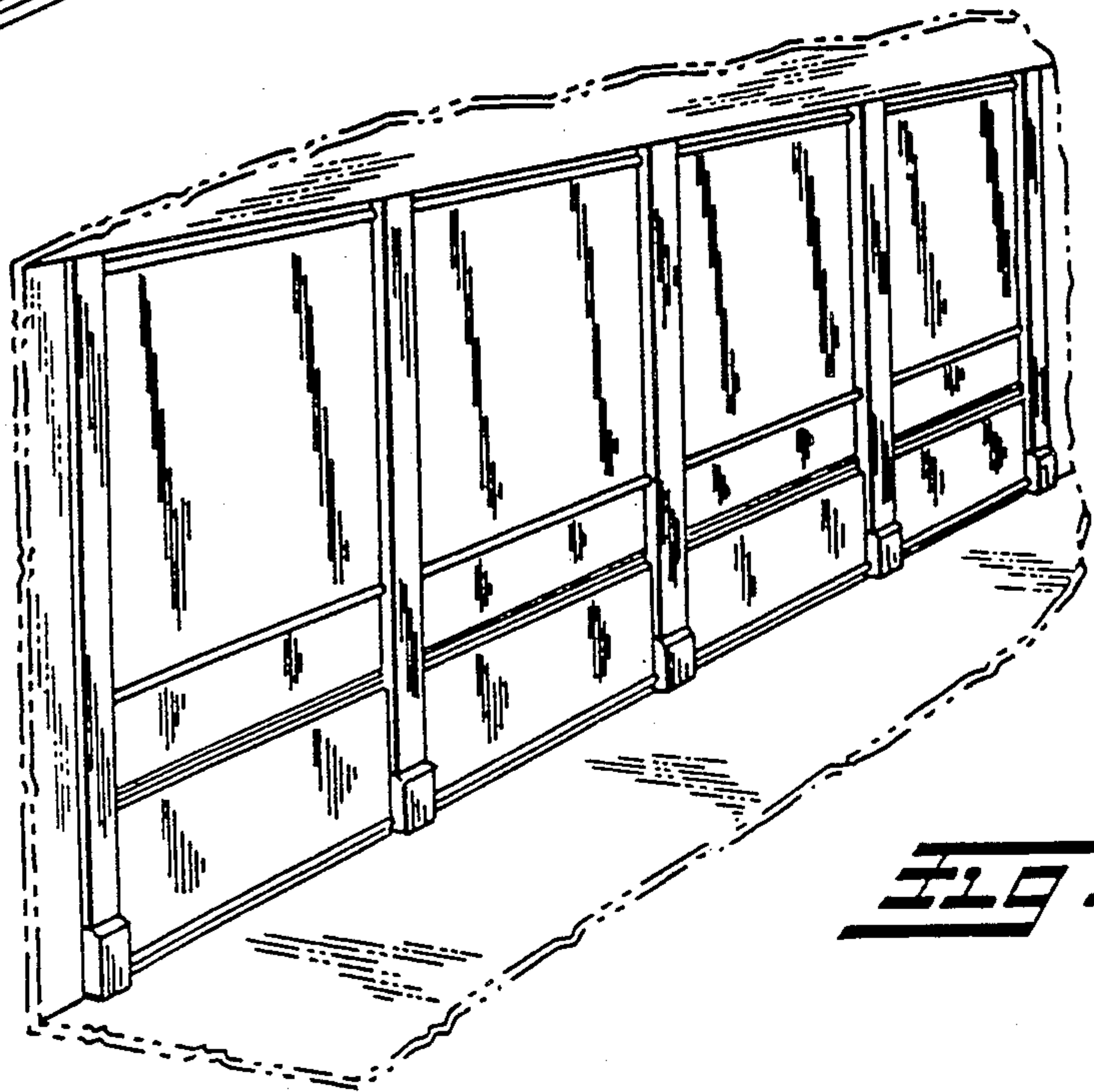
